FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a flashlight holder showing my new design;

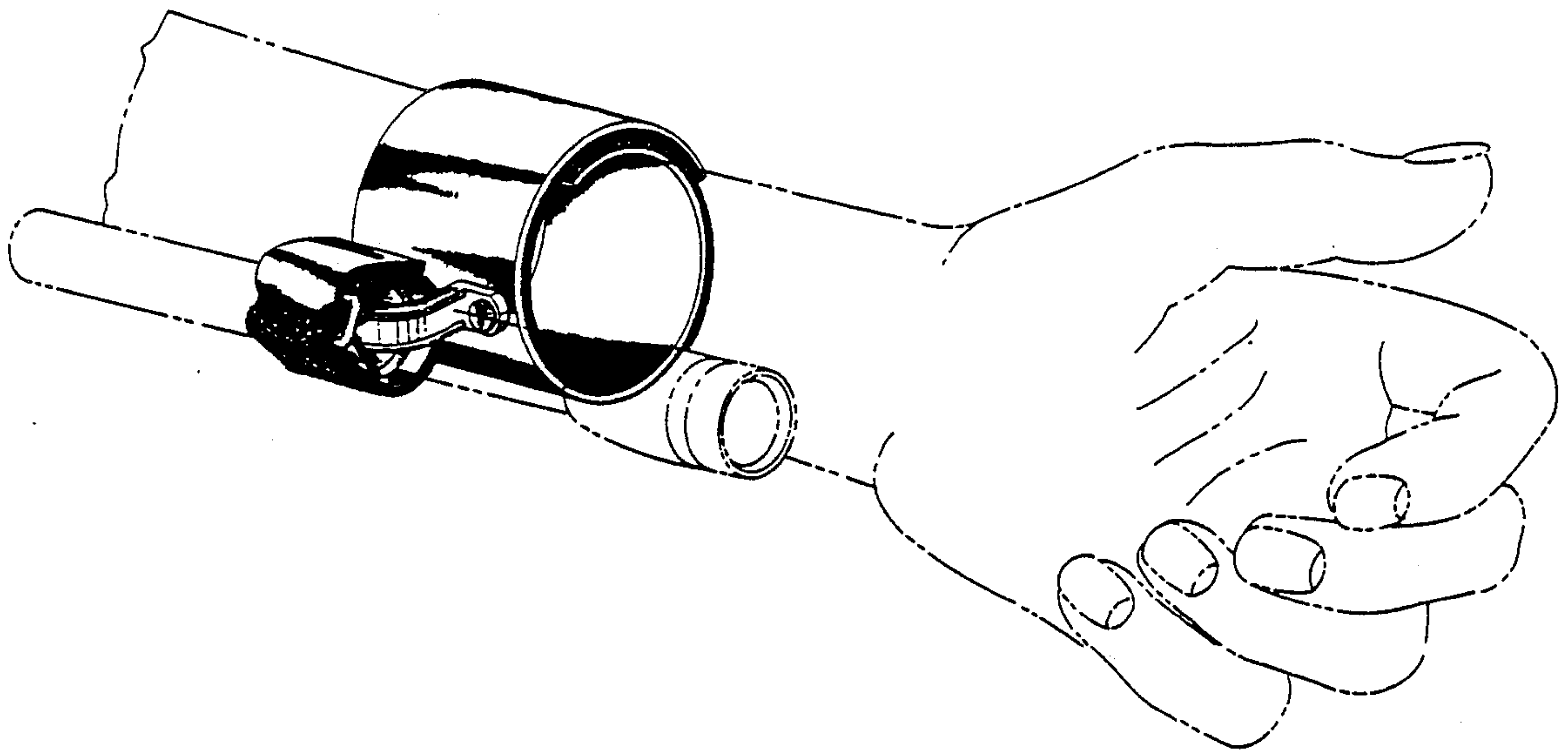
FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



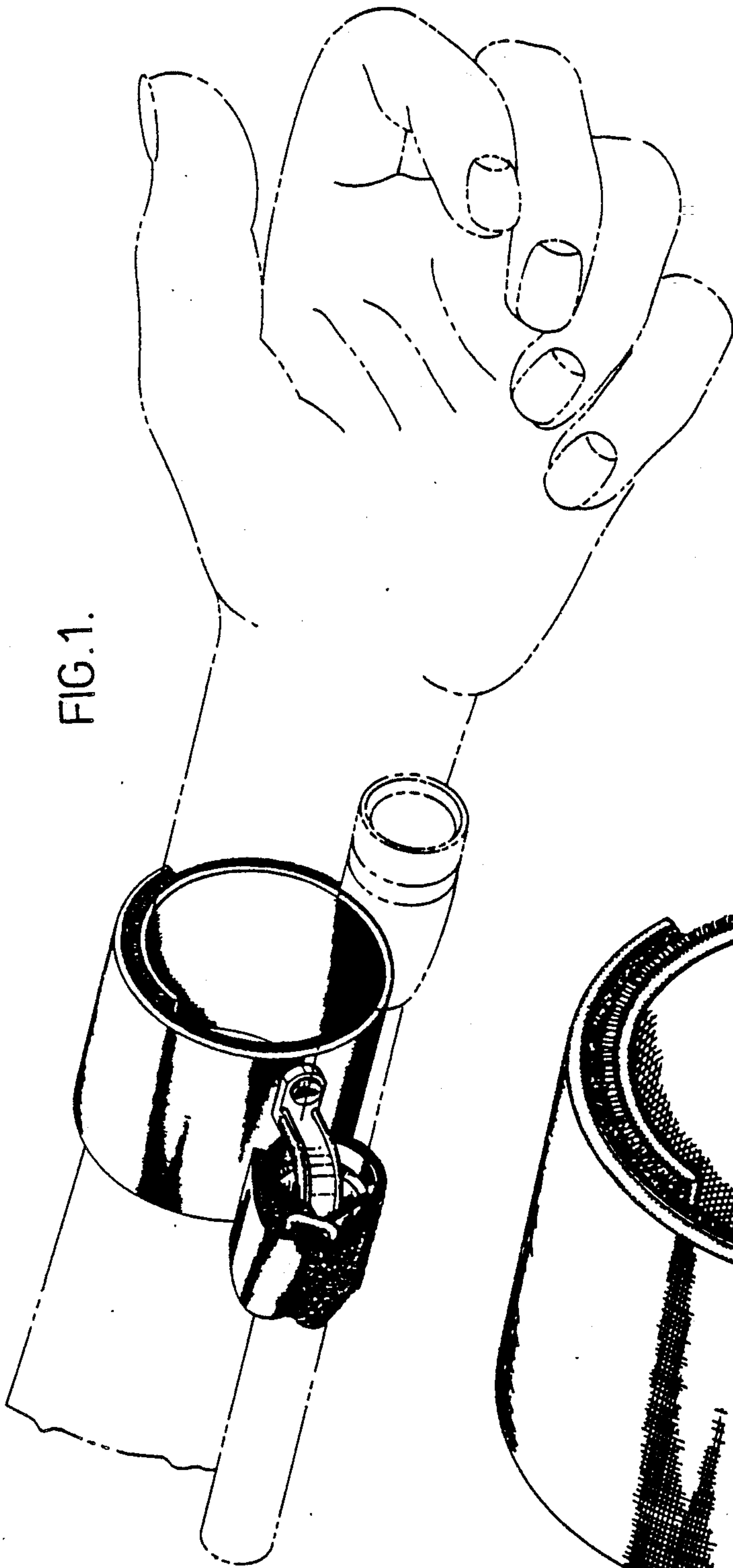

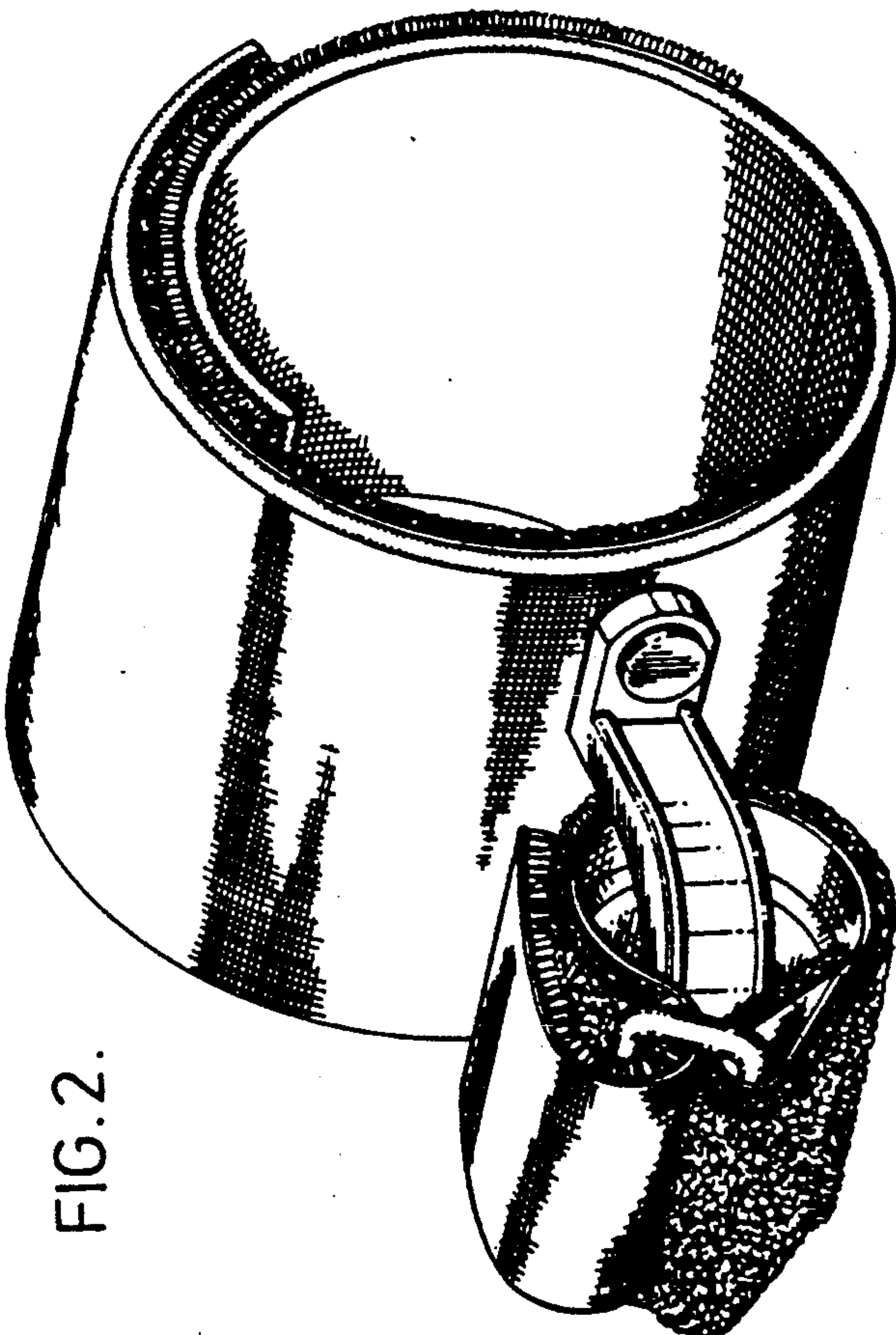

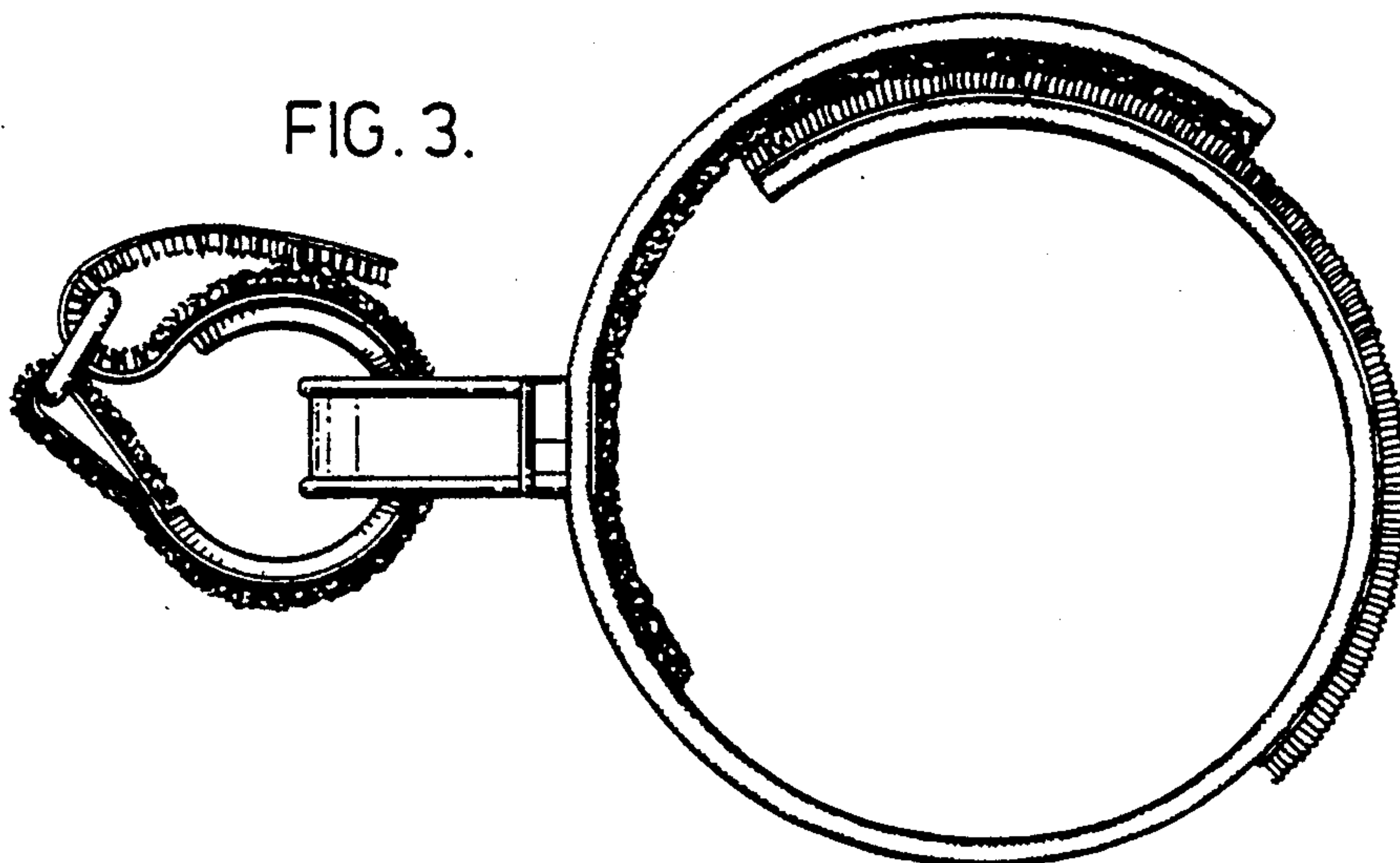

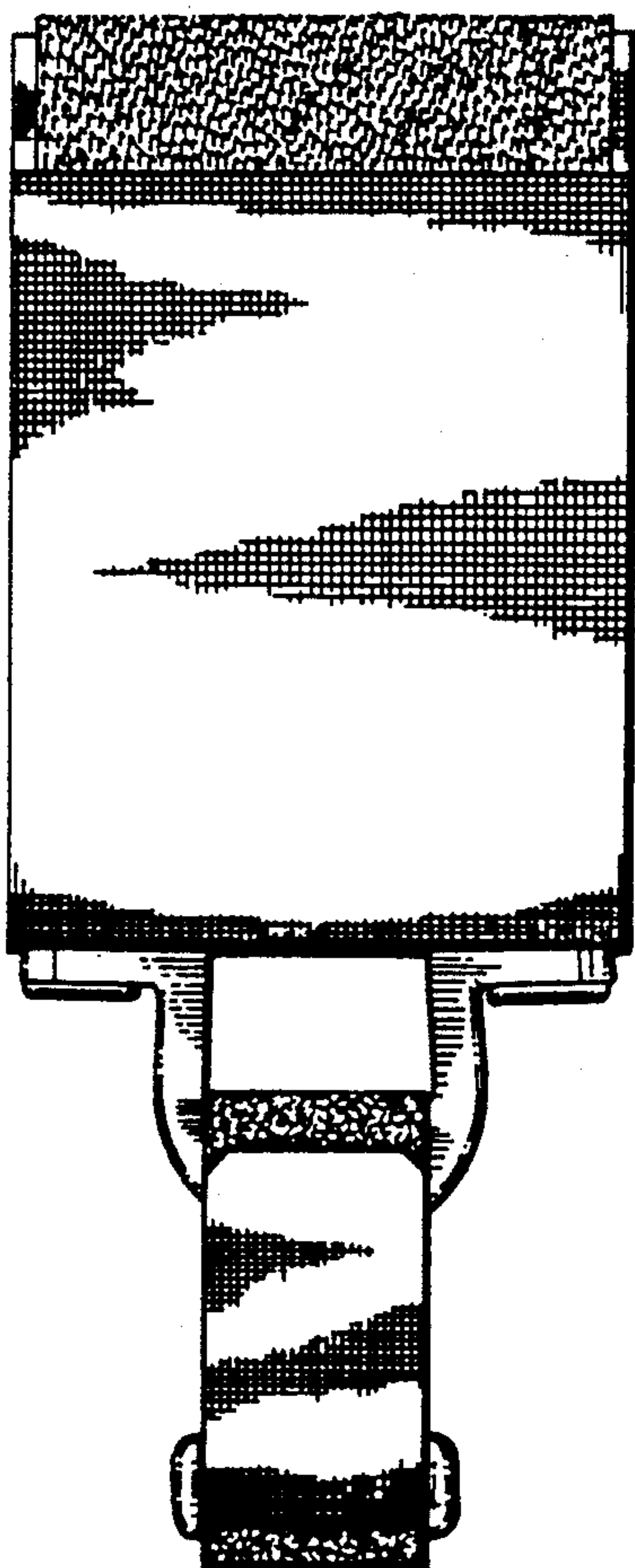

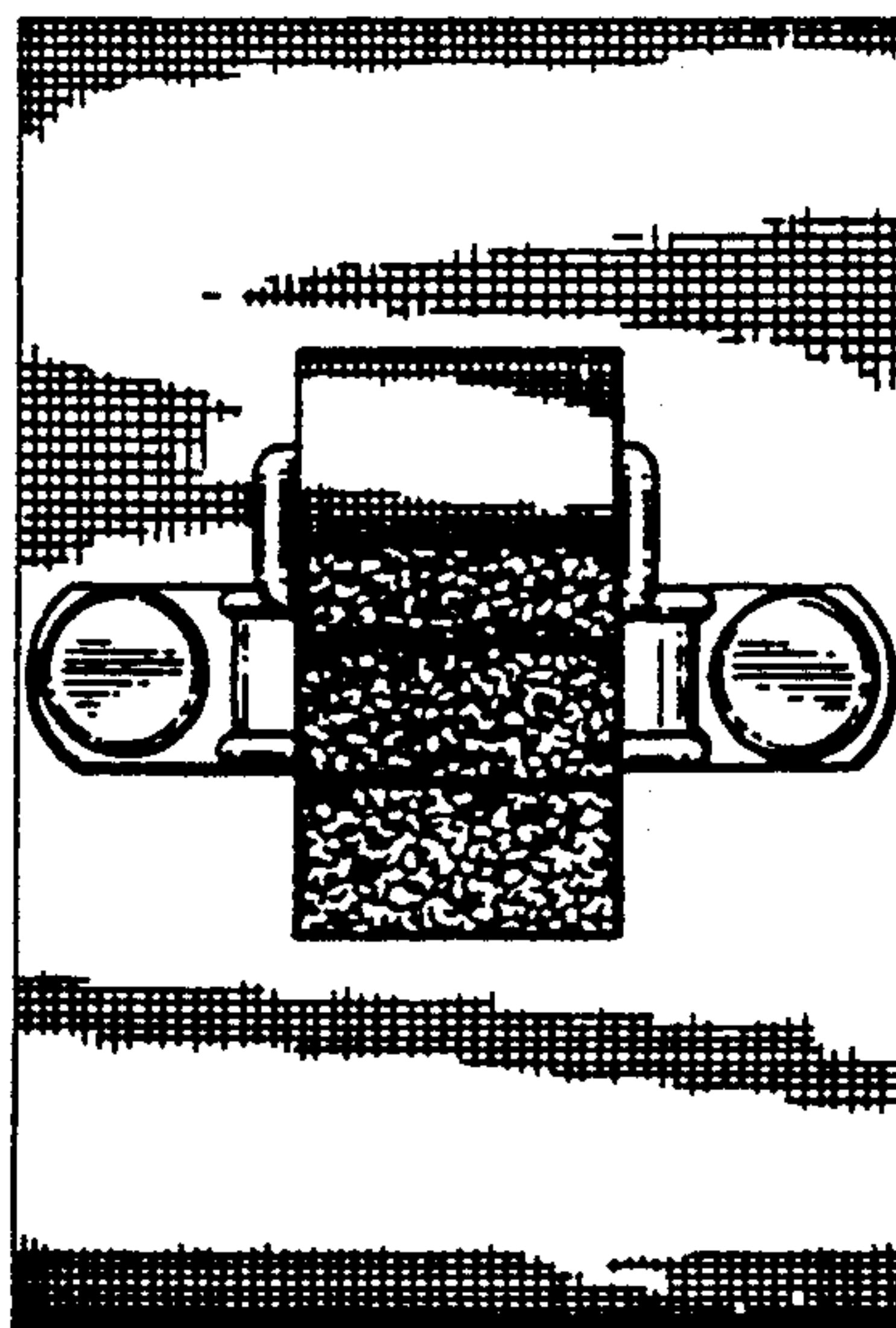
