FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe sole showing my new design in a position of use. The broken line showing of the shoe in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

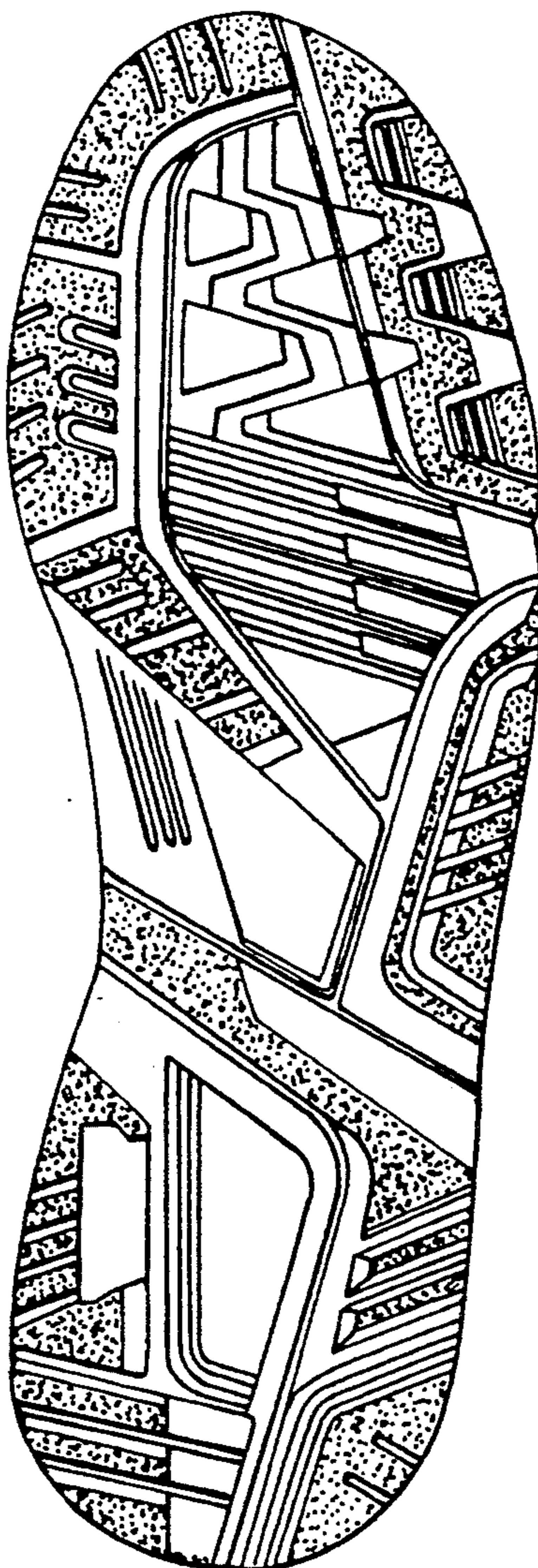

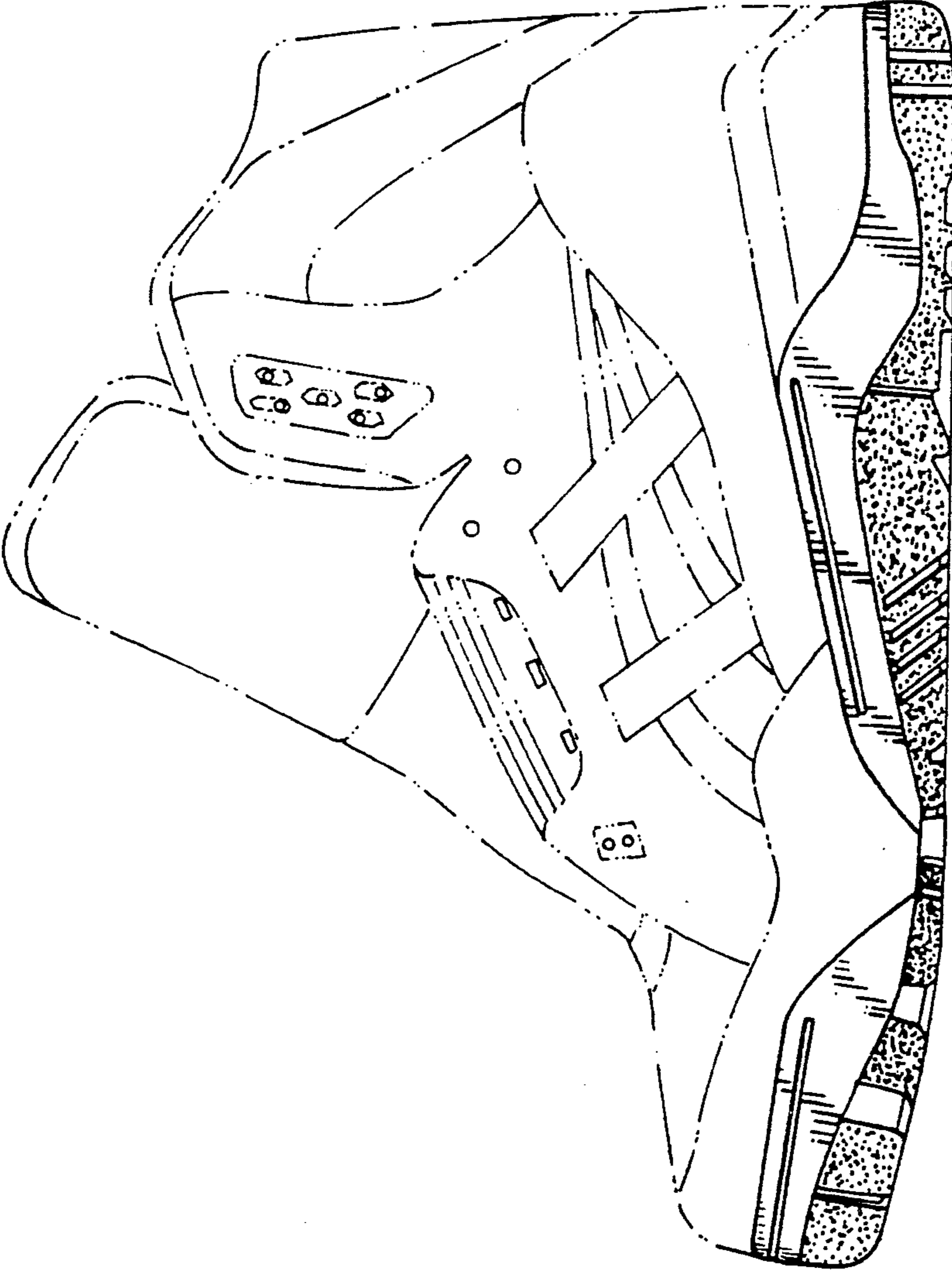

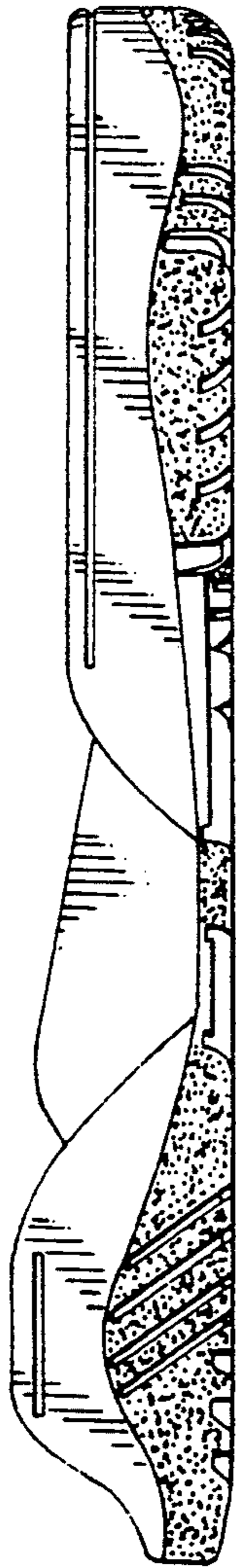

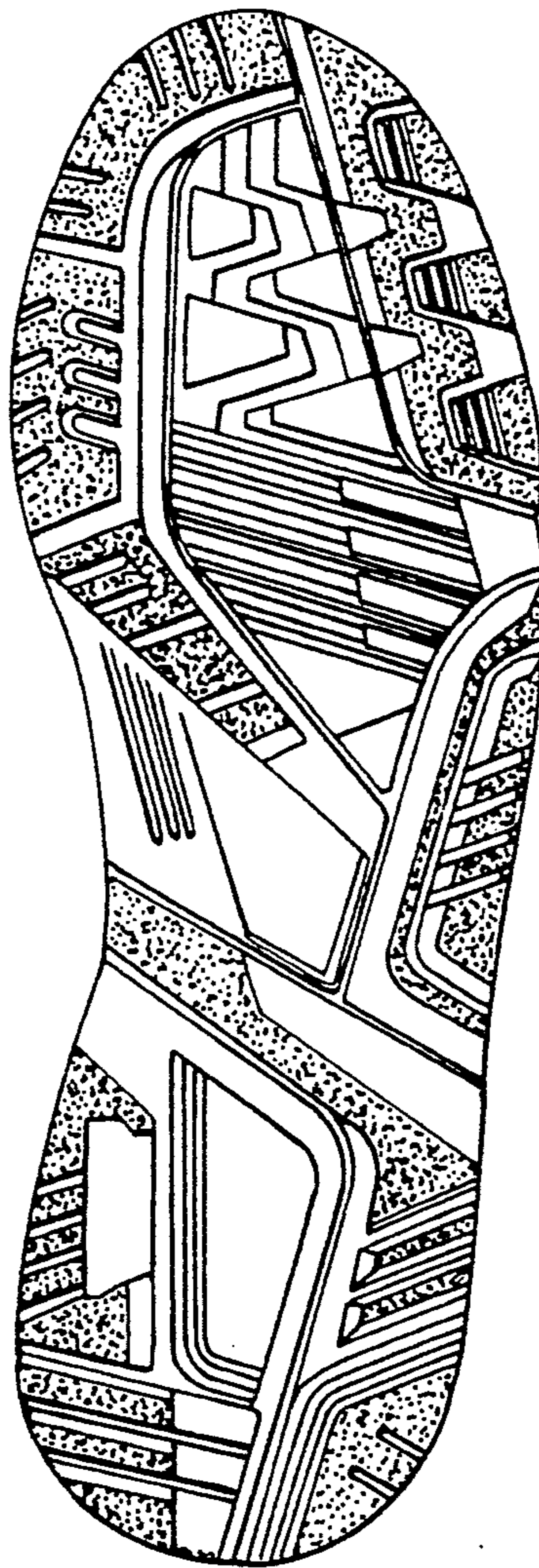

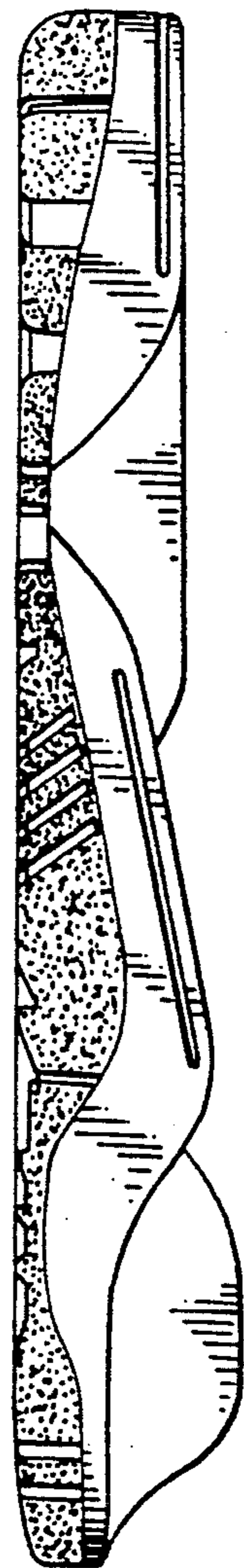

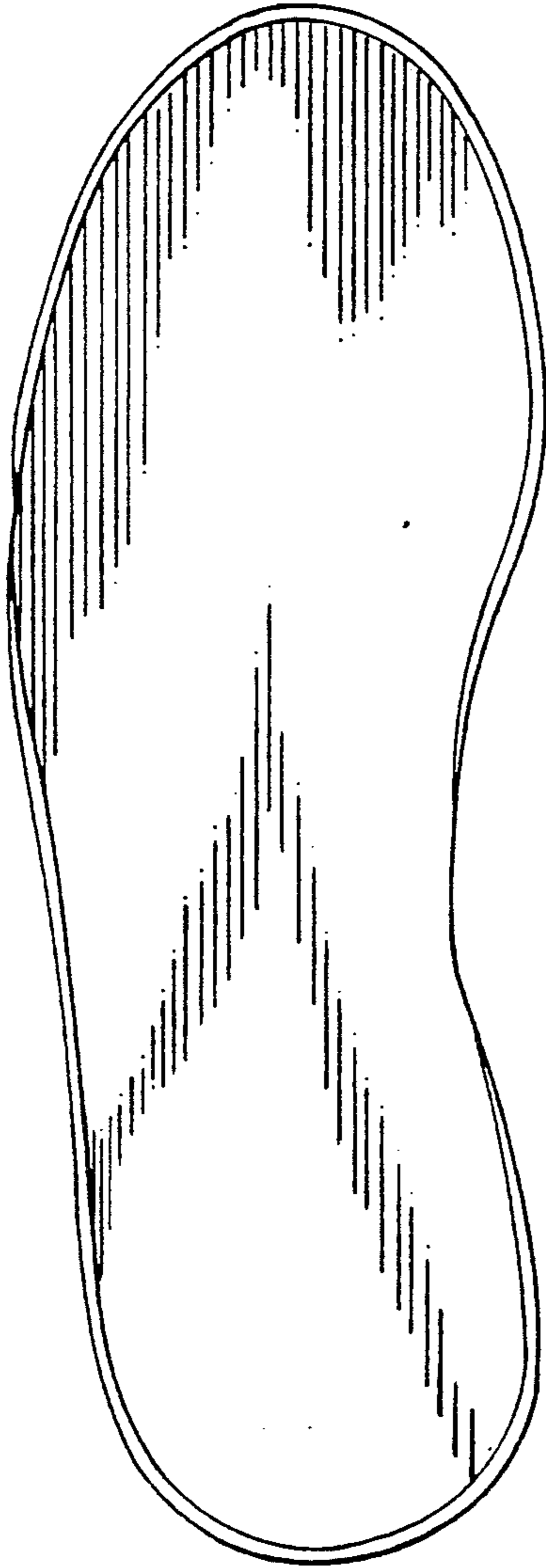

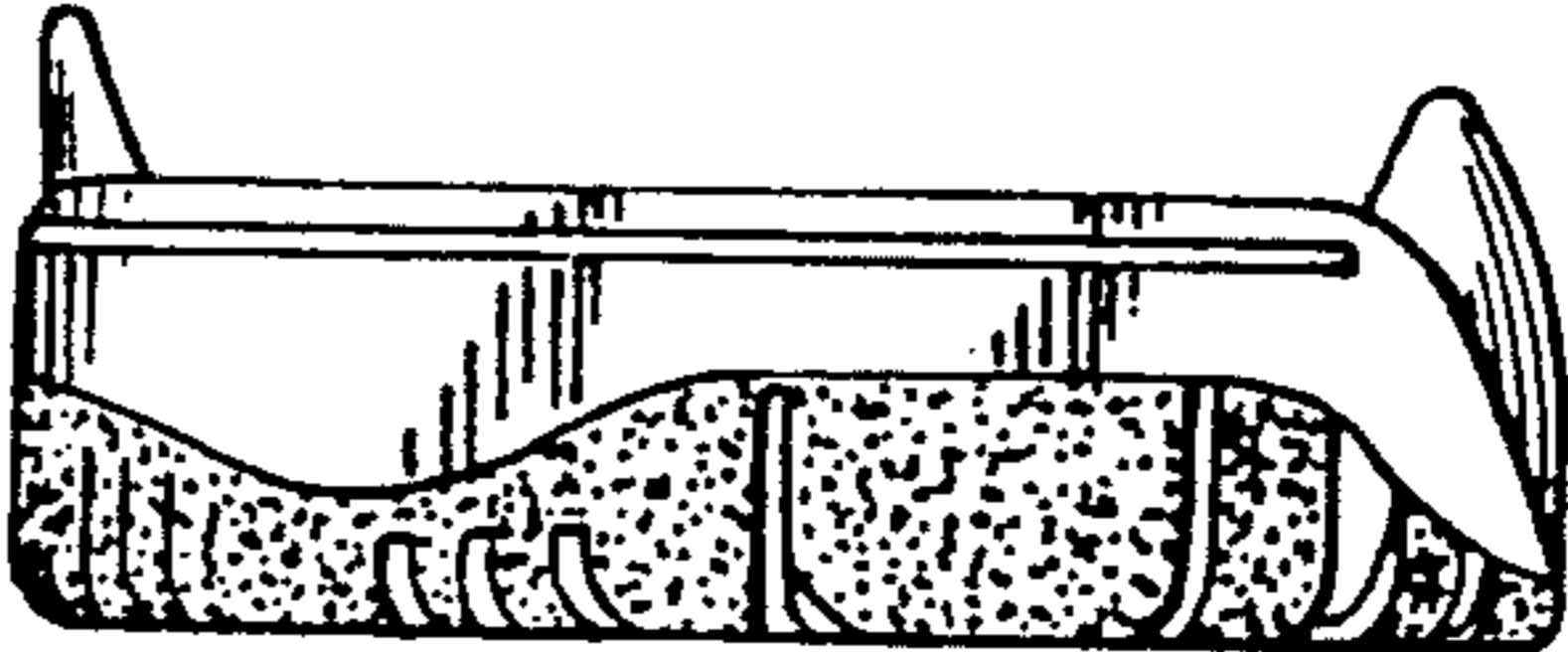

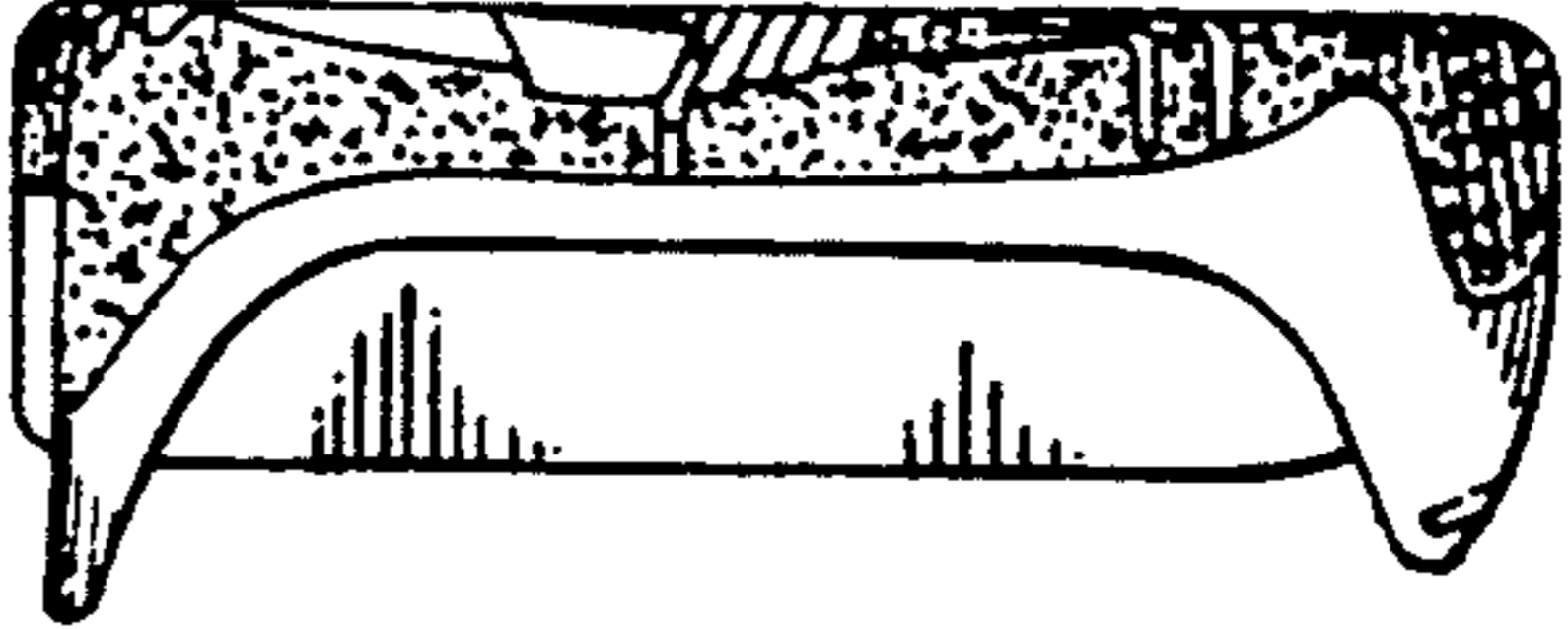
