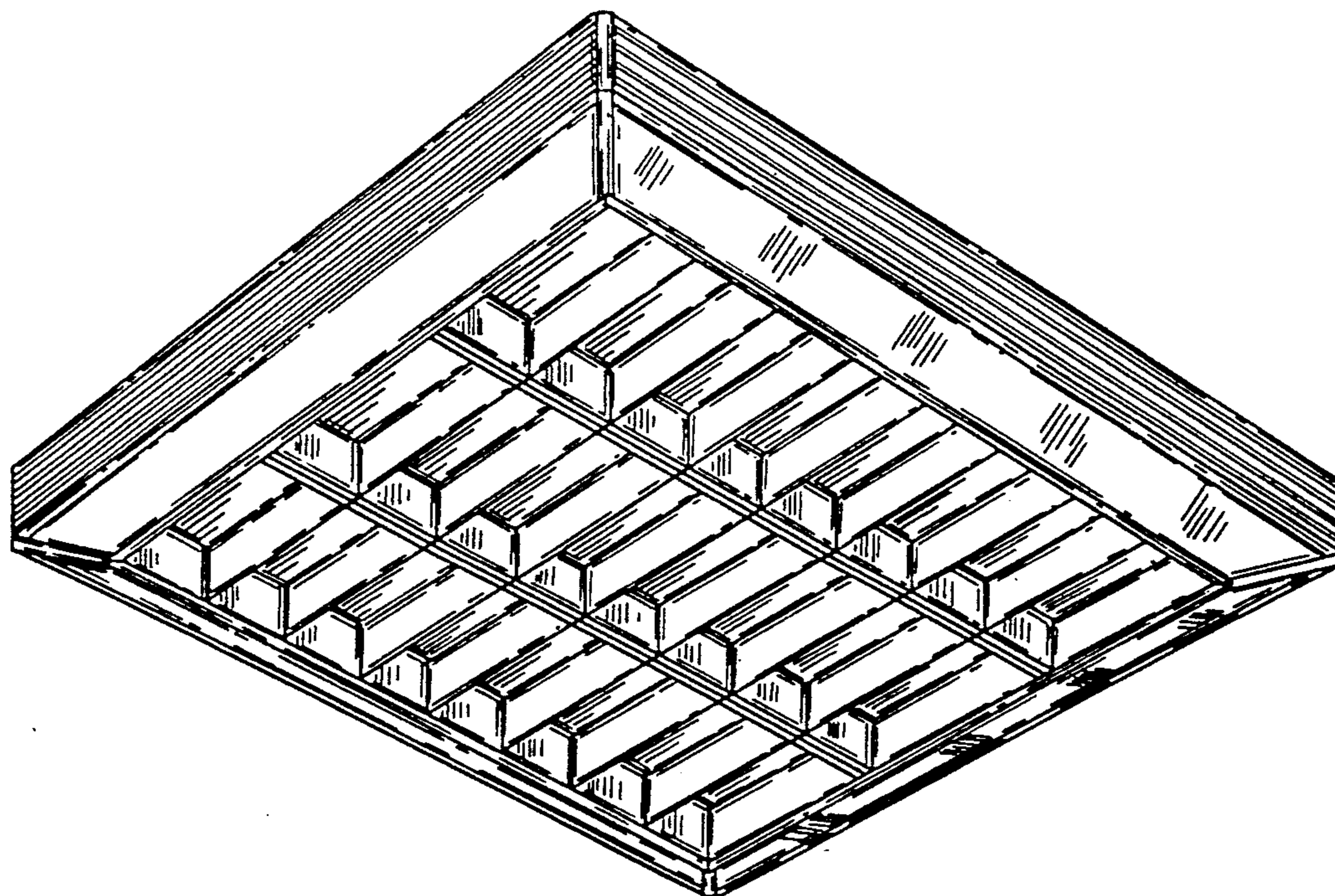
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.



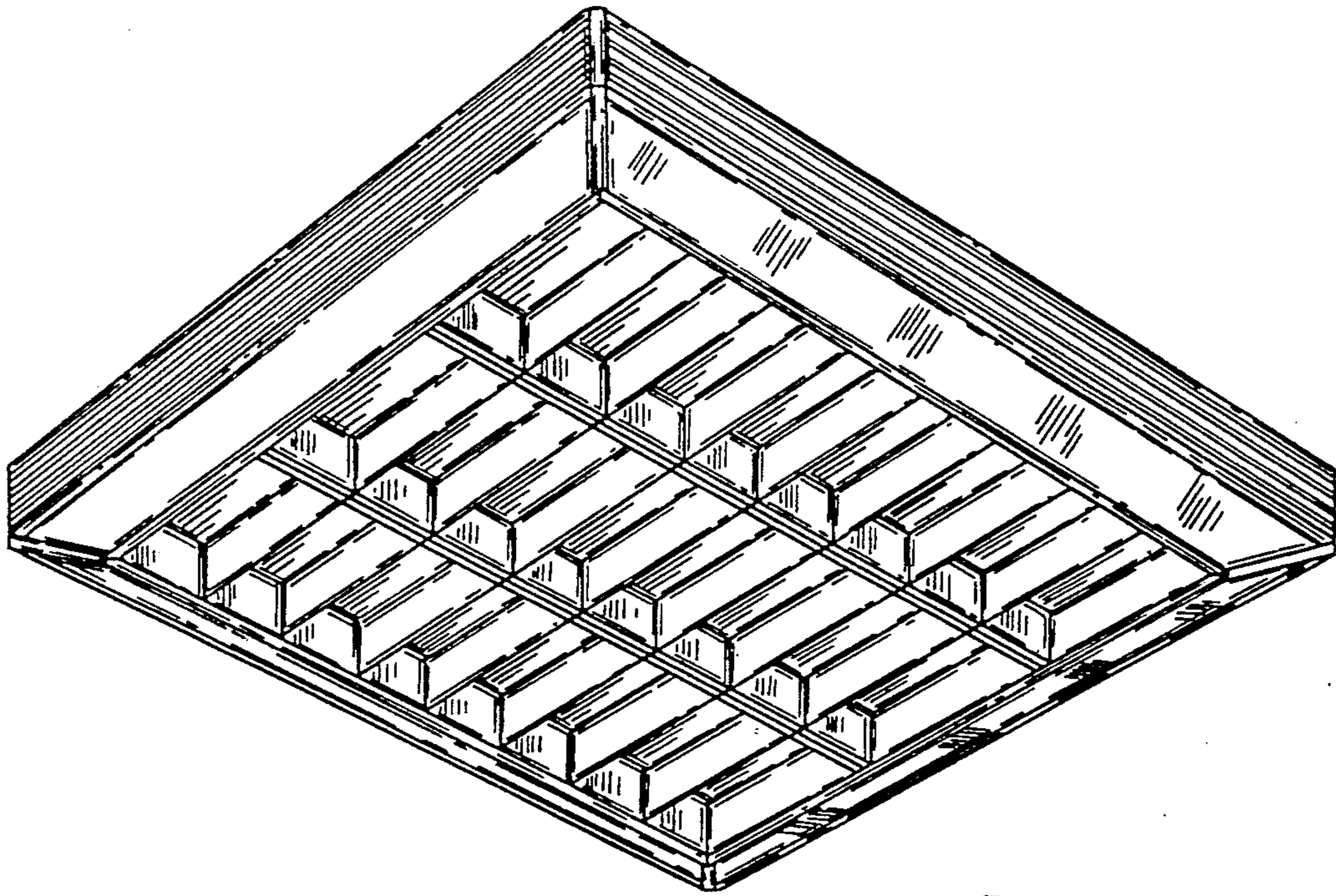

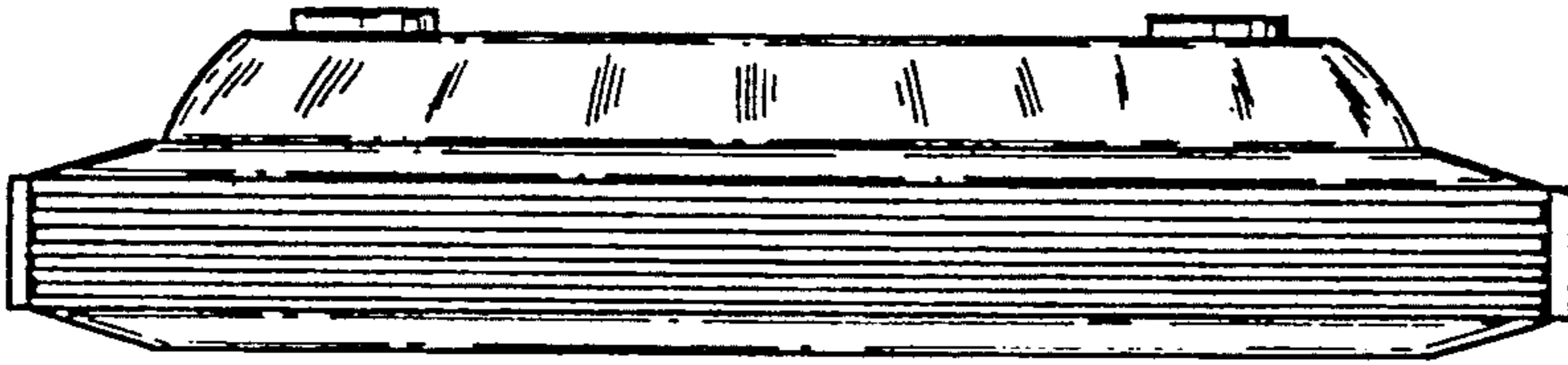

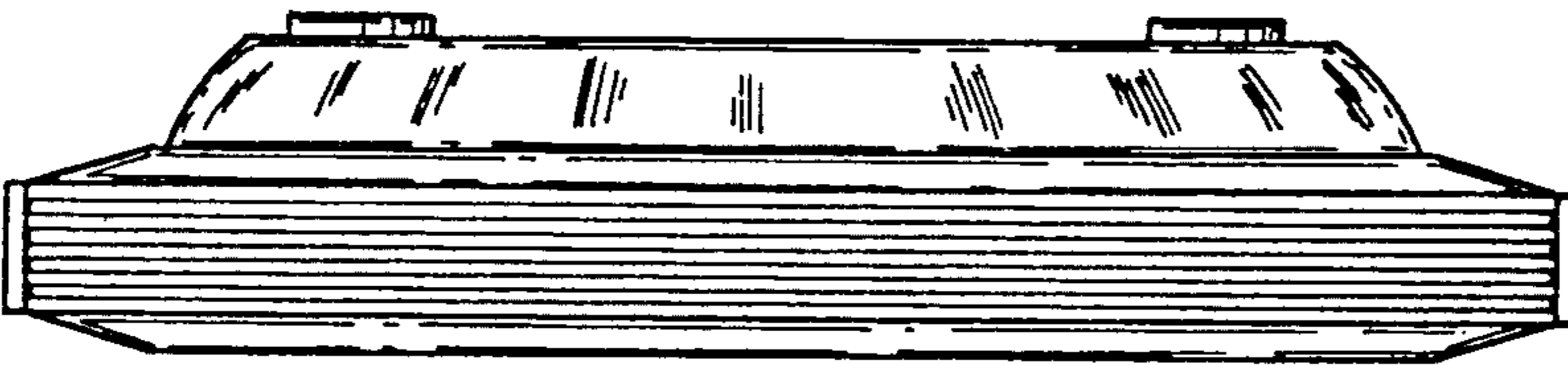

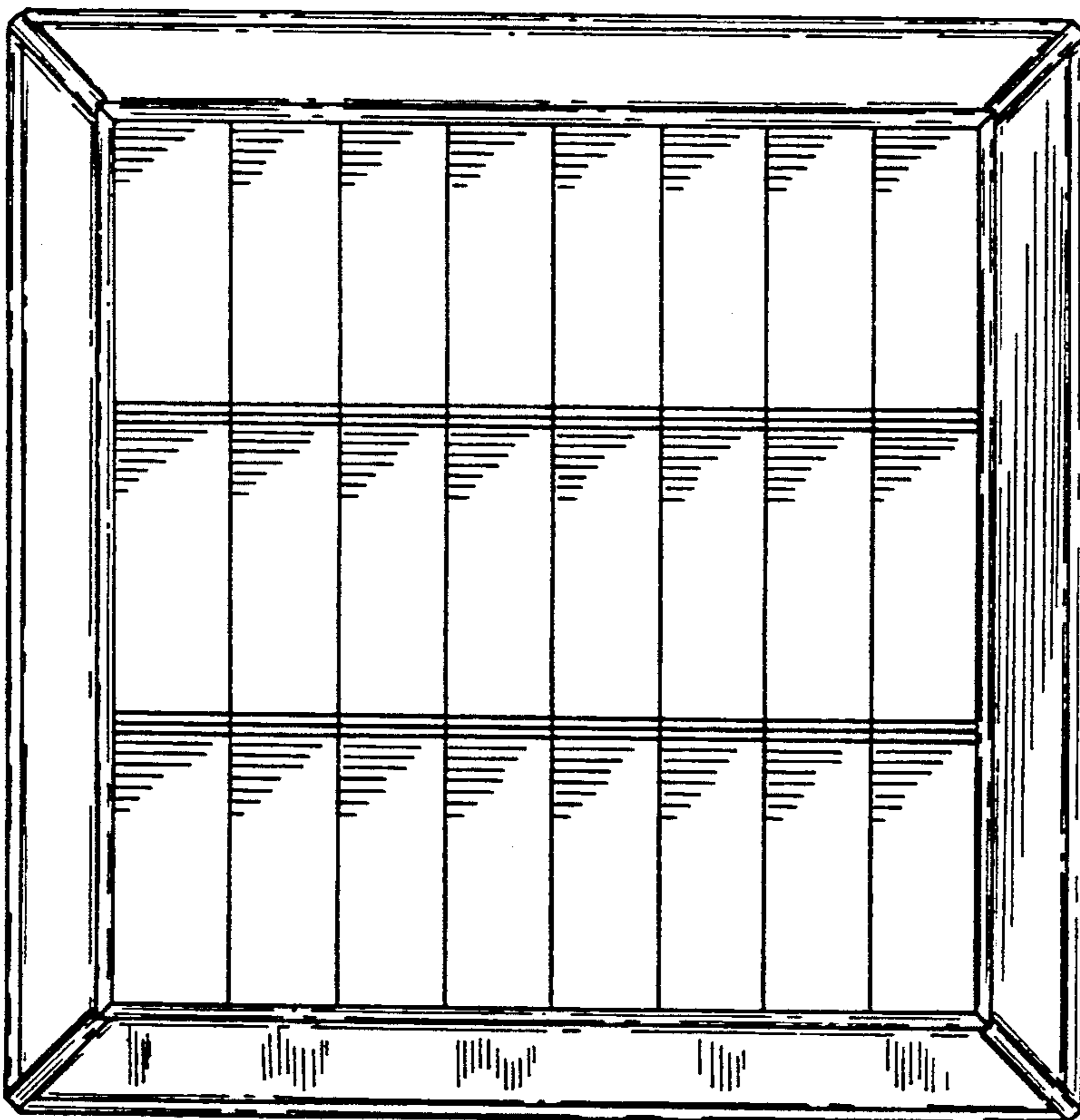

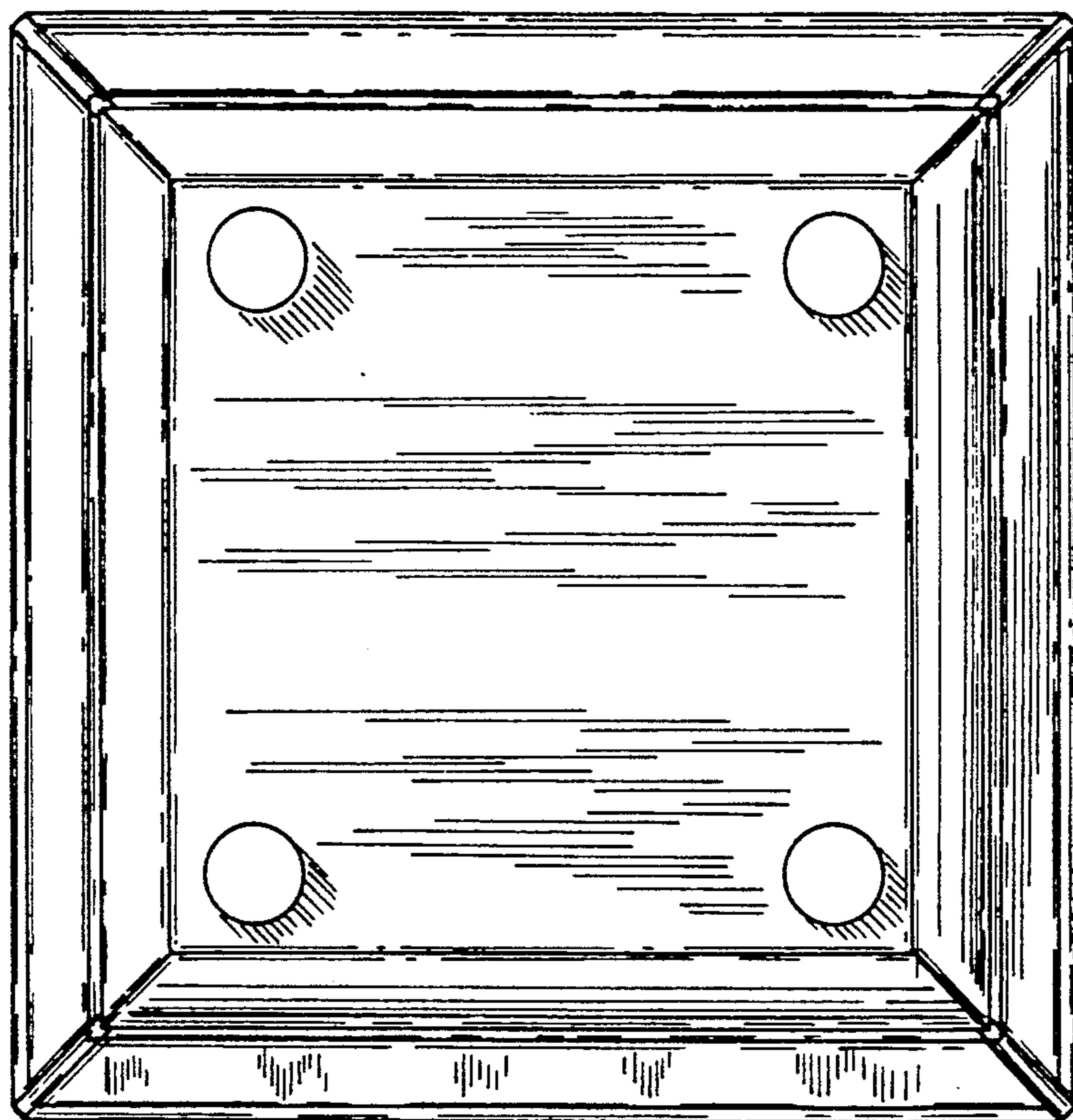

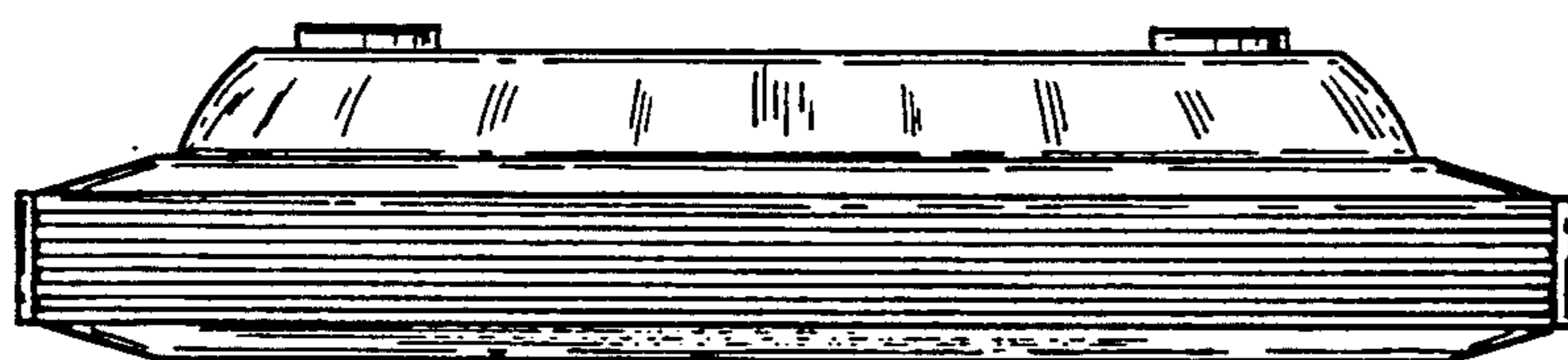

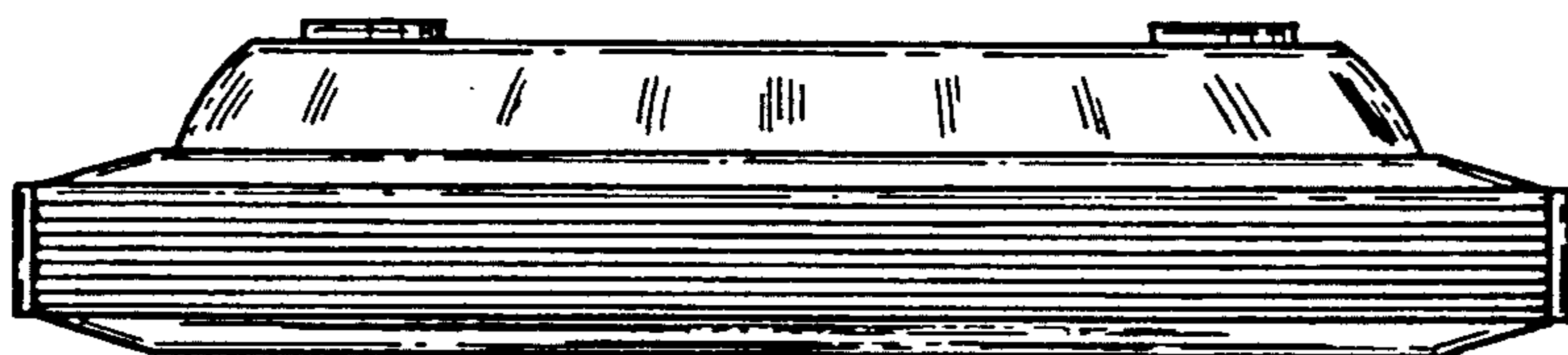
