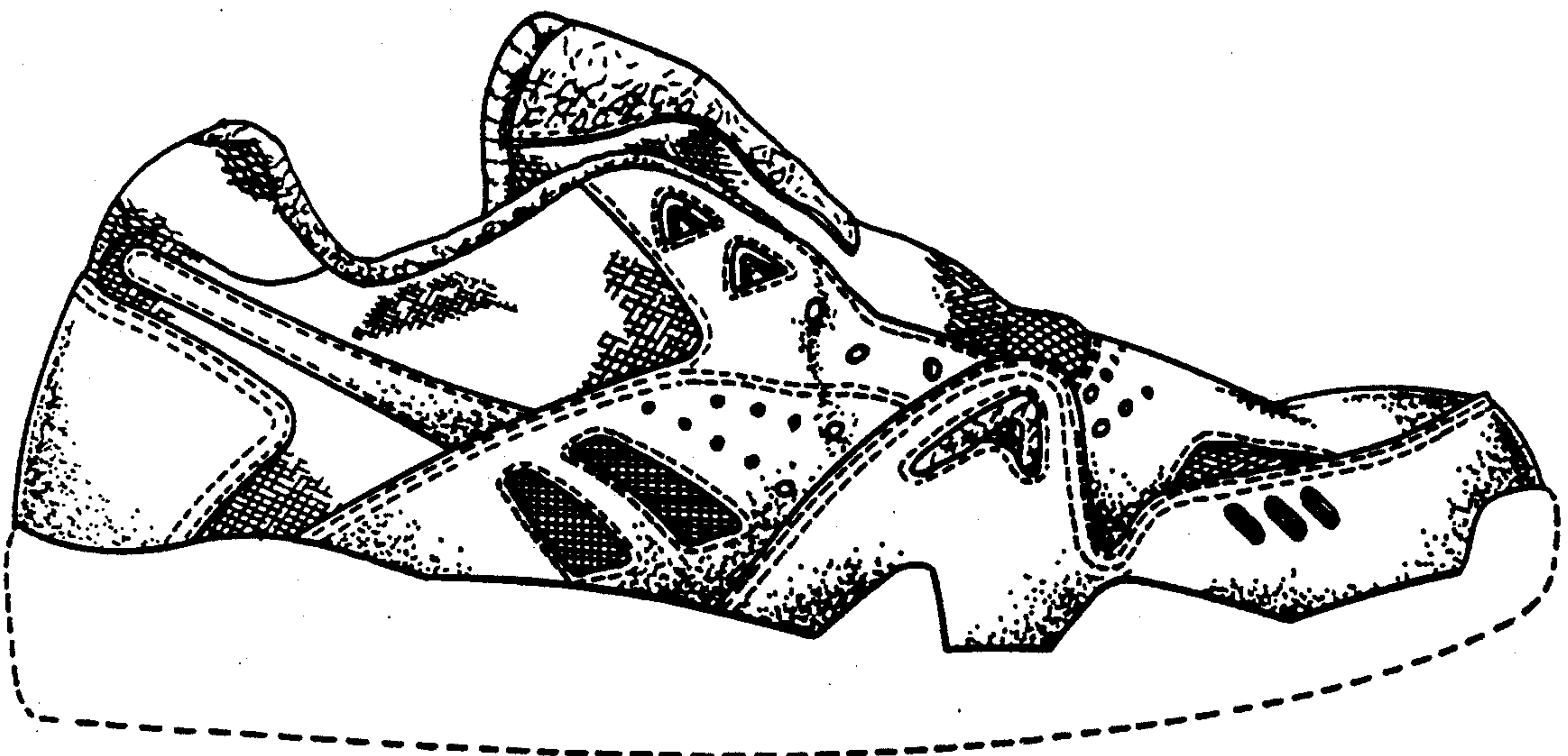
[57] CLAIM

The broken line showing a shoe sole in the figures is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design.



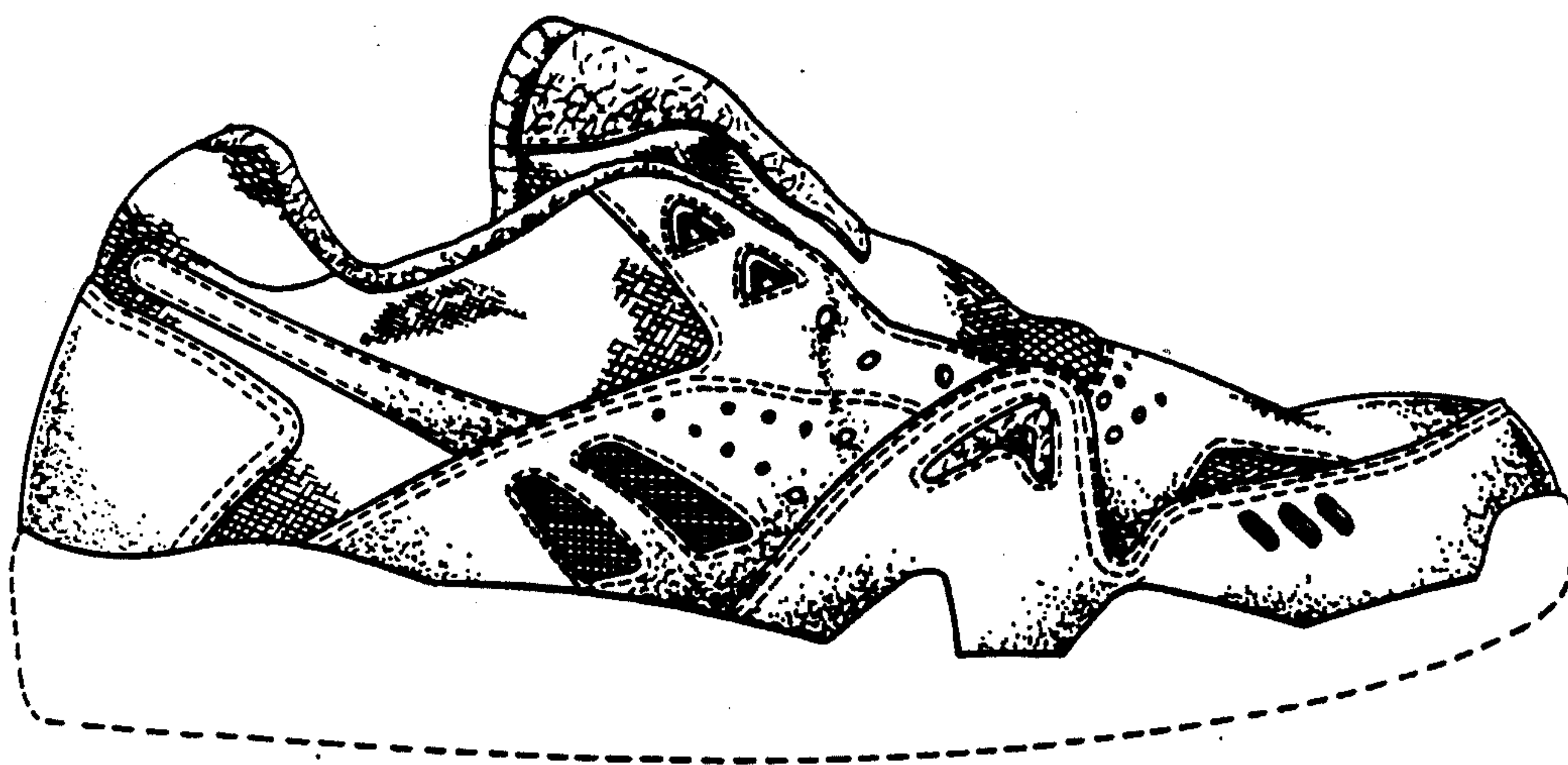

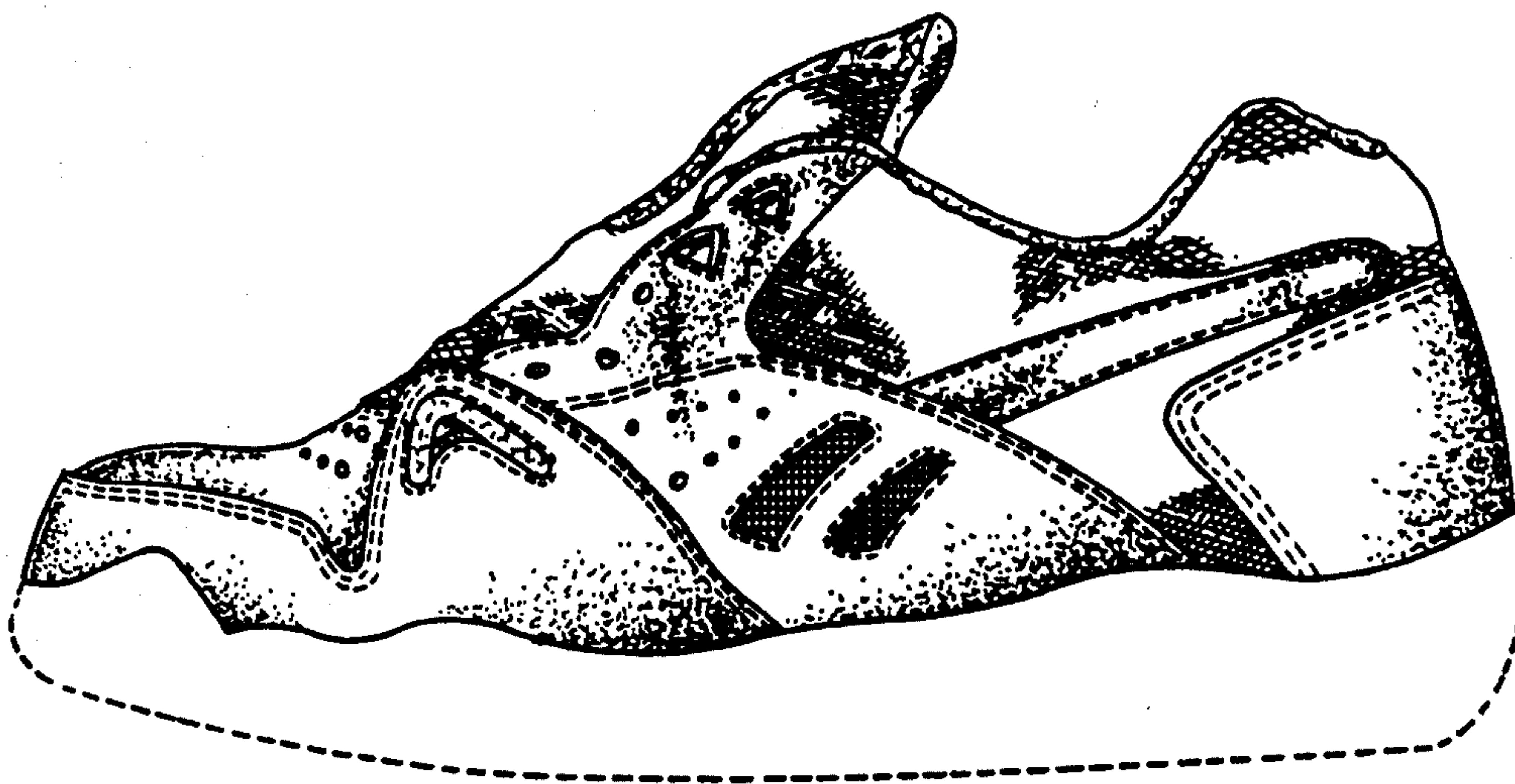

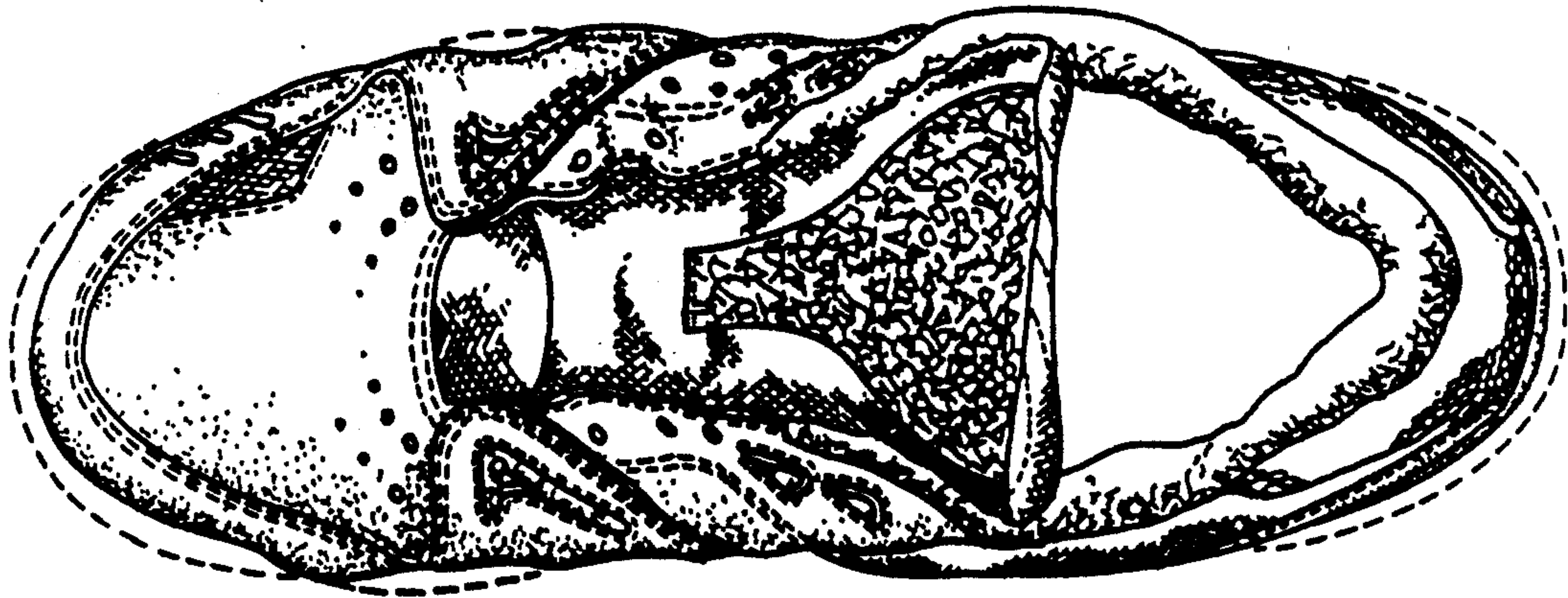

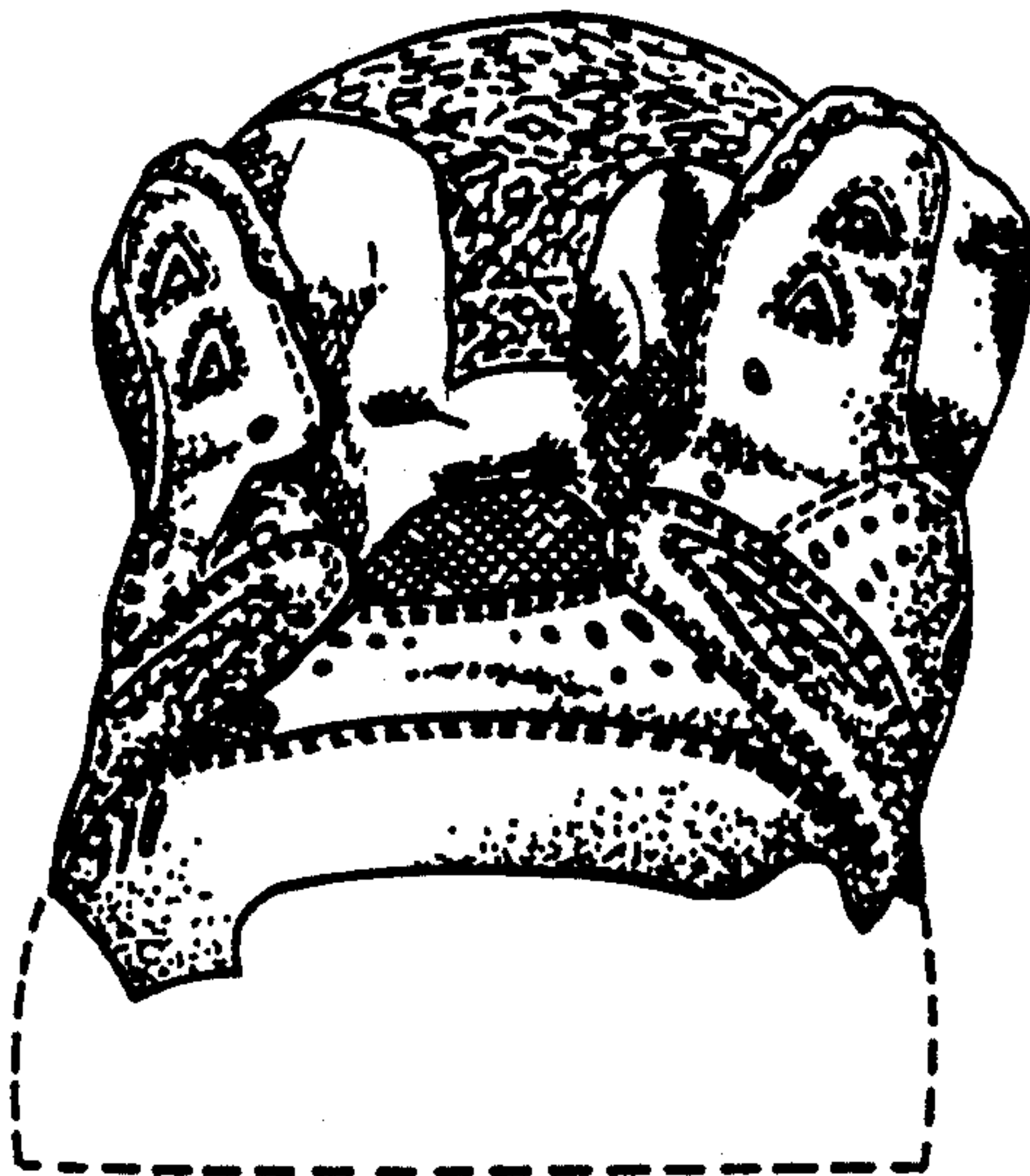

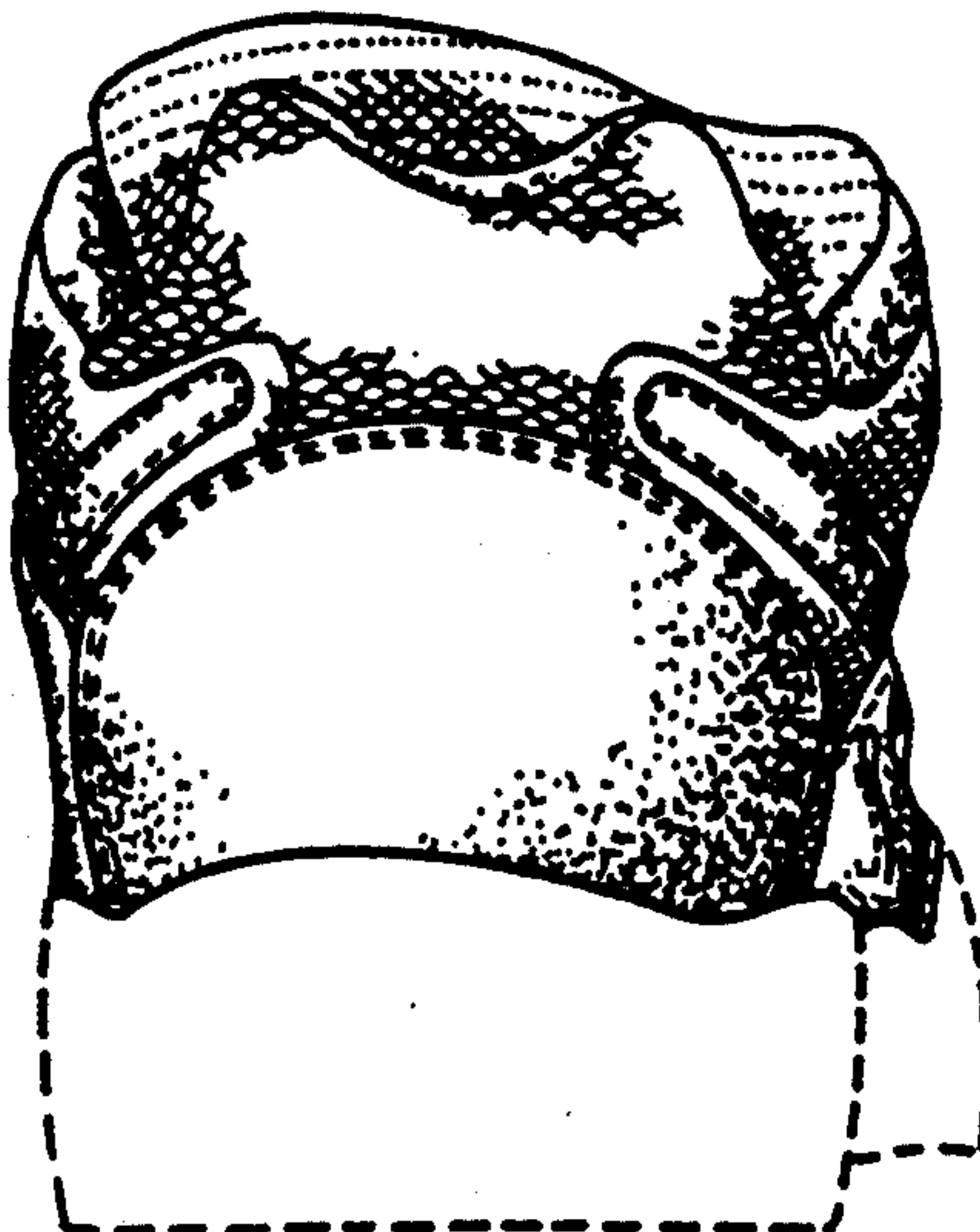

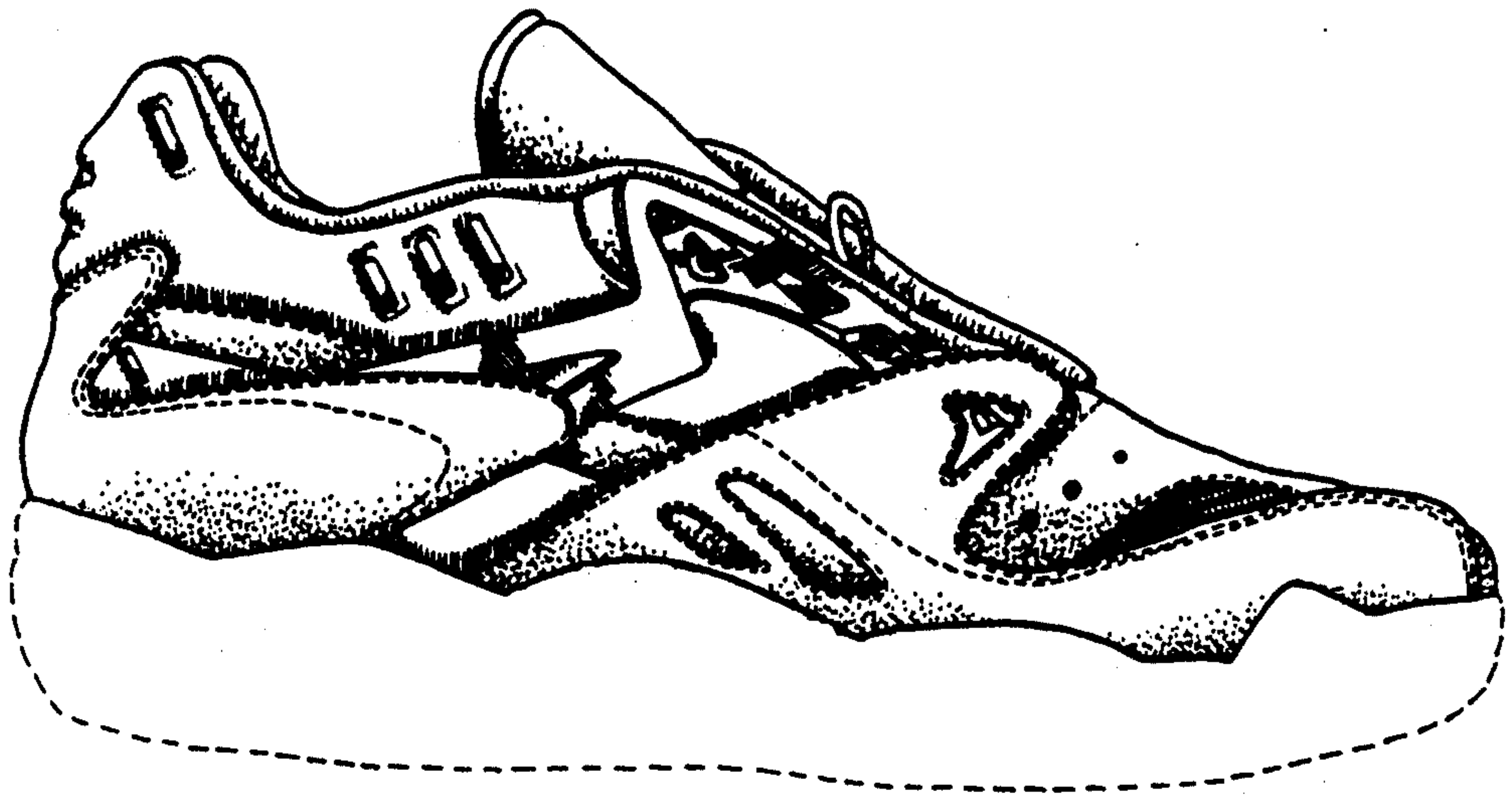

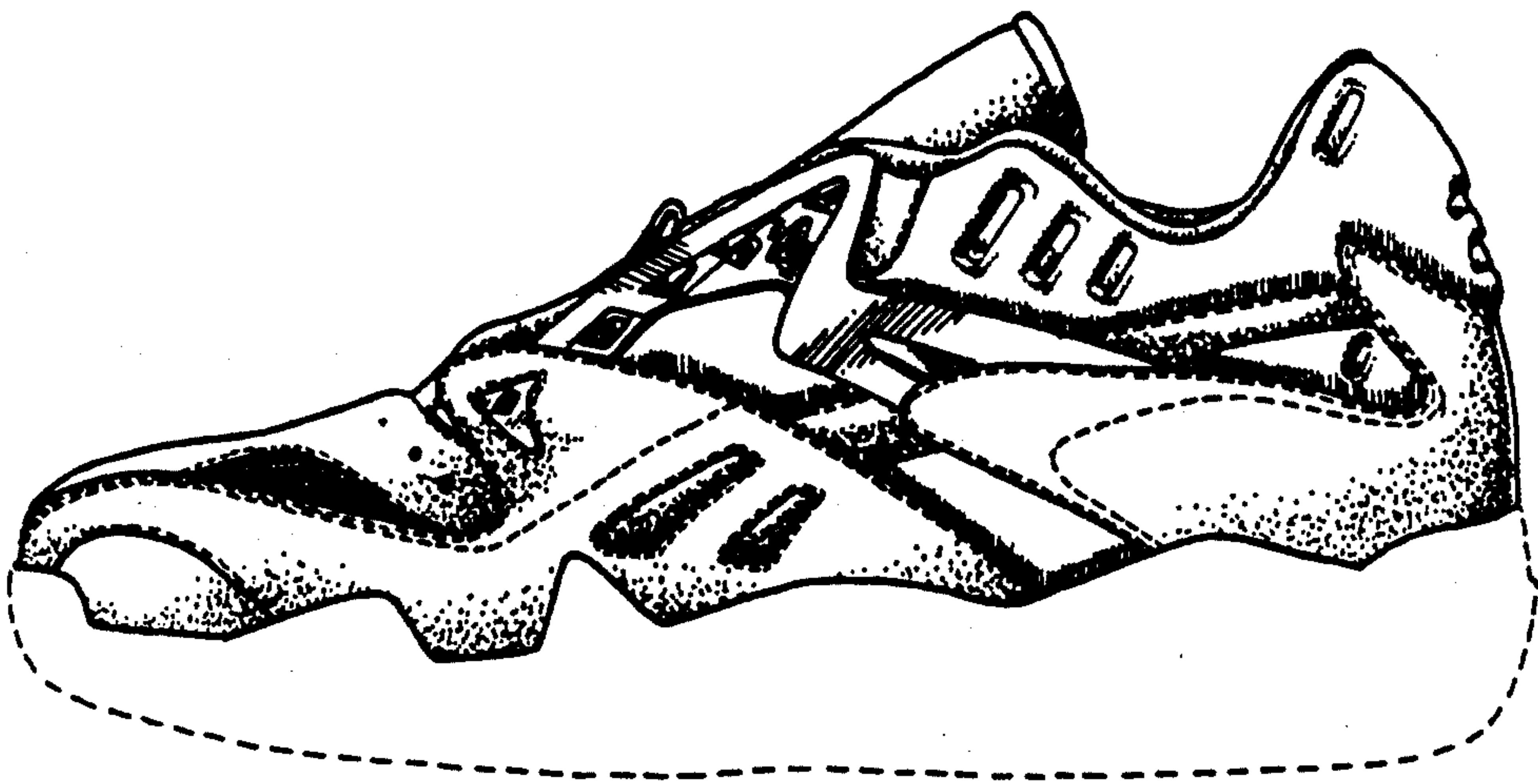

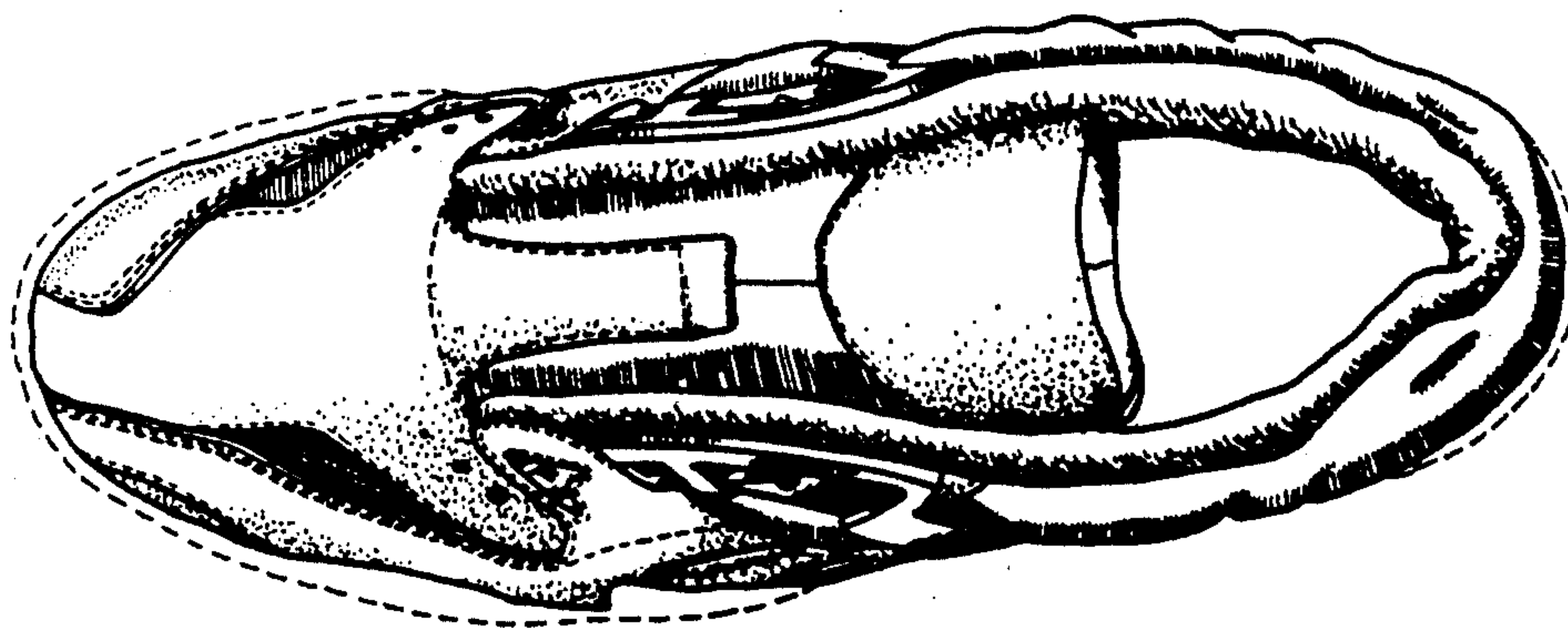

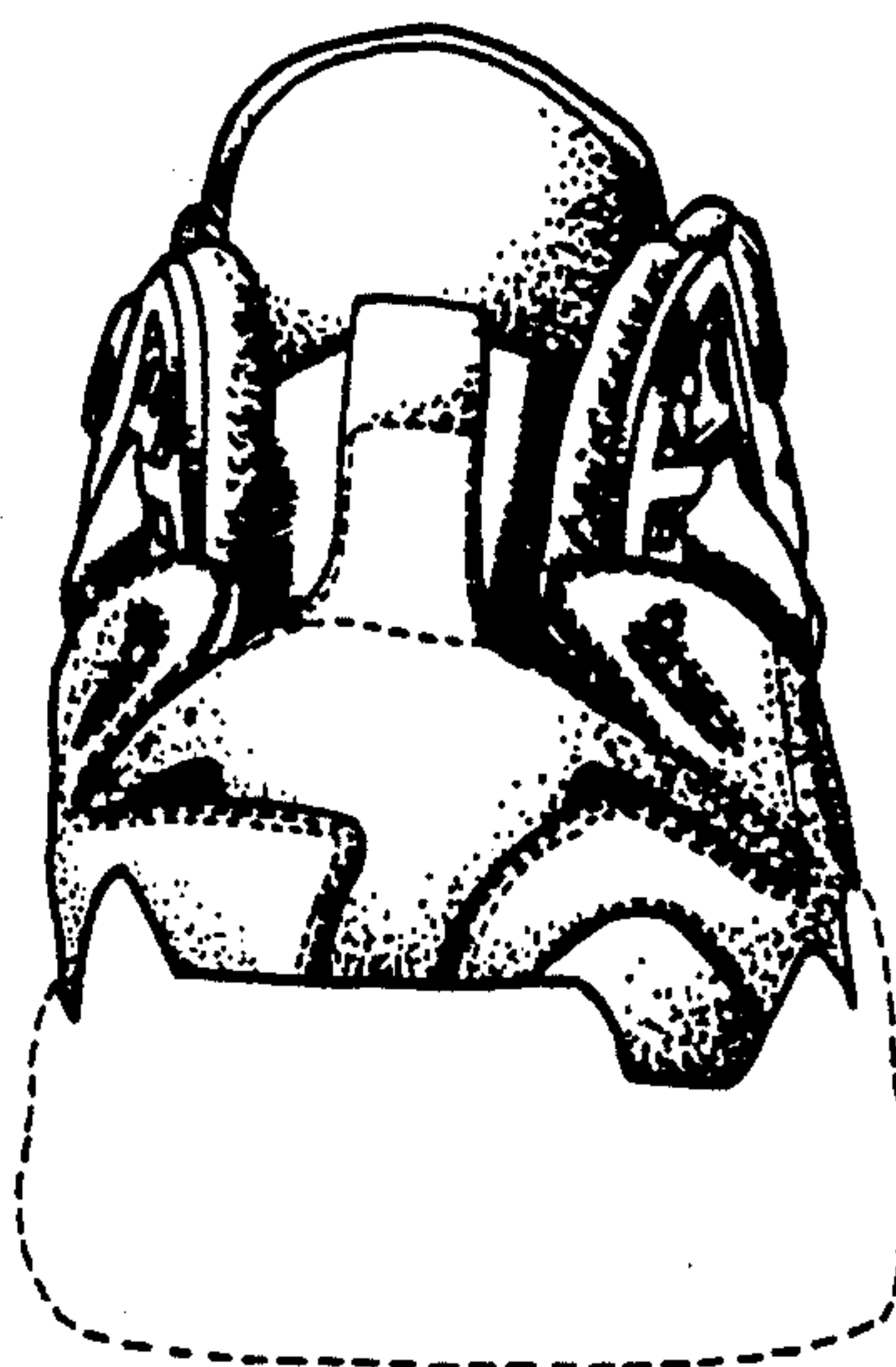

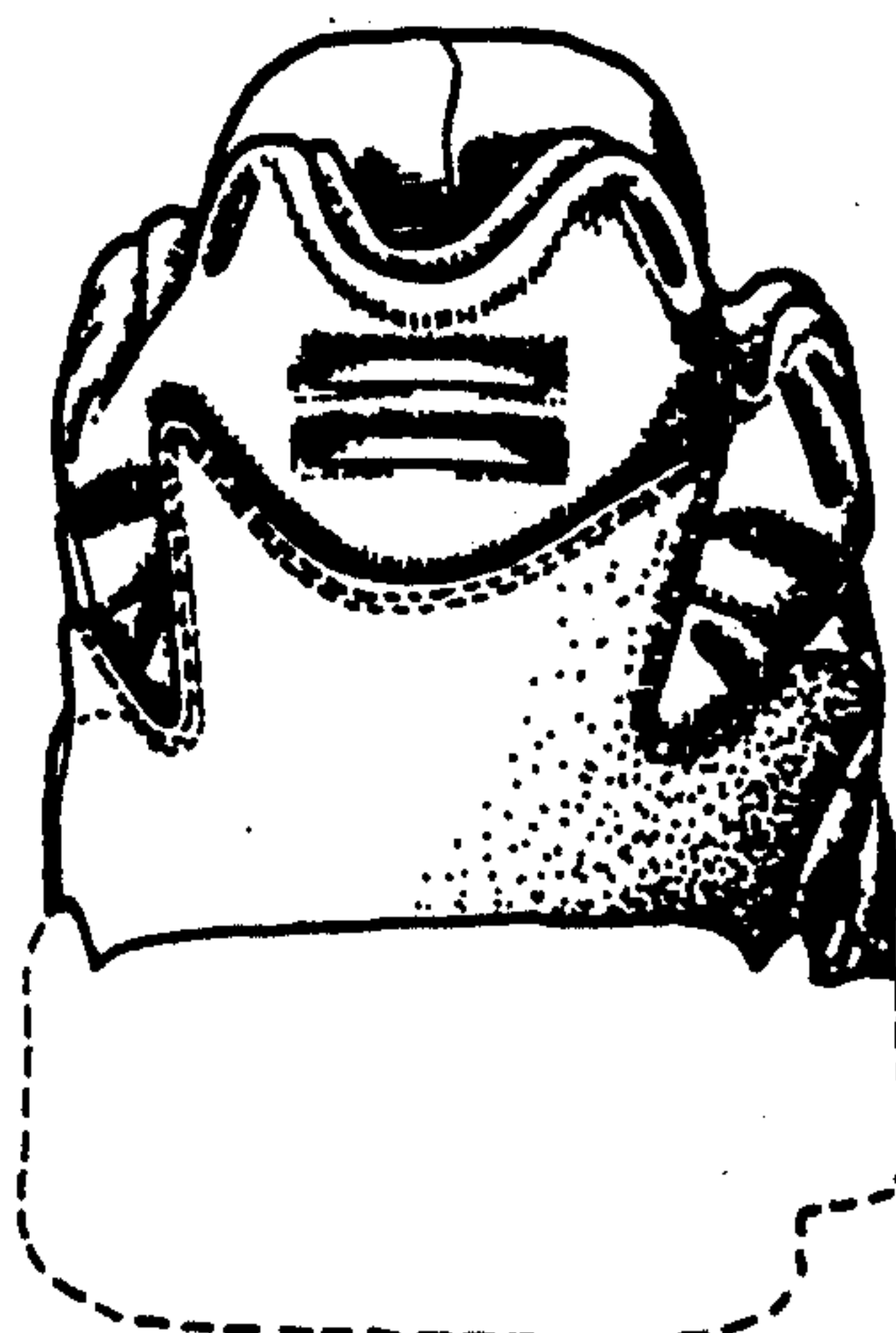

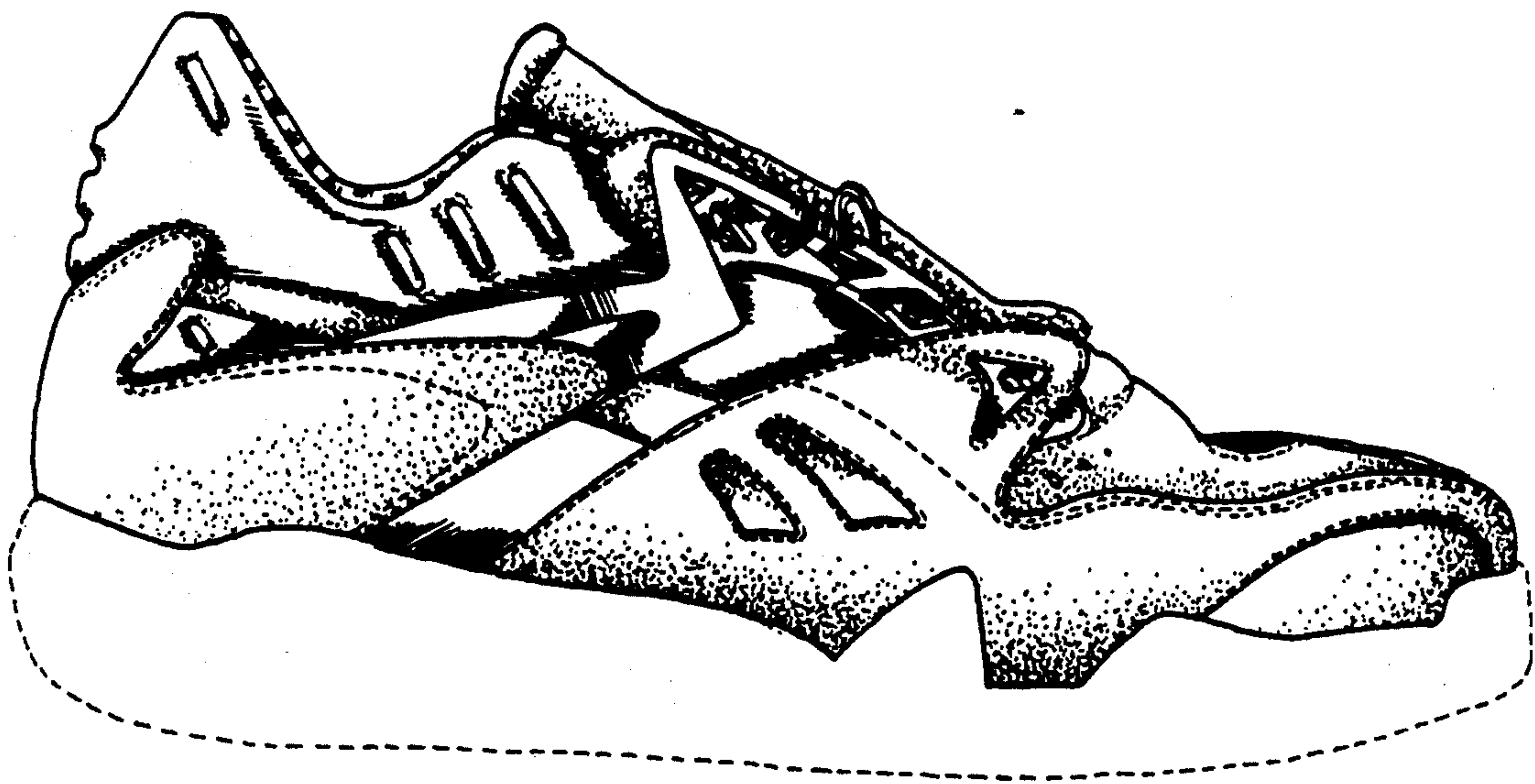

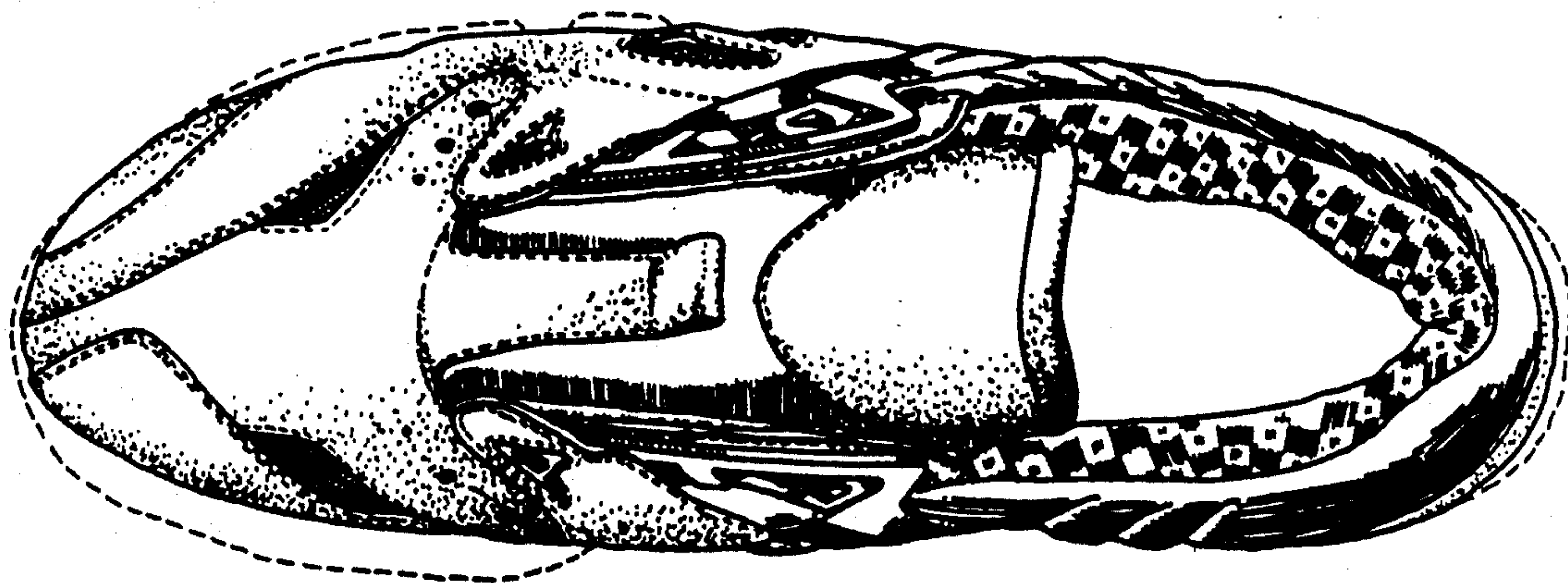

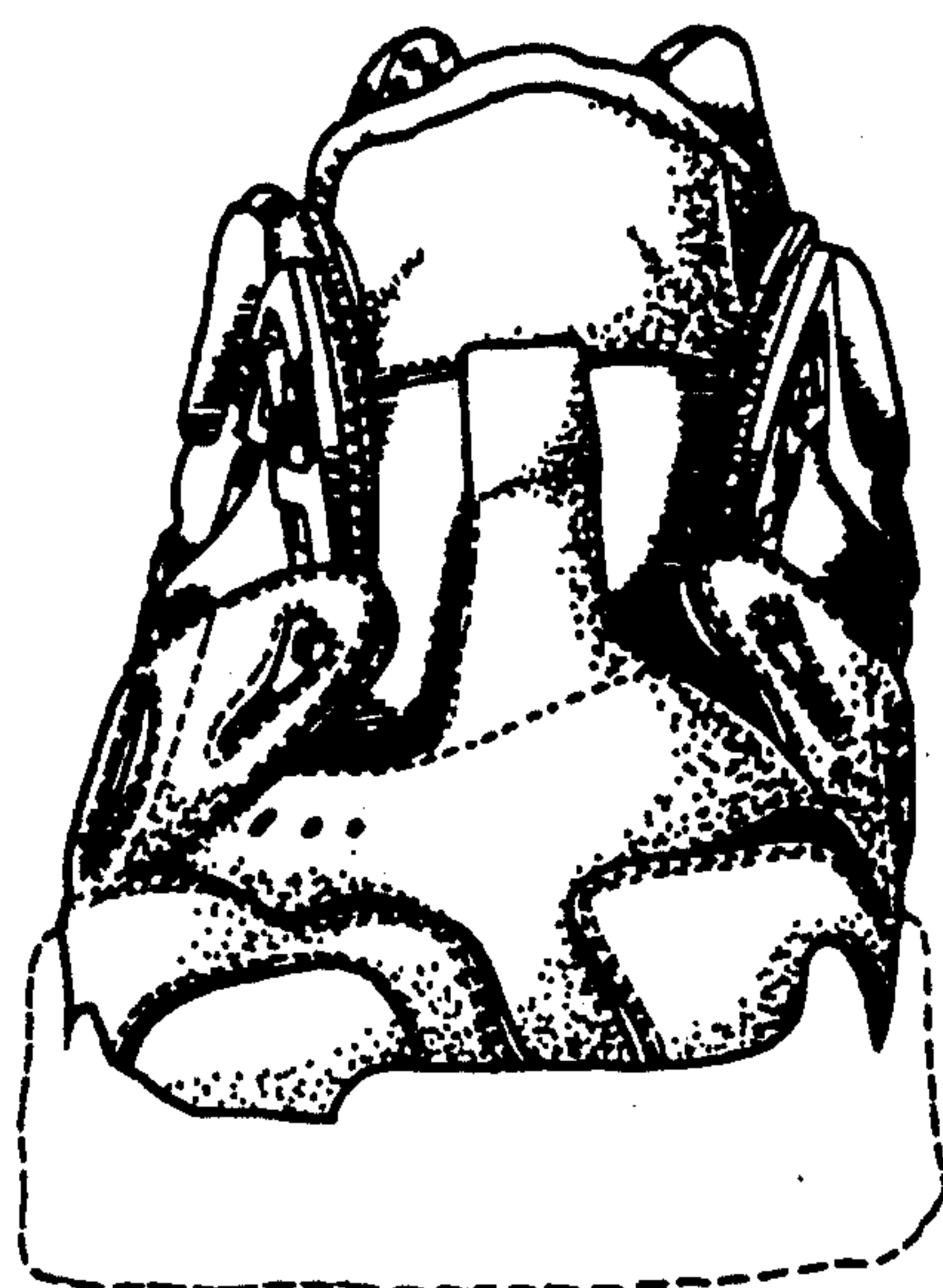

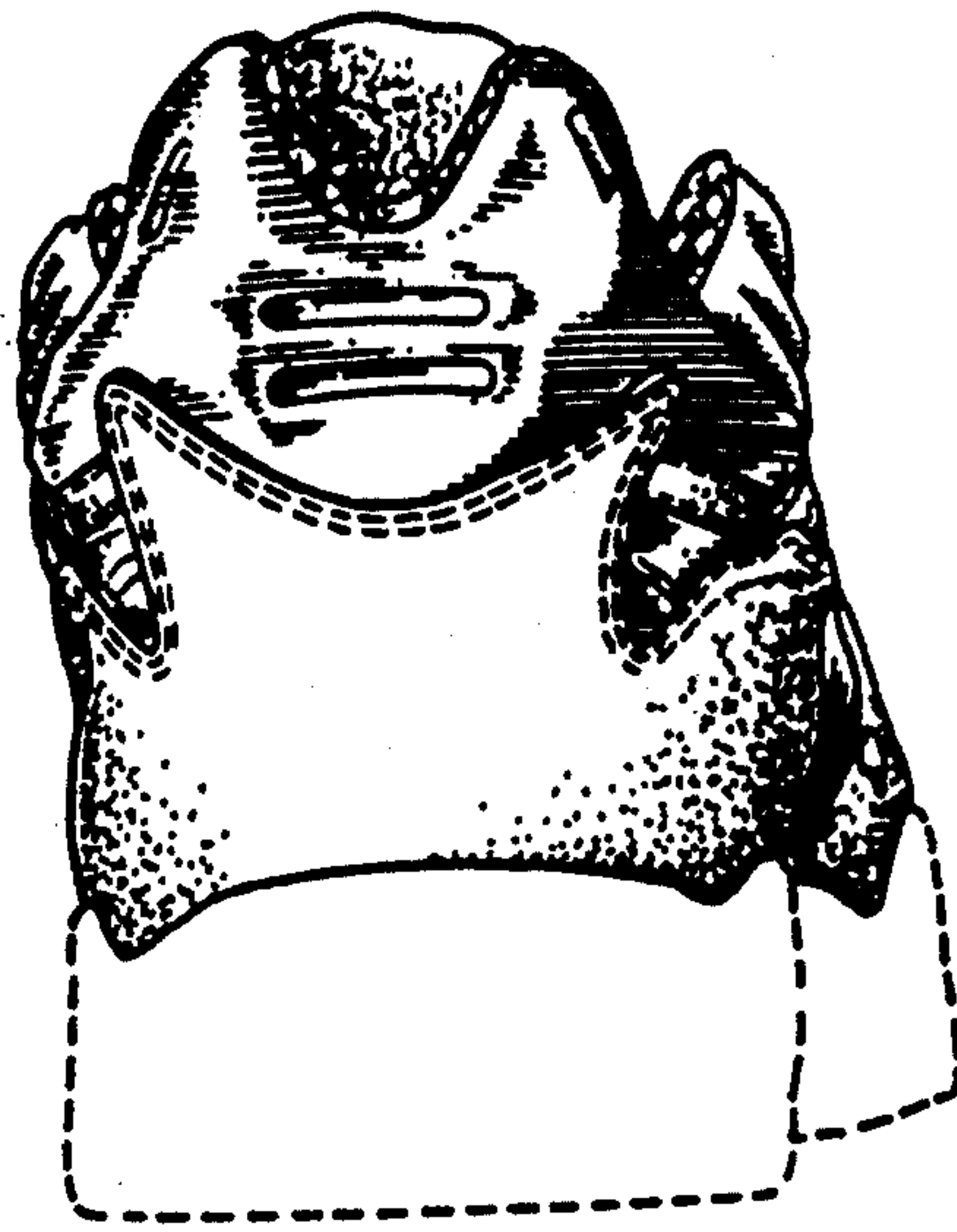

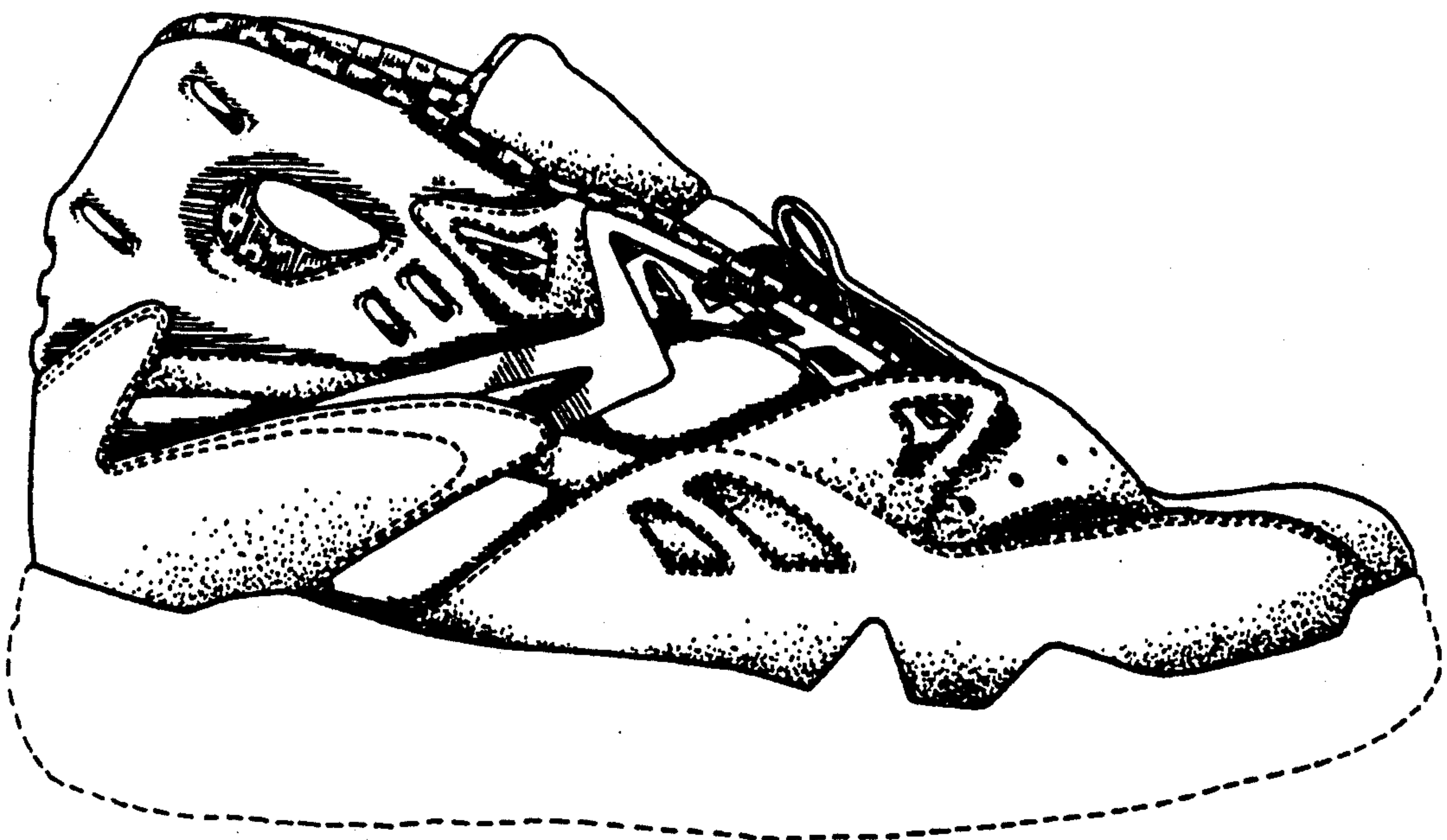

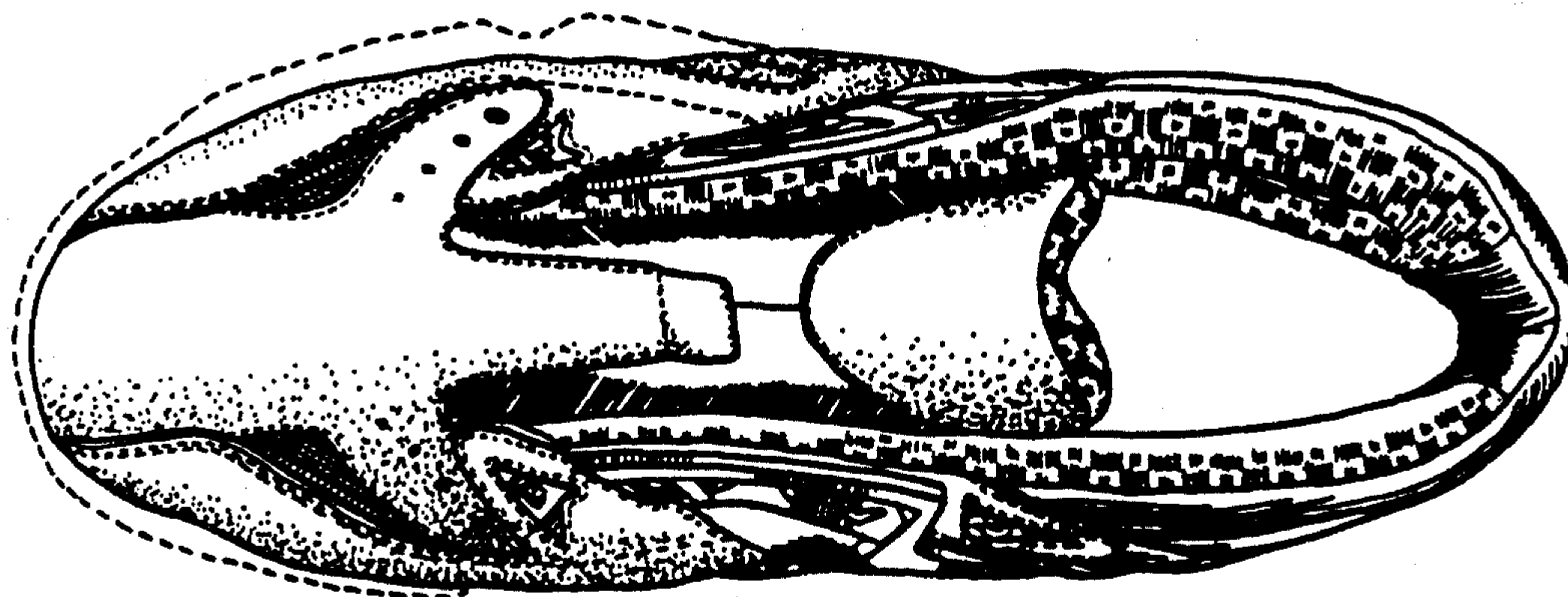

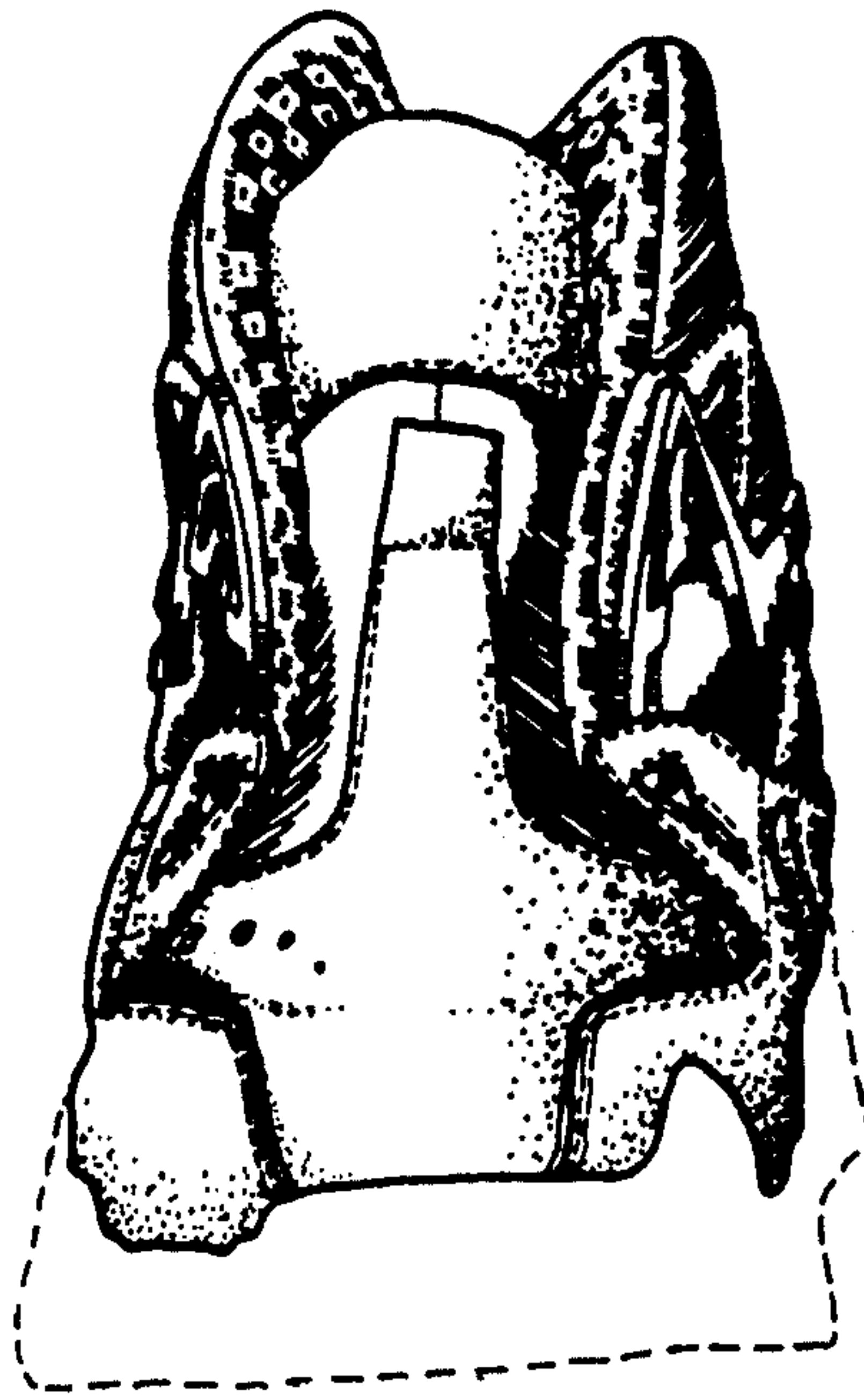

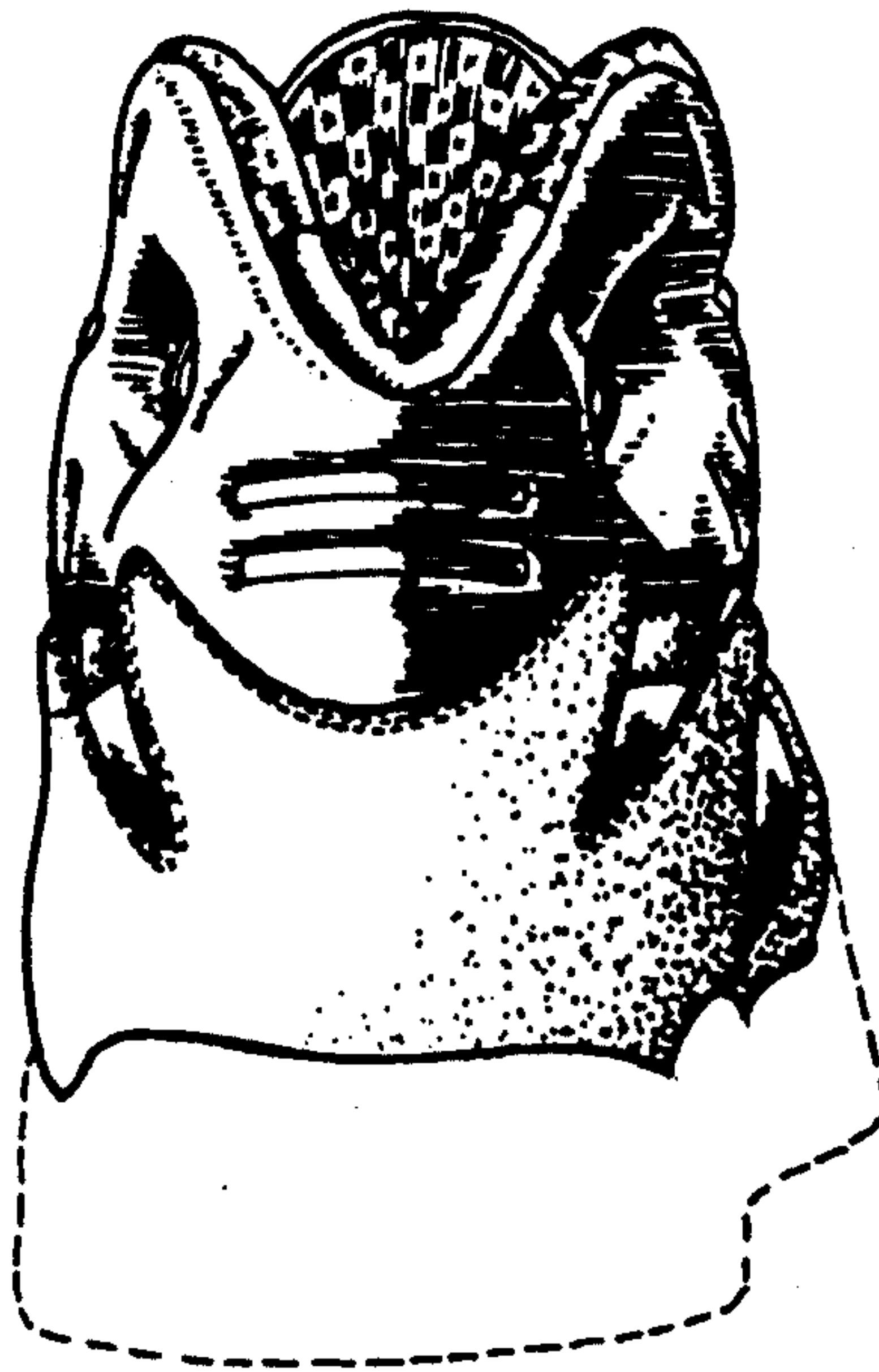
