The ornamental design for mirror, as shown and described.

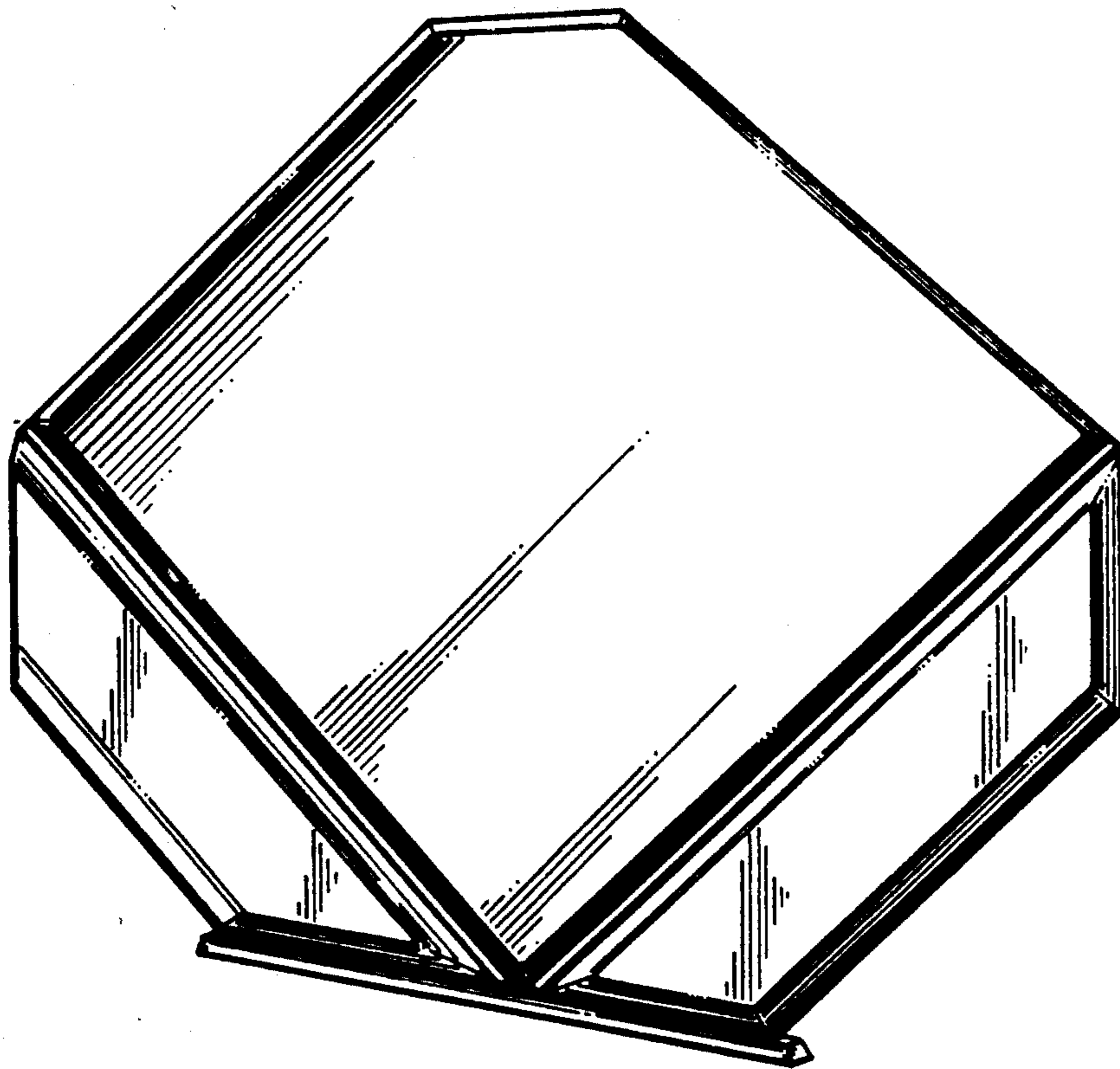
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof.



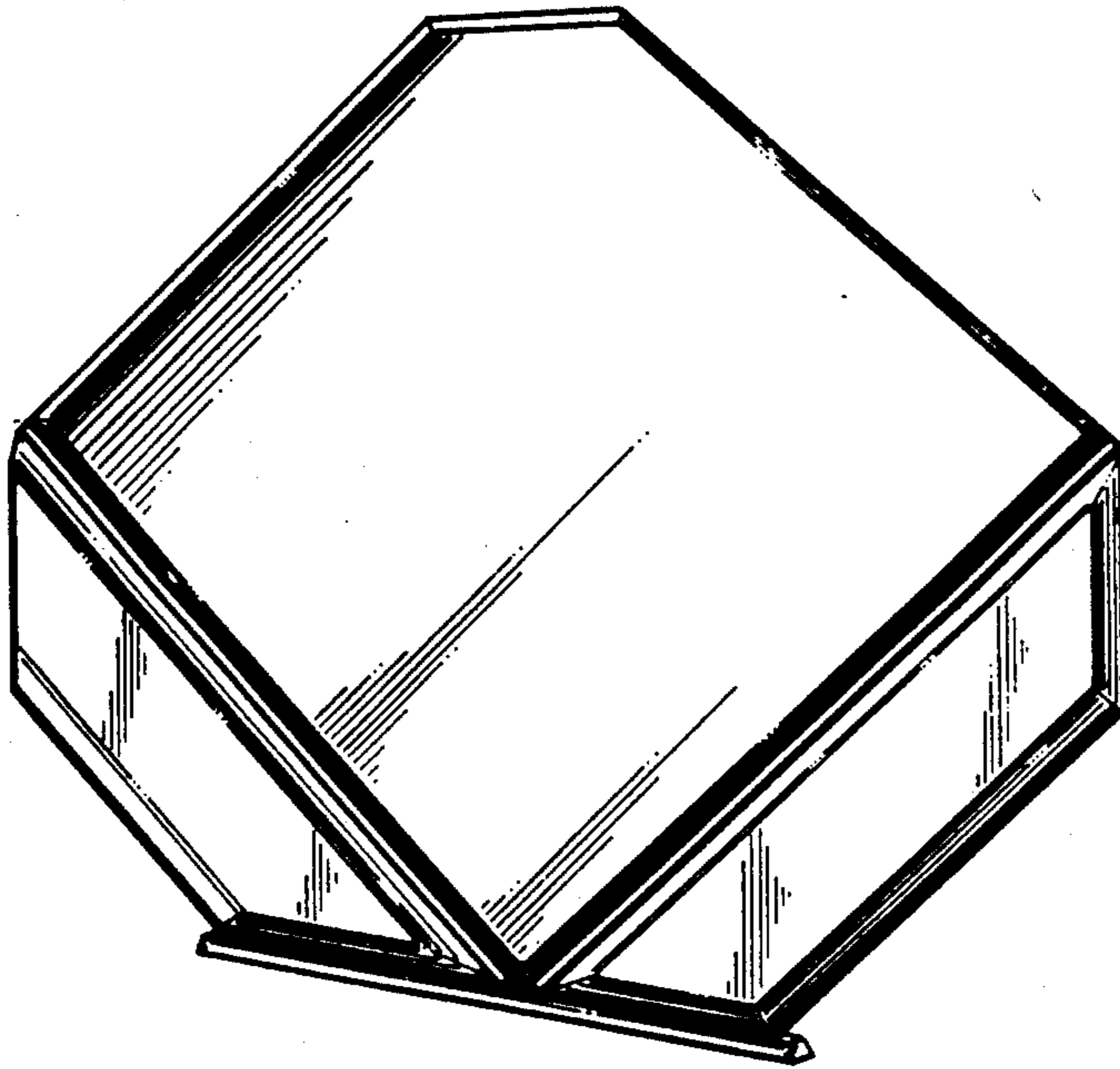

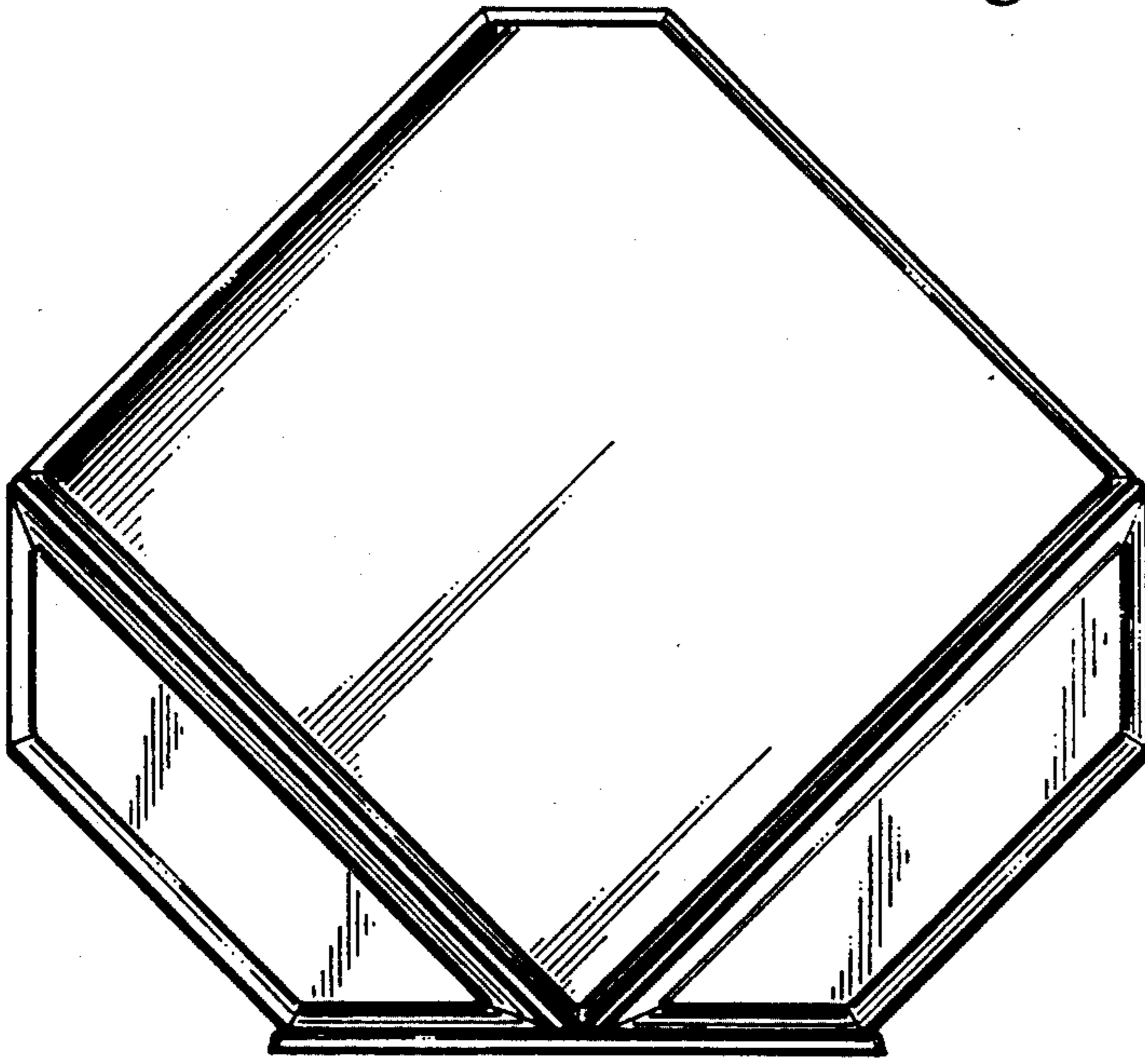
