FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

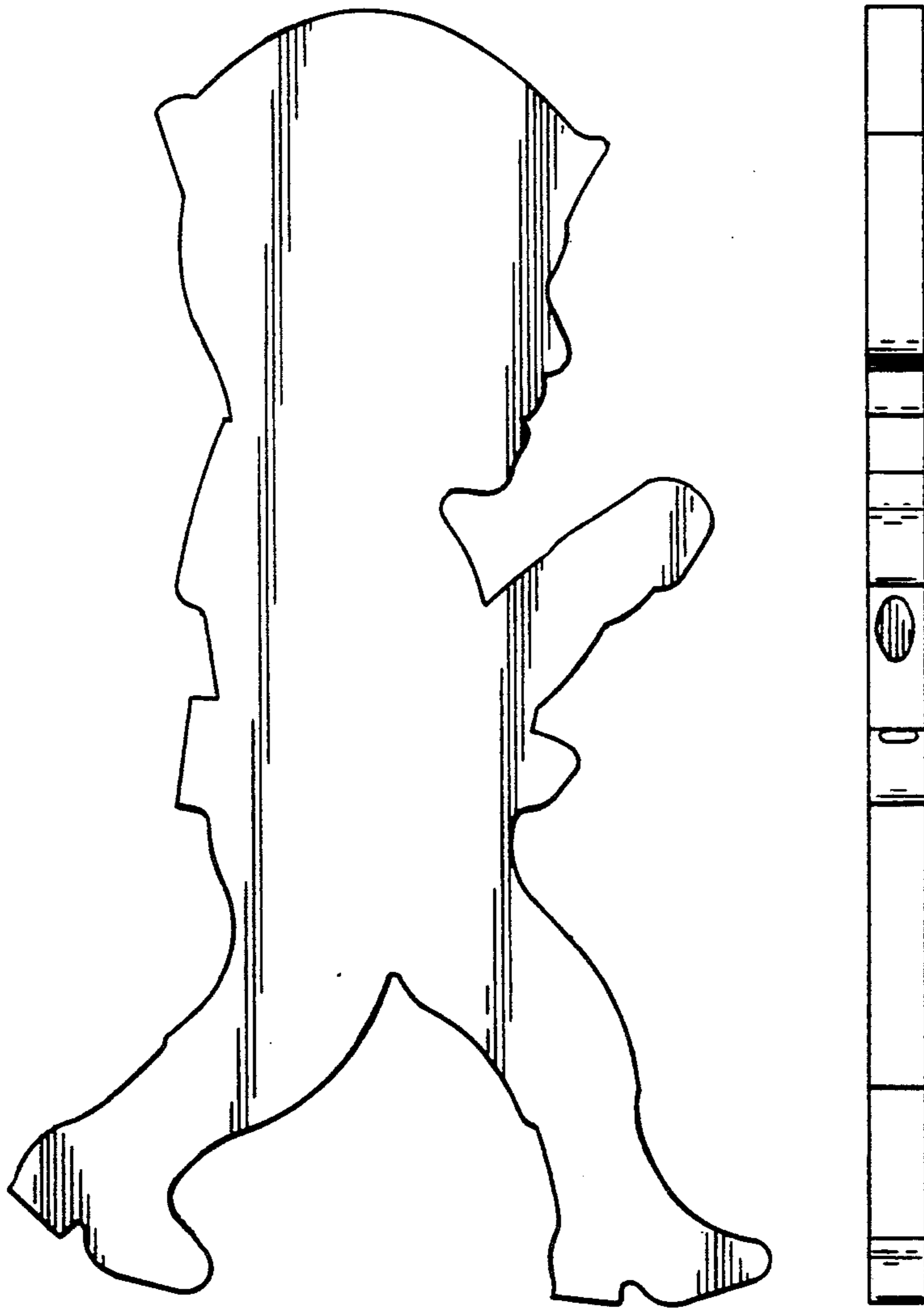

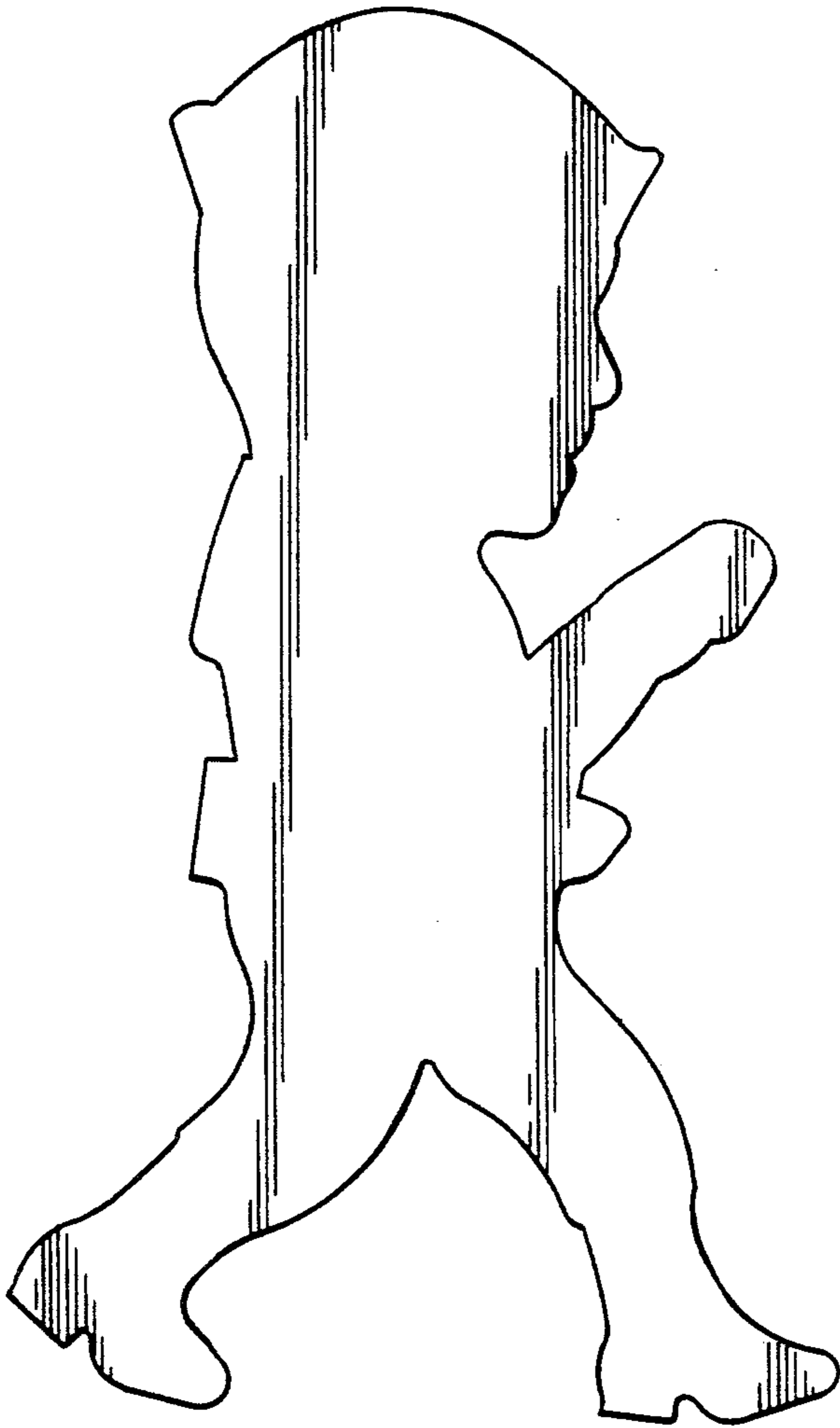


FIG. 2 FIG. 3

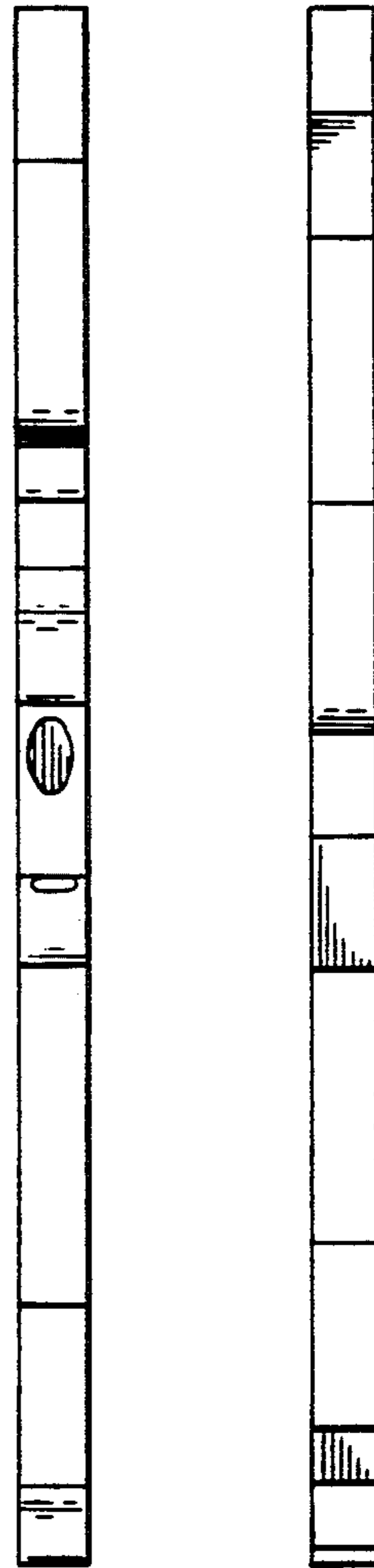
