[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a neck, chest and shoulder protector, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a neck, chest and shoulder protector showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
 FIG. 6 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is an enlarged cross-sectional view taken along lines 7—7 in FIG. 2; and,
 FIG. 8 is an enlarged cross-sectional view taken along lines 8—8 in FIG. 6.

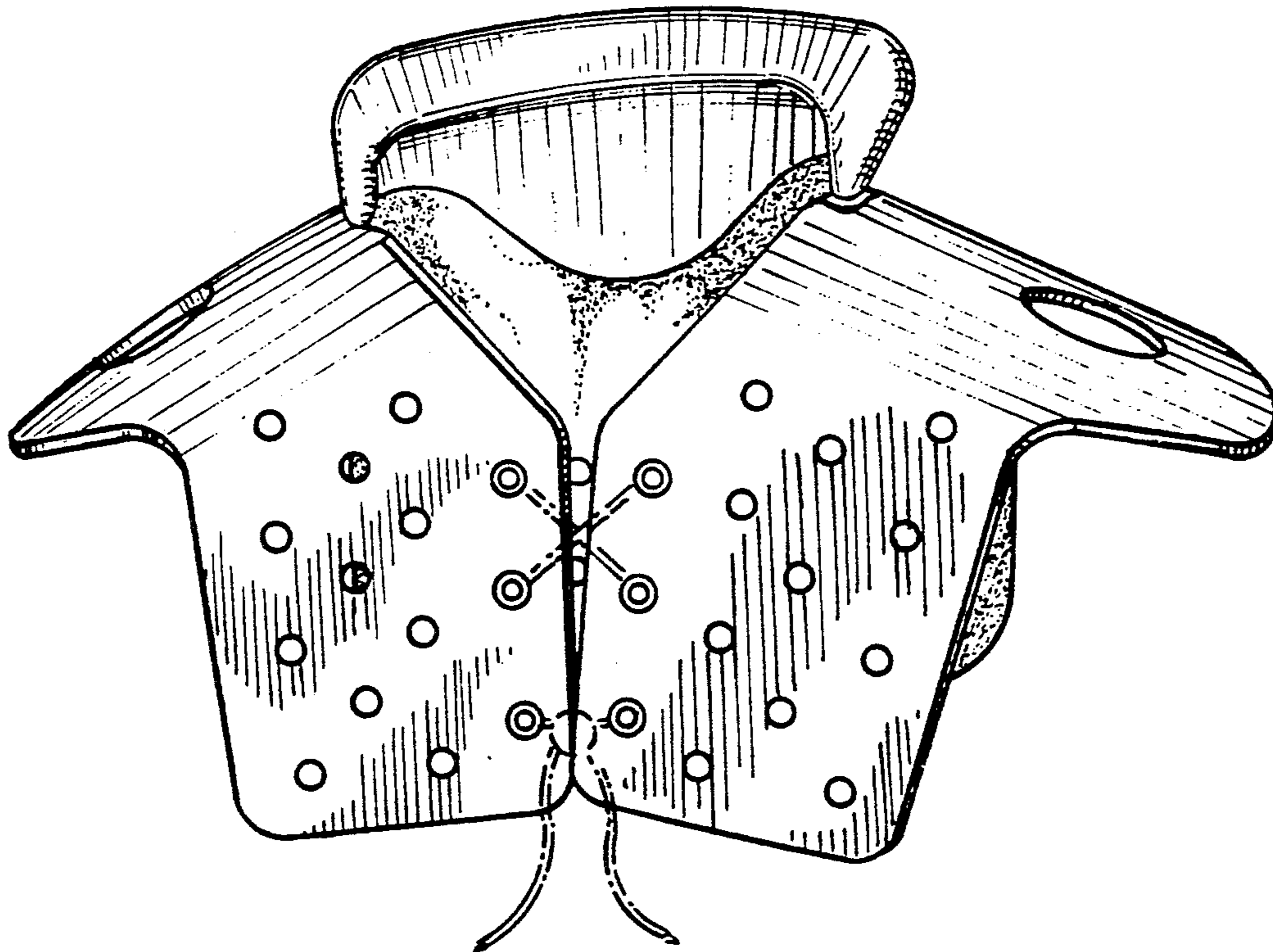

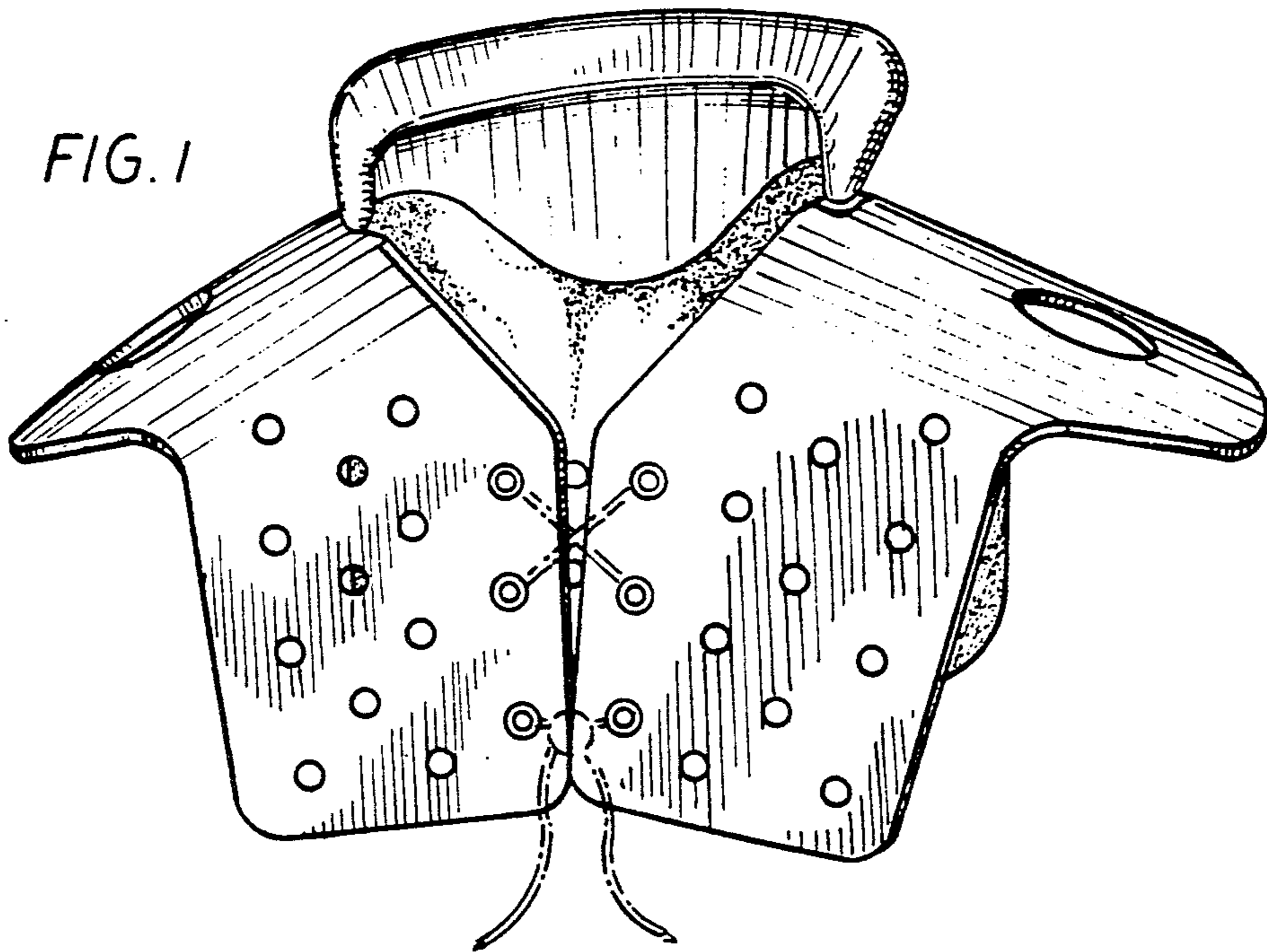

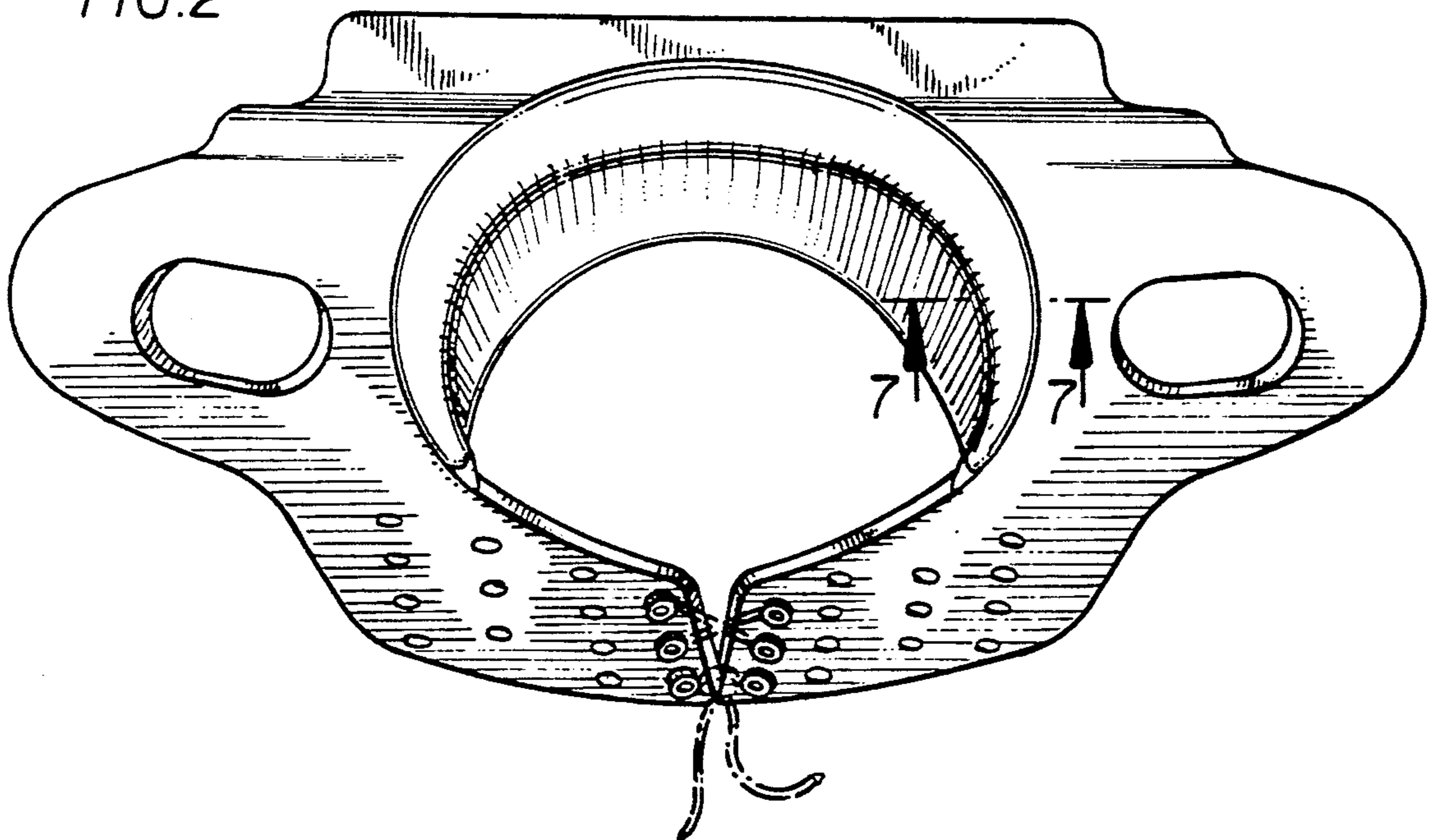

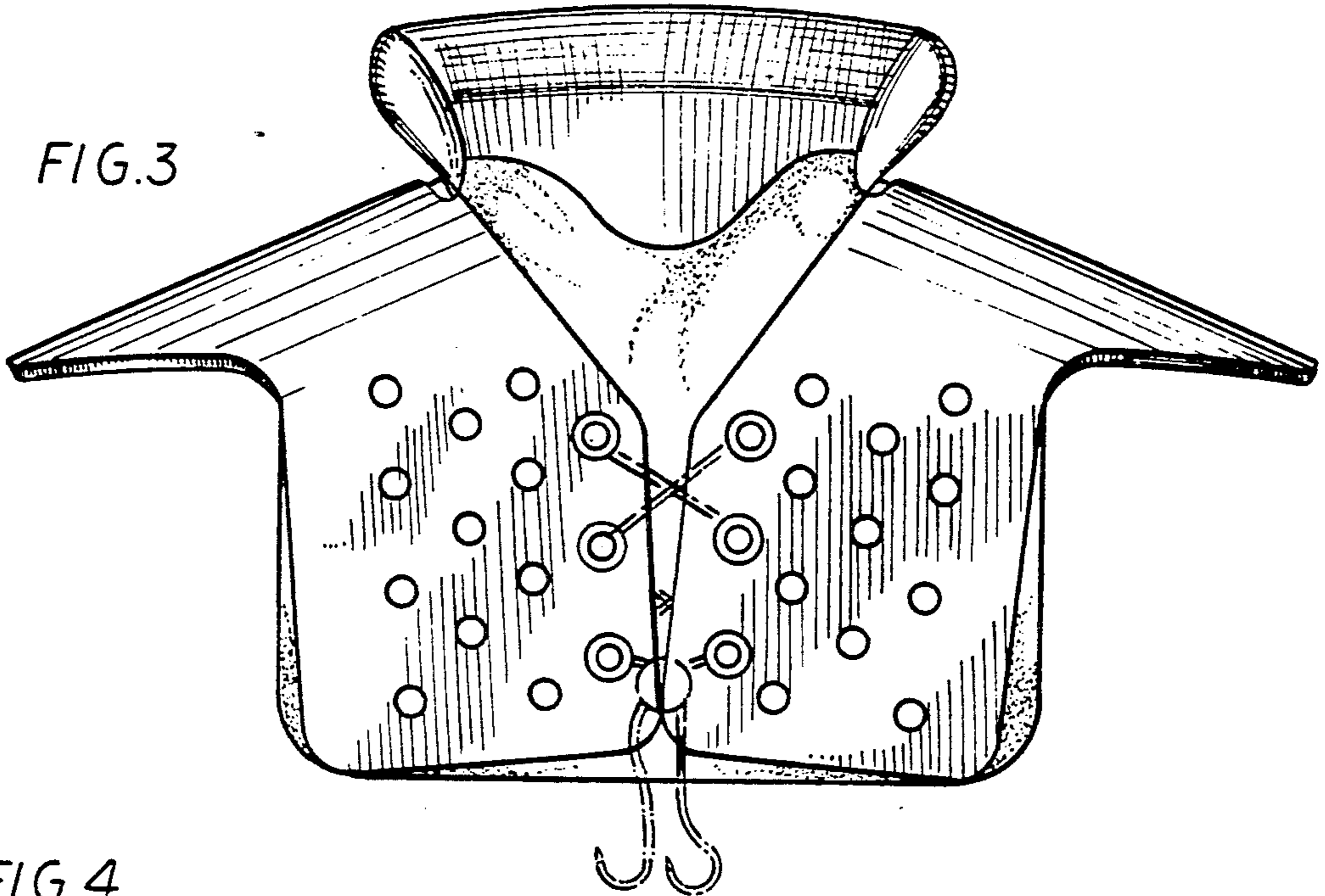

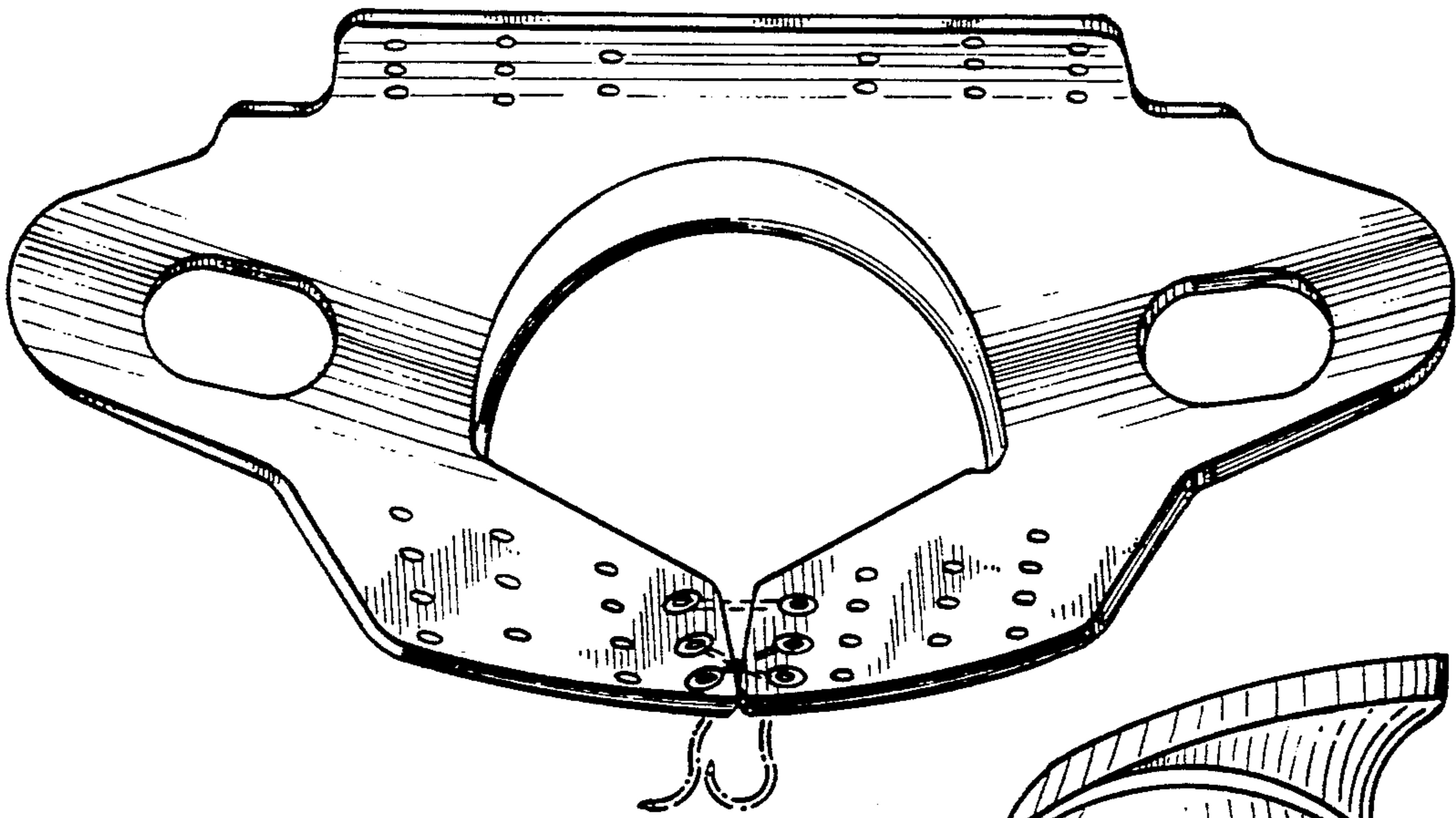

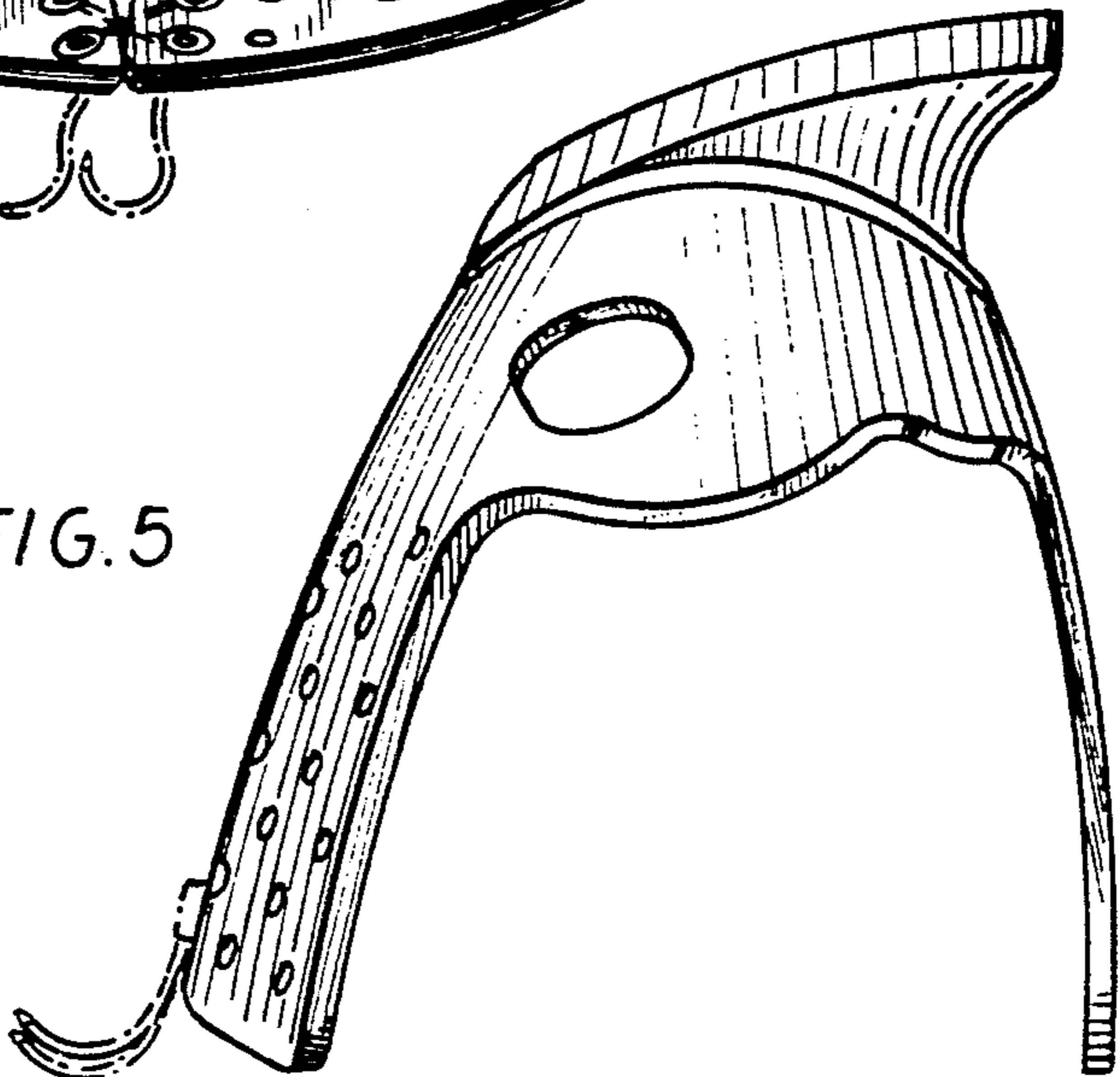

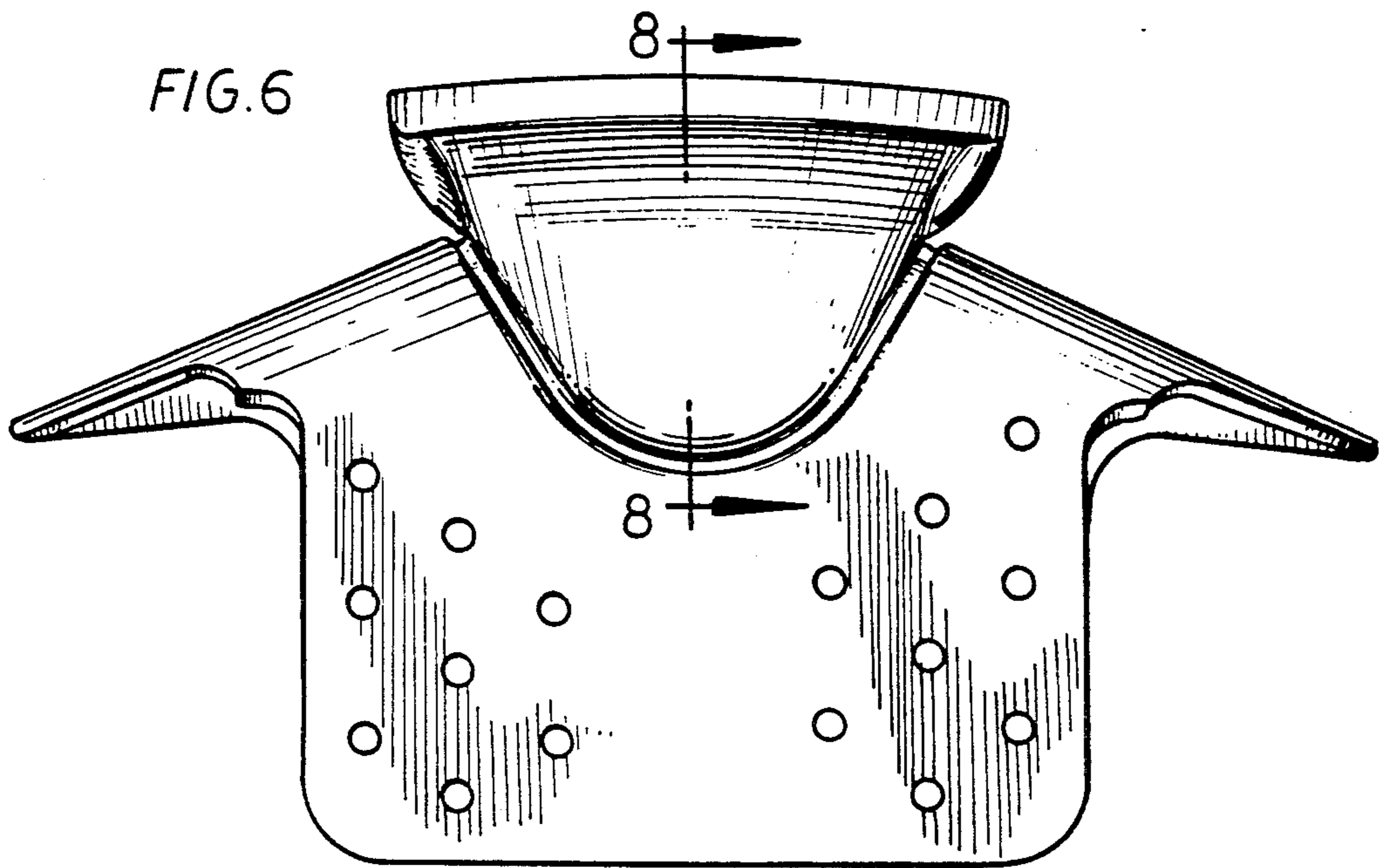

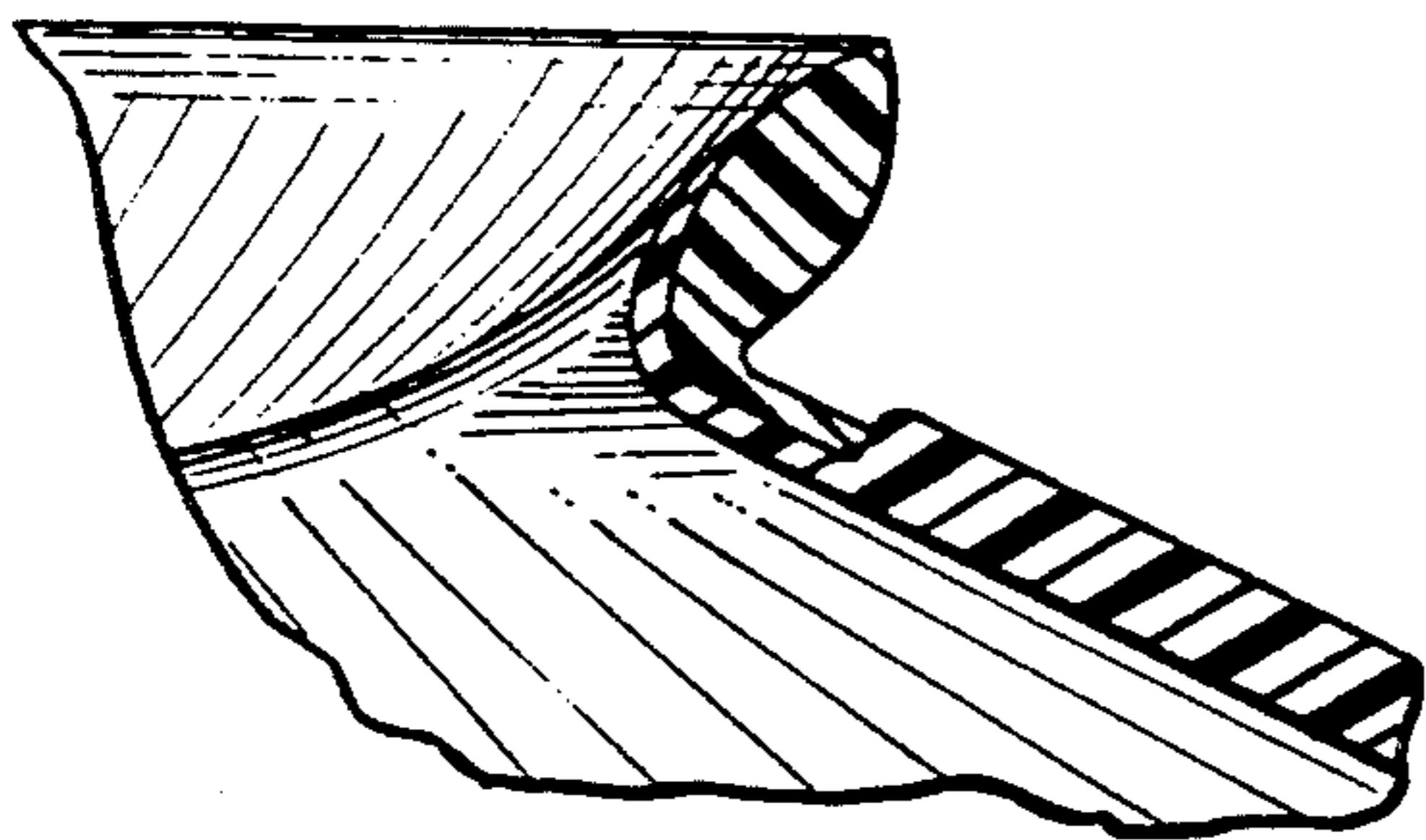
