FIG. 8 is an exploded perspective view thereof.

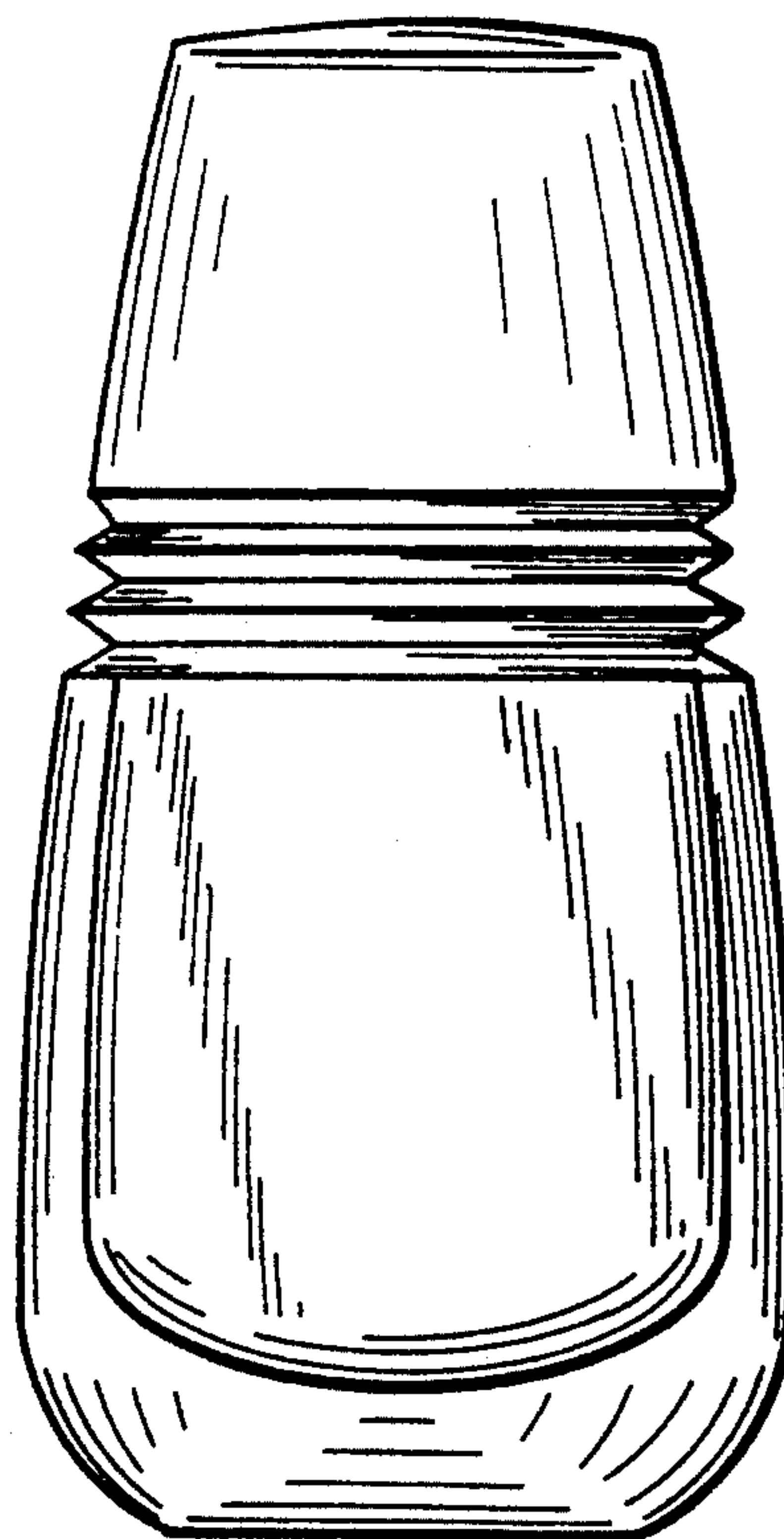

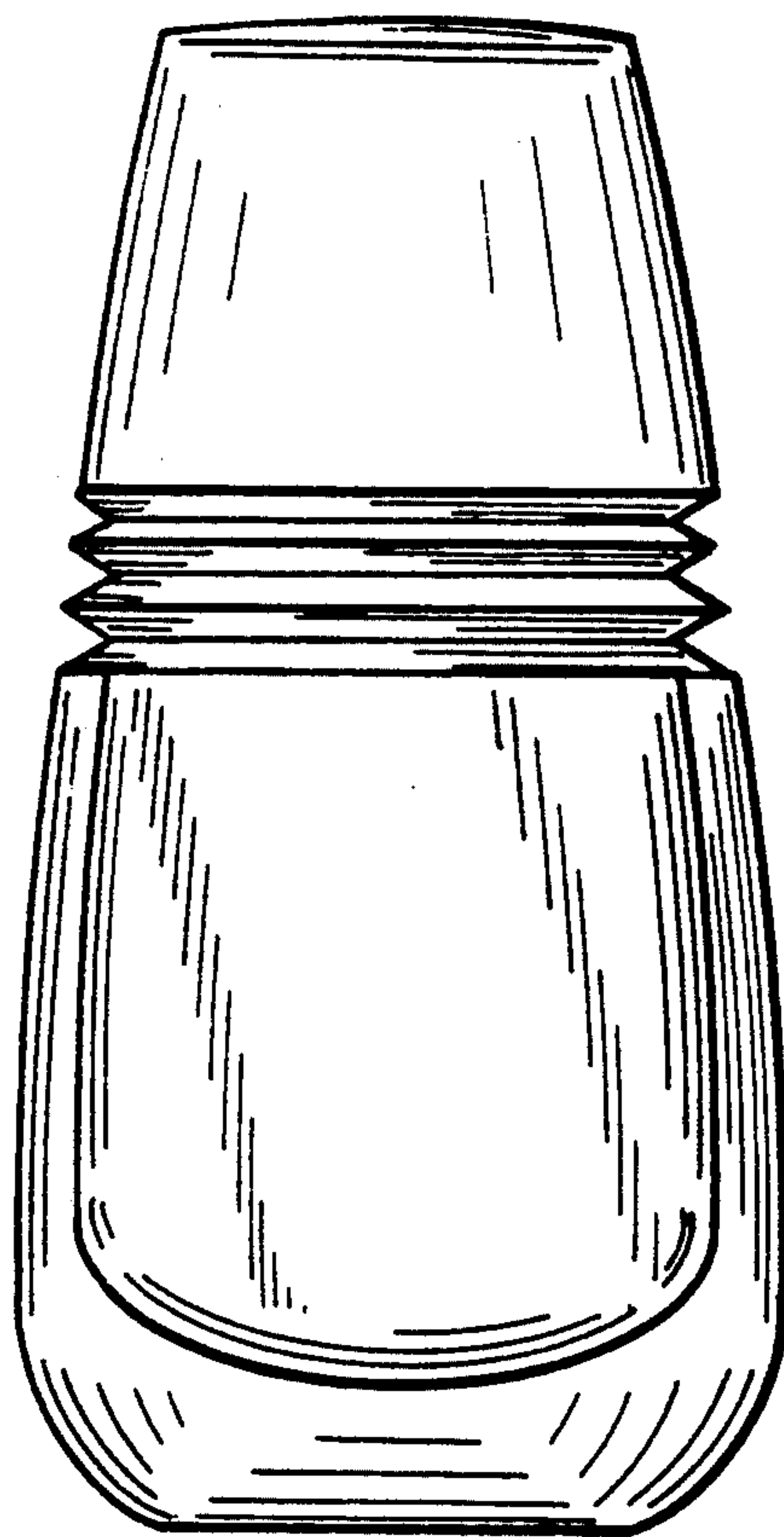

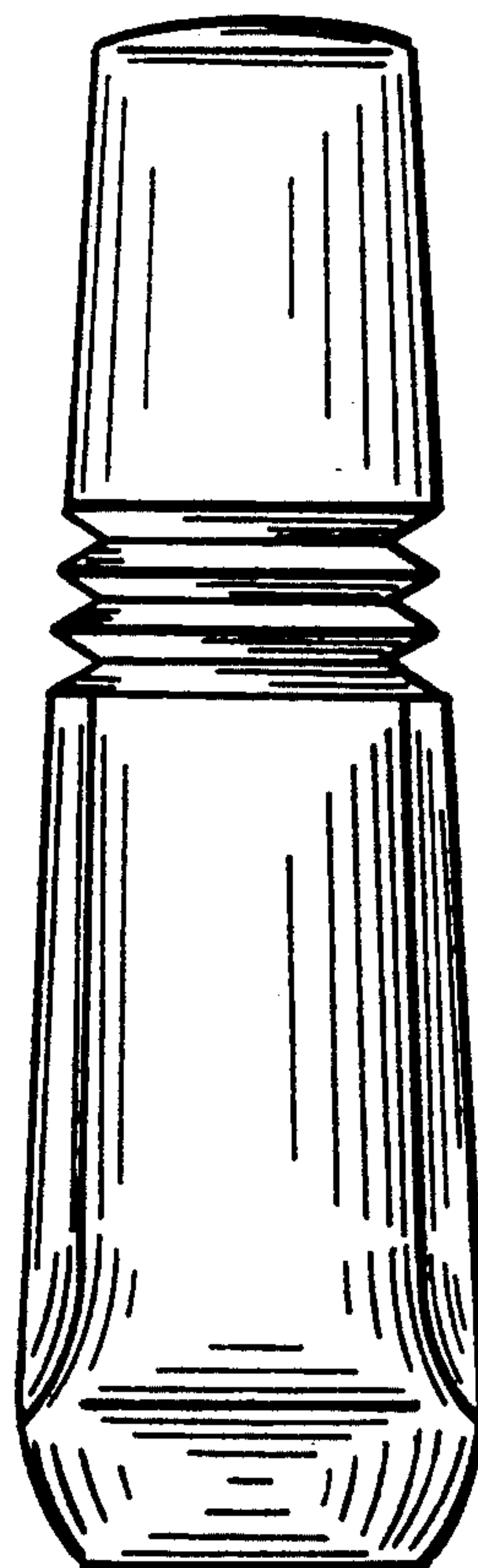

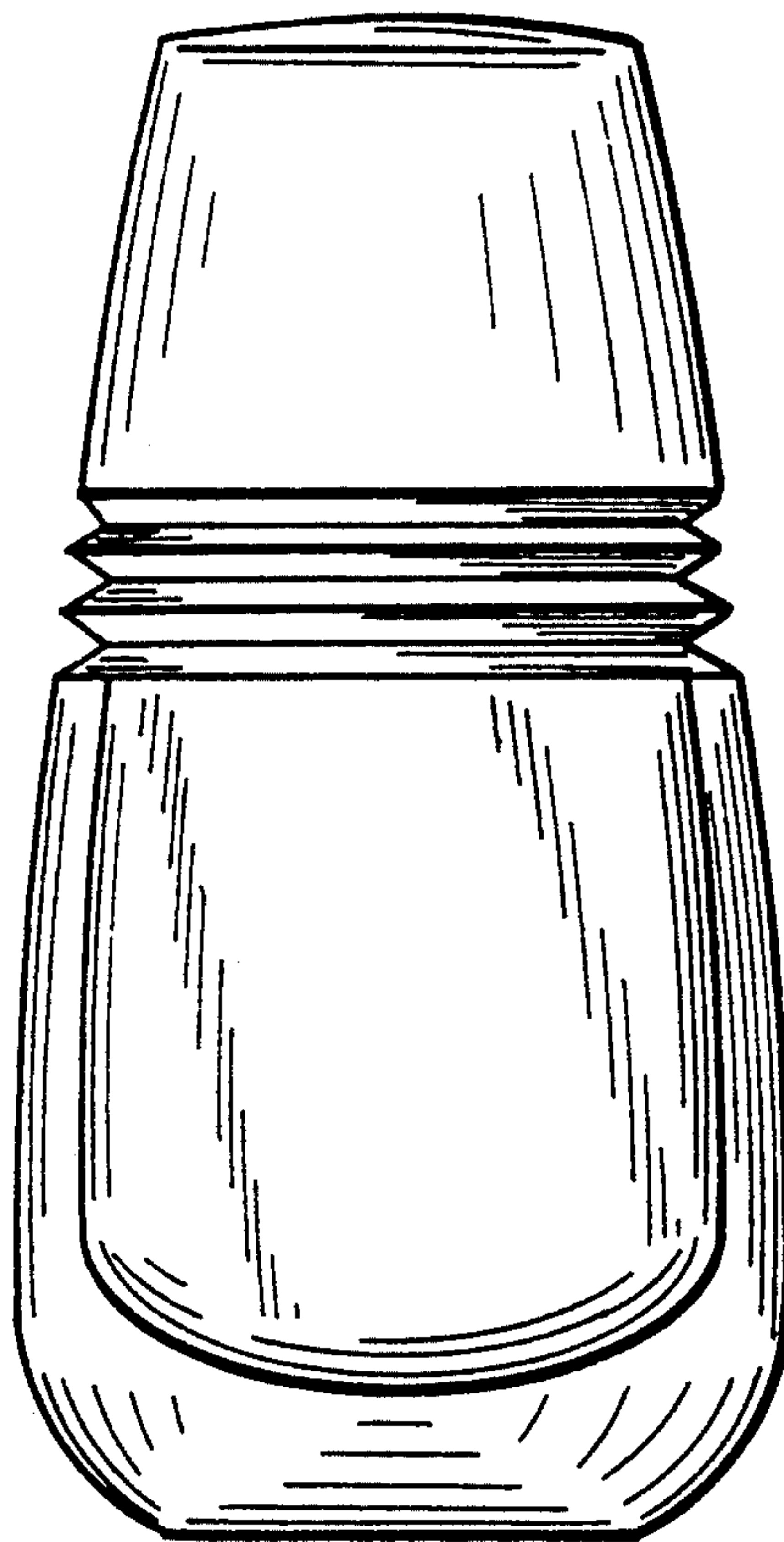

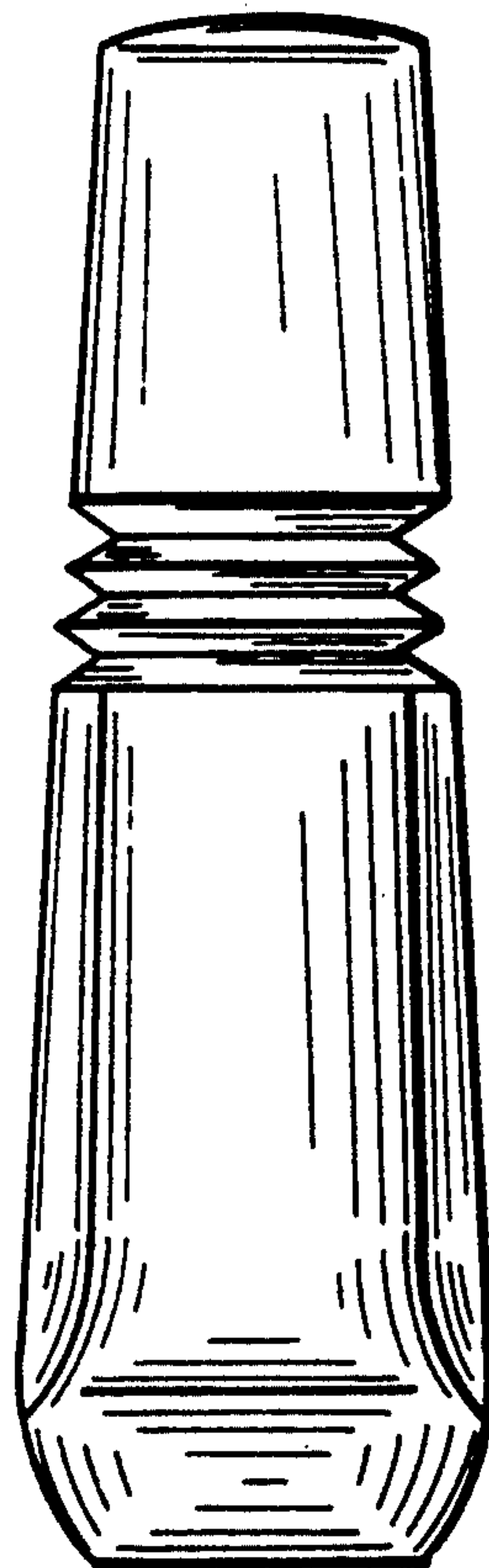

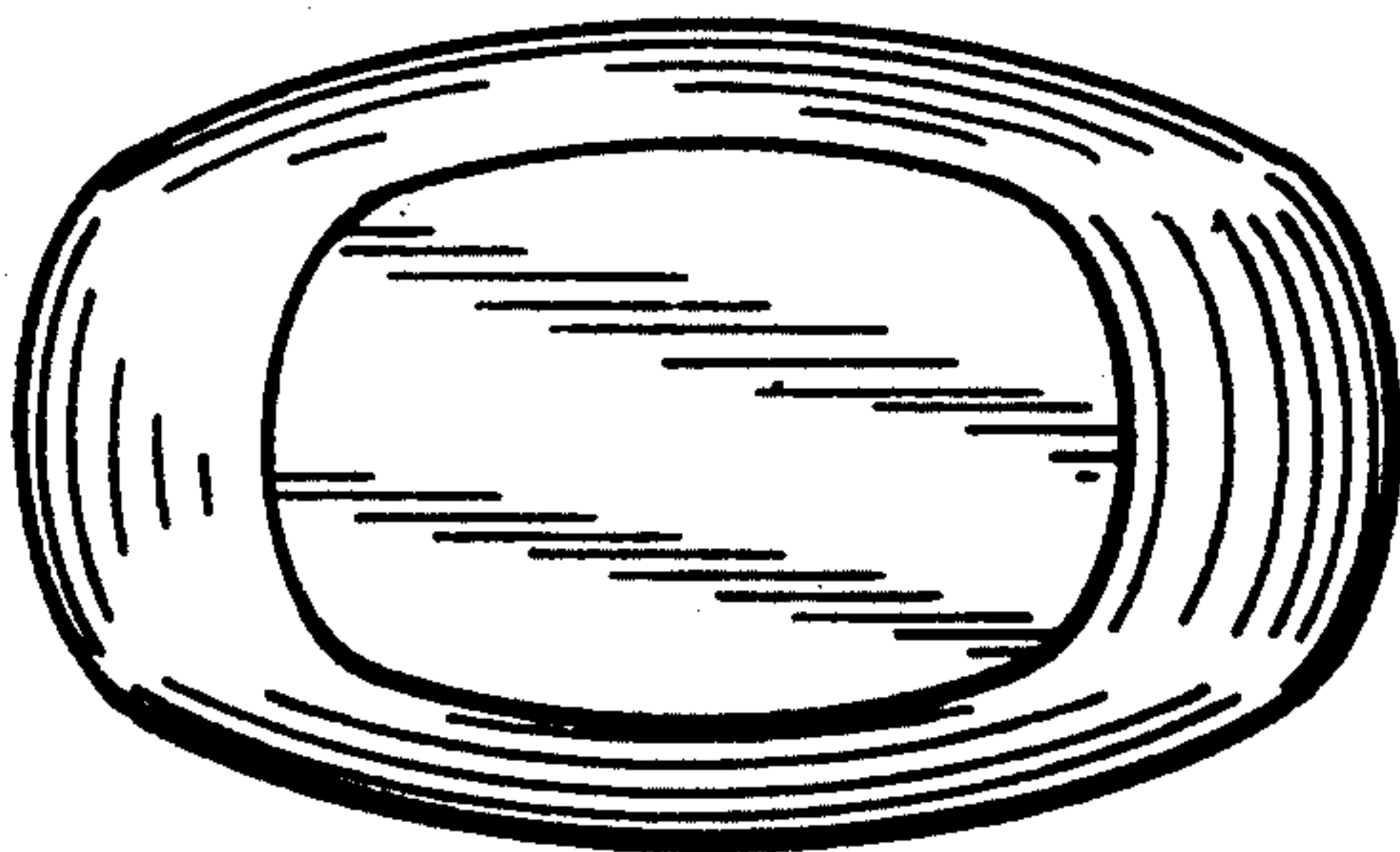
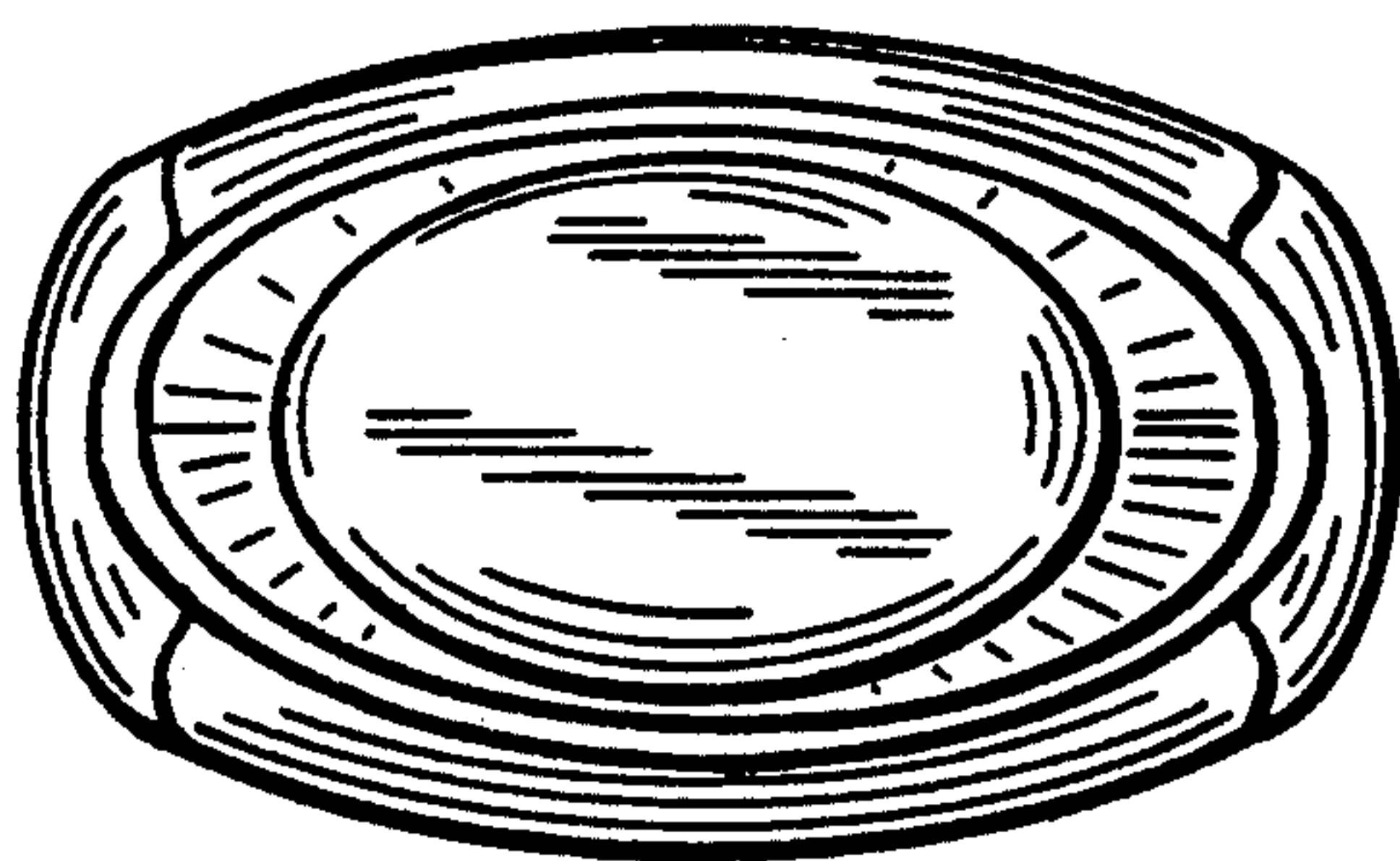
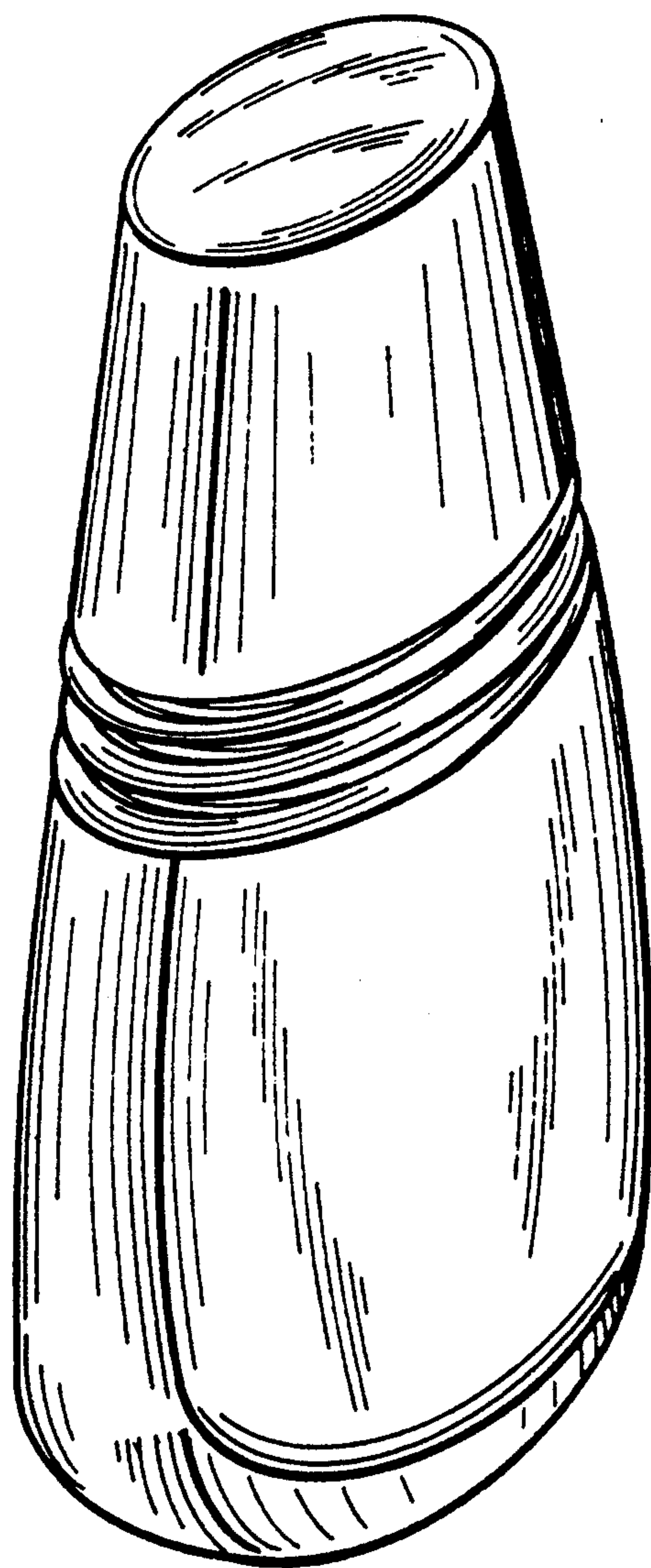
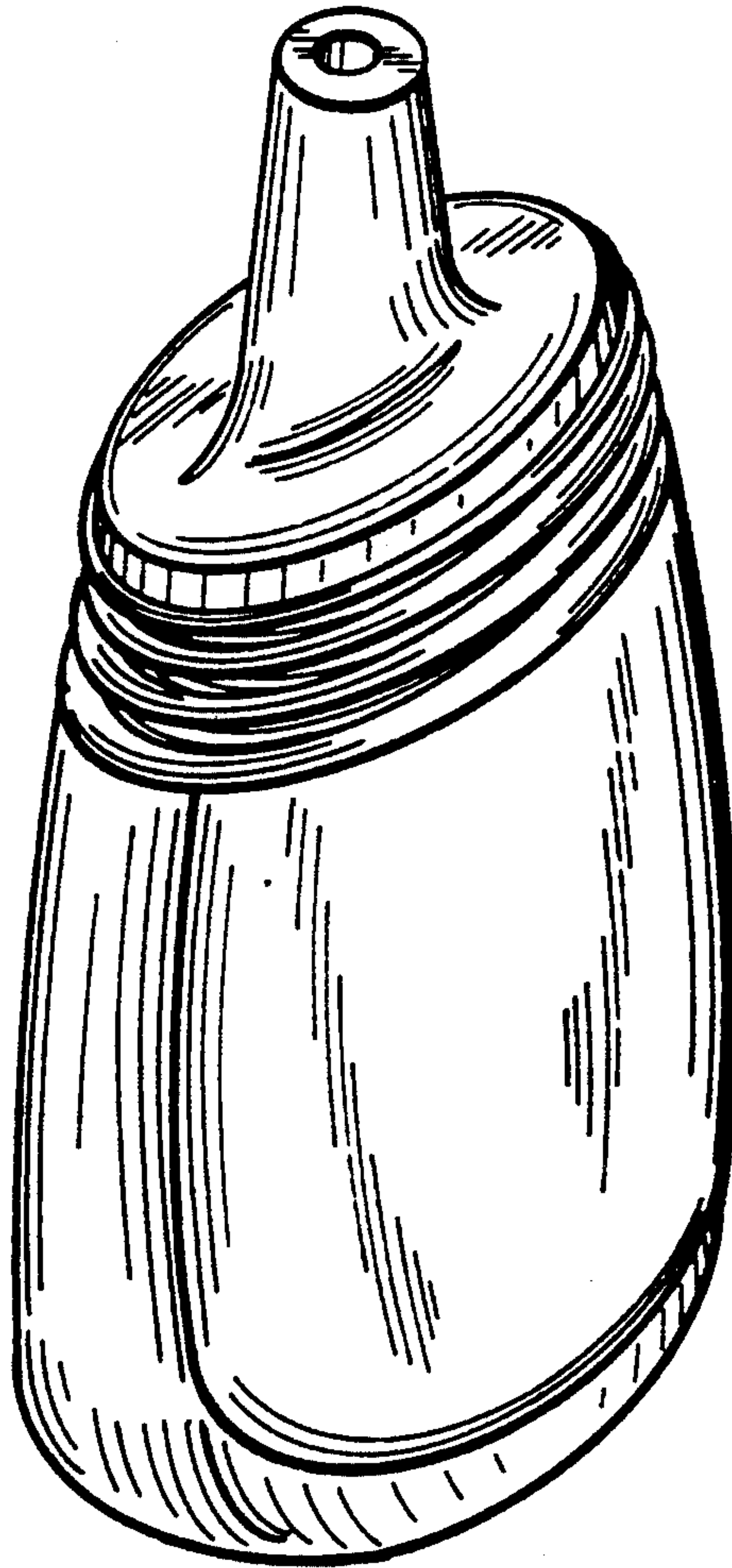
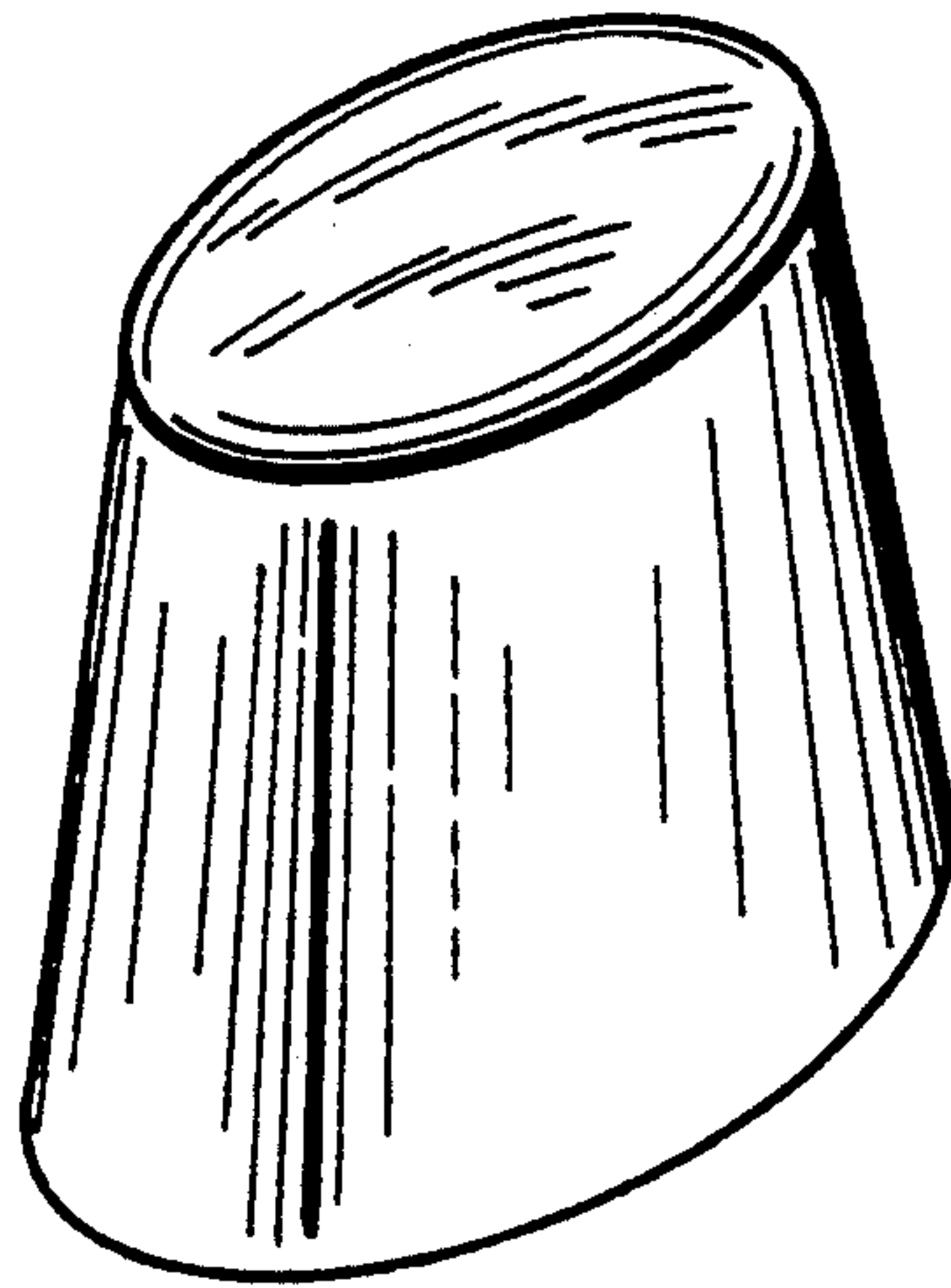
