[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a covering for refrigerators or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and right side perspective view of a covering for a refrigerators or the like showing my new design;

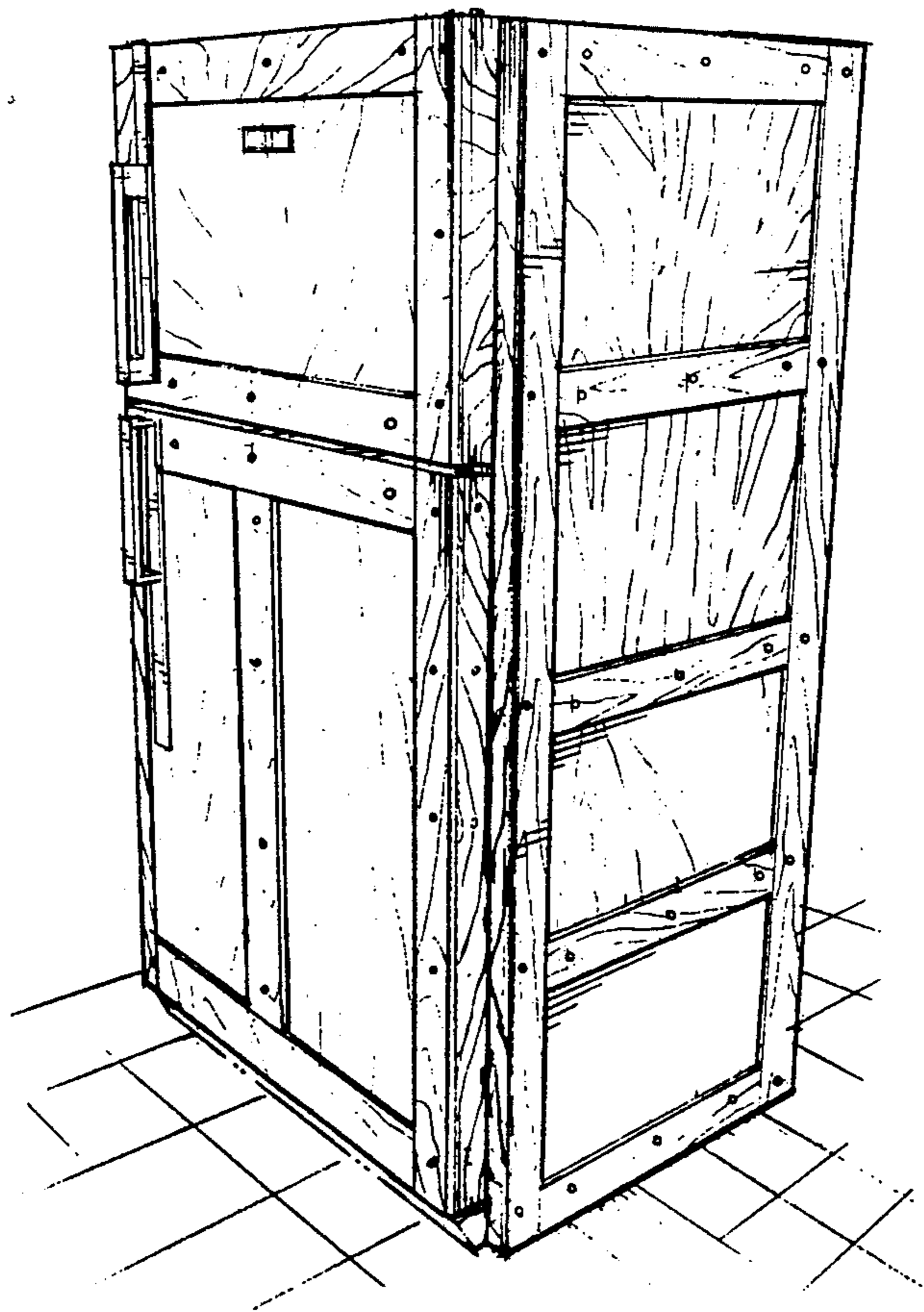
FIG. 2 is a reduced front and left side perspective view thereof, with the refrigerator doors being shown in an open position;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of that shown; and,

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being a mirror image of that shown.

The broken-line disclosure of portions of the refrigerator and floor in the views is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



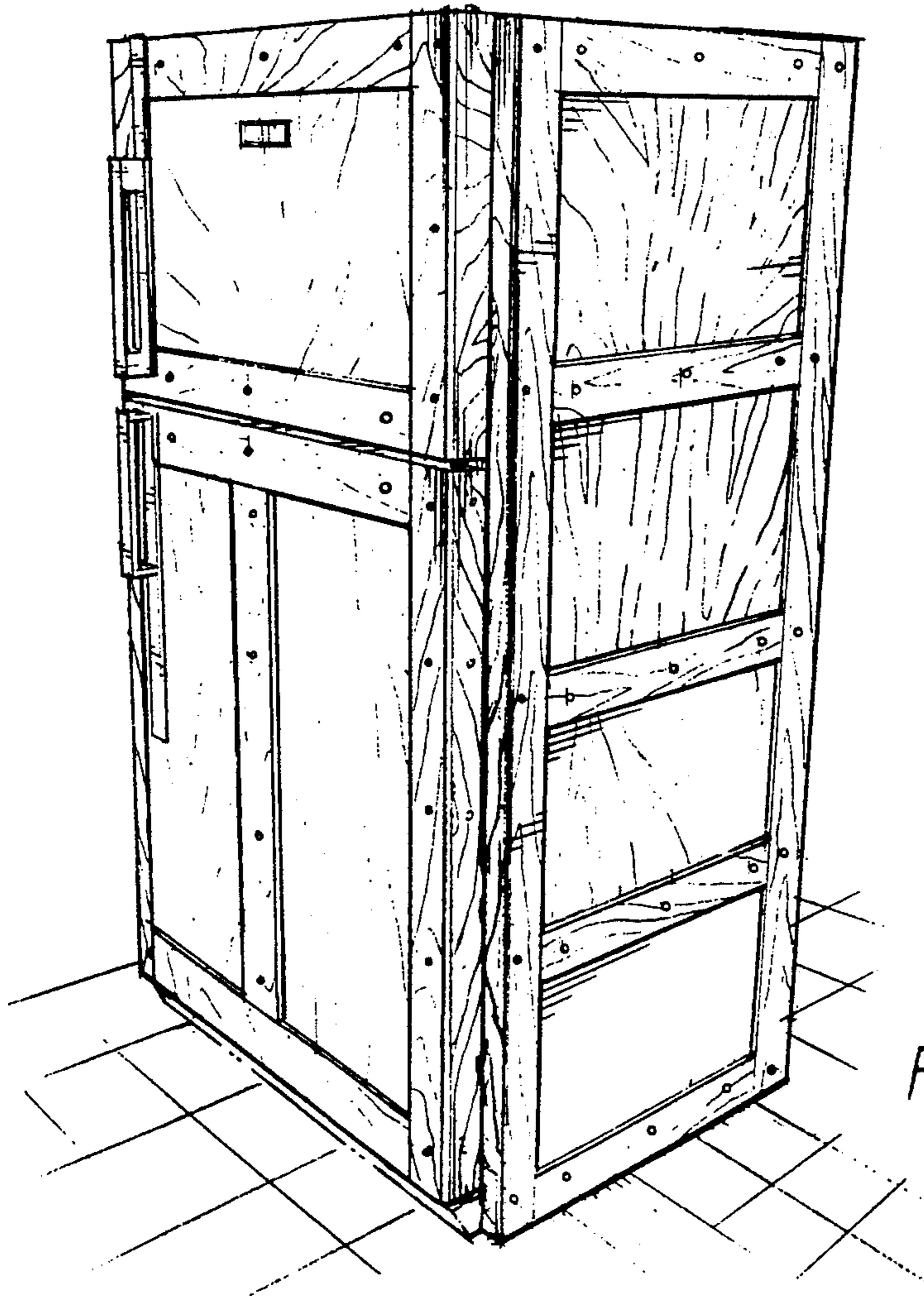

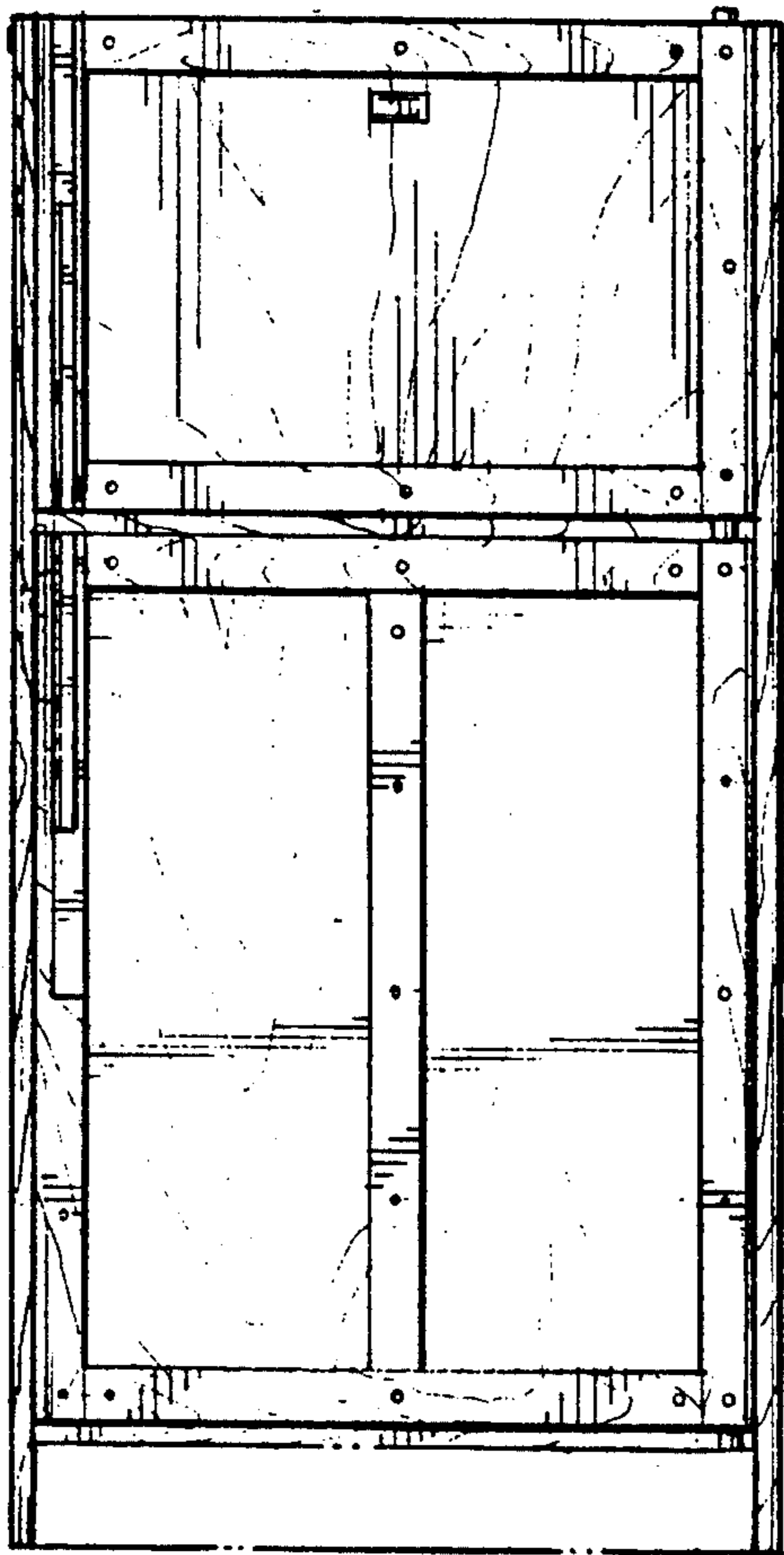

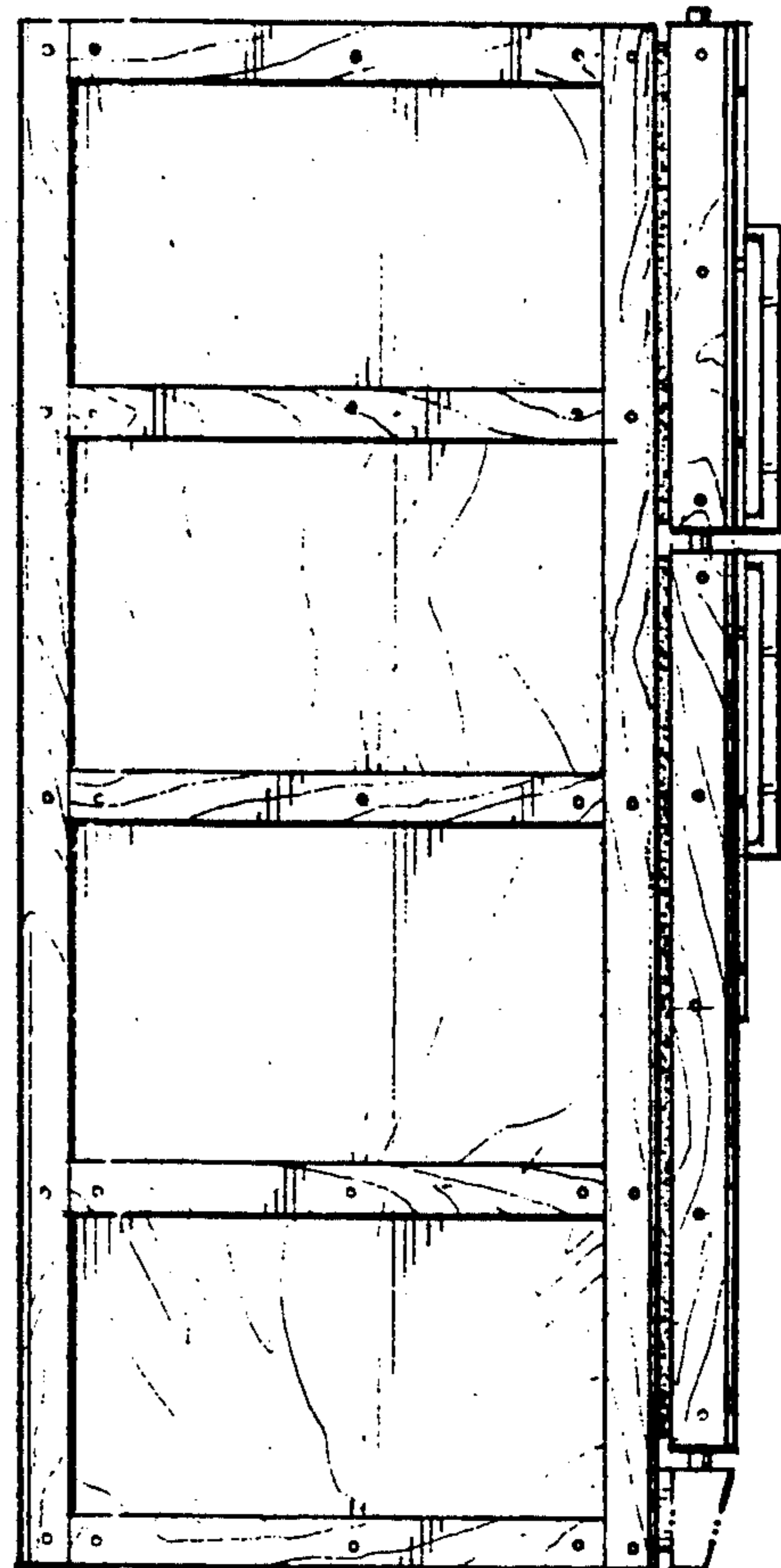

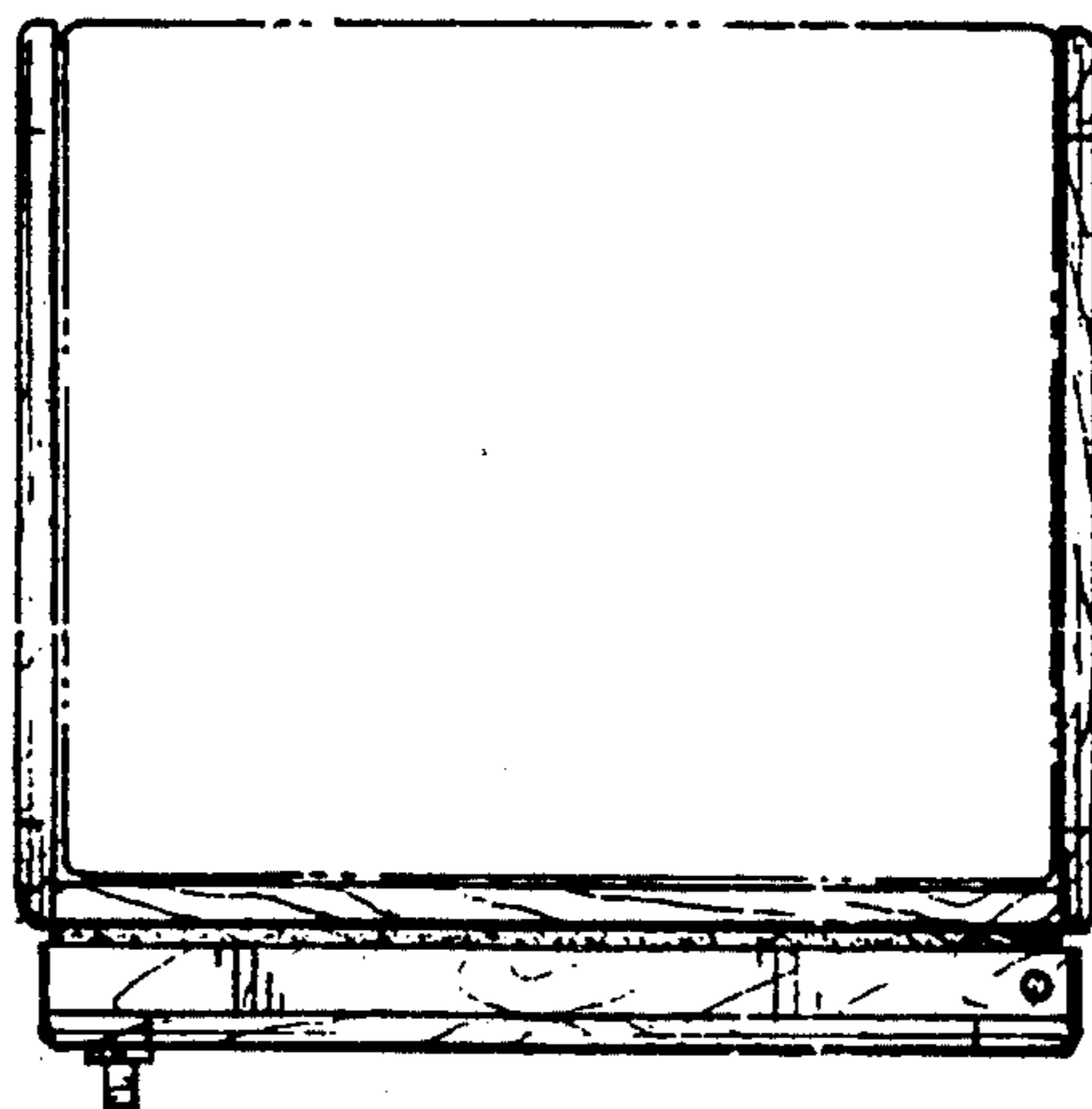
