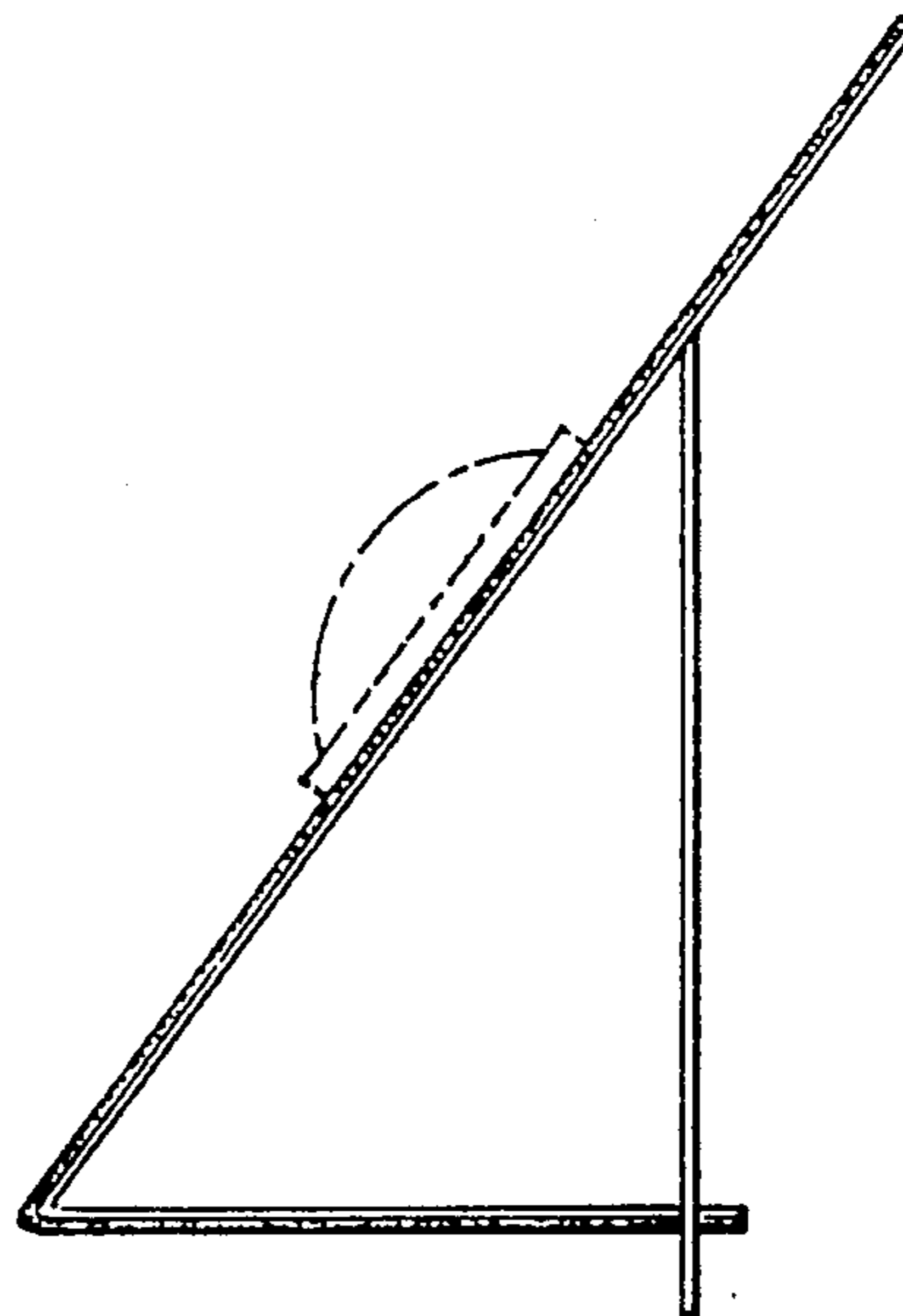
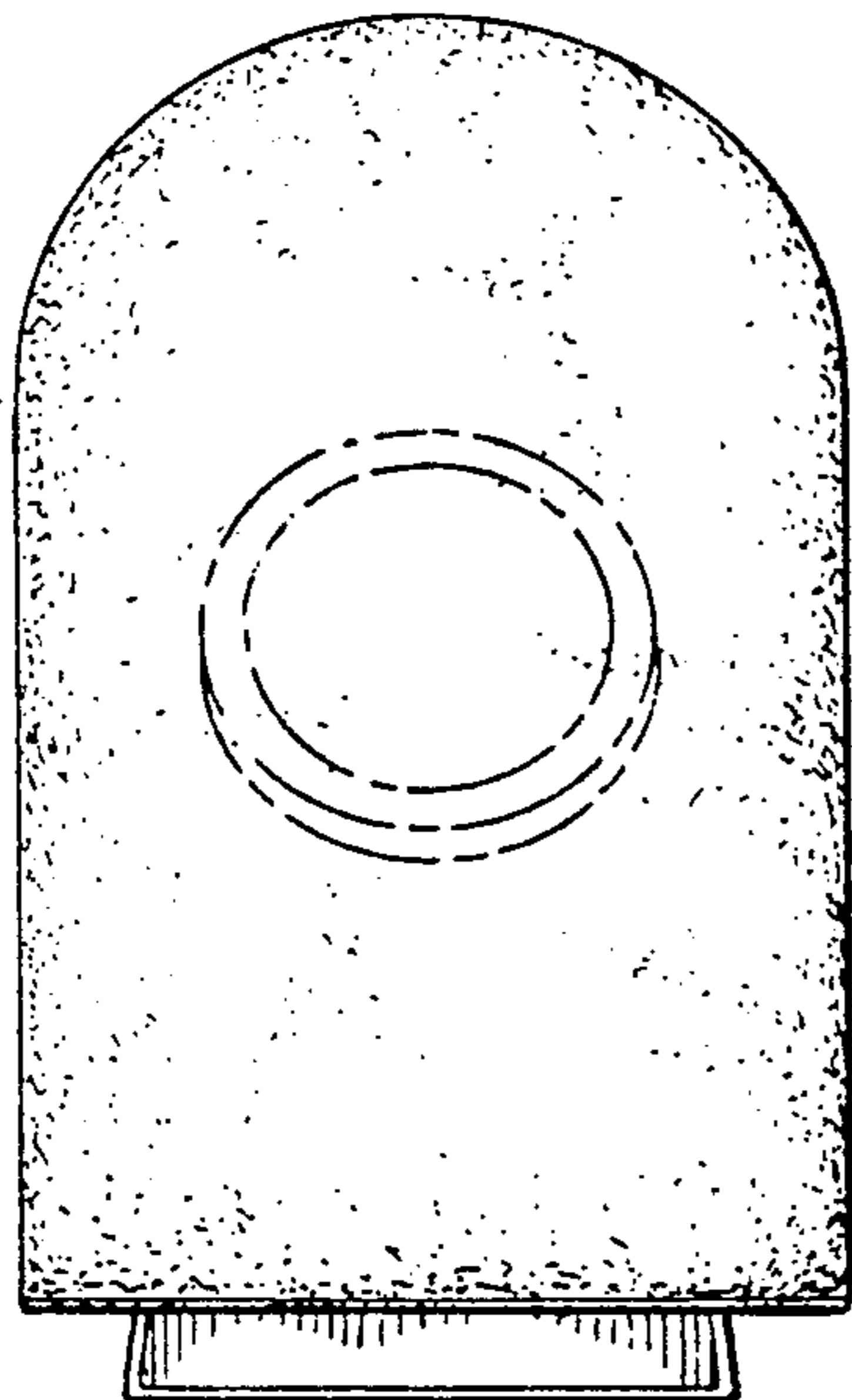
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a jewelry display stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a jewelry display stand showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the blank from which the display stand is formed; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the blank shown in FIG. 6.

The item of jewelry shown by means of broken lines in Figs. 1, 3, and 4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



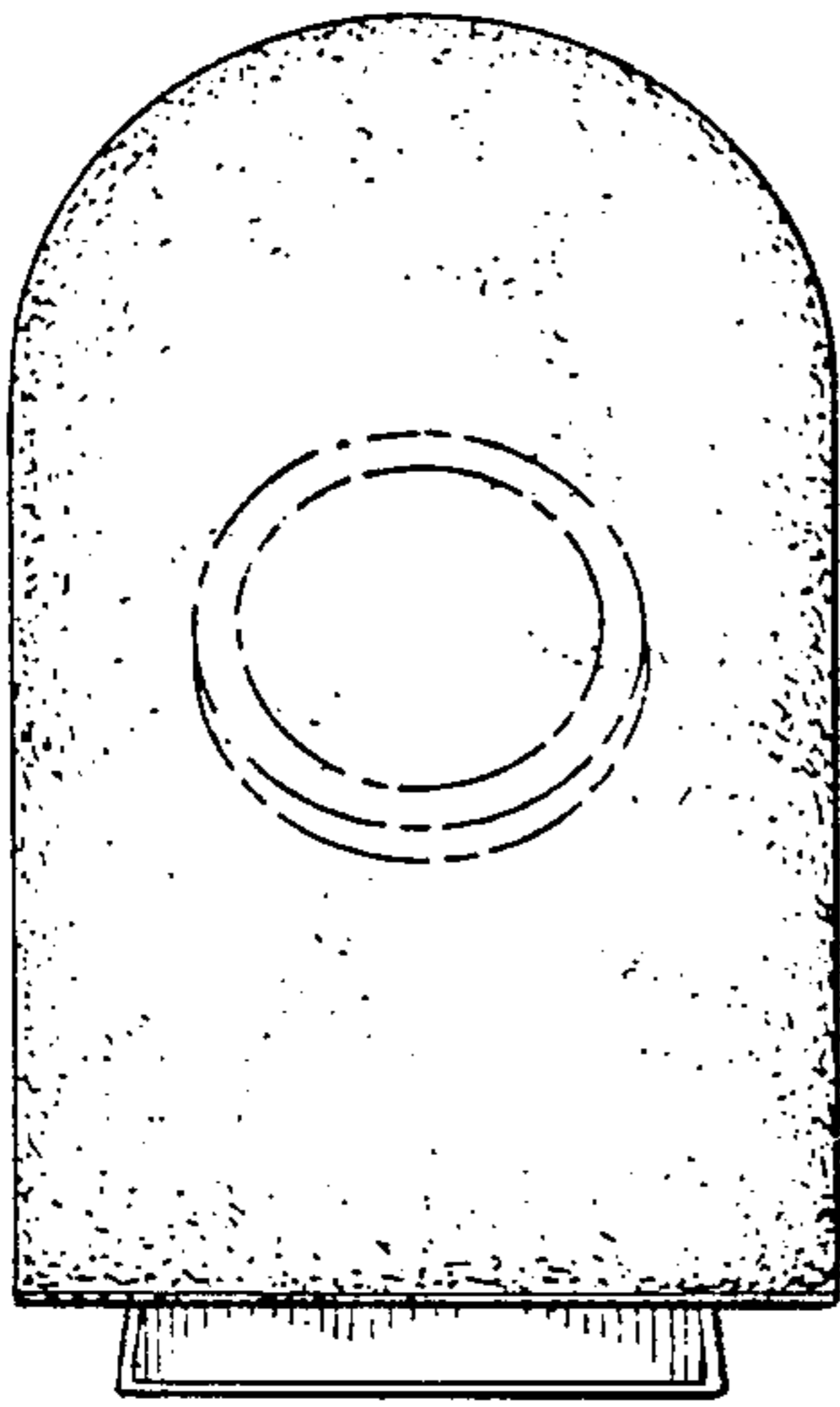

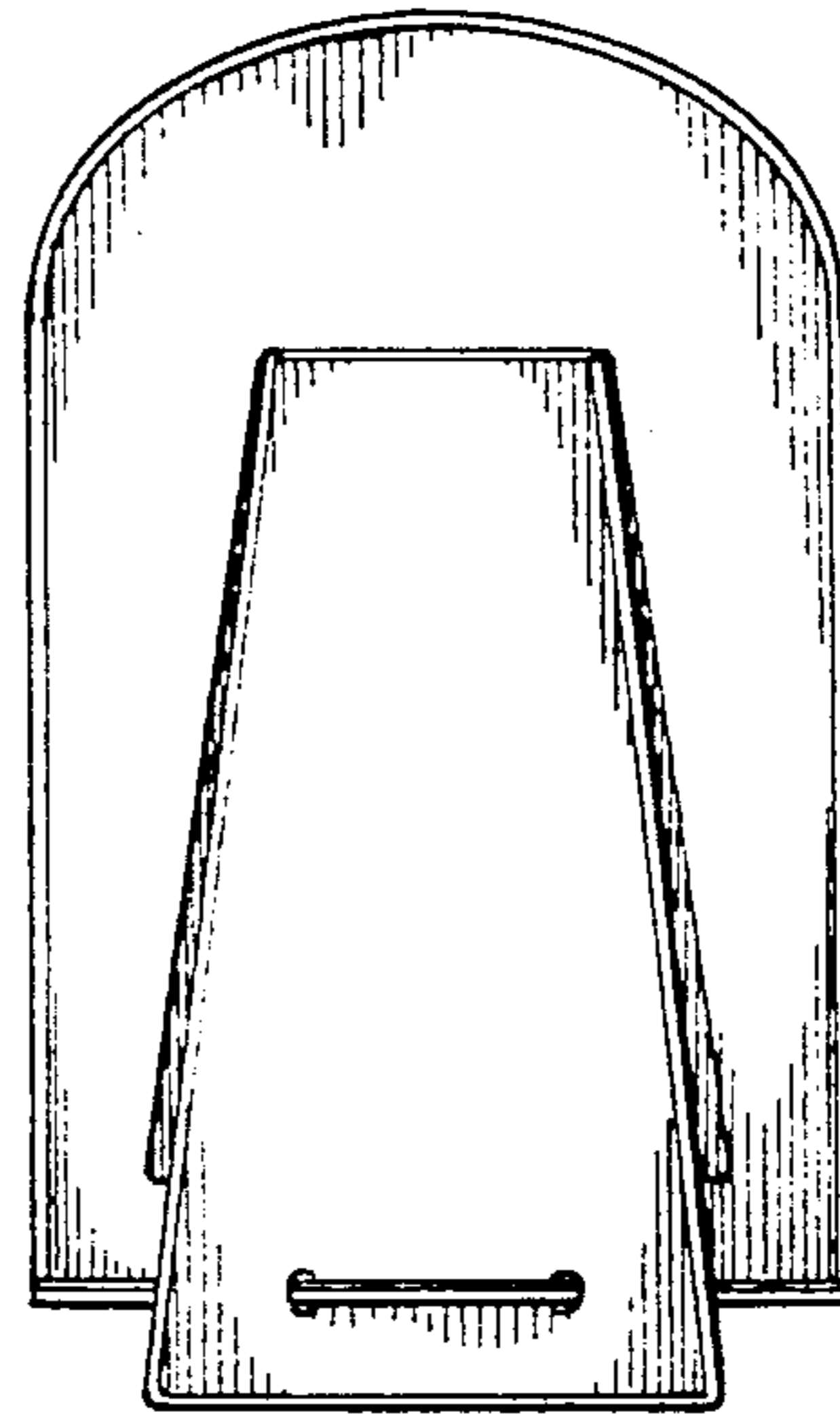

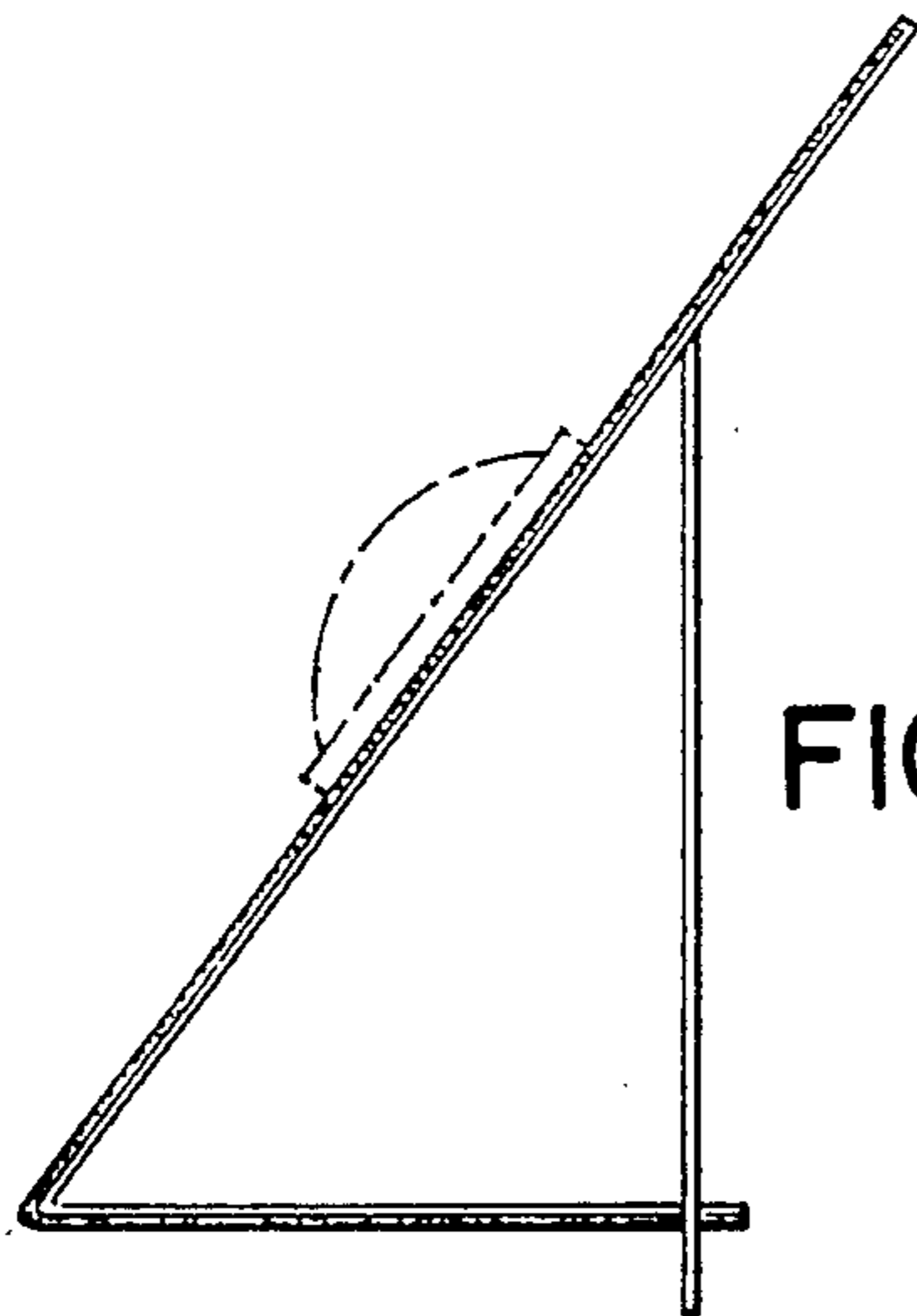

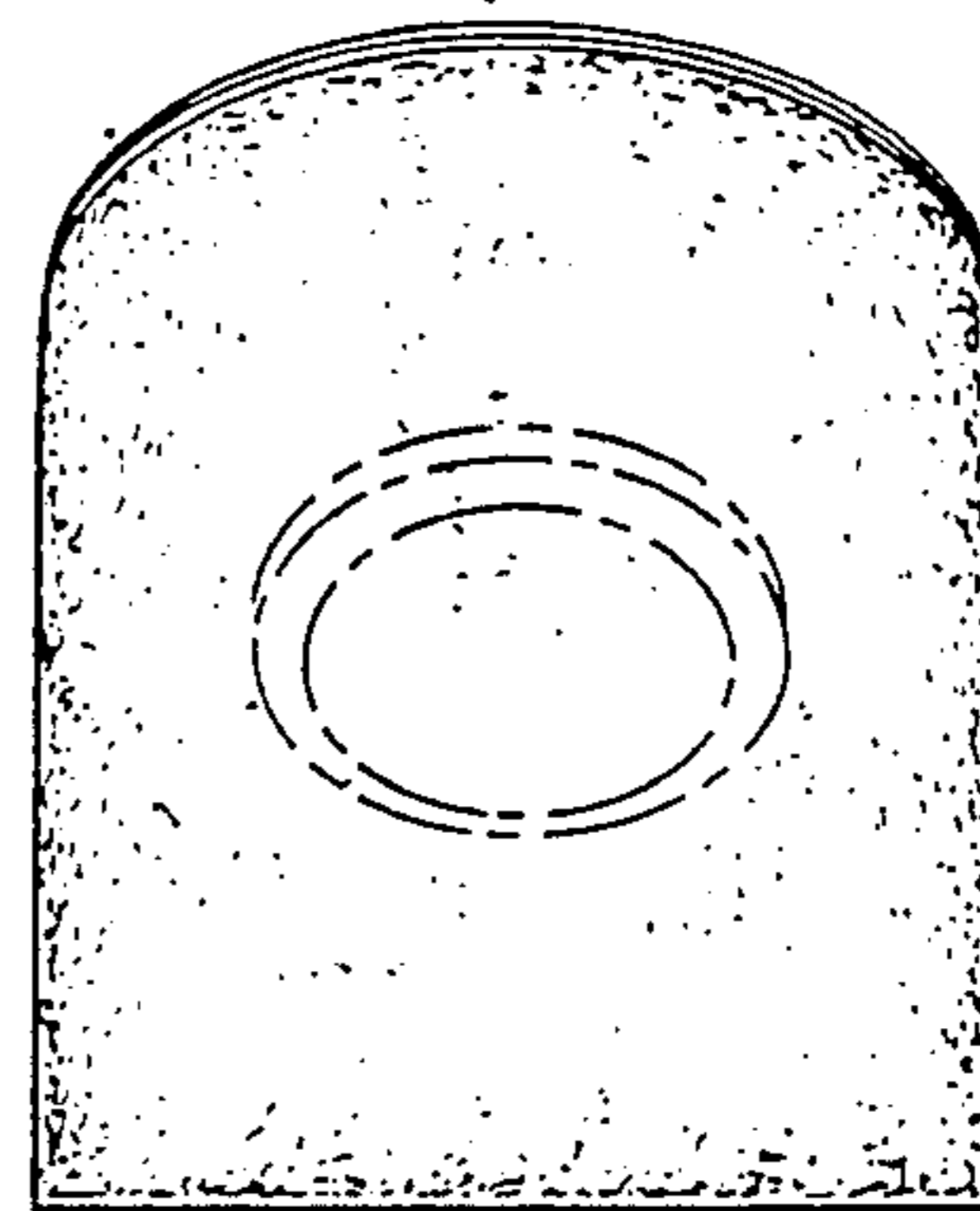

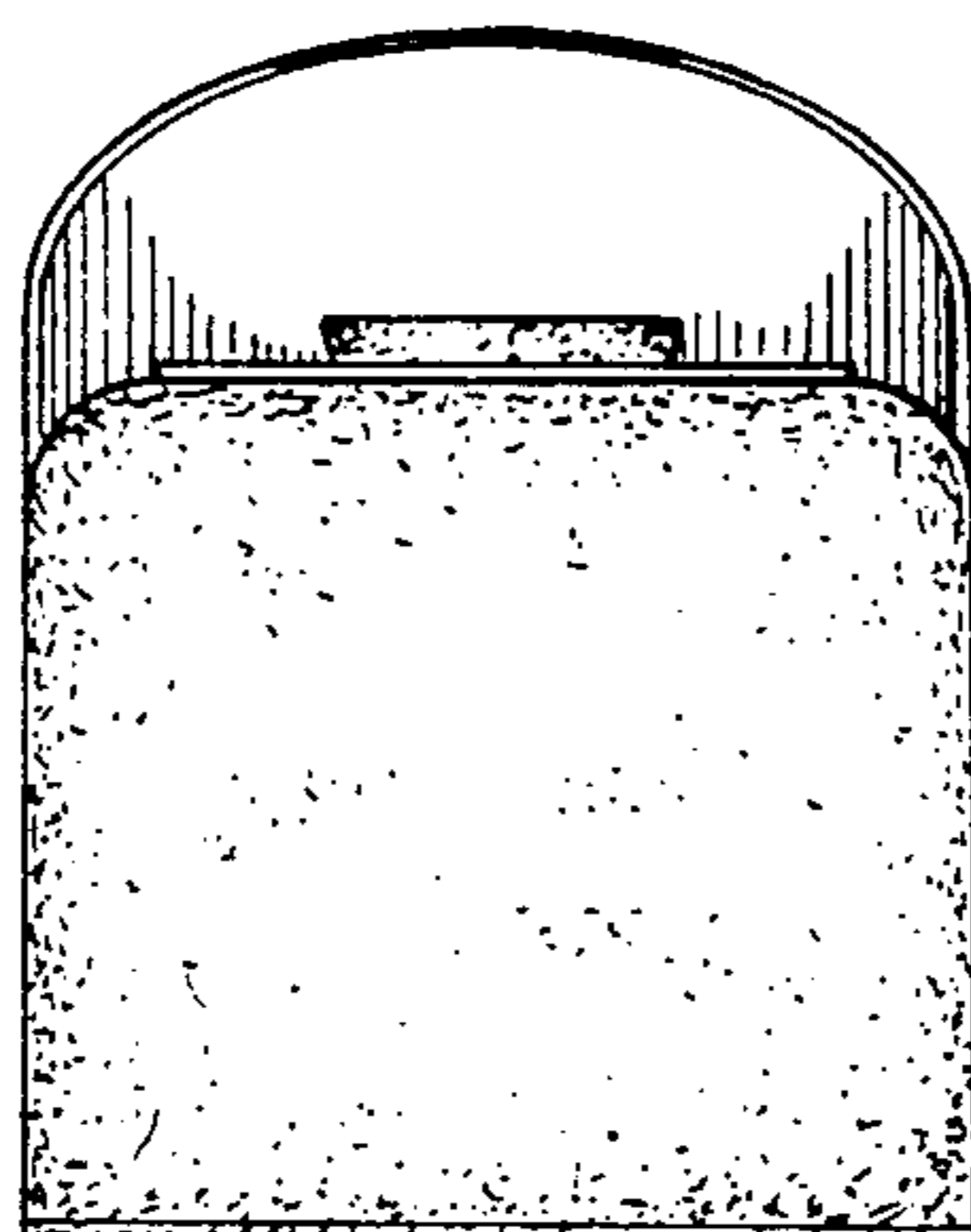

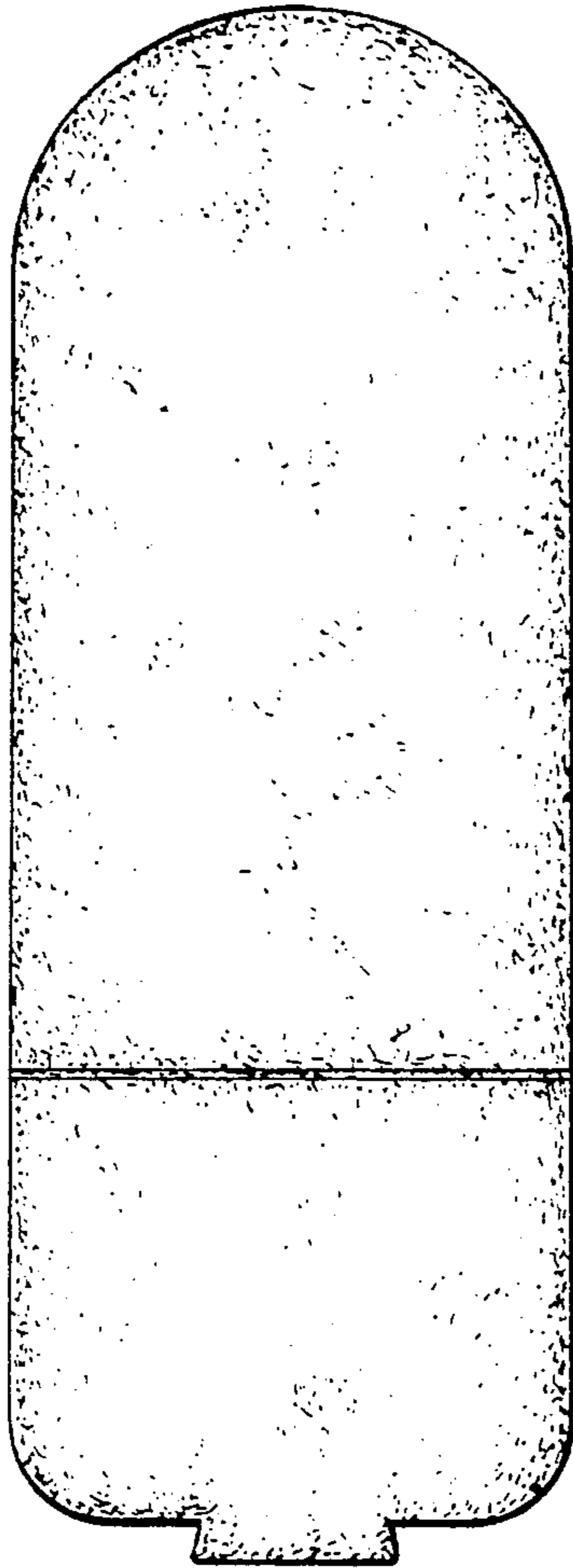

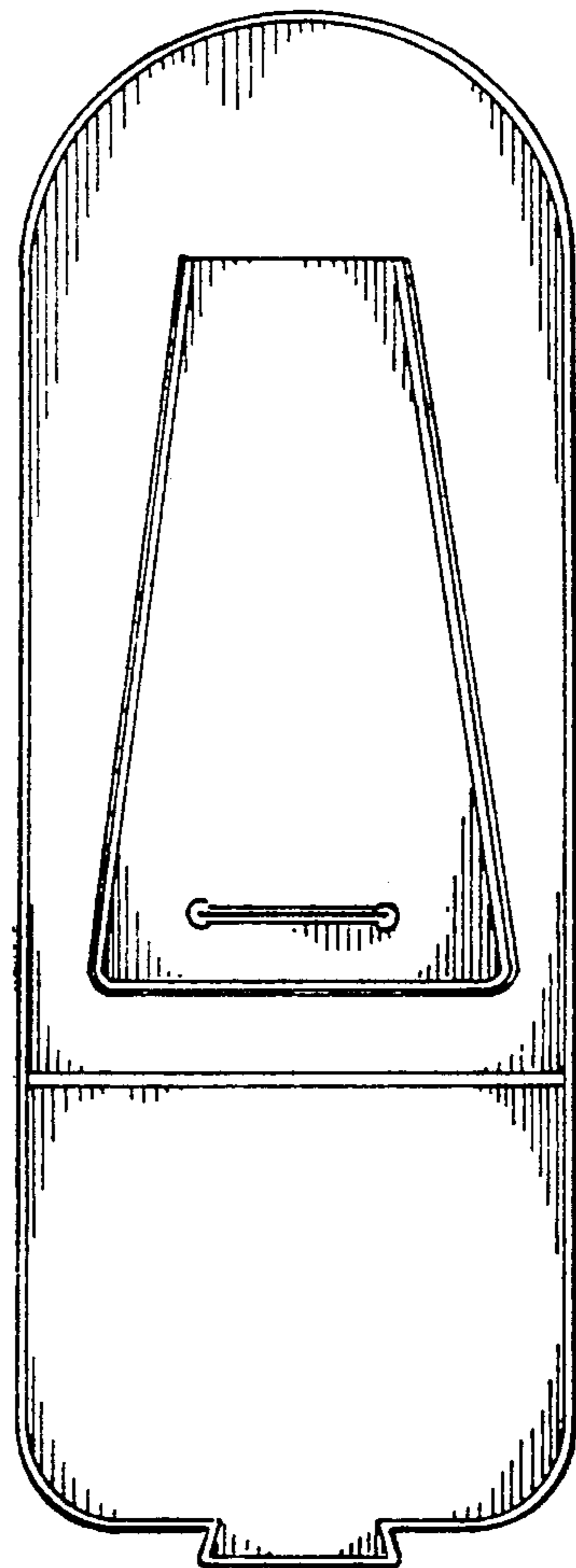
