FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pulling handle unit for attachment to the handlebars of a tricycle or the like showing my new design;

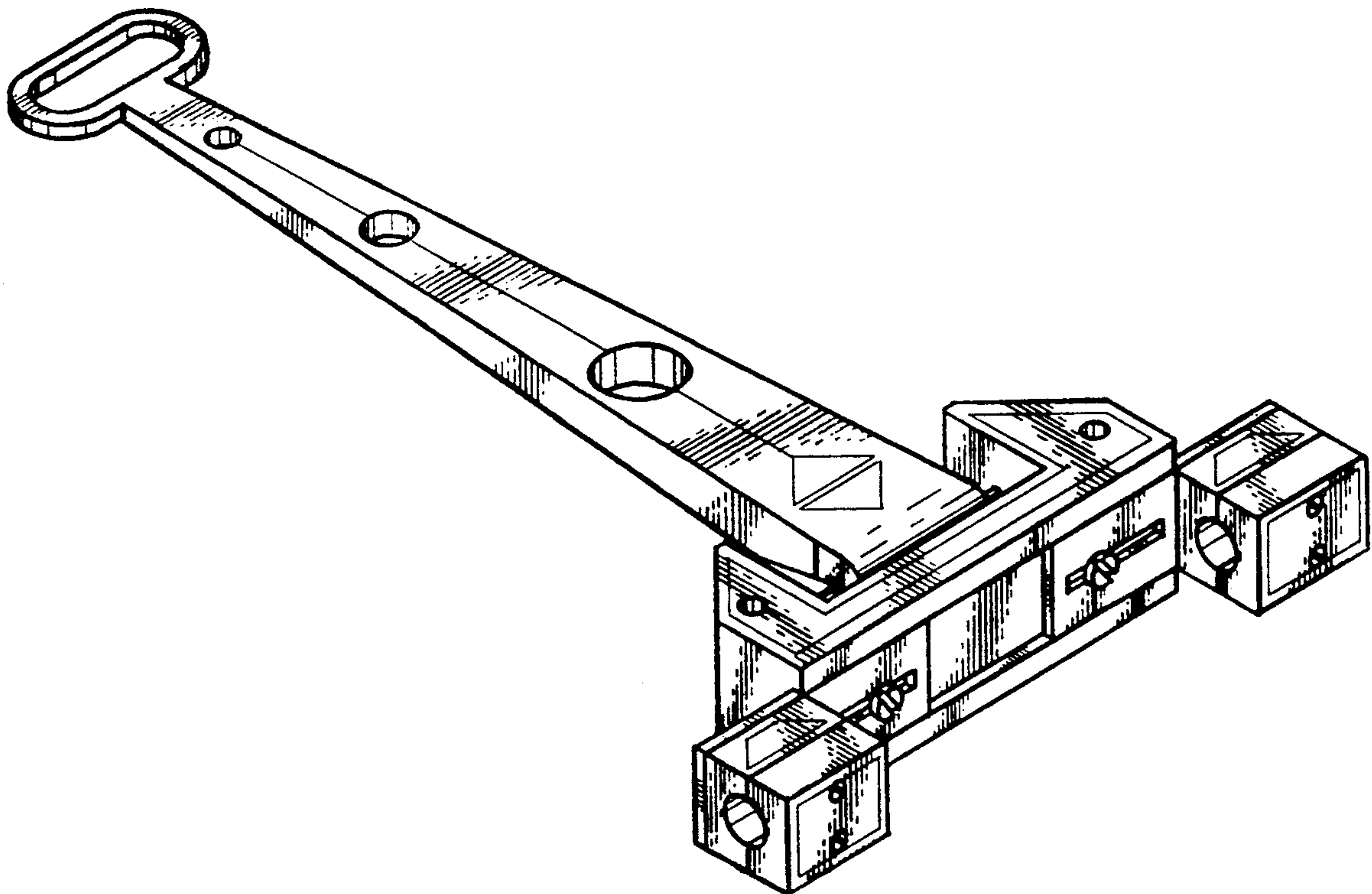
FIG. 2 is a front end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



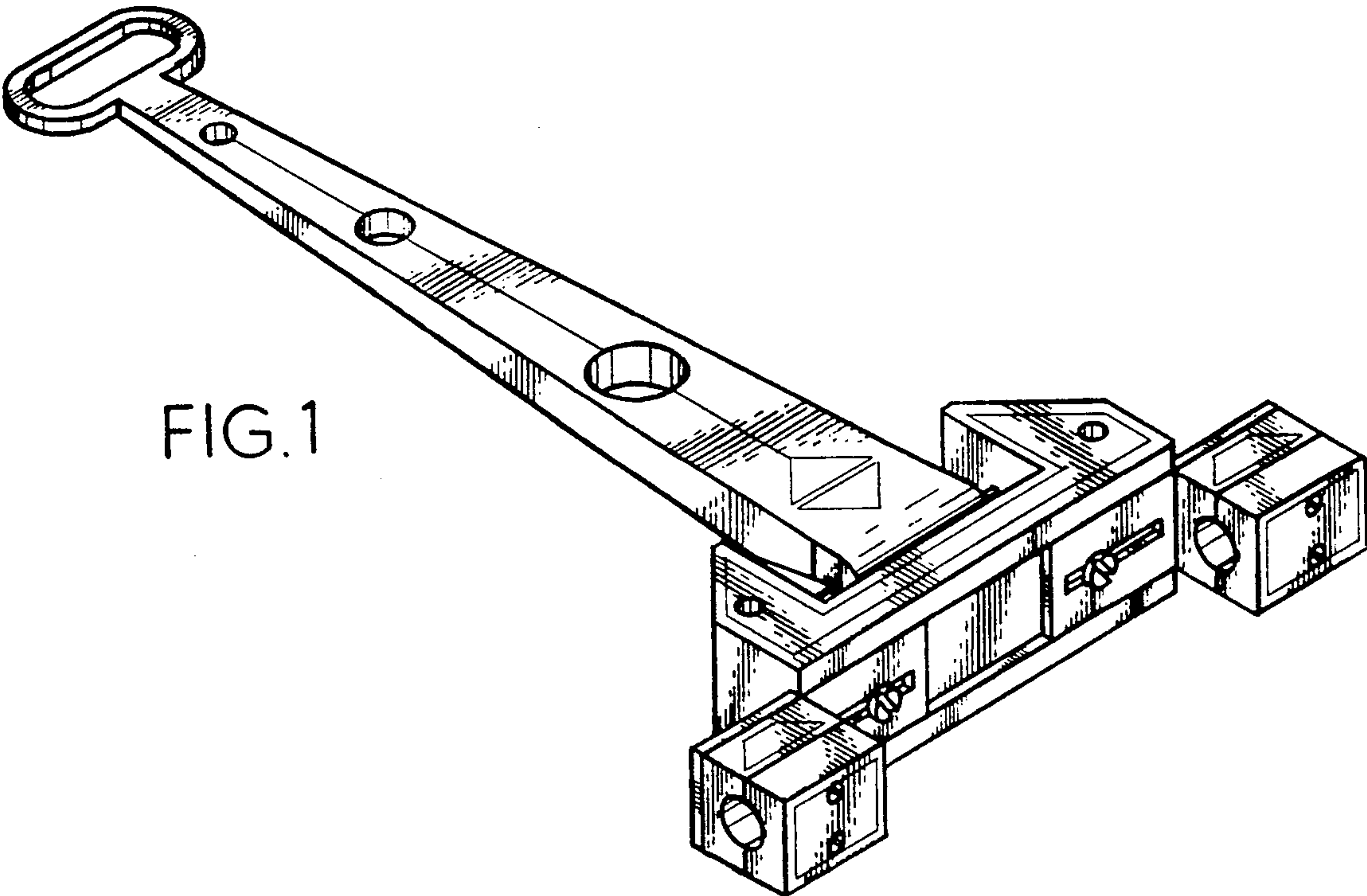

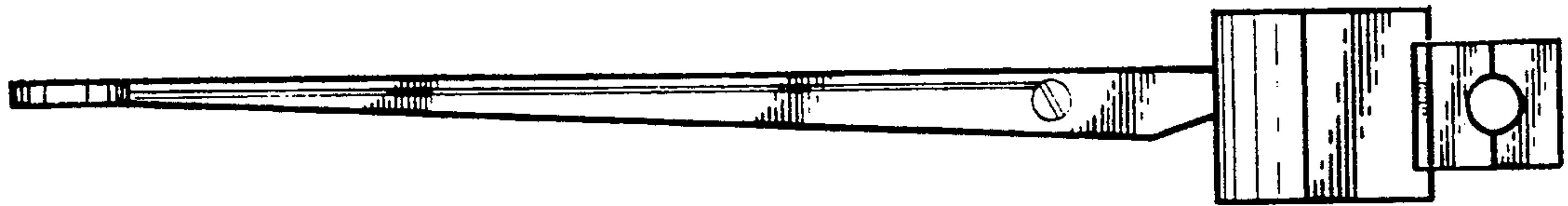

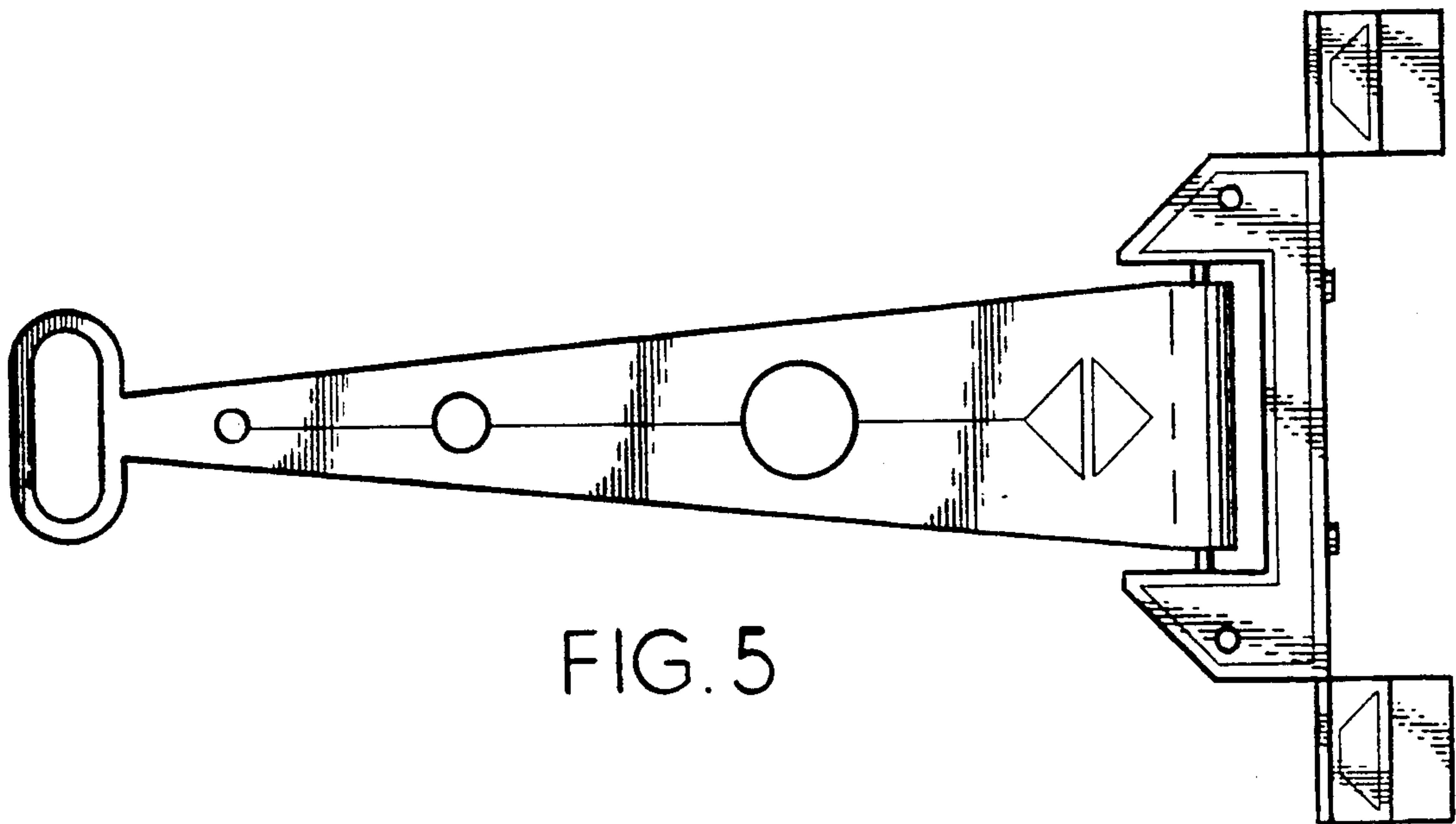

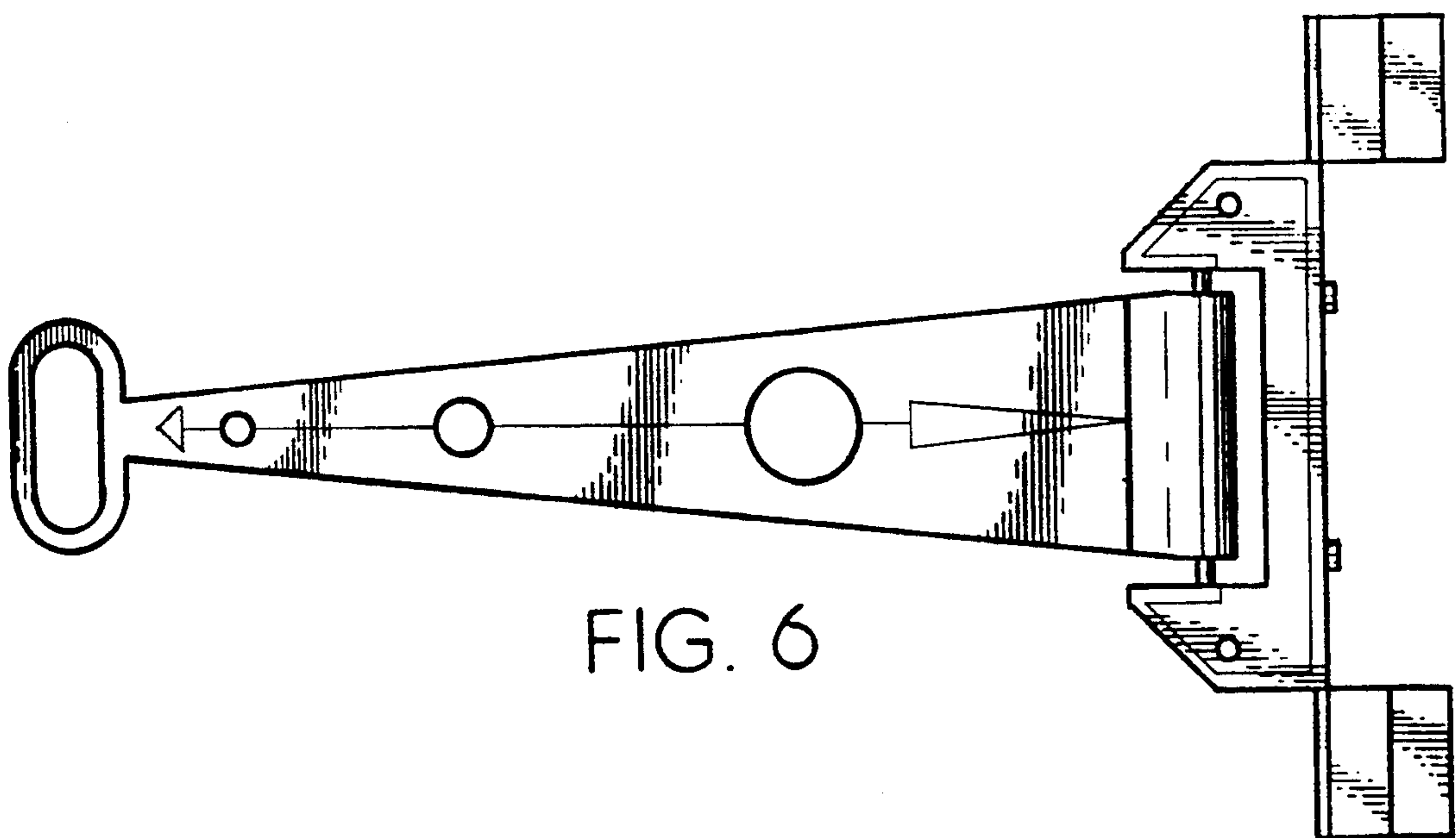
