[57] CLAIM-

The ornamental design for a side of a midsole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of one side of a side of a midsole showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the other side of the side of the midsole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the side of the midsole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a cross-section taken generally along line 4—4 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a cross-section taken generally along line 5—5 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of one side of a side of a midsole showing another embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the other side of the side of the midsole shown in FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of the side of the midsole shown in FIG. 6;


FIG. 9 is a cross-section taken generally along line 9—9 of FIG. 7;


FIG. 10 is a cross-section taken generally along line 10—10 of FIG. 7;


FIG. 11 is a front elevational view thereof; and,














