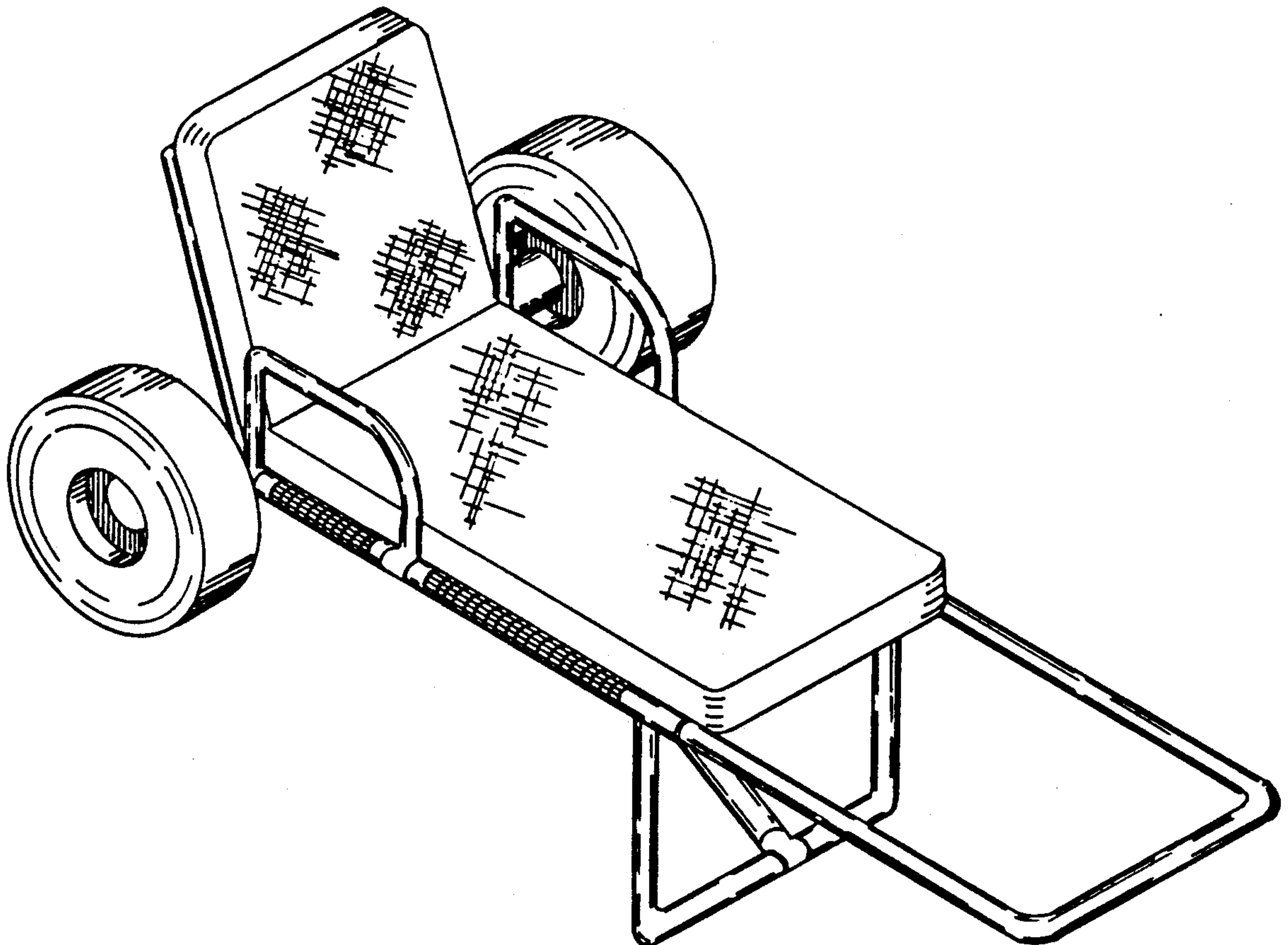
FIG. 1 is a top and front perspective view of an invalid-carrying beach chair with telescoping handle showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image of that shown.



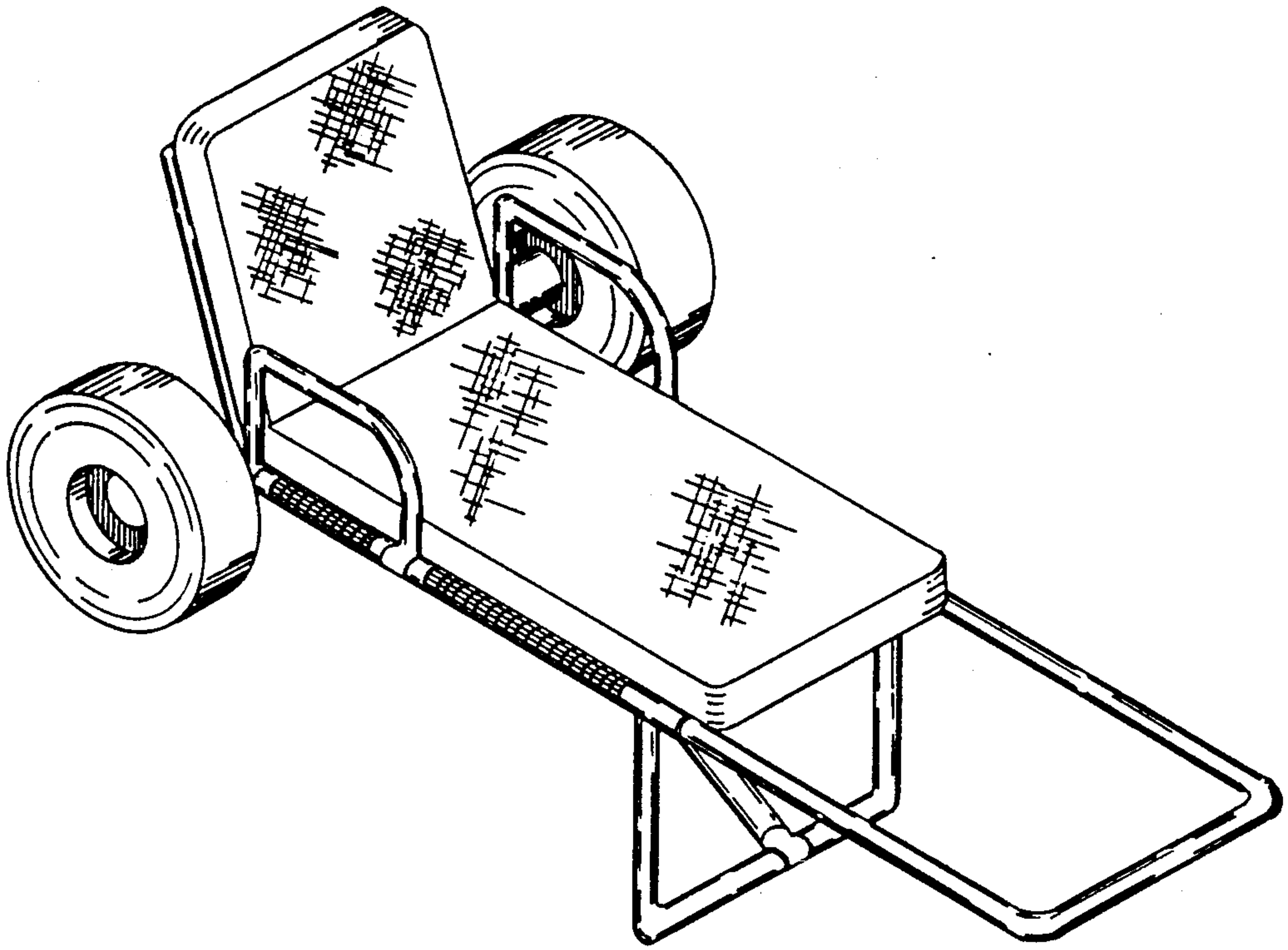

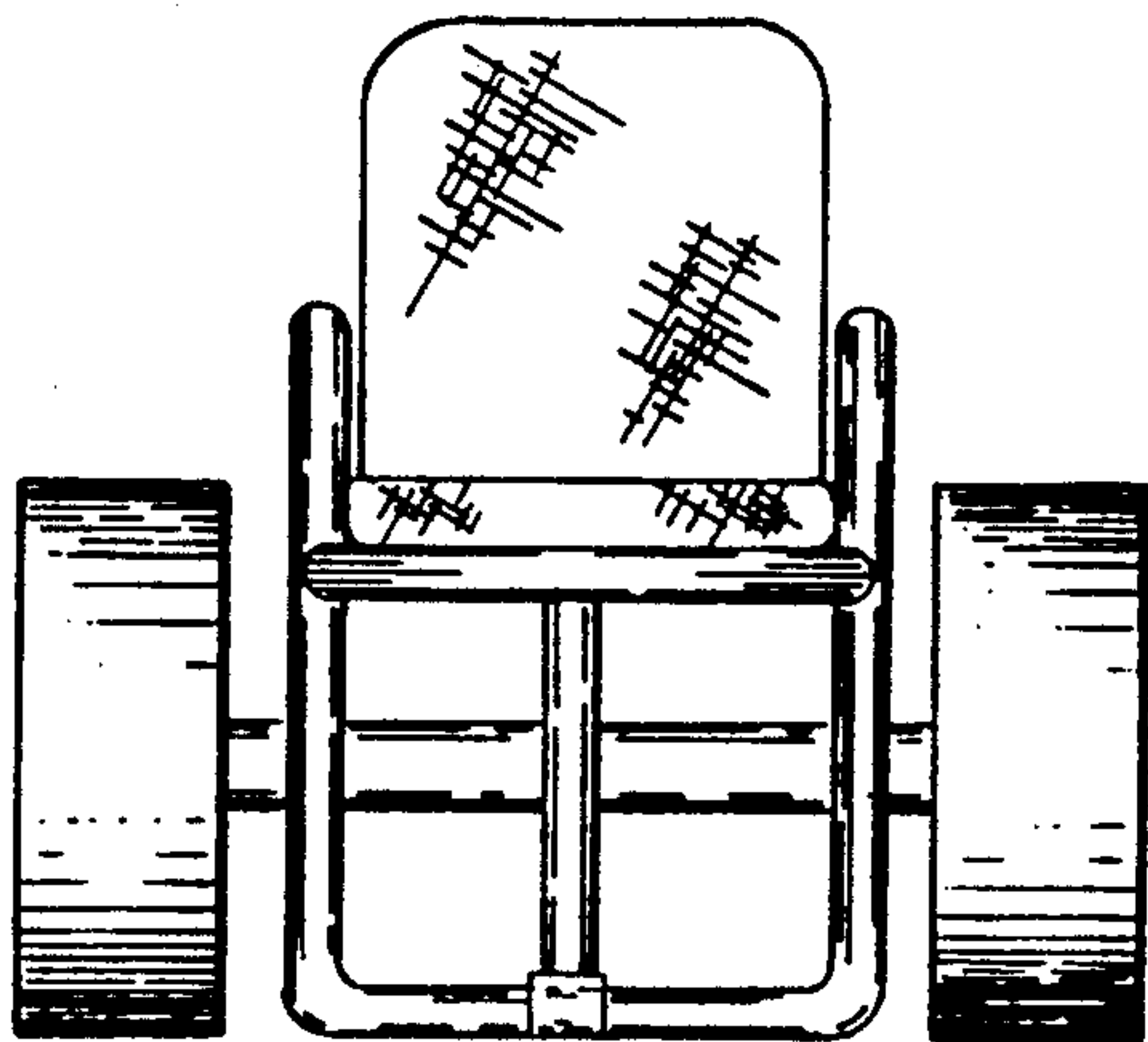

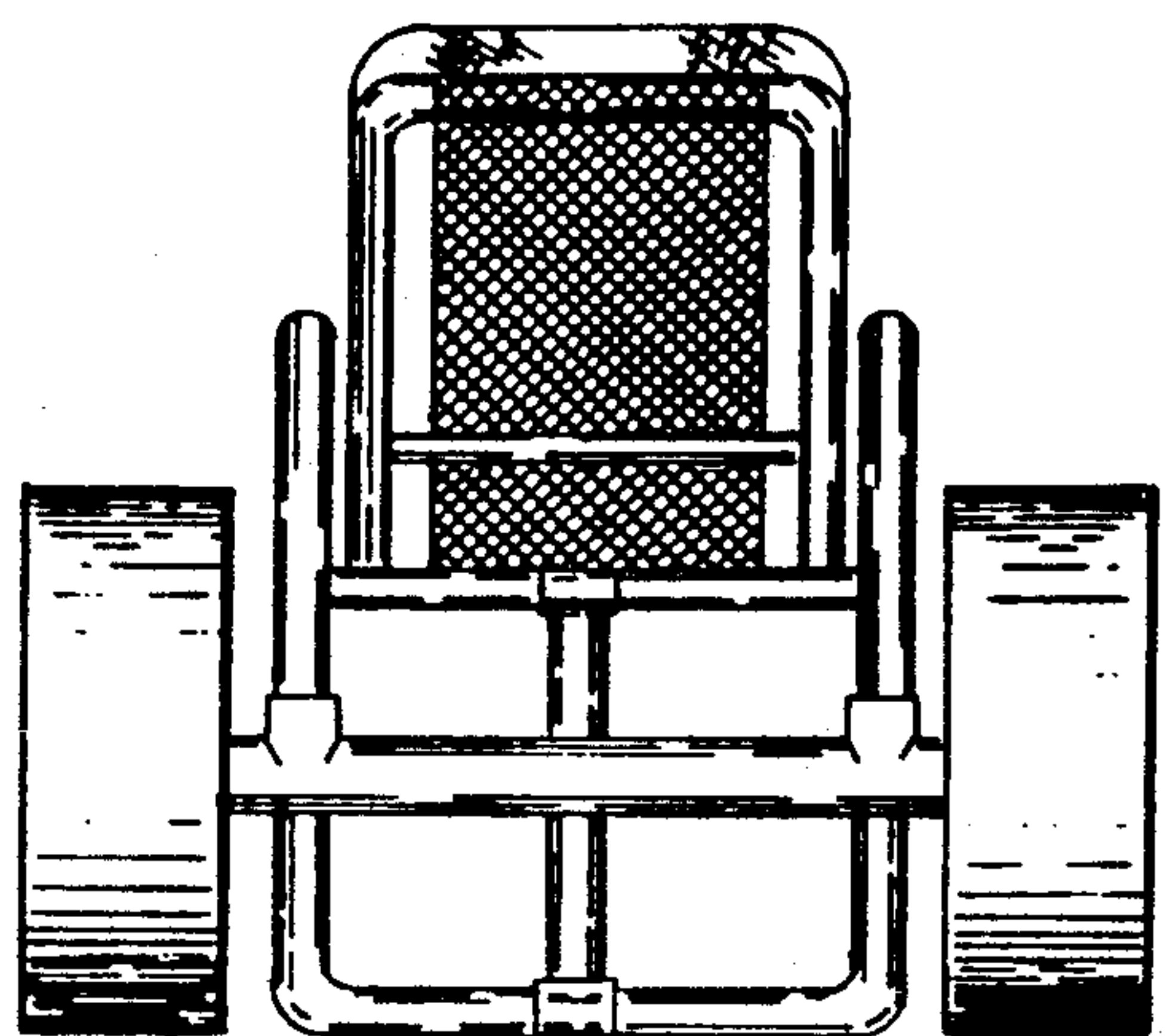

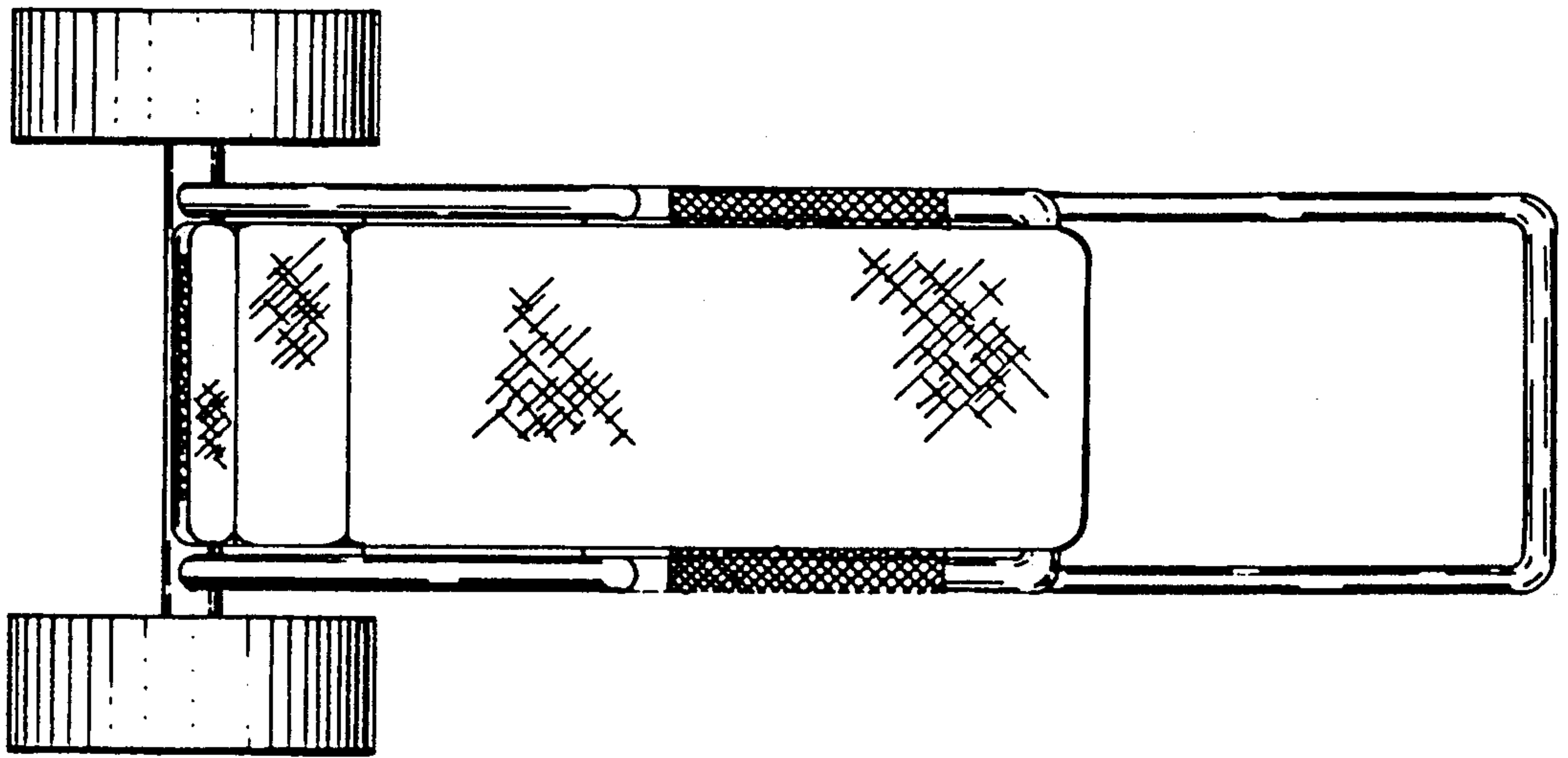

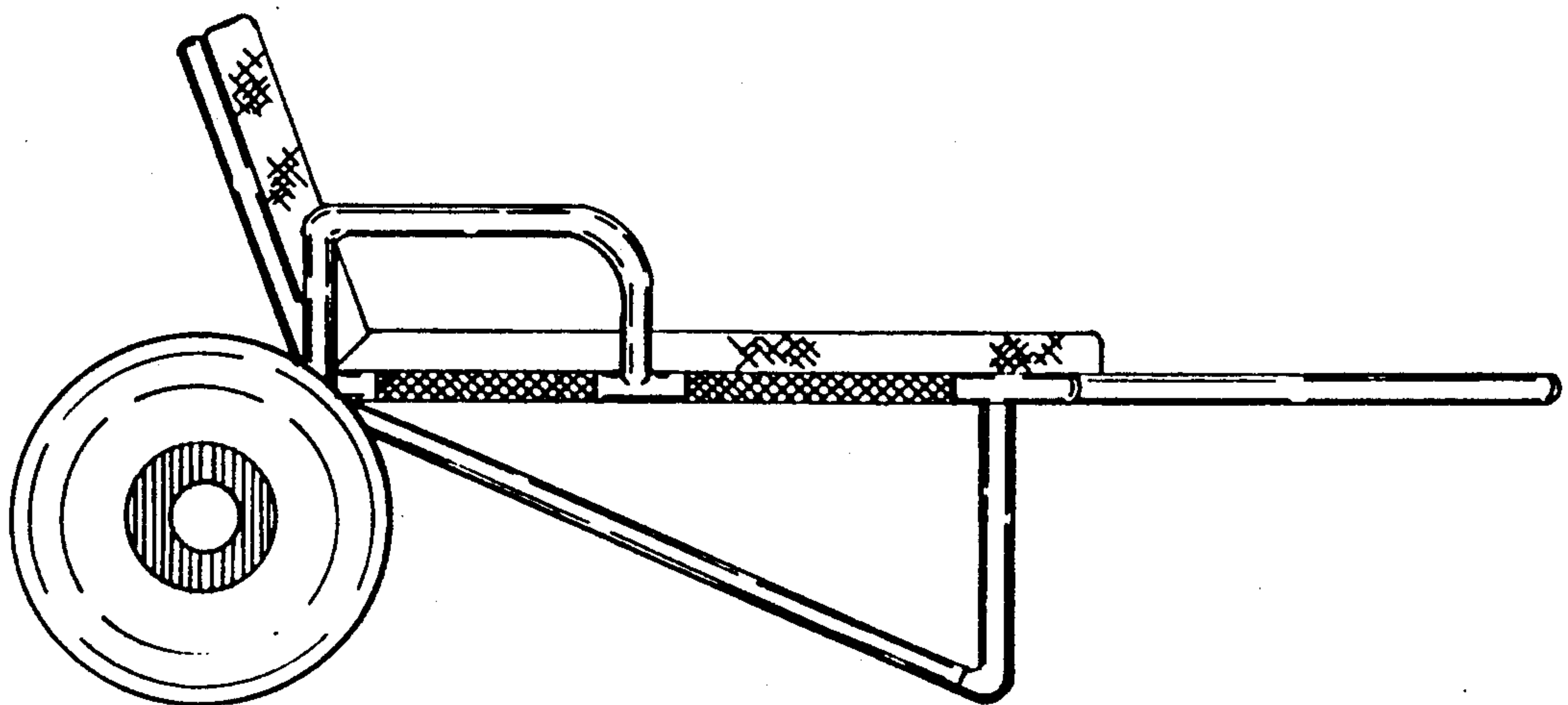
