FIG. 2 is a right-rear perspective view; and, FIG. 3 is a right-front perspective view thereof.

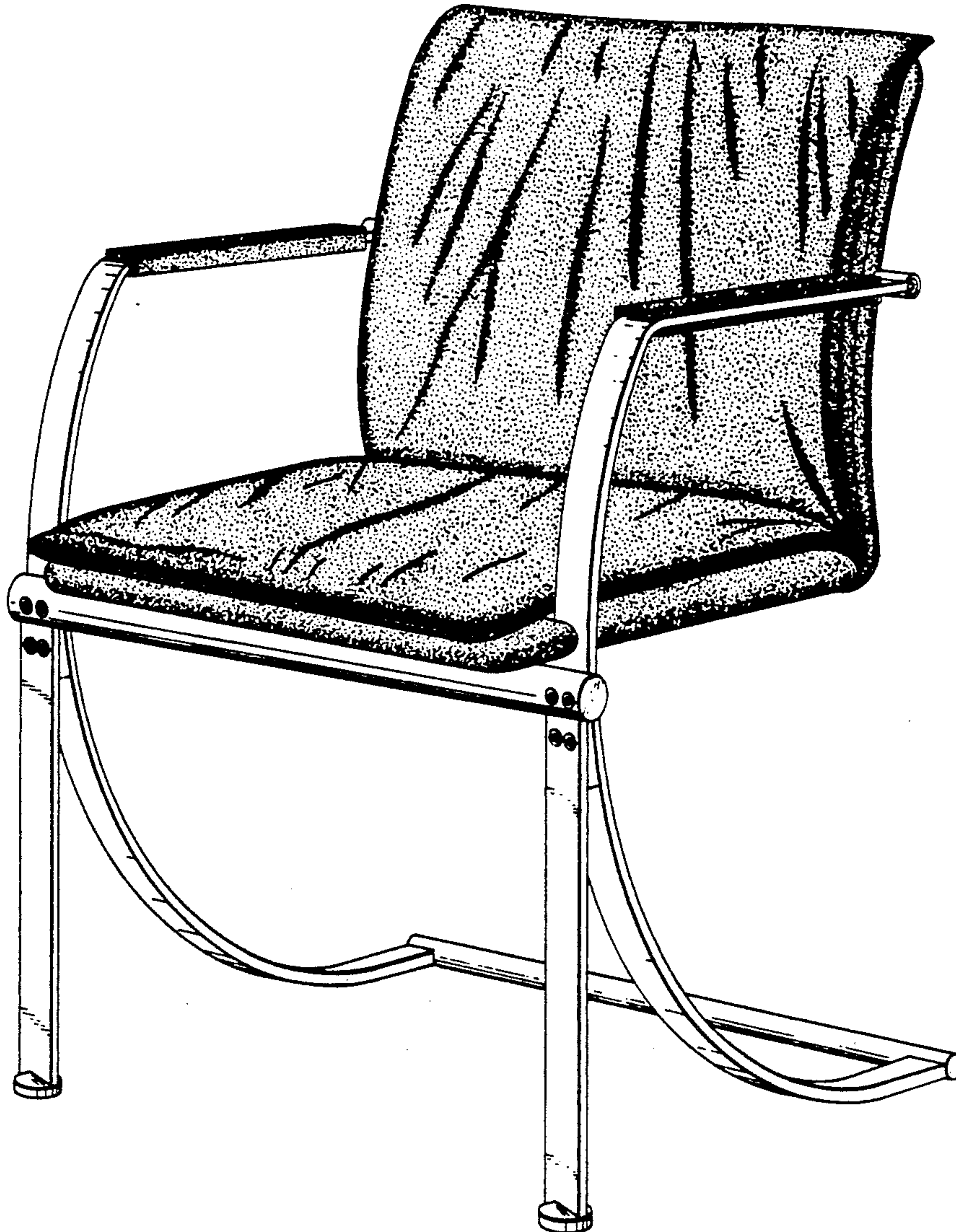

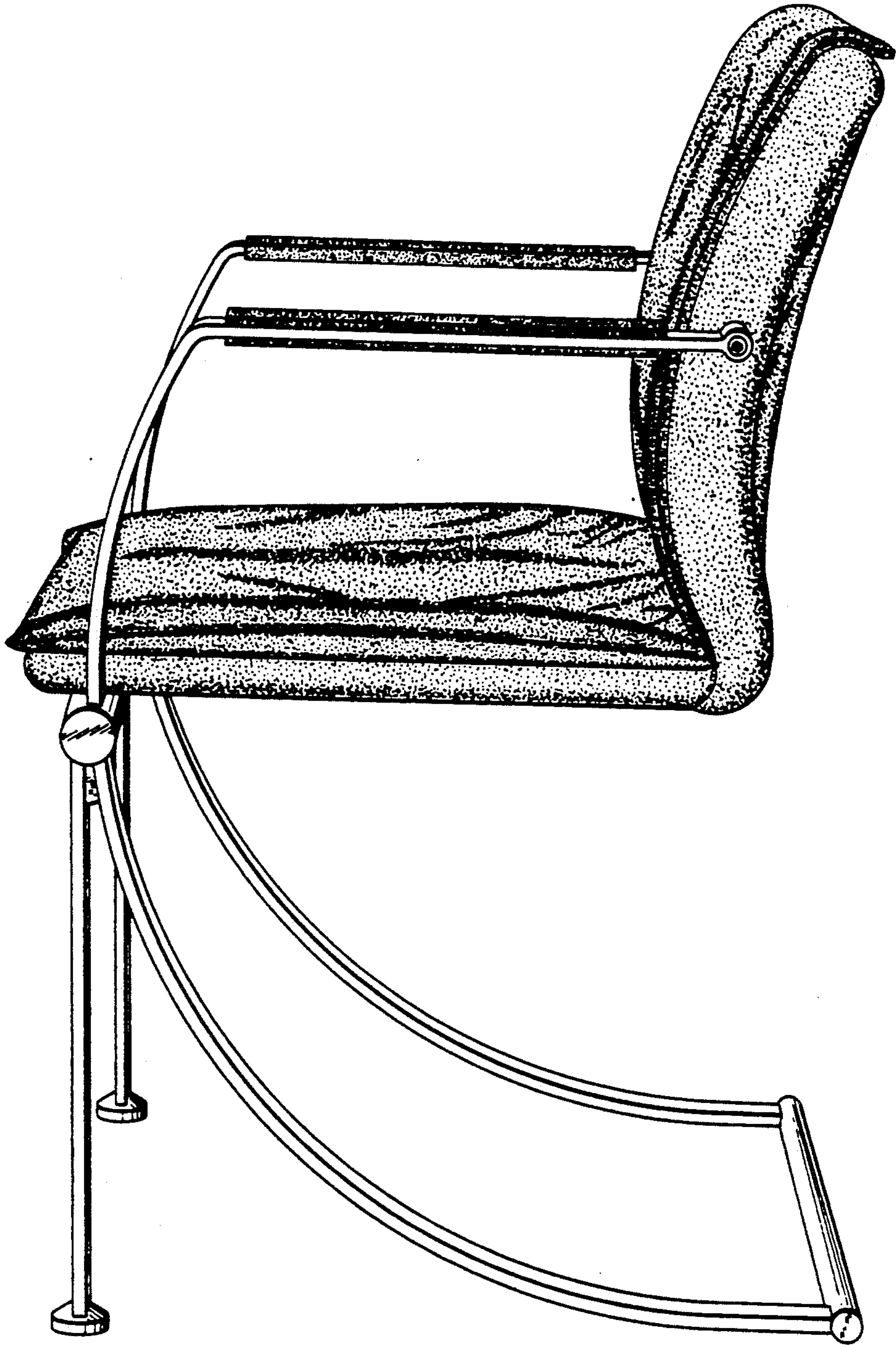

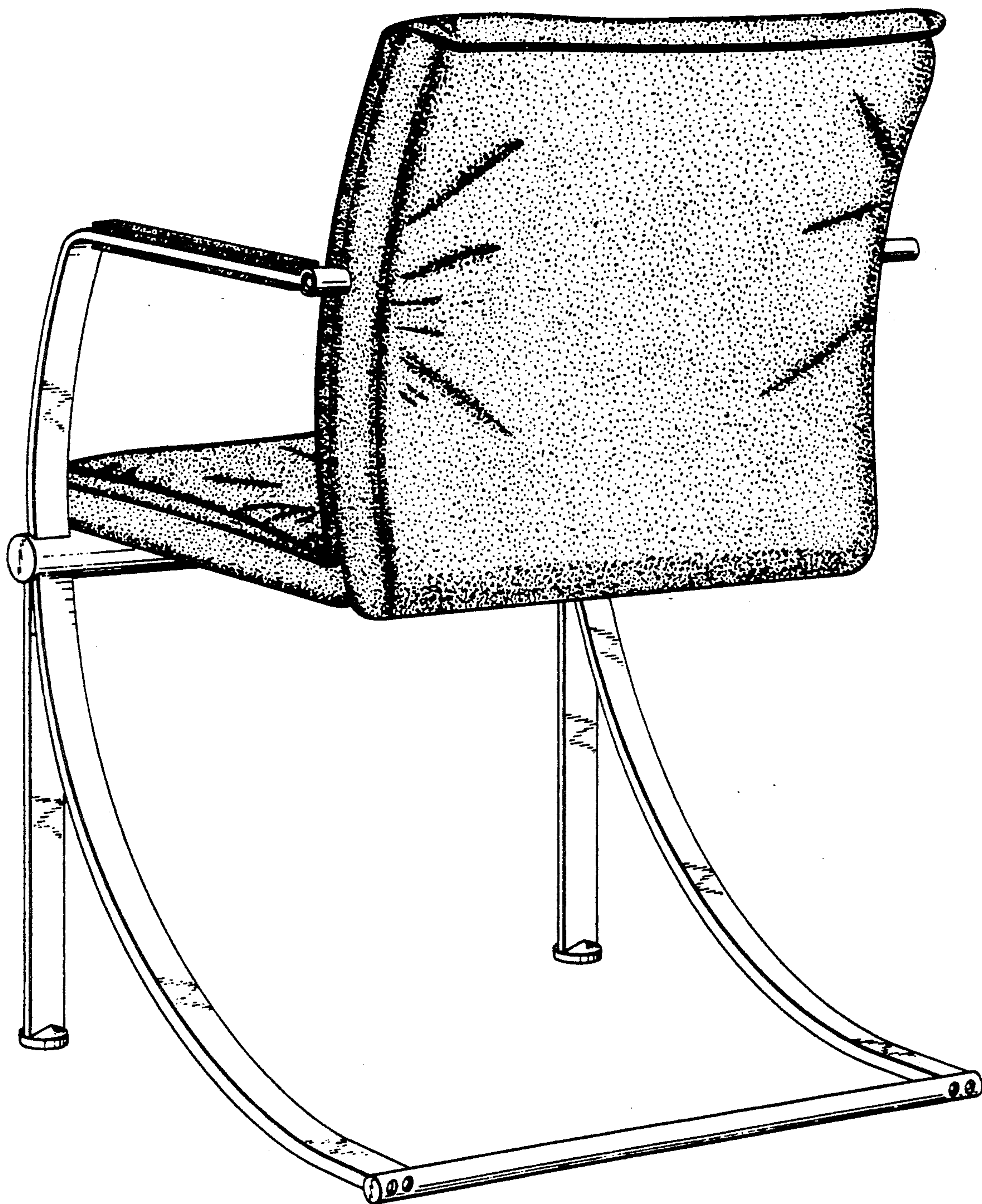
