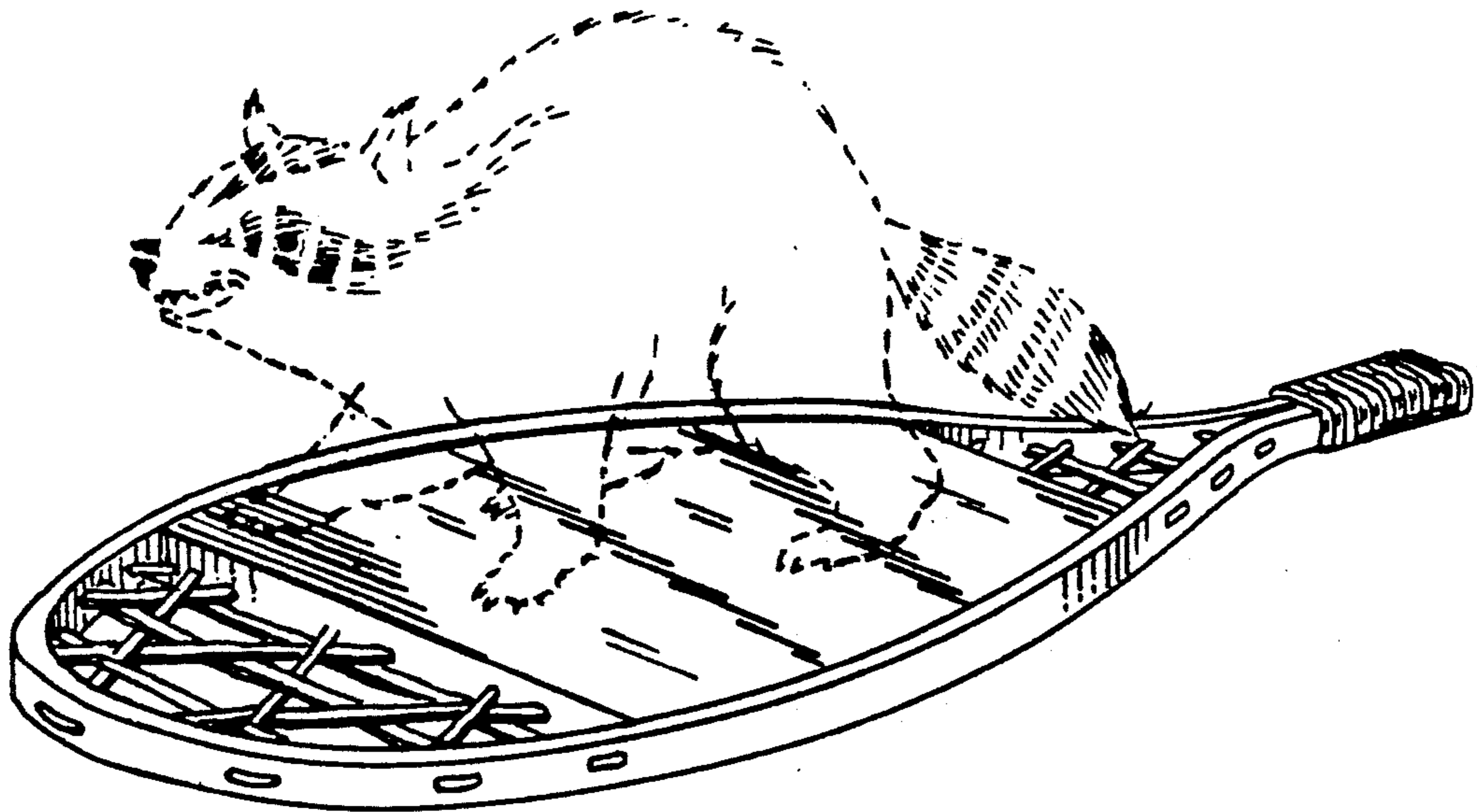
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image;

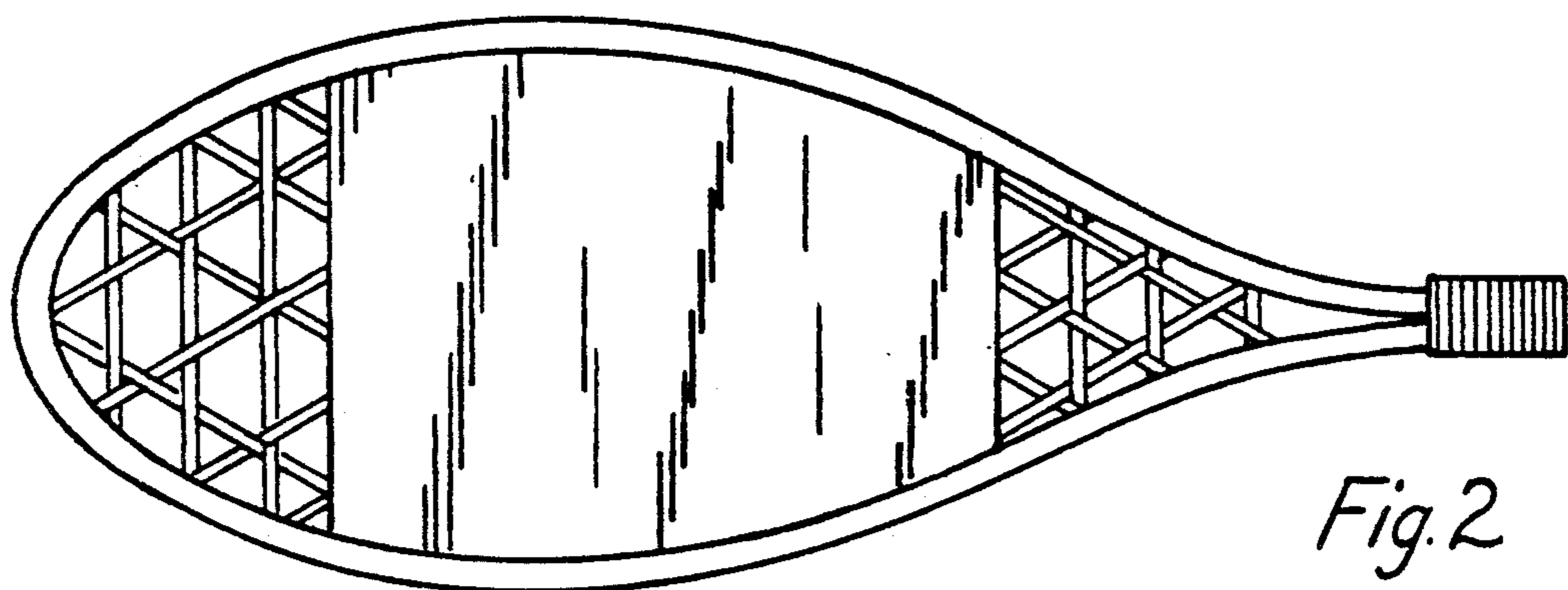
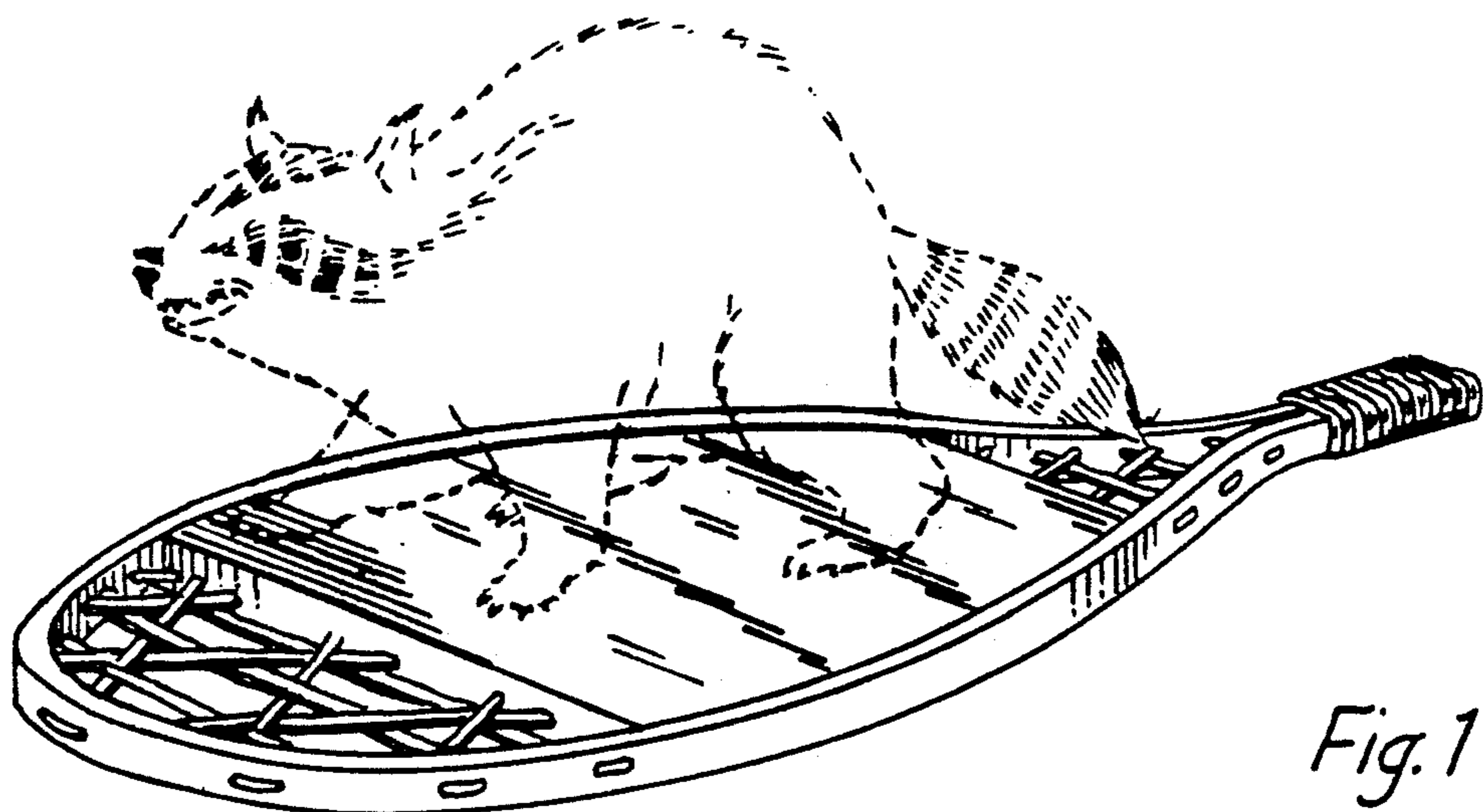
