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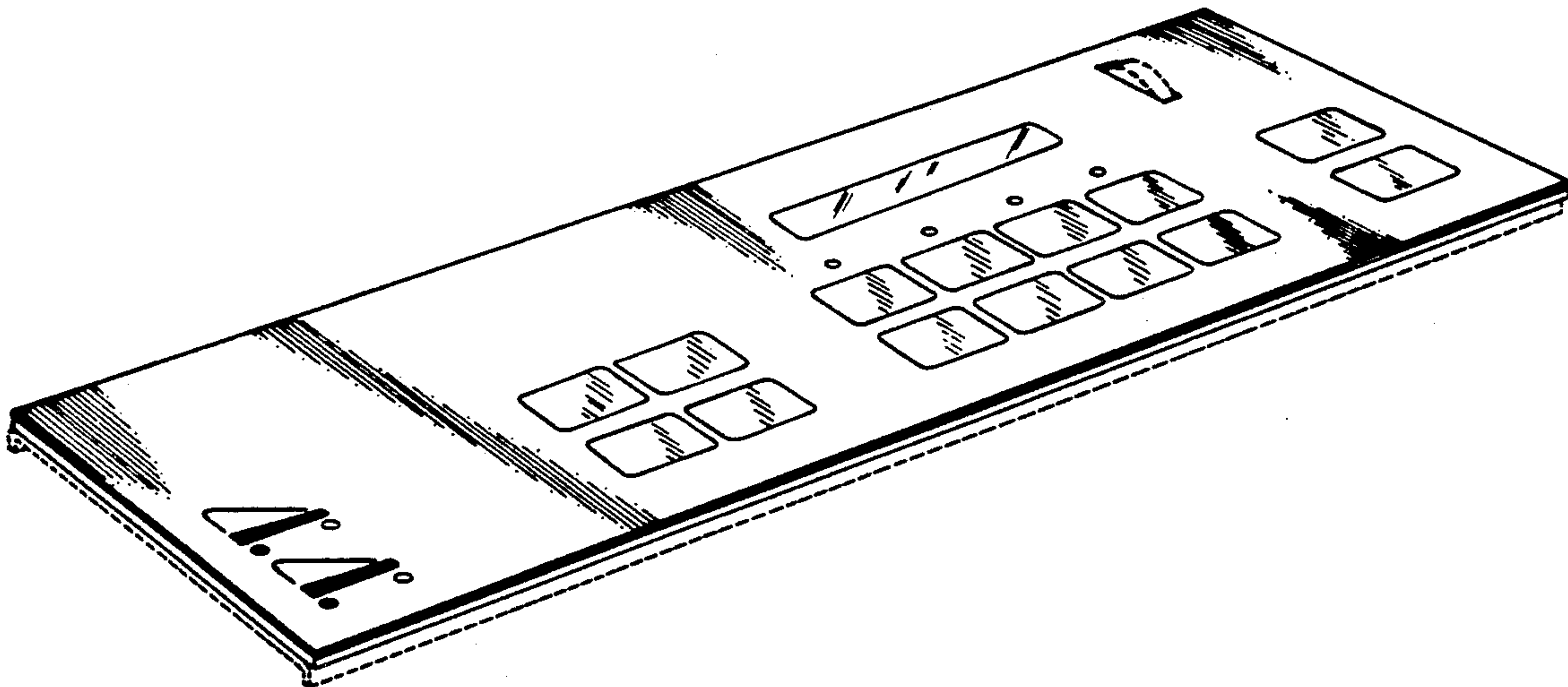

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left, front and top perspective view of a control panel for a microfilmer showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view; and,
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view.
The broken line showings of the underneath structure and wheel knob in FIGS. 1-6 are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.



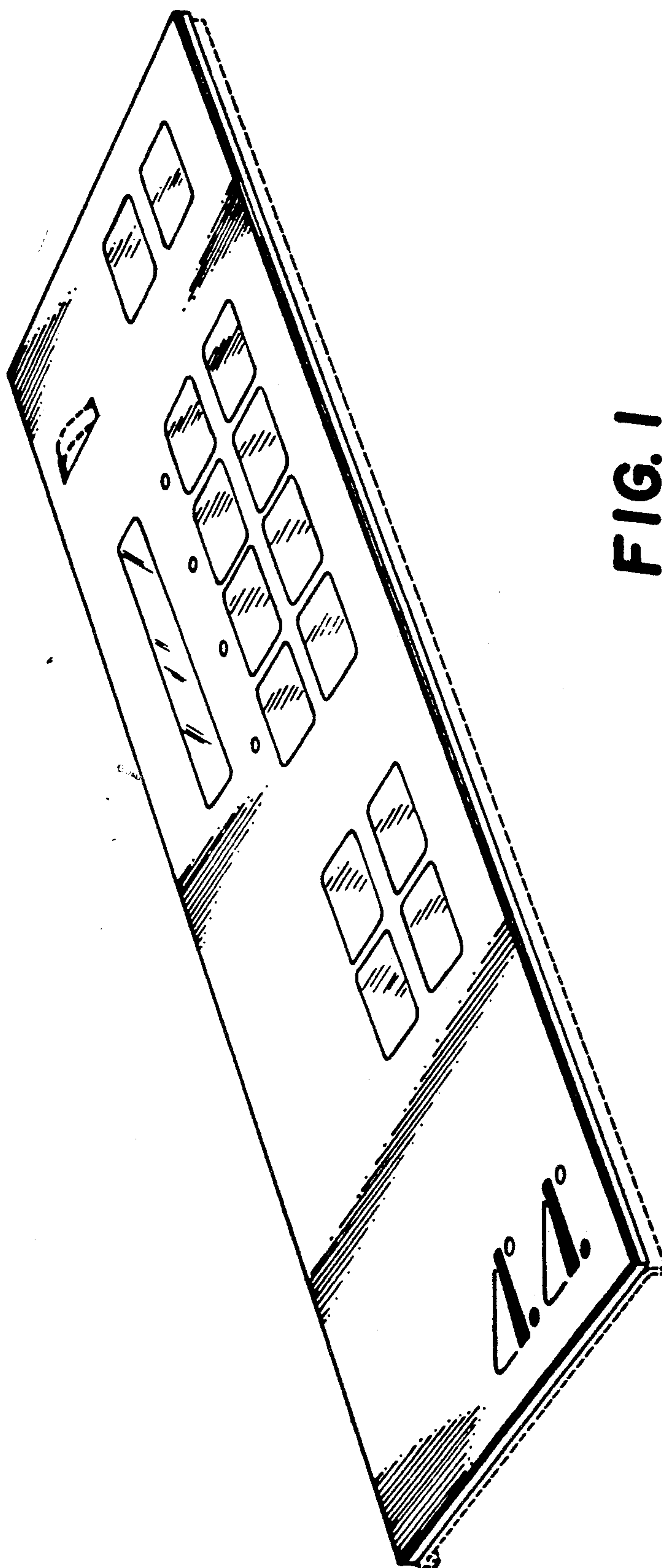

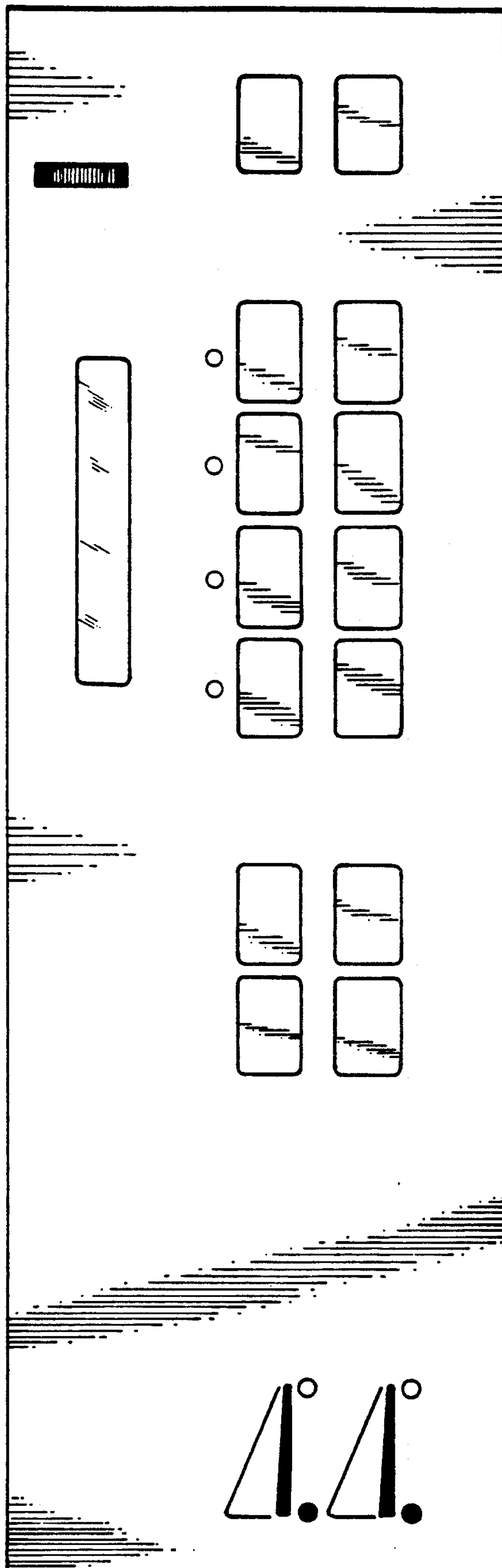

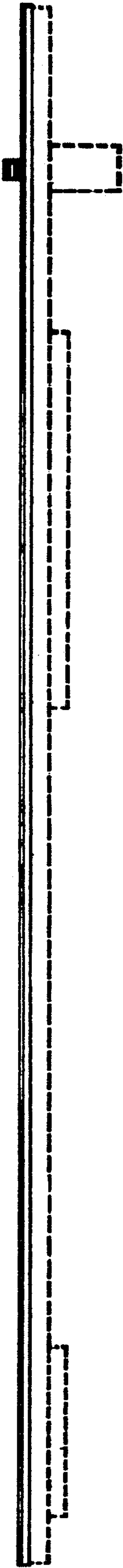

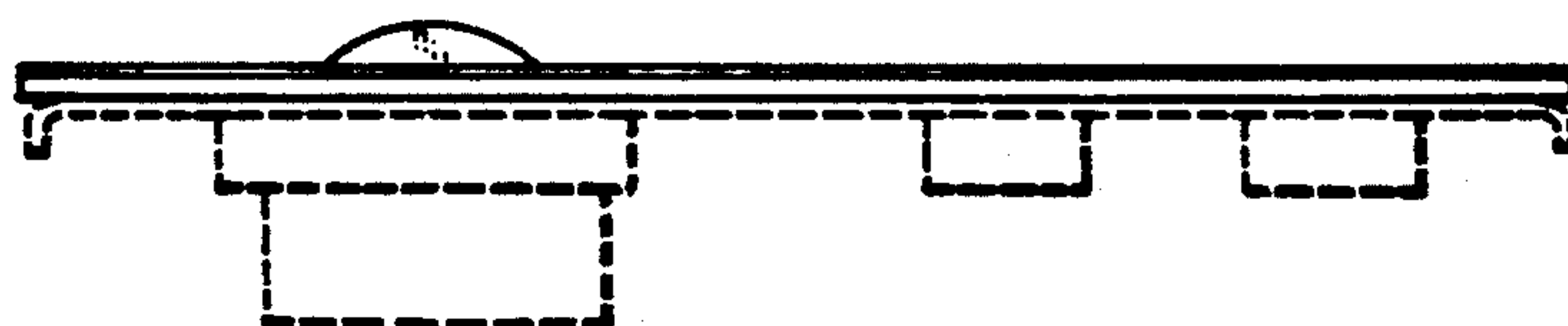

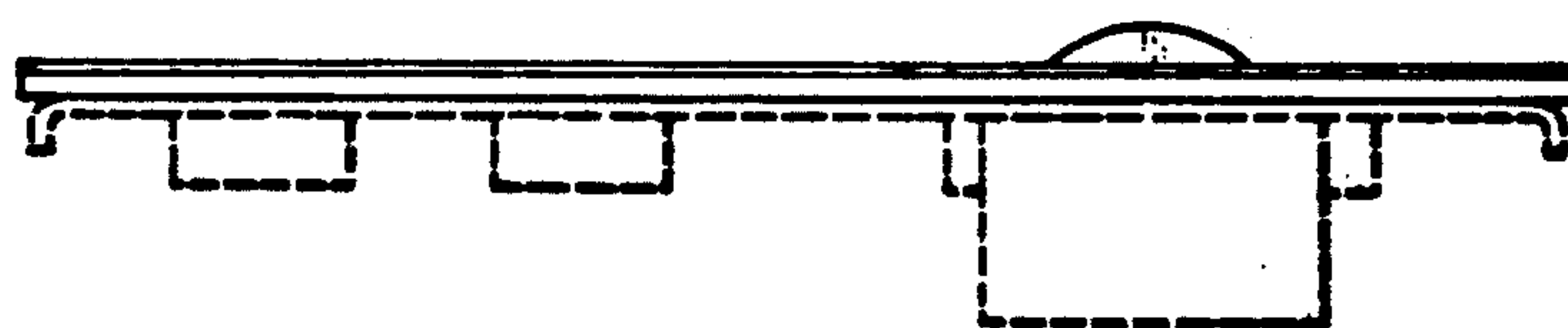
