FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined head and body protector for sparring showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

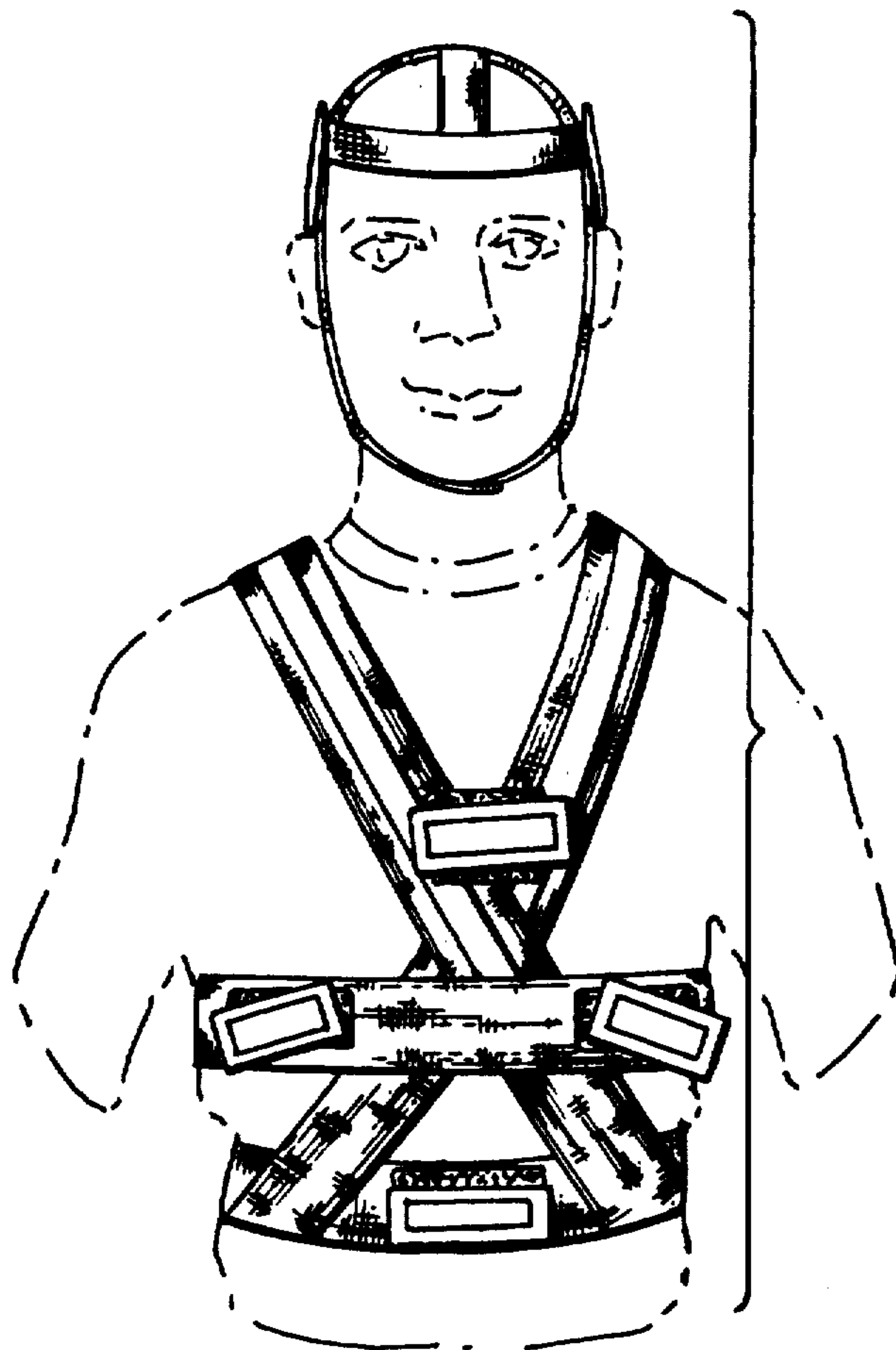
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; and,

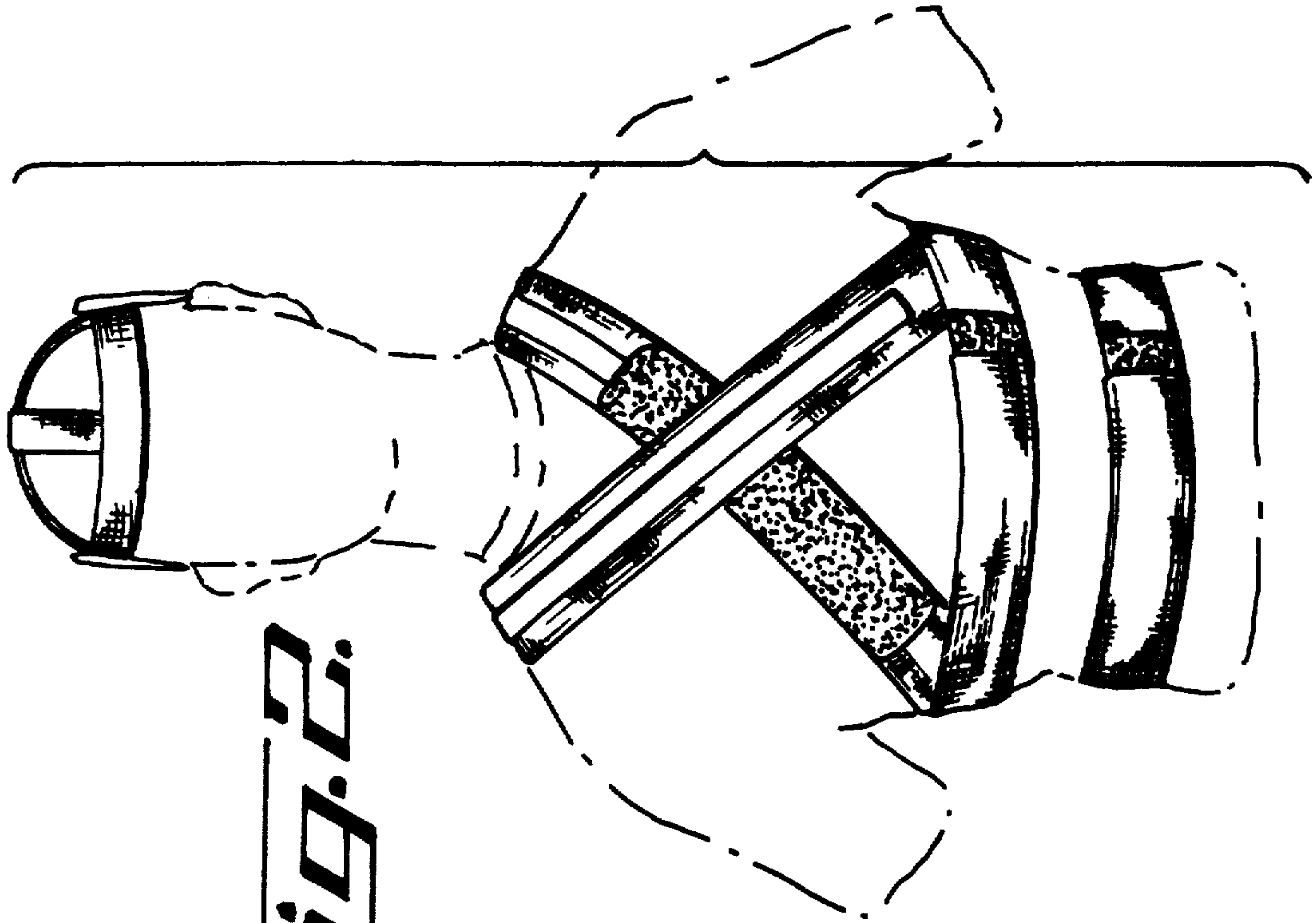

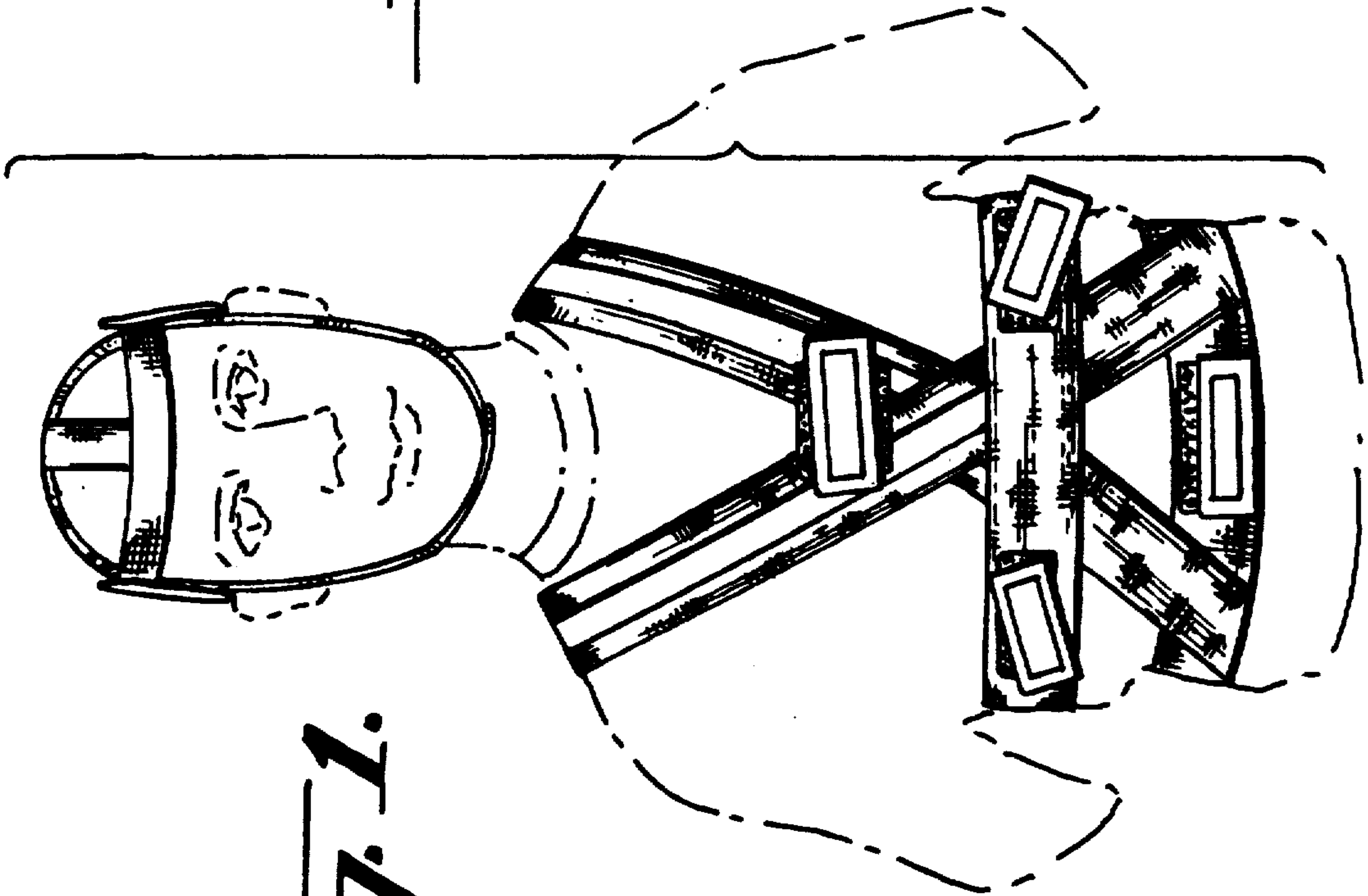

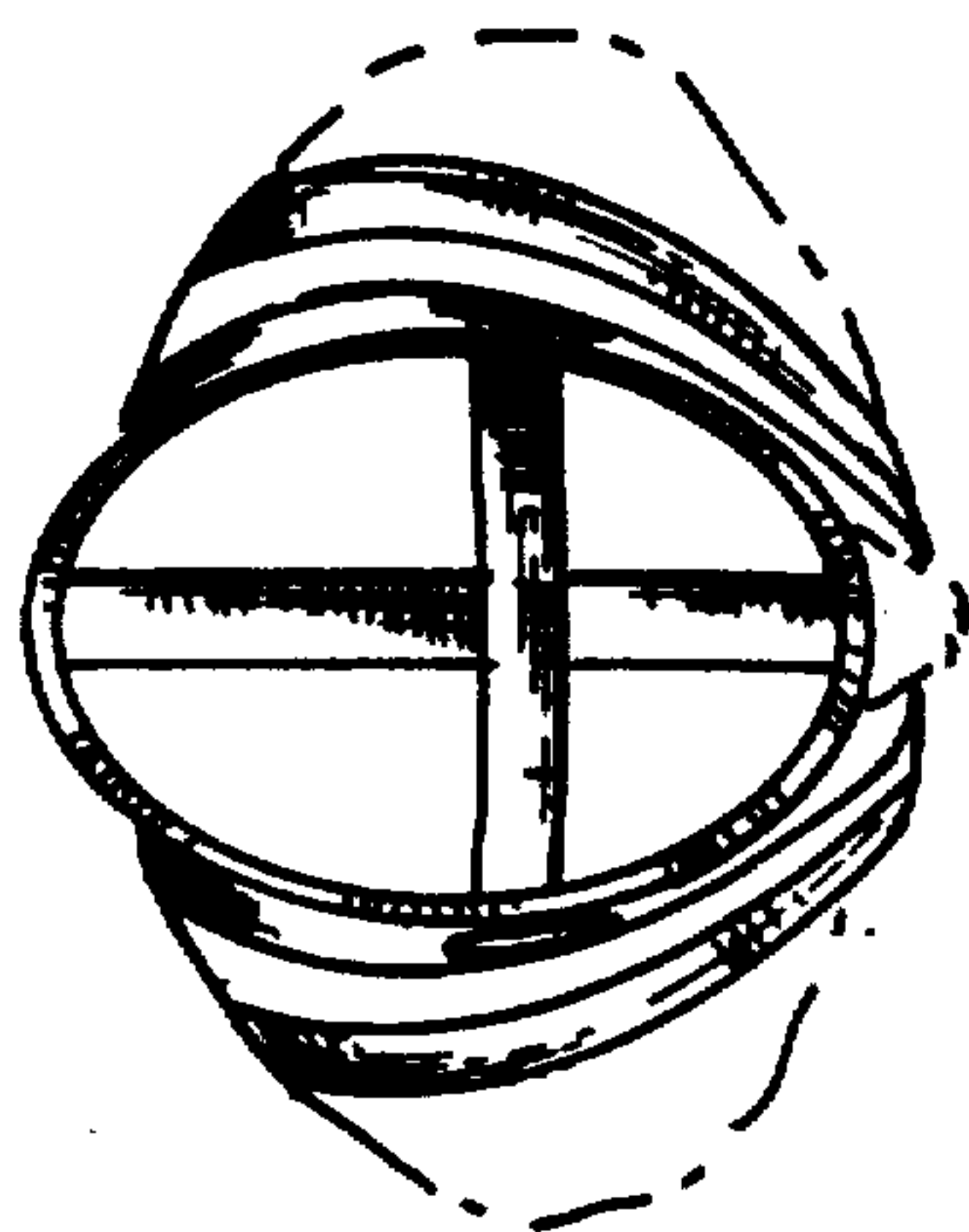

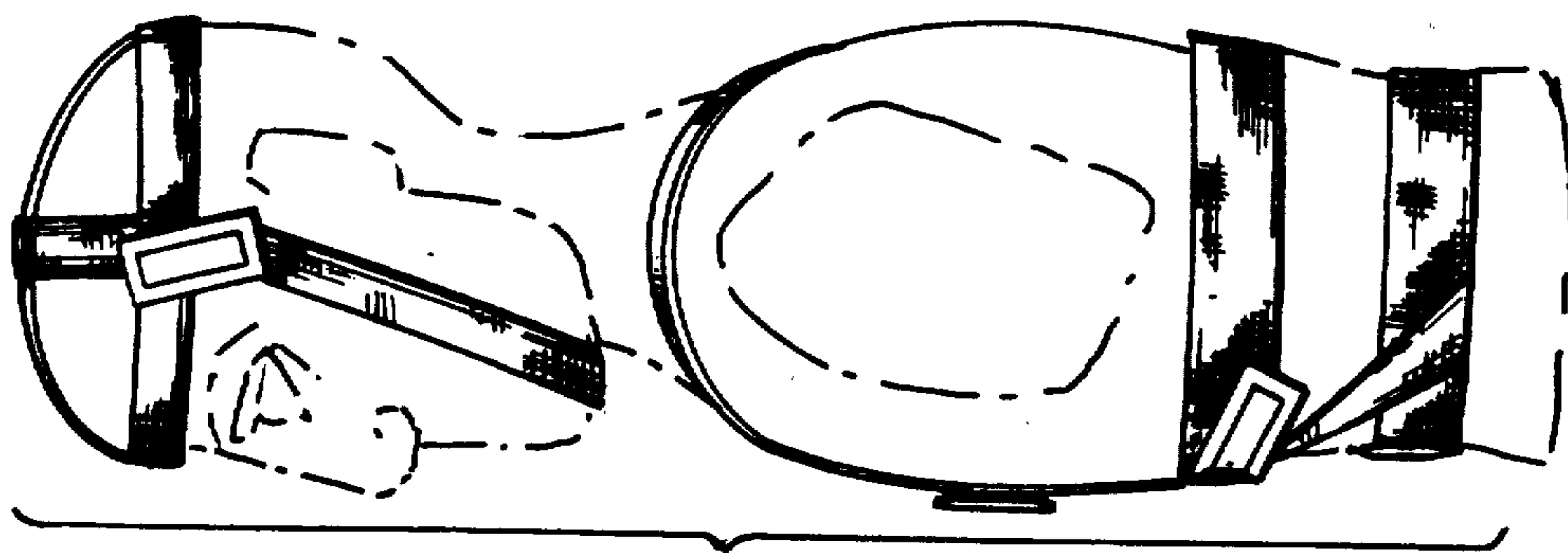

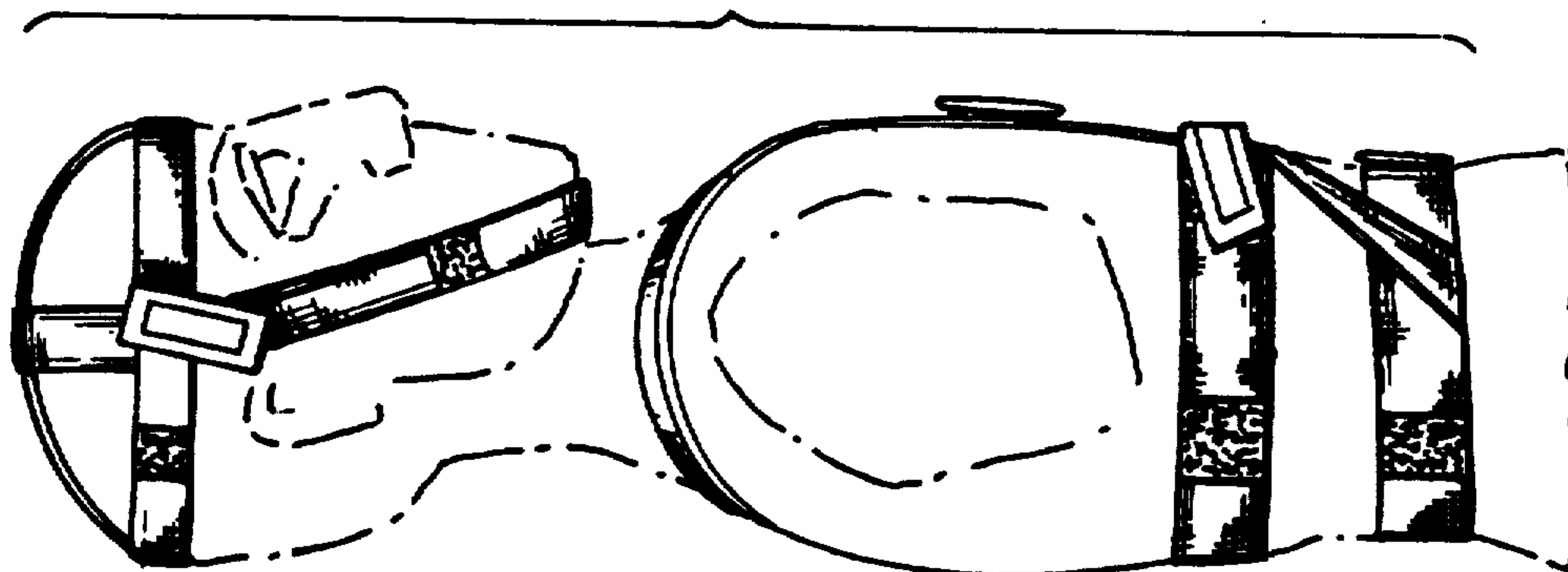
