FIGS. 1, 3 and 4 are shaded to indicate color contrast.

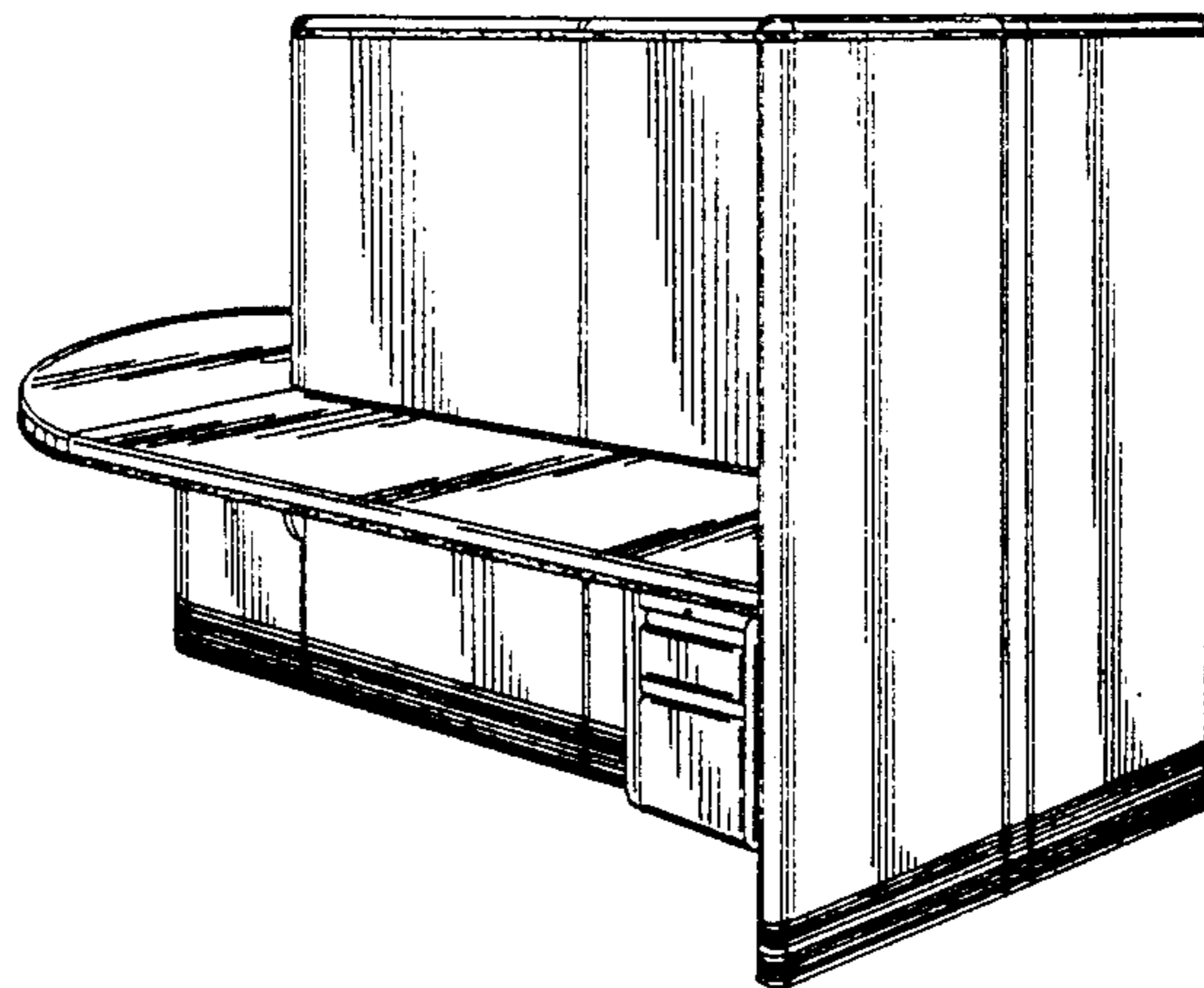
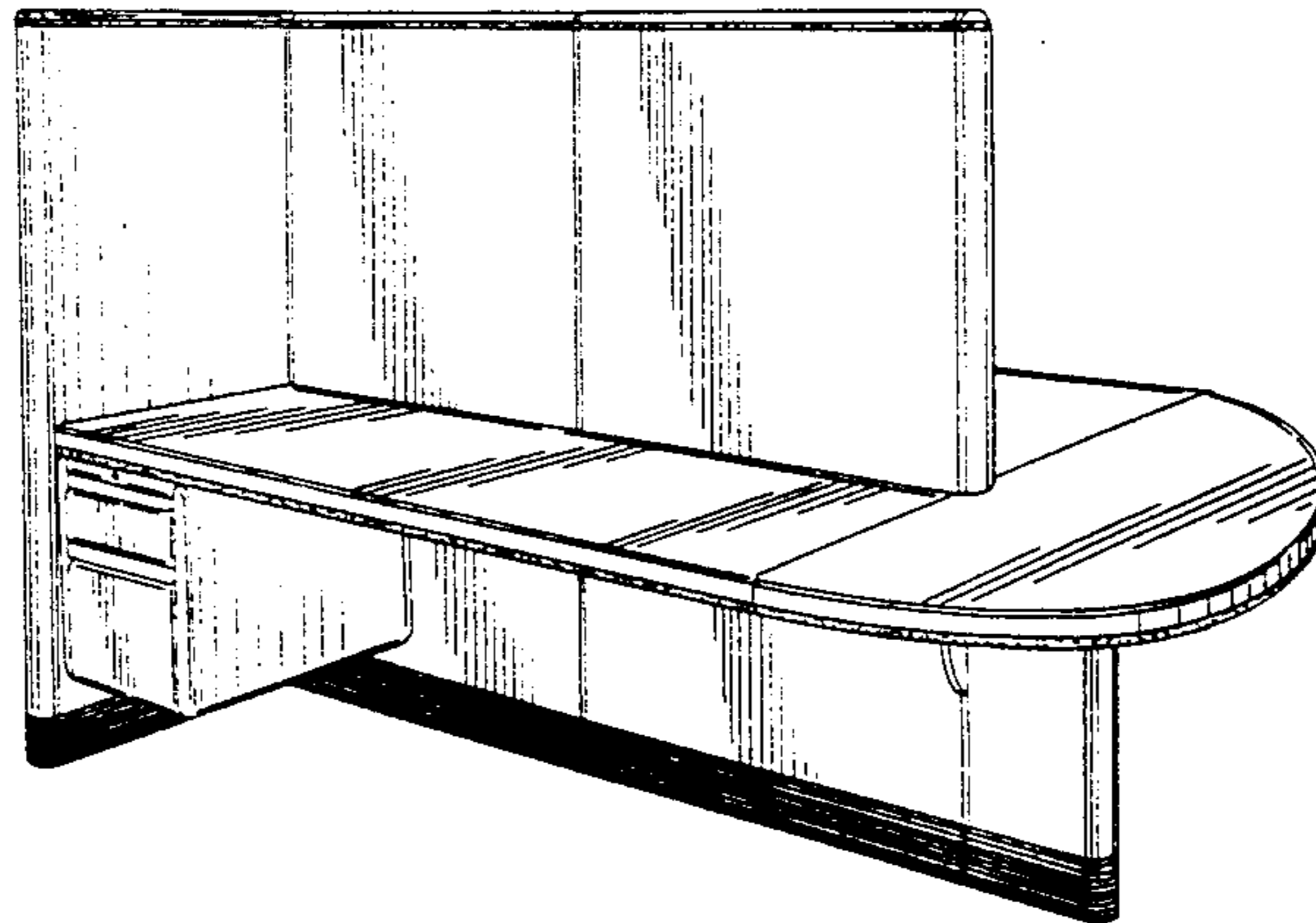

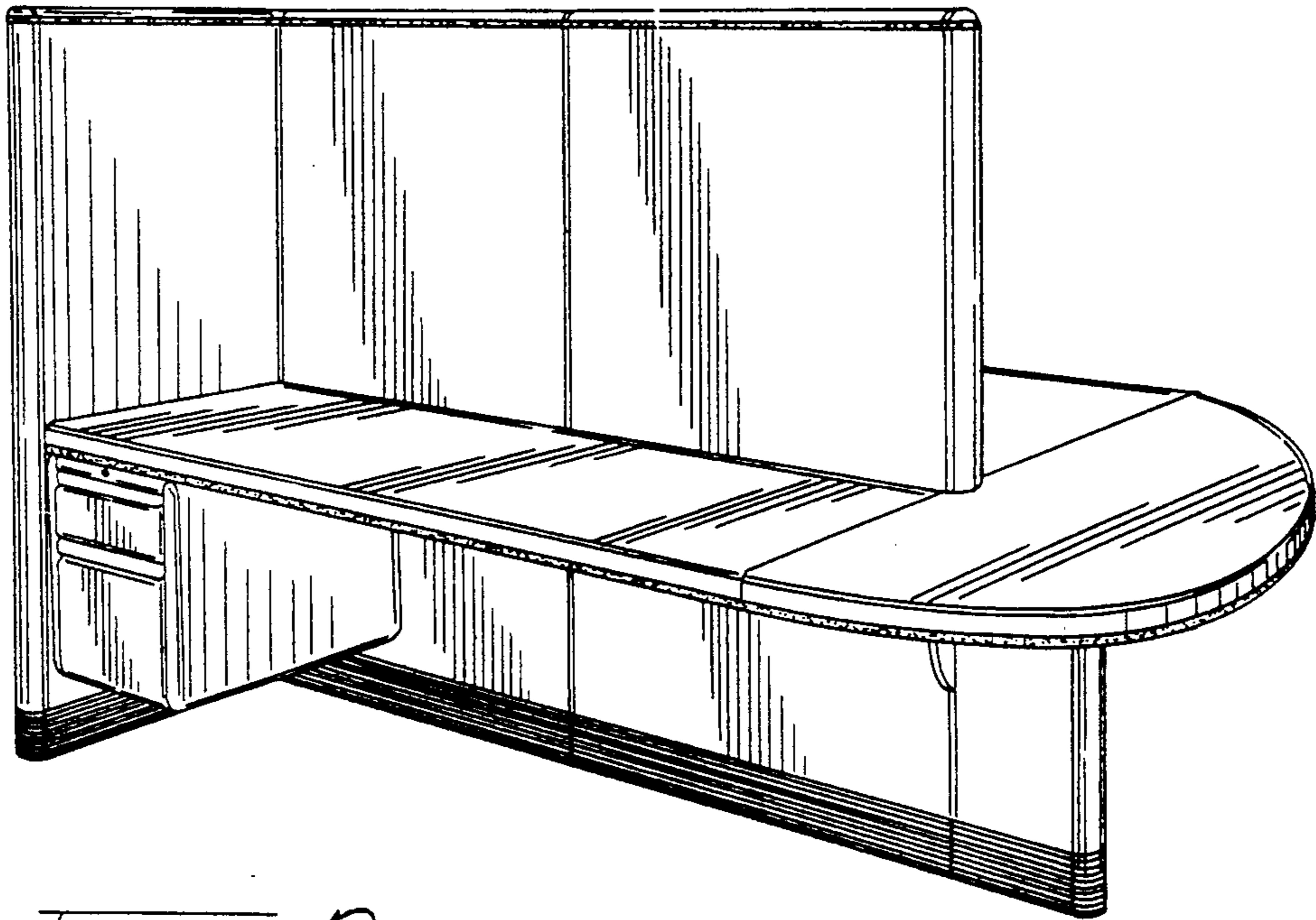

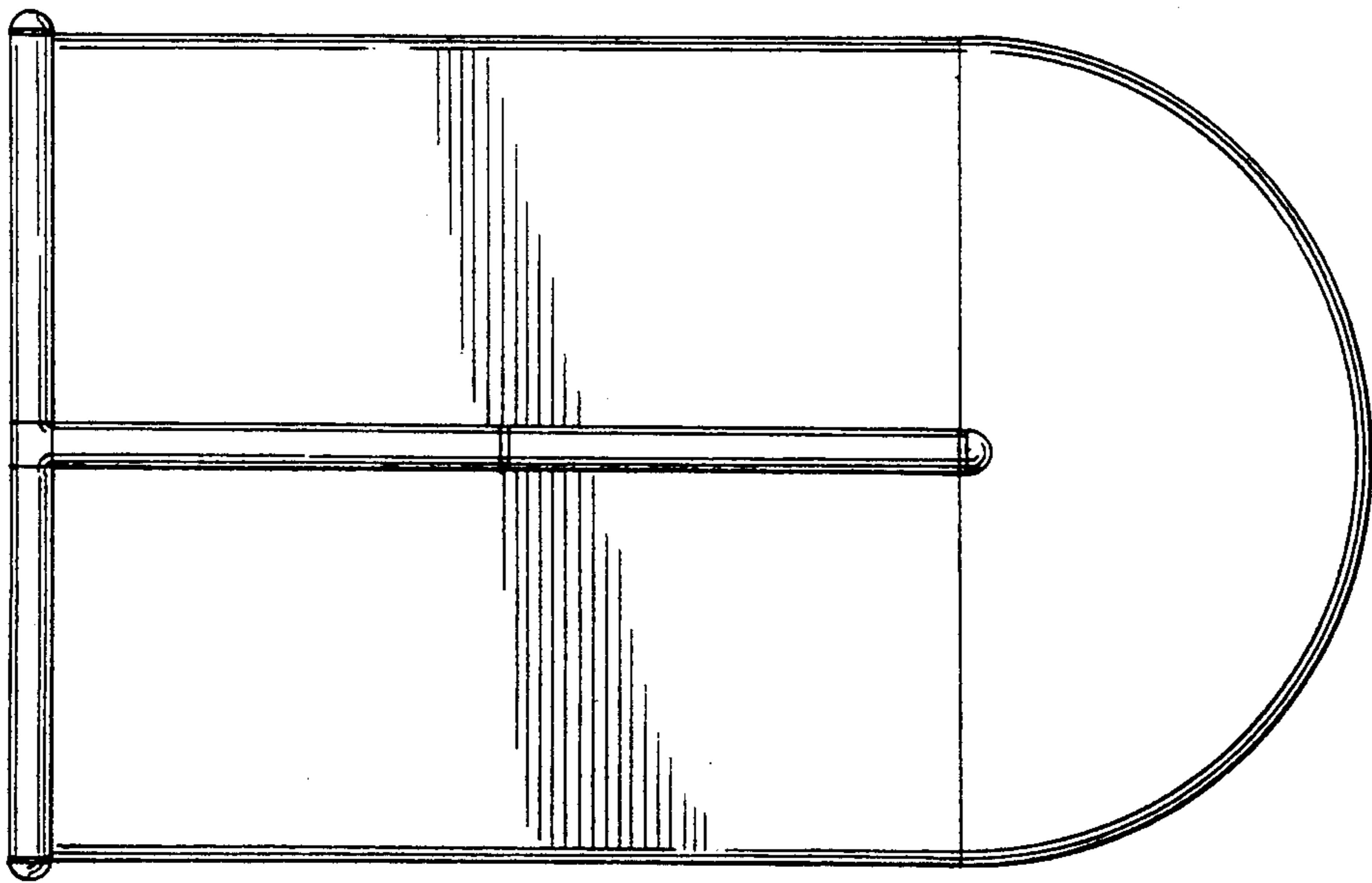

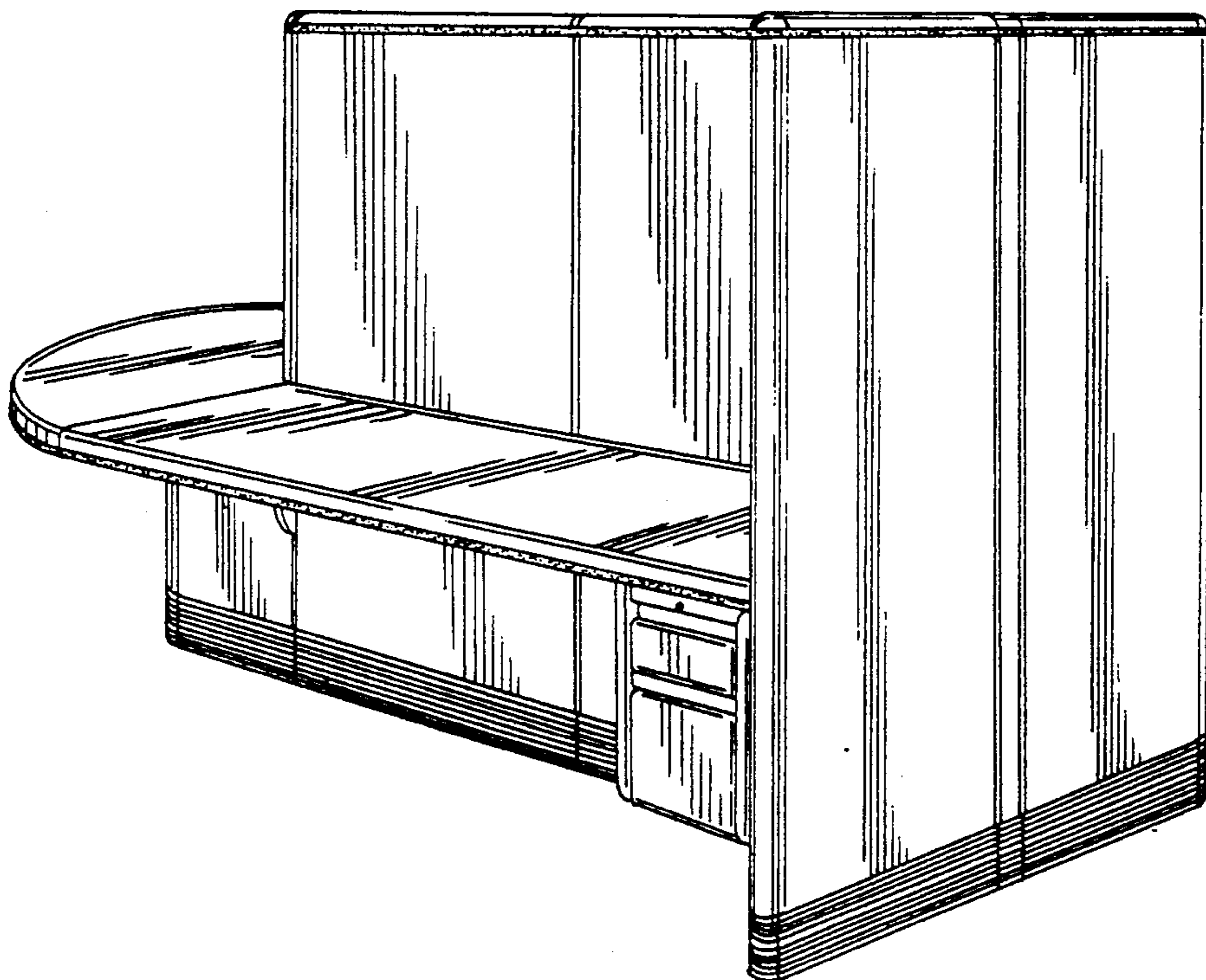
