DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined disposable bag and disinfectant container for sterilizing infectious waste showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

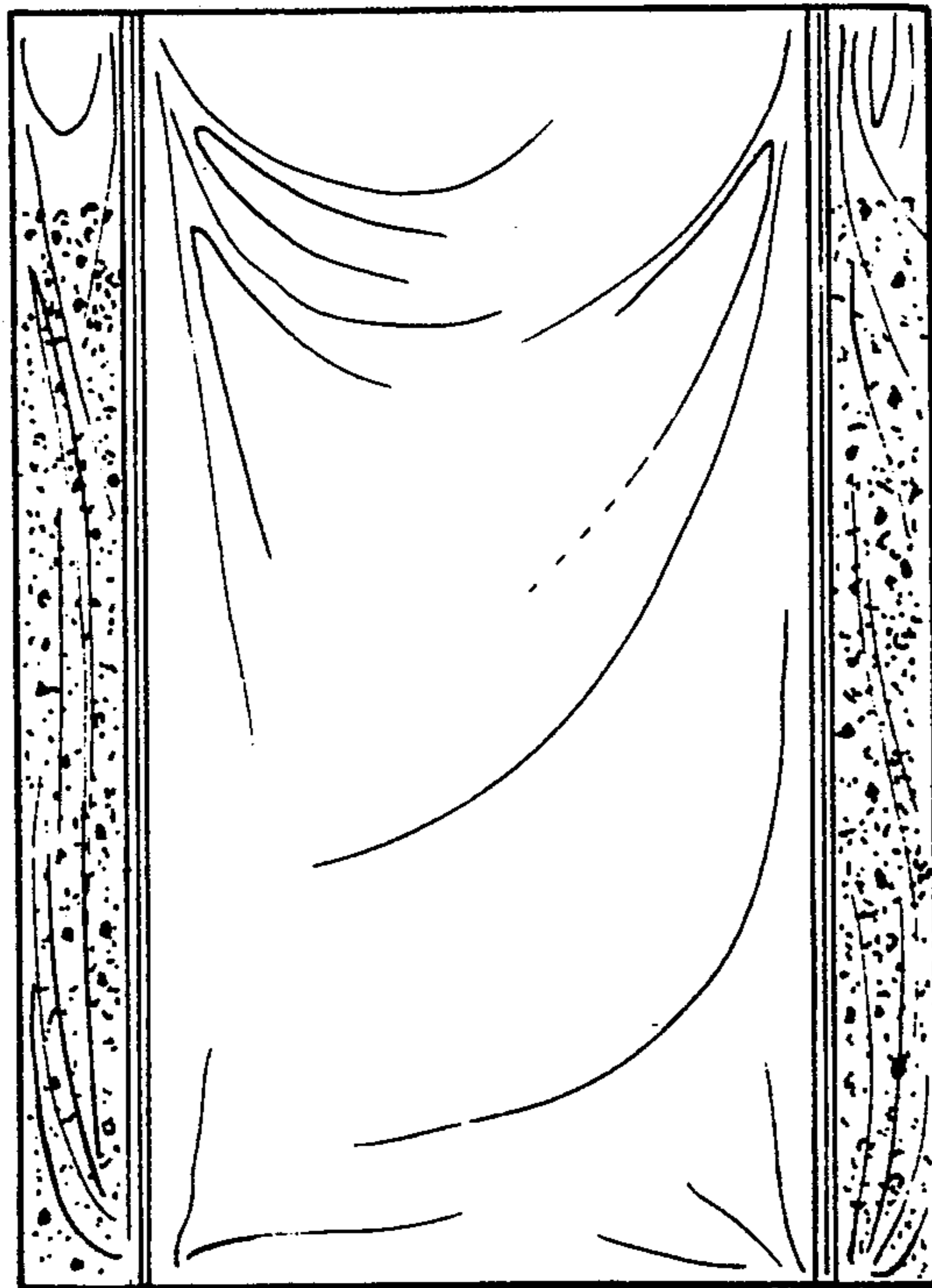

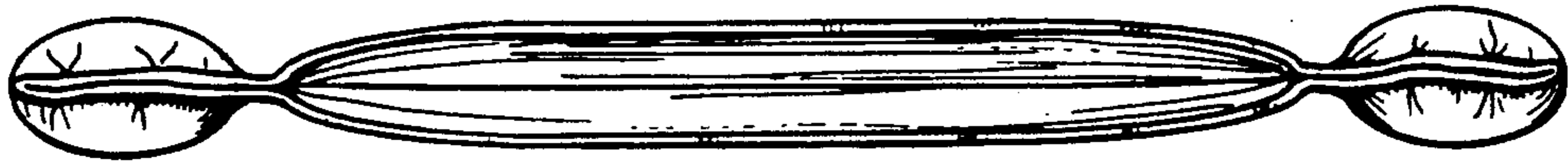

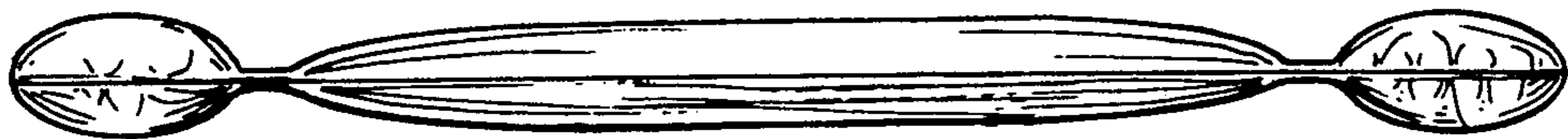
