DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the sunglasses showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

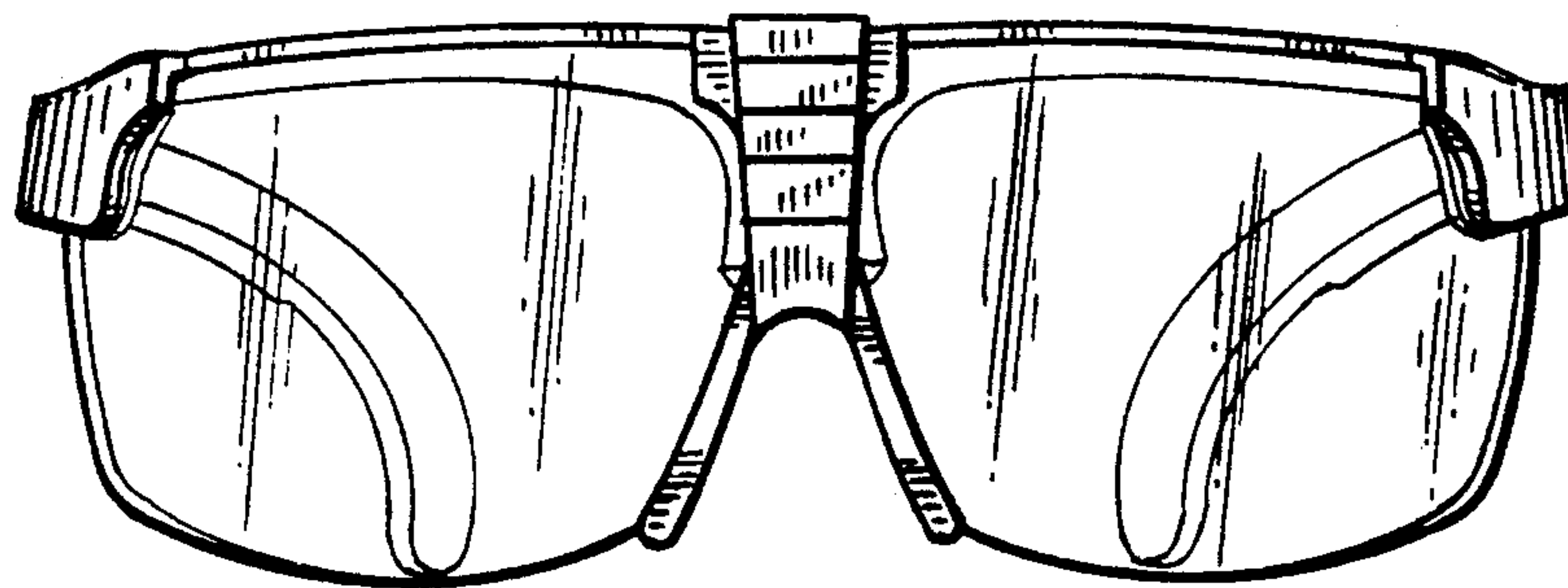

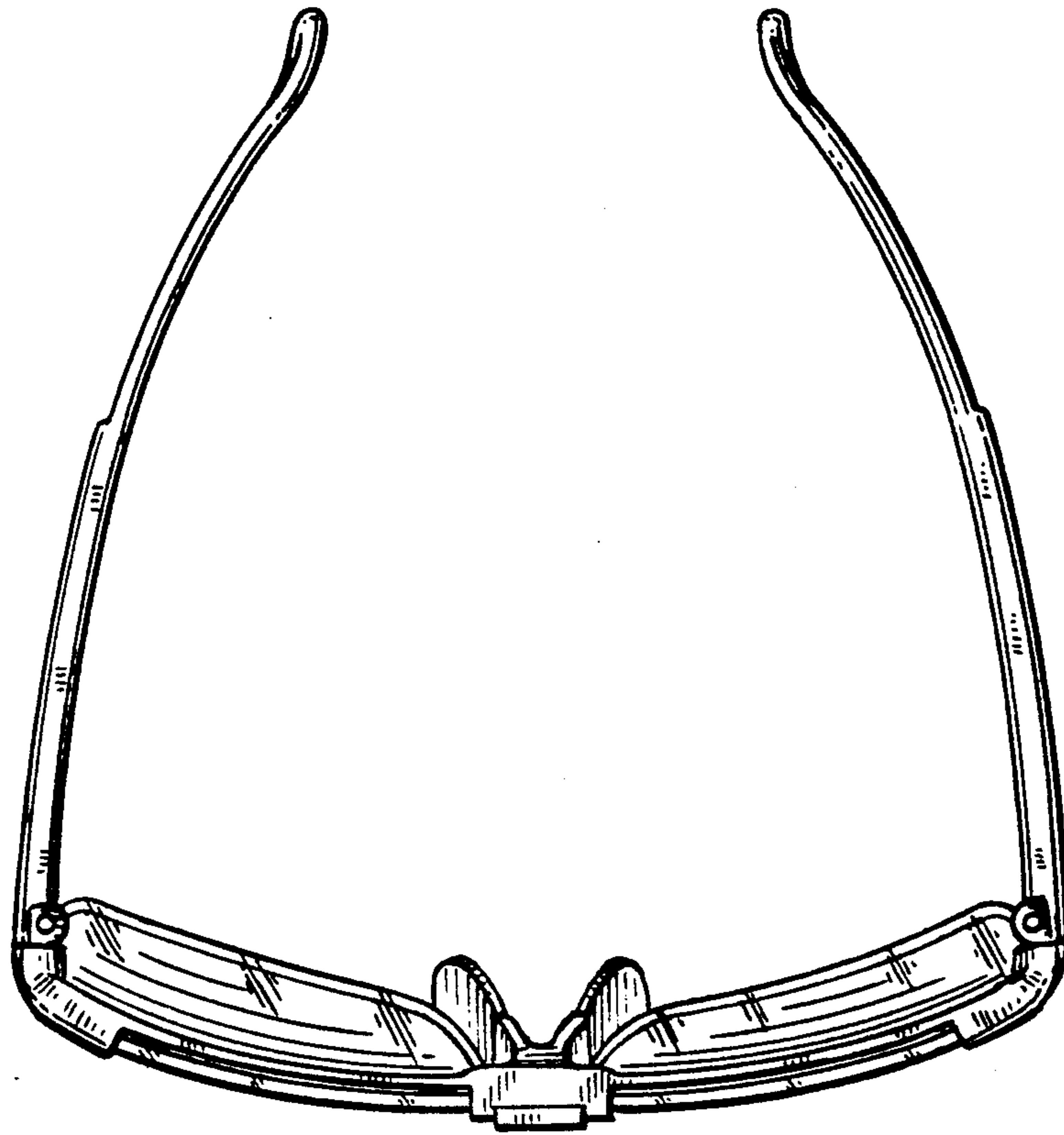

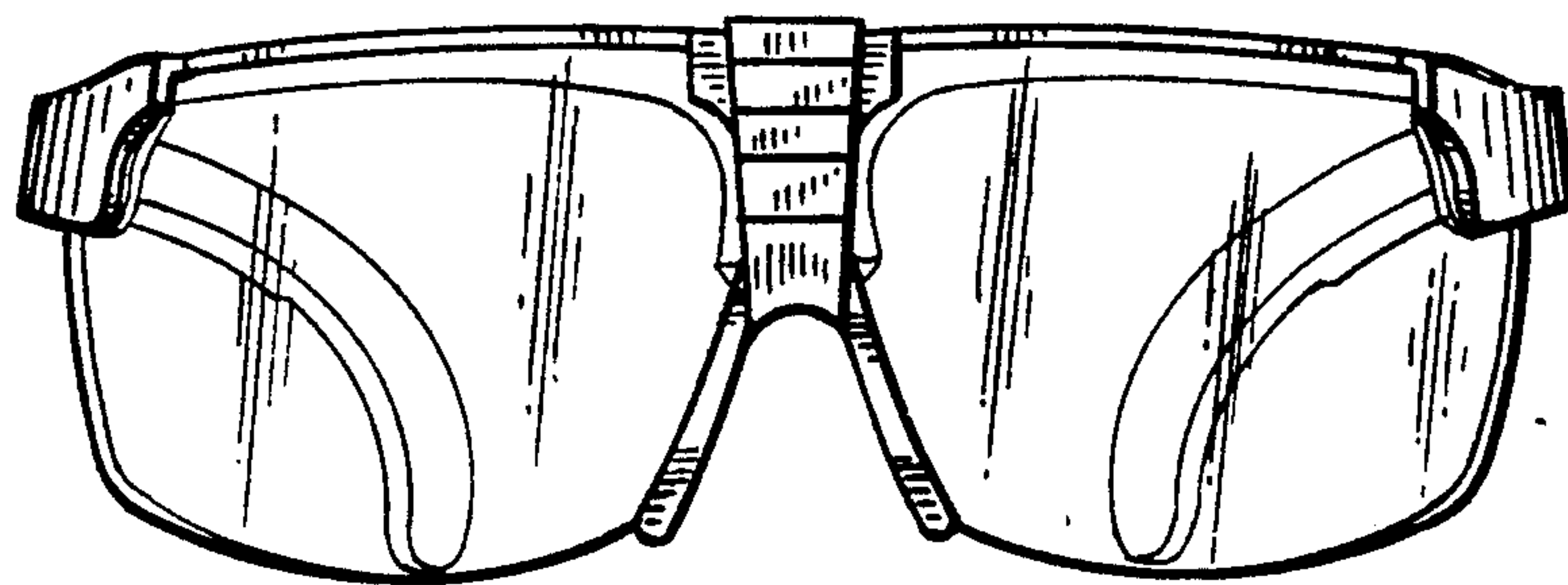

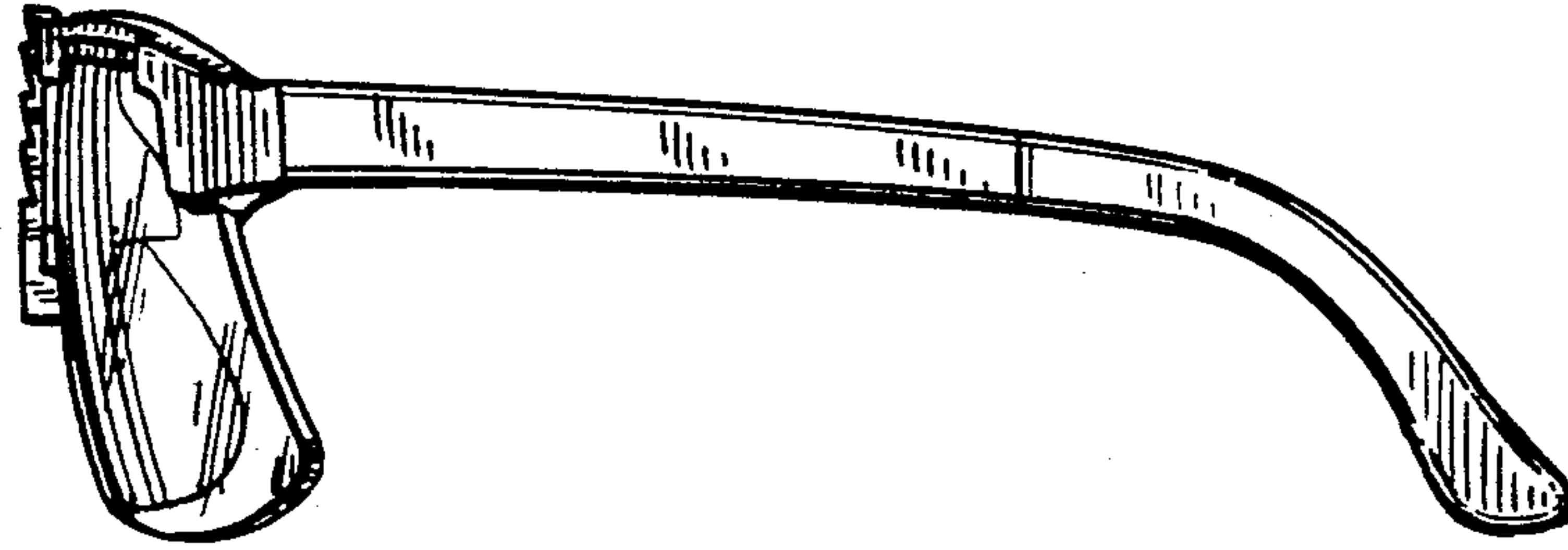

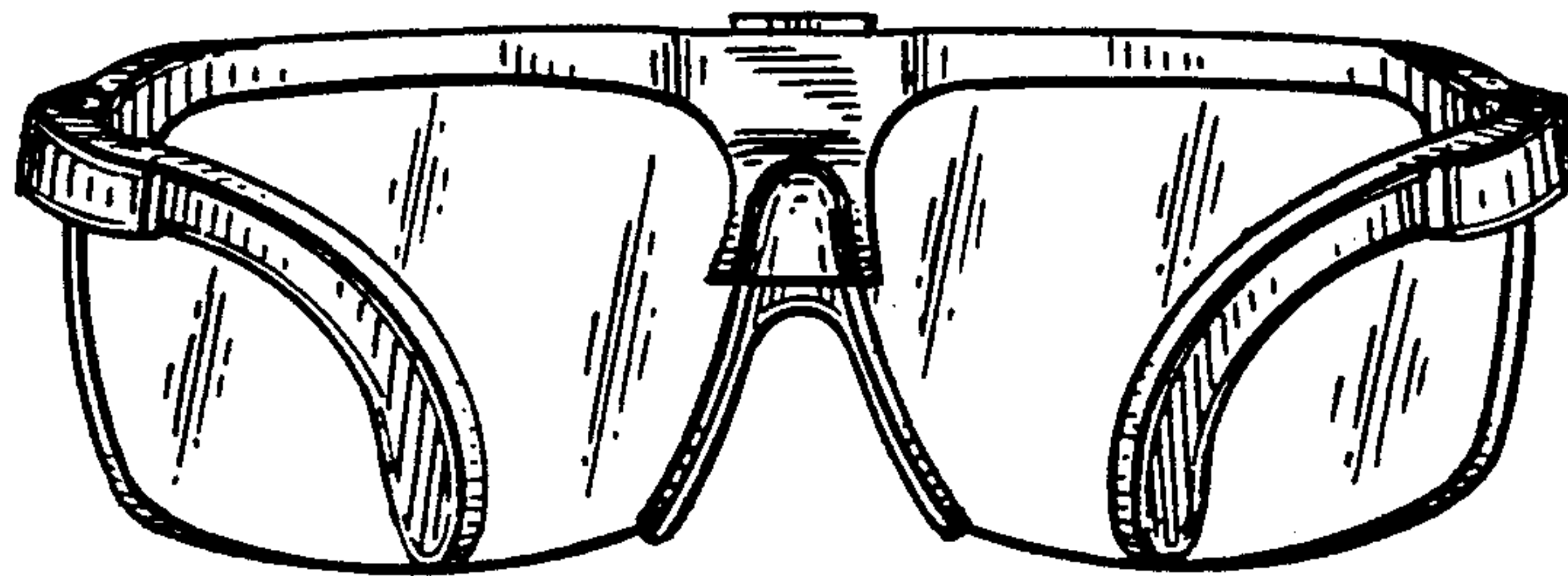
