The ornamental design for a carrier for folding chairs and accessories, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and right side perspective view of a carrier for folding chairs and accessories showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top and right side perspective view, showing said carrier when partially opened;

FIG. 3 is a top and left side perspective view showing said carrier when partially opened;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof shown at a reduced scale;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof with the shoulder strap removed;


FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 10 is a plan view, showing the inside of the carrier in an open, extended position;


FIG. 11 is an enlarged sectional view thereof taken along line 11—11 of FIG. 4; and,

FIG. 12 is a top, rear and right side perspective view of the detachable sack shown in FIG. 1.


The cross-hatched shading shown in all views represents conventional fabric and is understood to cover the entire surface.









