The ornamental design for a hair pick, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hair pick showing our
new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the side oppo-
site being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the side
opposite being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second modified em-
bodiment;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof, the side oppo-
site being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view thereof, the side
opposite being a mirror image of the side shown; and,

FIG. 11 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken along
line 11-11 of FIG. 2.

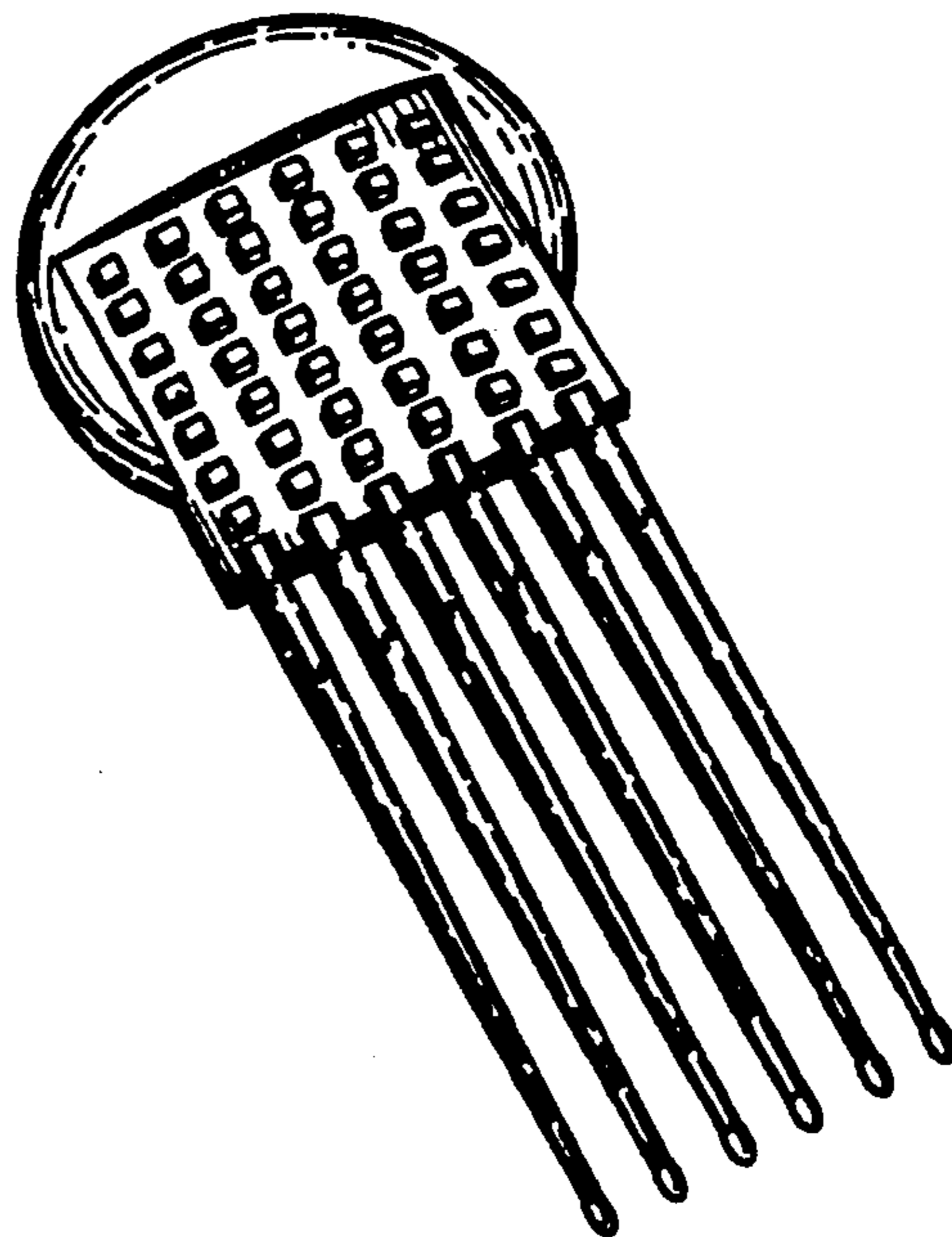
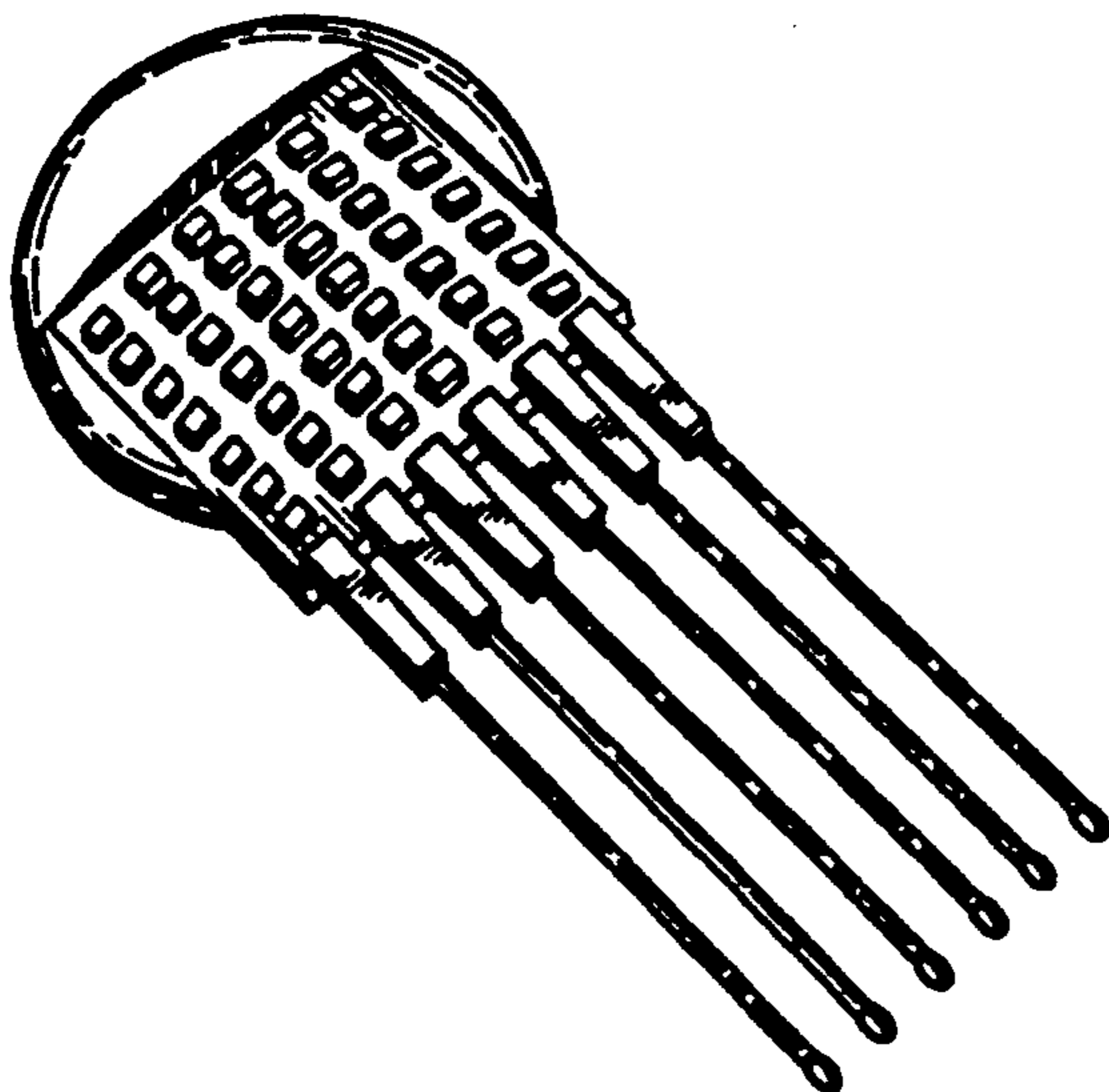

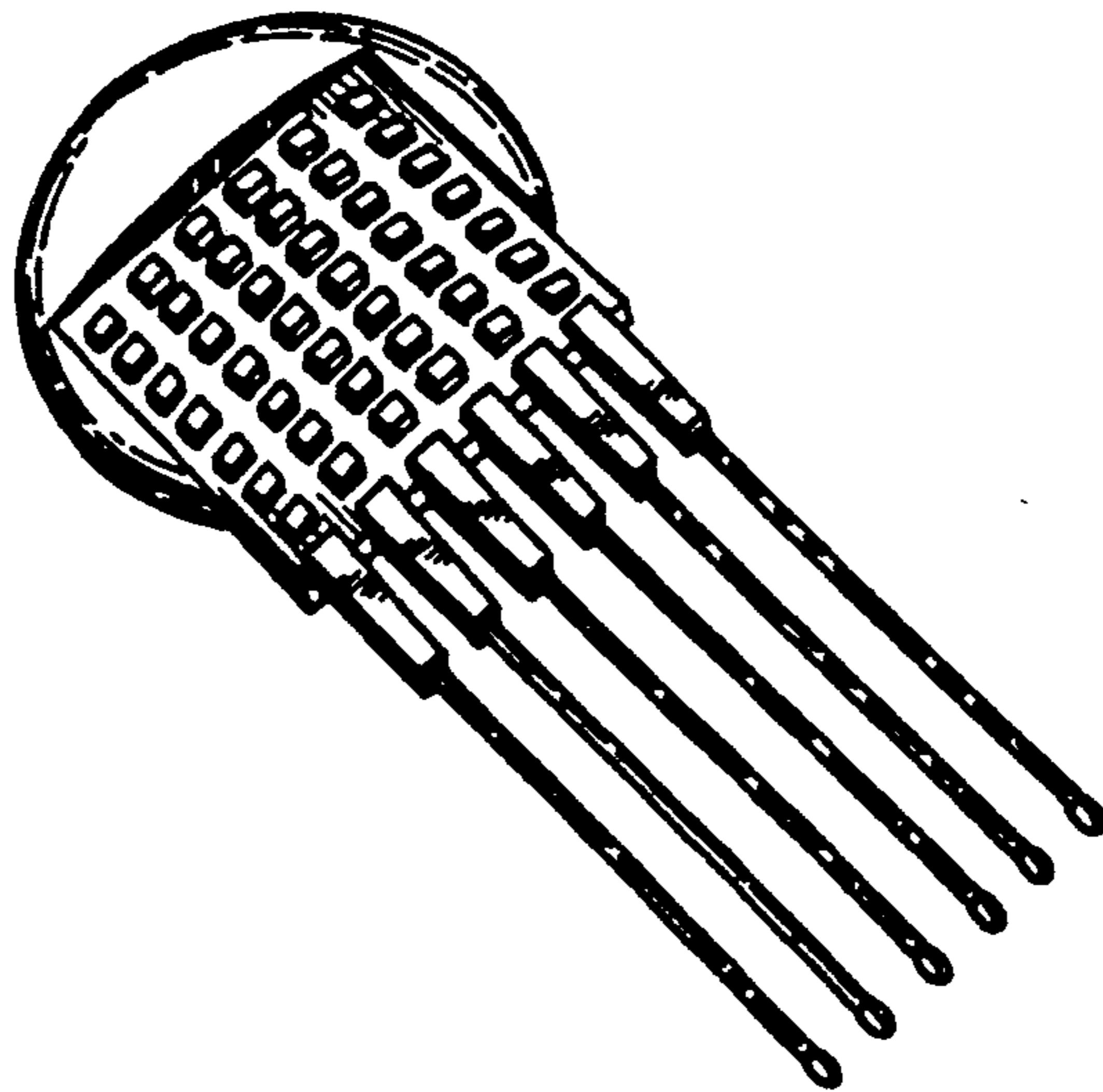

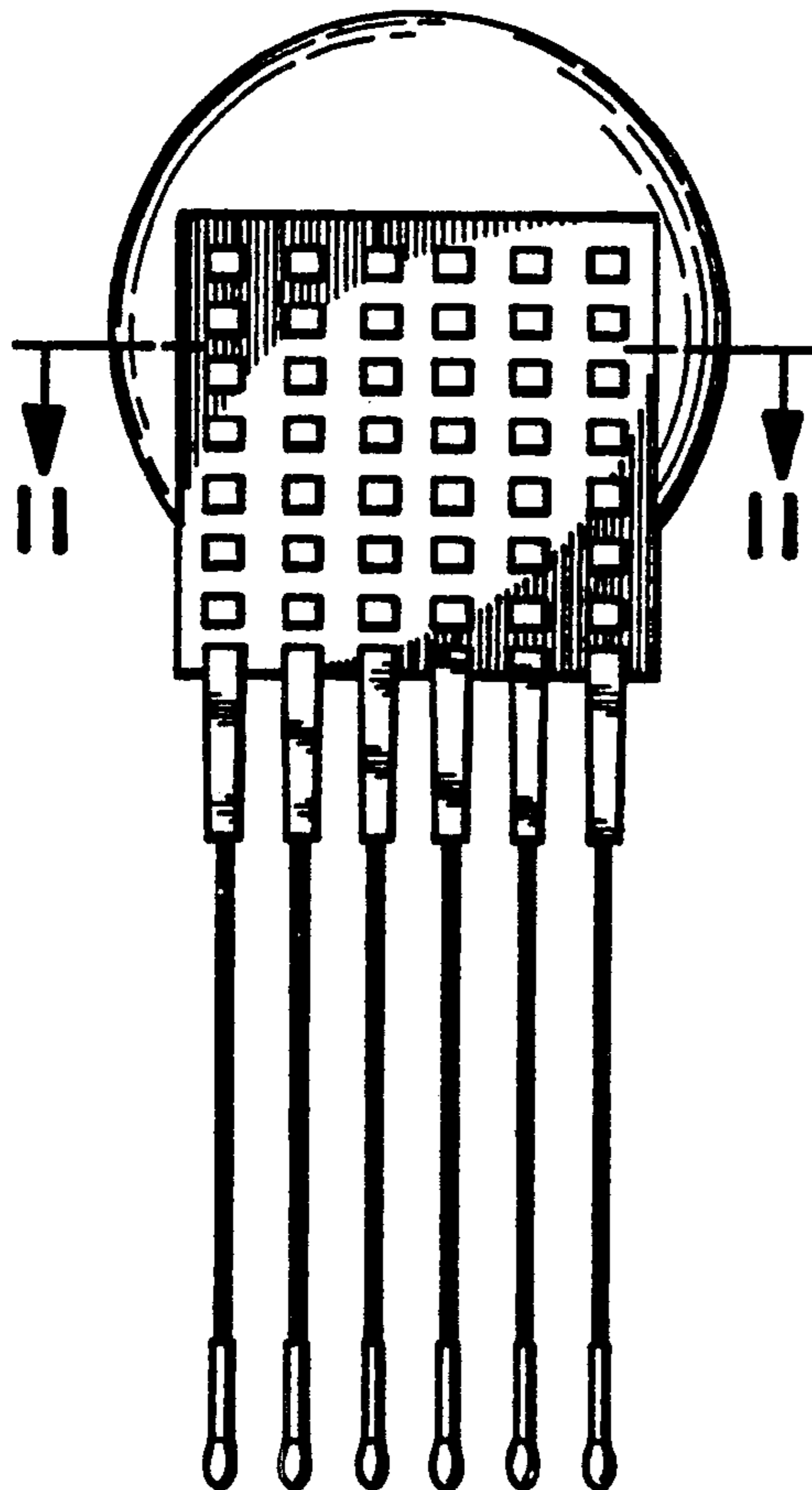

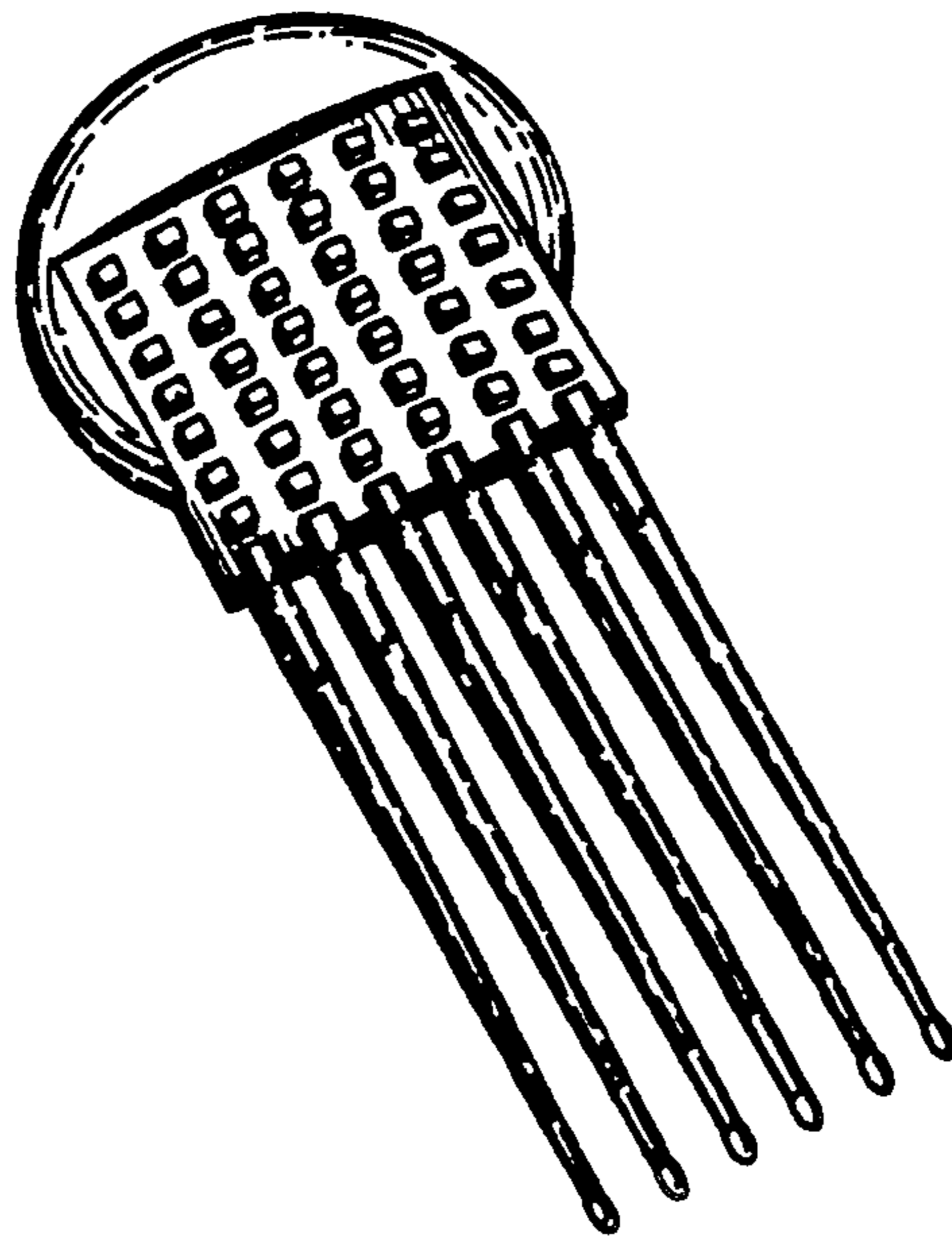

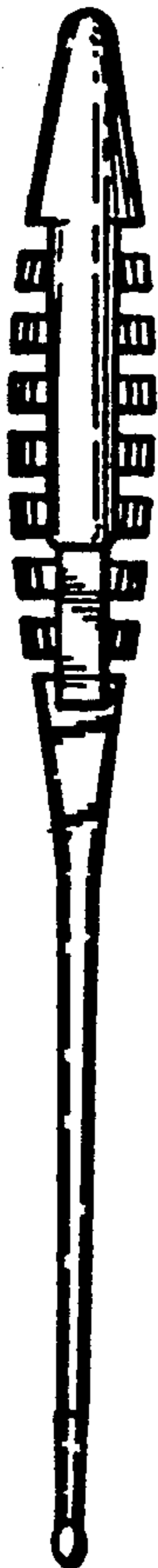

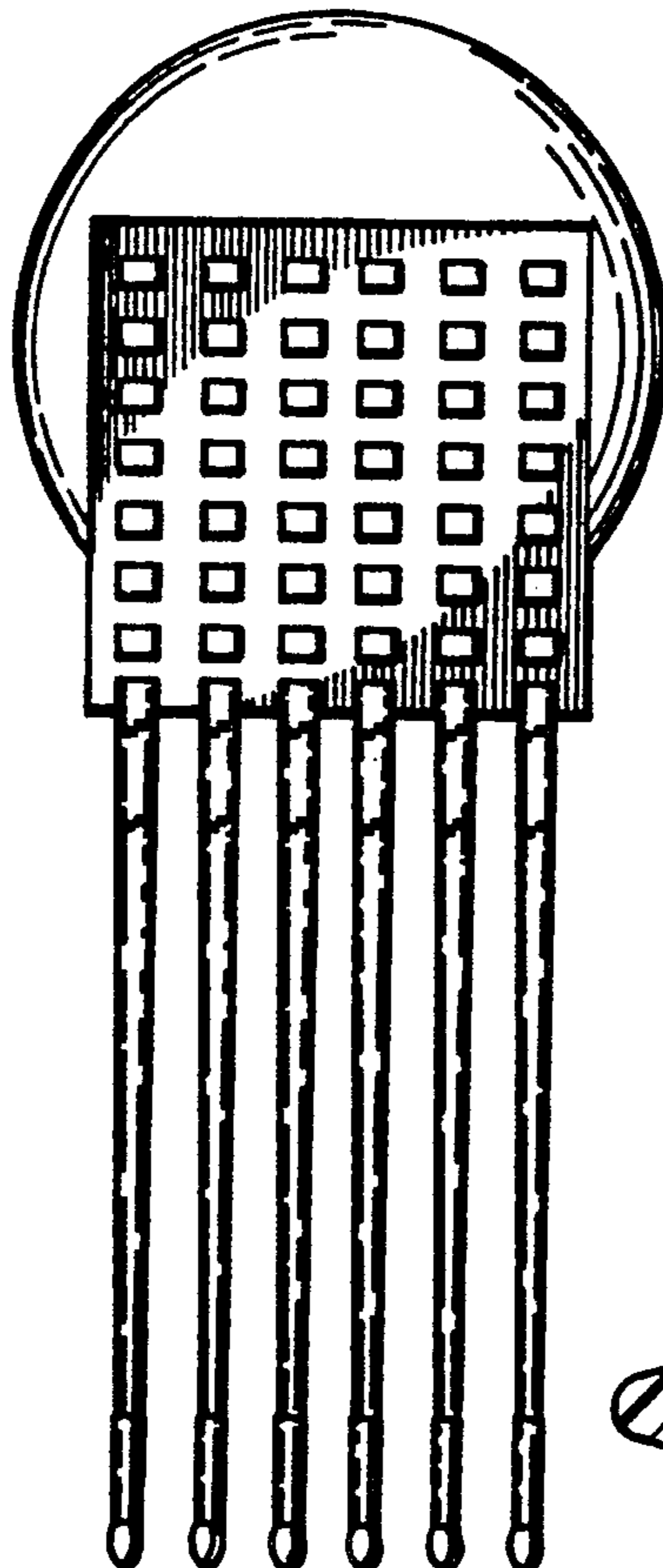
