[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a bottle showing my new design, the rear elevation being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; and,

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation thereof, the left side elevation being a mirror image thereof.

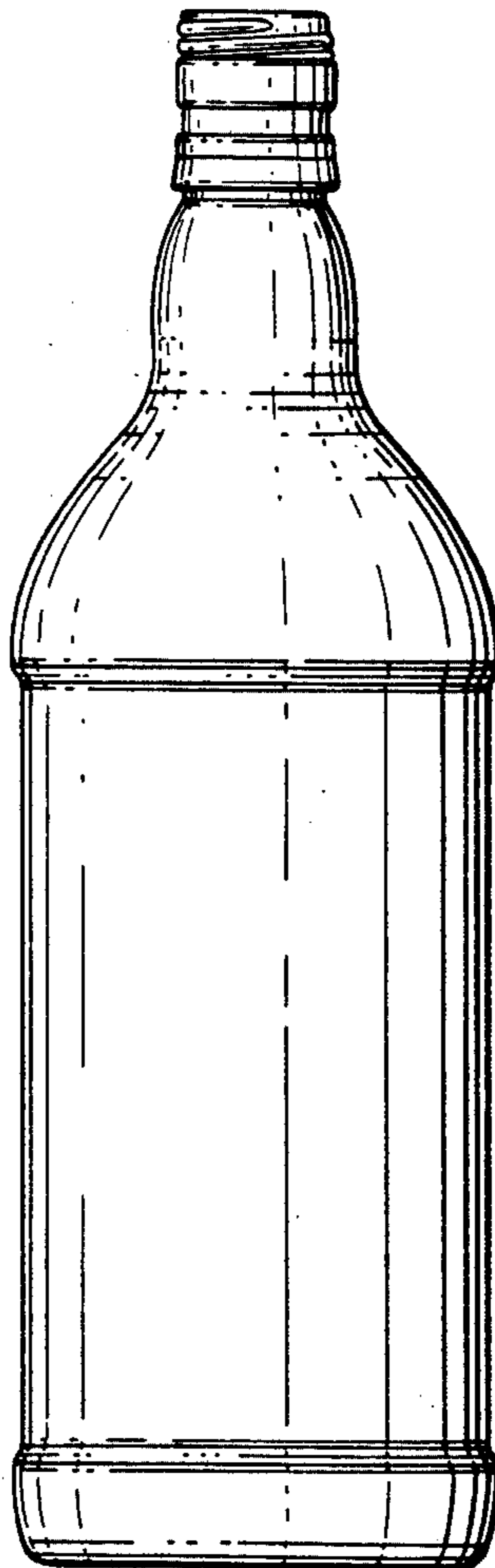

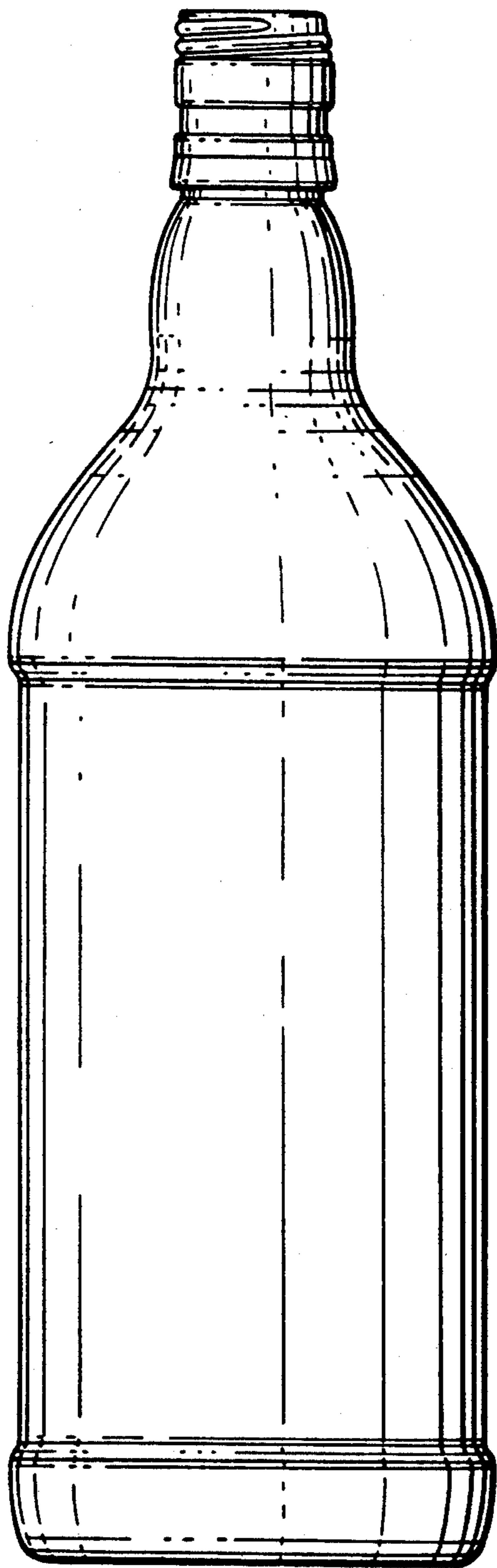

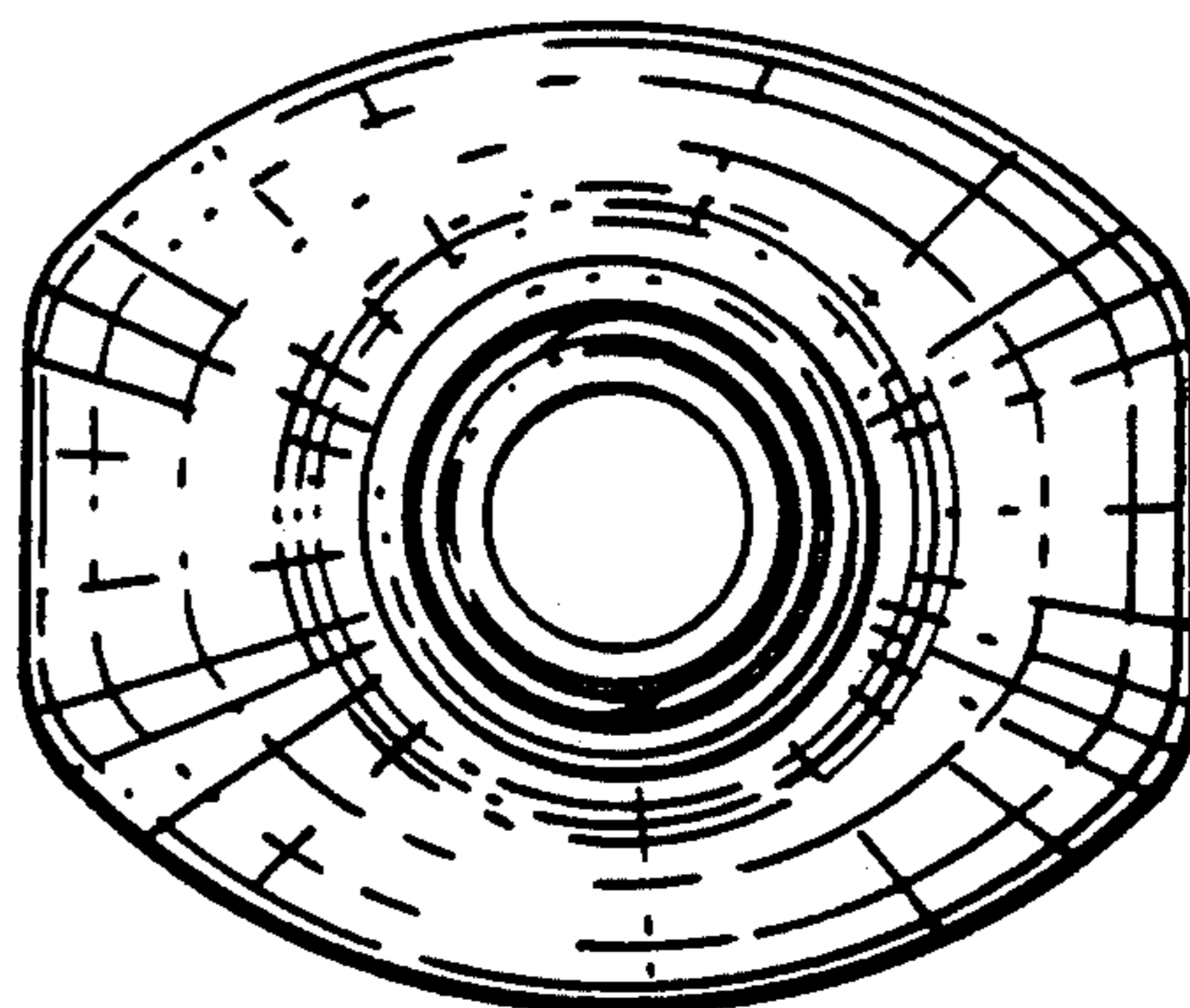

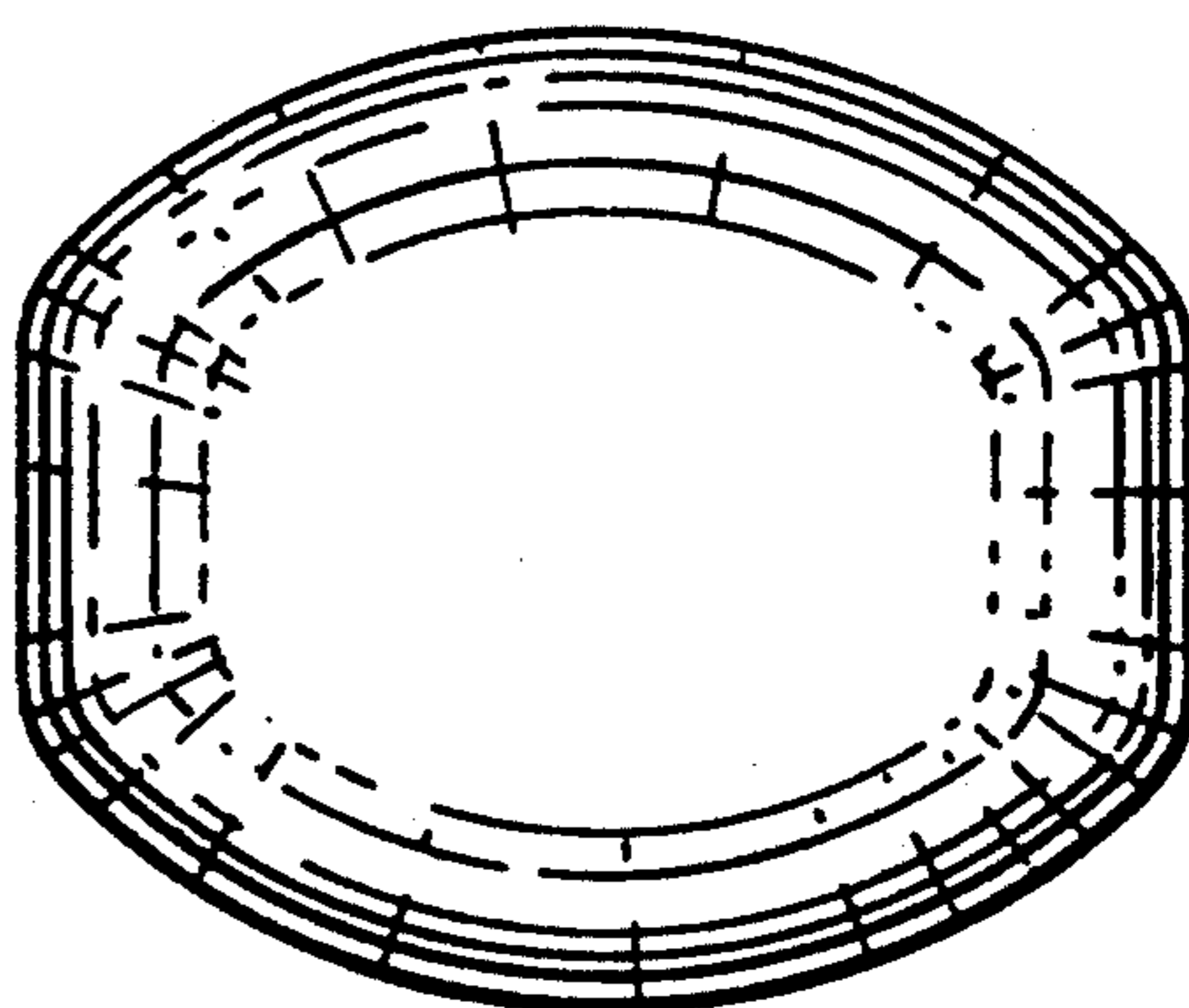
