view;

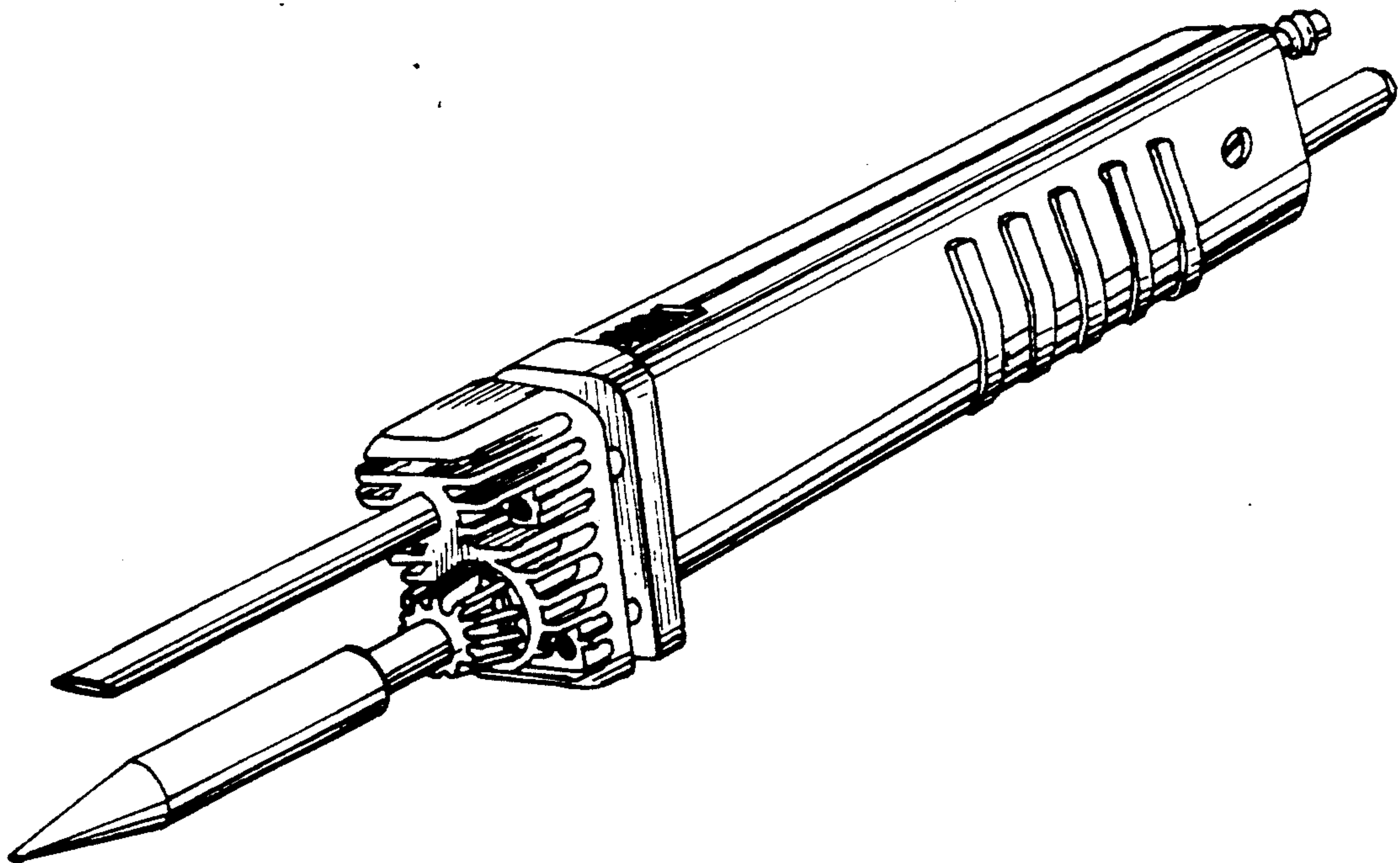
FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view, the opposite side
being a mirror image thereof;

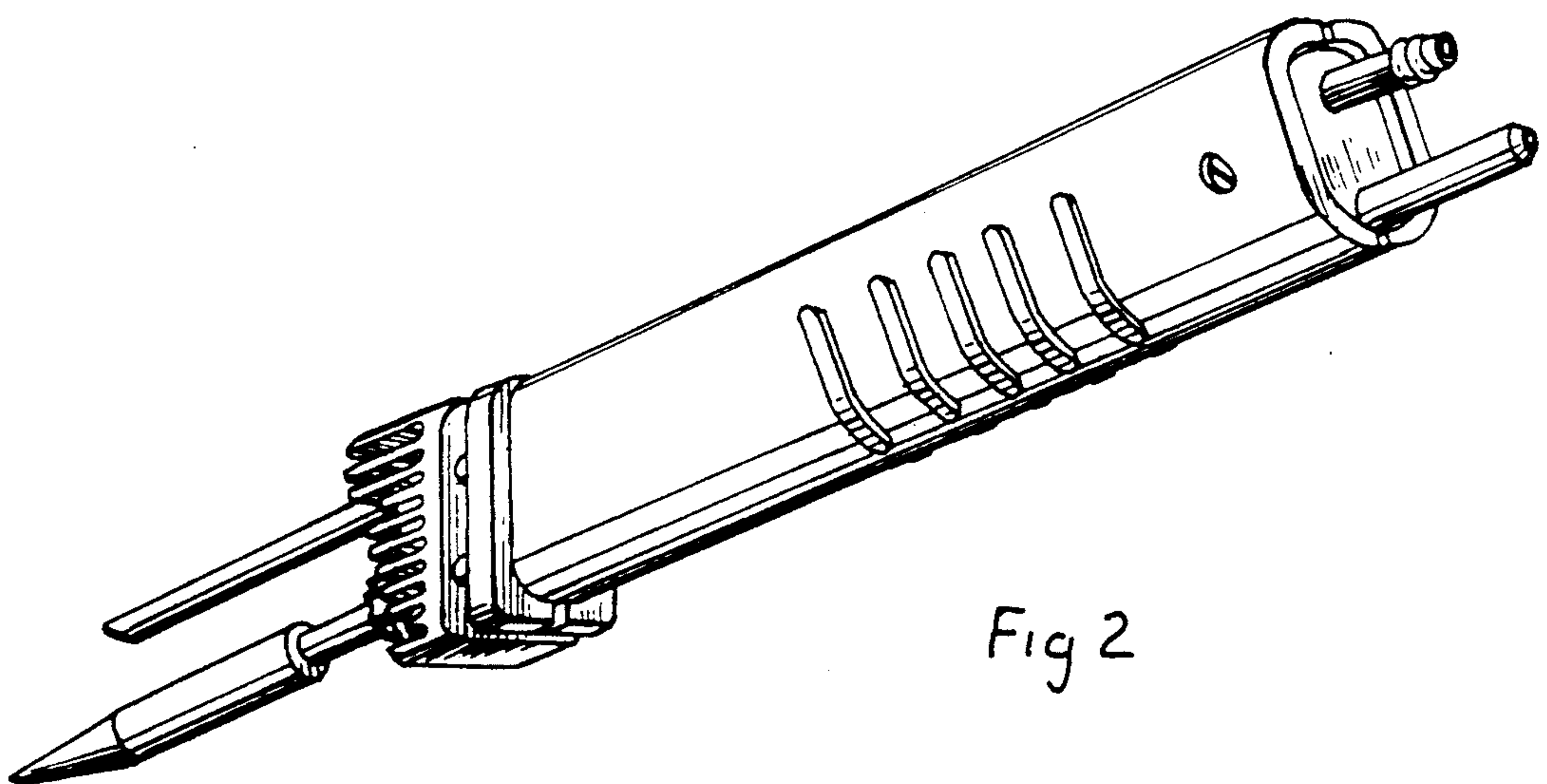
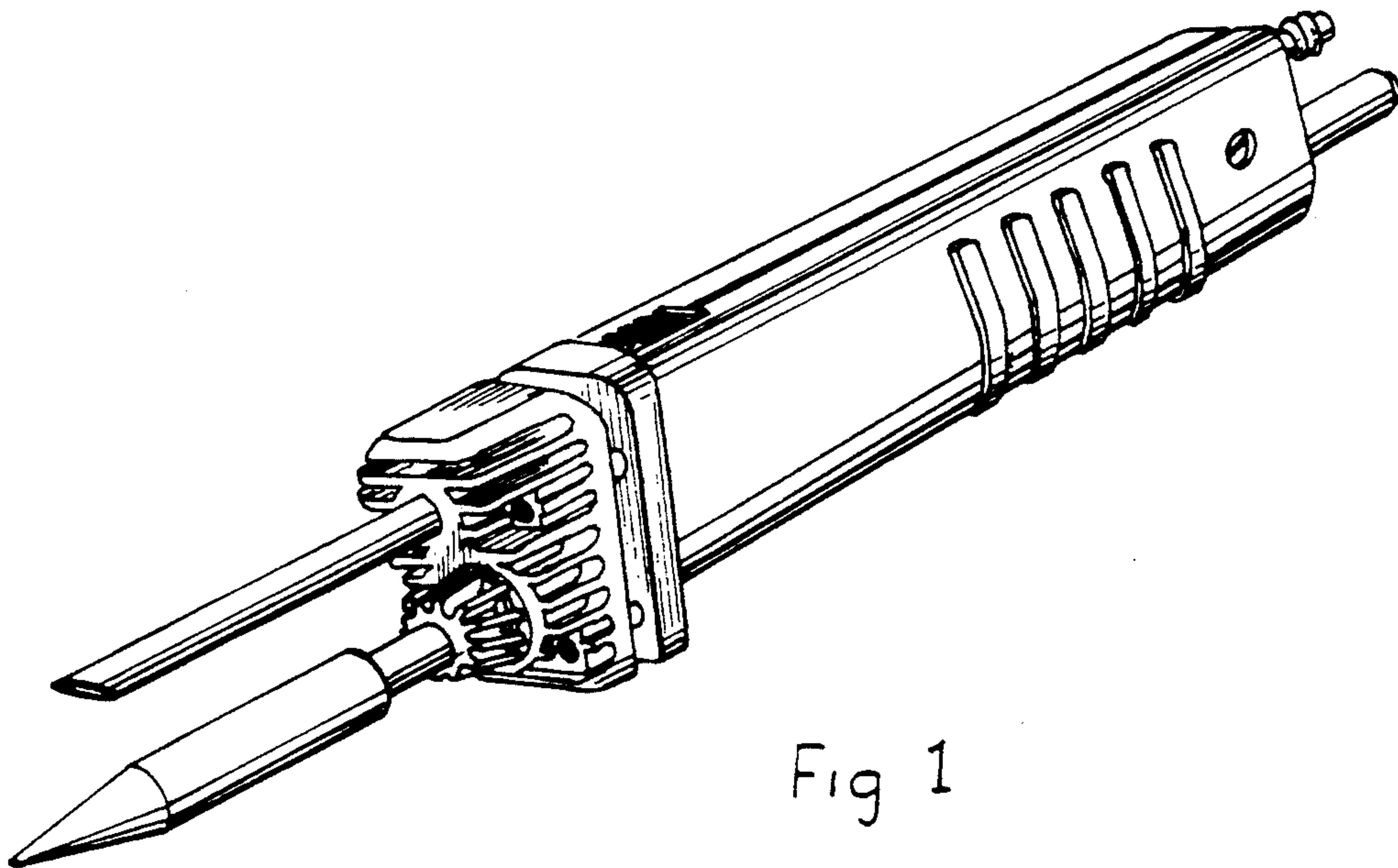
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view.





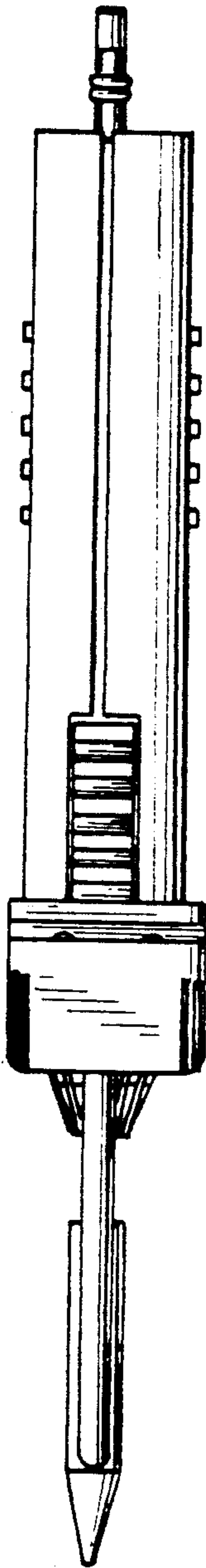

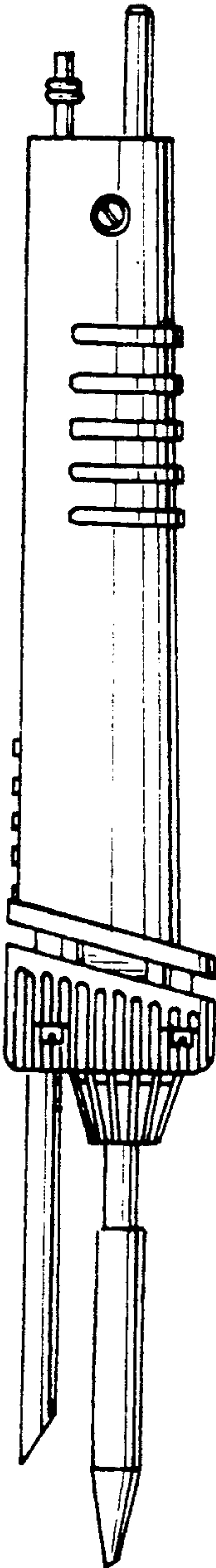

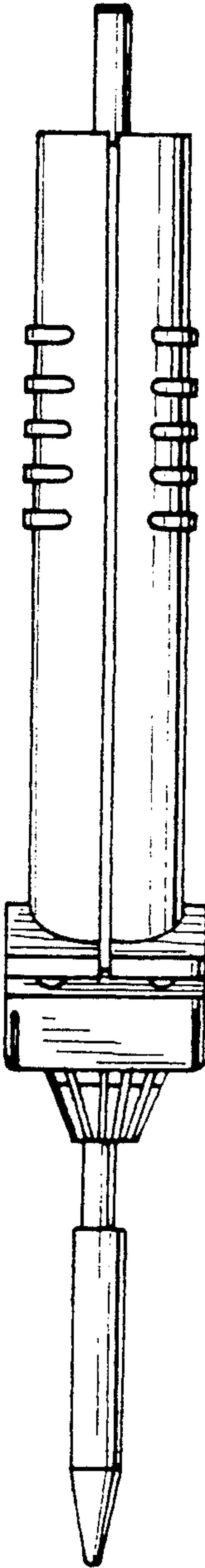

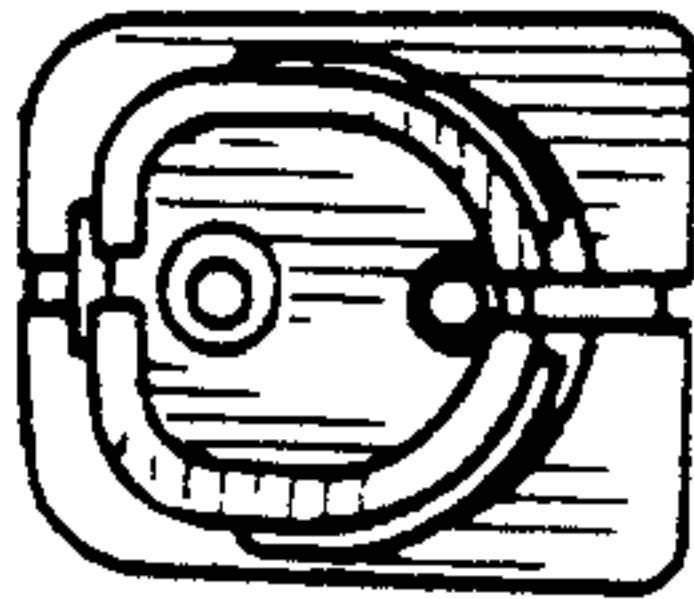

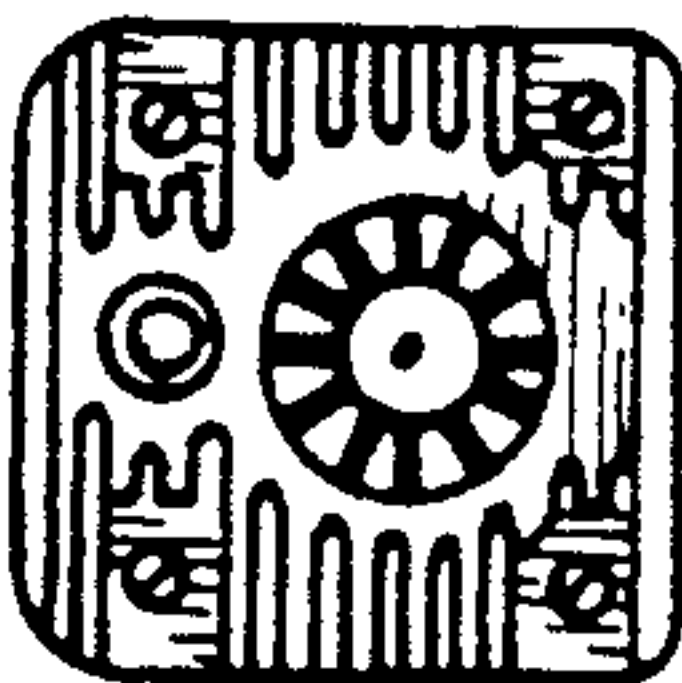
