FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an undergarment for posture enhancement showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of a fourth embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 10; FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of a fifth embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 12; FIG. 14 is a front elevational view of an ungarment for posture enhancement as used on a child; FIG. 15 is a rear elevational view, of the undergarment for posture enhancement as see in FIG. 14; FIG. 16 is yet another front elevational view, of the undergarment for posture enhancement as used on a child; and, FIG. 17 is a rear elevational view of the undergarment for posture enhancement as seen in FIG. 16. The broken lines partially showing a human torso throughout the views are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

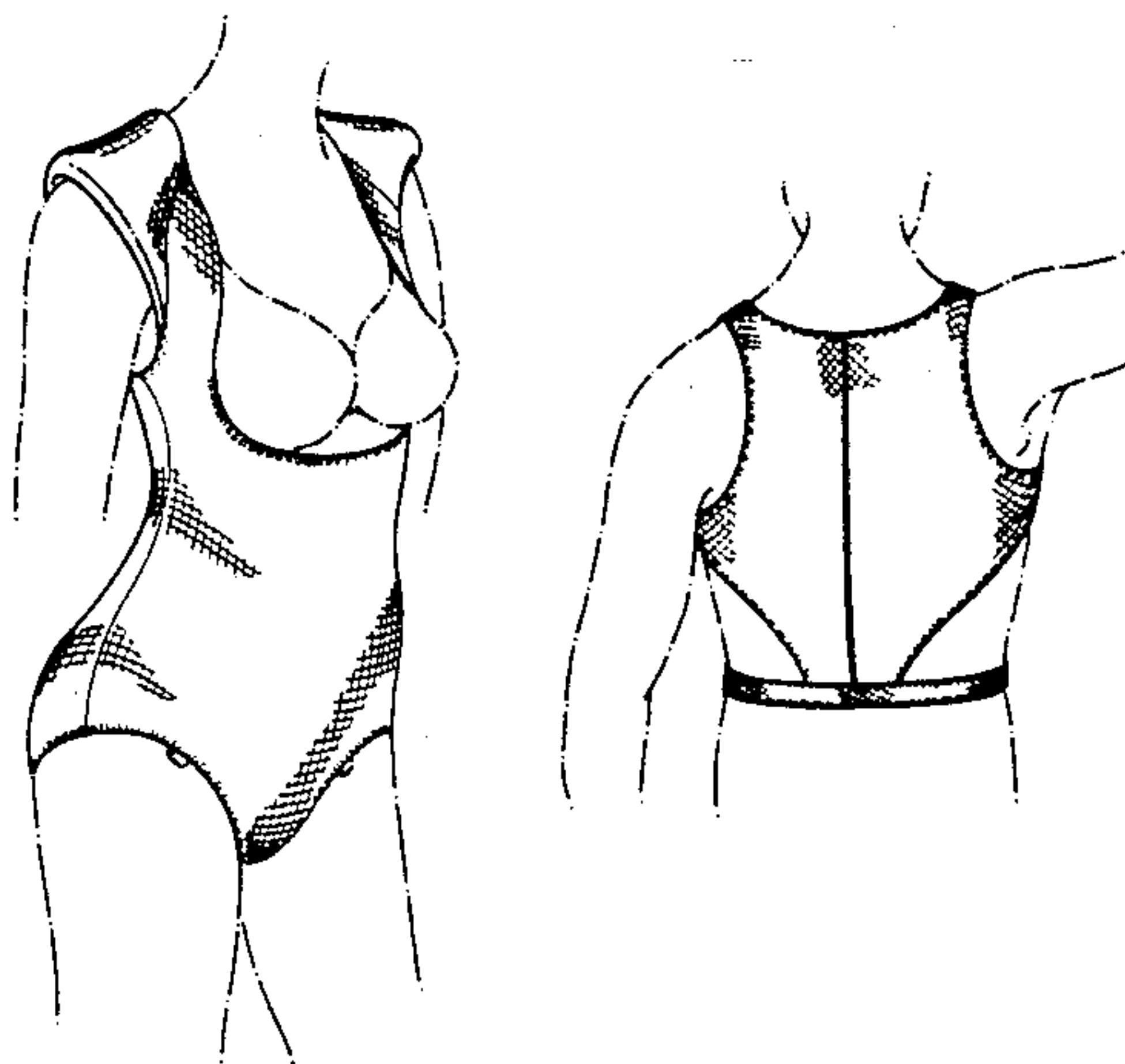

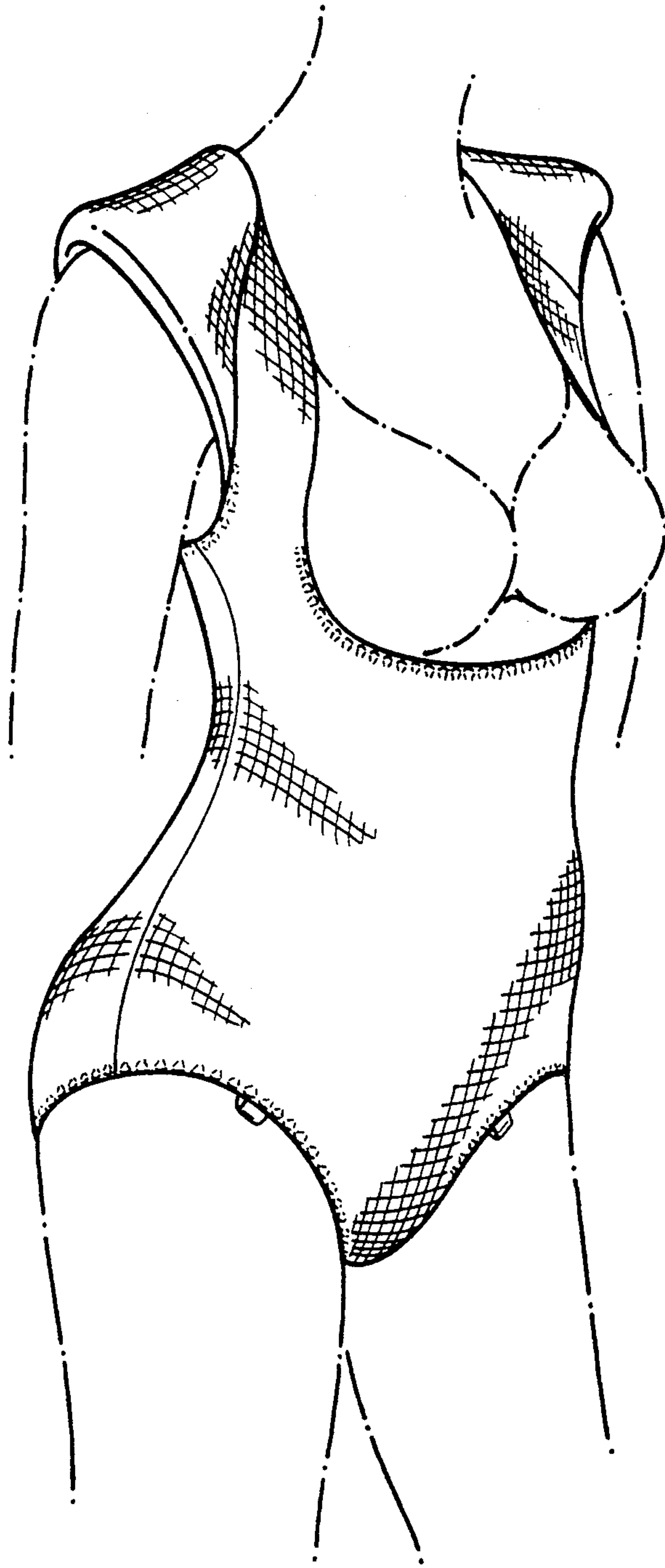

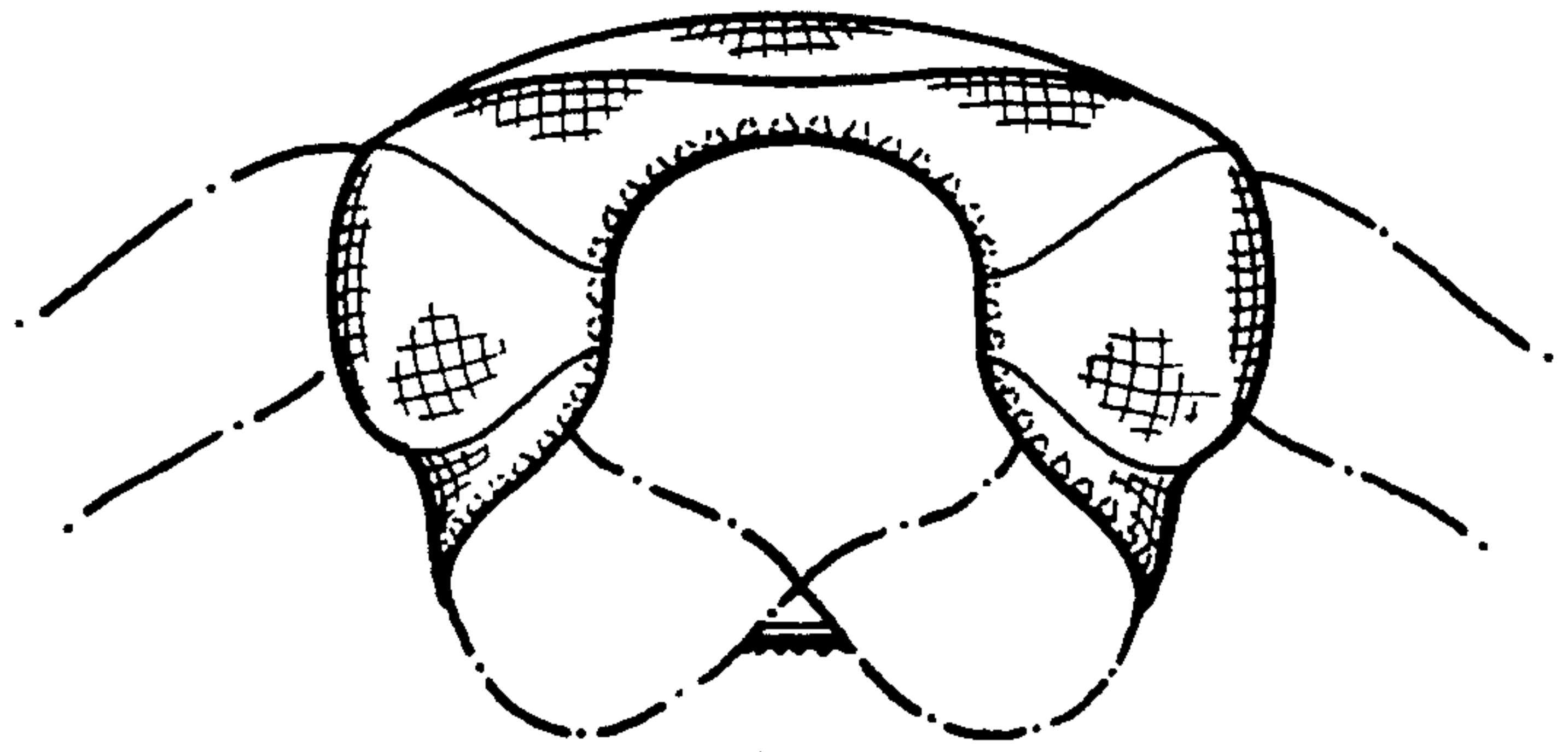

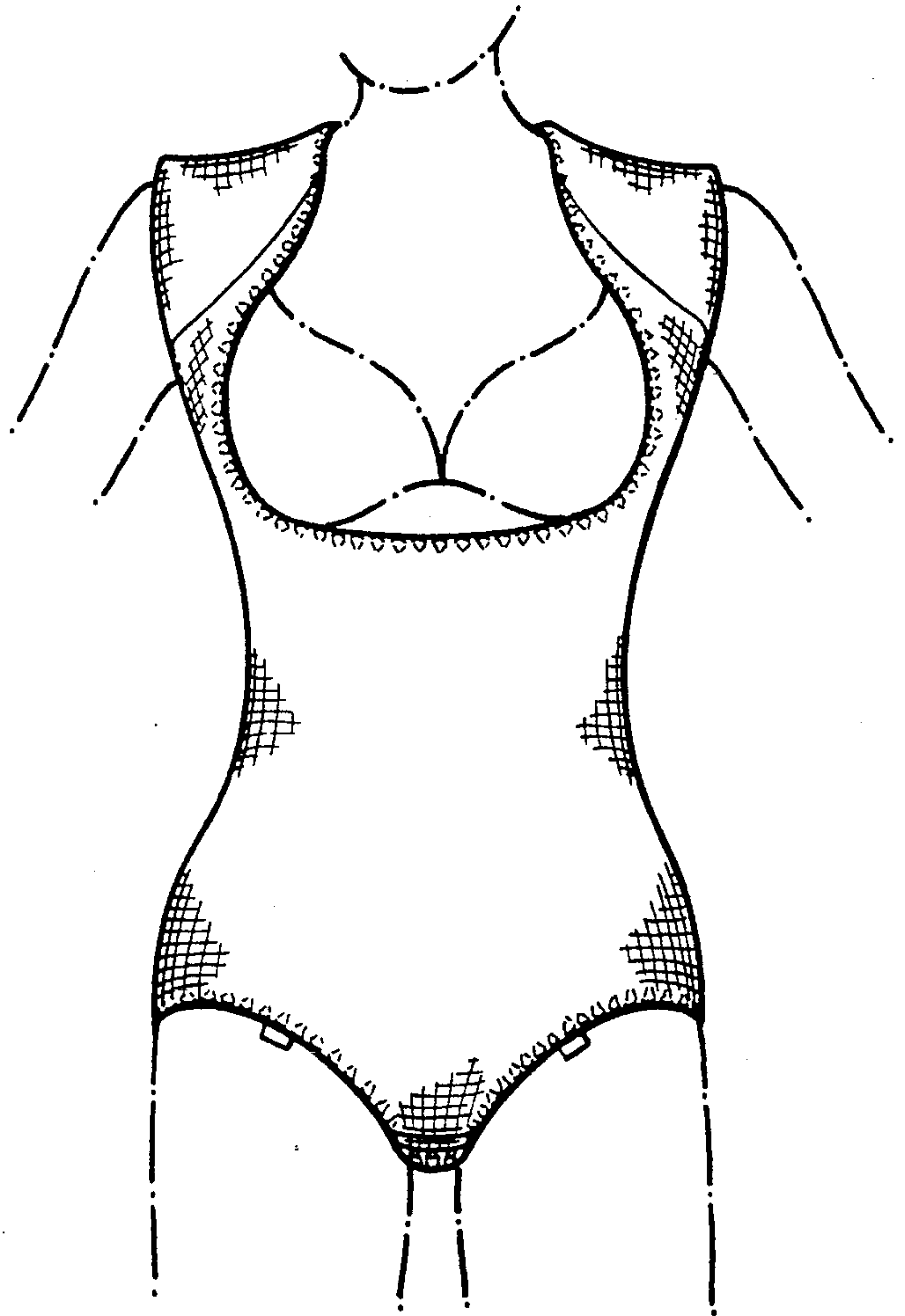

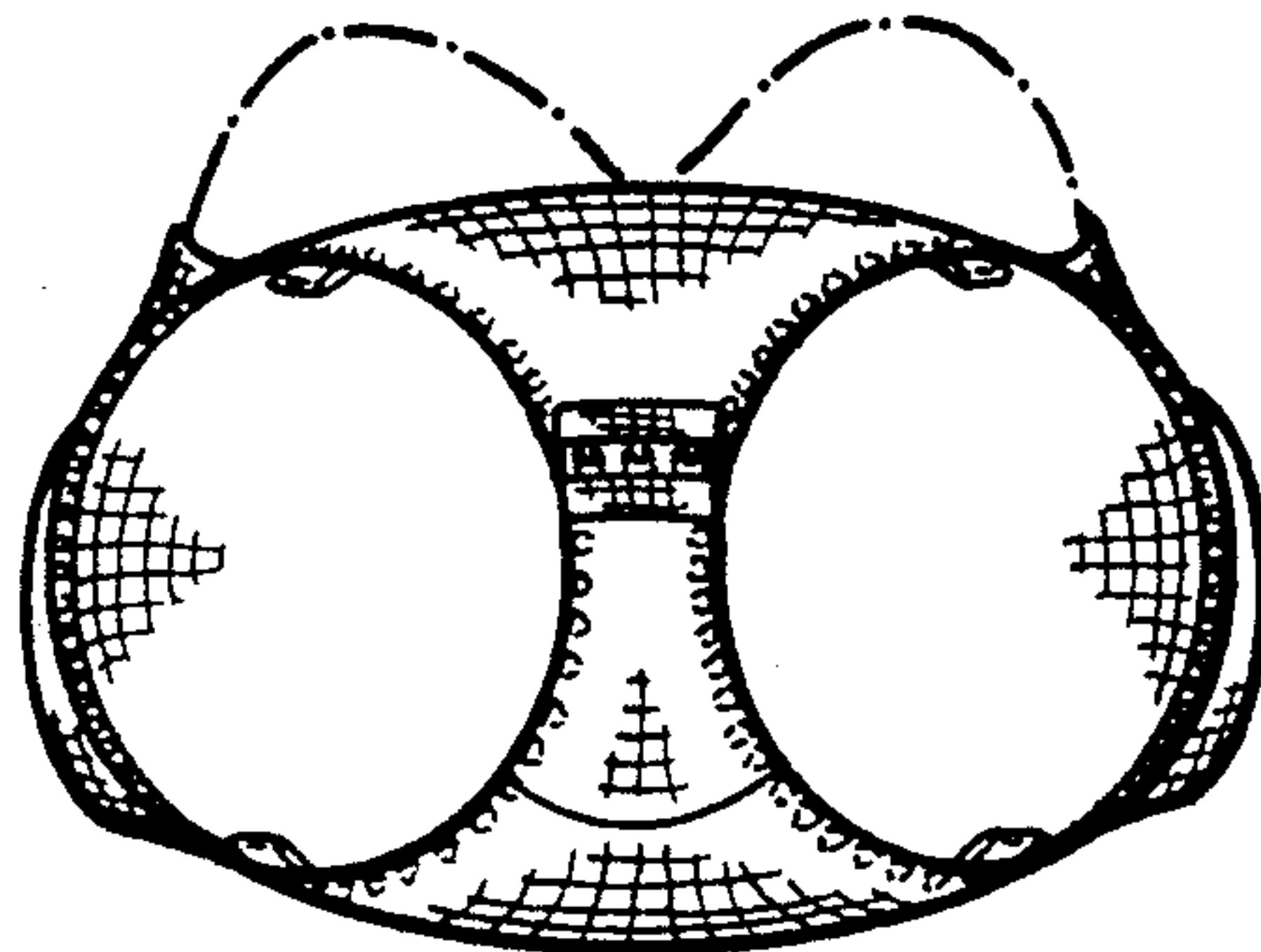

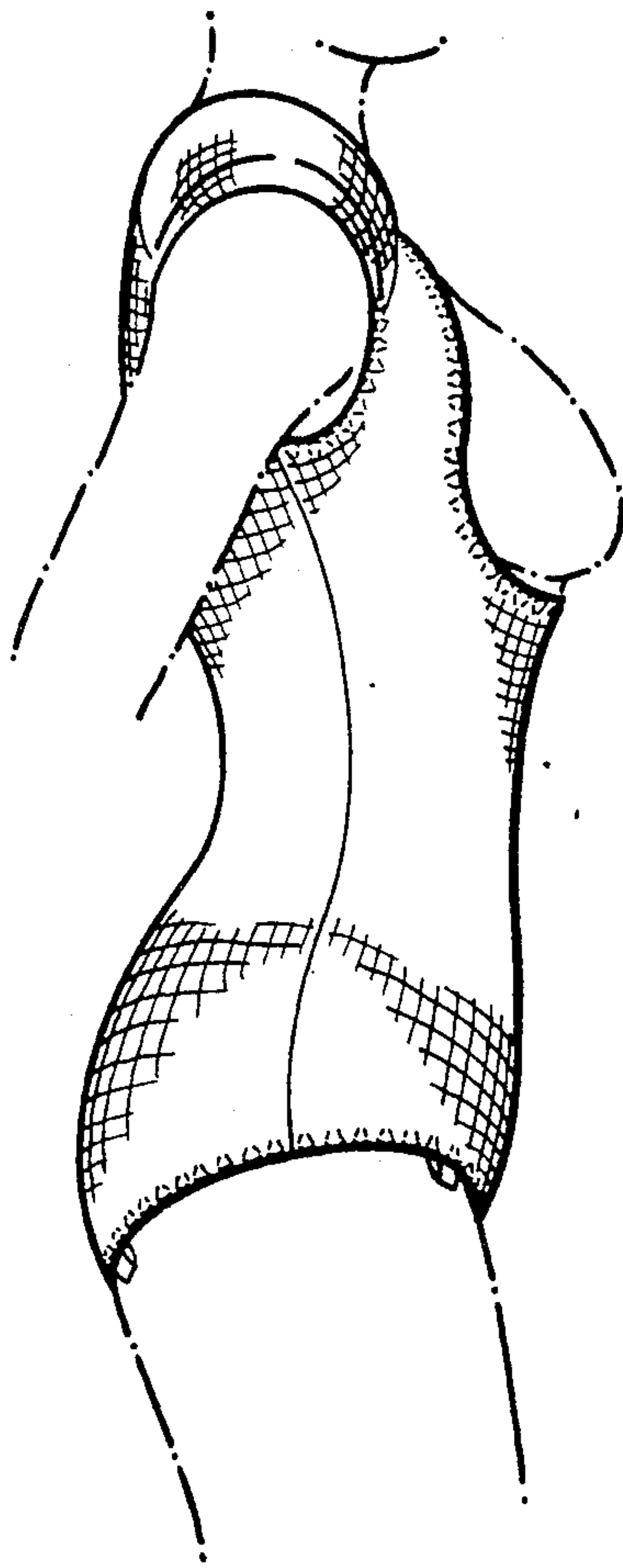

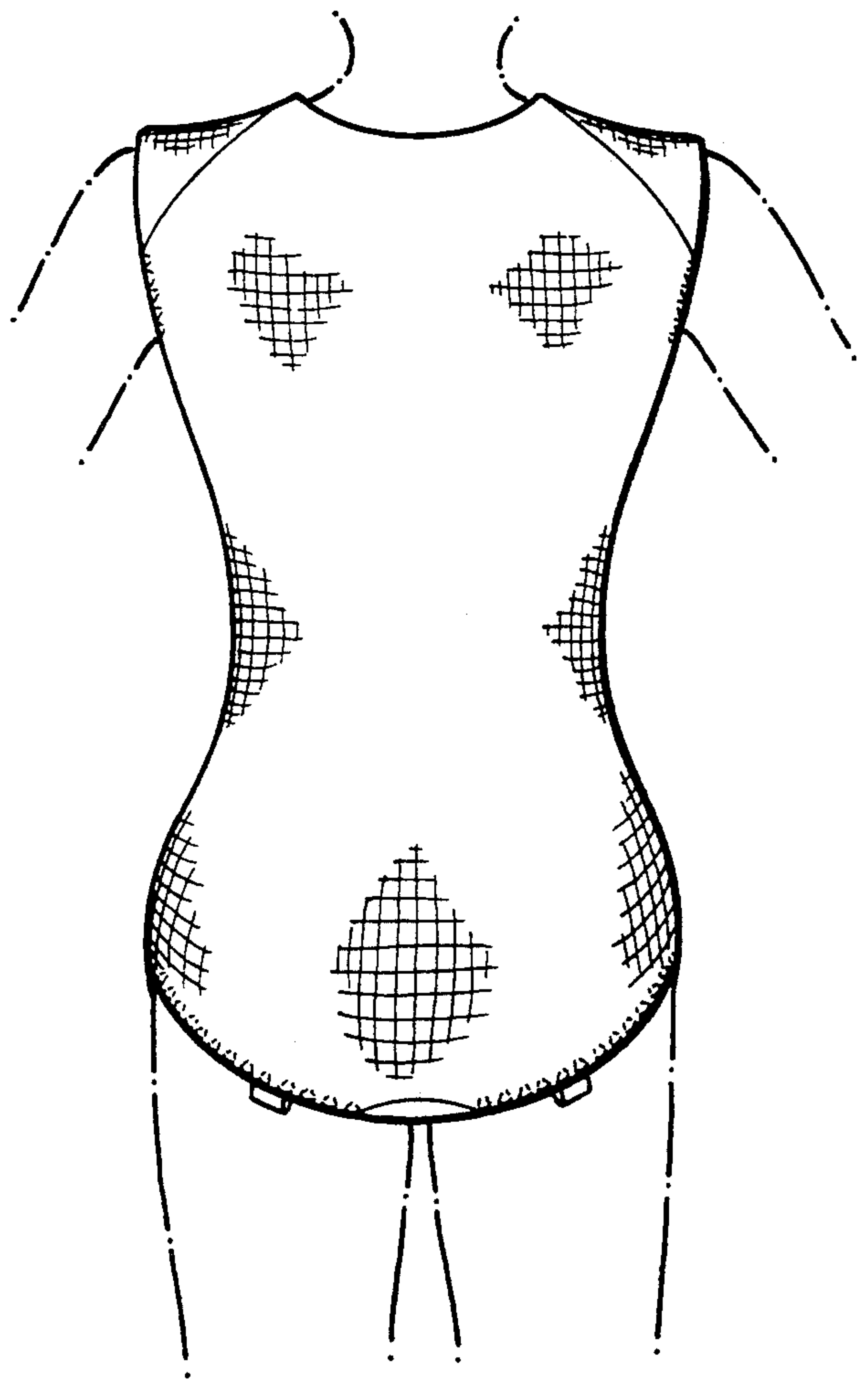

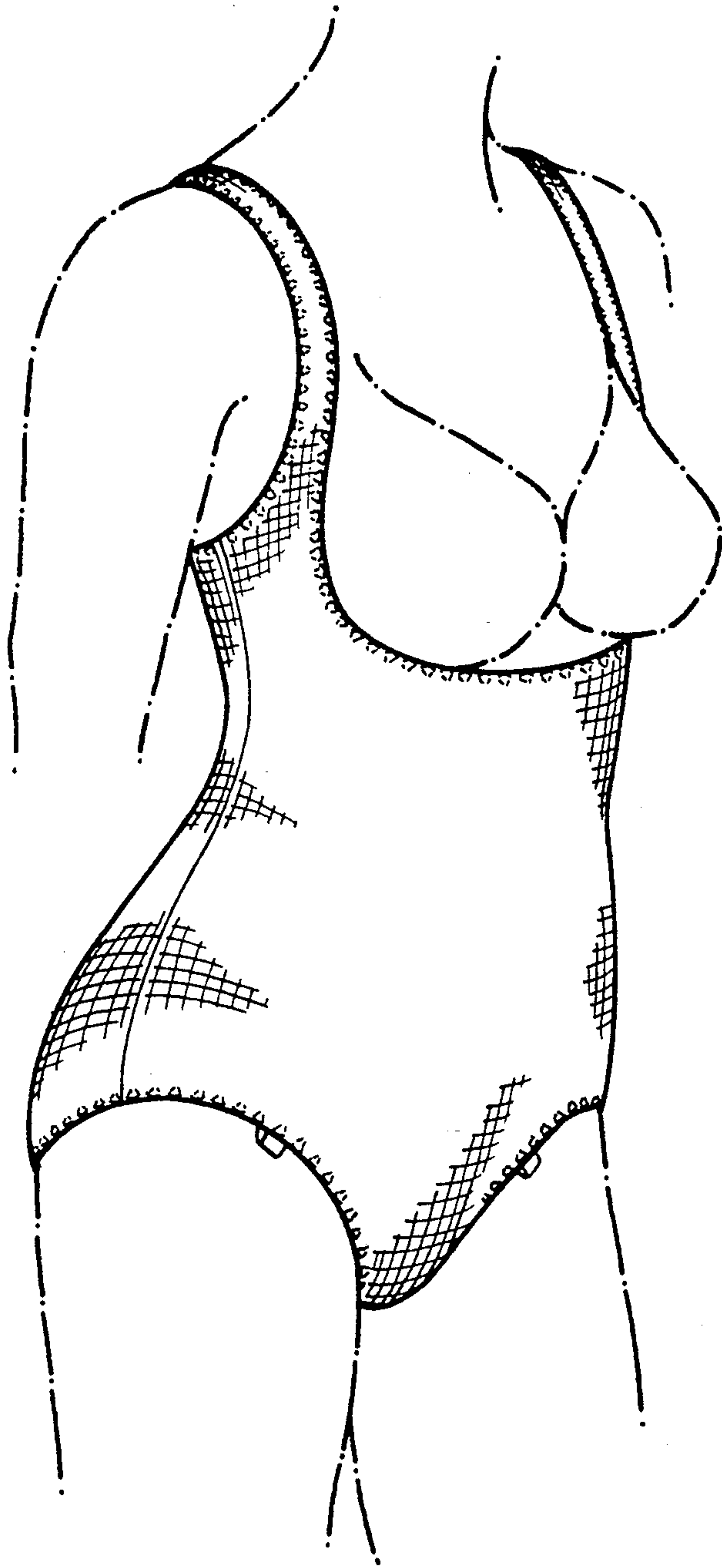

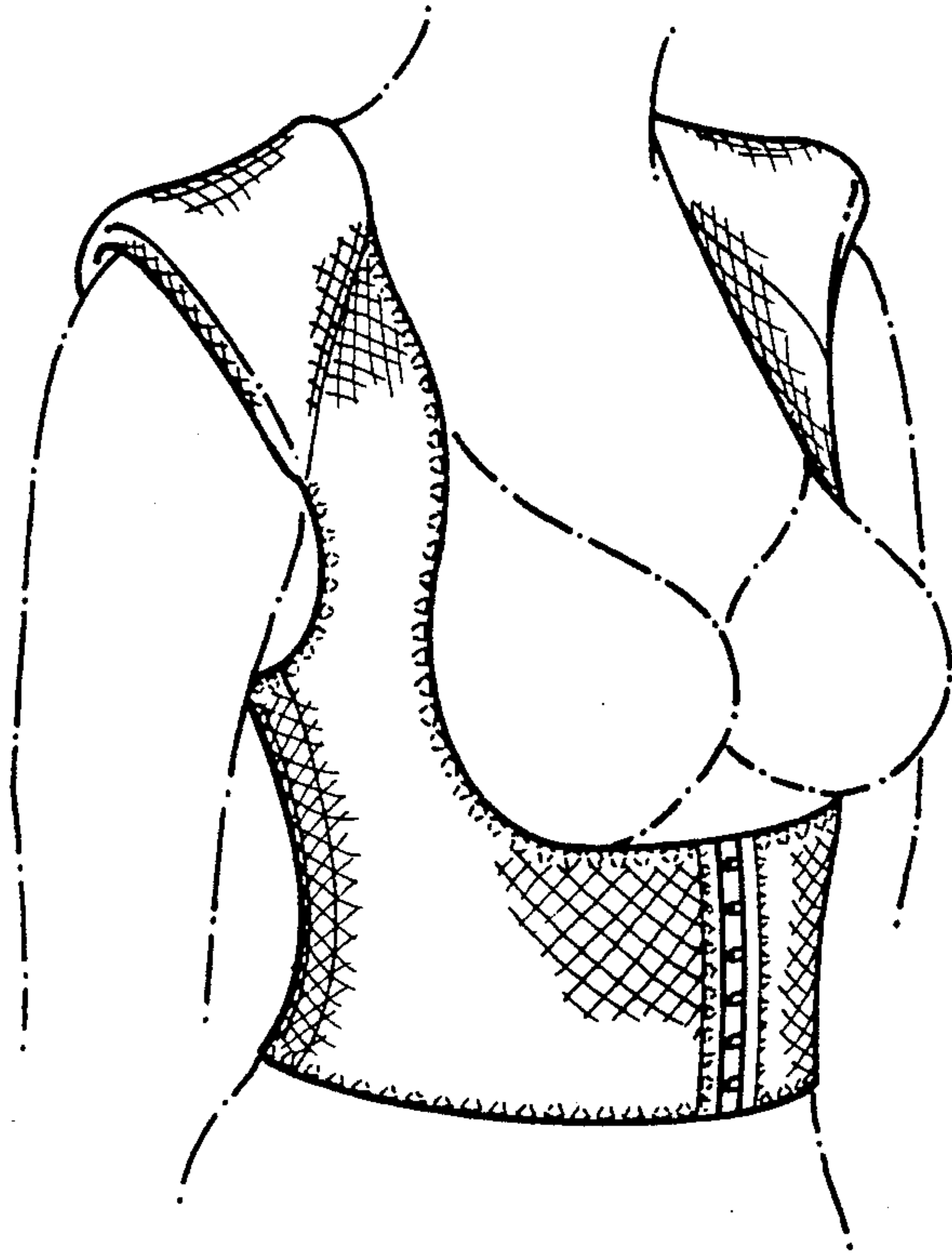
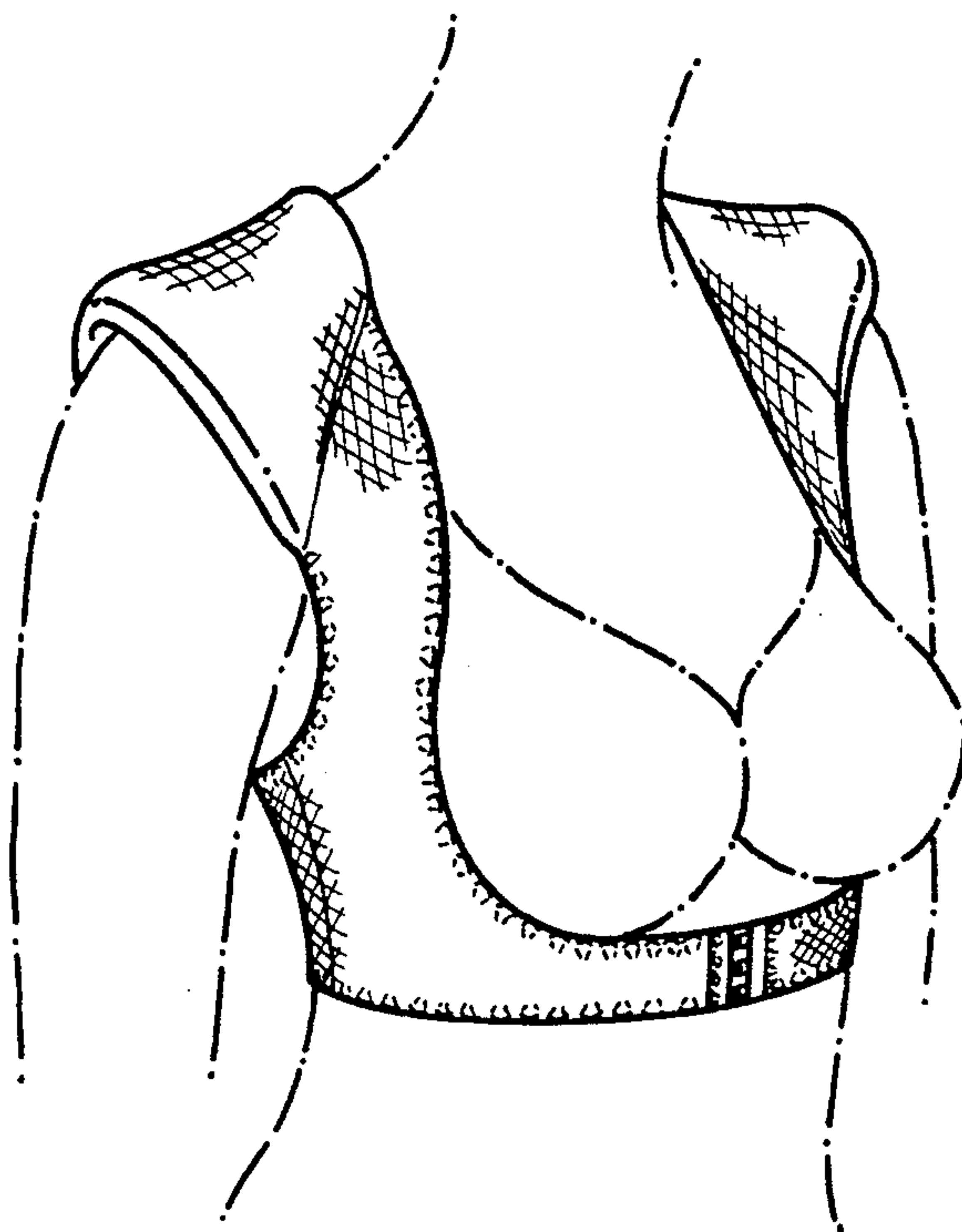
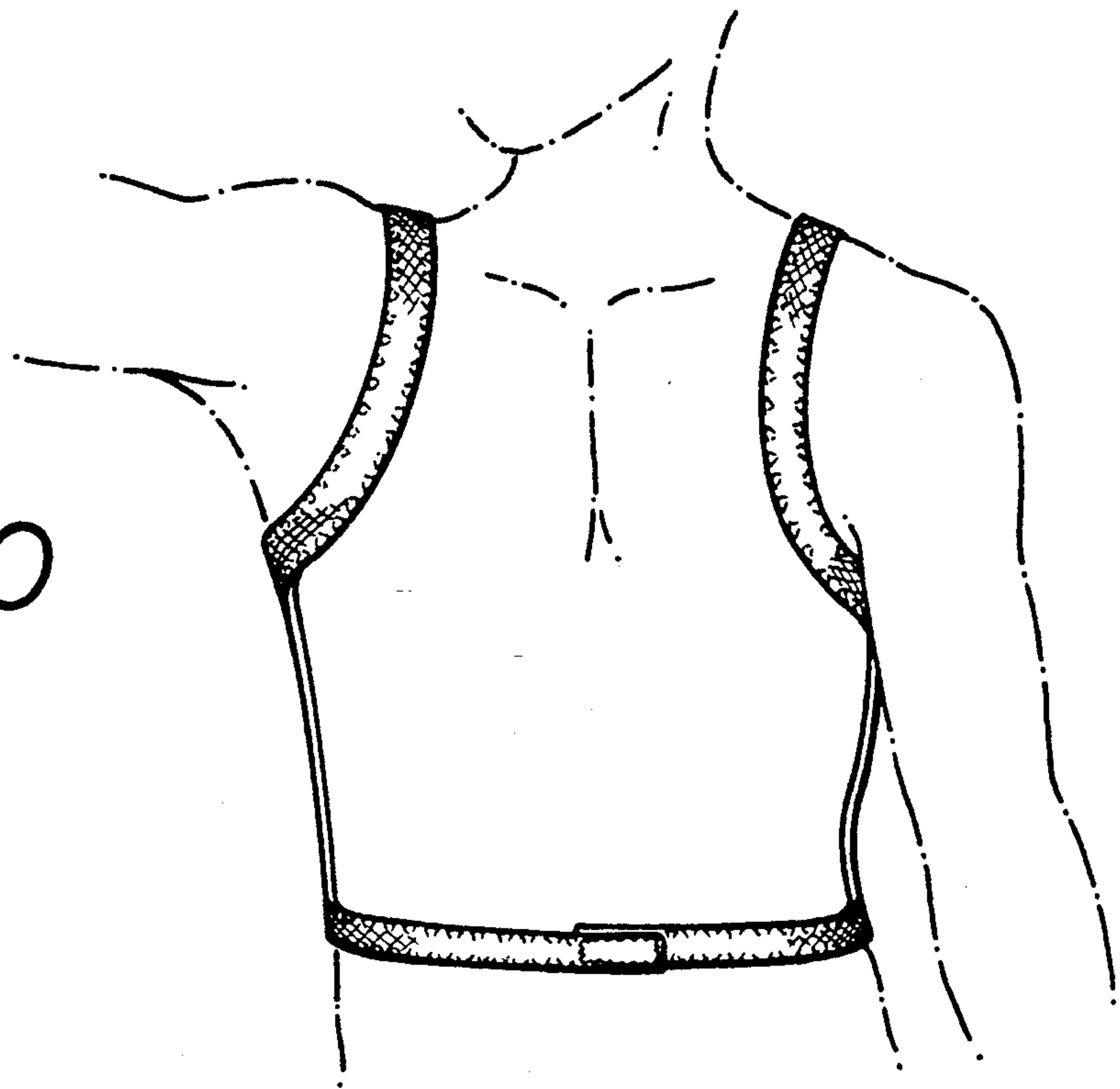

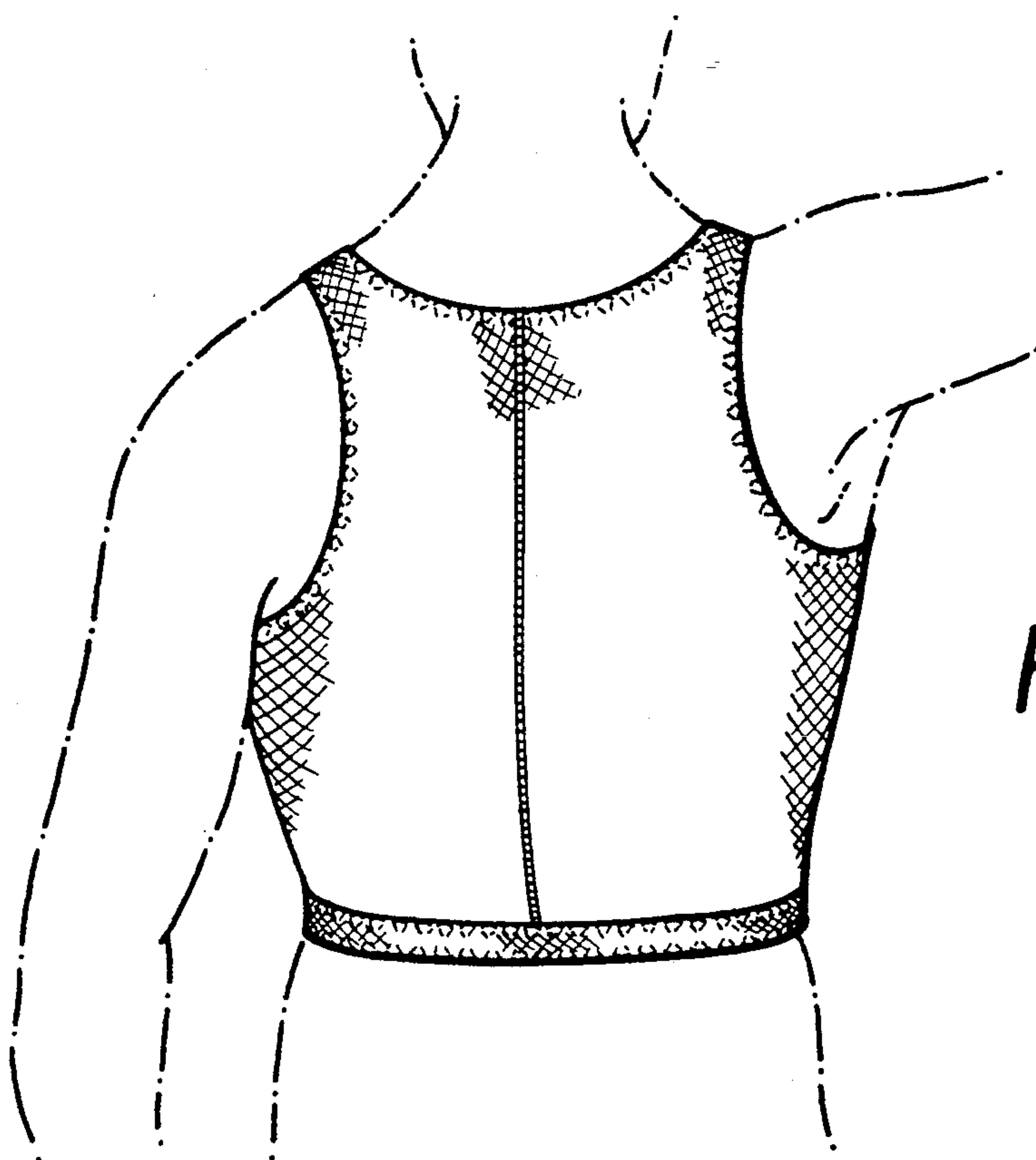

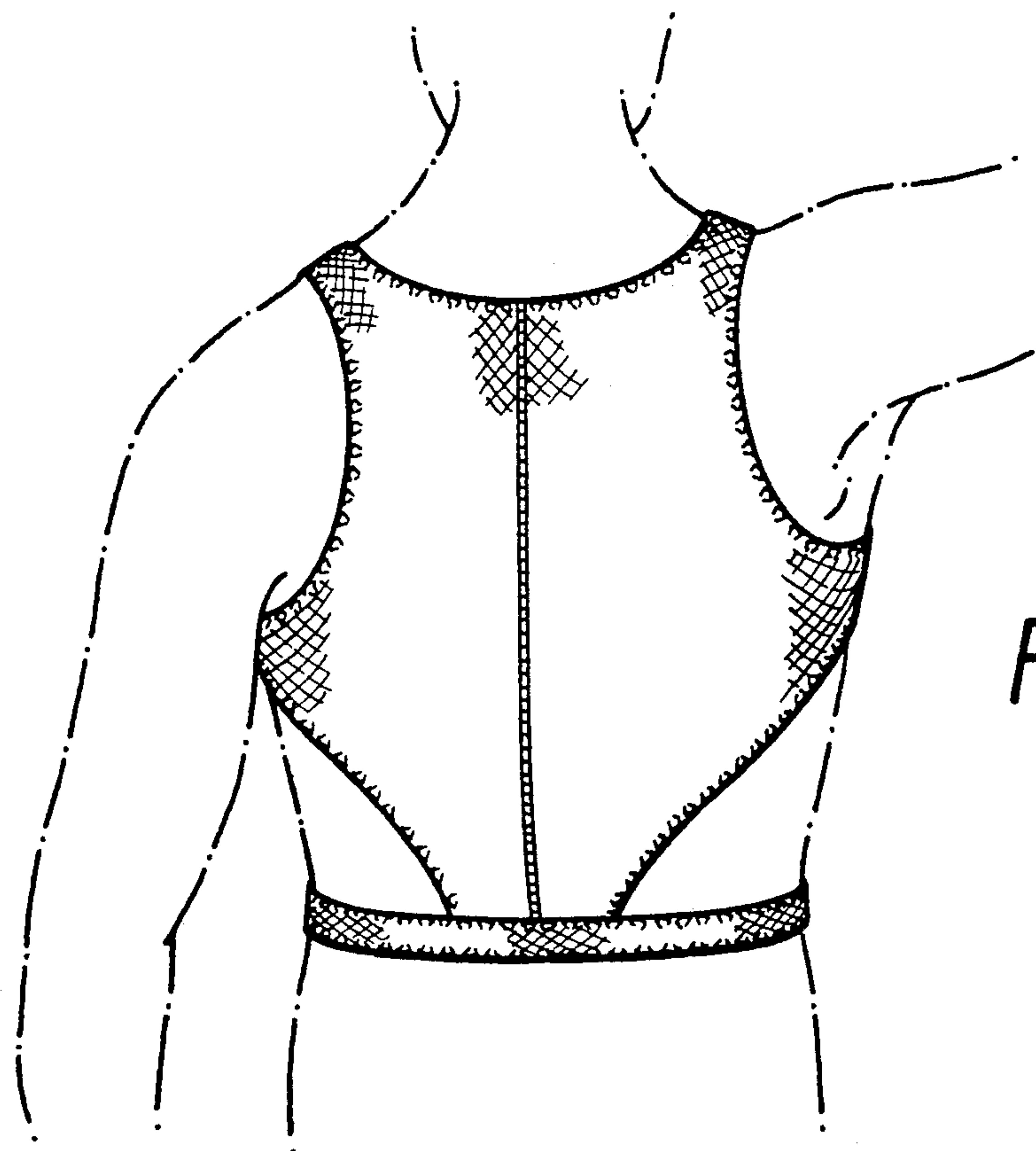
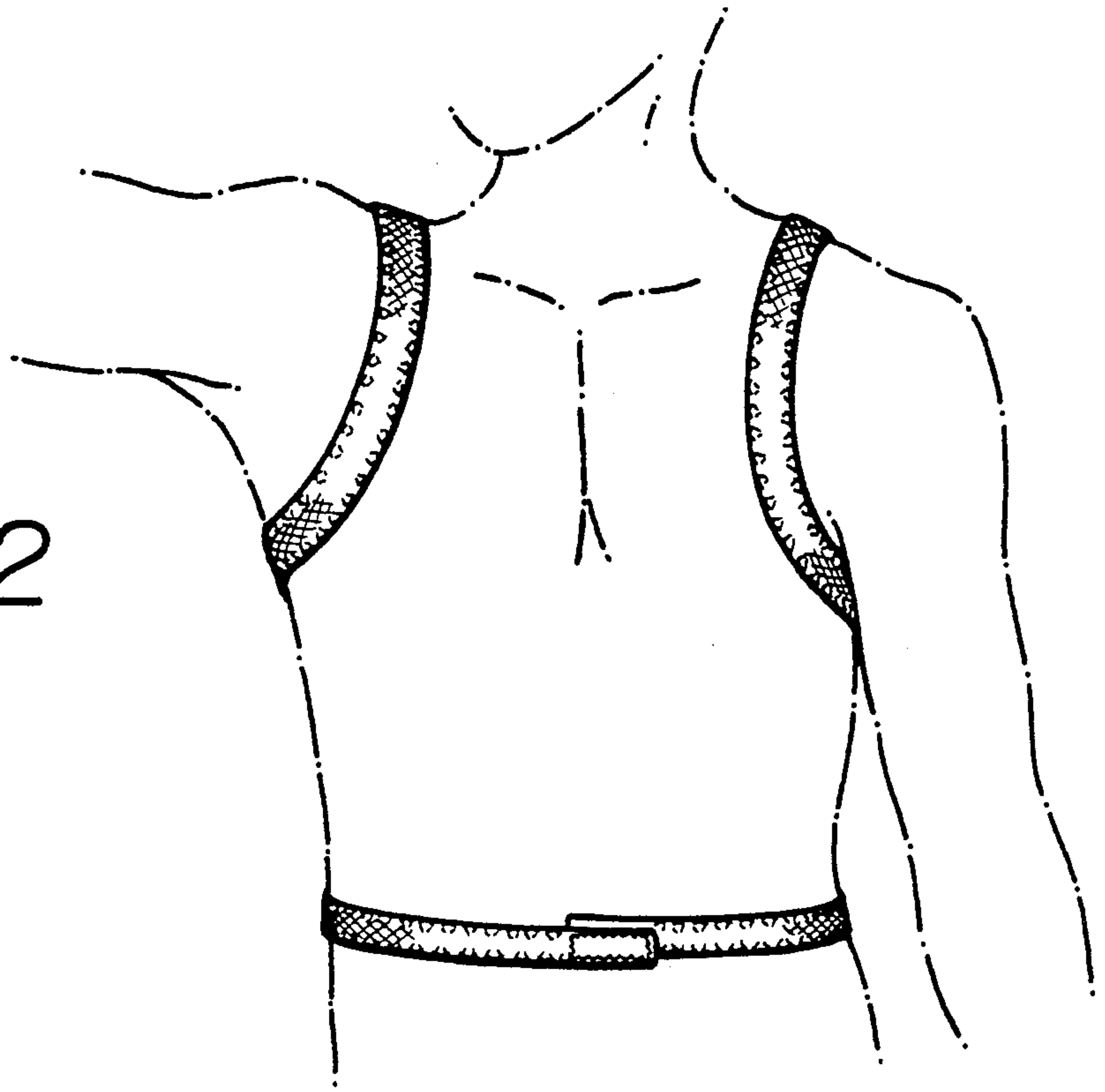
