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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a surface of an eyelet stay for a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a first surface of an eyelet stay for a shoe upper showing our new design;

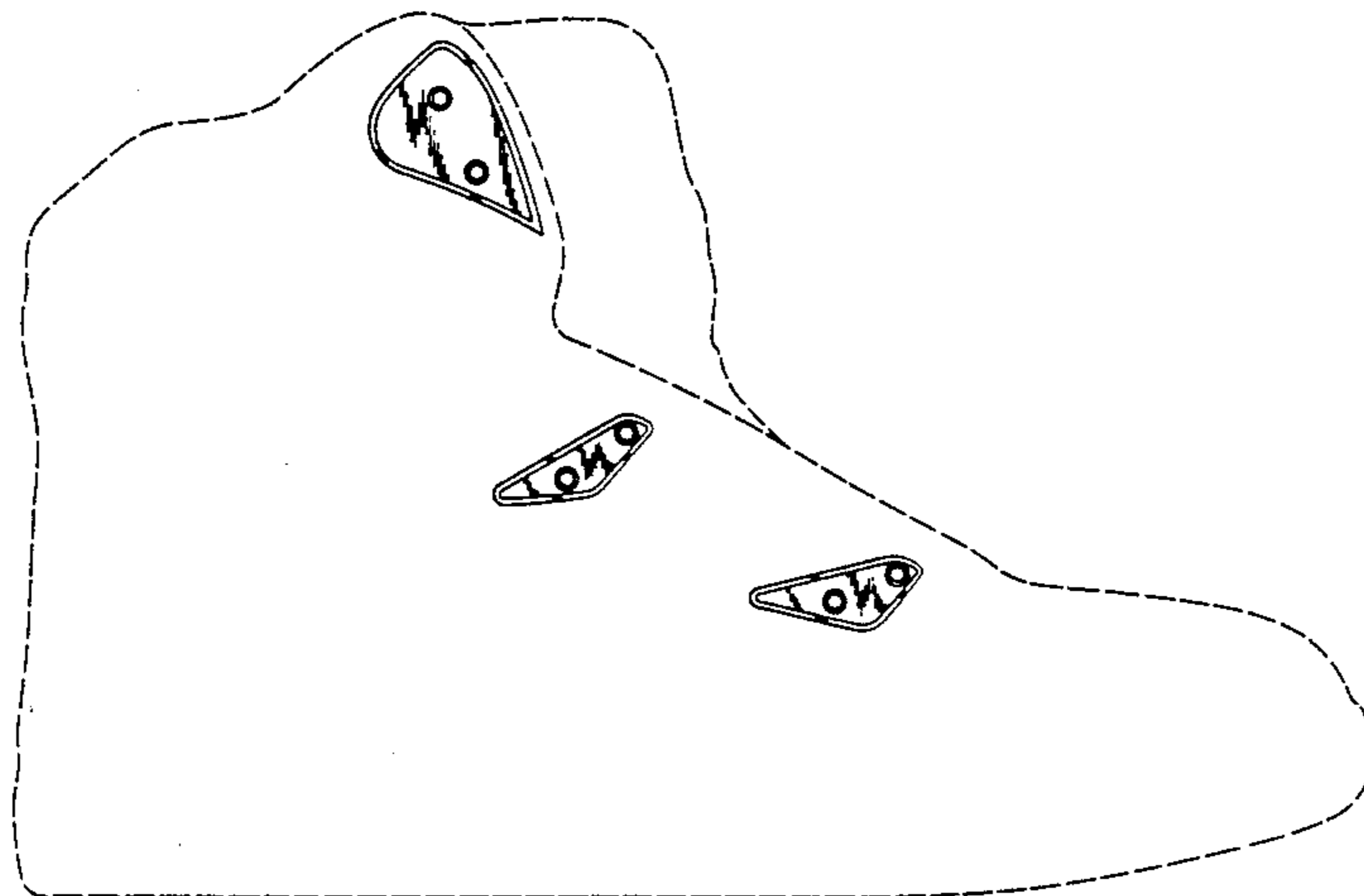
FIG. 2 is a second side elevational view of the opposite side from that shown in FIG. 1 and showing a second surface of the eyelet stay for a shoe upper;

FIG. 3 is a cross-section taken generally along lines 3-3 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a cross-section taken generally along lines 4-4 of FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 5 is a cross-section taken generally along lines 5-5 of FIG. 2.

The broken line showing of a shoe upper in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The cross-section Figures illustrate the surface of the eyelet stay for a shoe upper only in the cross sectional planes, and it being understood that there is a like cross-section with respect to FIG. 1.



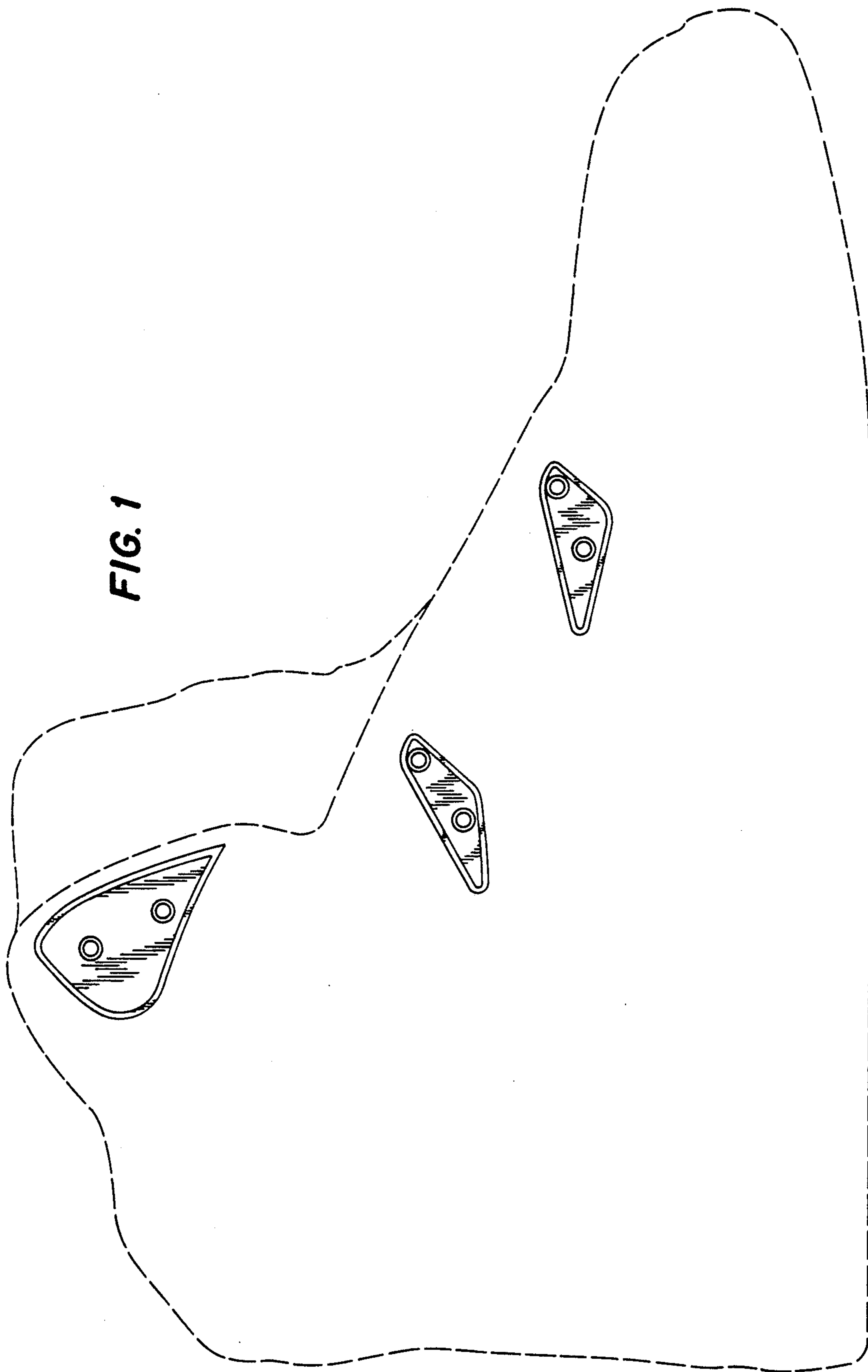
