FIG. 8 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof, with the shield in an opened position.

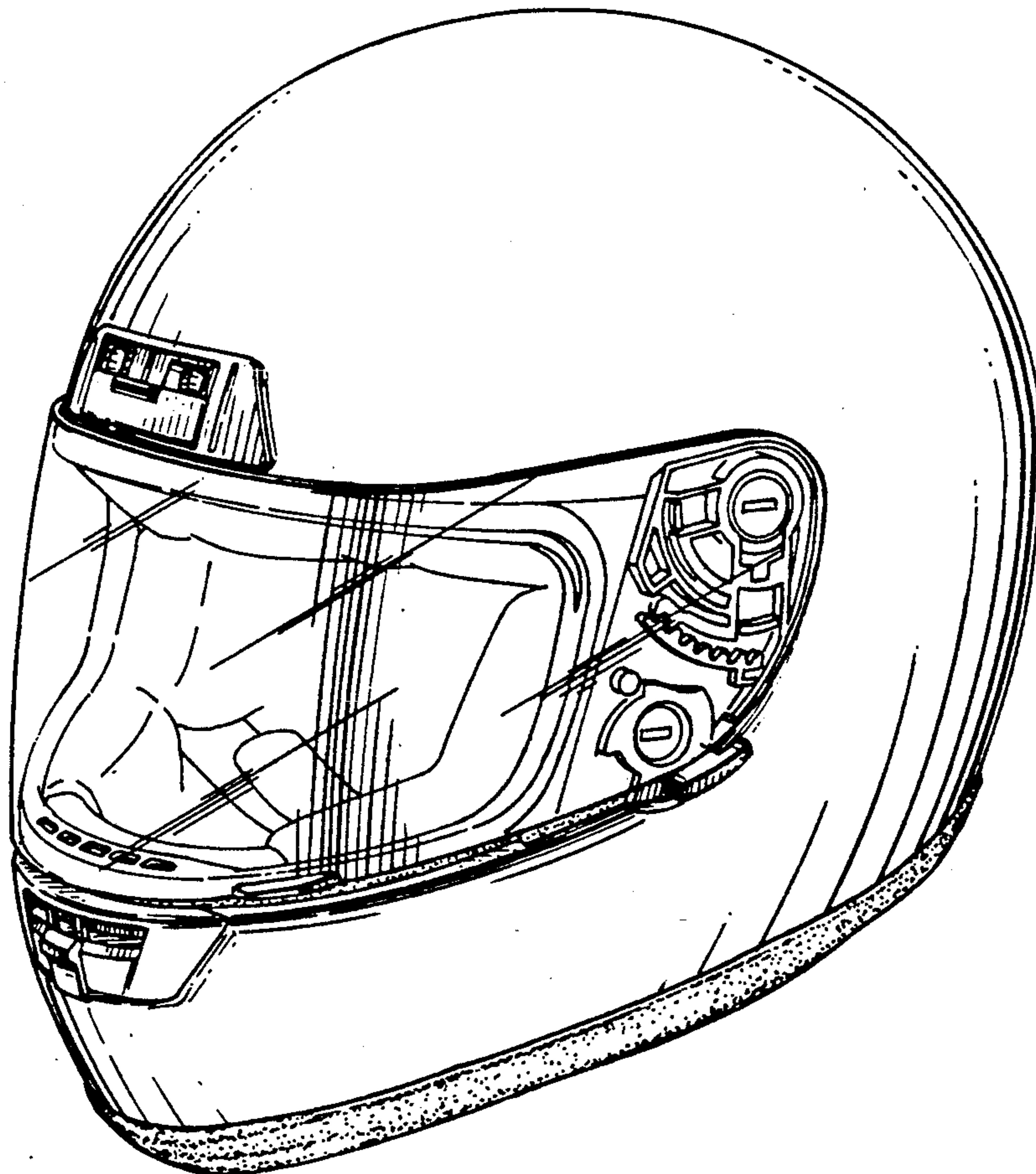

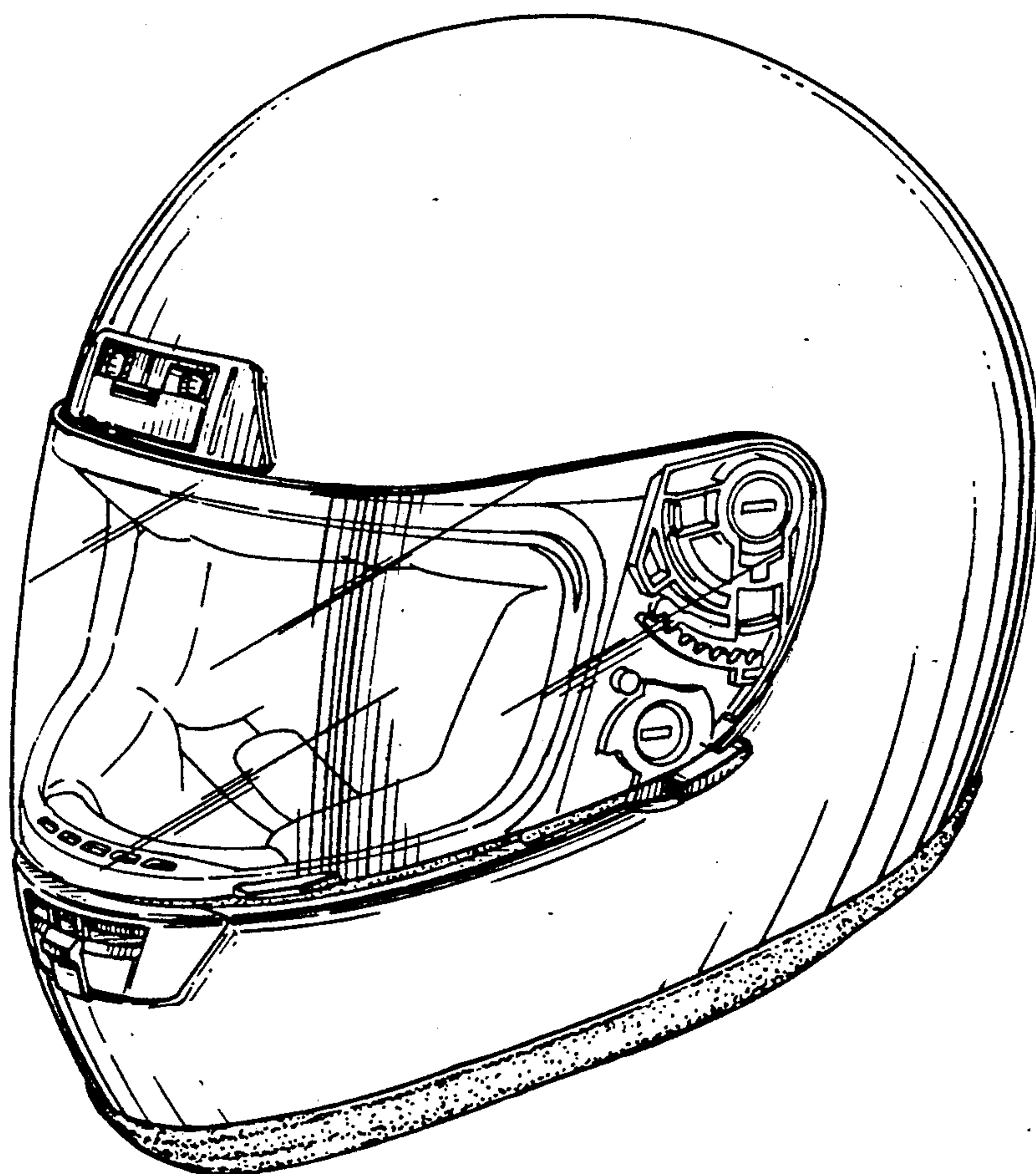

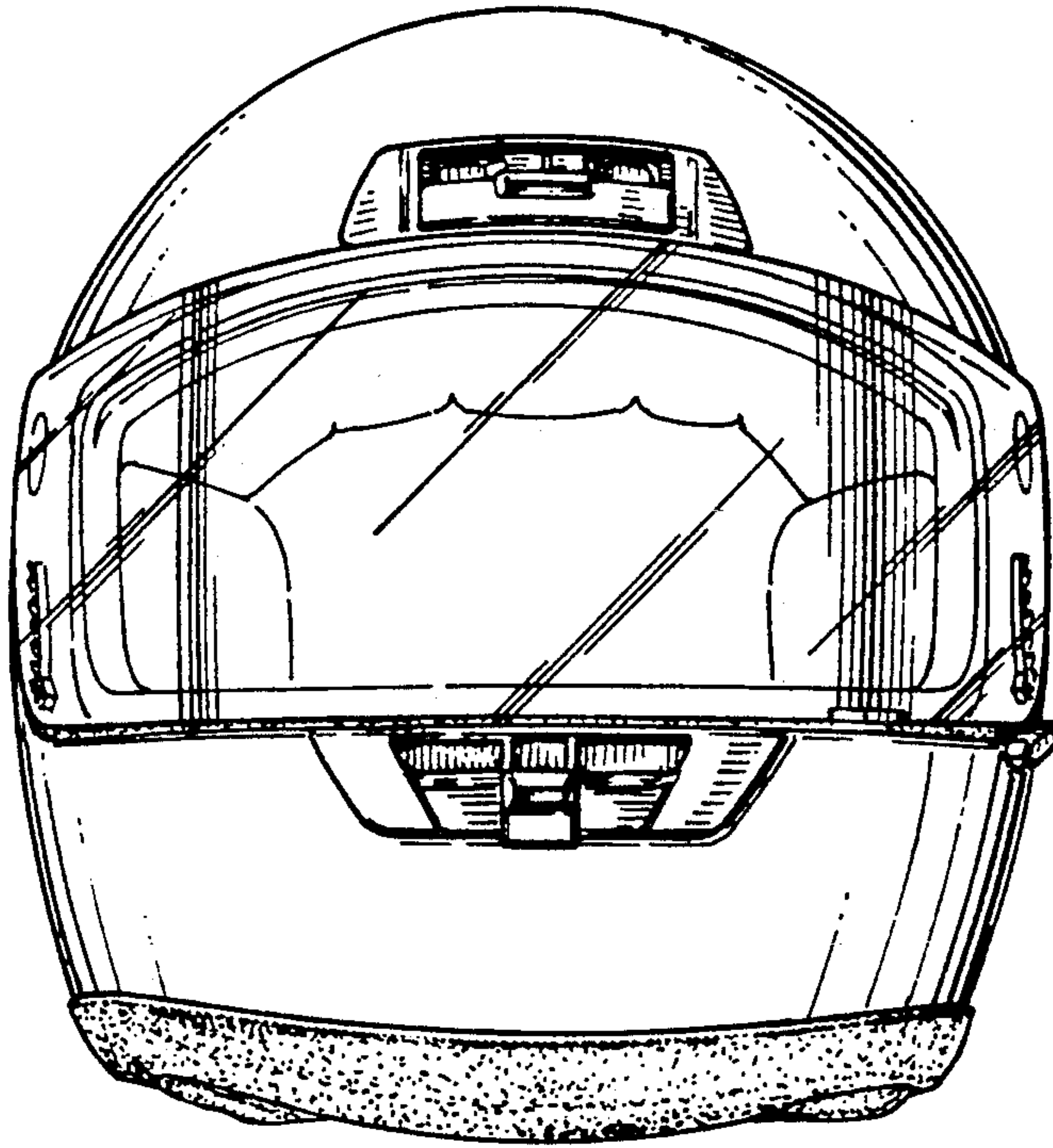

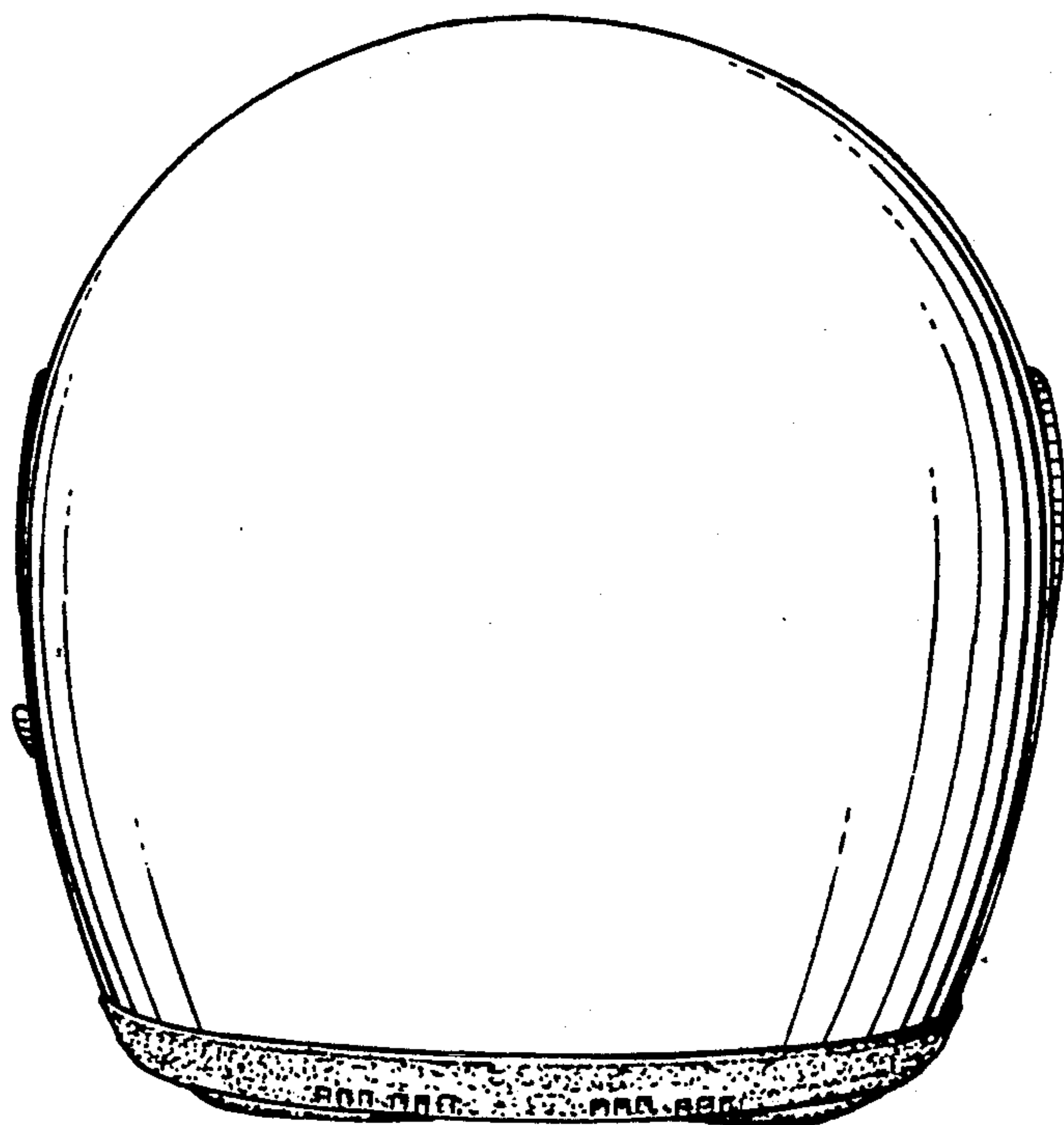

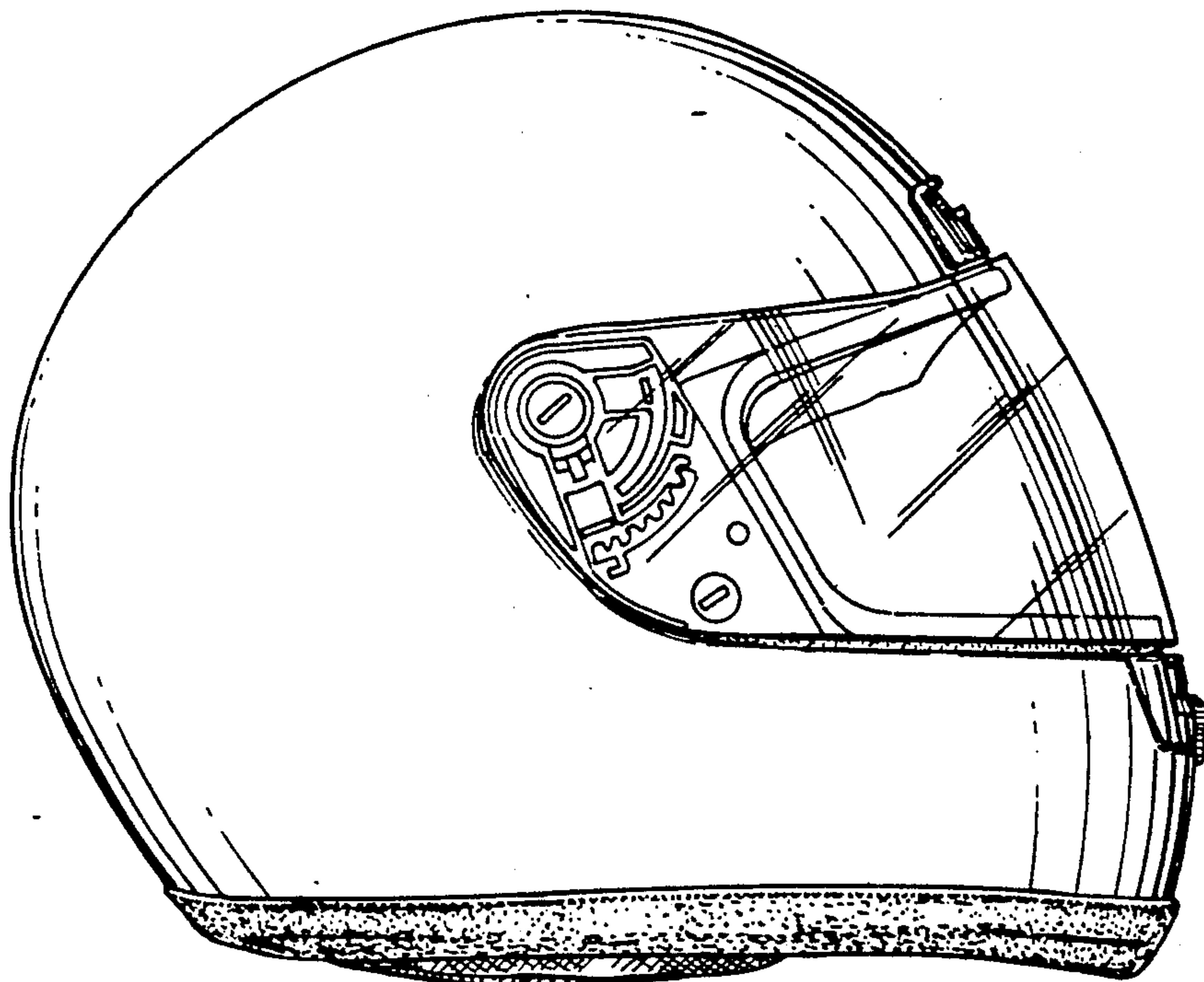

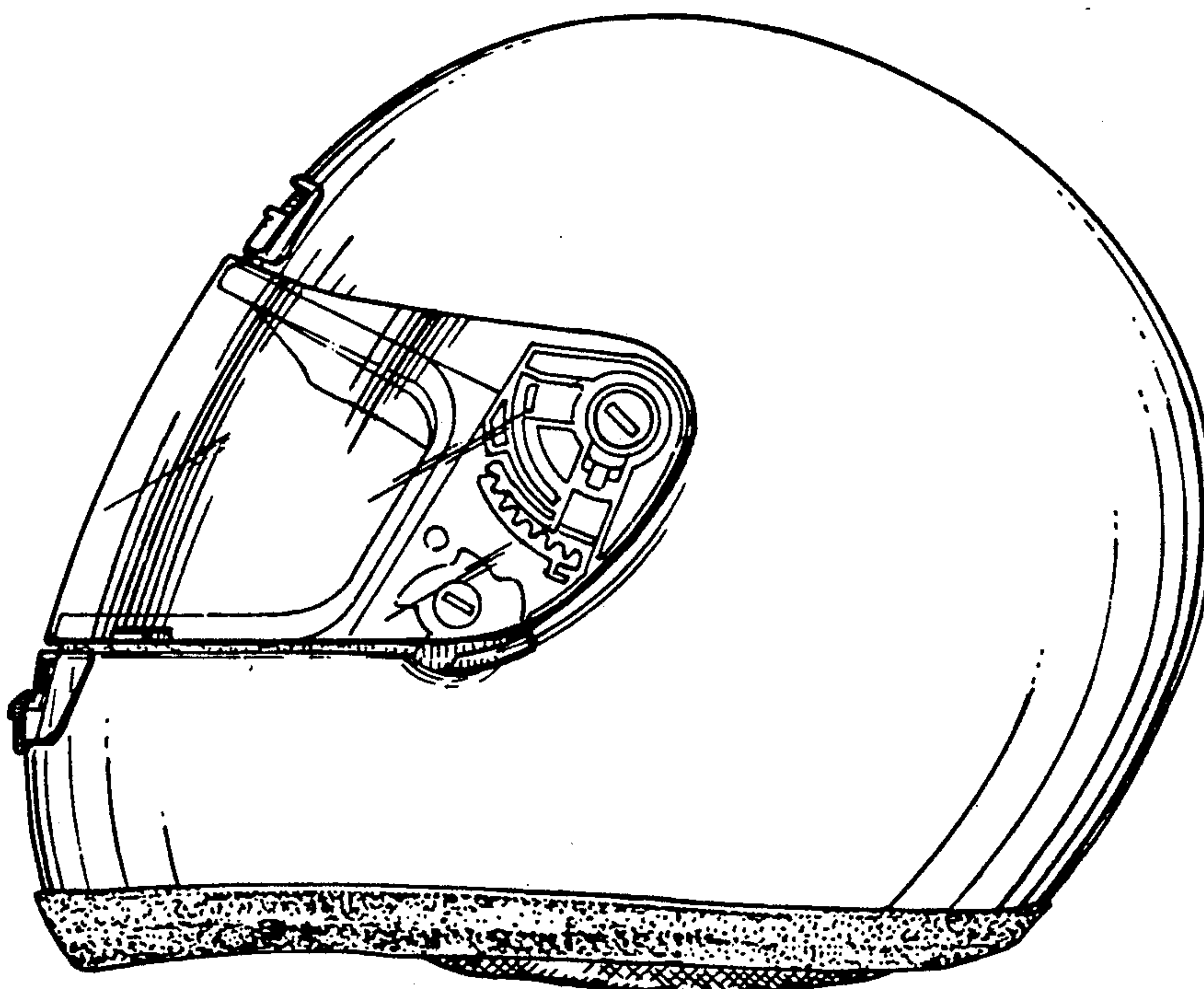

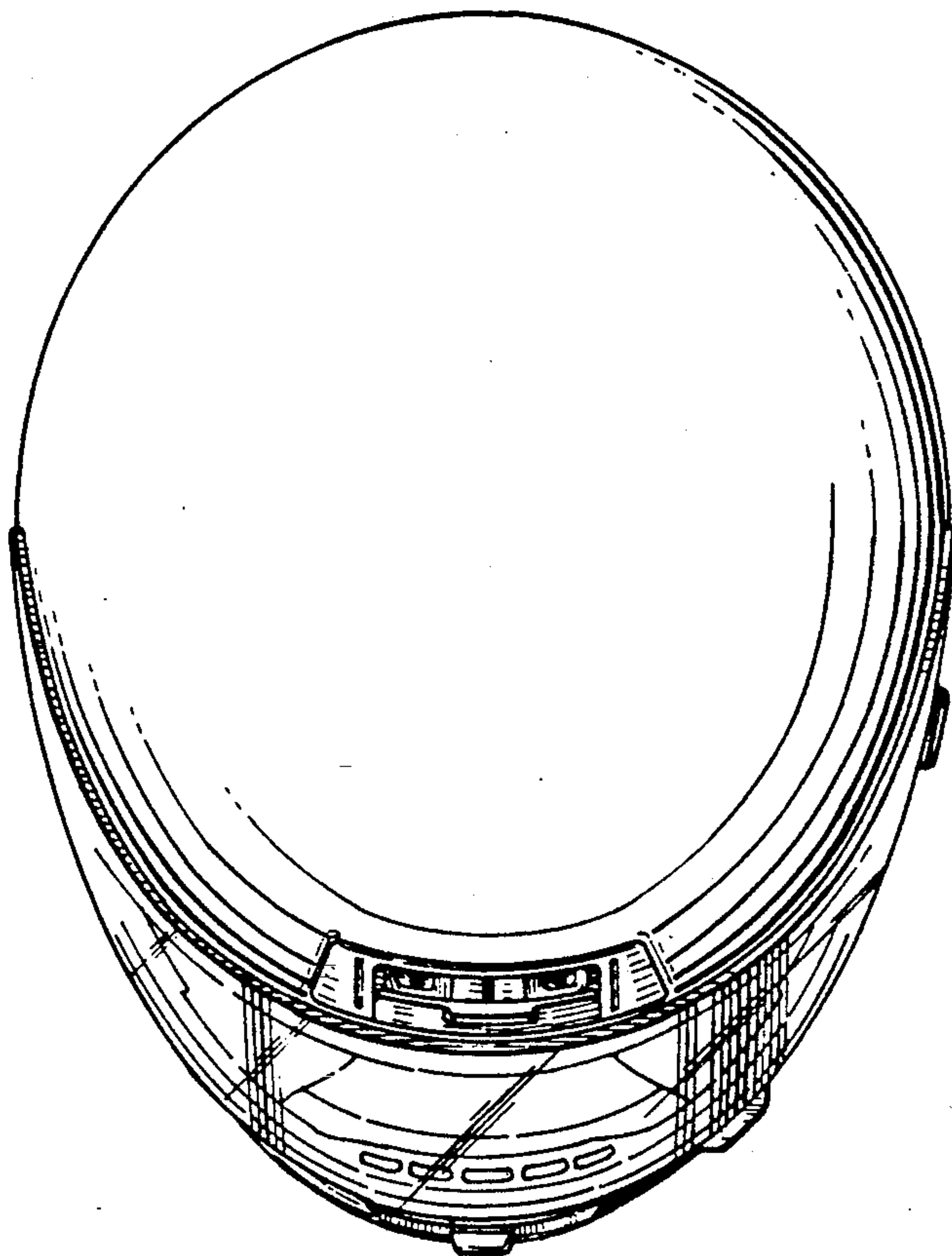

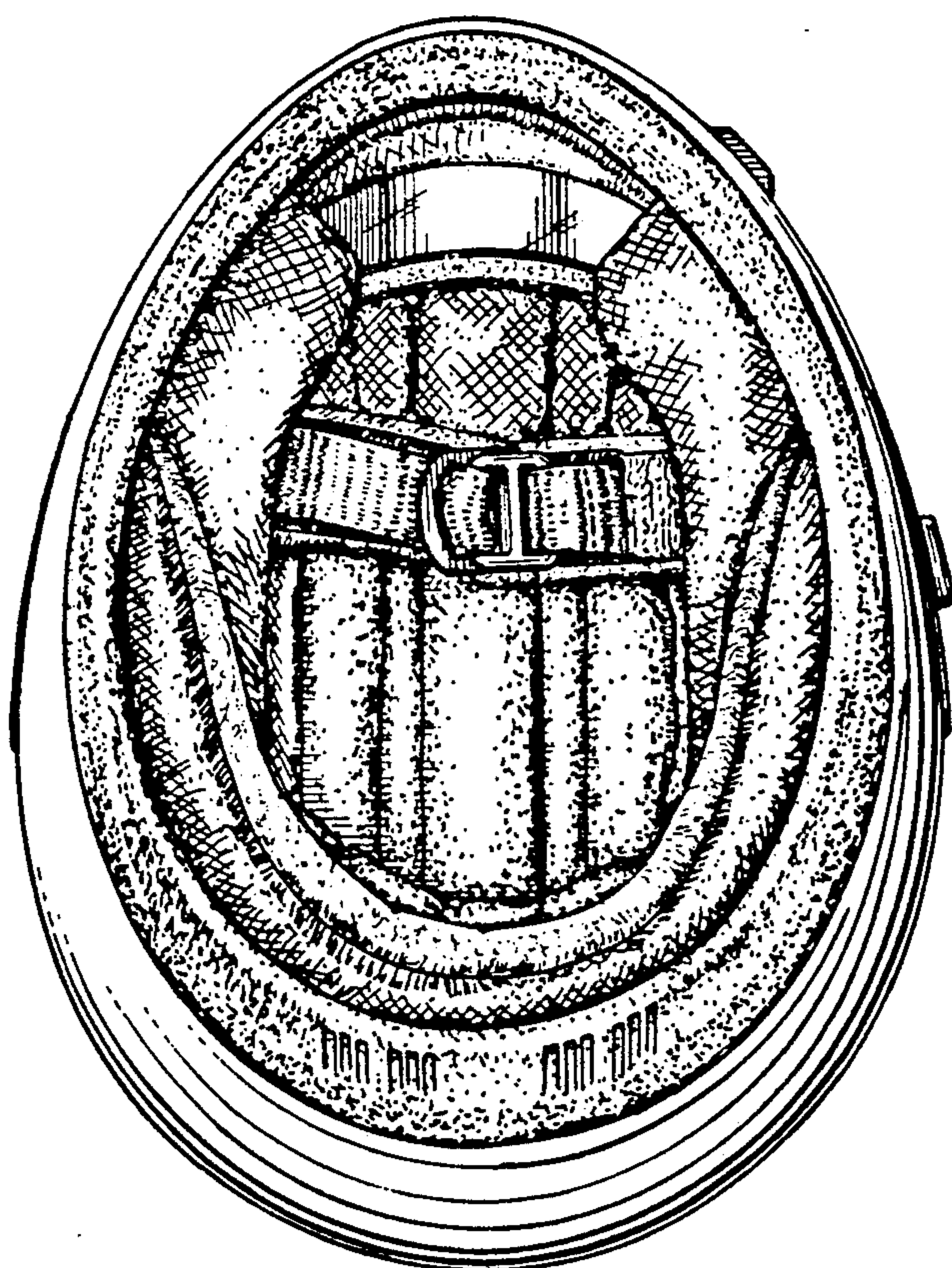
