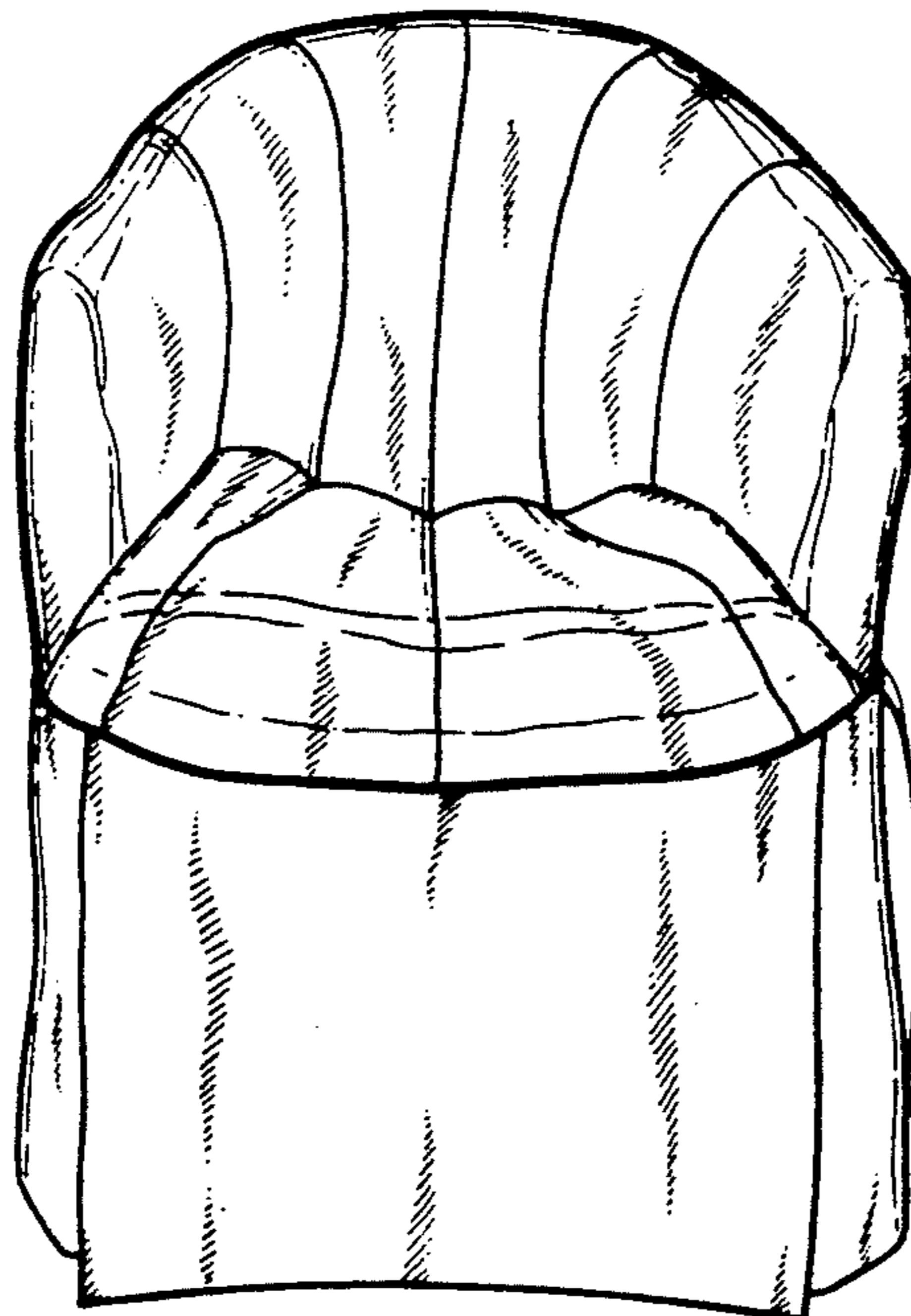

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a furniture cover, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a furniture cover, showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left side perspective view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown;  
FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of a furniture cover showing a second embodiment of my new design;  
FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view of FIG. 4;  
FIG. 6 is a right side perspective view of FIG. 4, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown;  
FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a furniture cover showing a third embodiment of my new design;  
FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view of FIG. 7;  
FIG. 9 is a left side perspective view of FIG. 7, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown;  
FIG. 10 is a front perspective view of a furniture cover showing a fourth embodiment of my new design;  
FIG. 11 is a left side perspective view of FIG. 10, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown; and, FIG. 12 is a rear perspective view of FIG. 10.



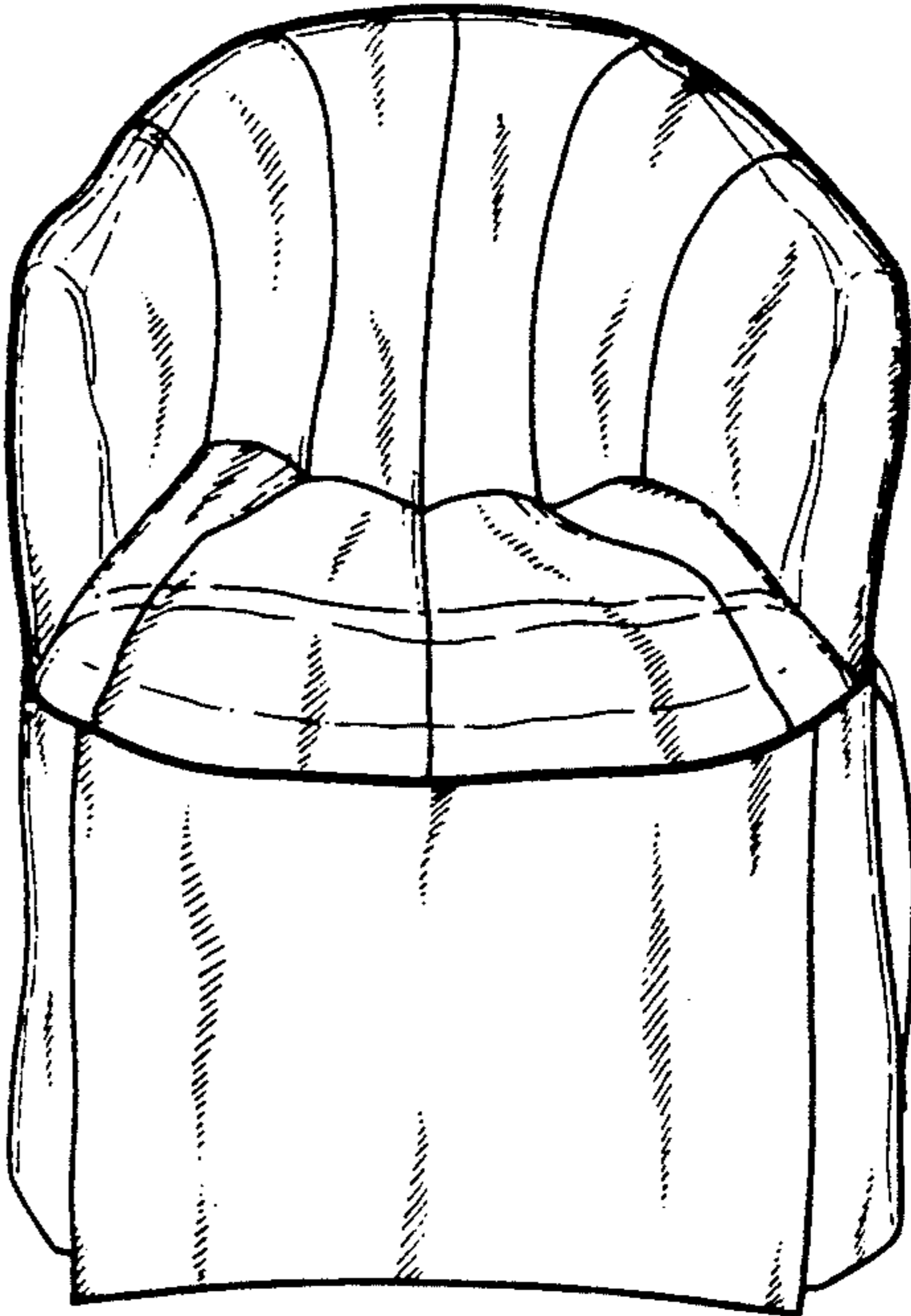

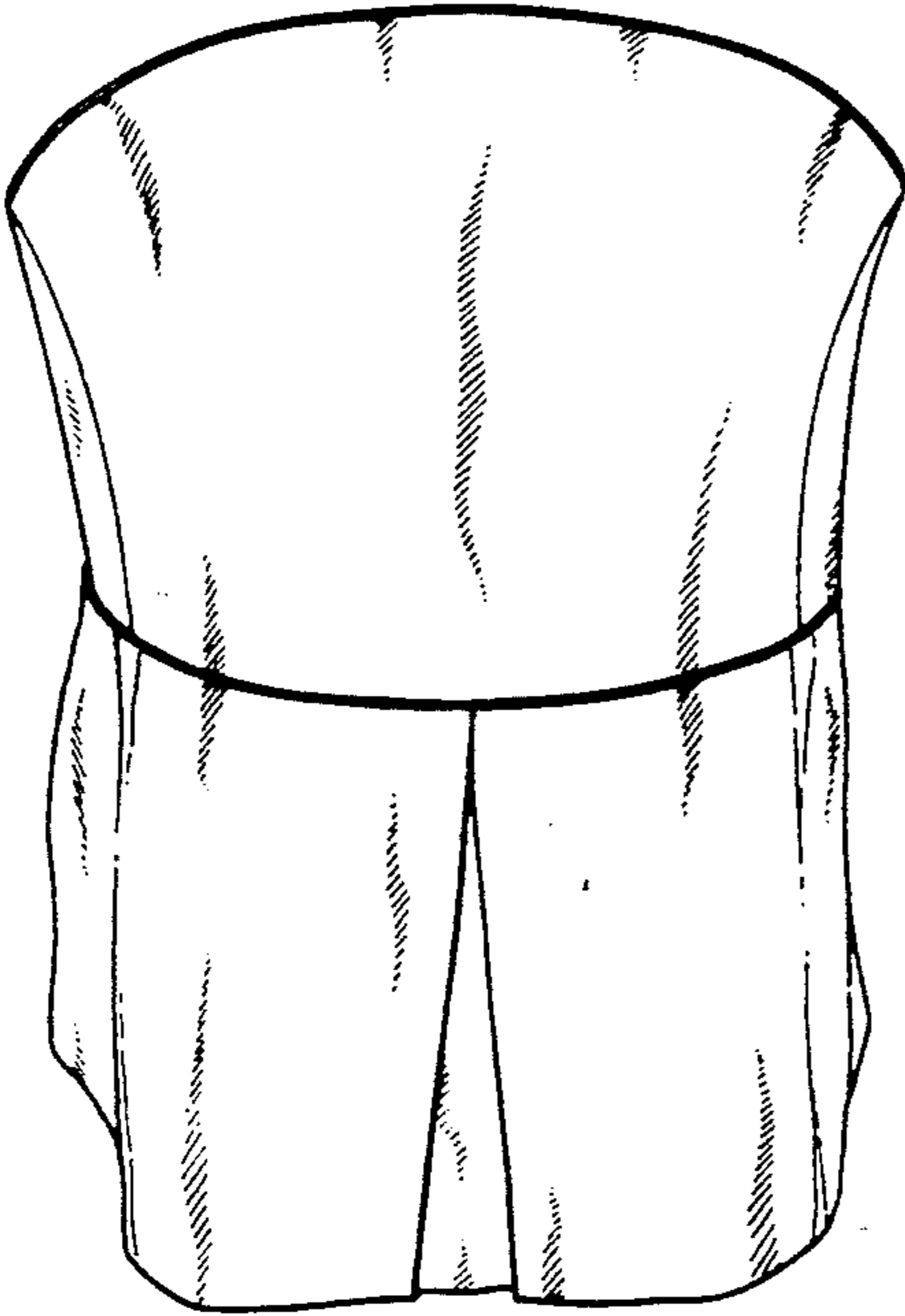

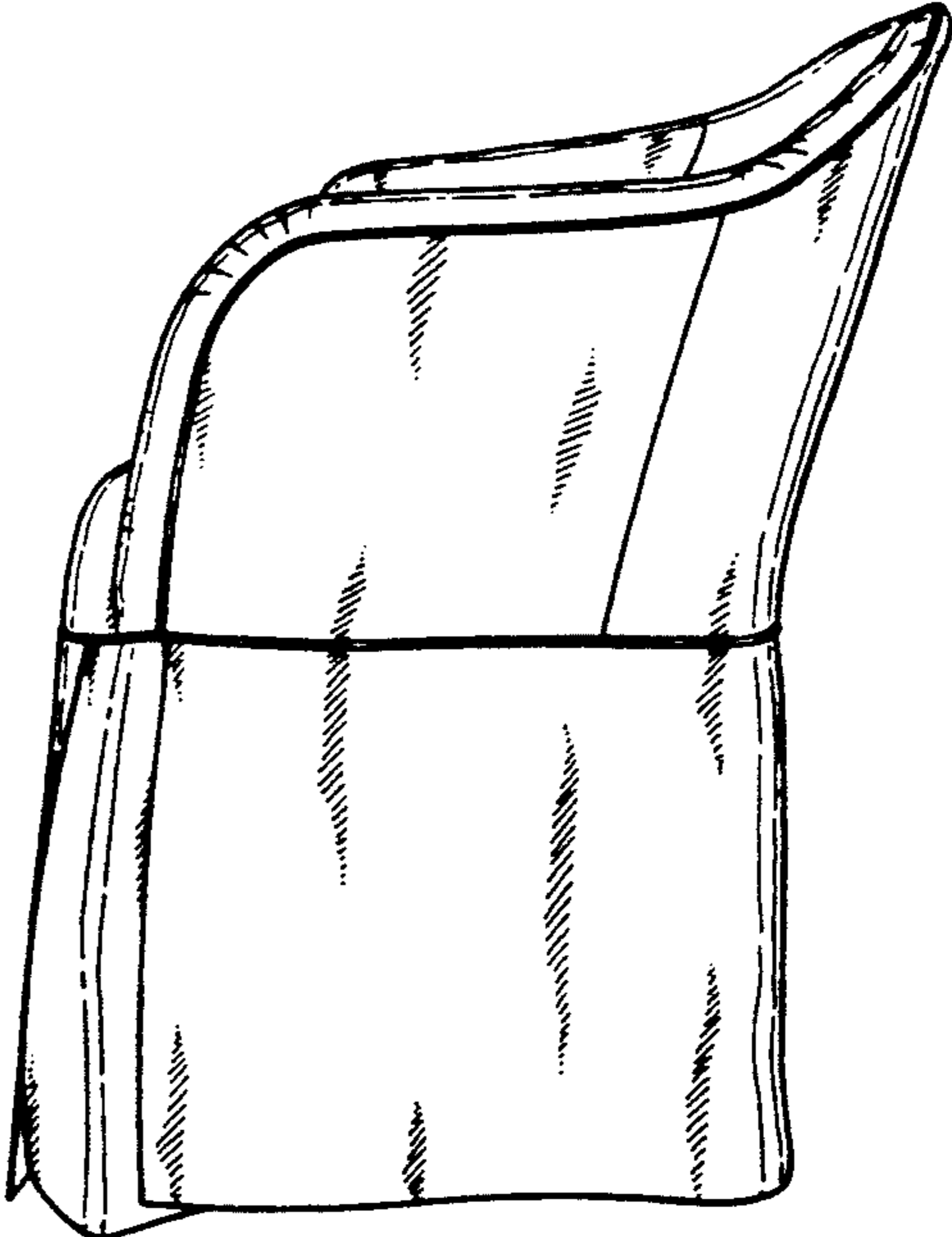

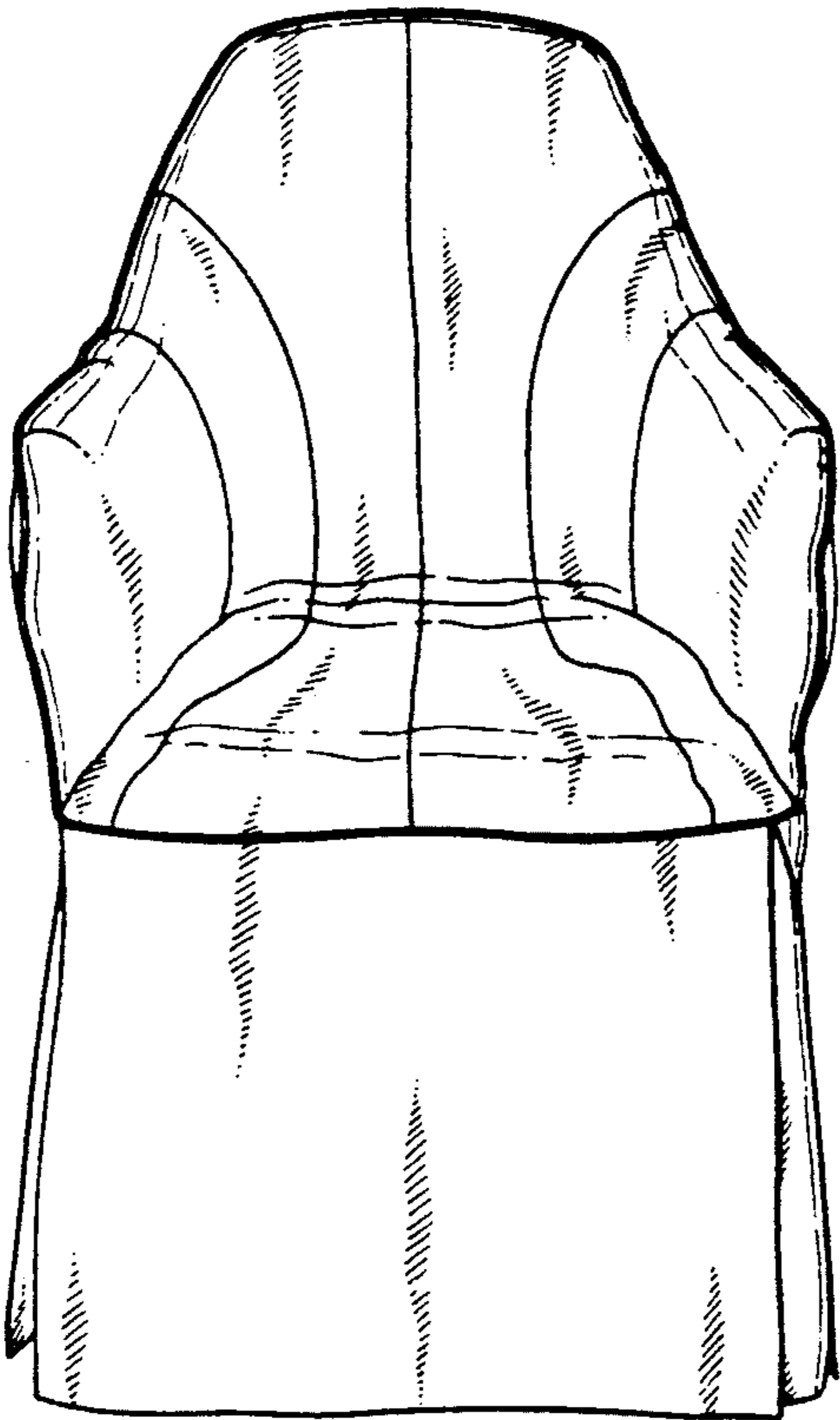

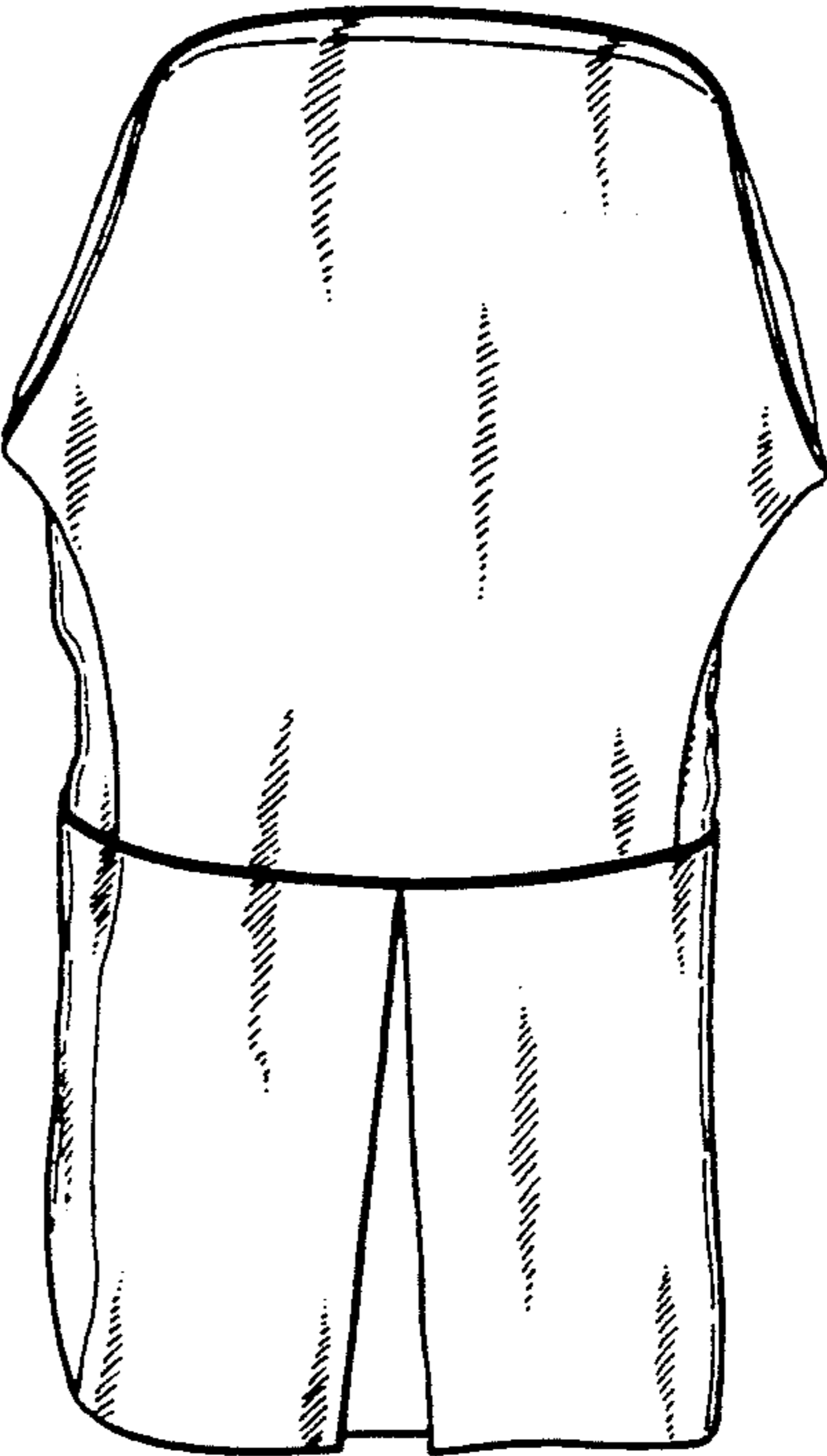

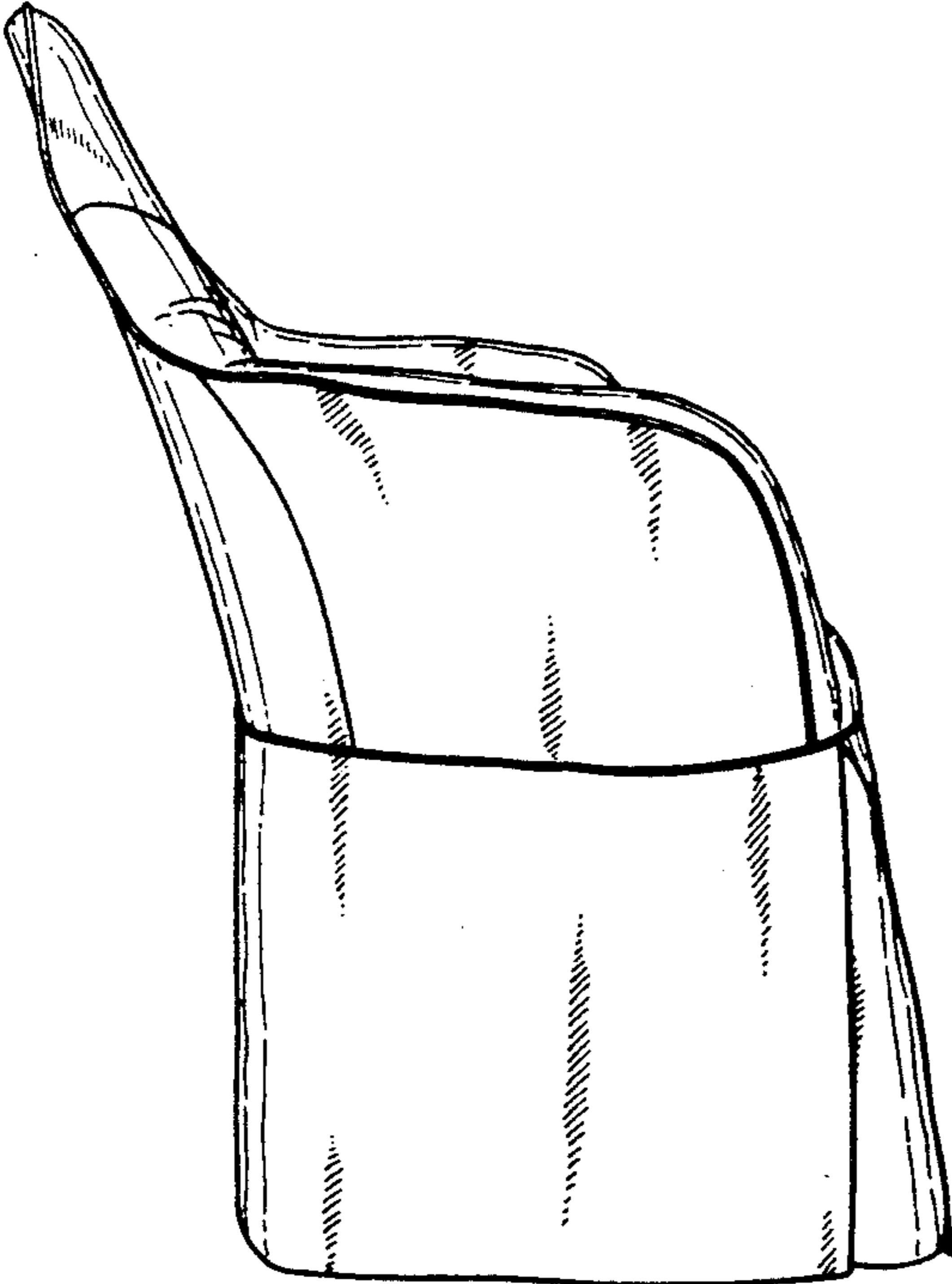

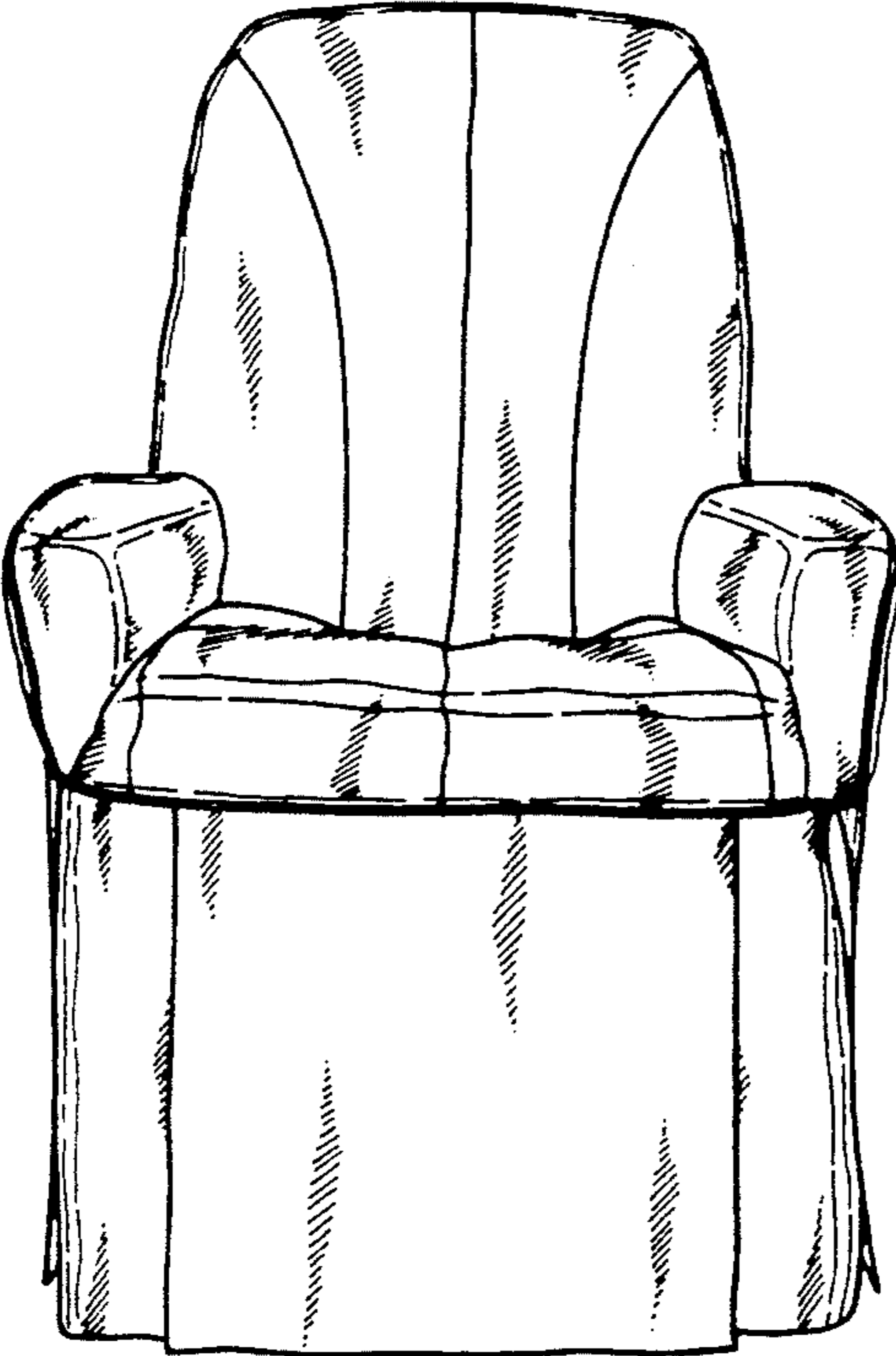

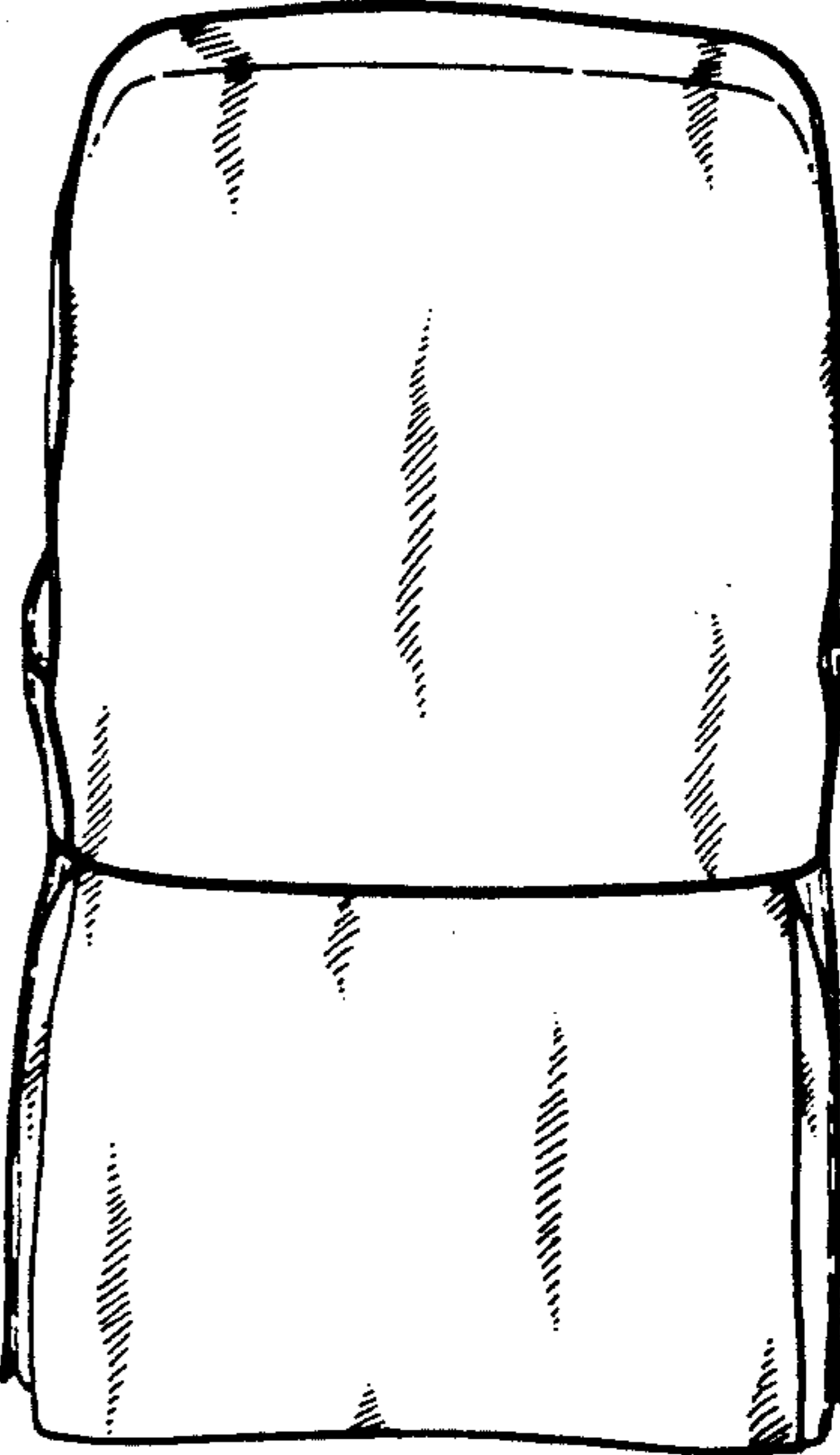

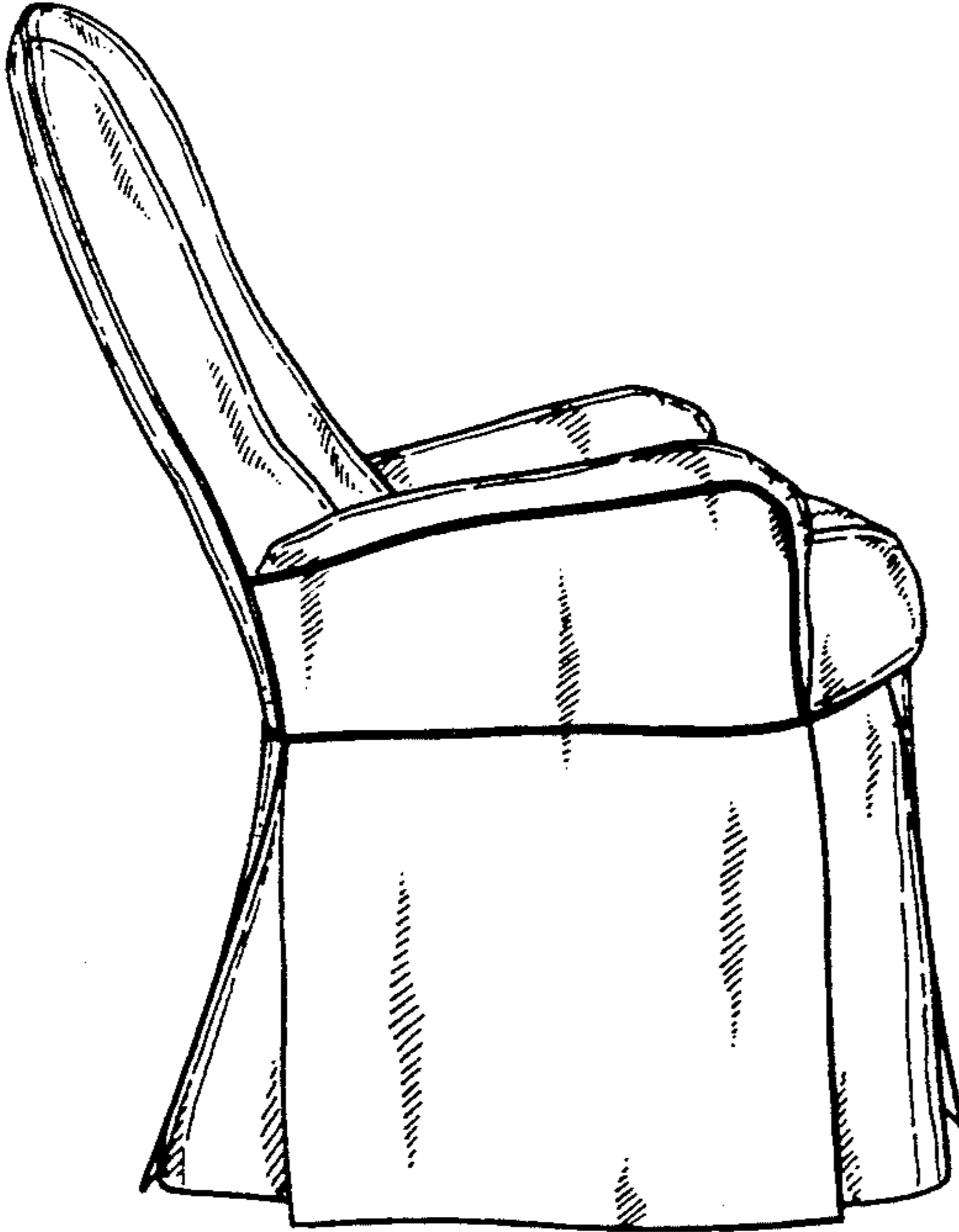

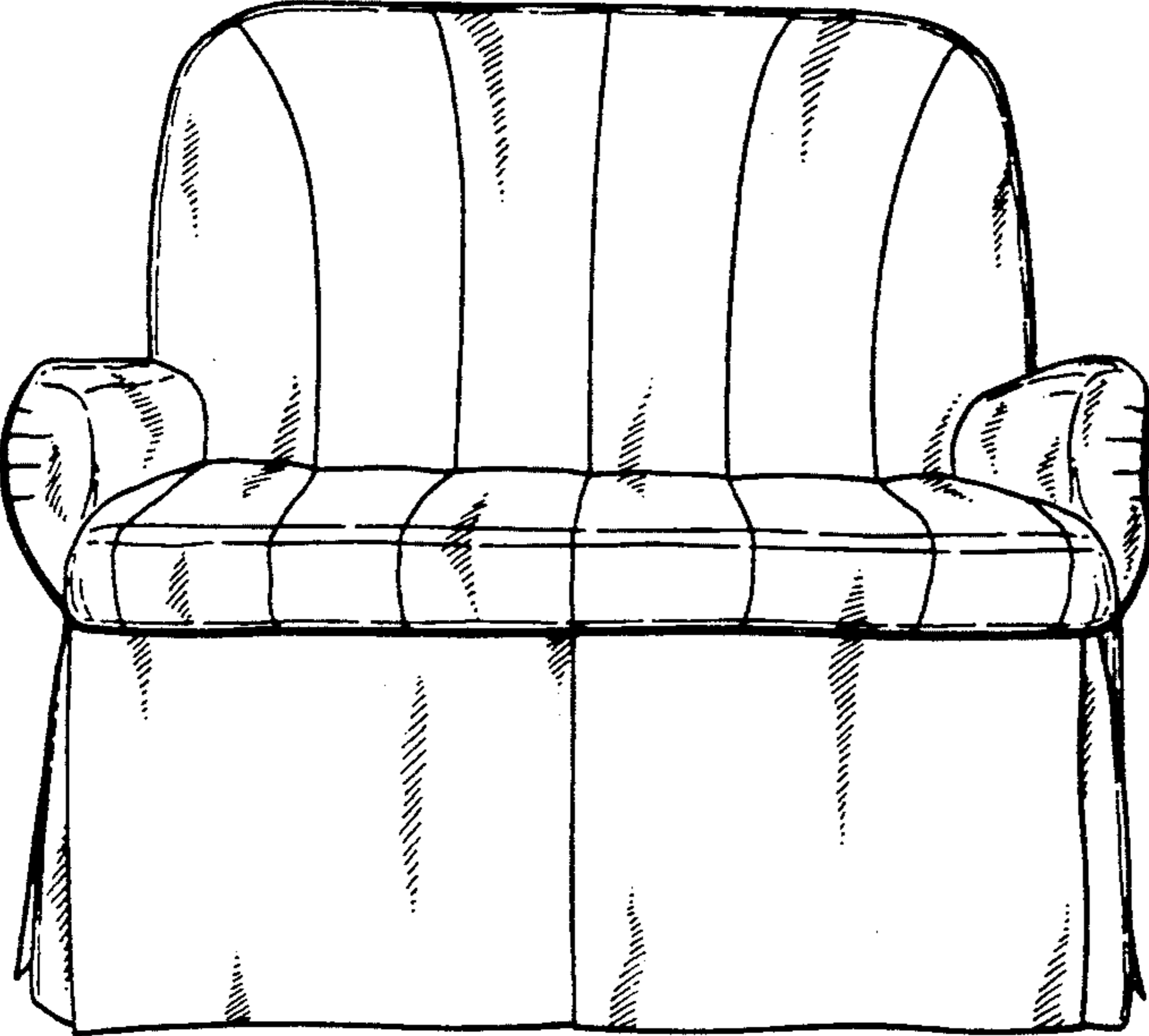

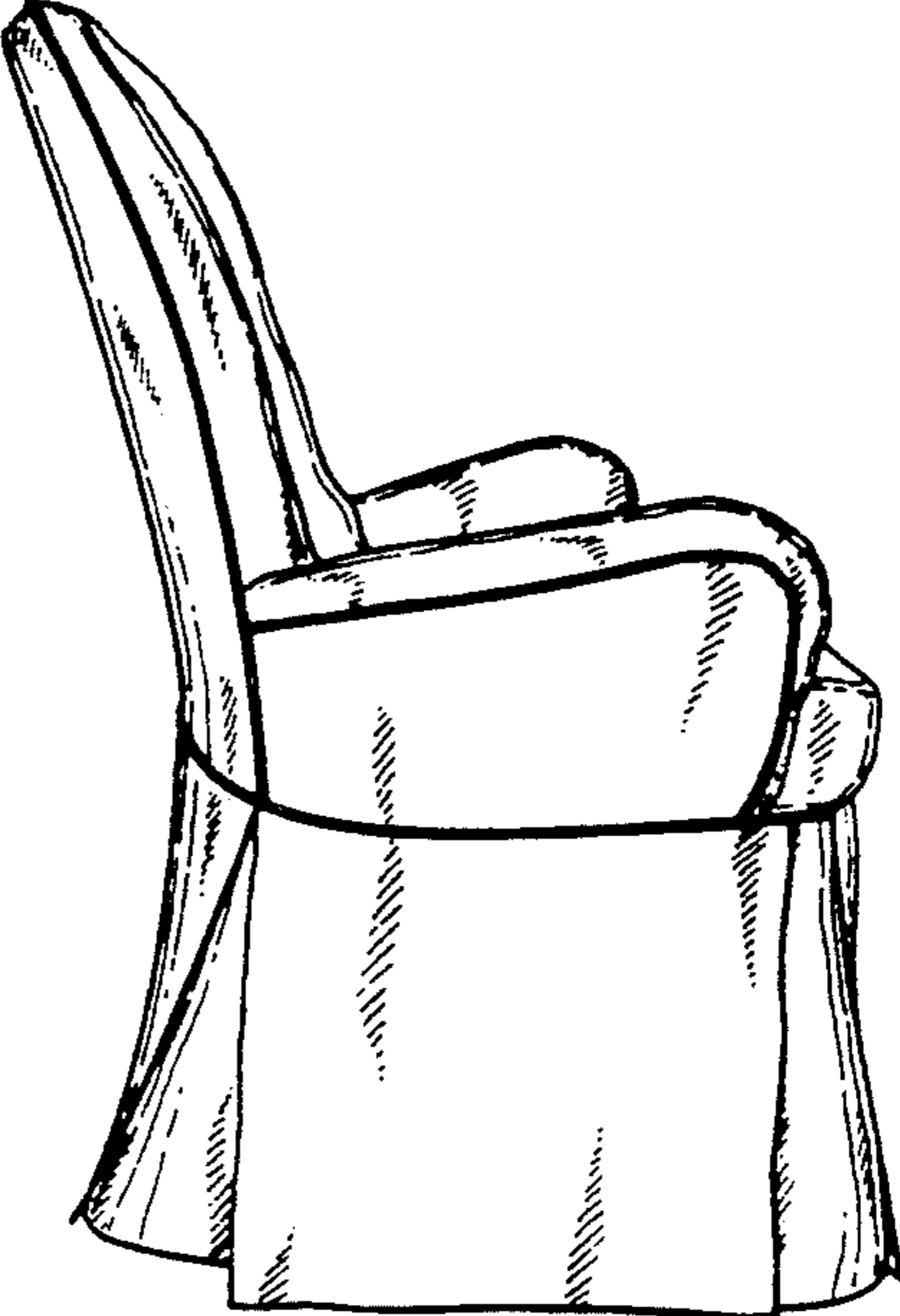

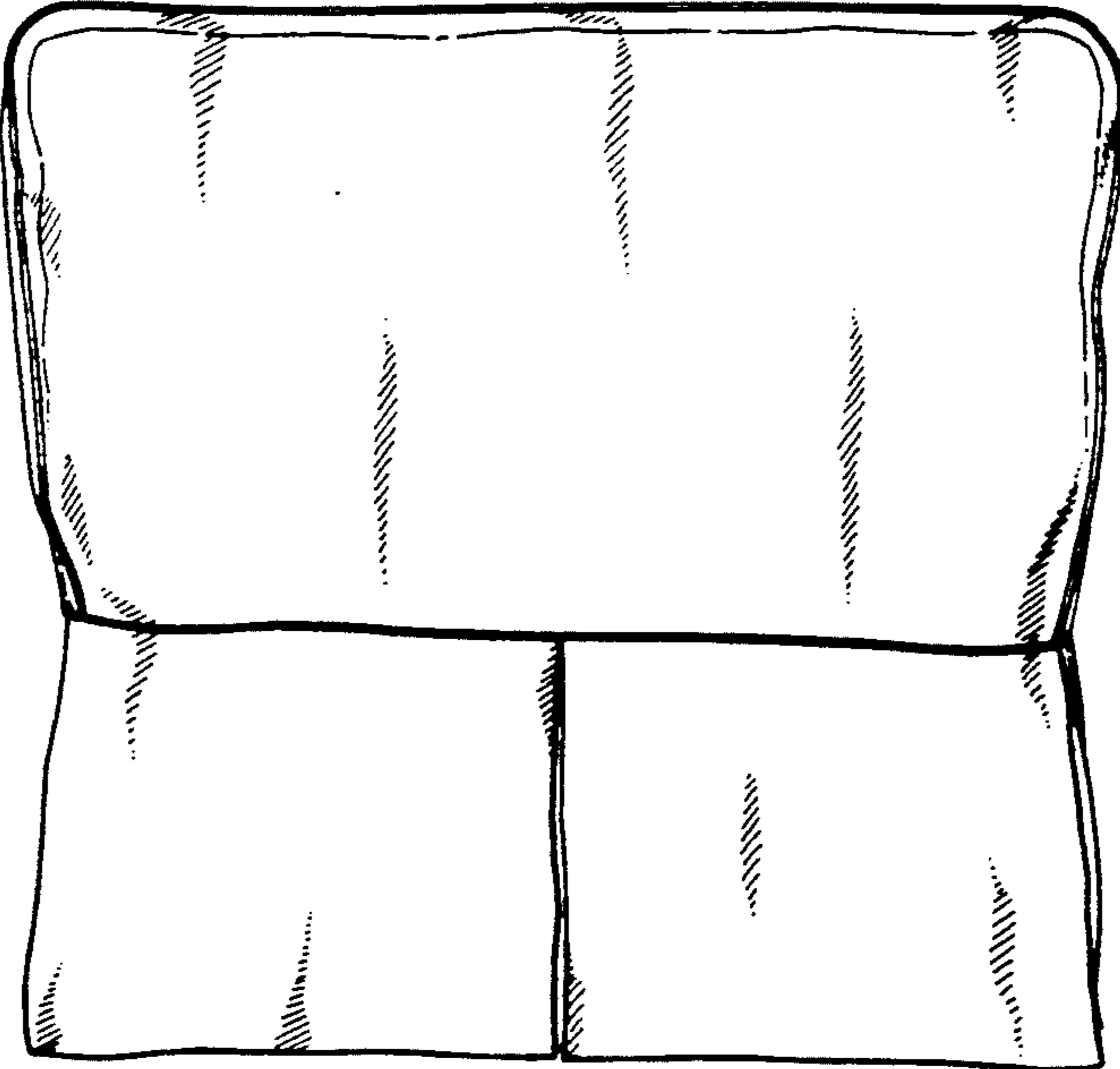
