DESCRIPTION

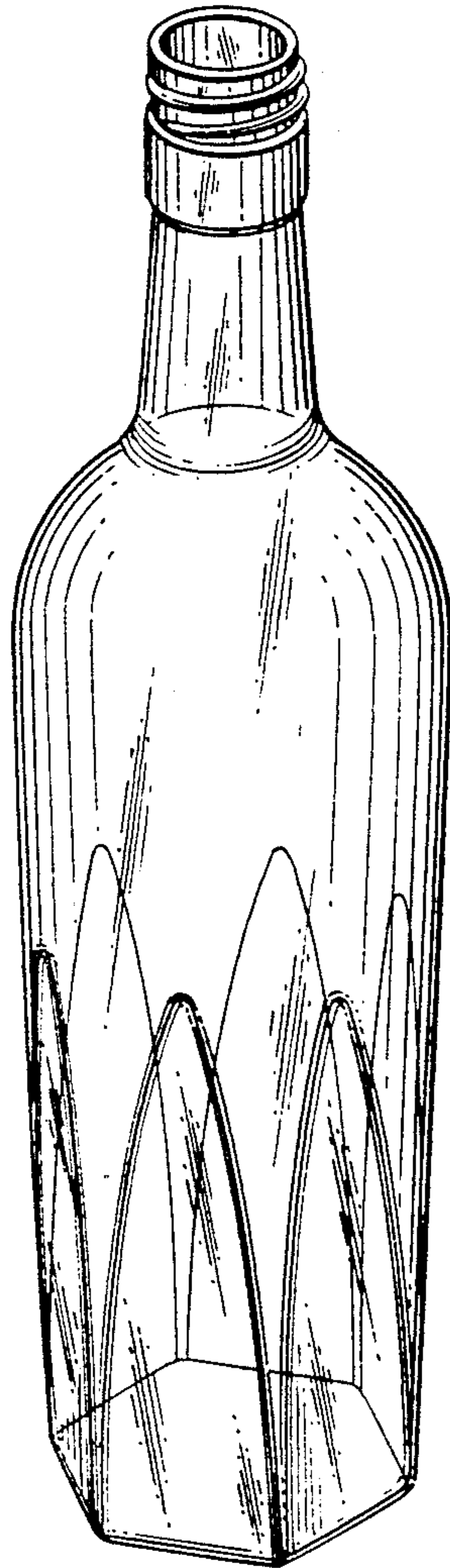
FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a bottle showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



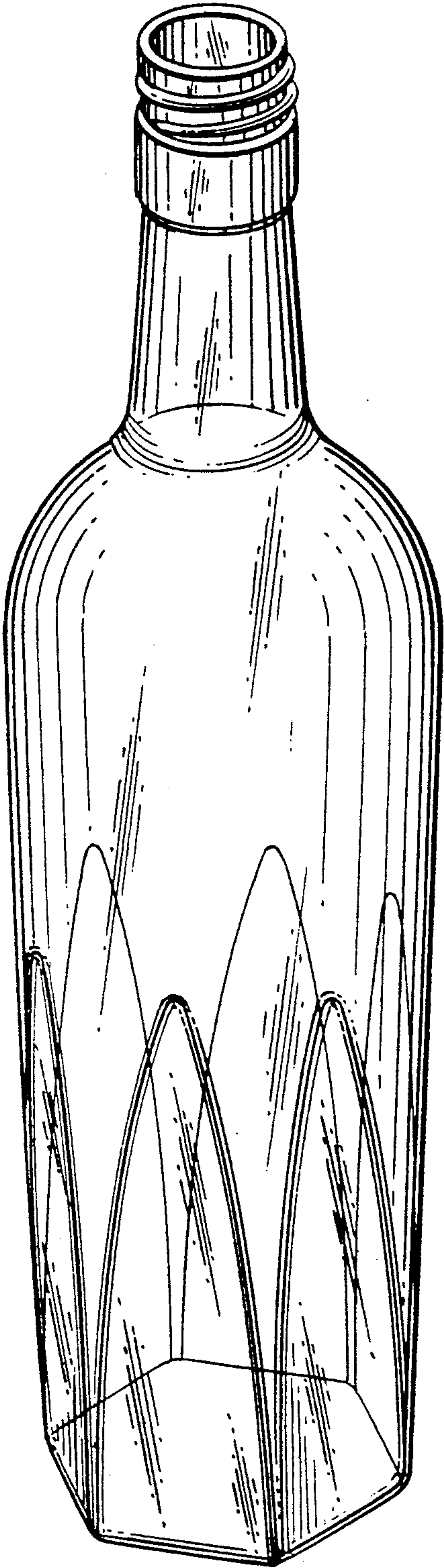

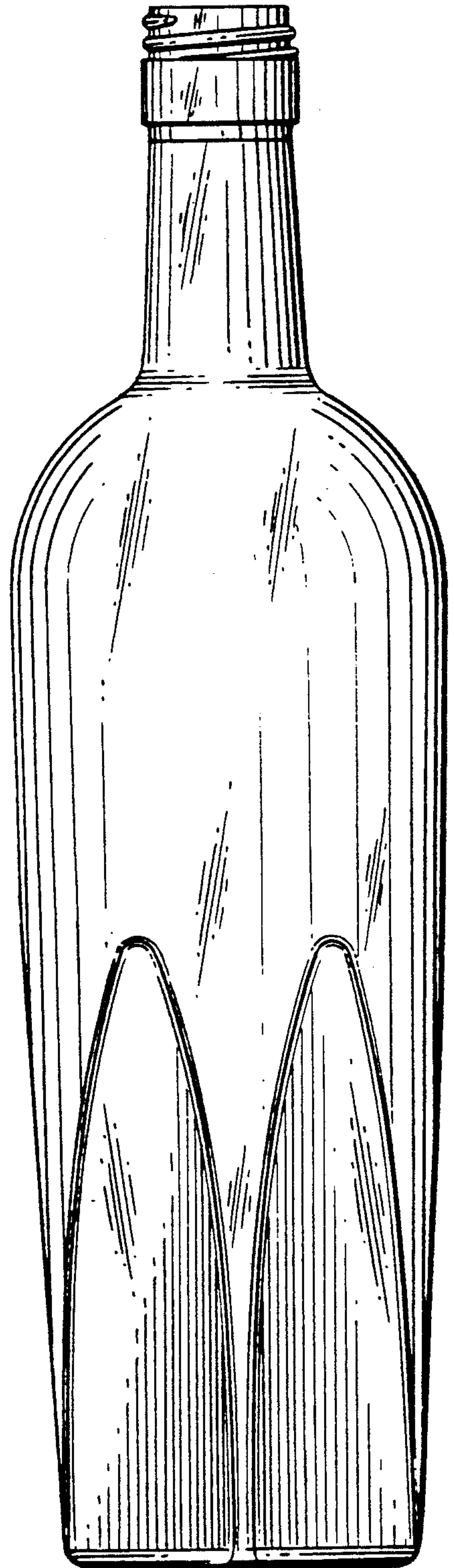

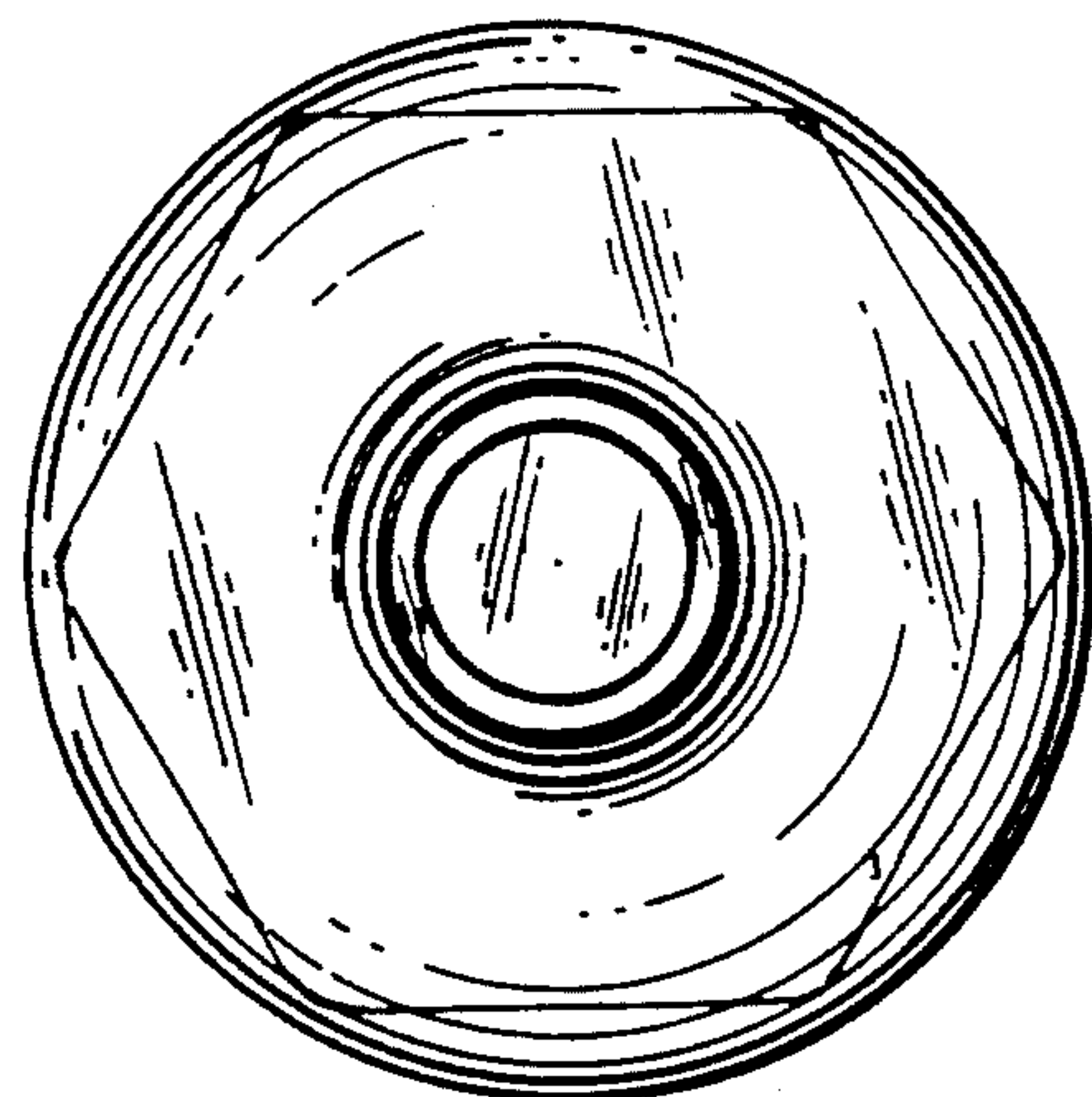
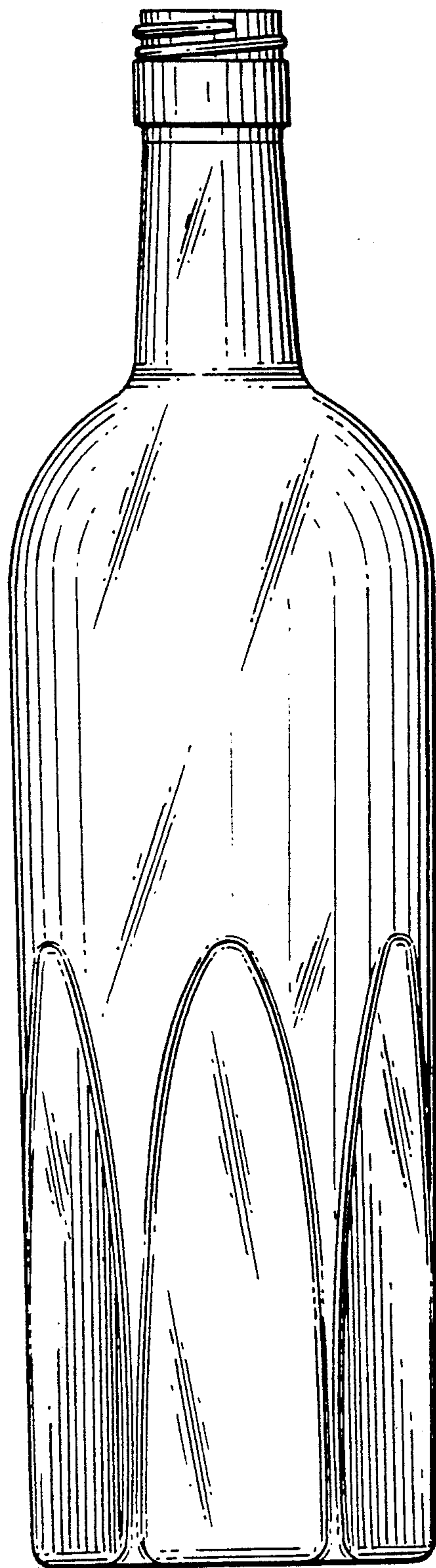

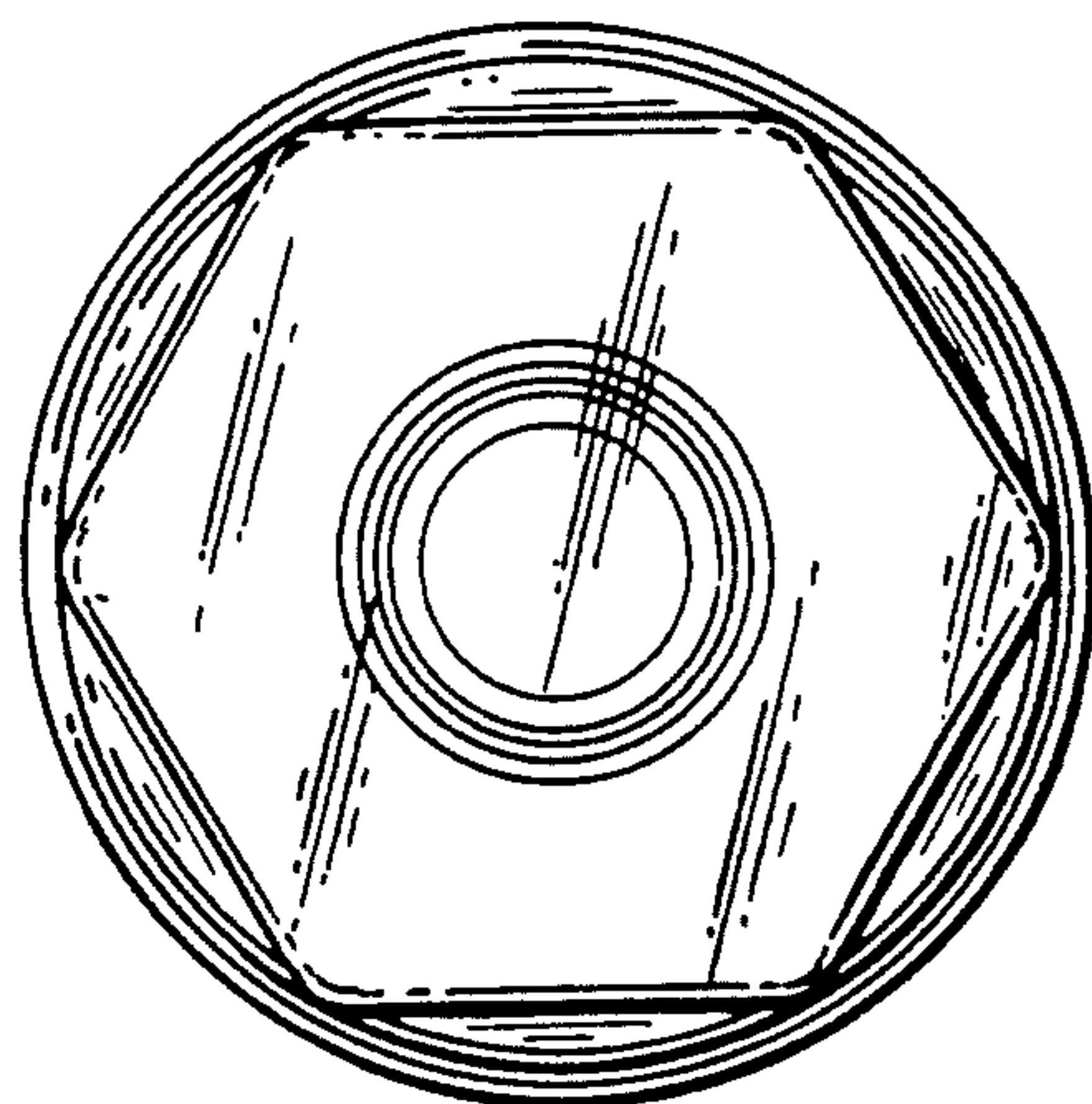
