[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tie tack, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a tie tack showing my new design, the opposite side being plain and unornamented;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a tie tack showing a second embodiment of my new design, the opposite being plain and unornamented;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a bottom side elevational view of FIG. 5; and,

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of FIG. 5.

The broken line showing of a pin is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

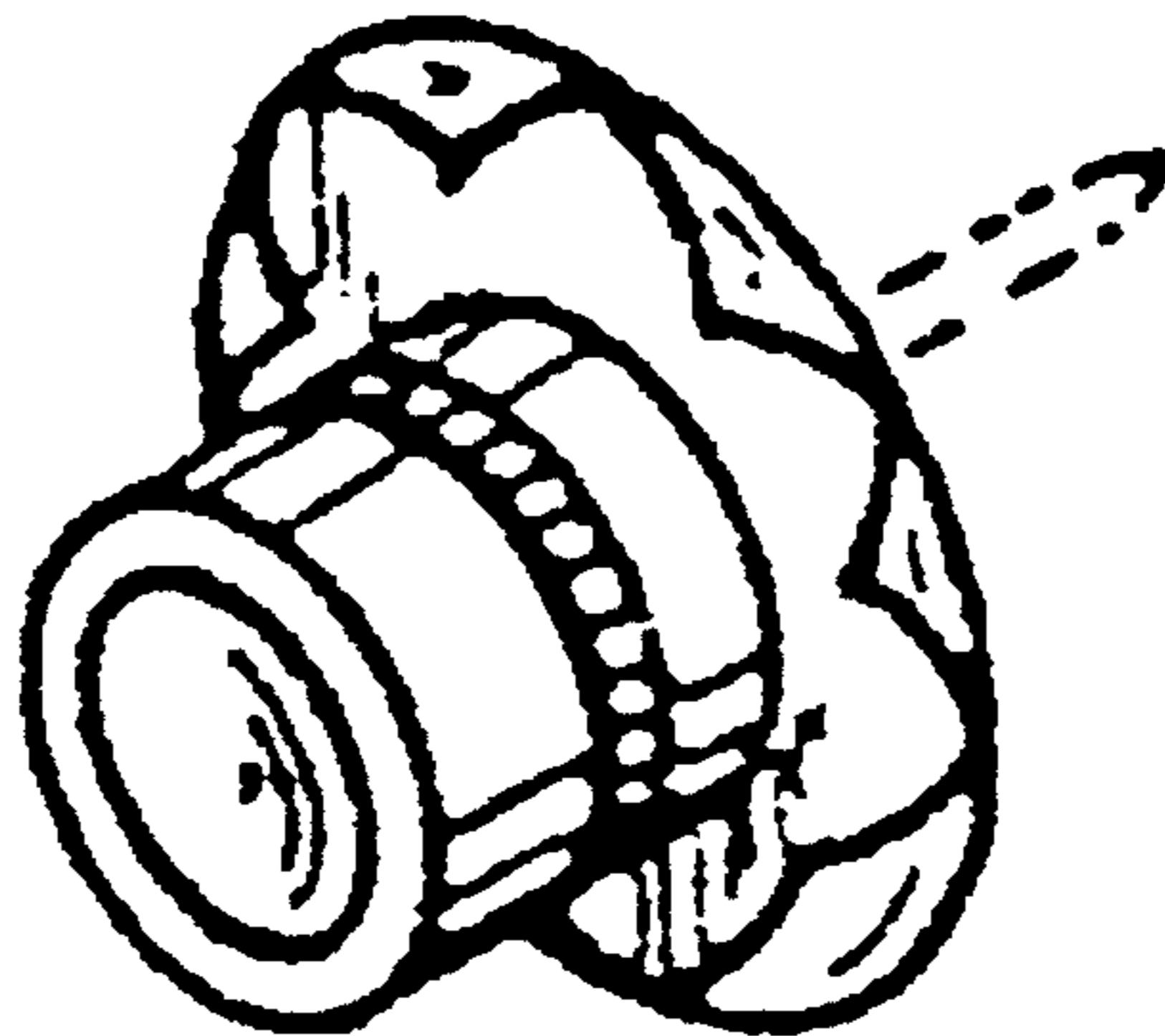

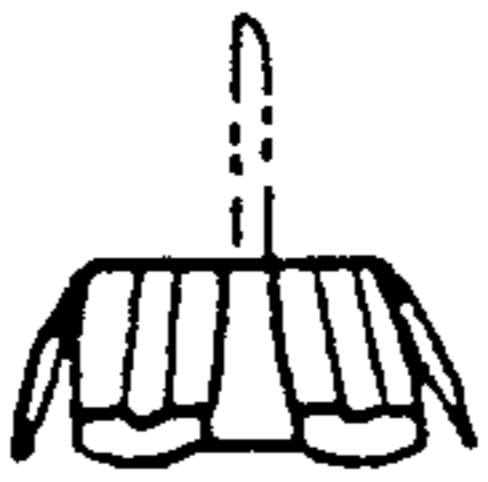

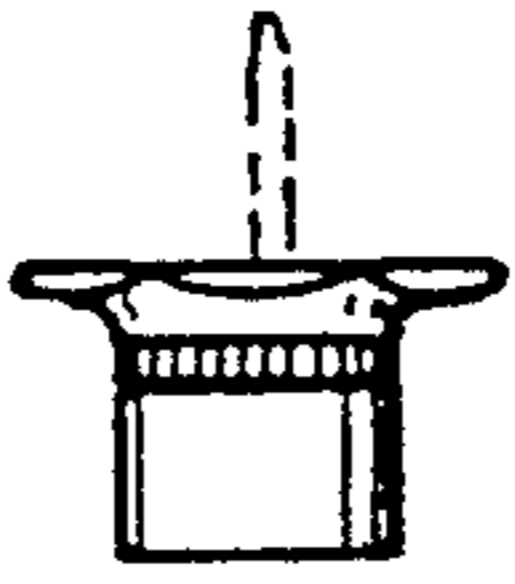

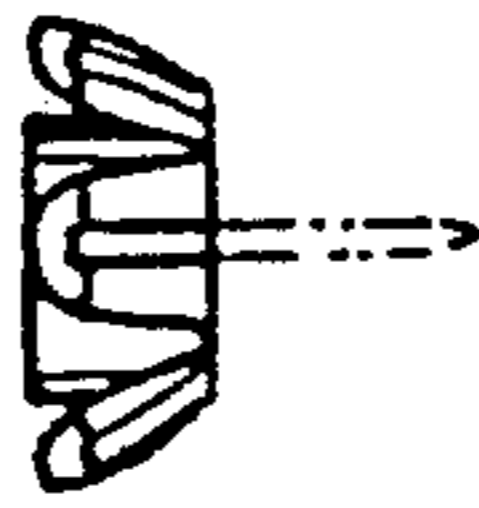

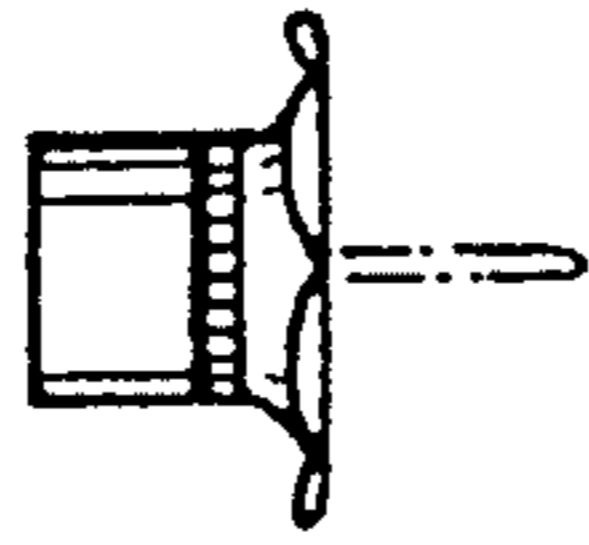
