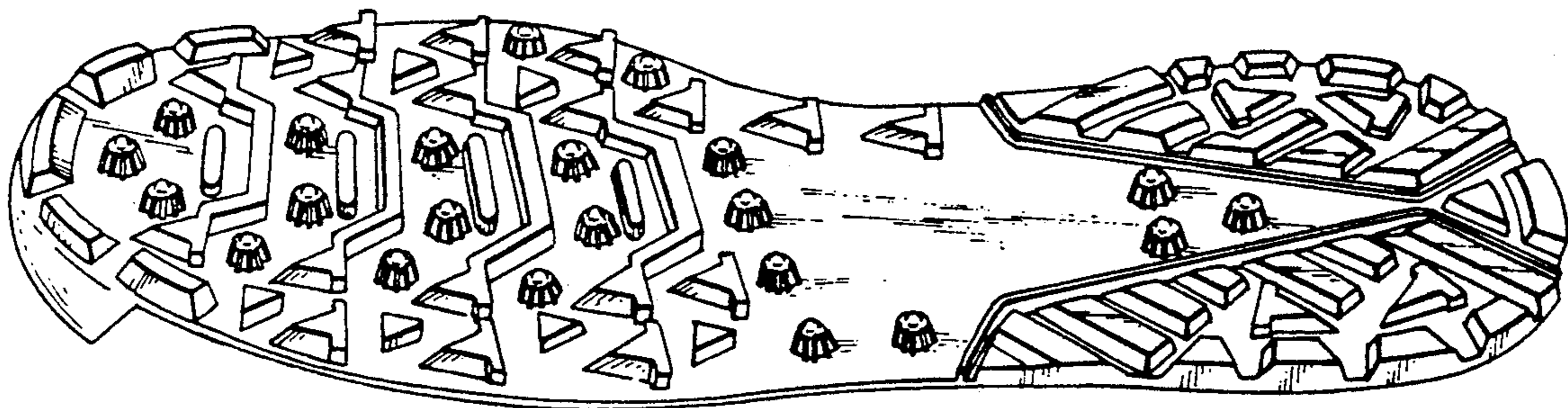

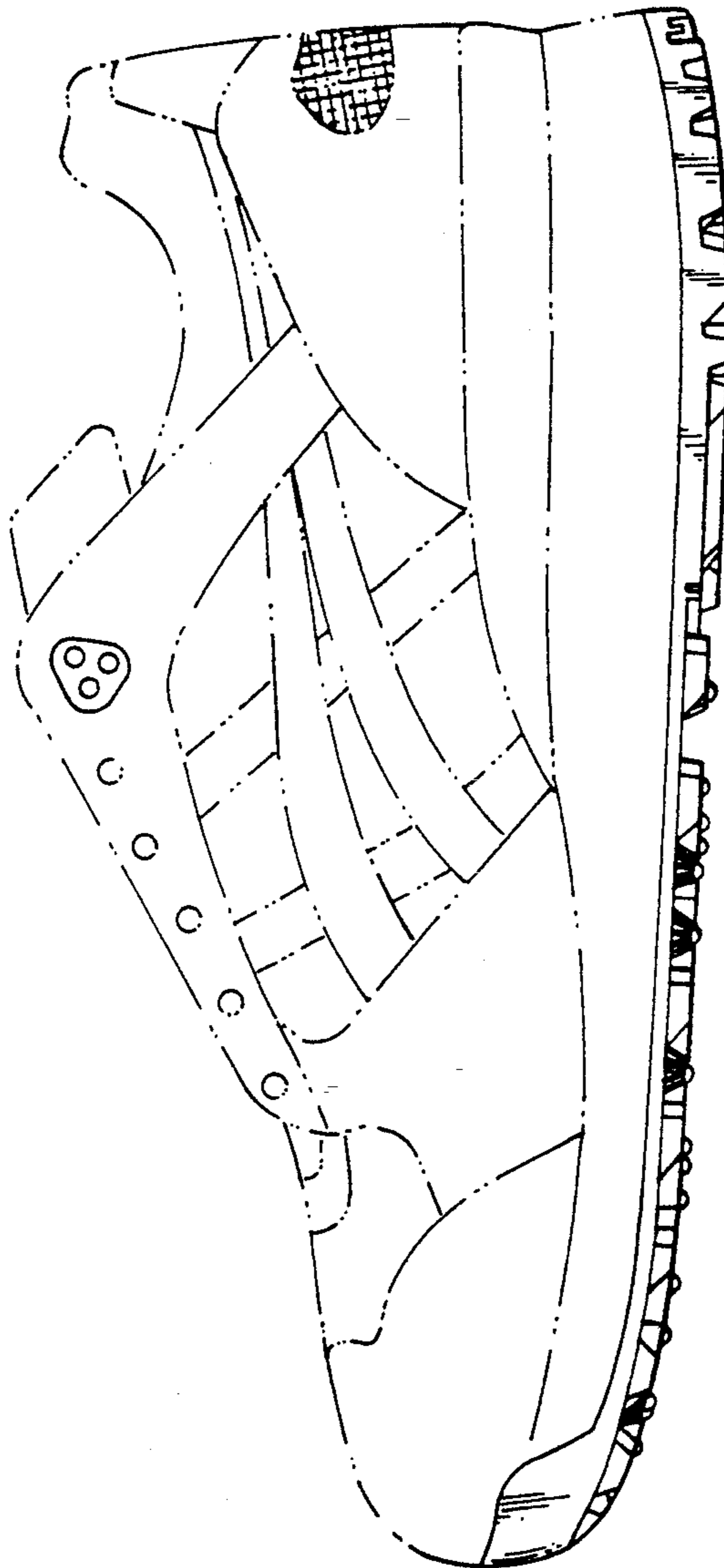

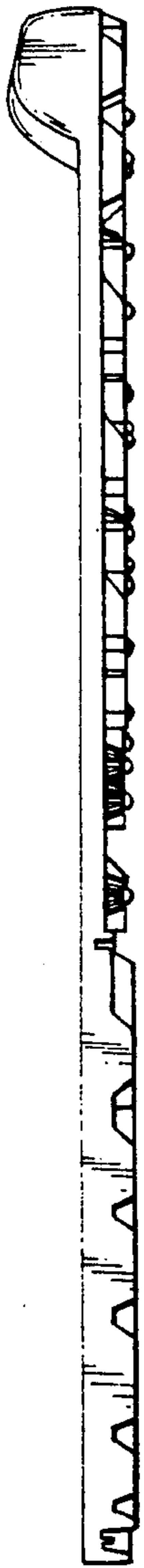
The broken line showing of shoe upper in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



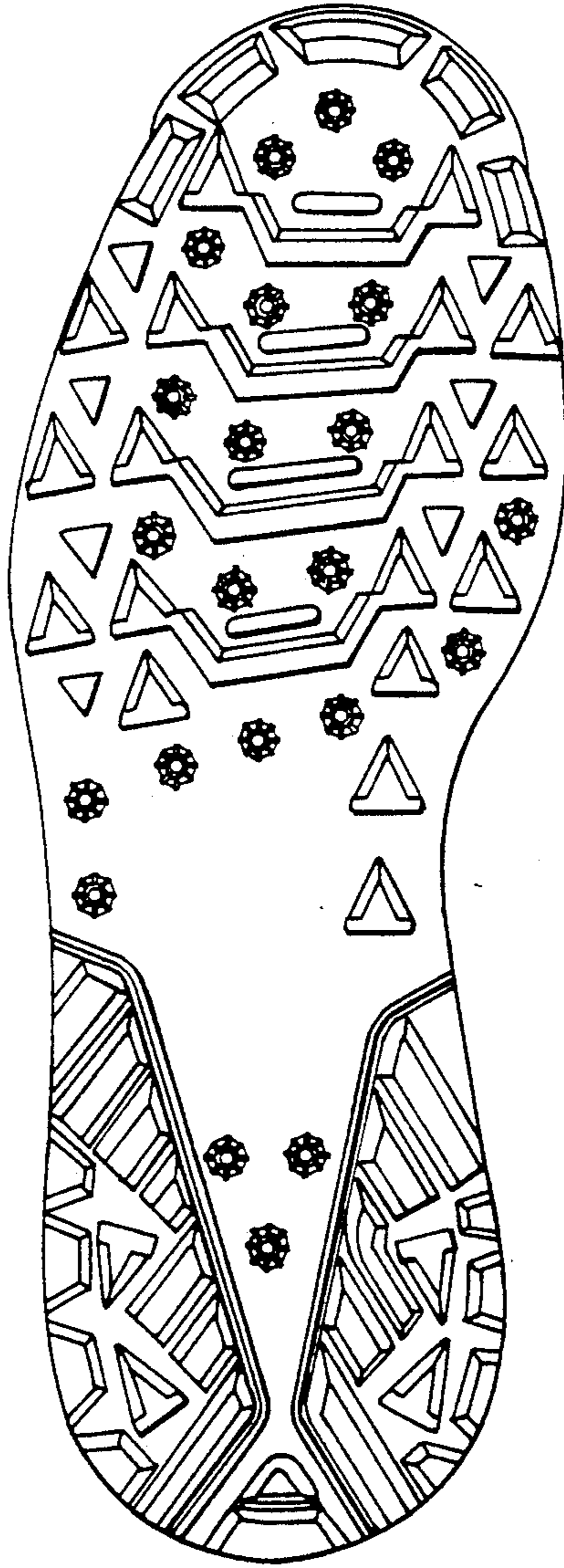

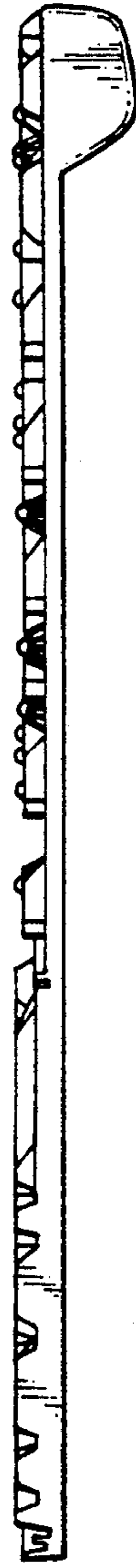

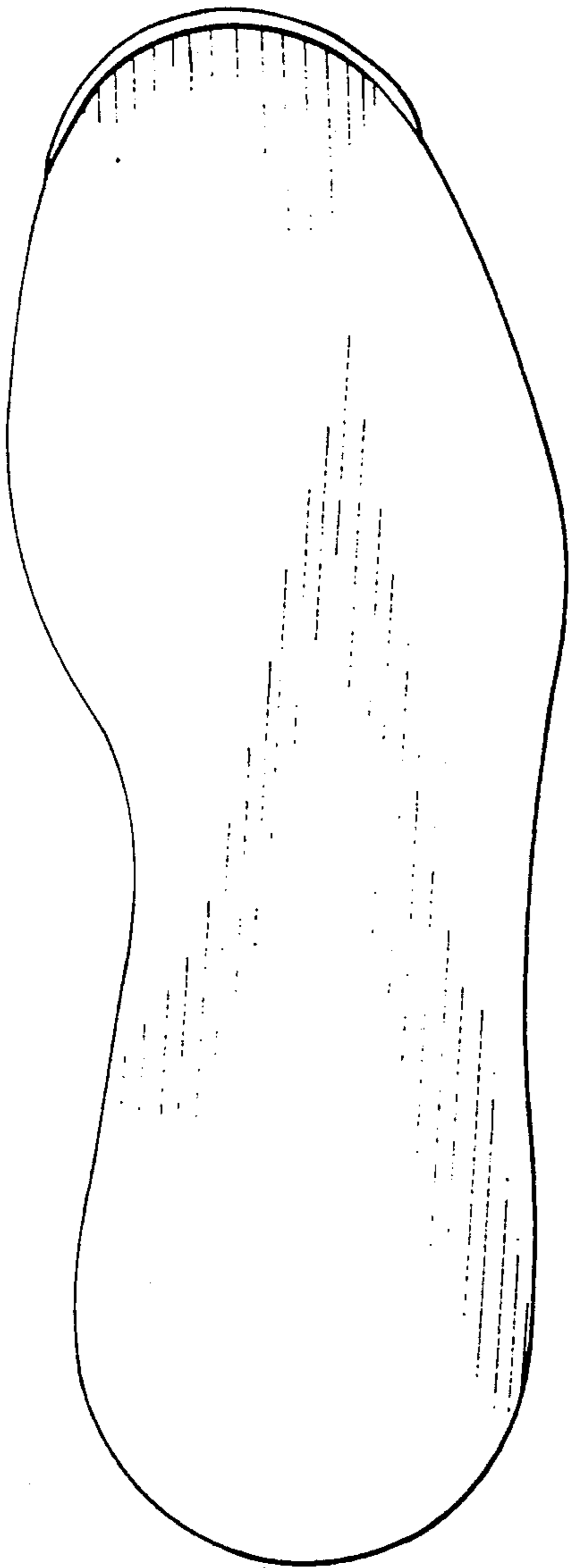
