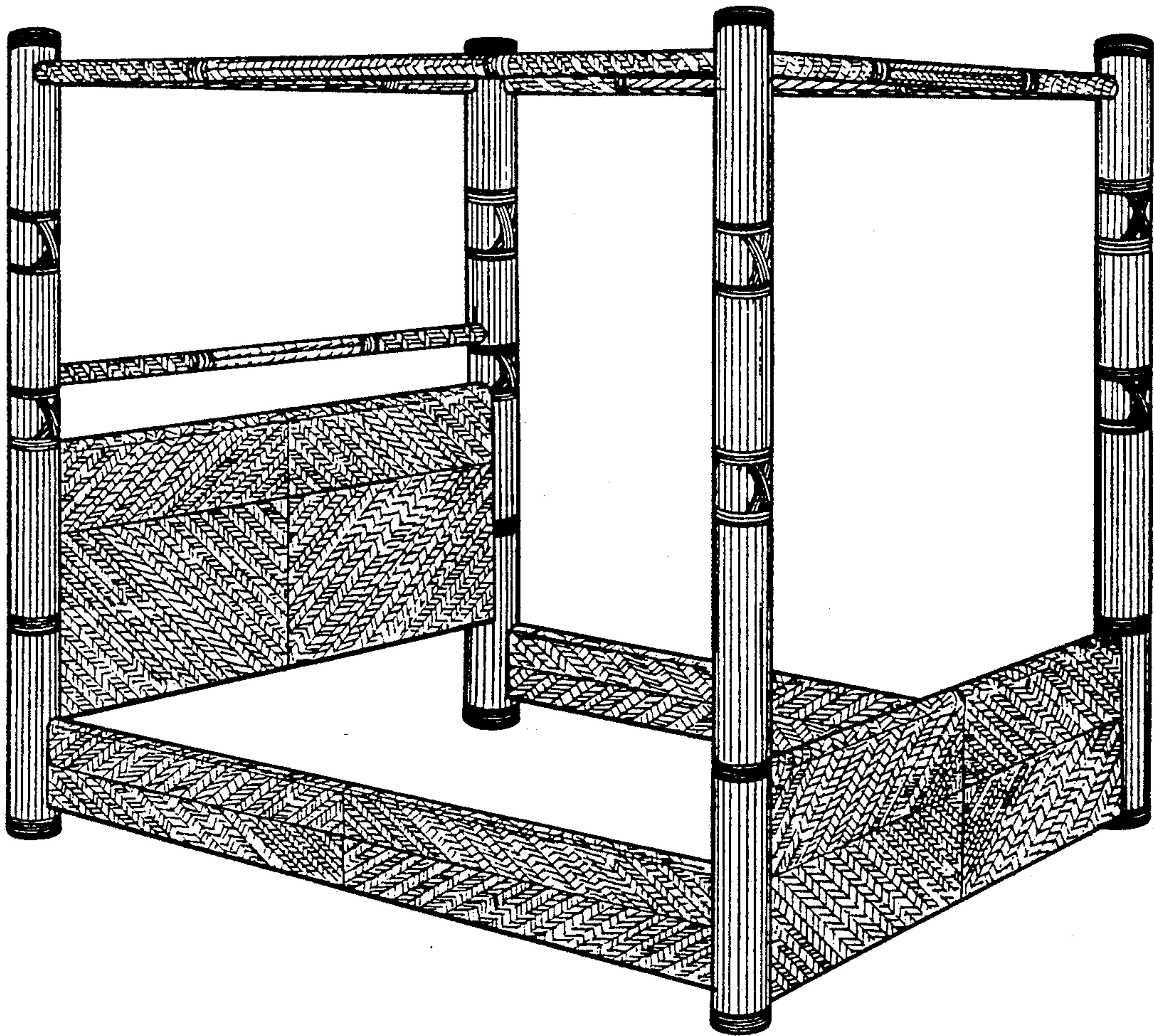

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a post bed showing my new design;

 FIG. 4 is an end elevational view, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof.



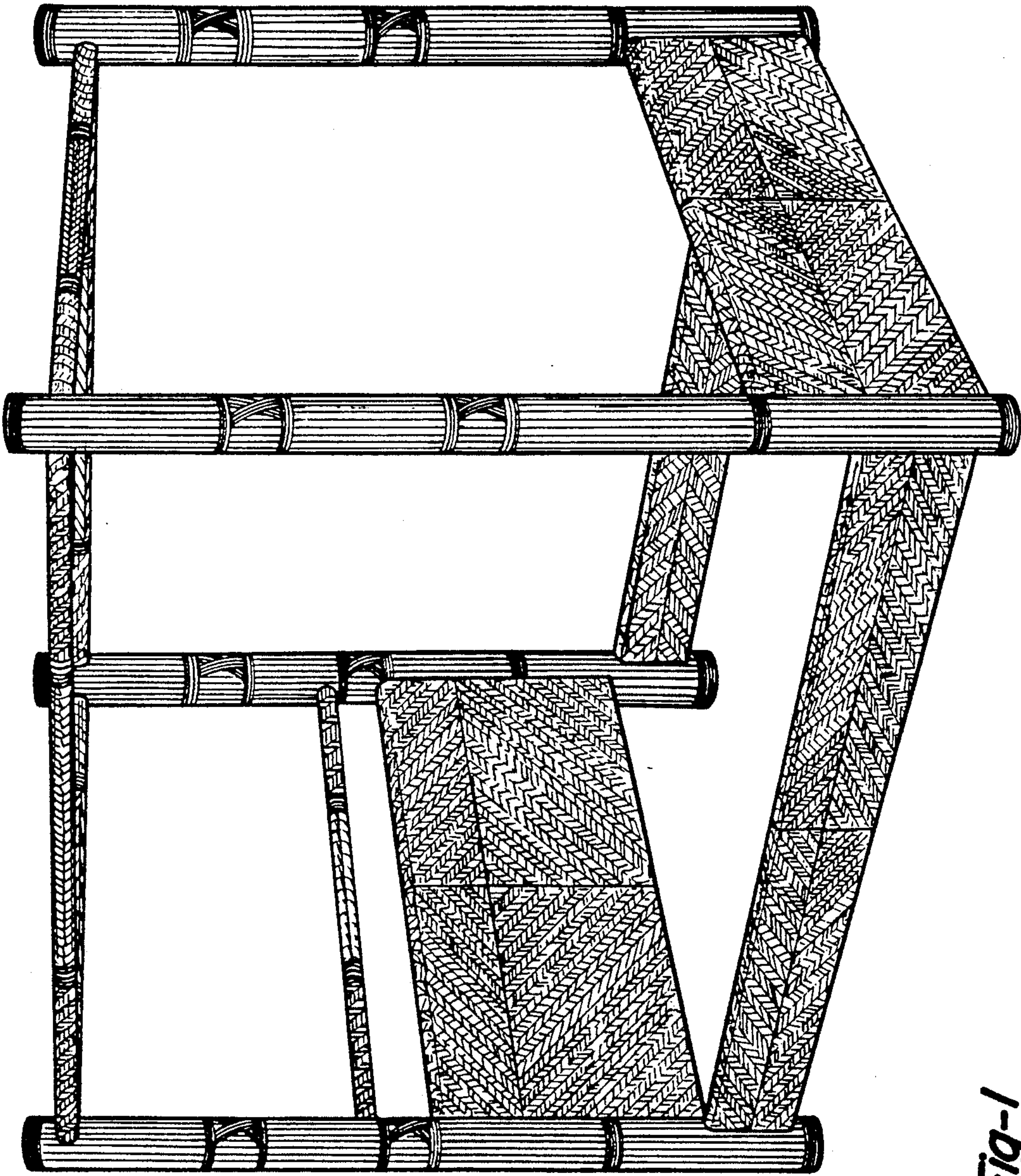

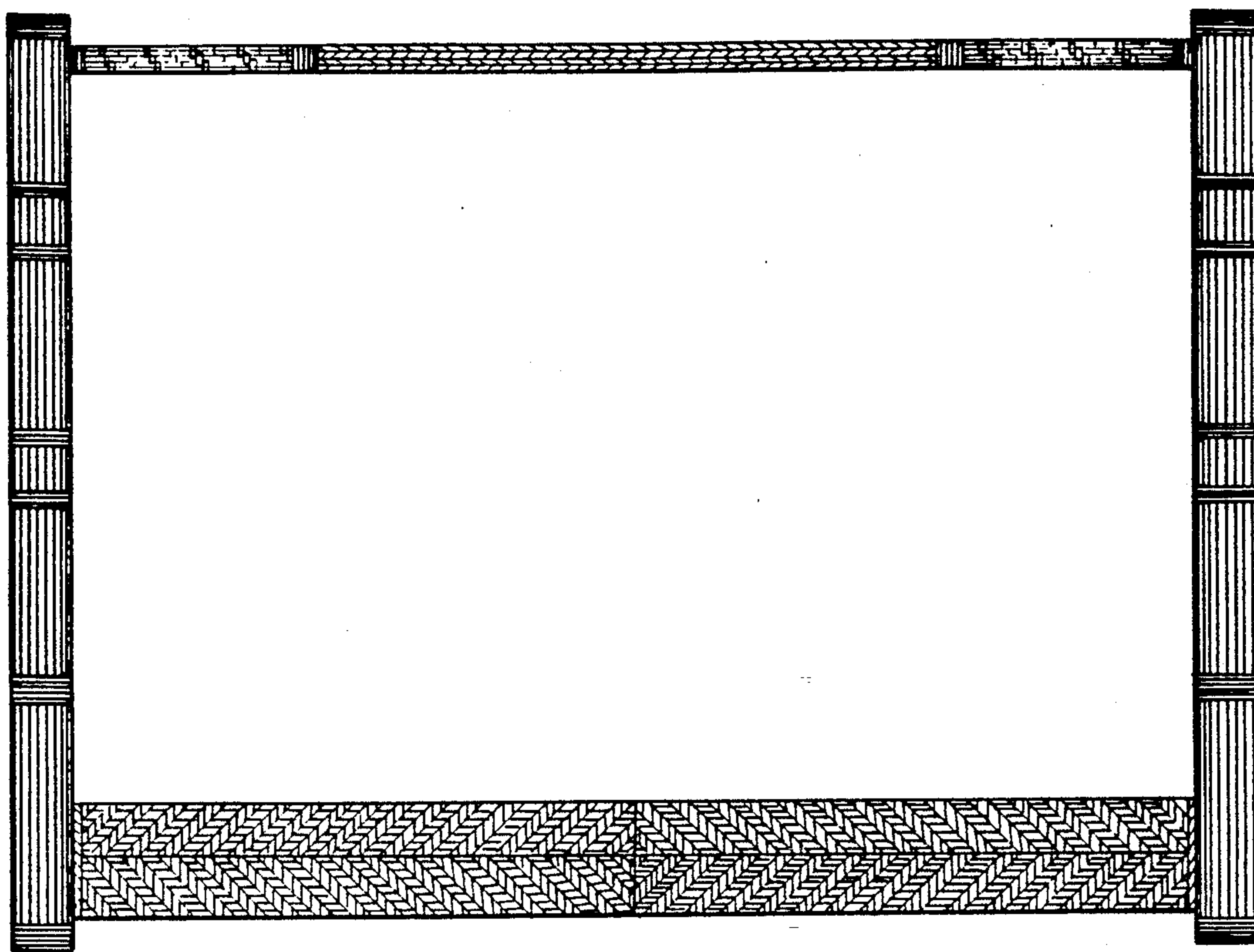

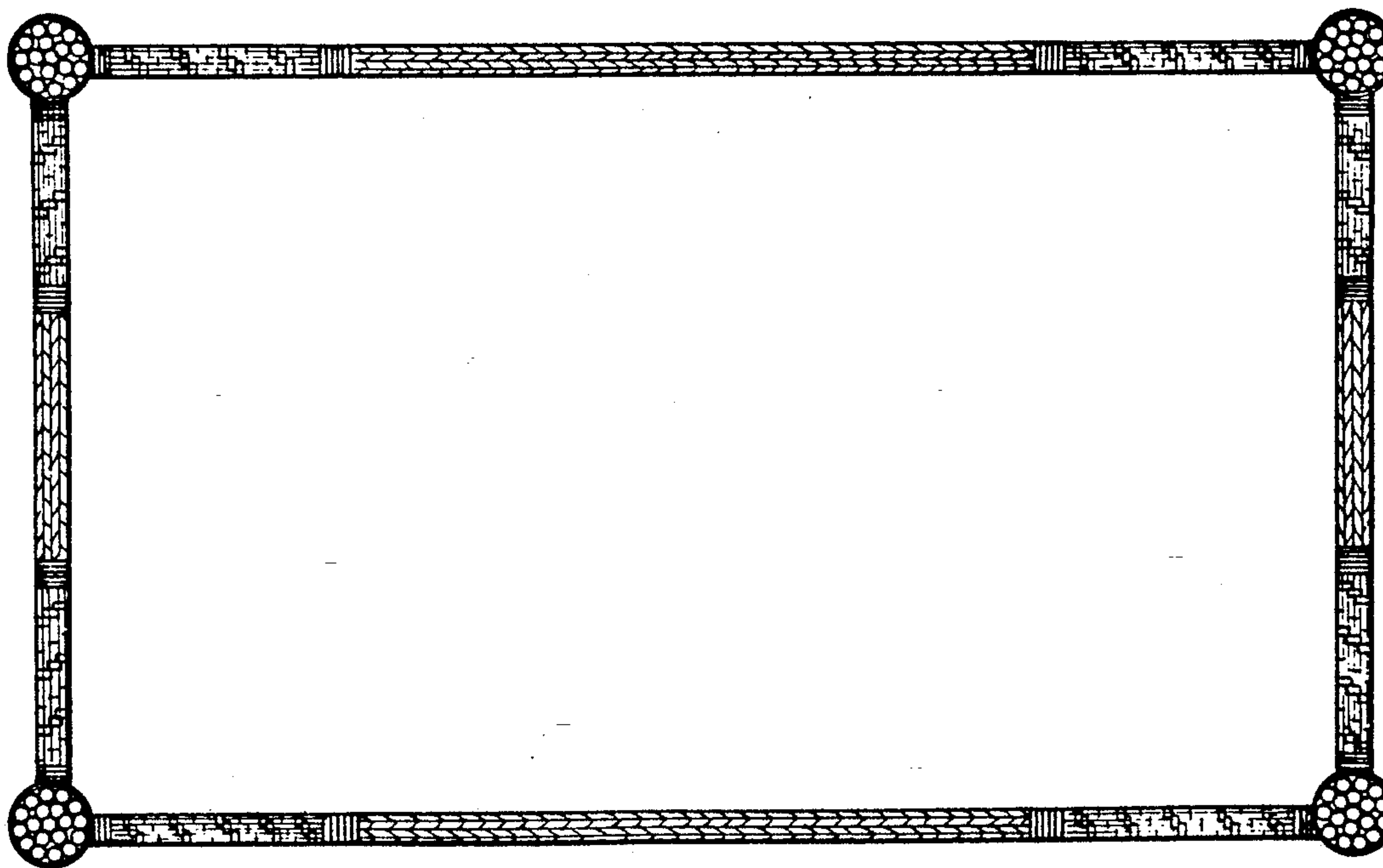

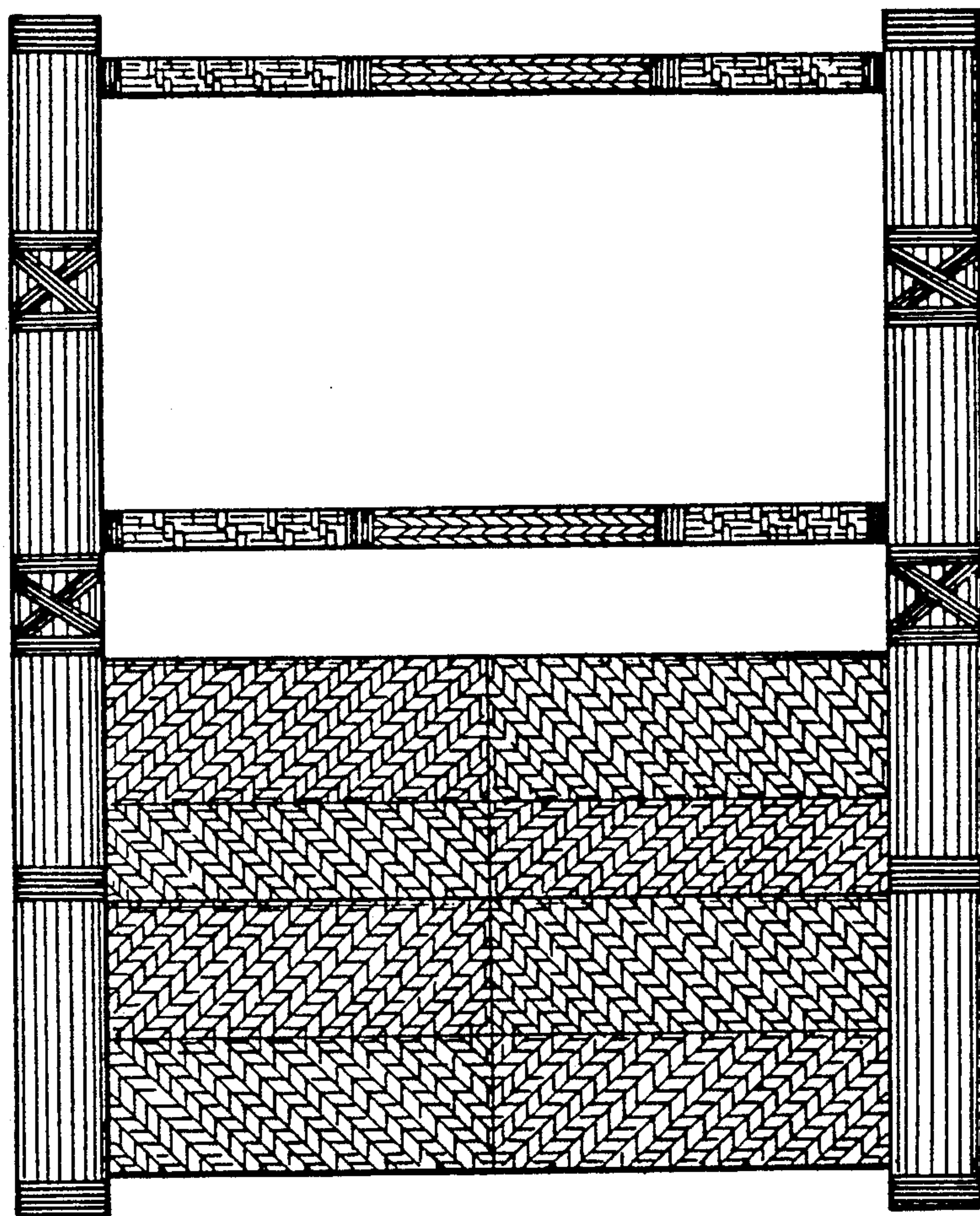
