The ornamental design for a triple dresser, as shown and described.

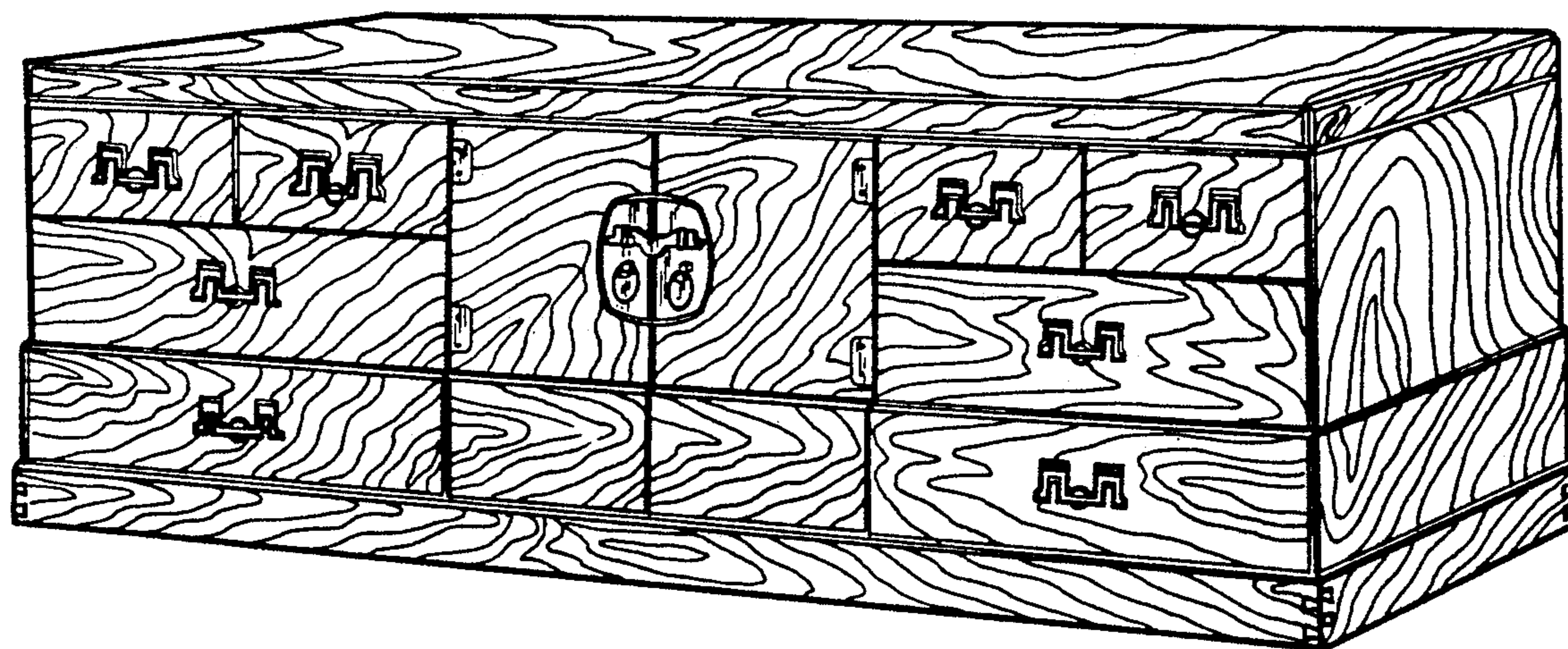
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.



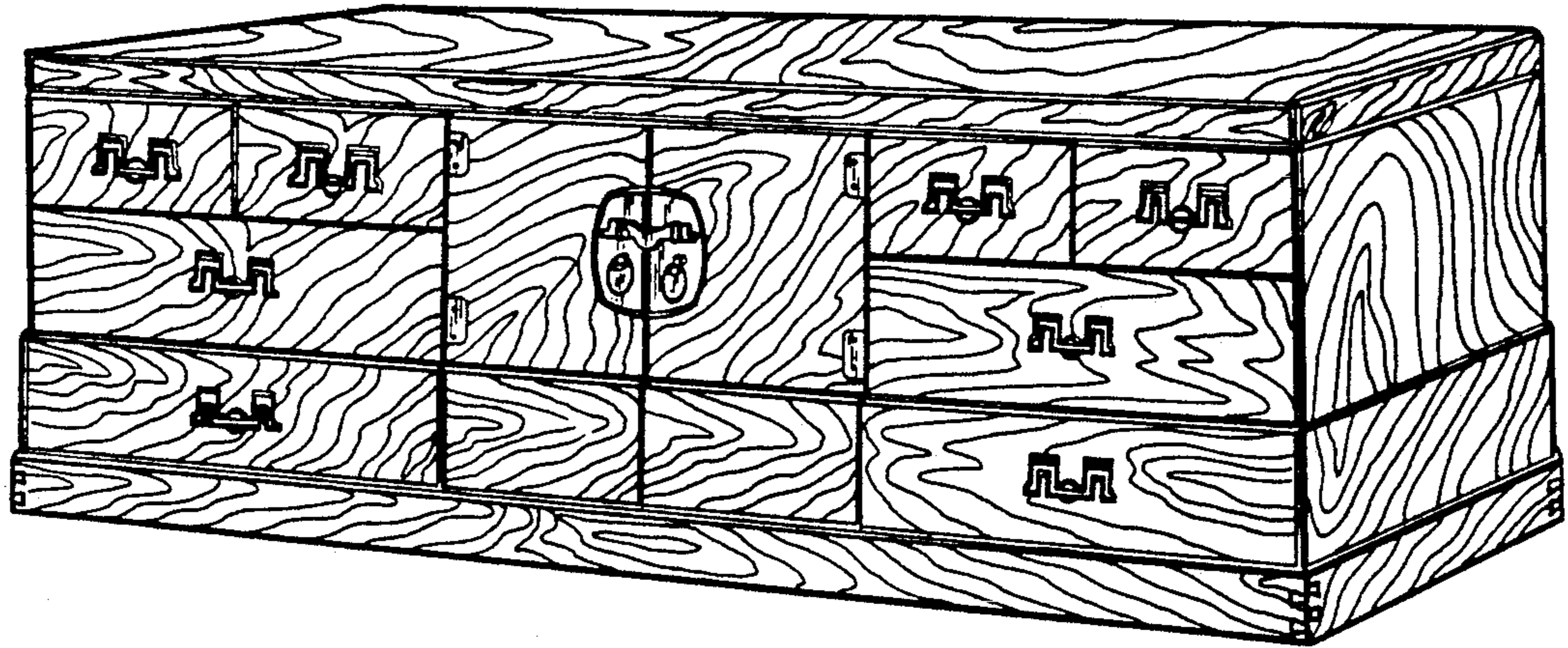
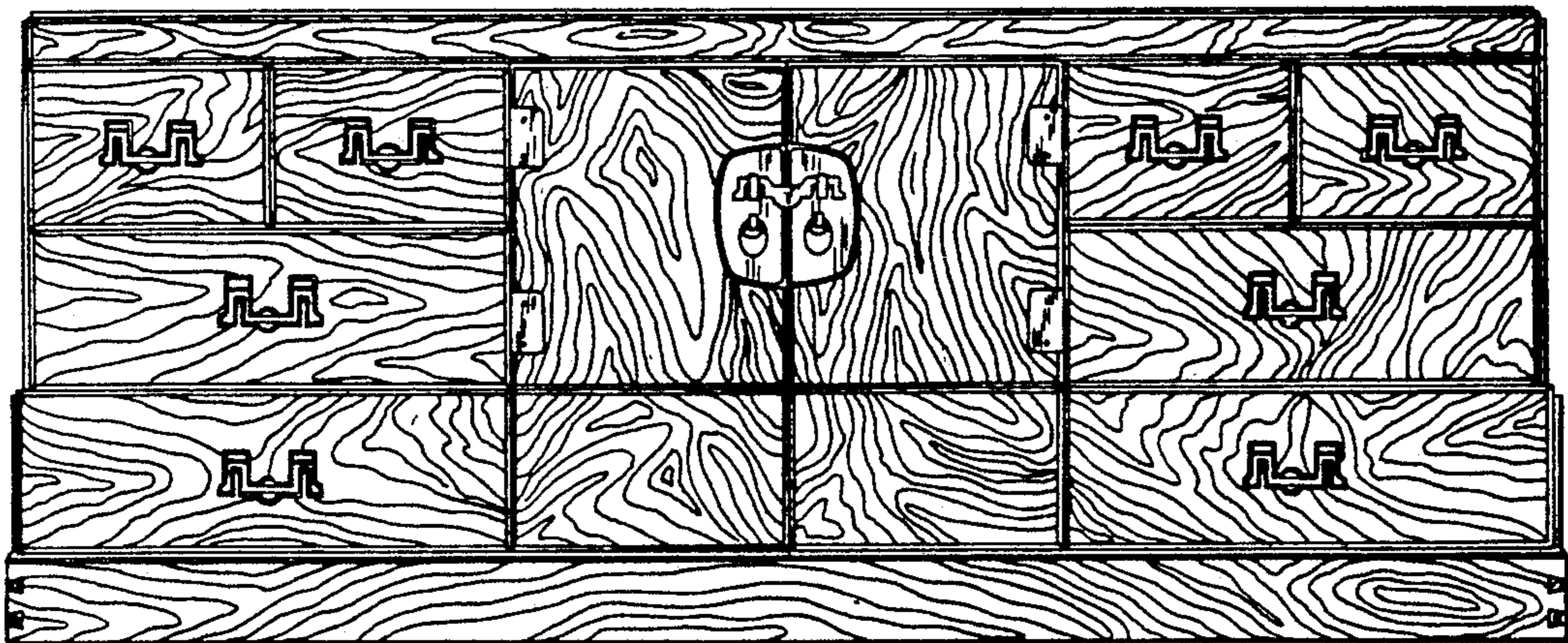

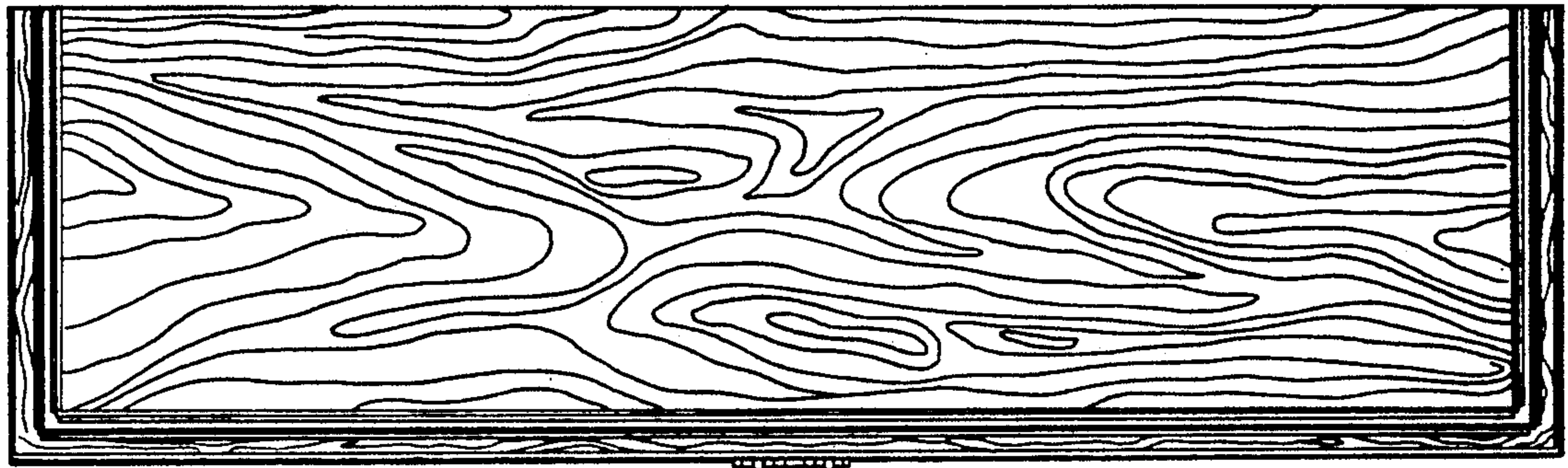

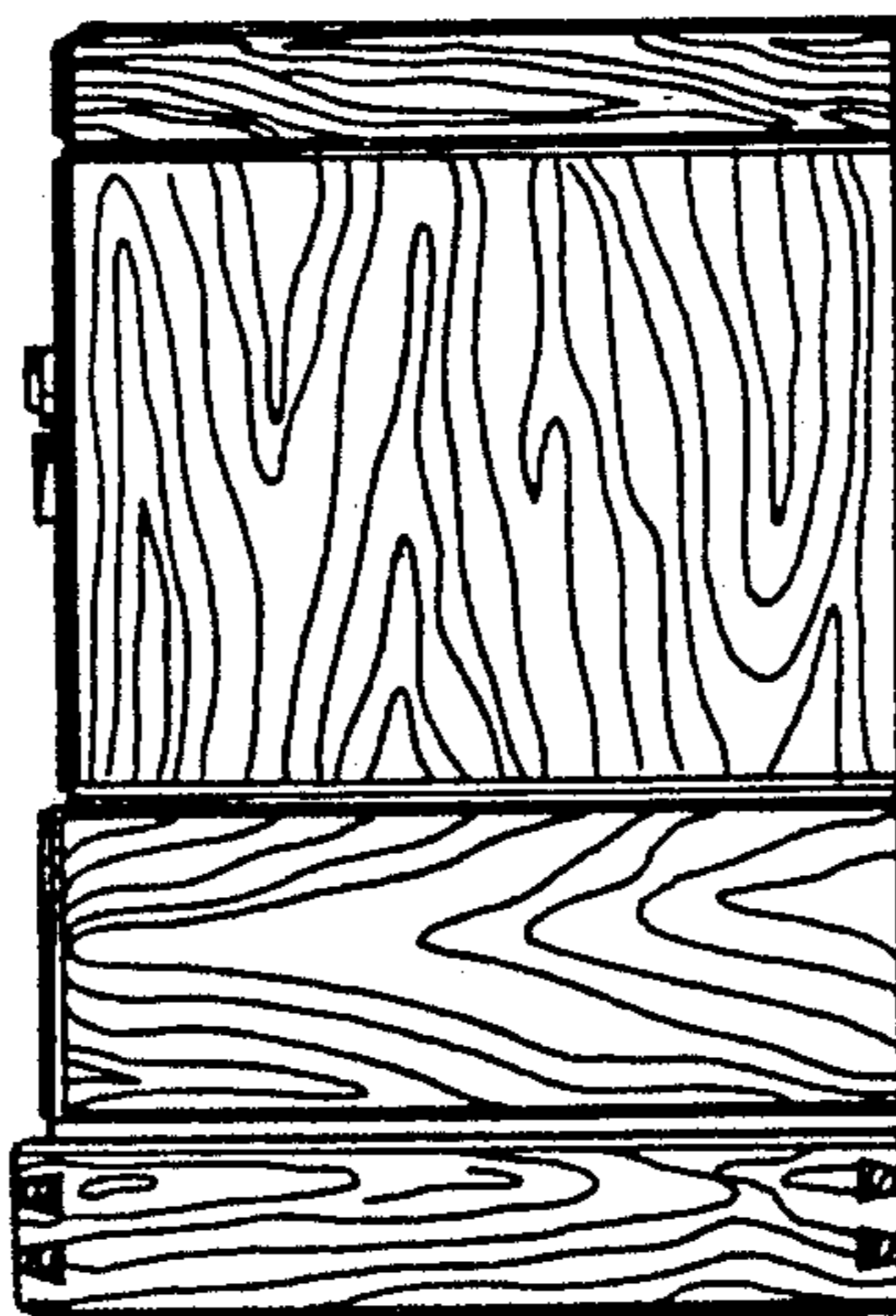
