The ornamental design for a chest, as shown and described.

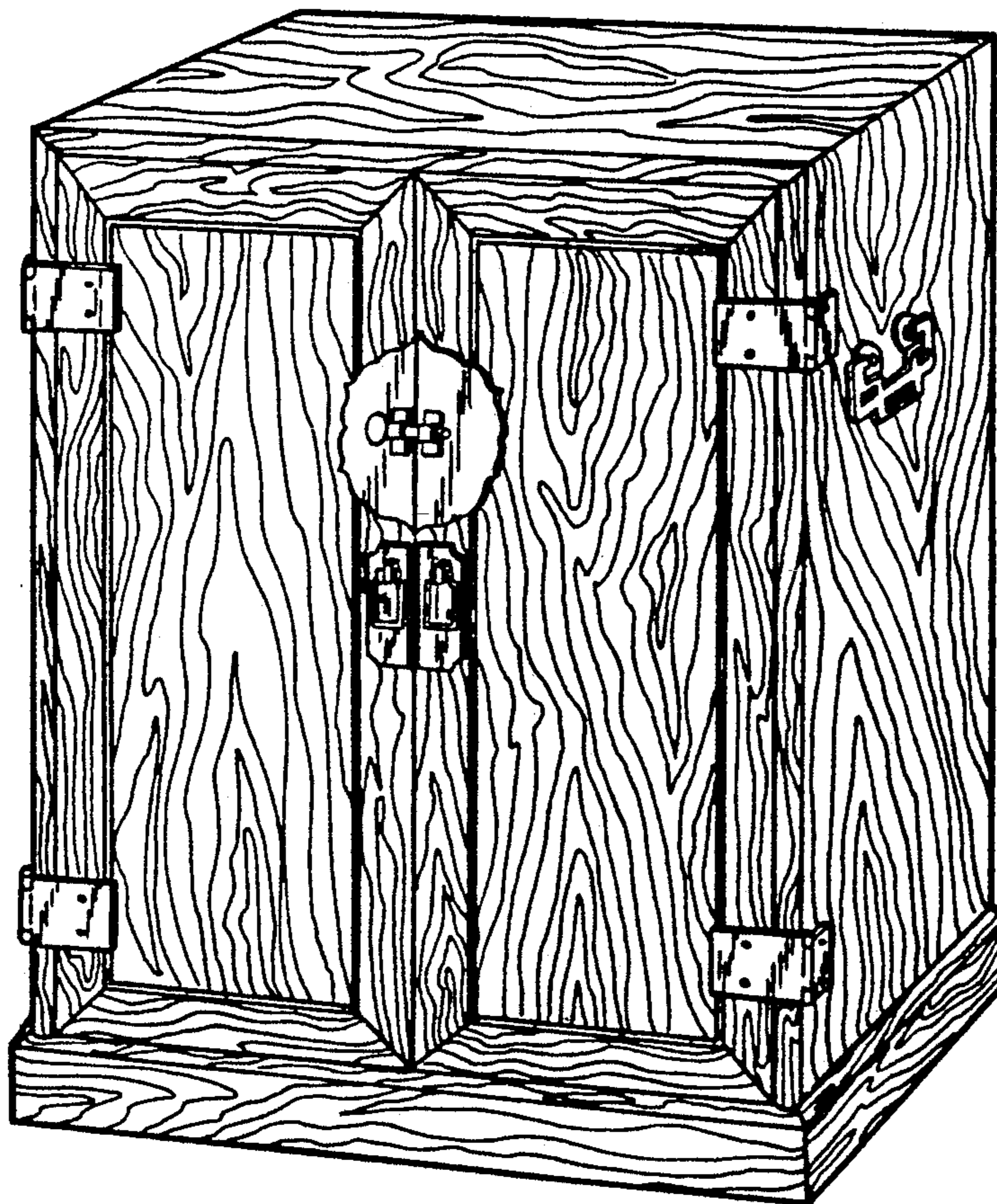

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.



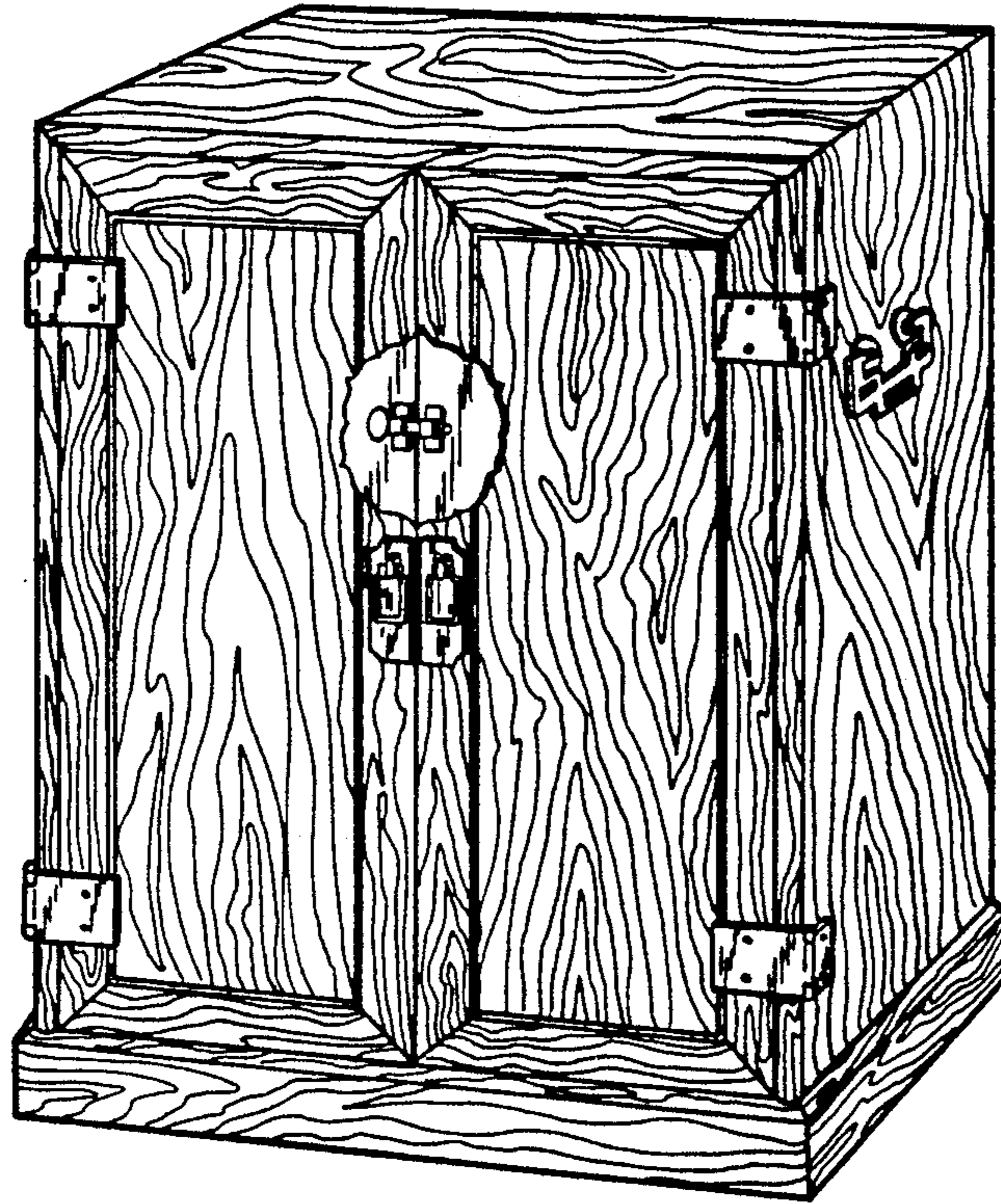

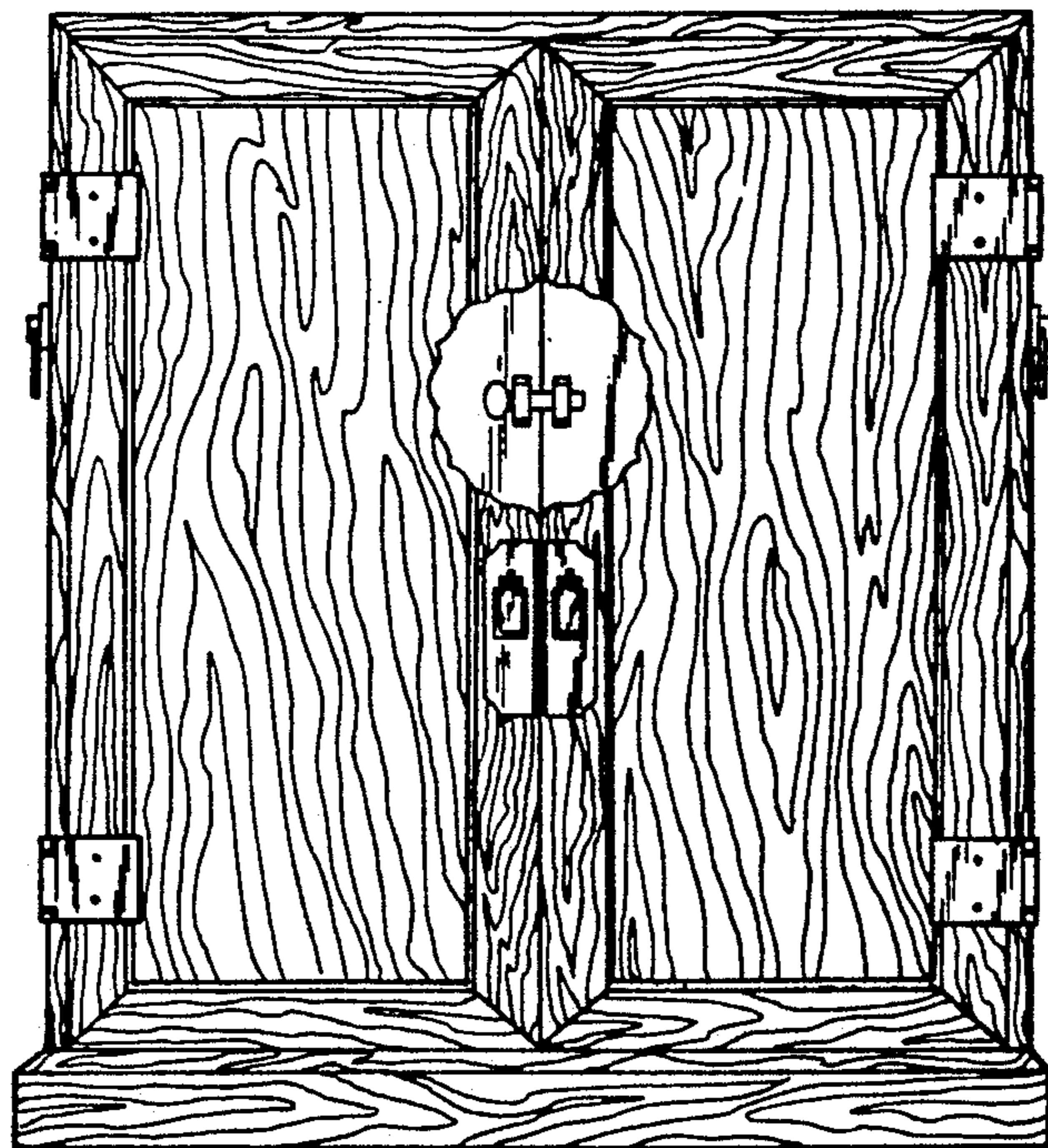

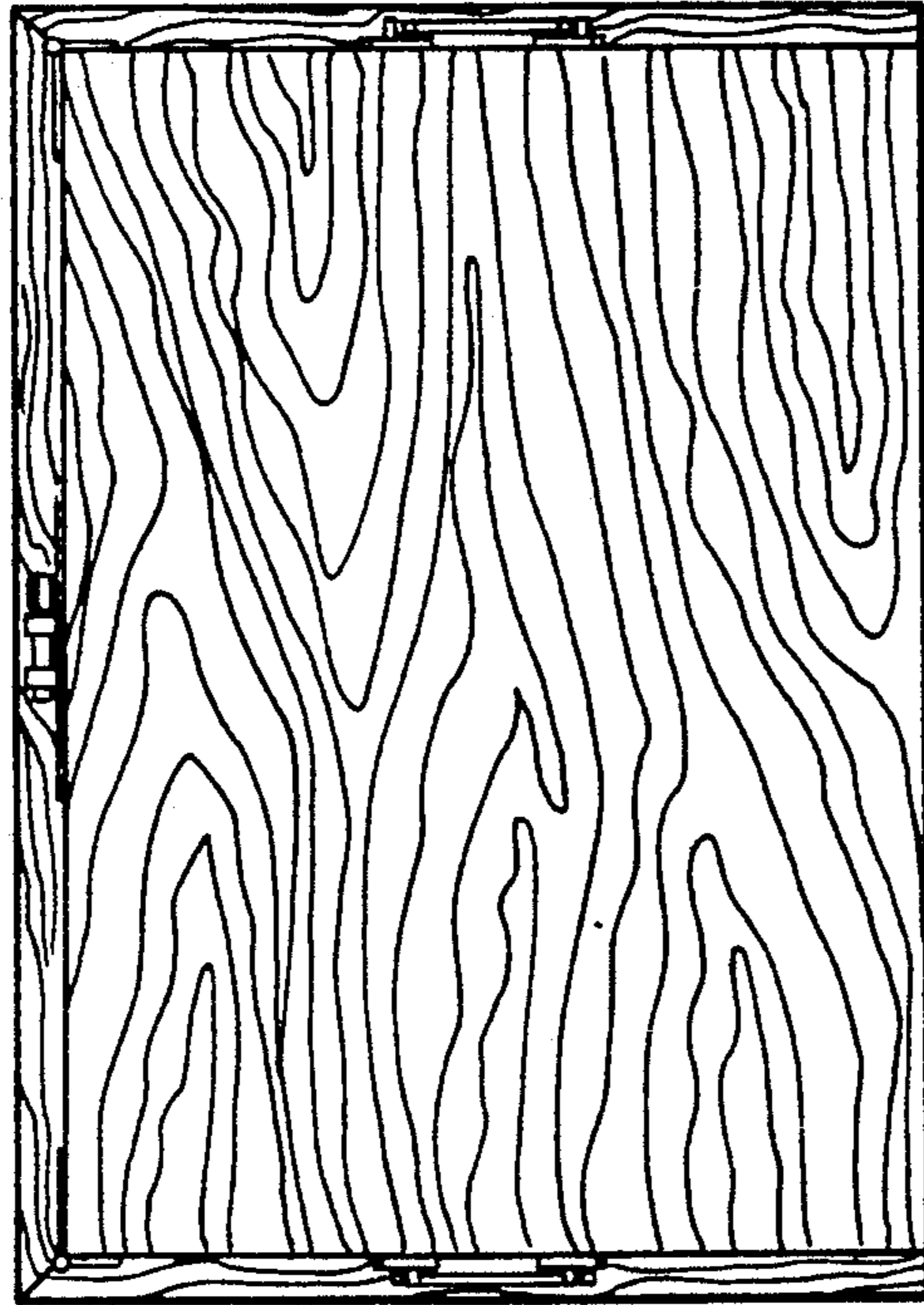

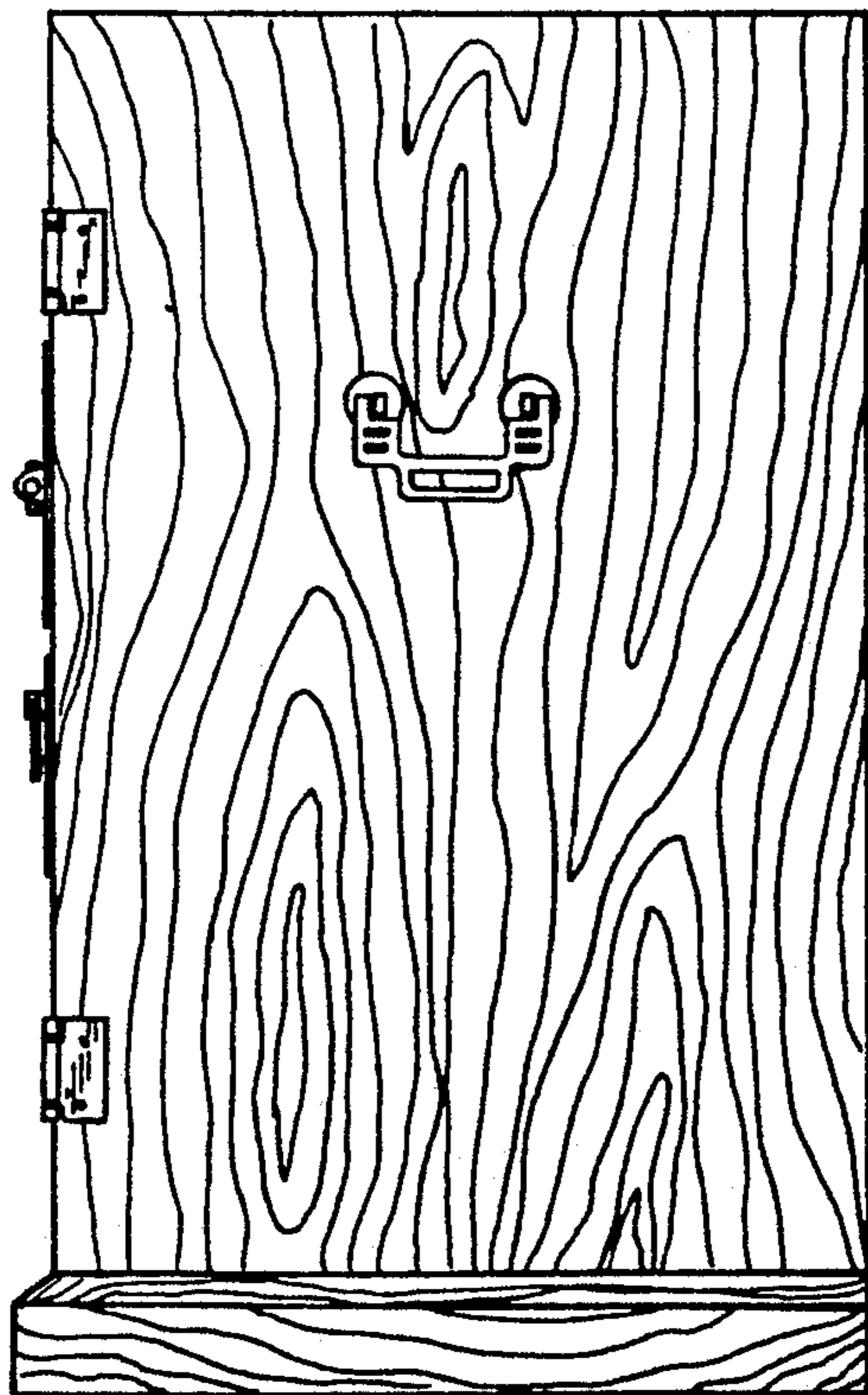
