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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a windshield corner post, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right, top perspective view of a windshield corner post, in closed condition, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged rear elevation view thereof taken from a slightly different angle than the front elevation view of FIG. 3;

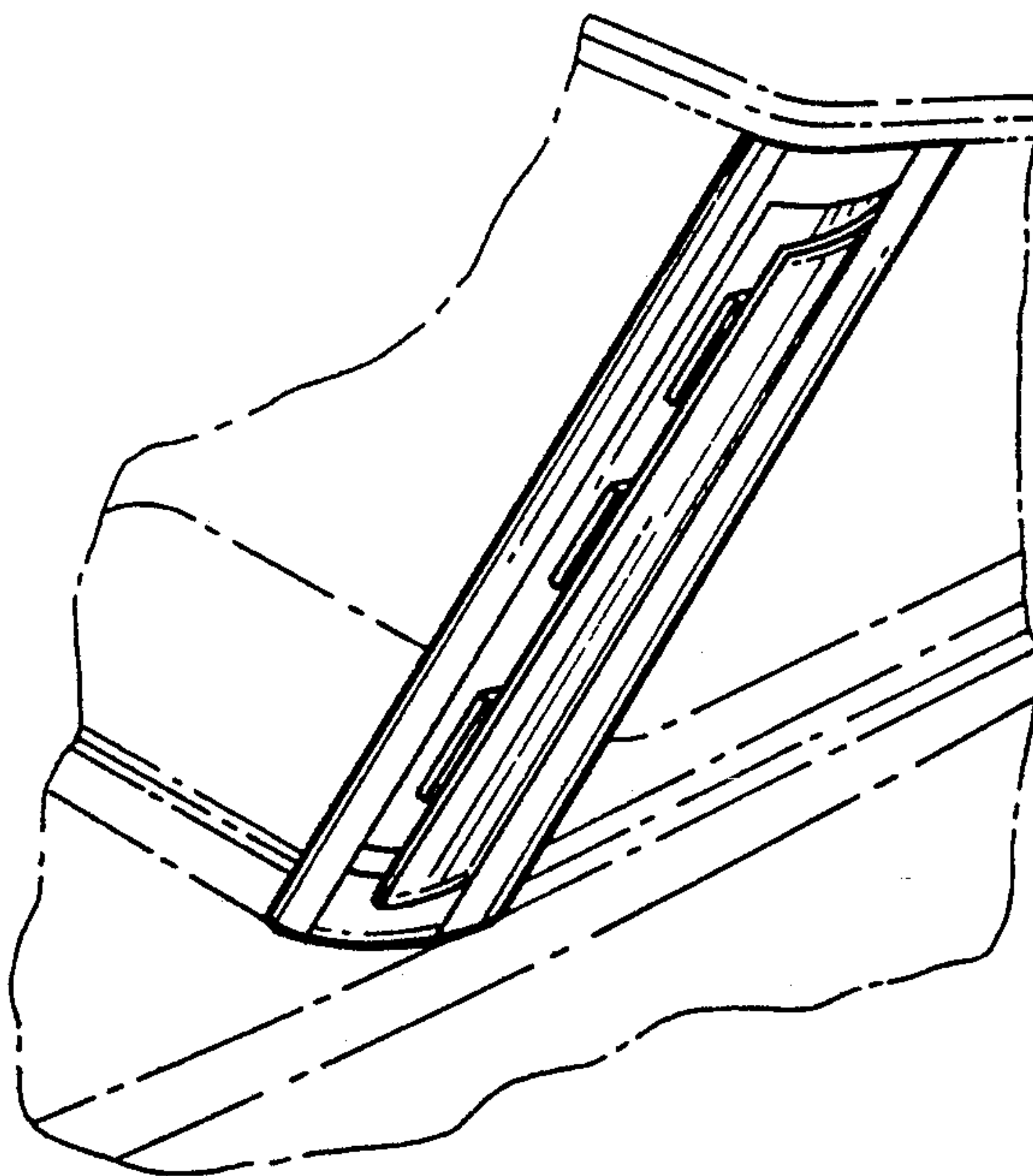
FIG. 5 is an enlarged left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is a front, right, top perspective view thereof in open condition;

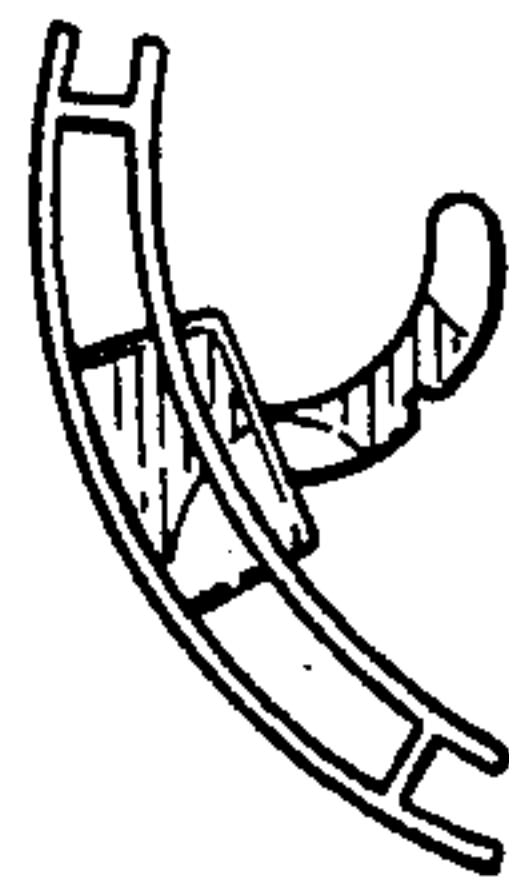
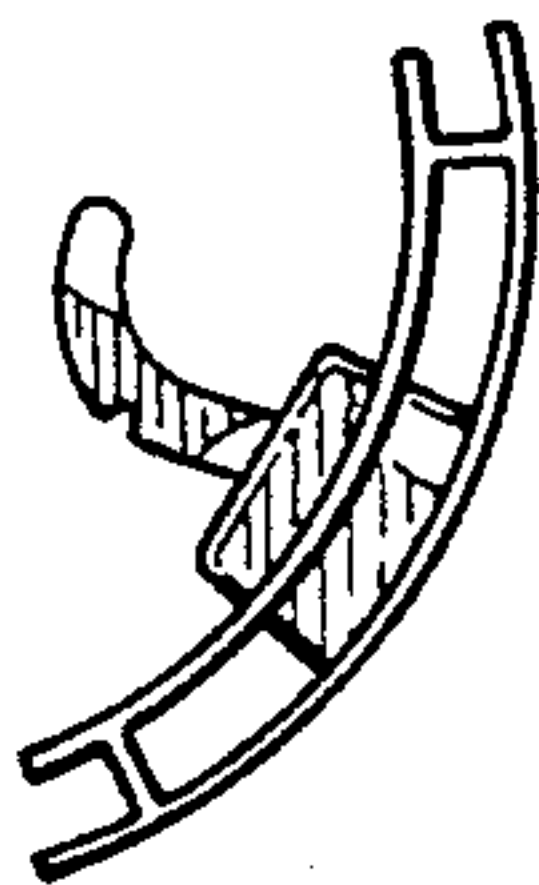
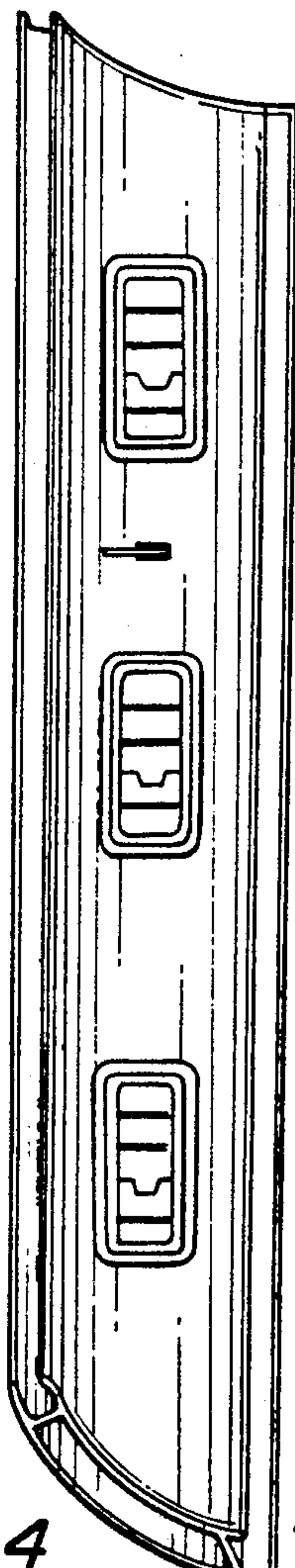
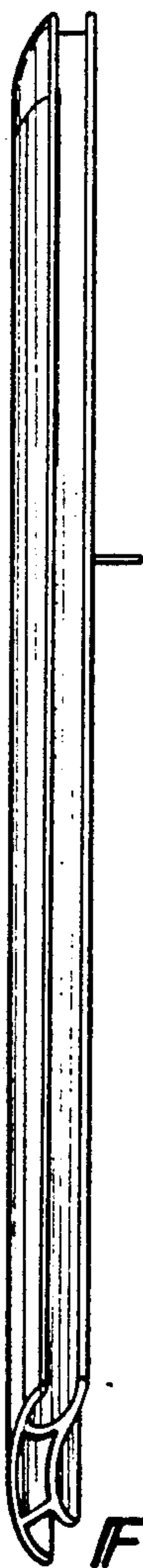
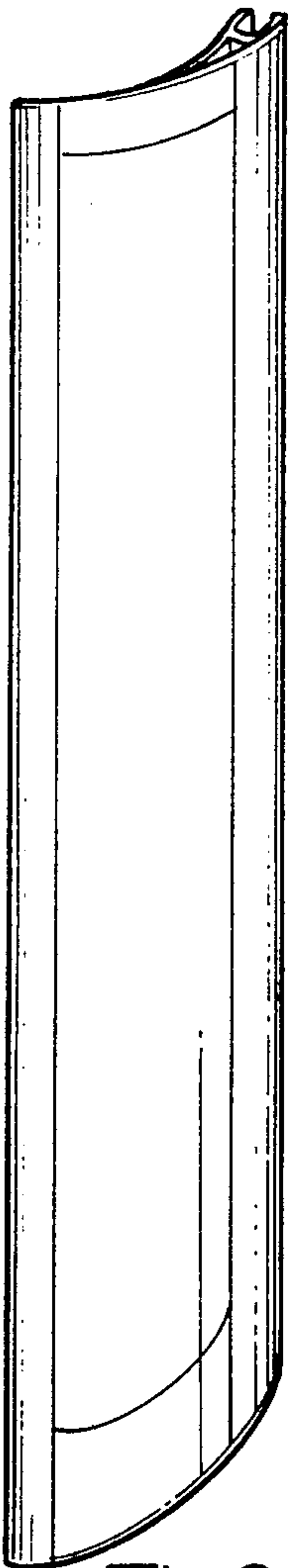
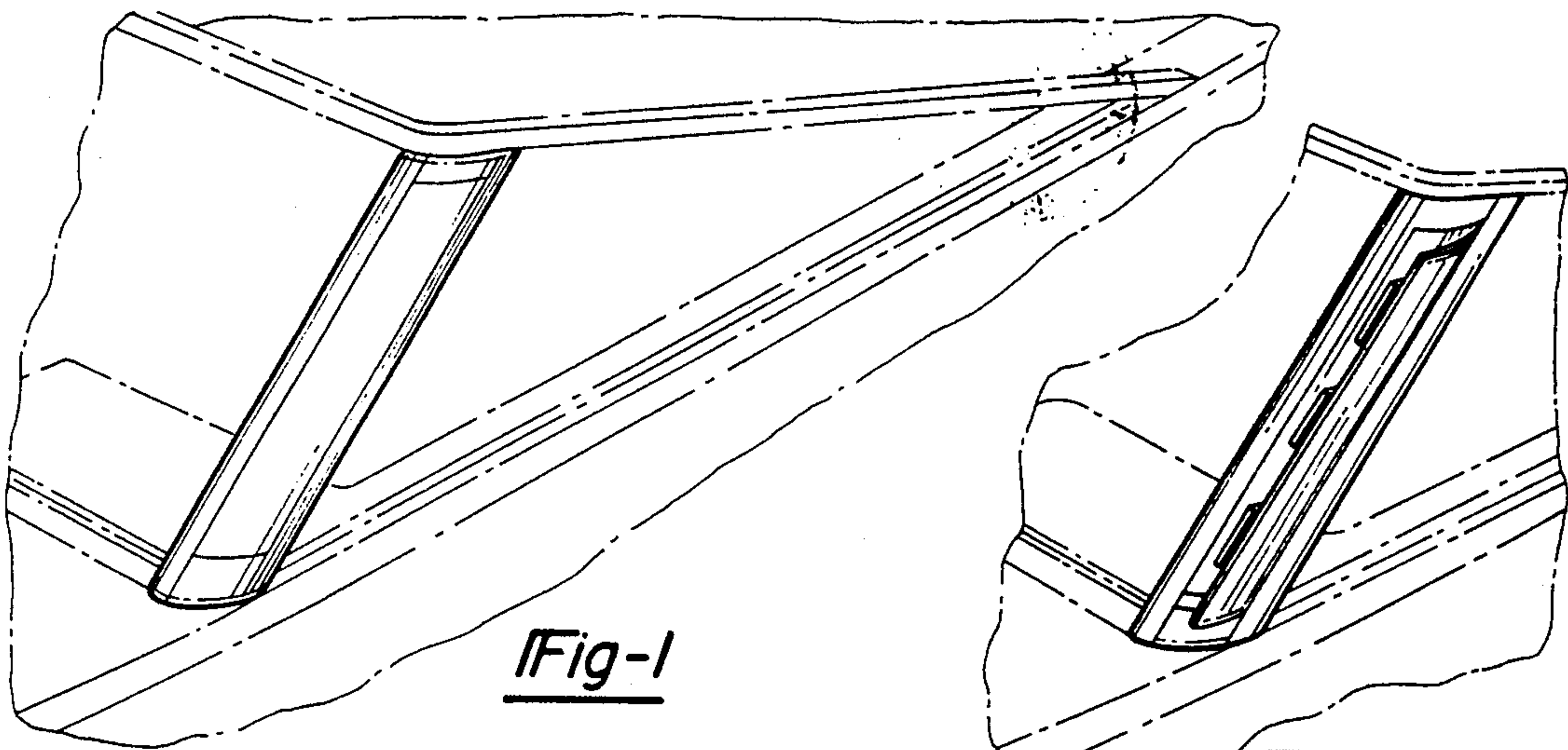
