The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side perspective view of a chair showing my new design, the left side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a left-front perspective view;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view;

FIG. 4 is a left side perspective view showing the chair in folded condition;

FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view; and,

FIG. 6 is a rear perspective view thereof, showing the chair in folded condition.

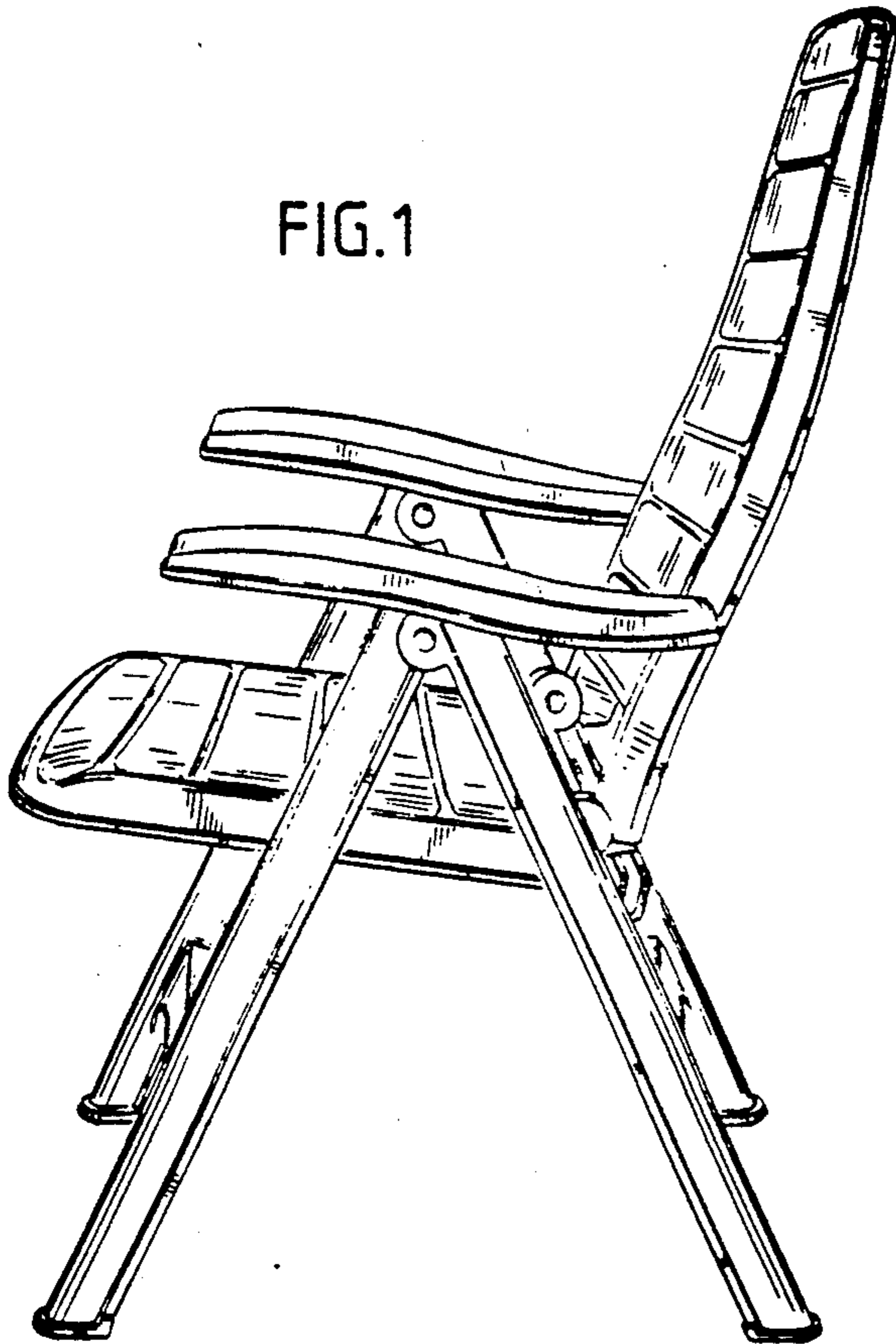

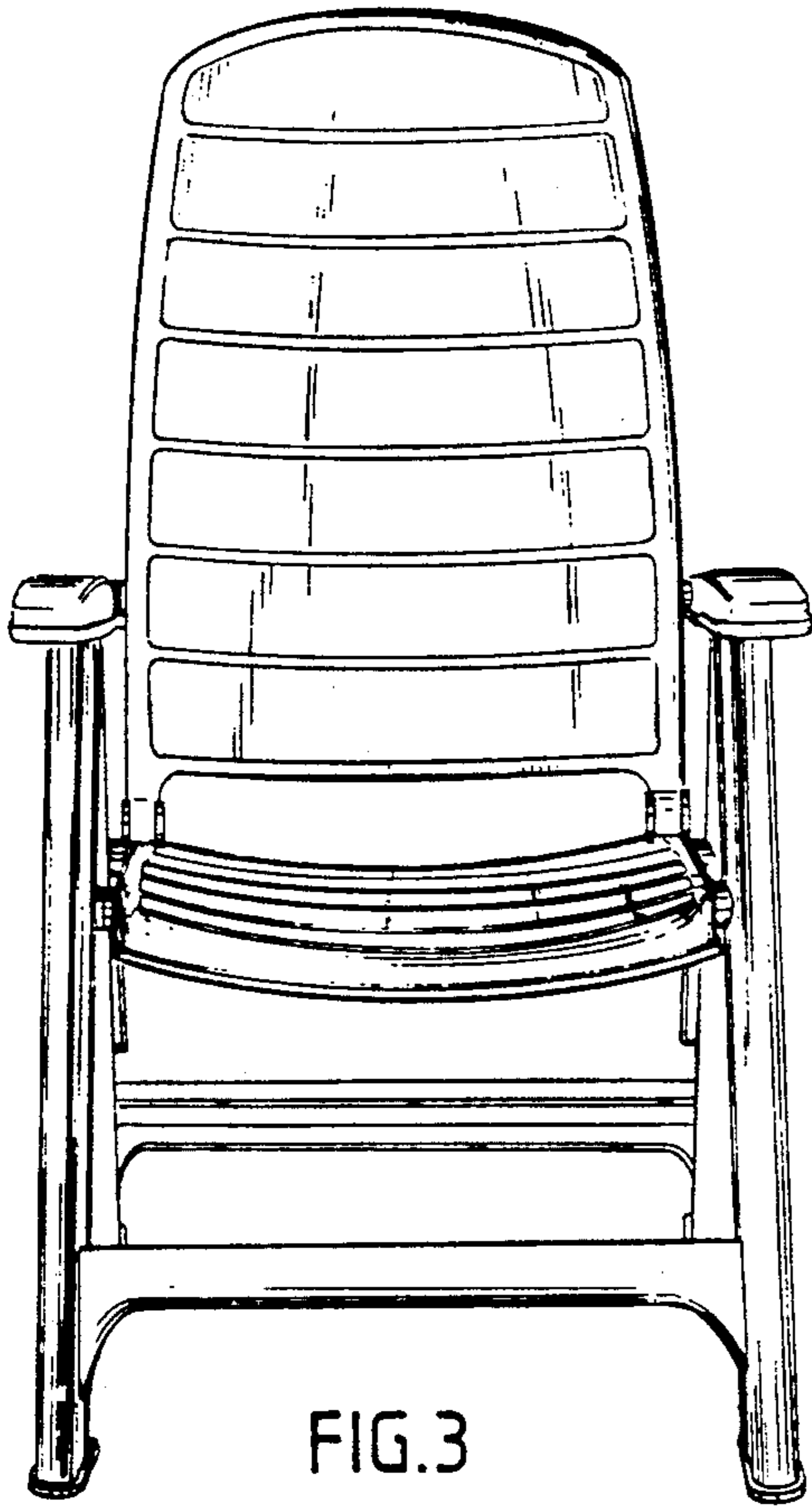

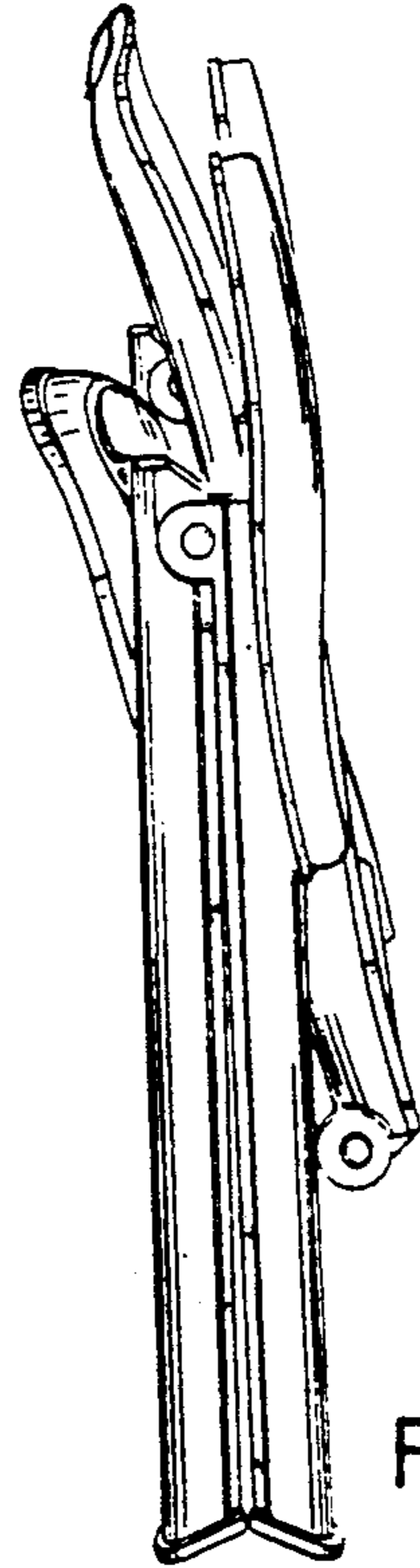

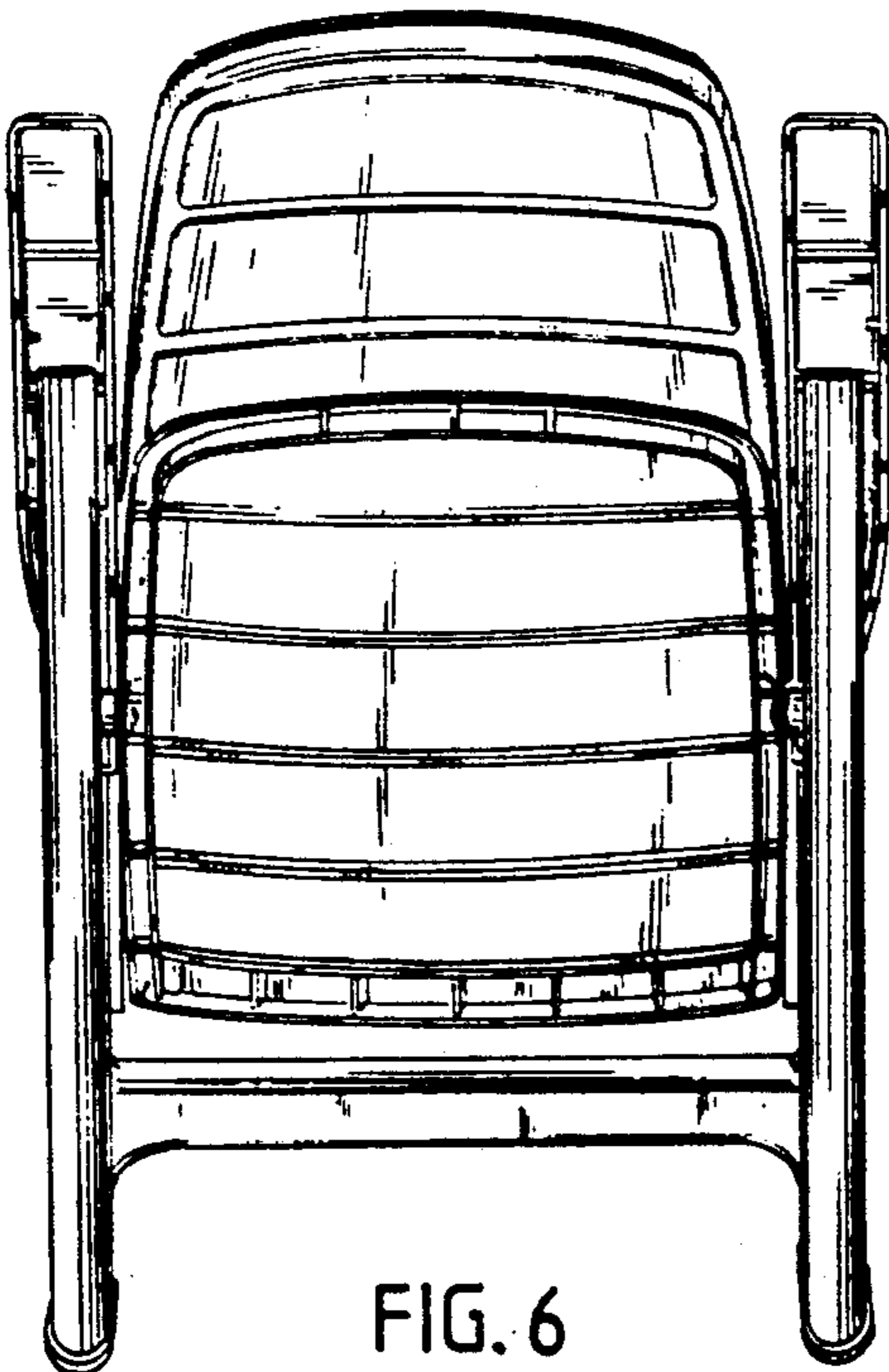

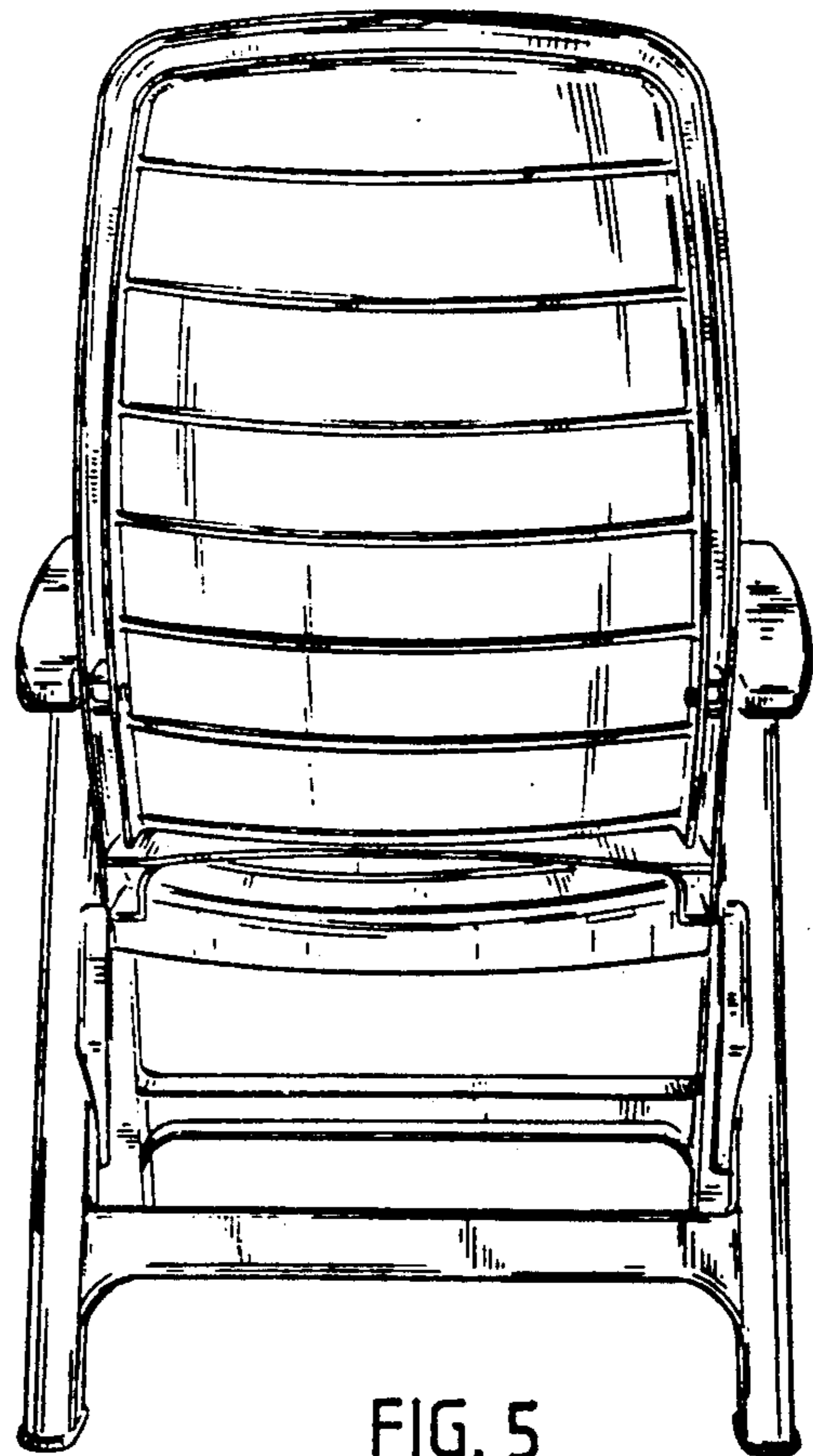
