The ornamental design for a display for baseball cards,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a display for base-
ball cards embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite being a
mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodi-
ment of that shown in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof.

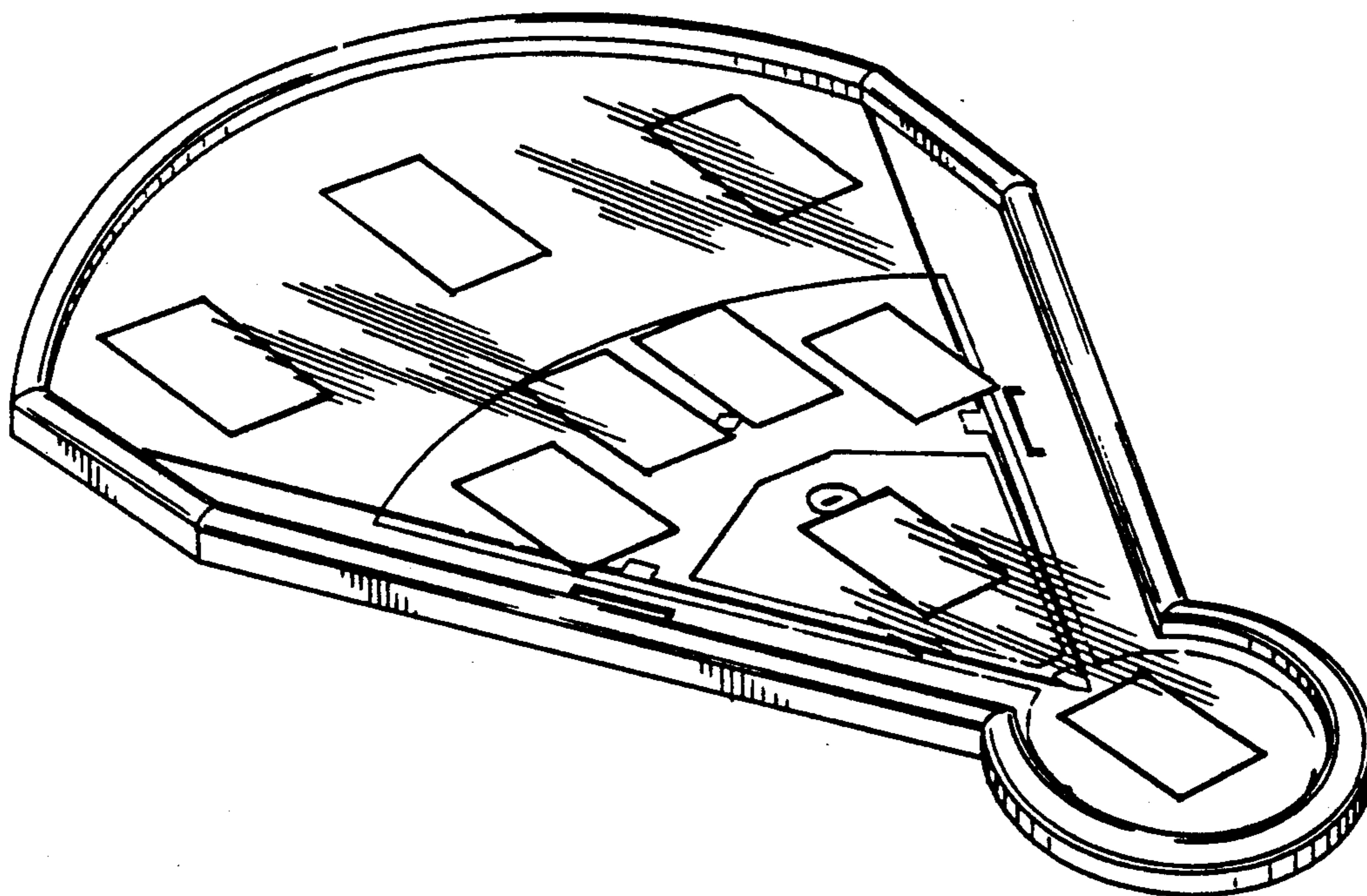

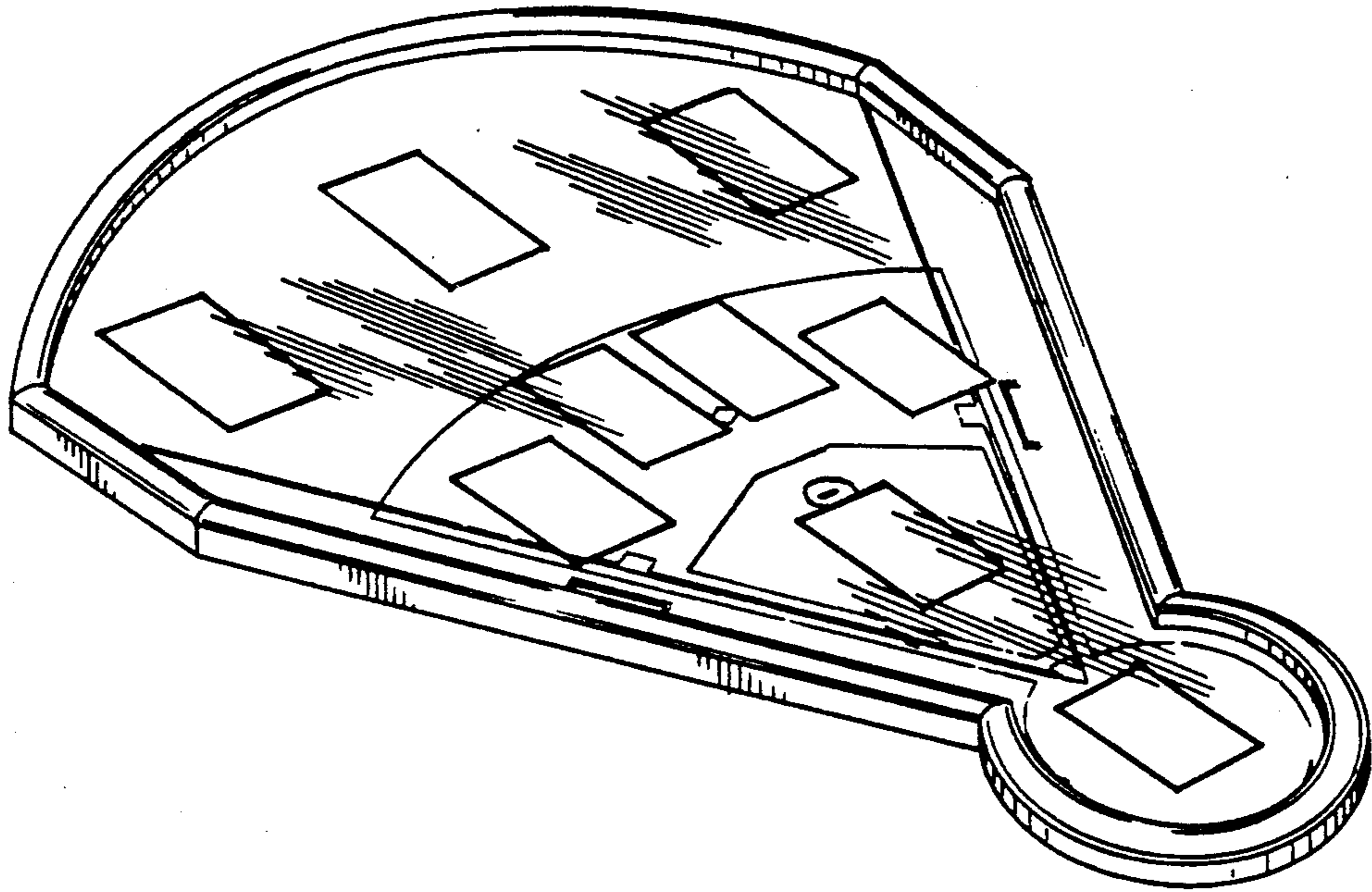

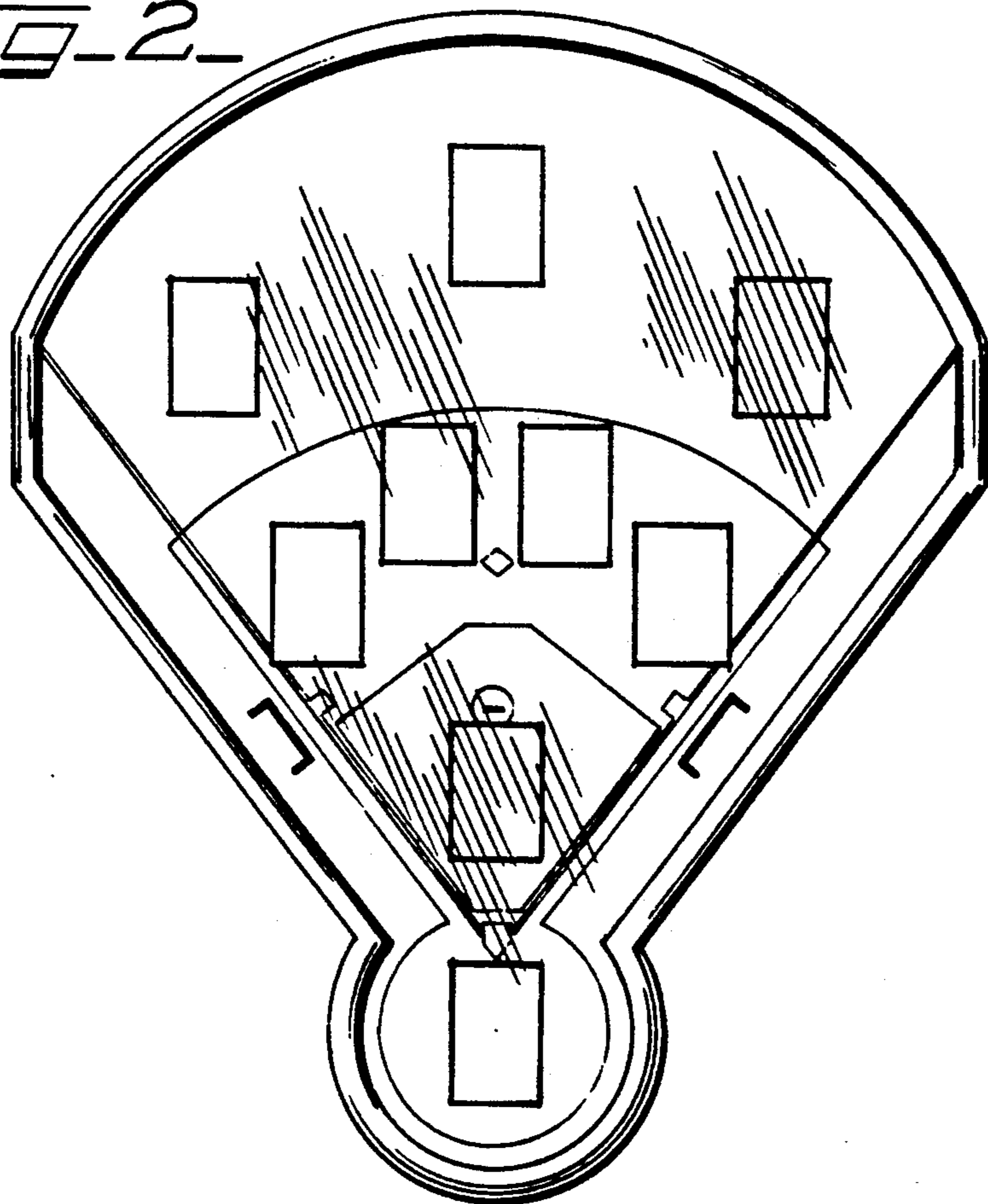

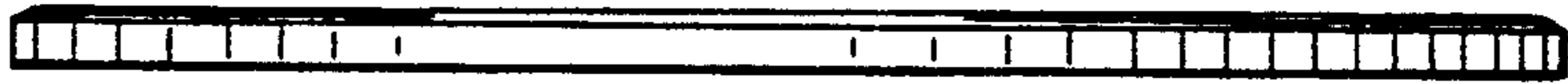

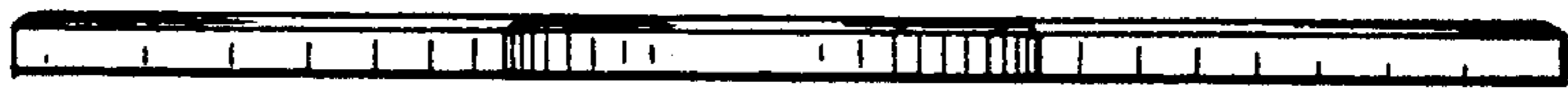

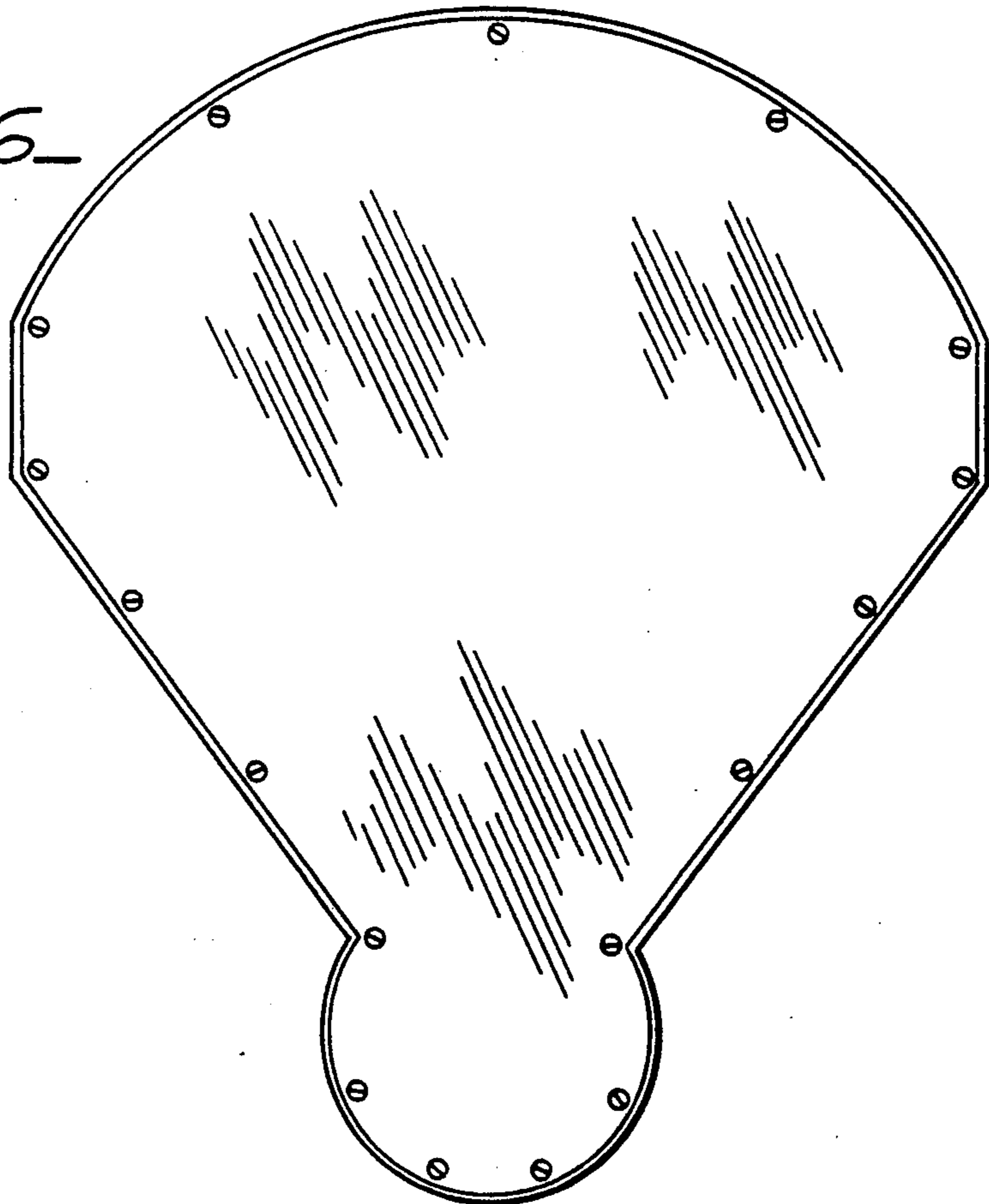

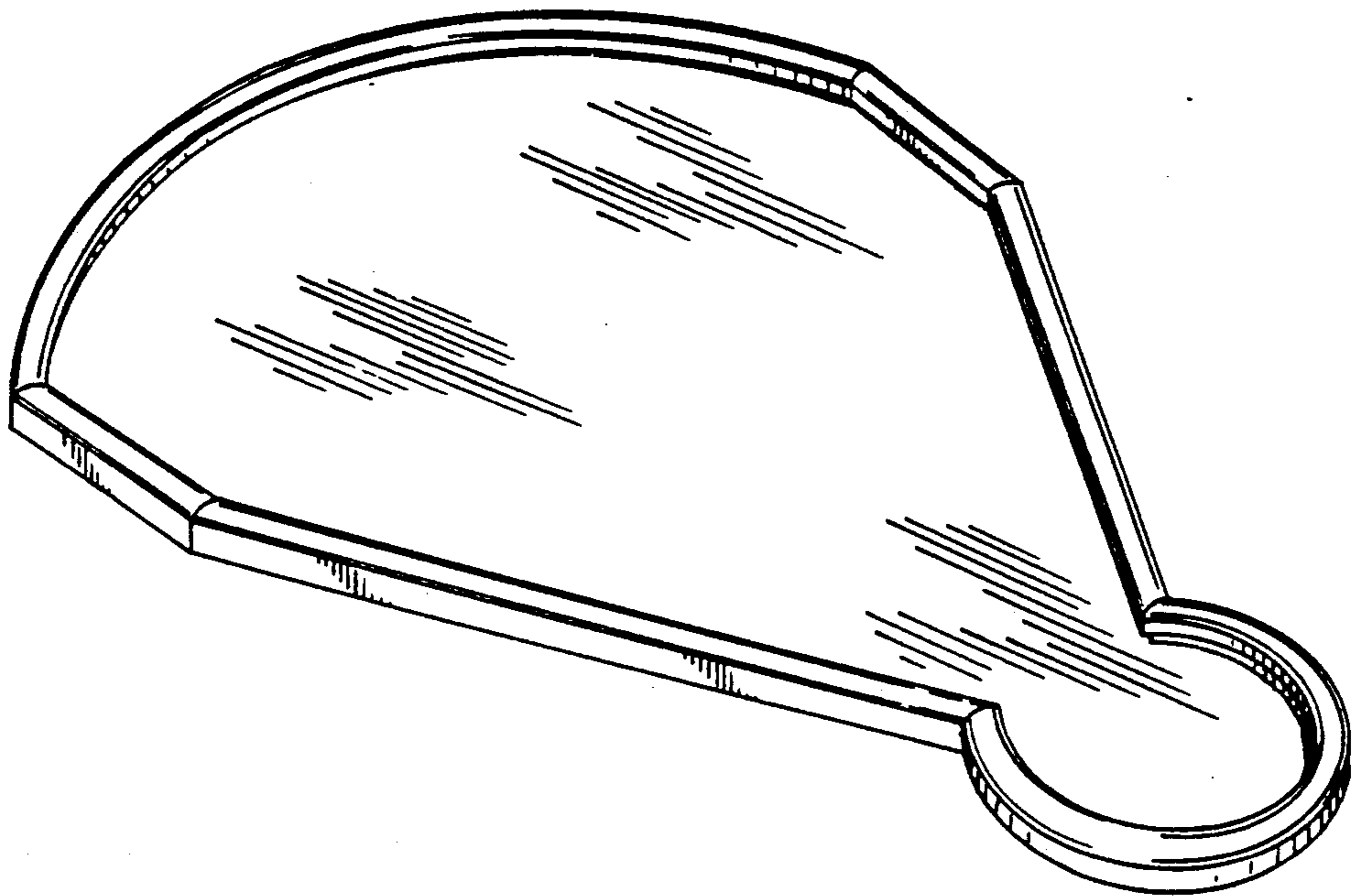
