[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sharpening rod, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a handle for sharpening rod showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a modified embodiment thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 6, the right side being a mirror image;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 6;

FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 6; and,

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of FIG. 6.

The broken line showing of the sharpening rod is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

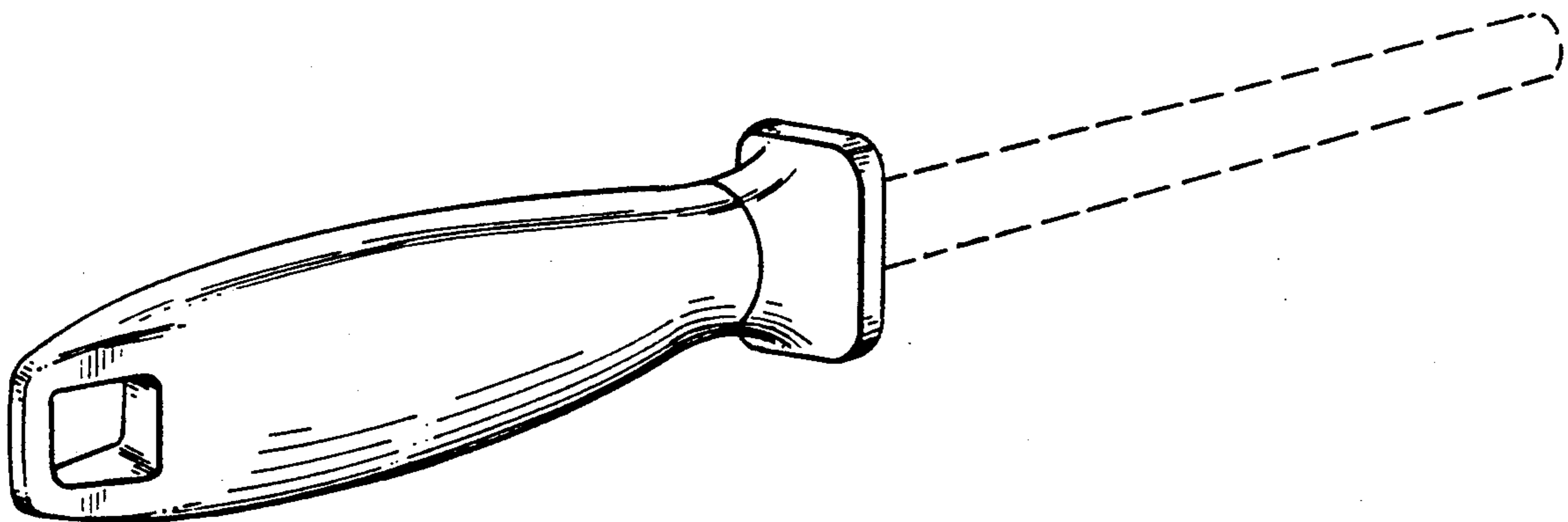

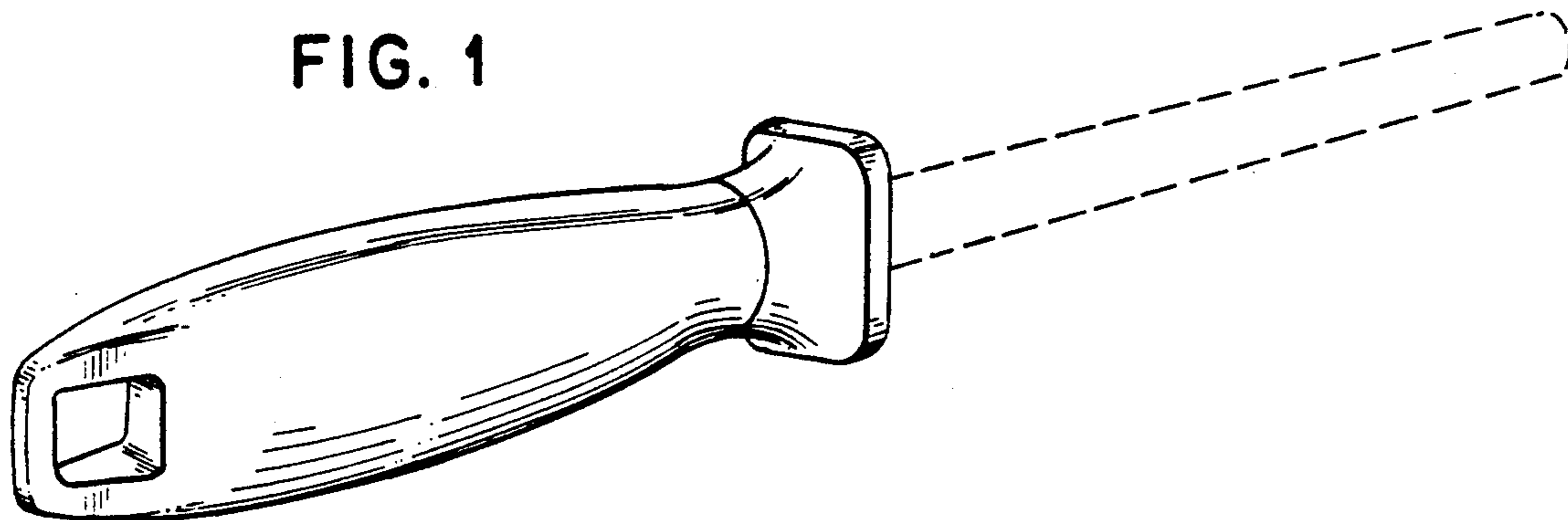

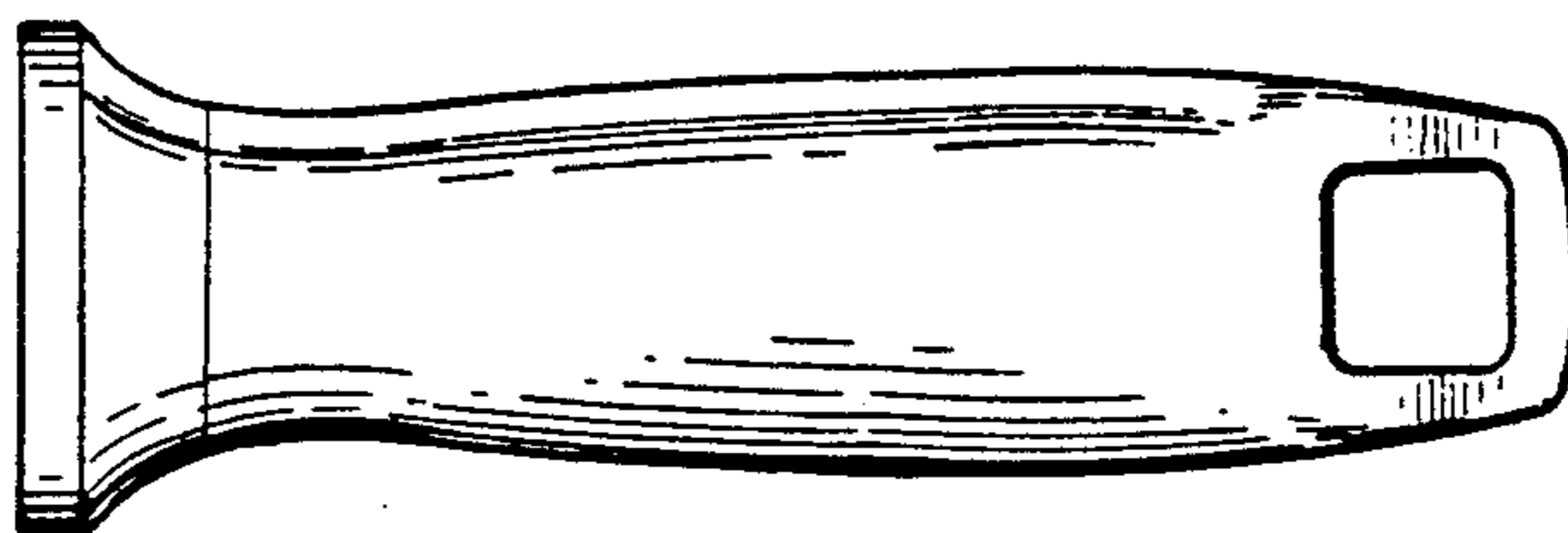

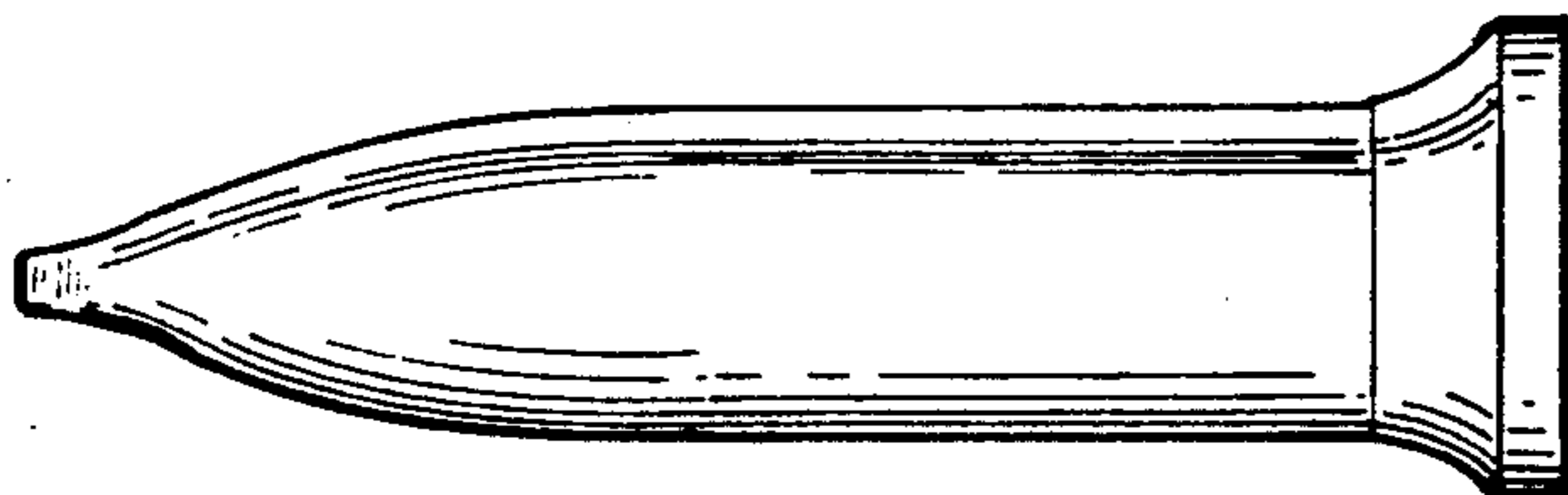

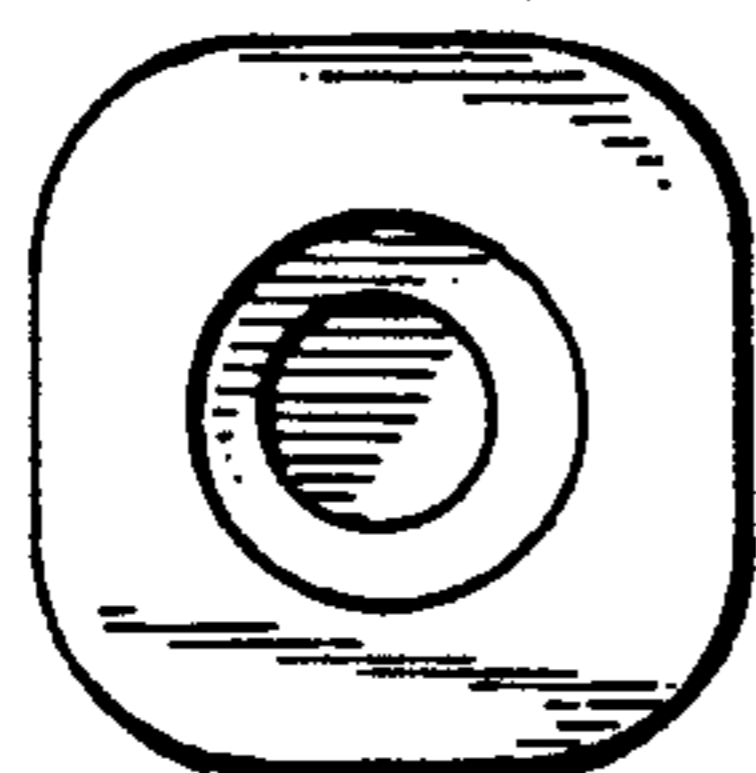

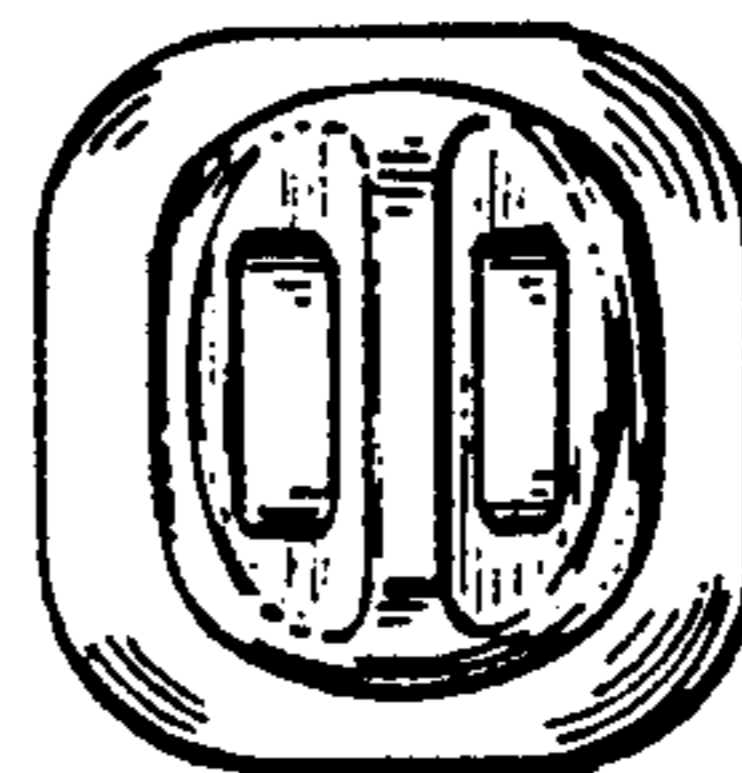

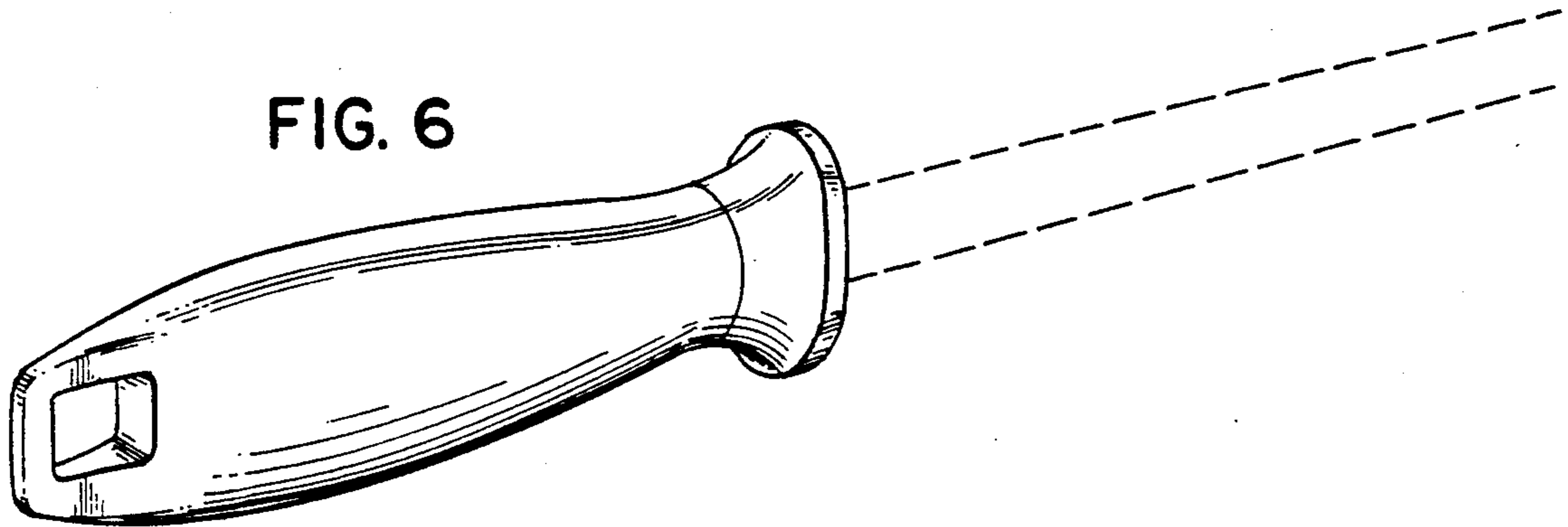

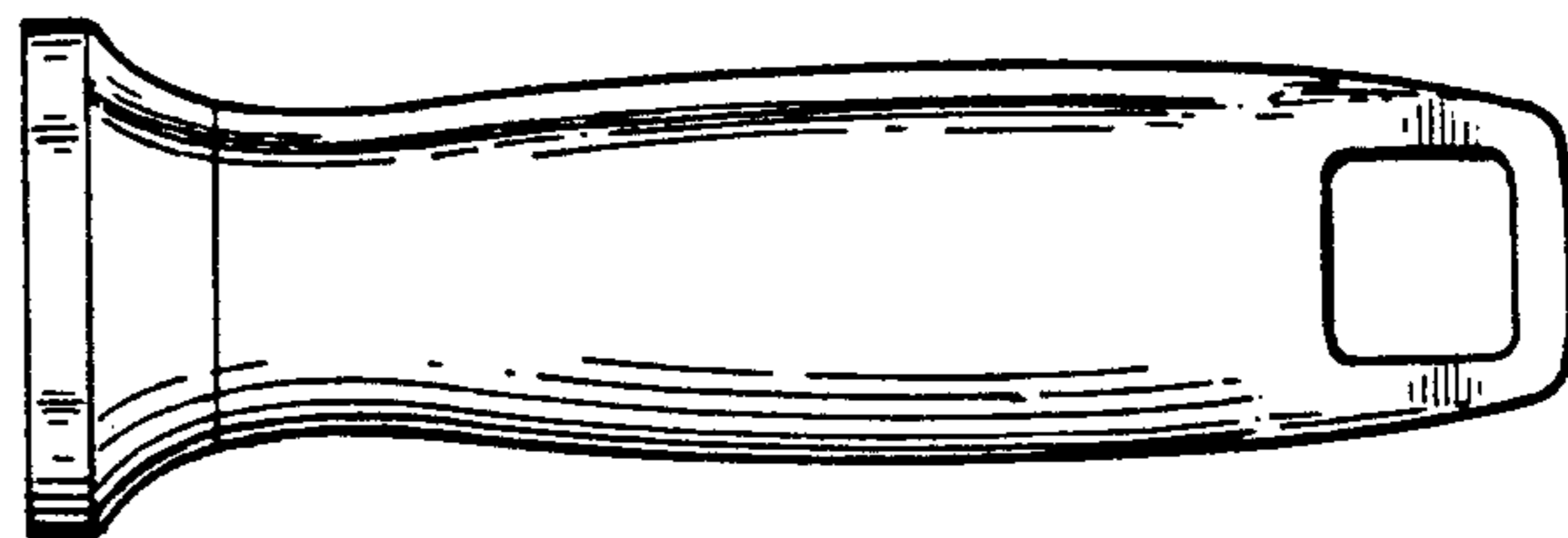

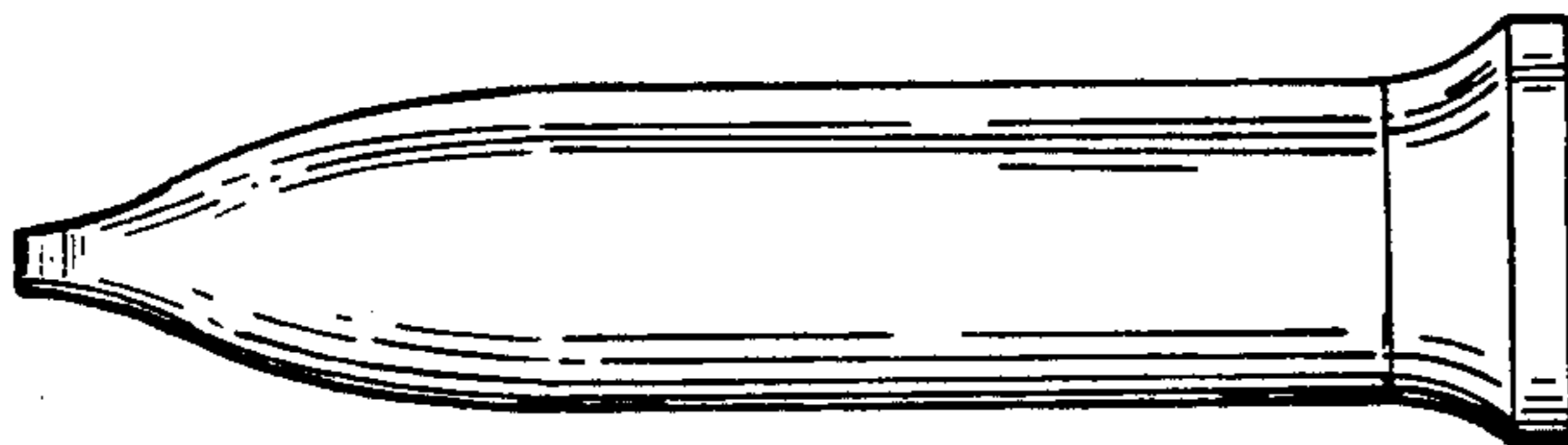

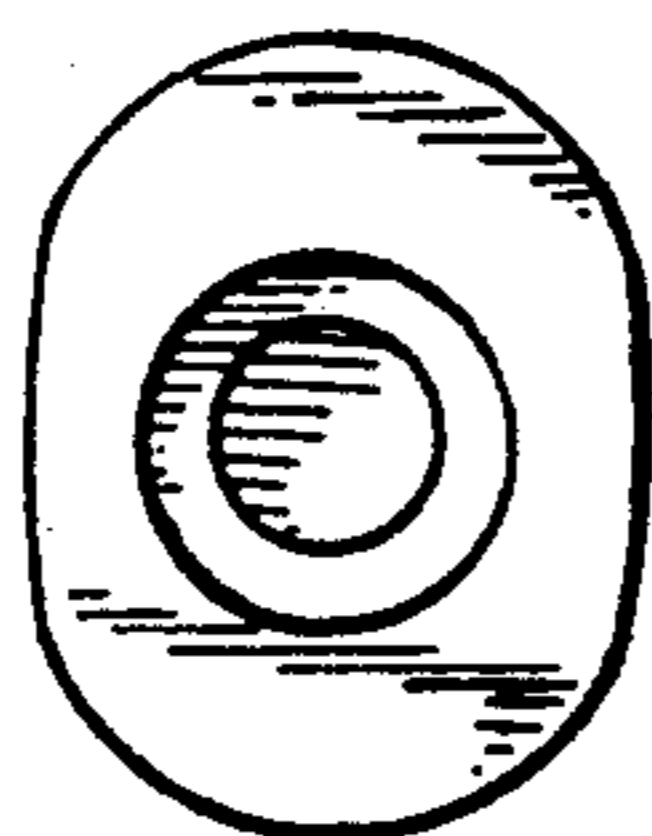
