[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a check protector/signer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a check protector/signer showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof. The electrical chord shown in FIGS. 2, 4, 5, 6 and 7 has been shown broken away for ease of illustration.

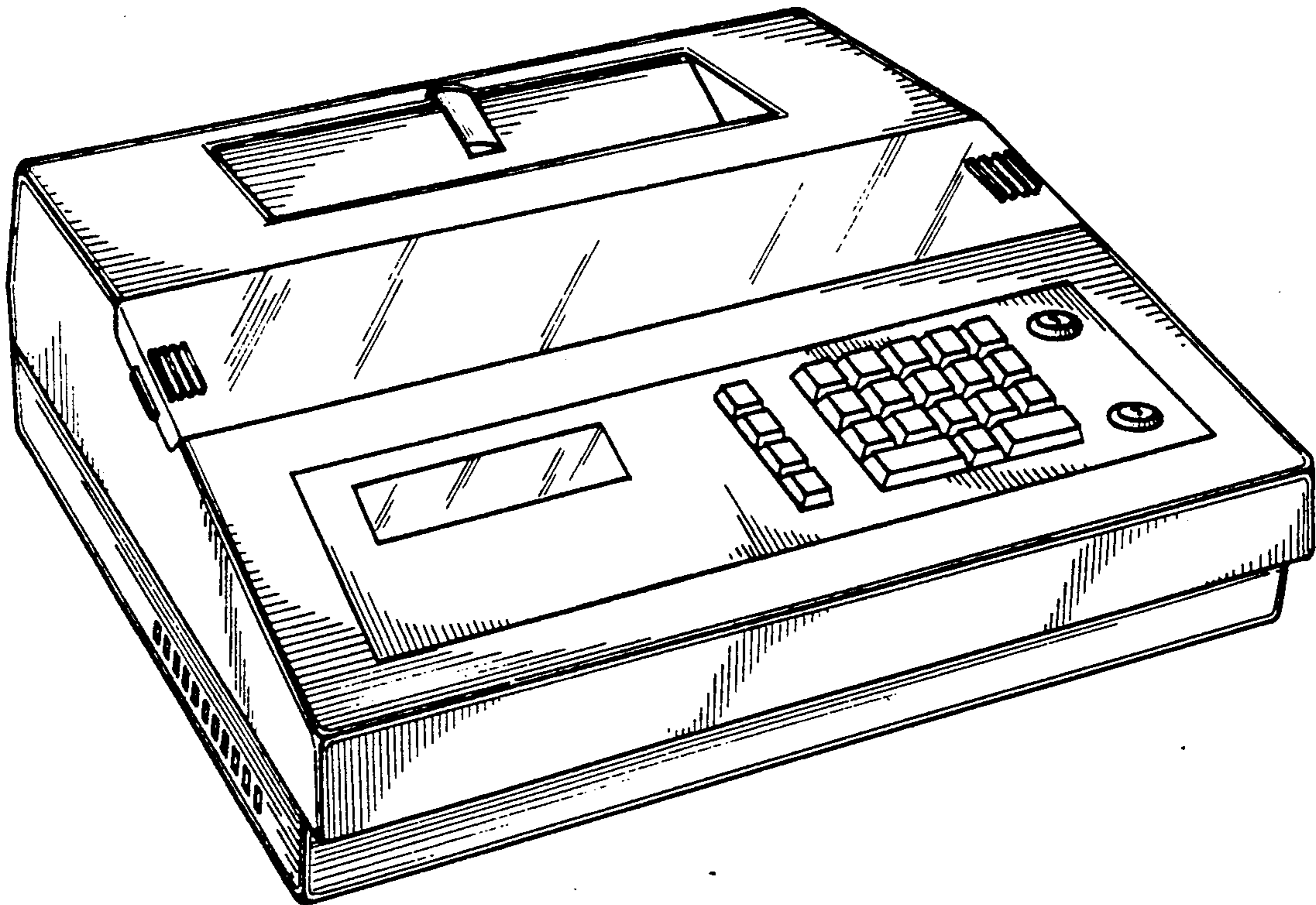

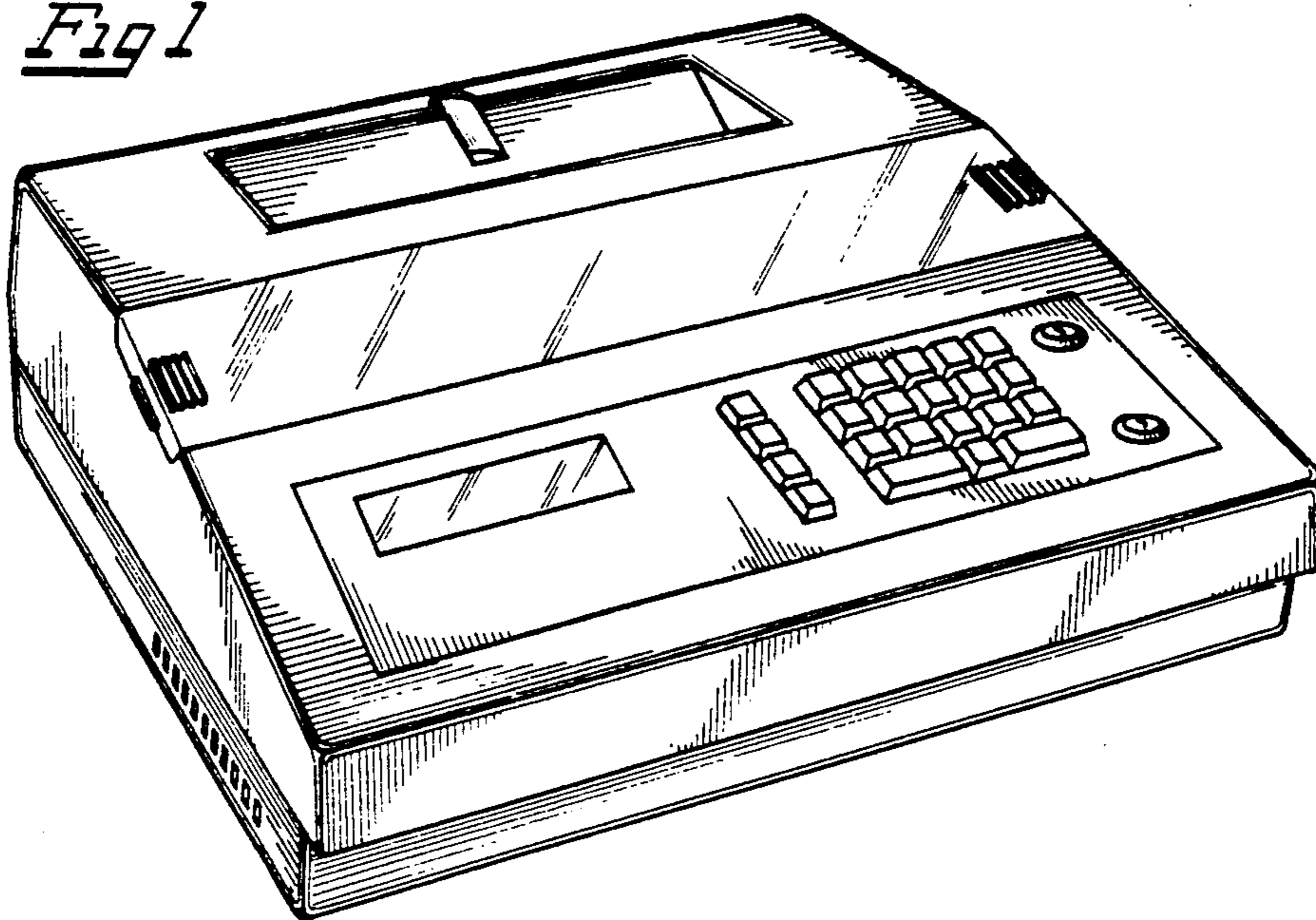

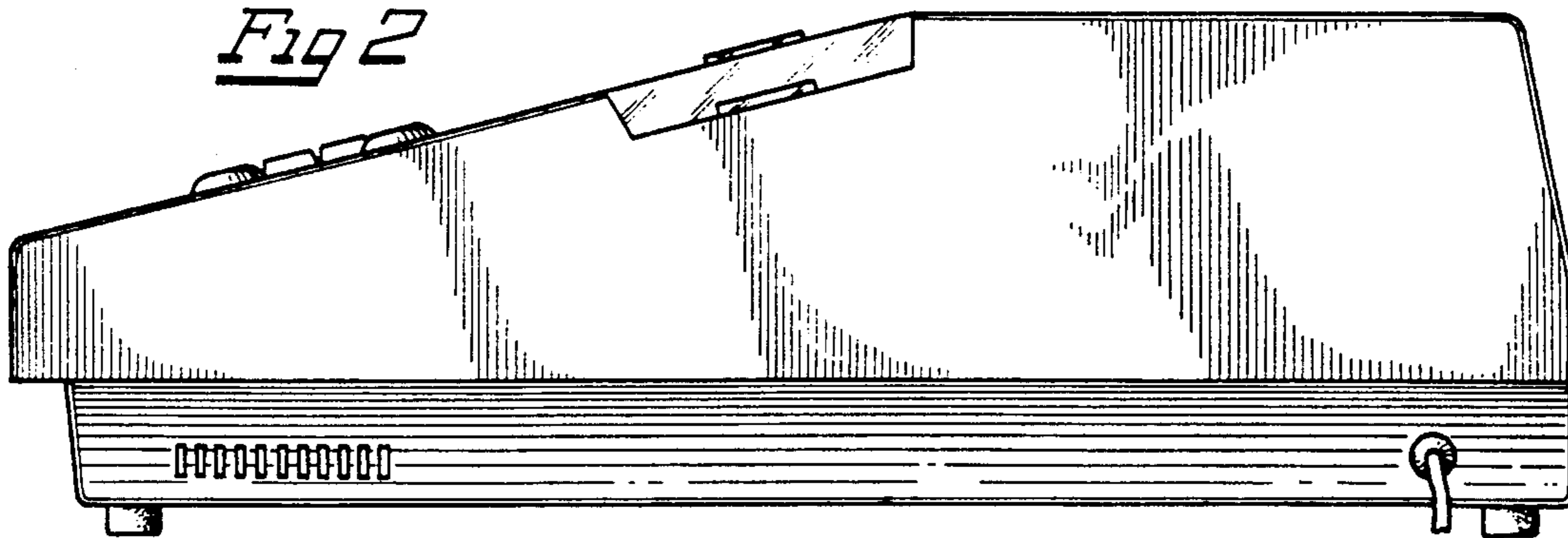

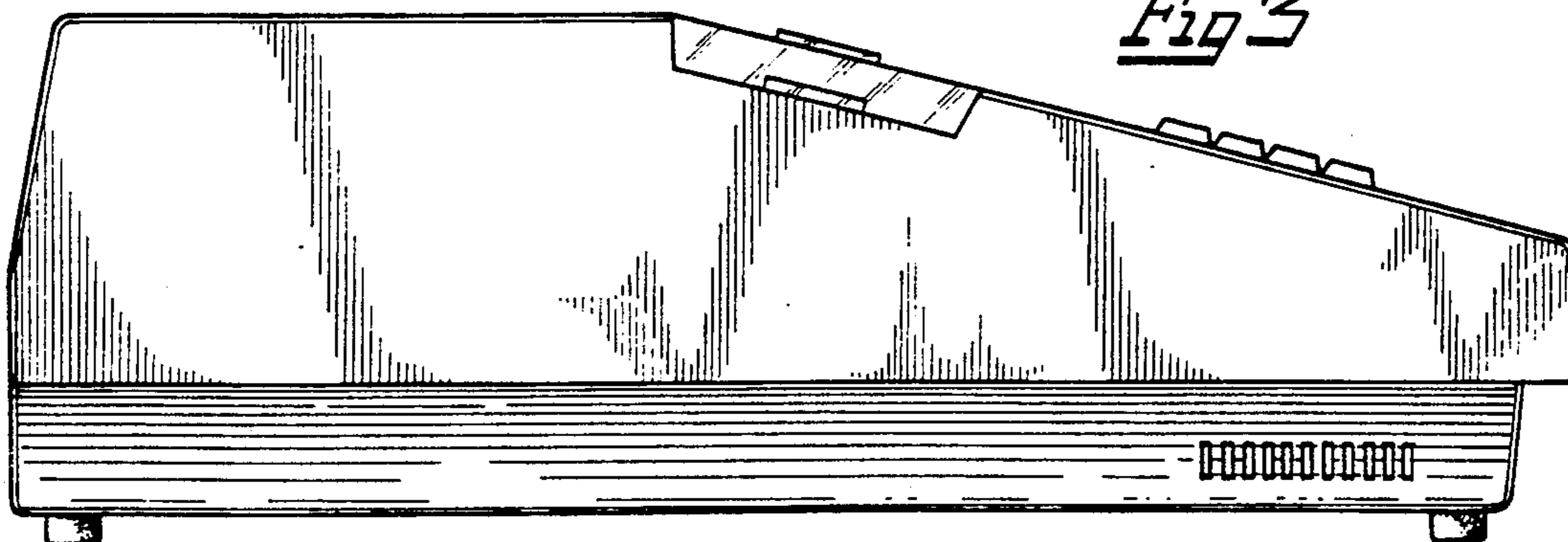

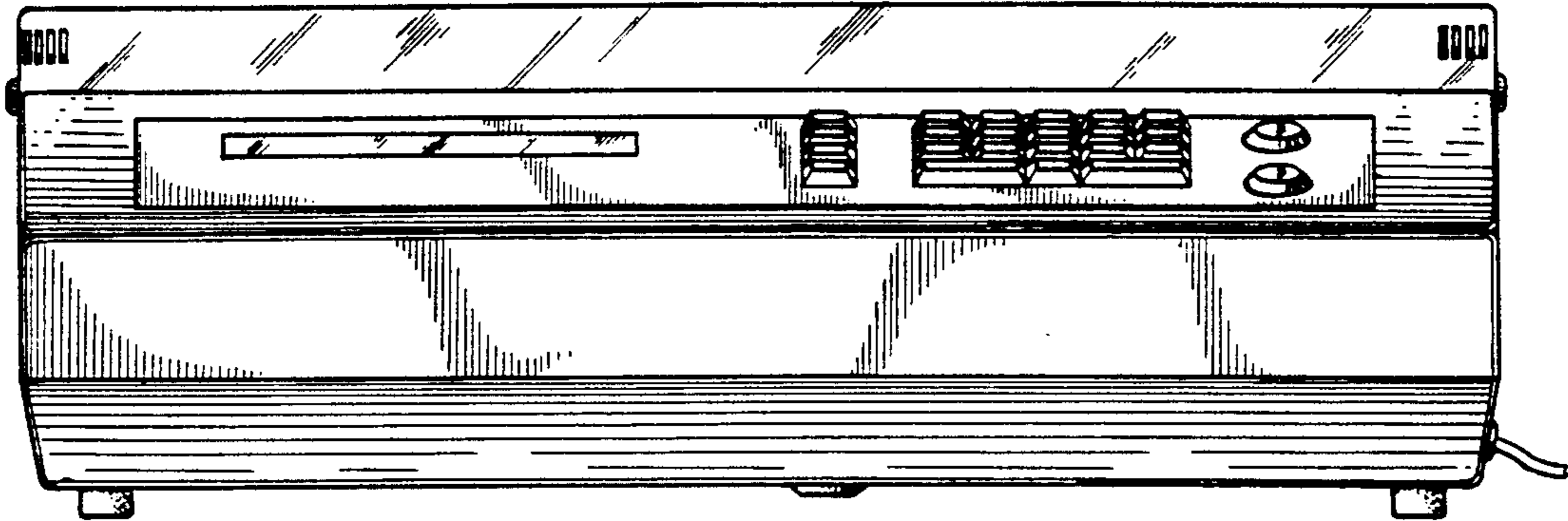

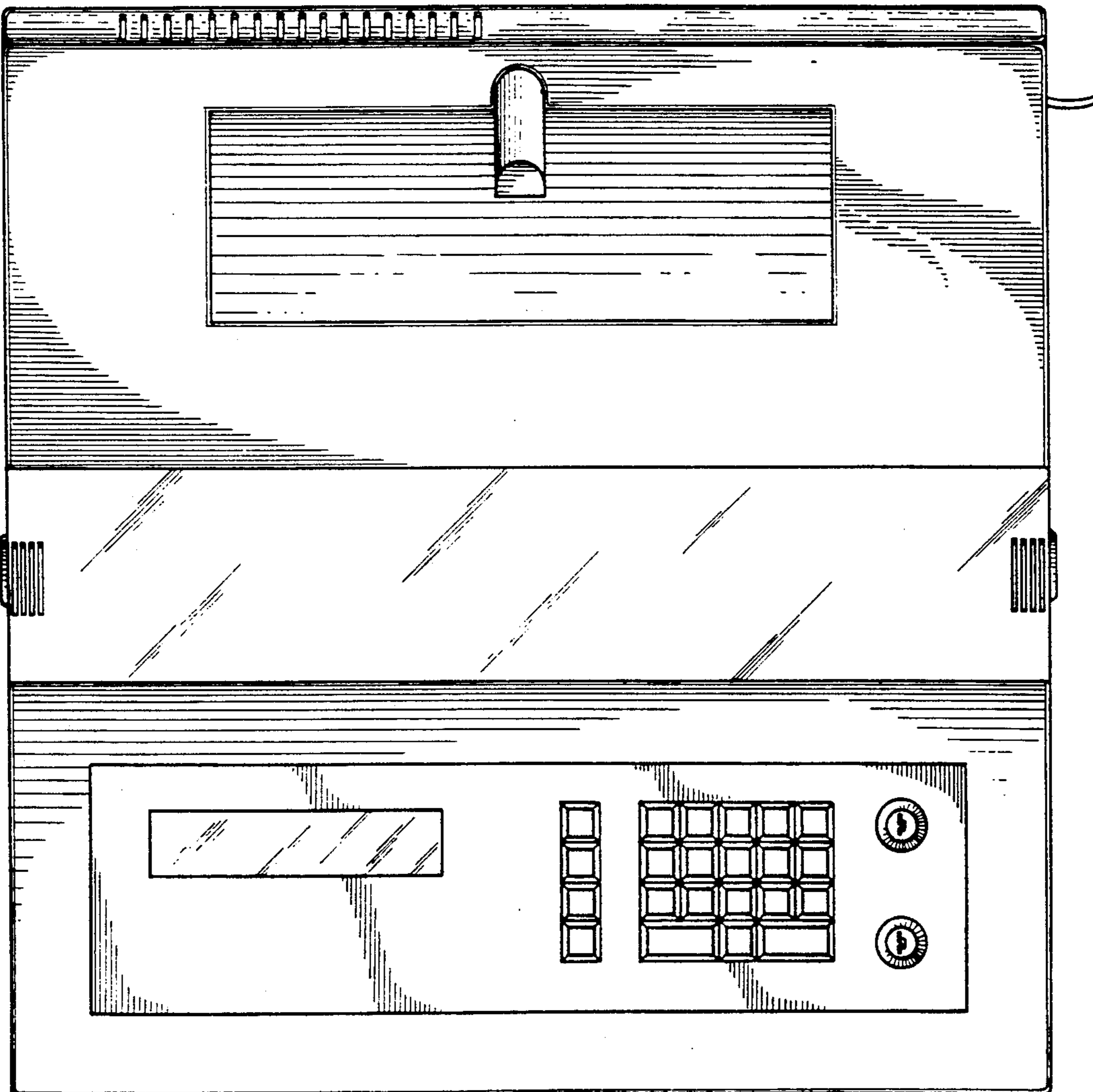

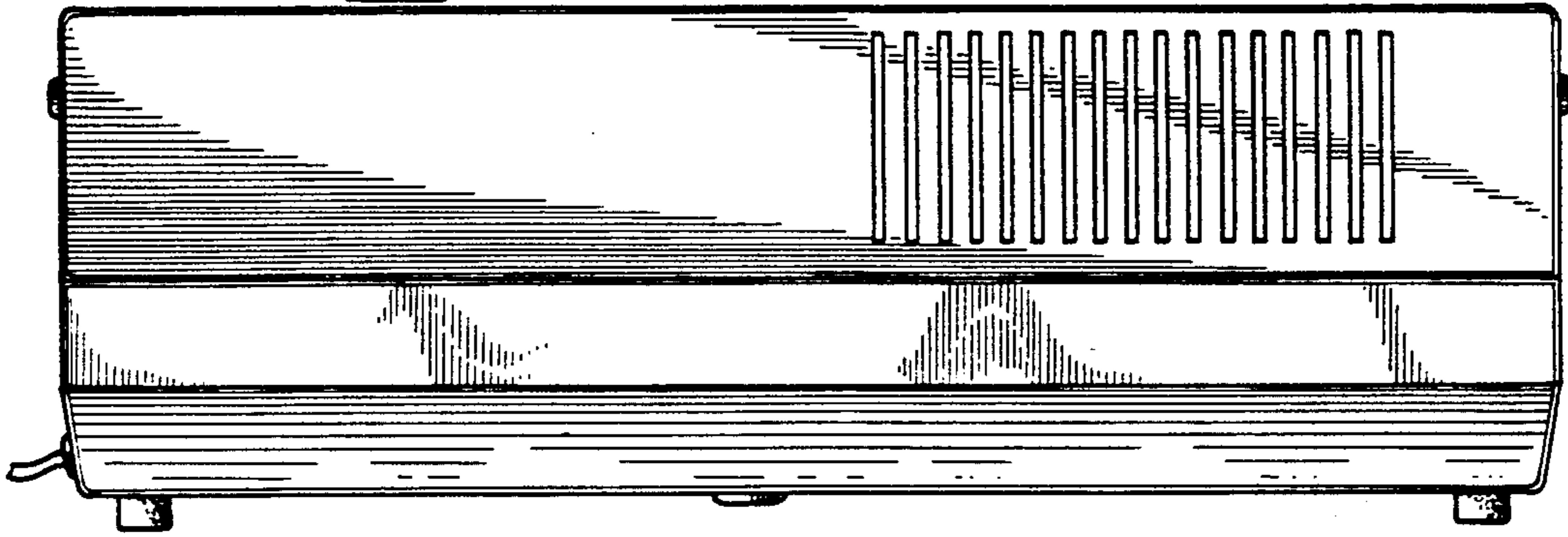
