FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of an electric-discharge processing machine showing my new design;

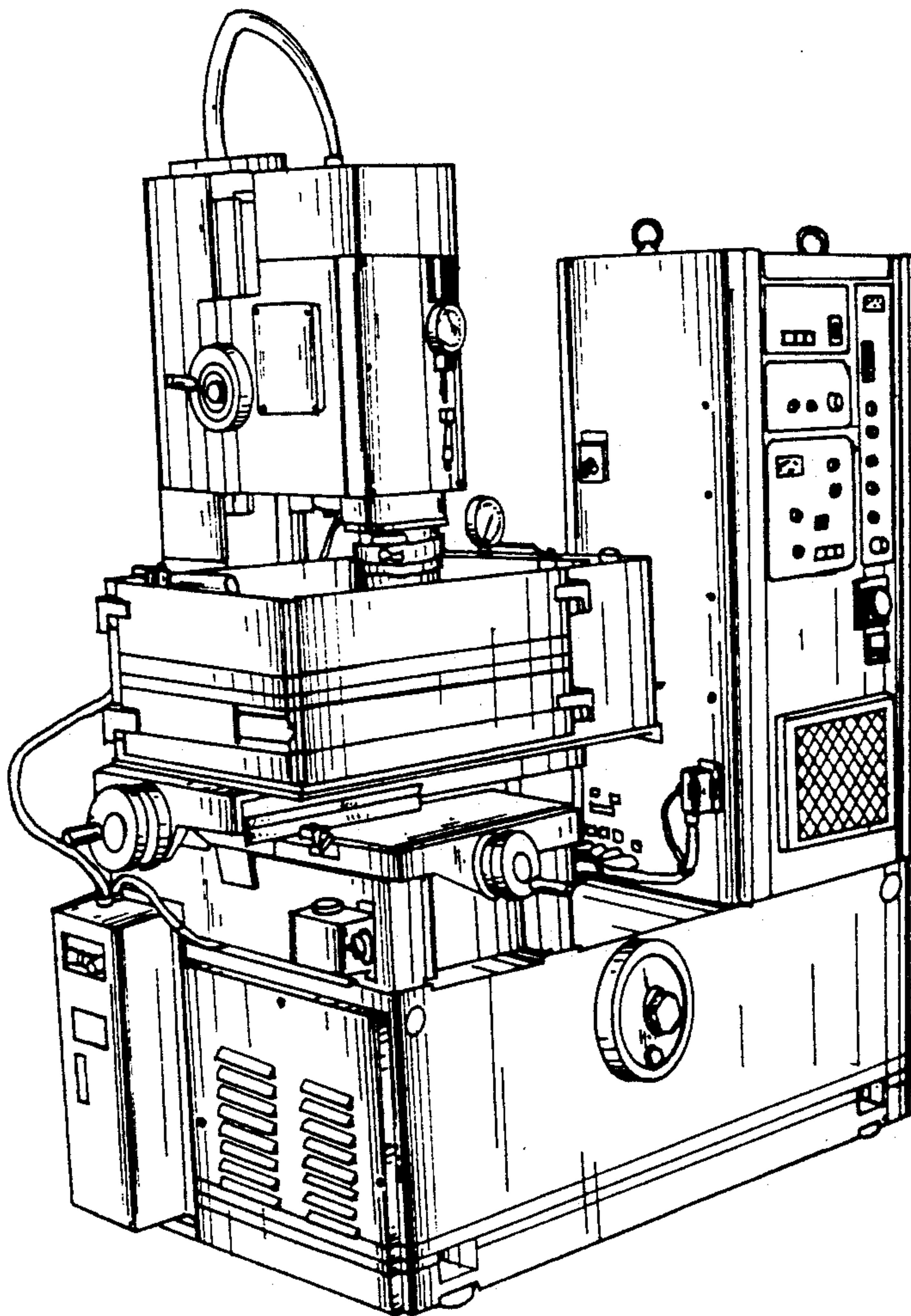
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.



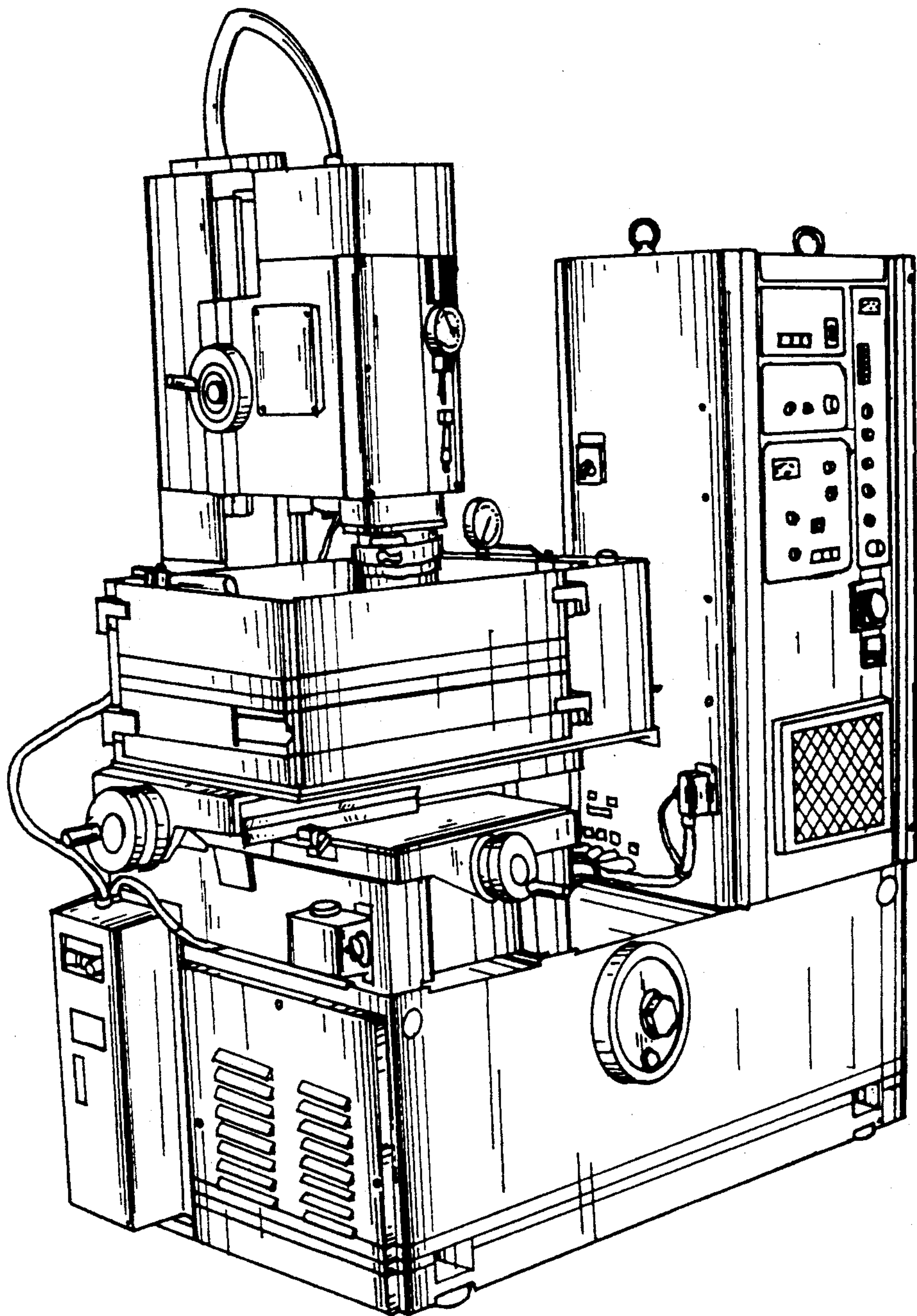

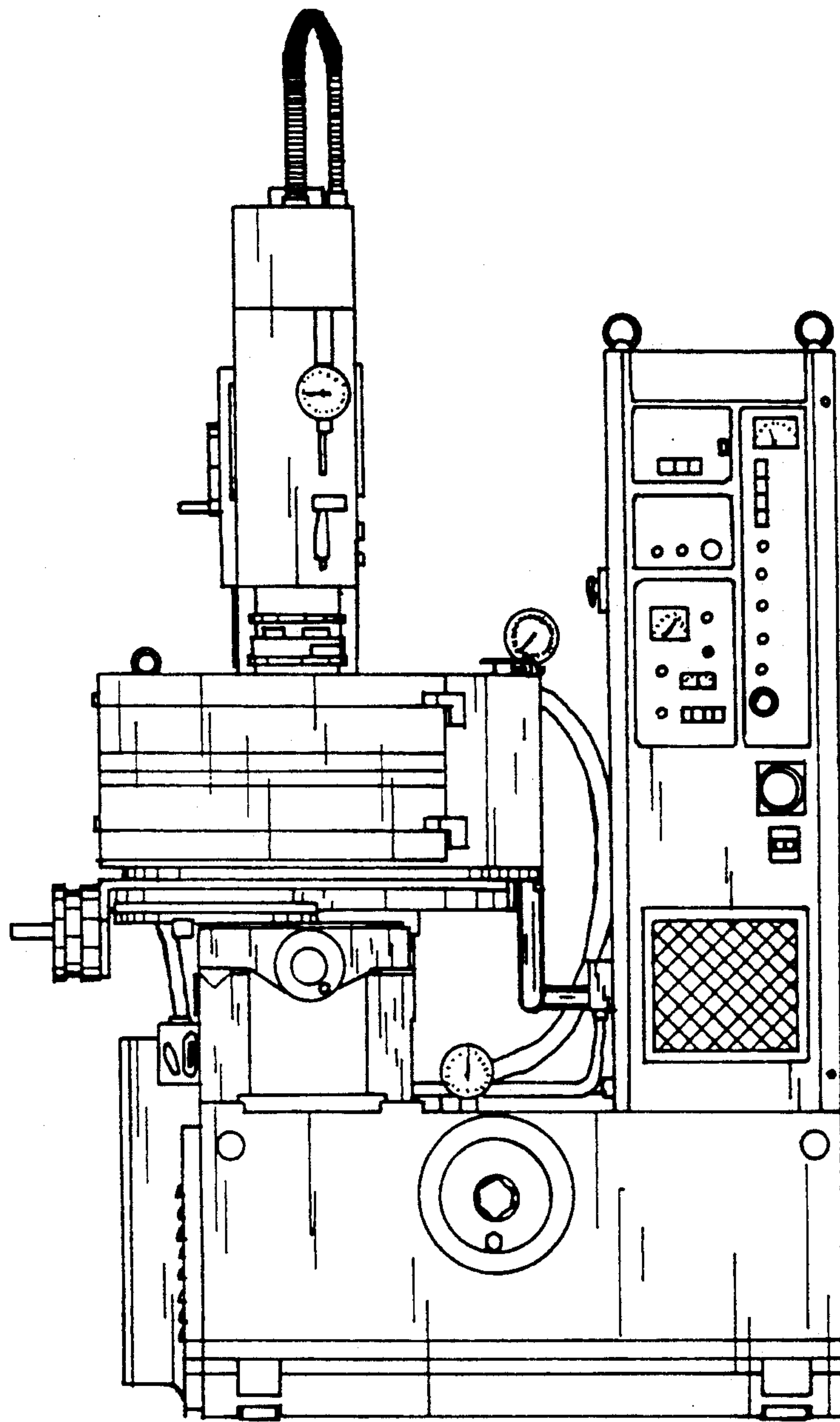

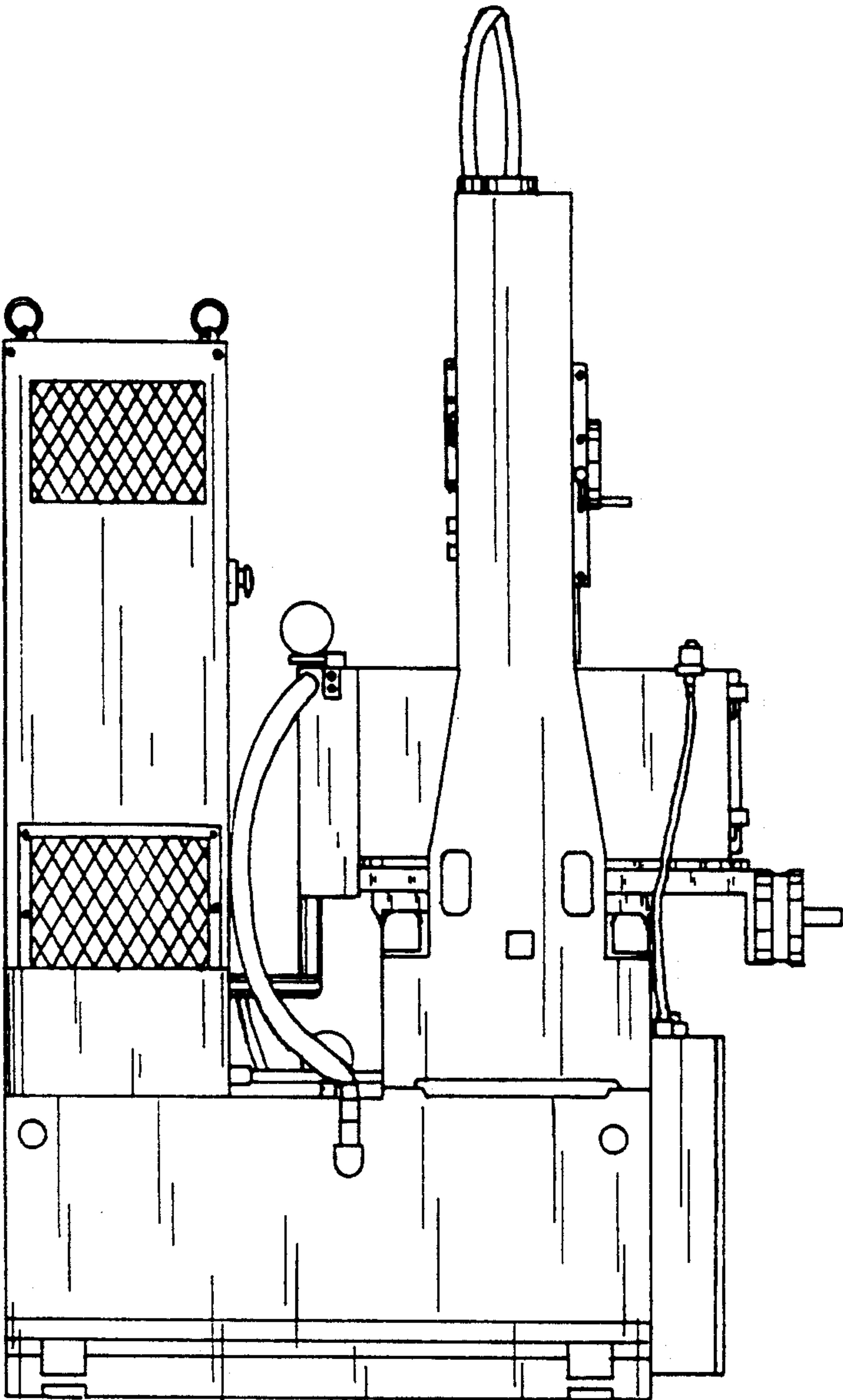

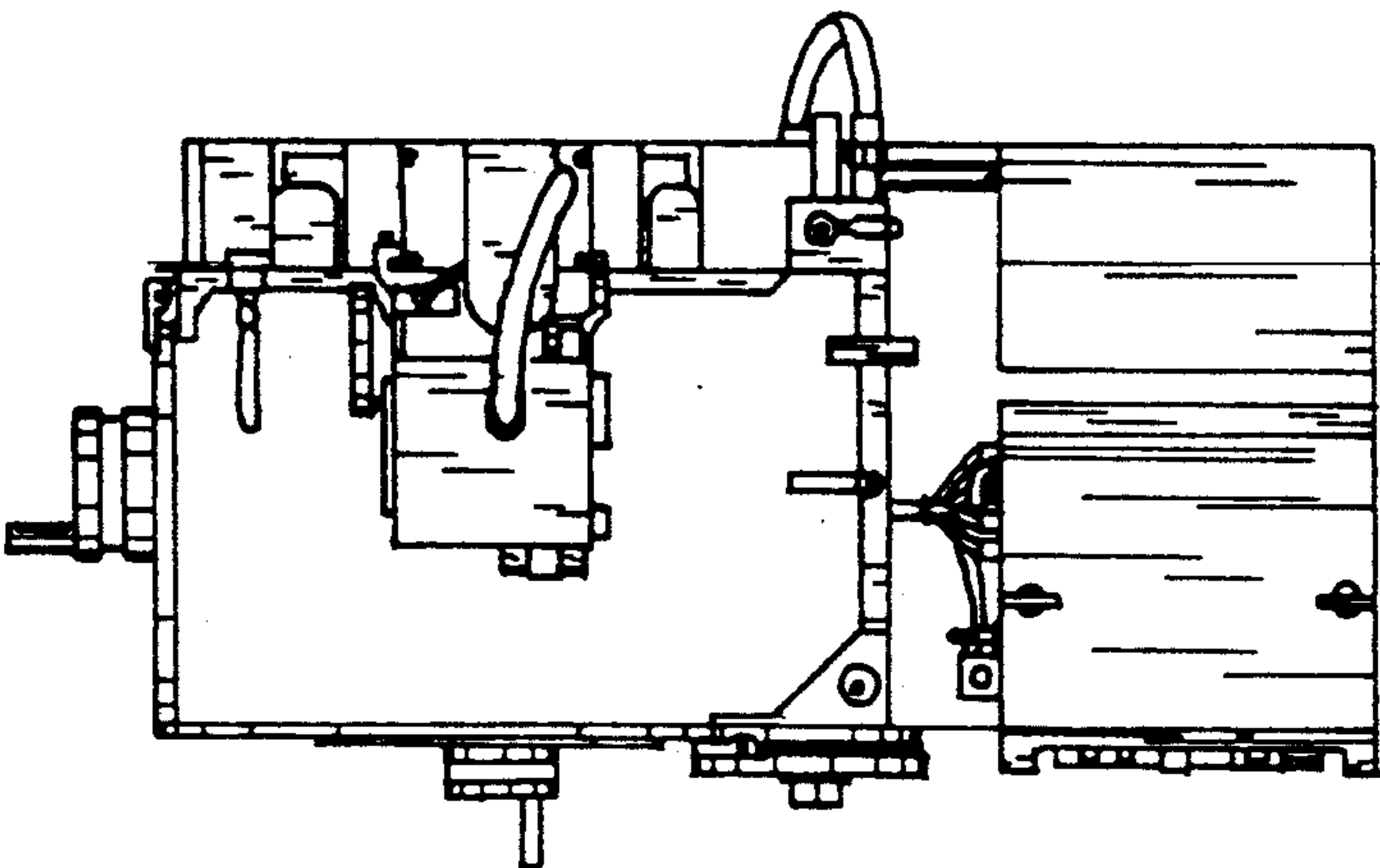

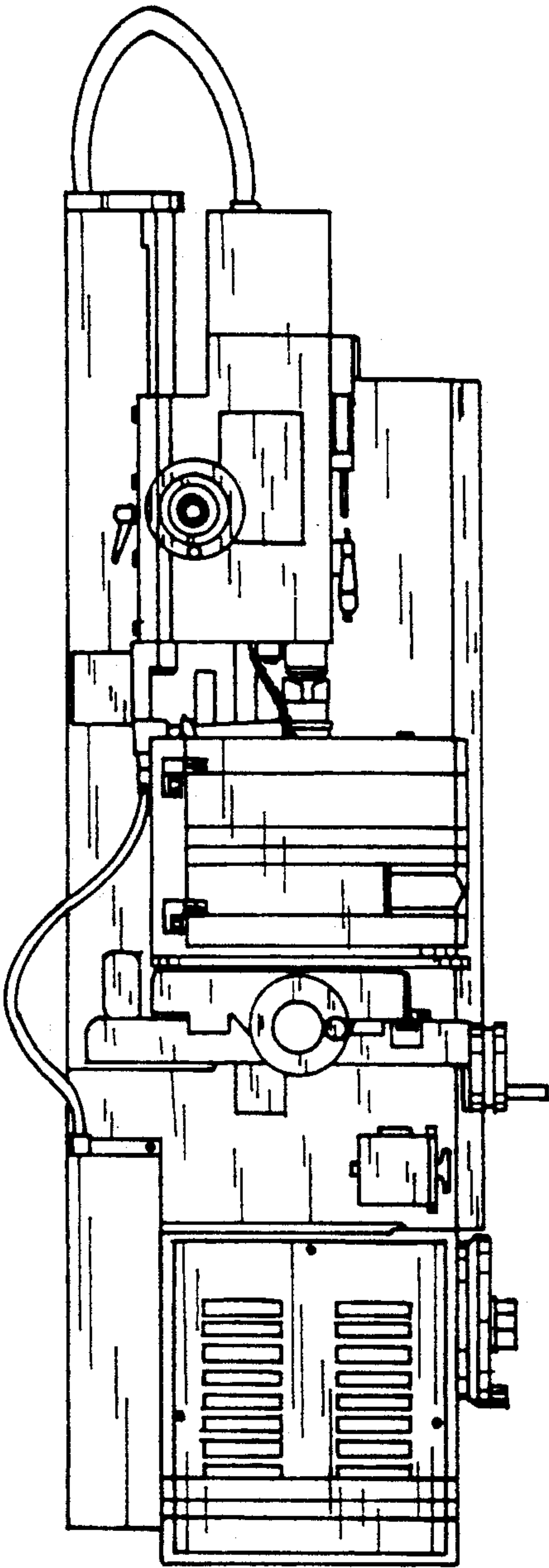

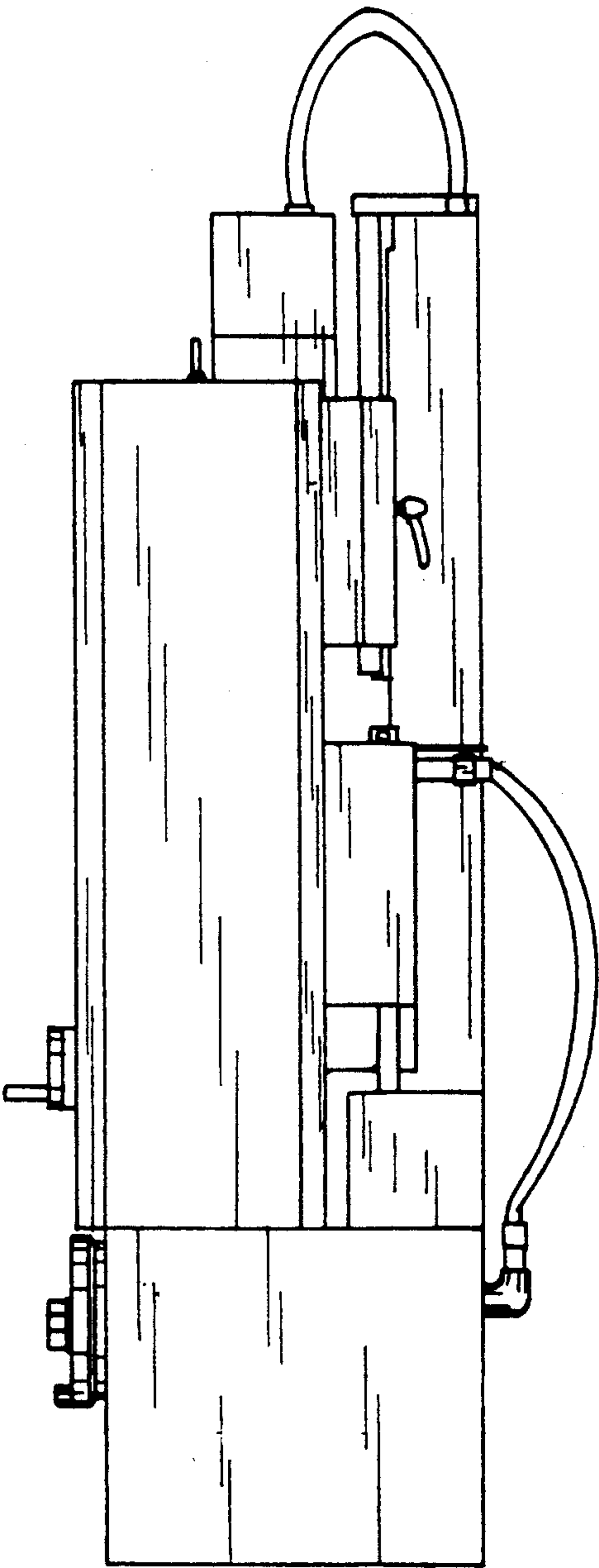
