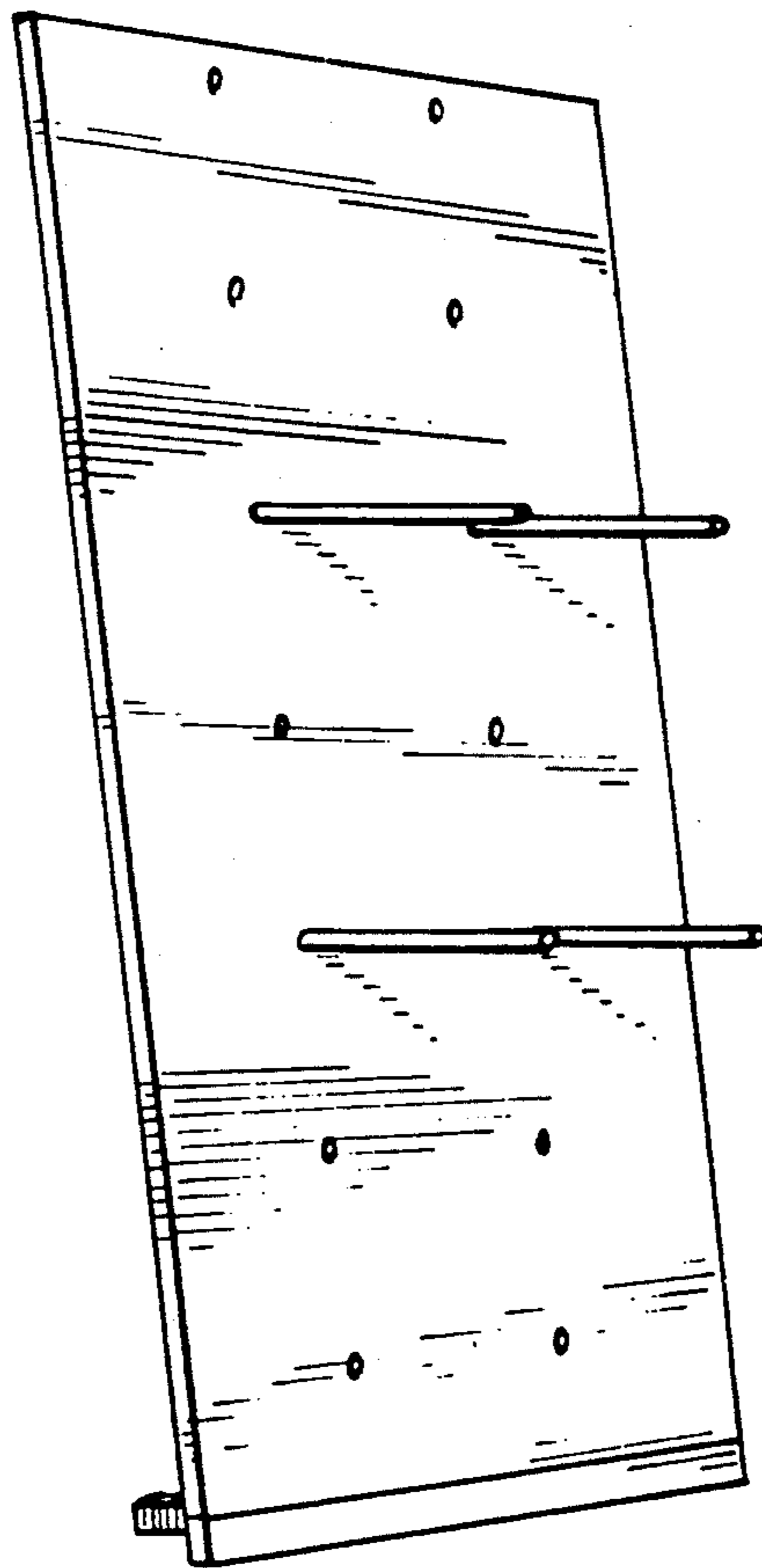
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view the right side being a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of thereof;



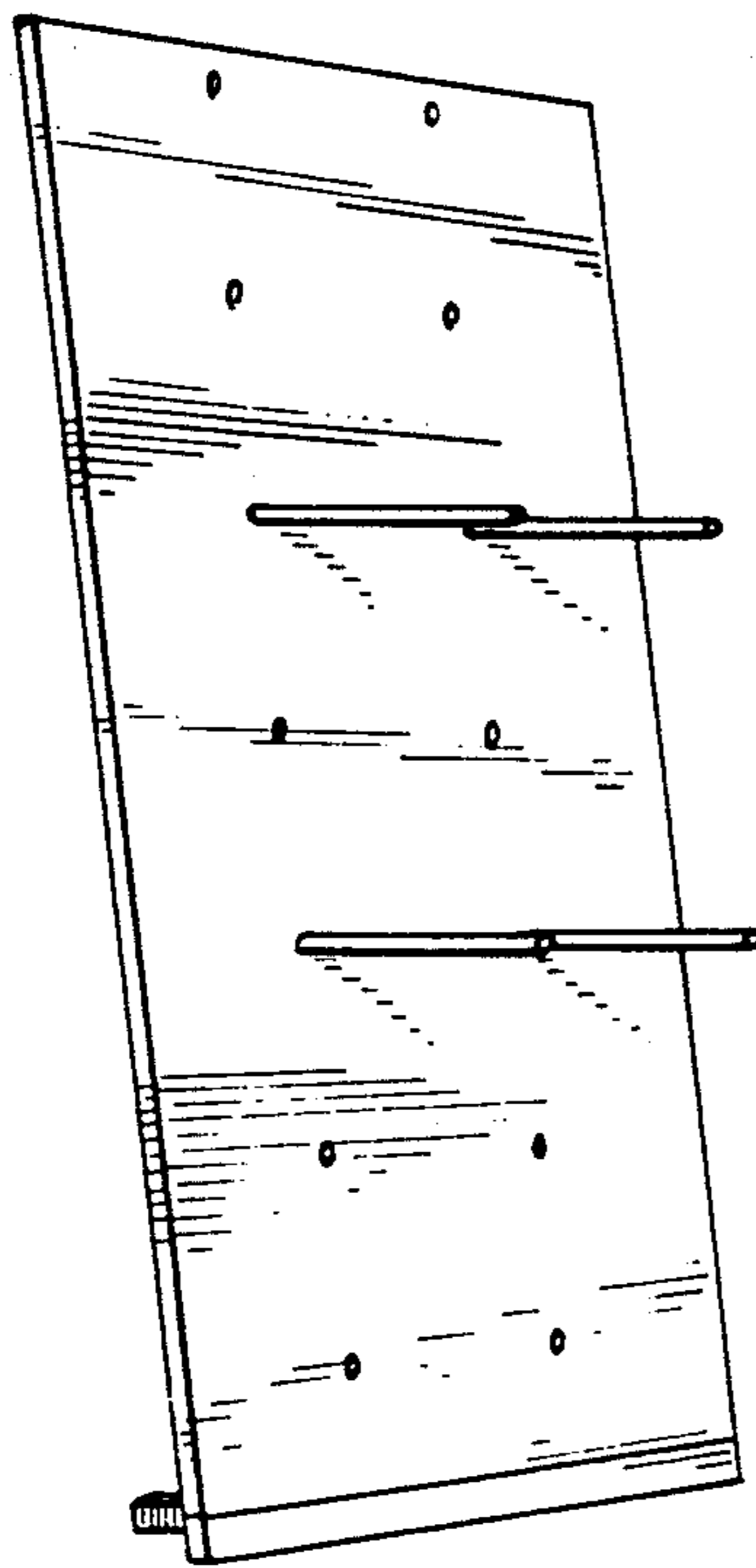

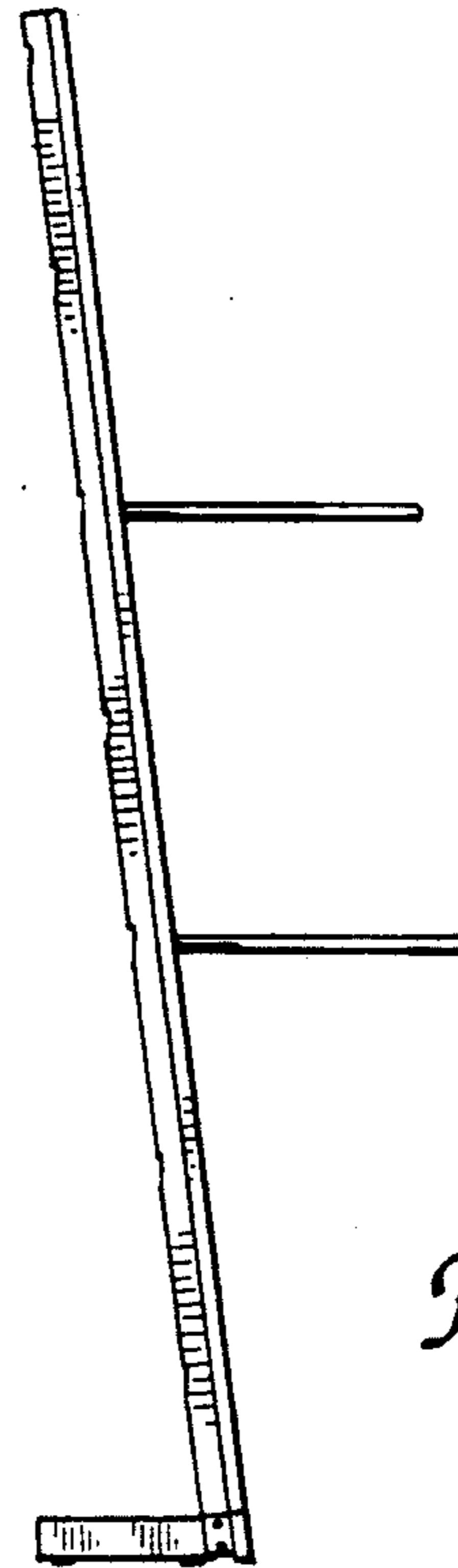

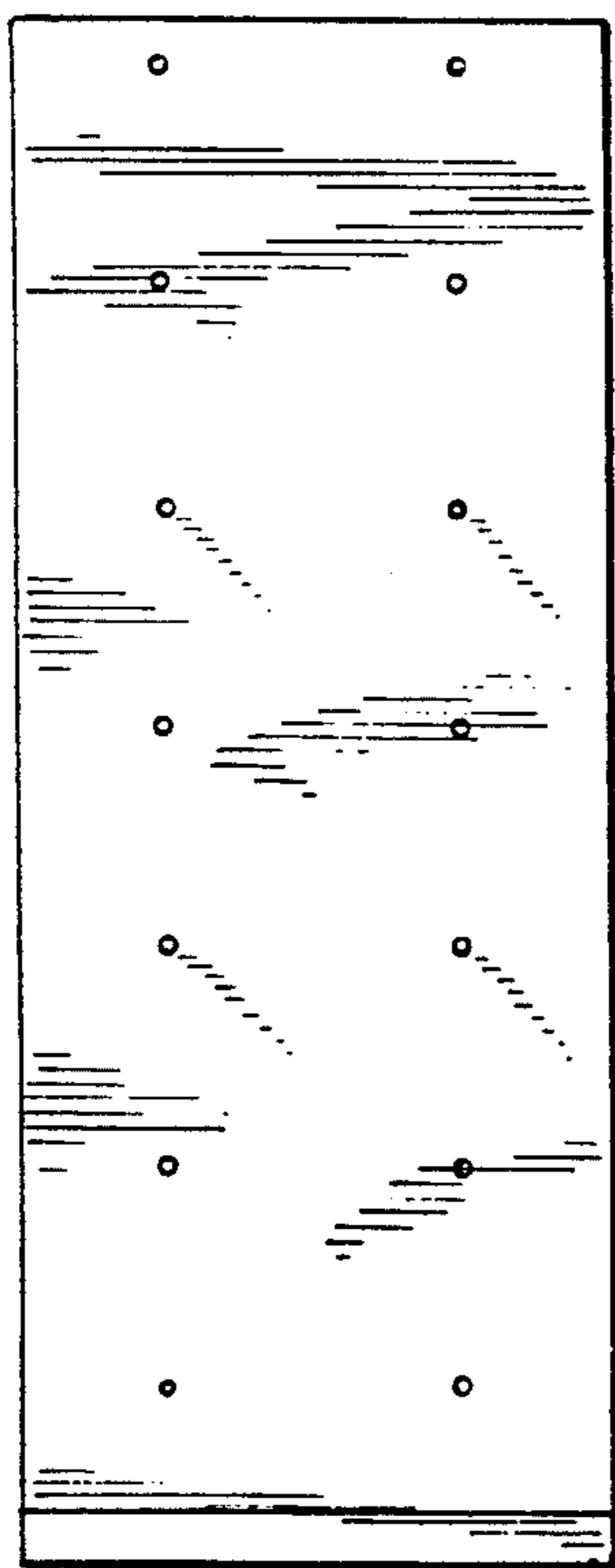

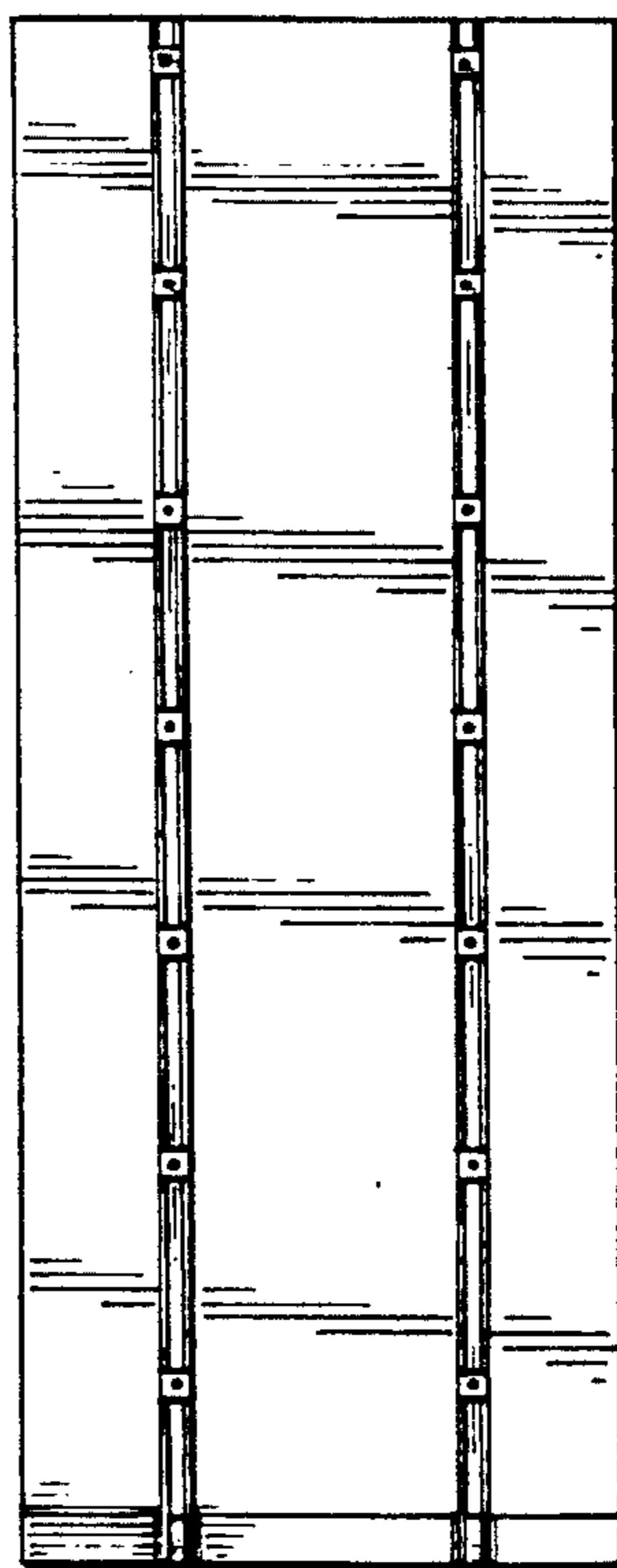

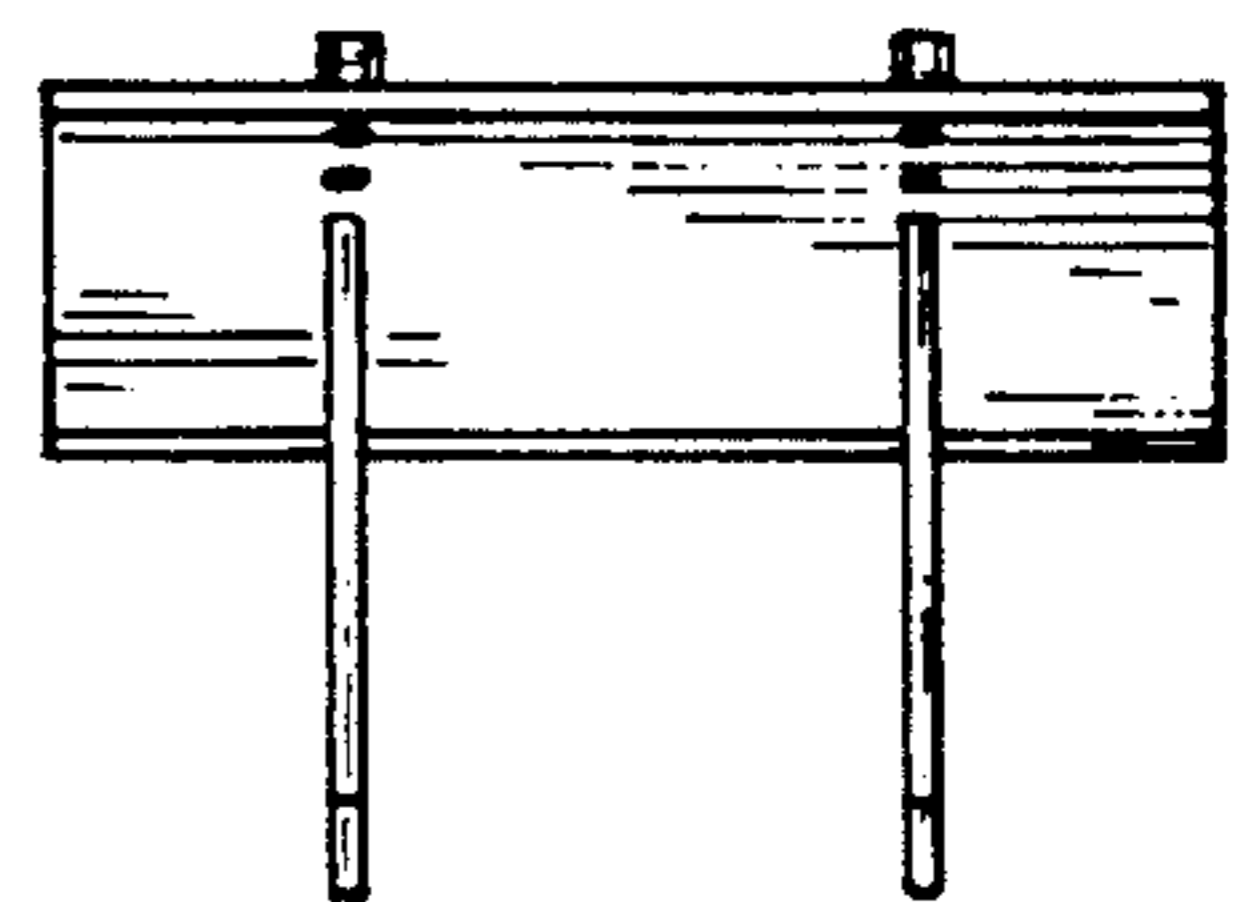

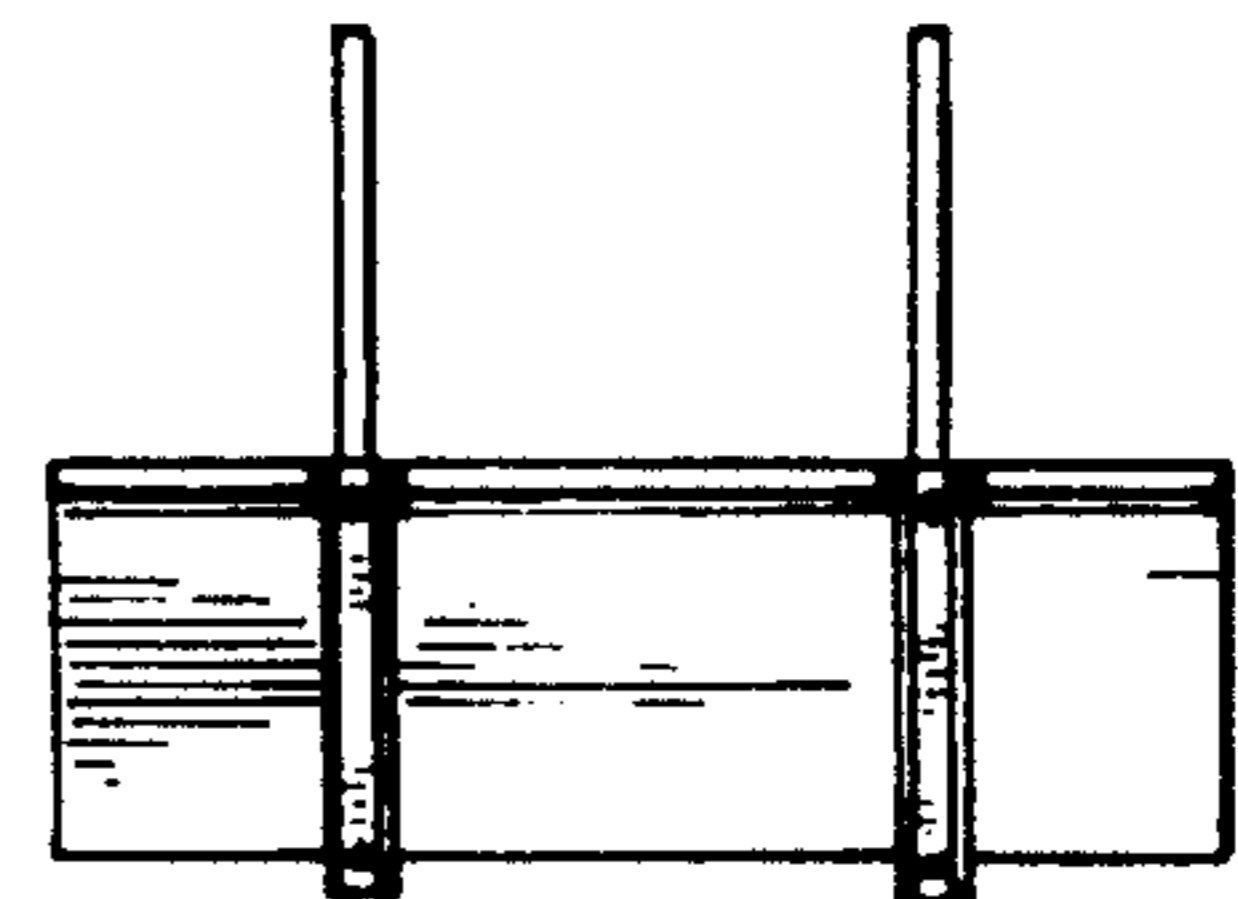
