FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

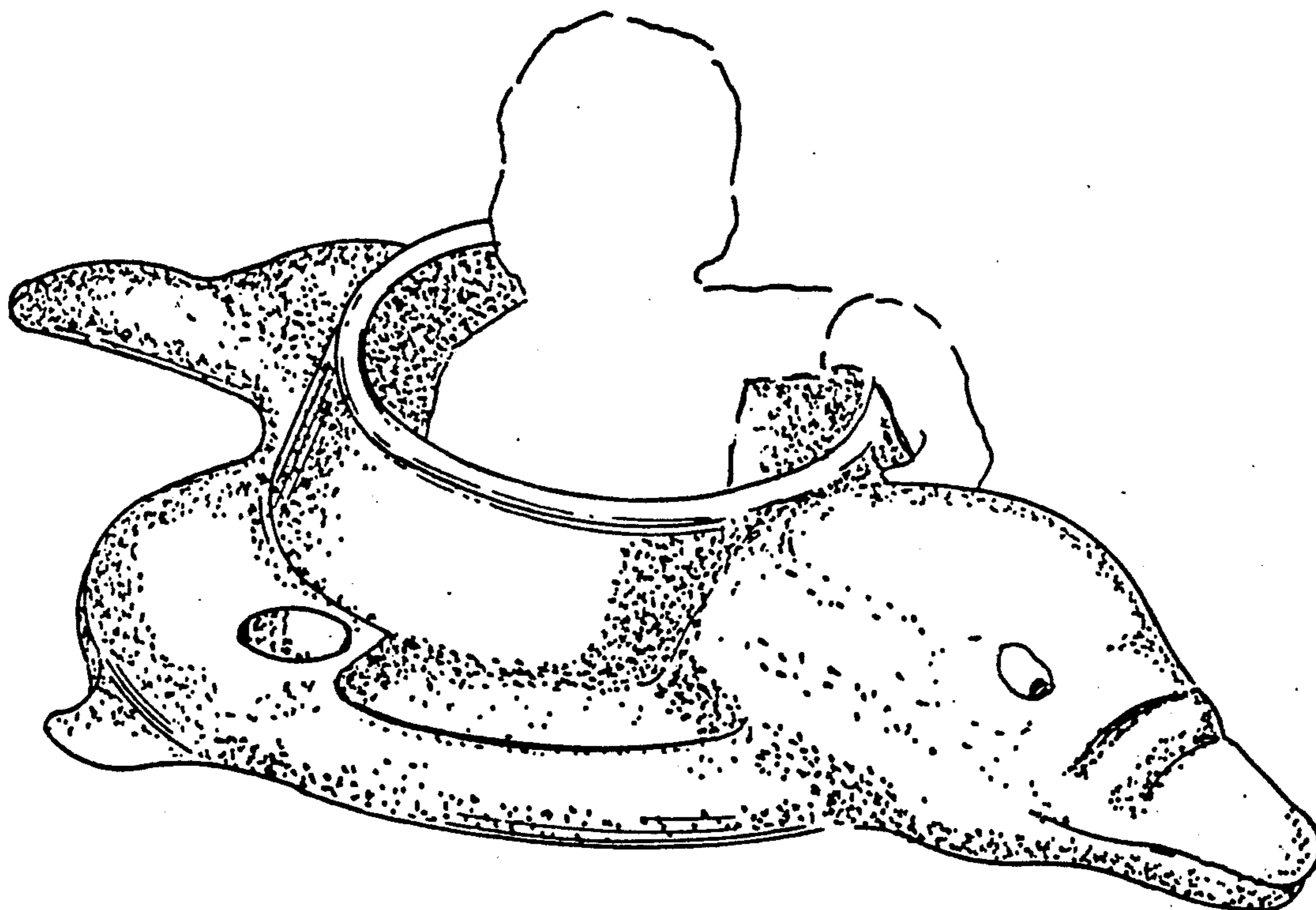
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

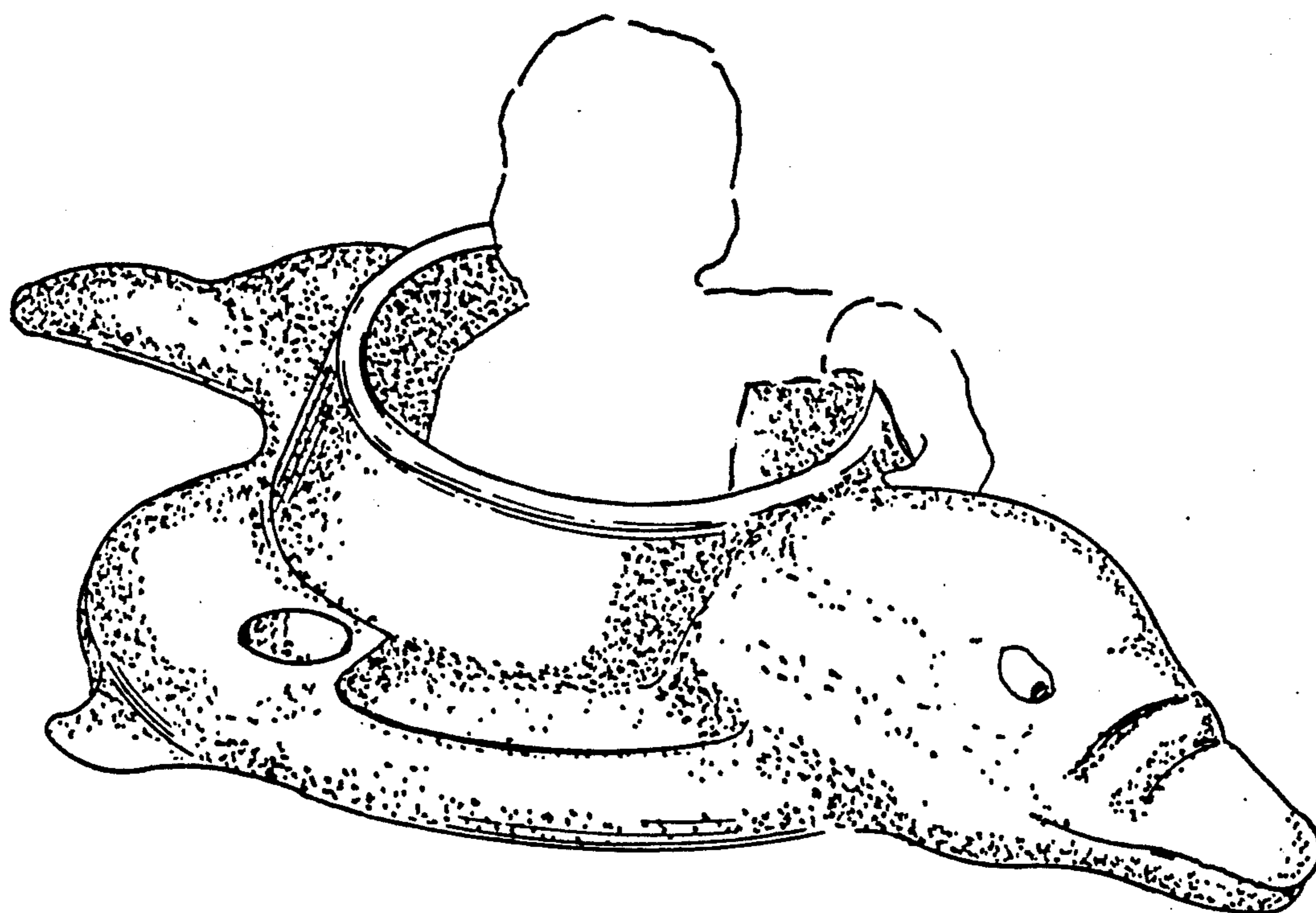

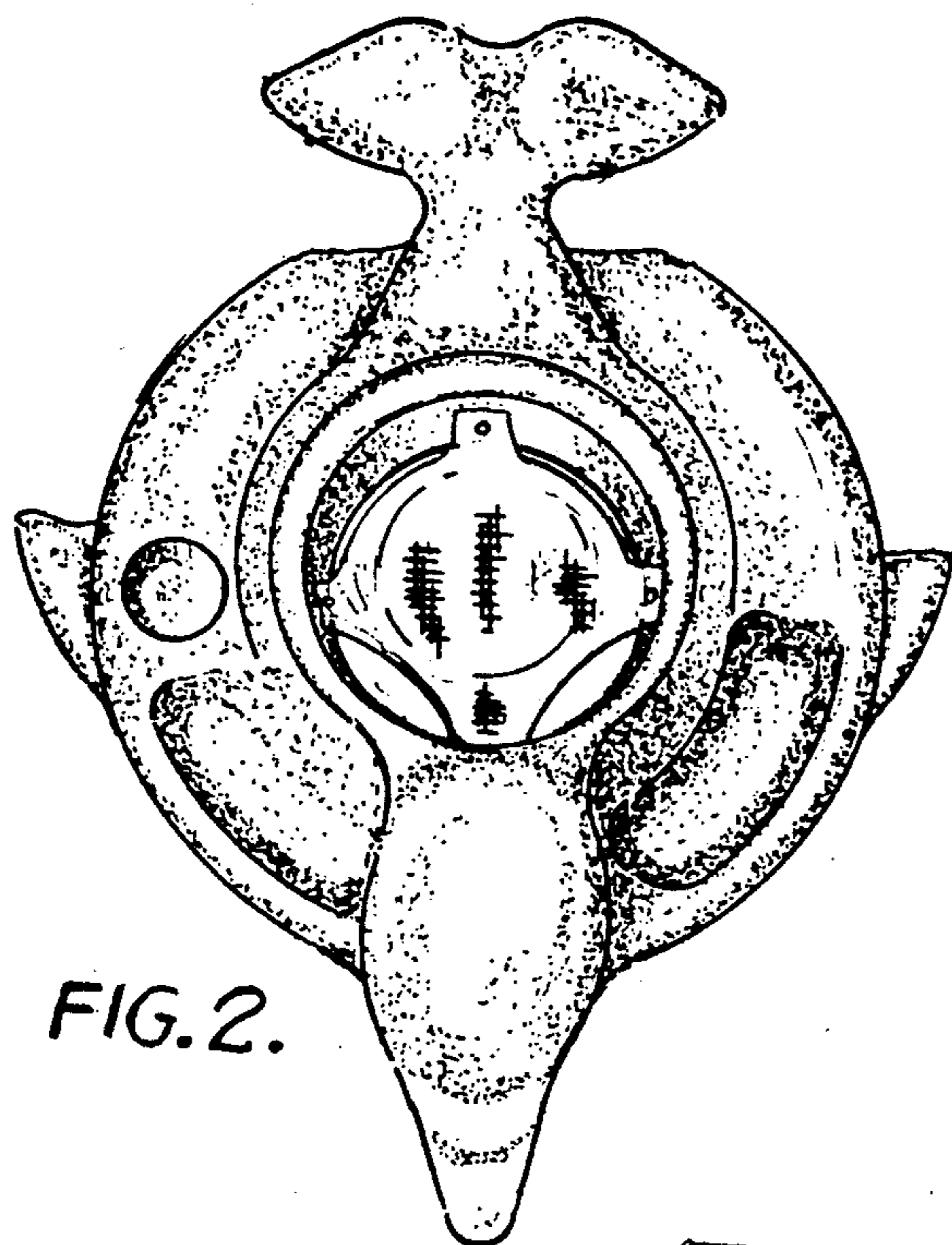

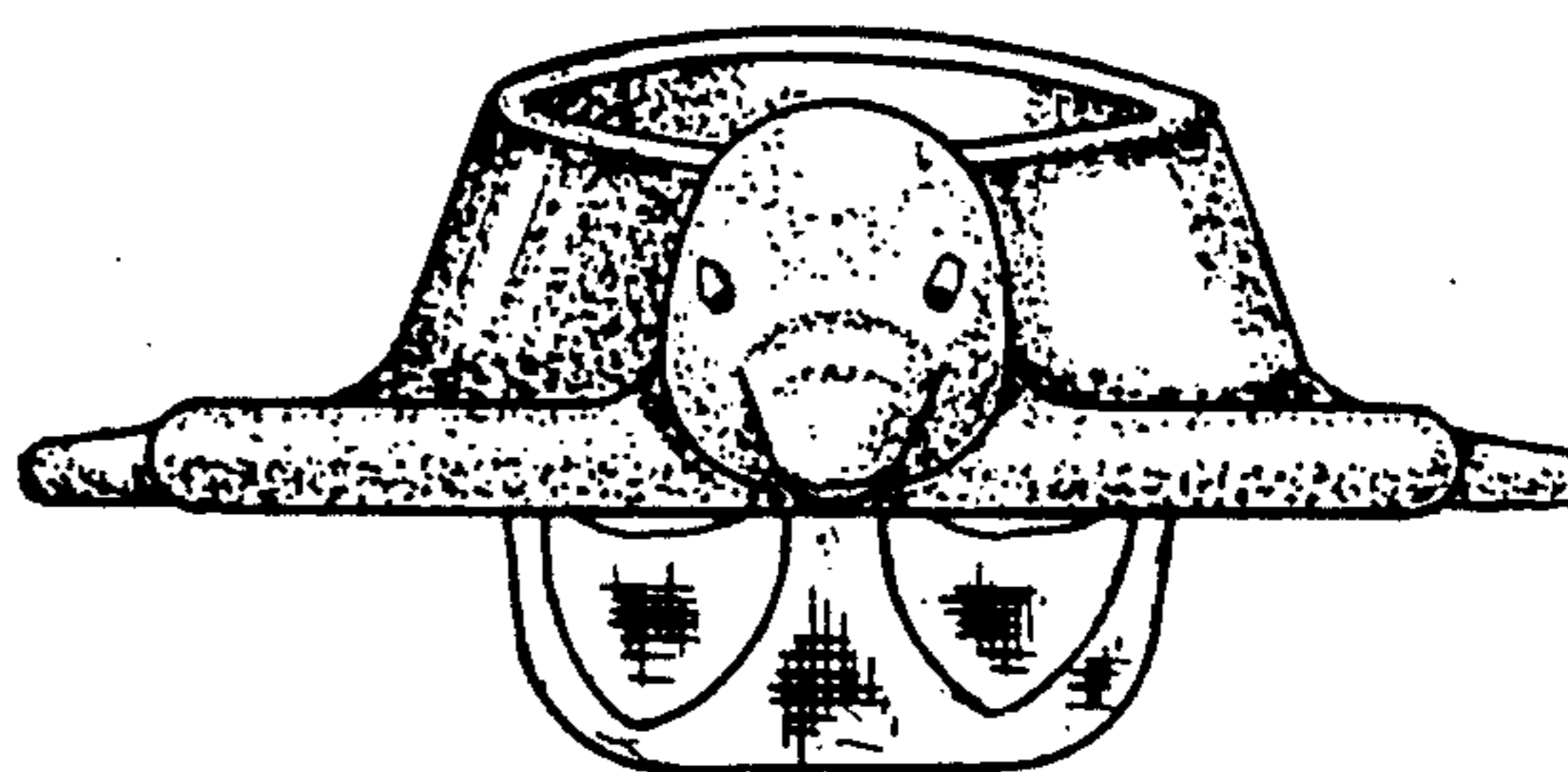

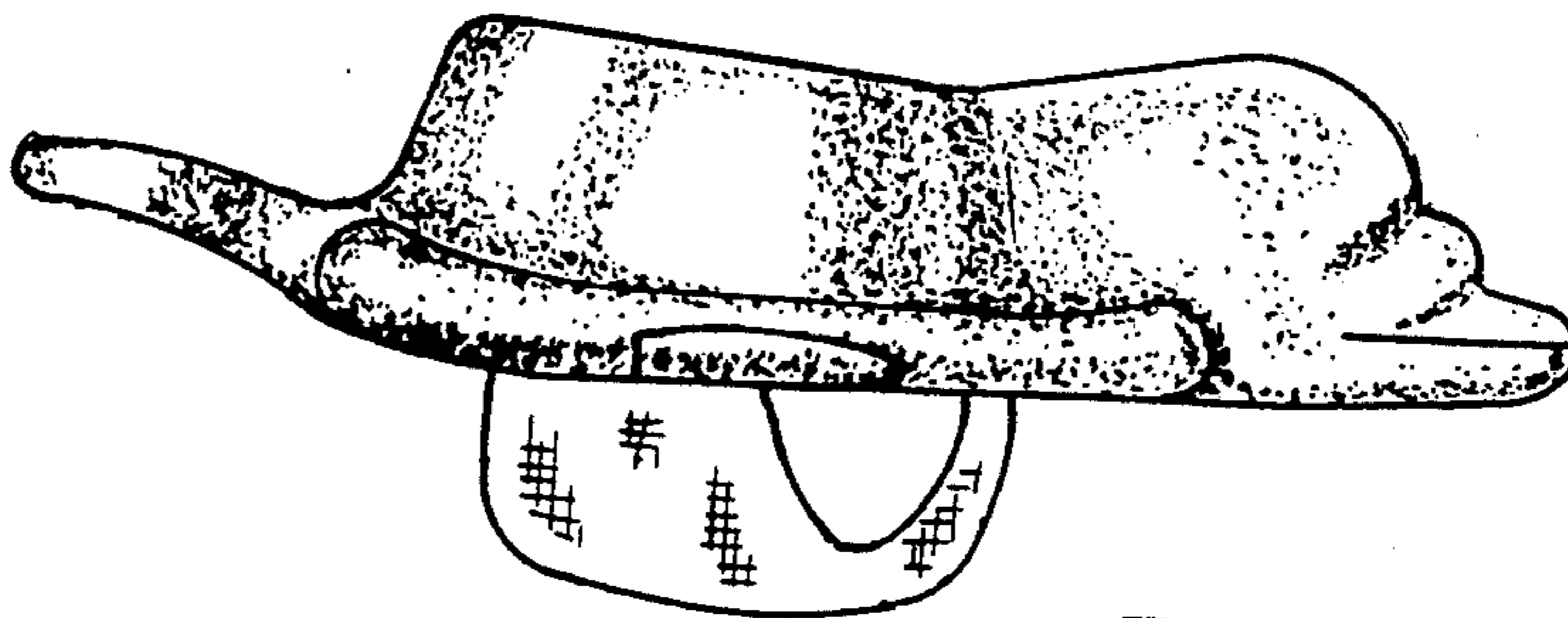

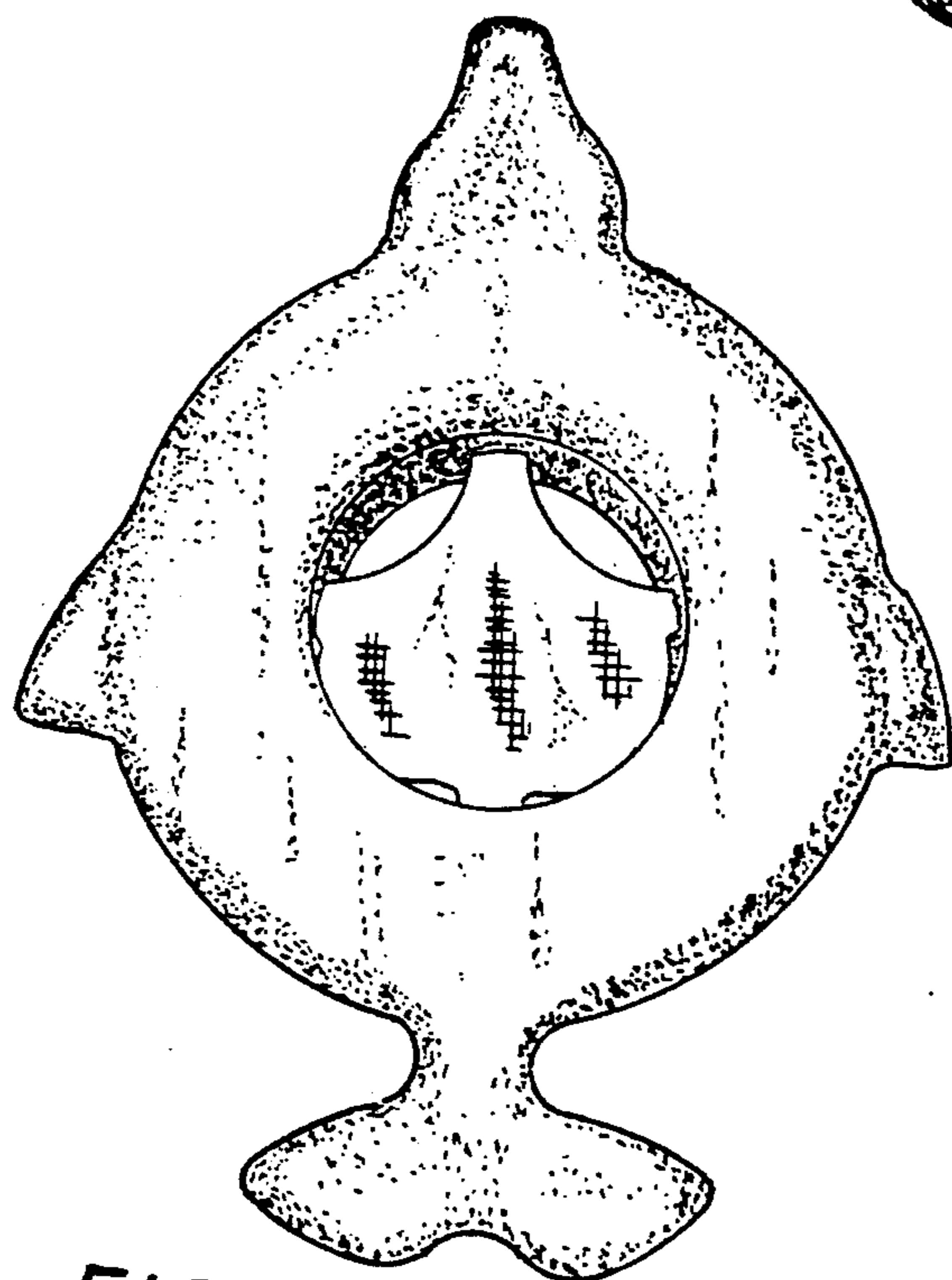

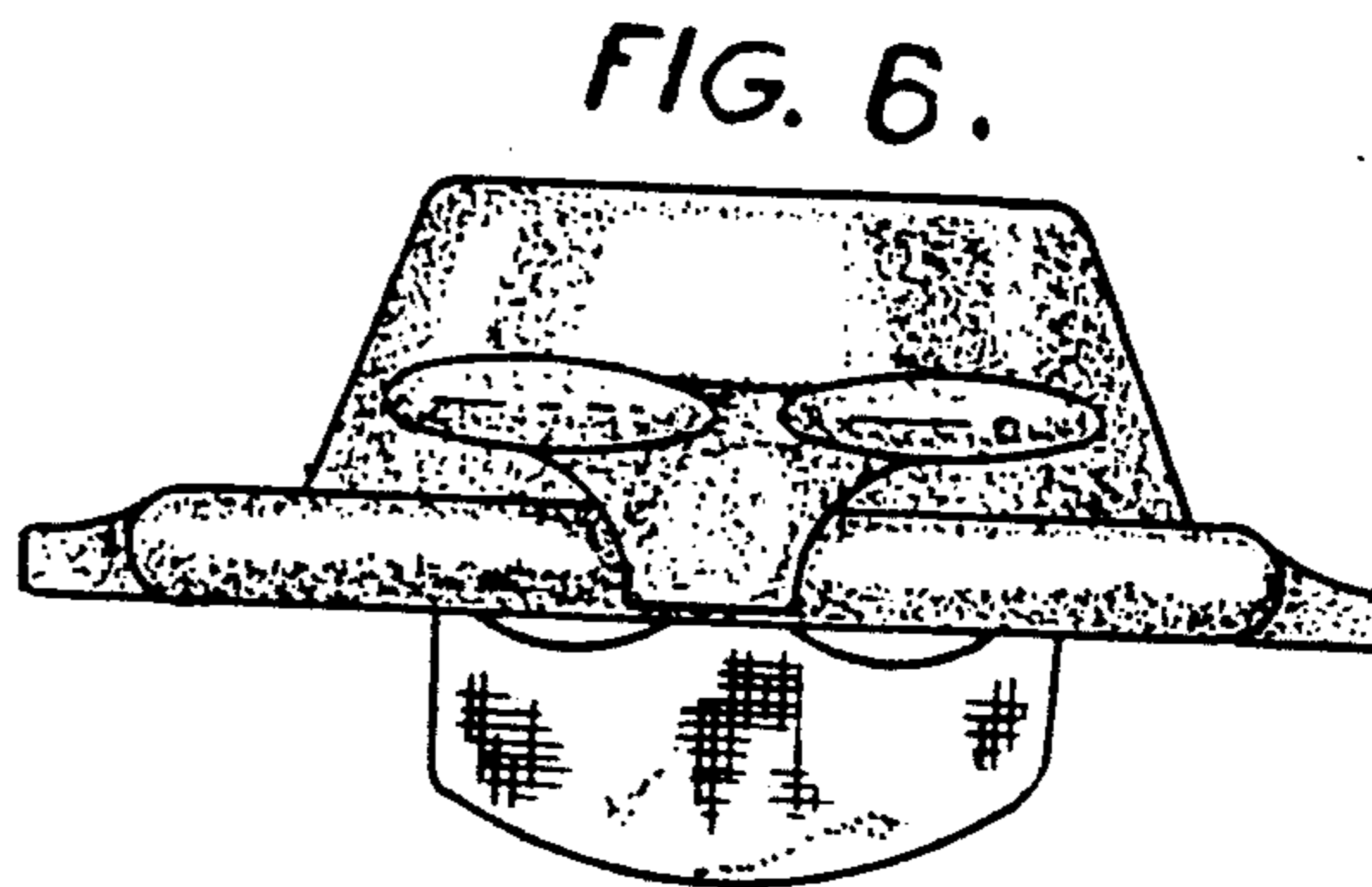
