The ornamental design for an anti-splash back unit for a urinal screen, substantially as shown and described.

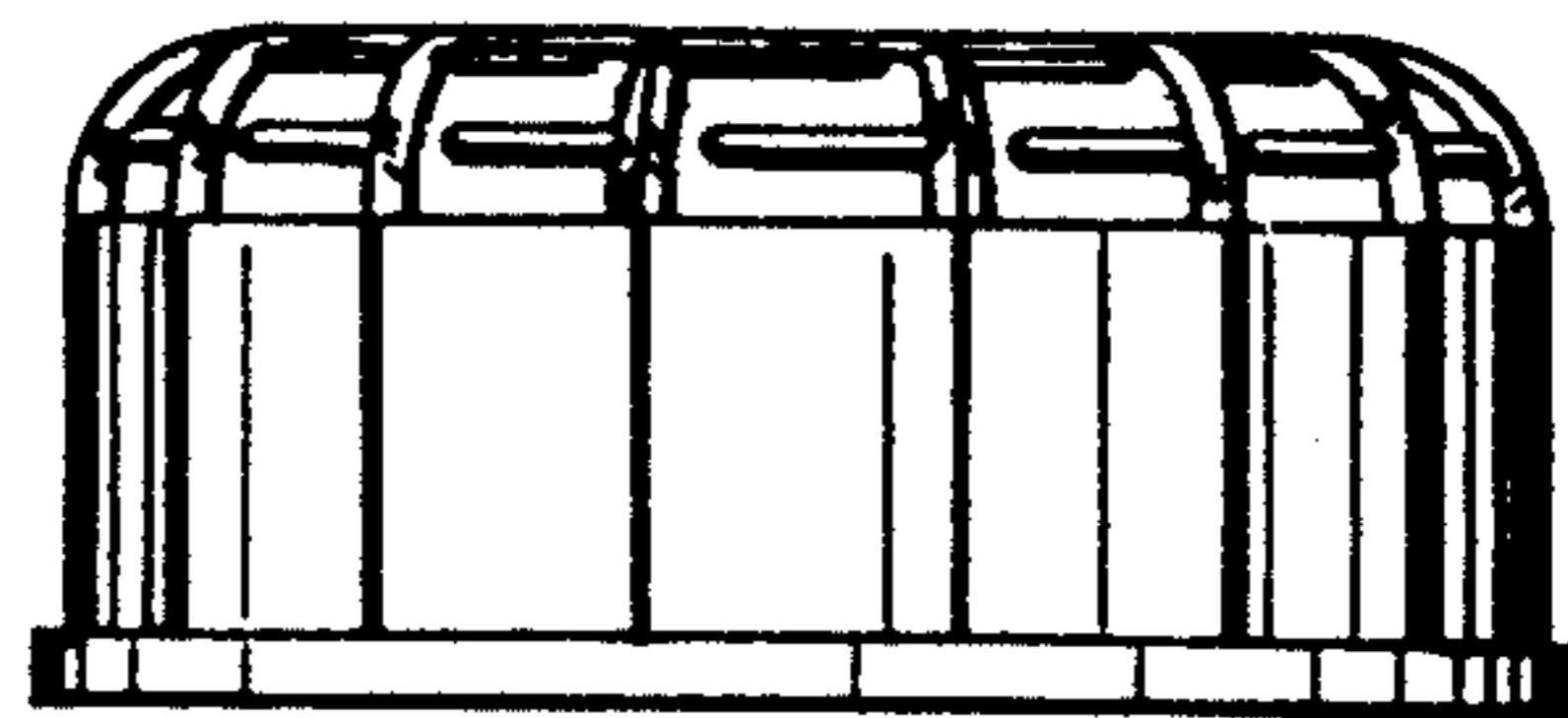
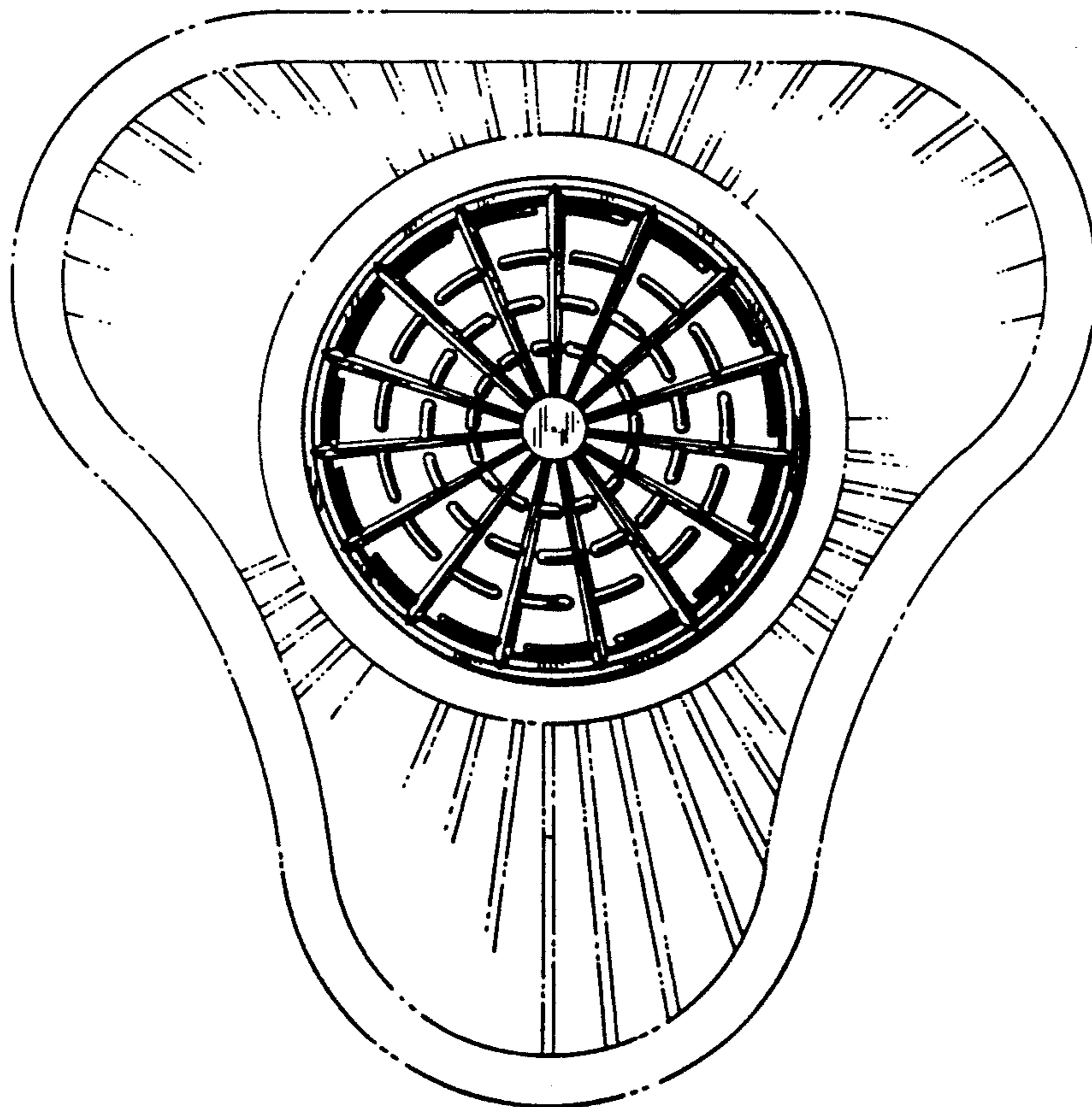
DESCRIPTION

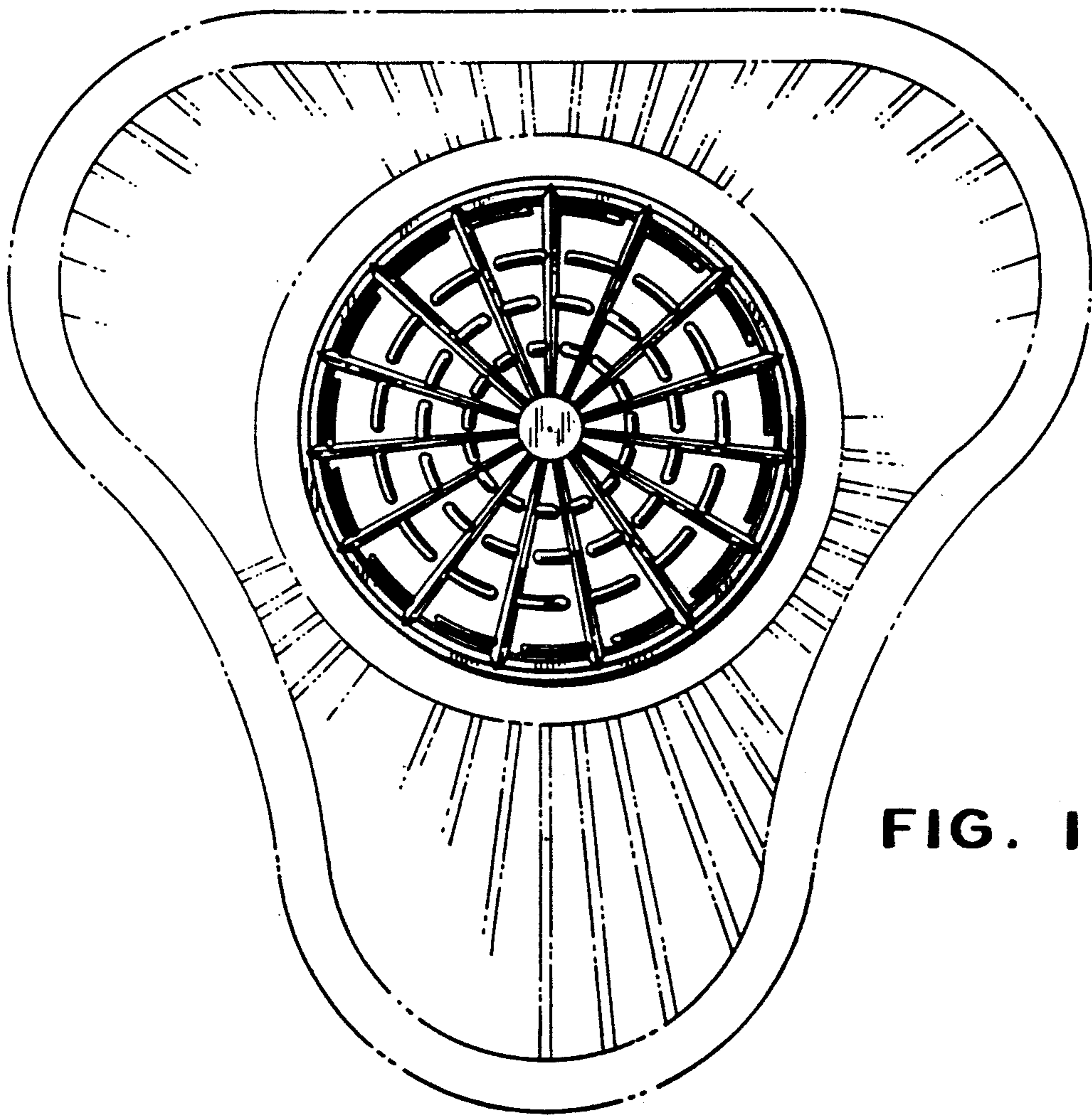

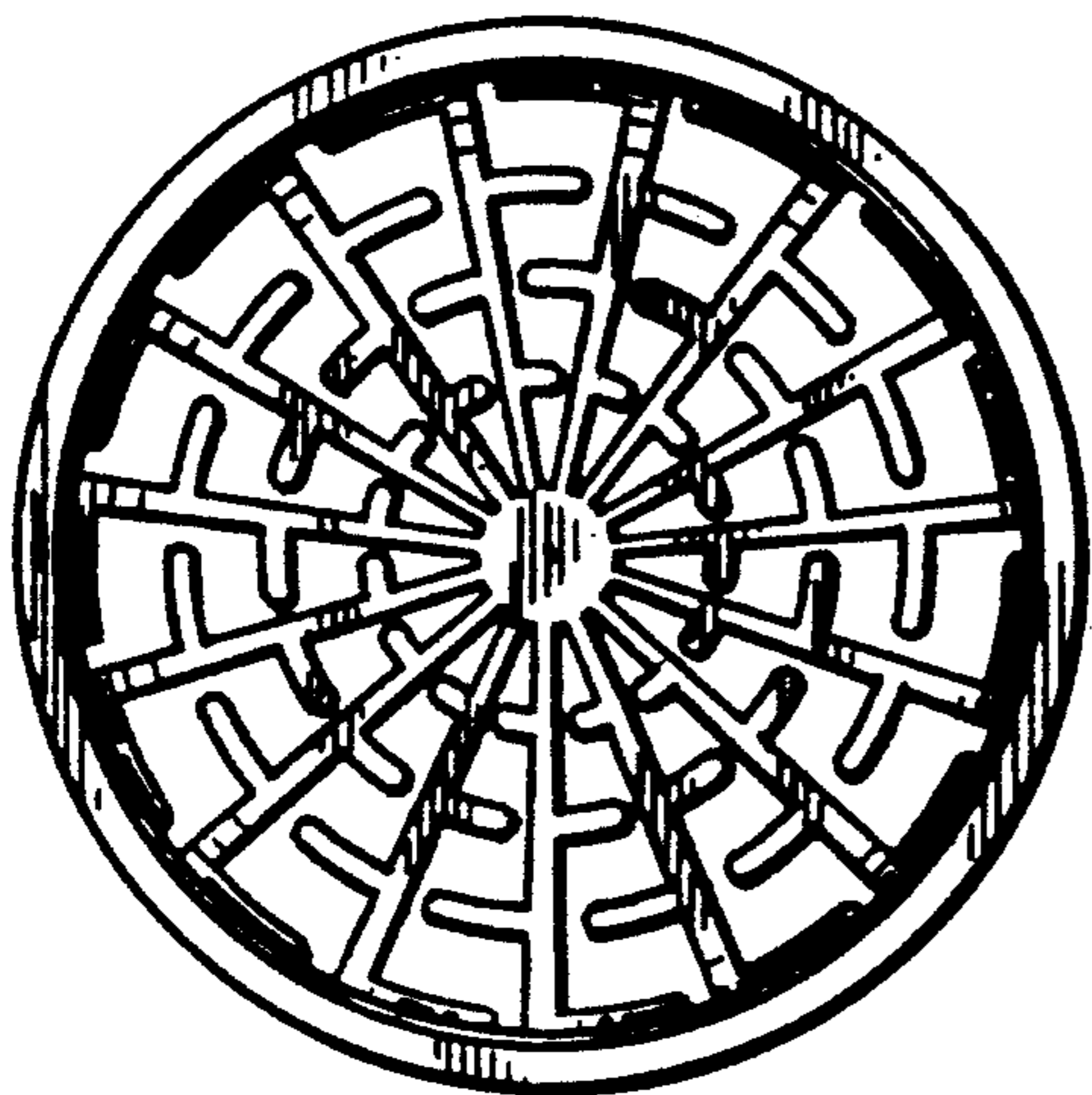

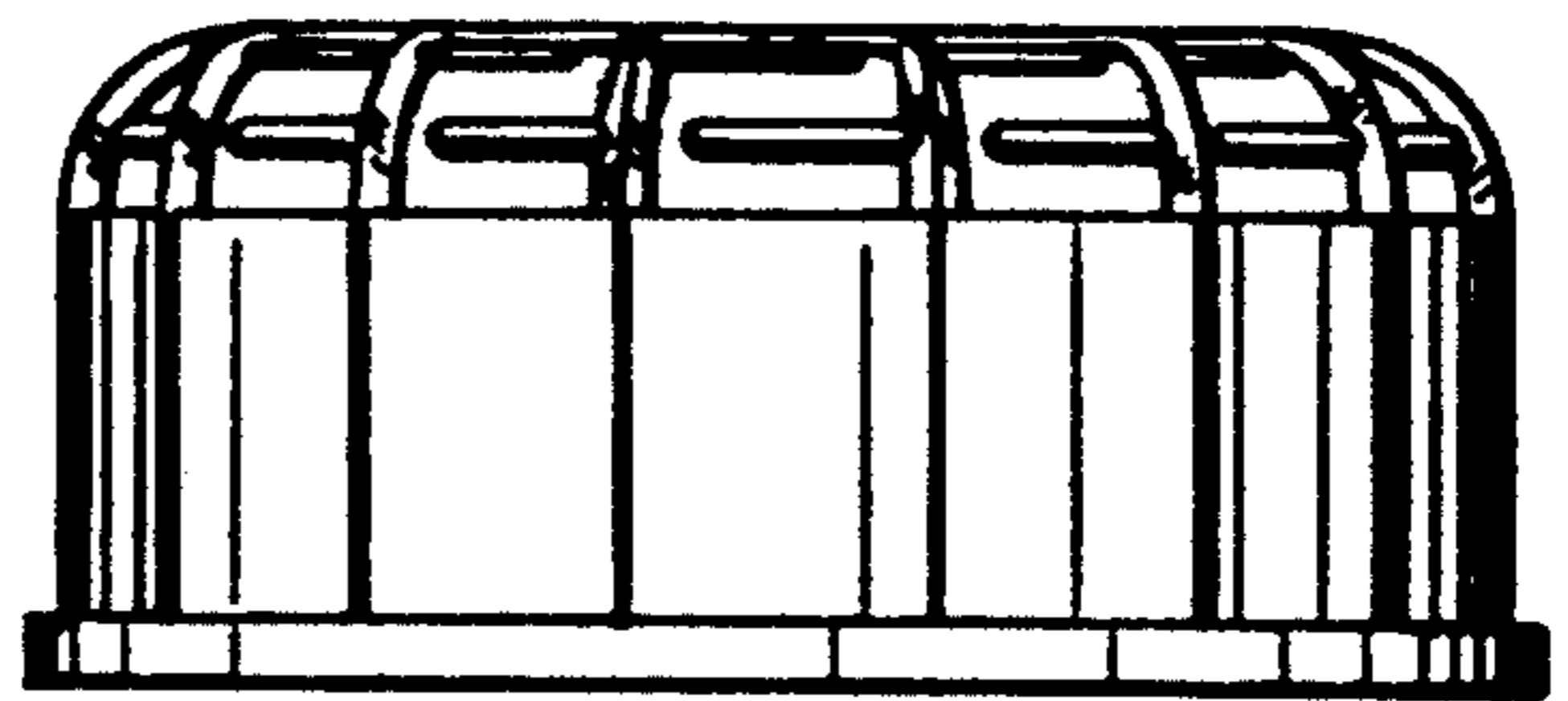
