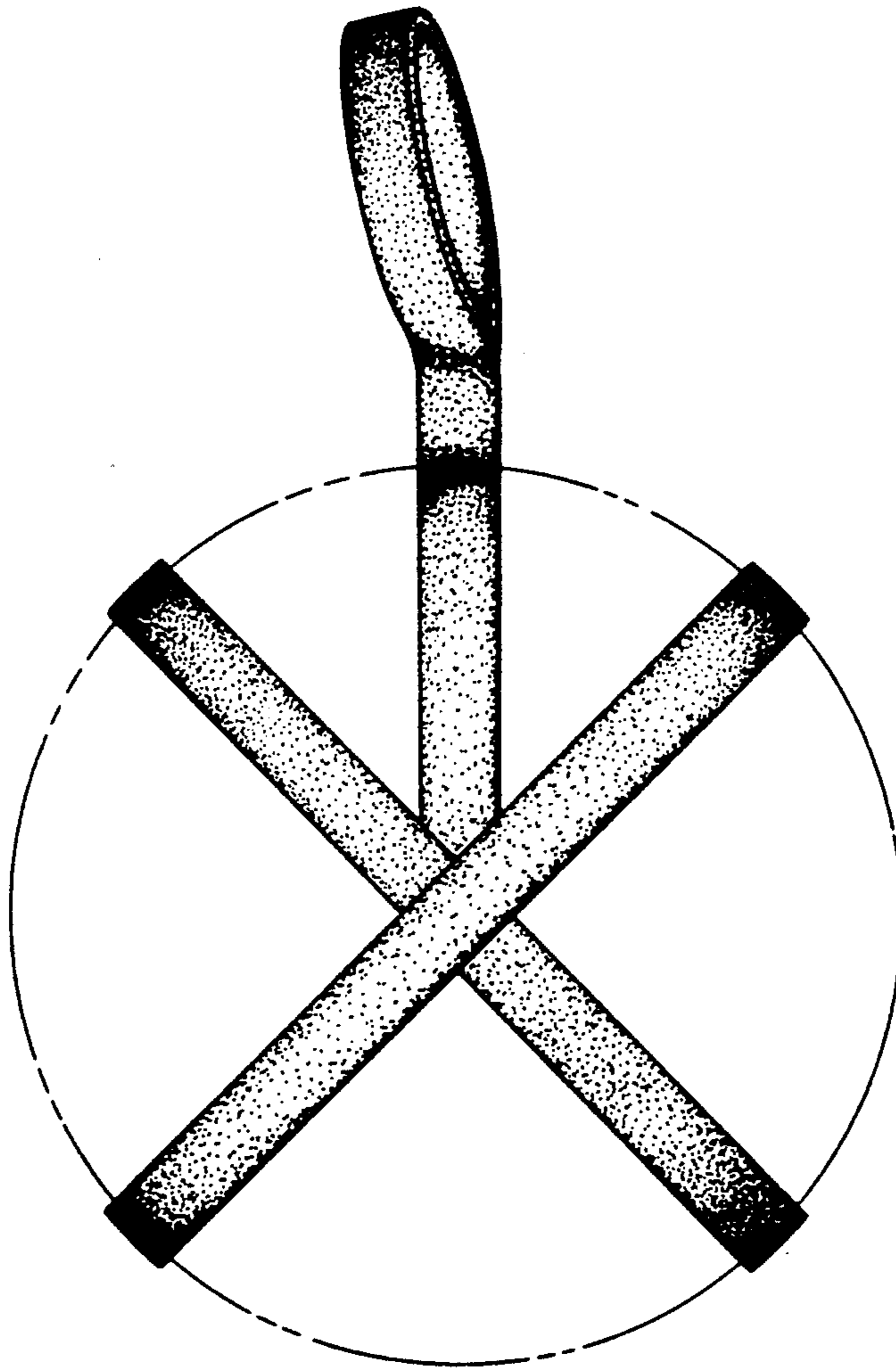

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sports ball carrying and storing device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a sports ball carrying and storing device;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.
The broken line showing of a ball in FIGS. 1-5 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



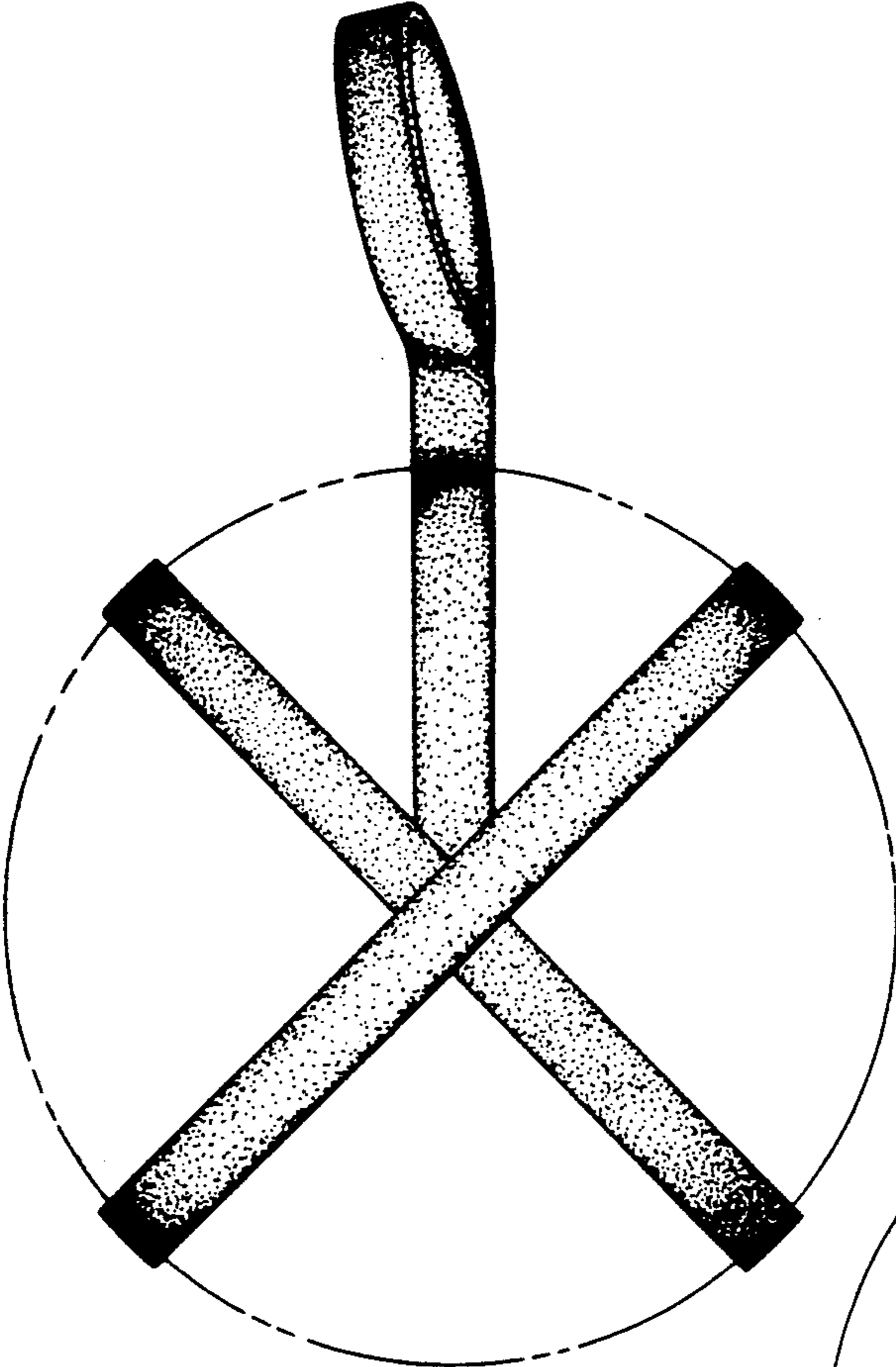

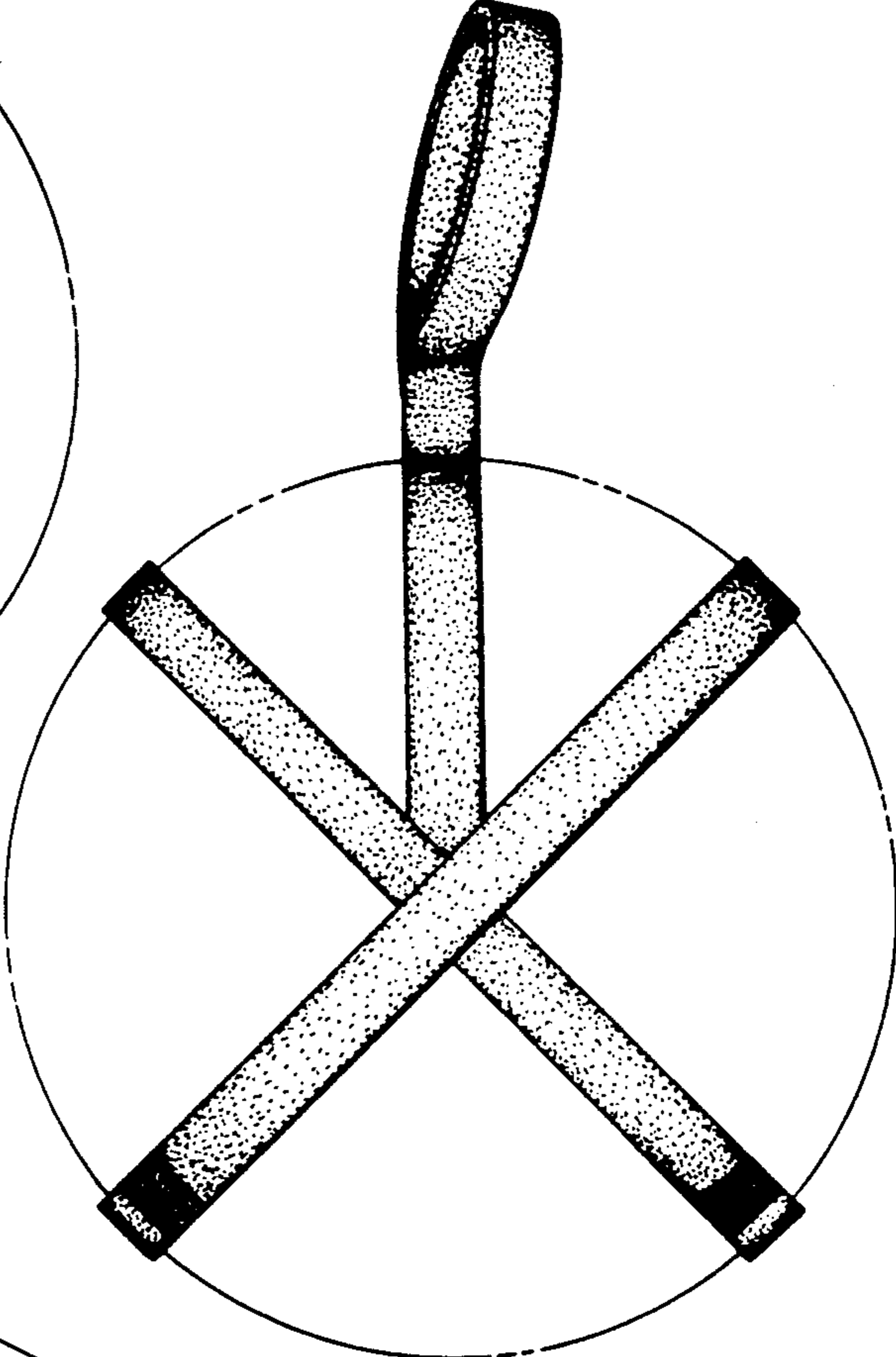

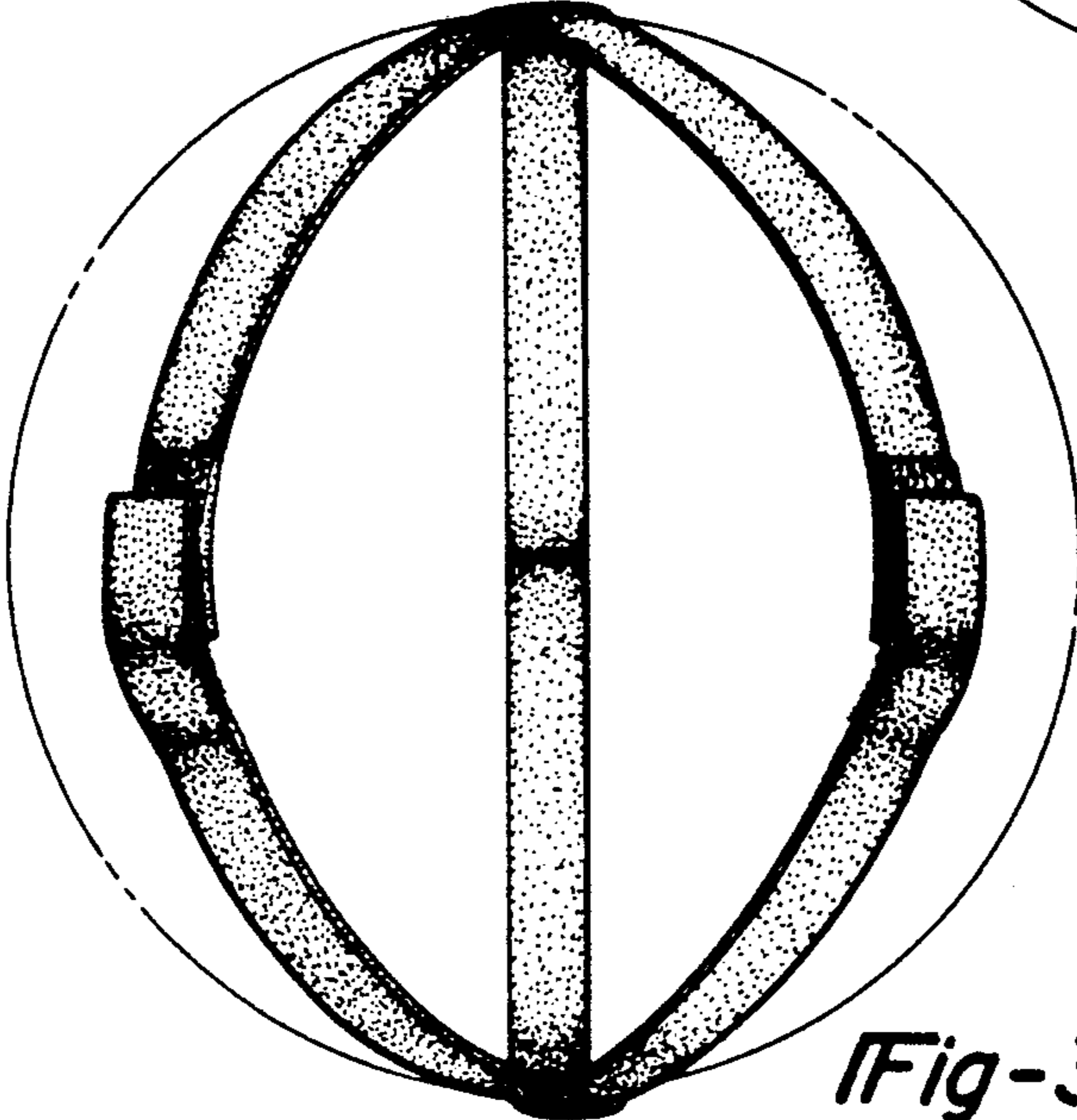

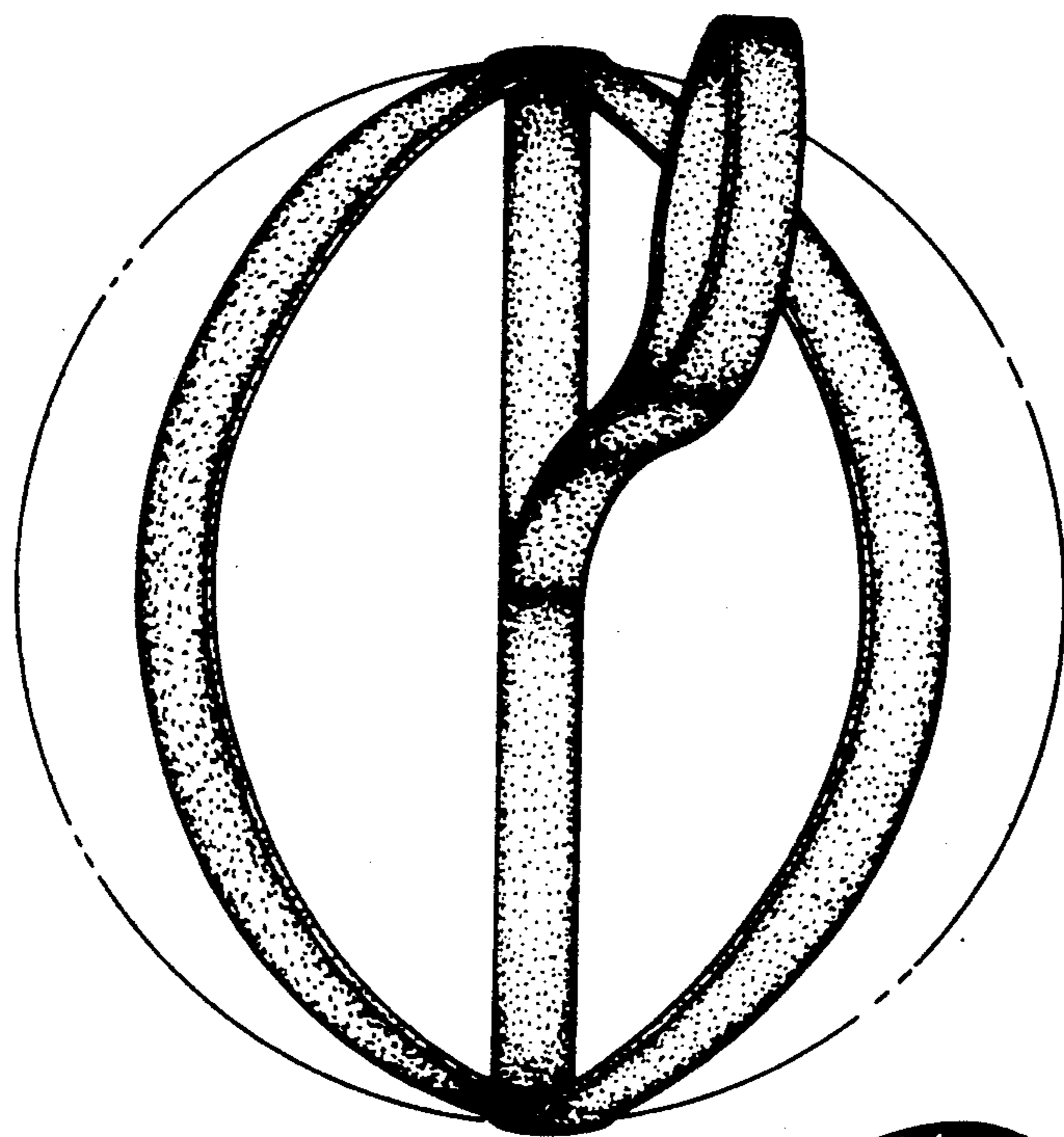

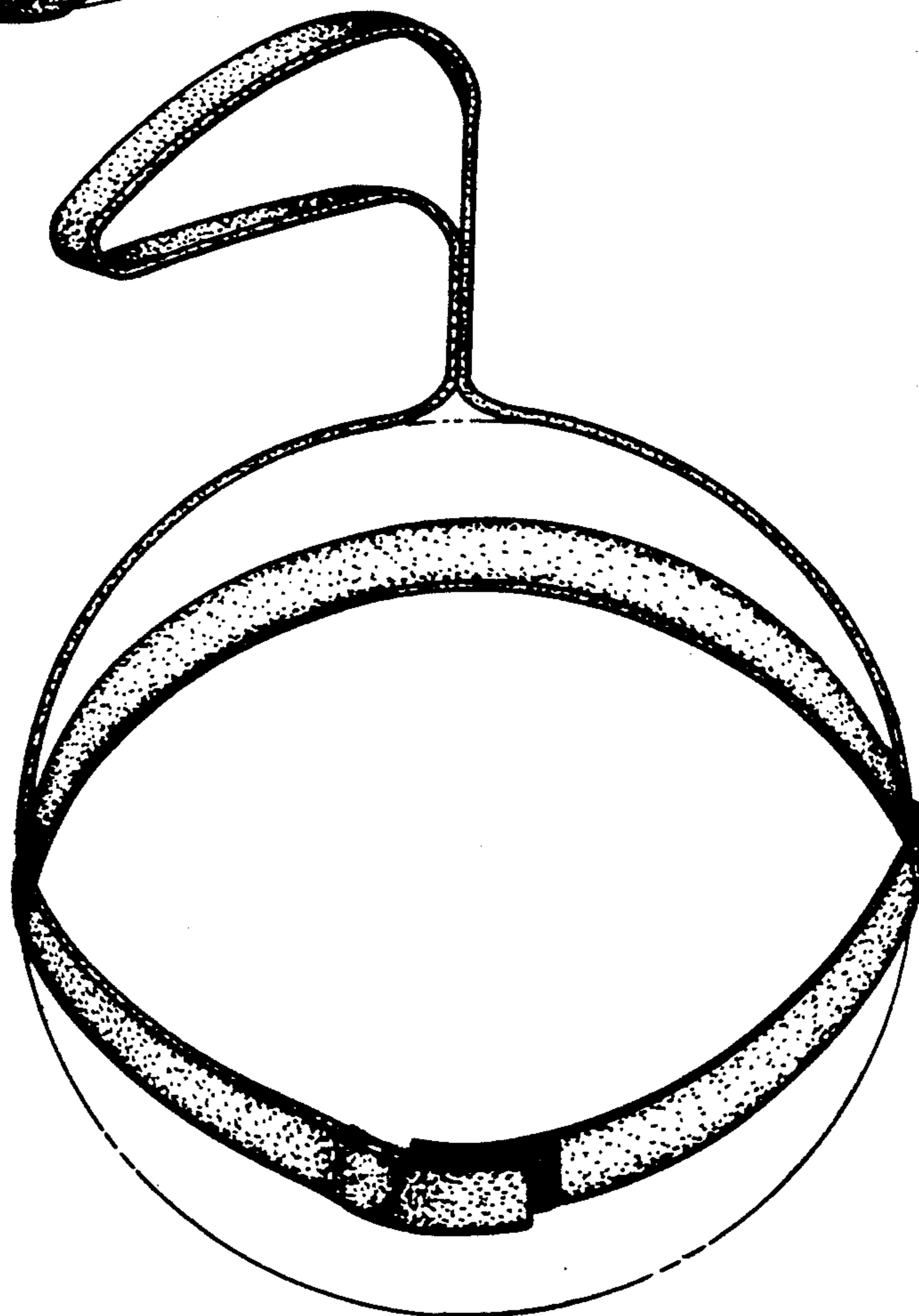
