DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a spoon showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a cross section view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 5 is a cross section view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

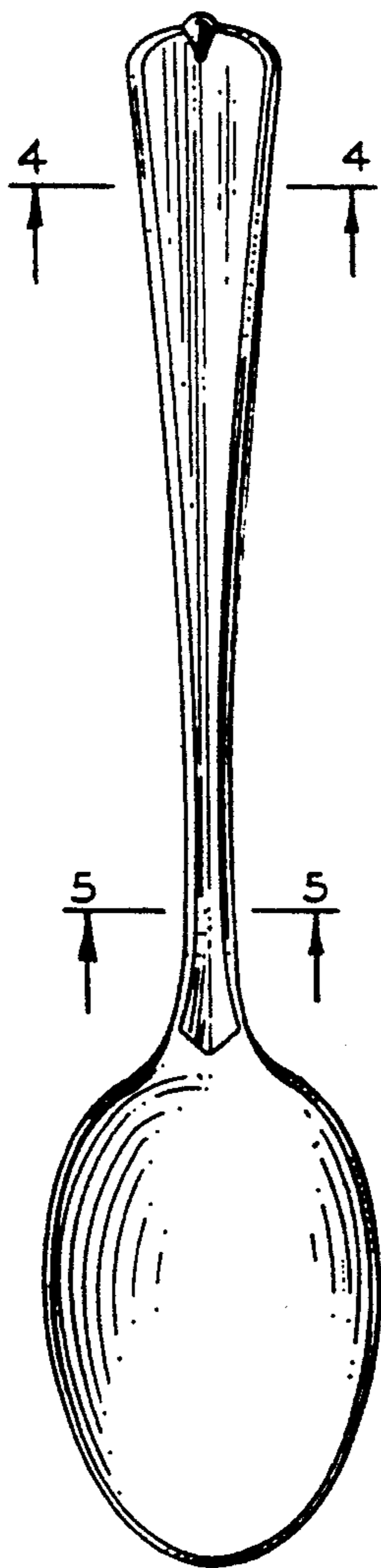

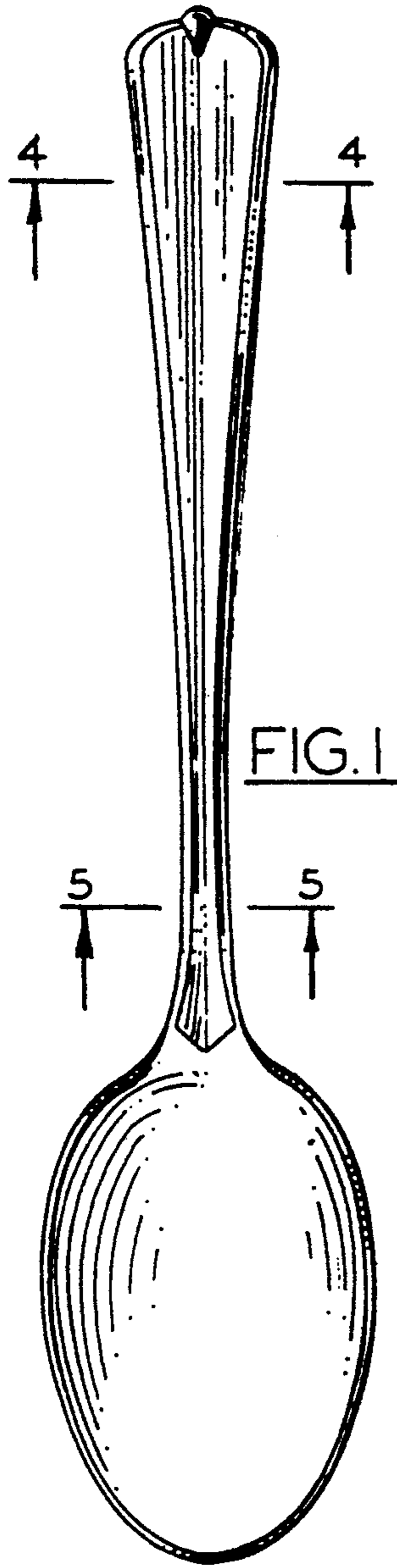

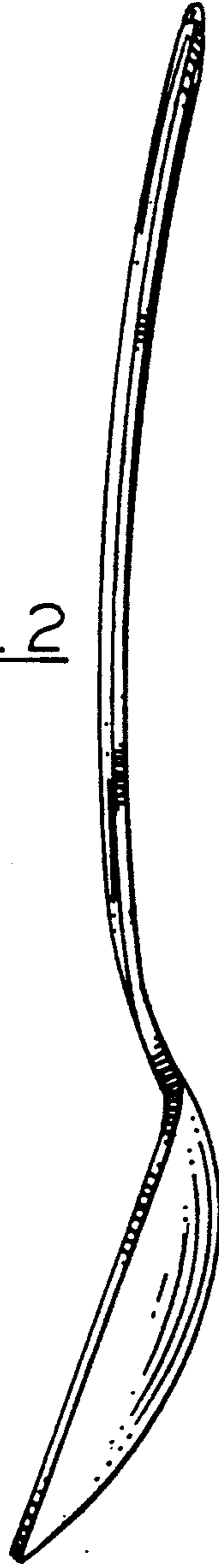

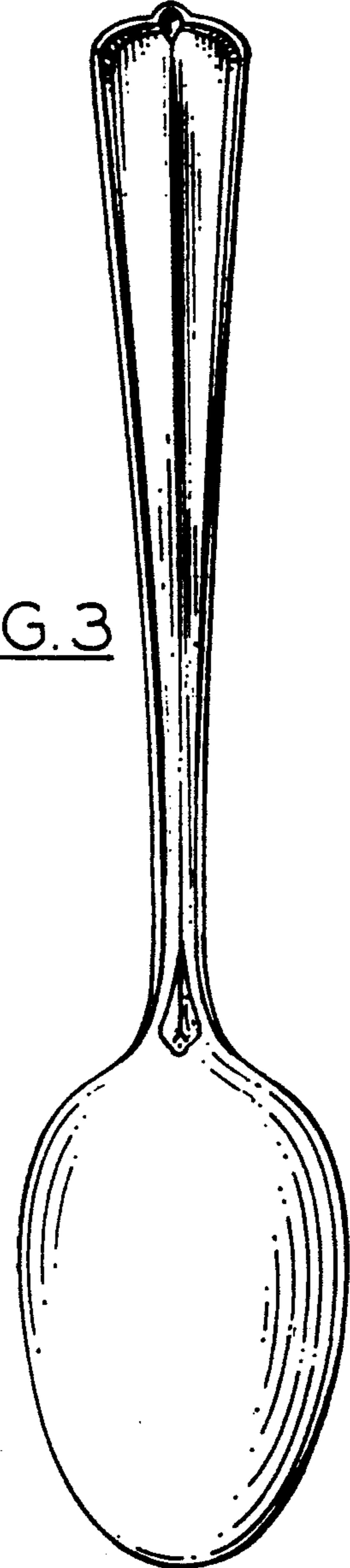
