DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and lower left perspective view of an enclosure for electrical equipment showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of an enclosure for electrical equipment showing the design on a slightly reduced scale;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof with the end covers removed;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view thereof being the same;

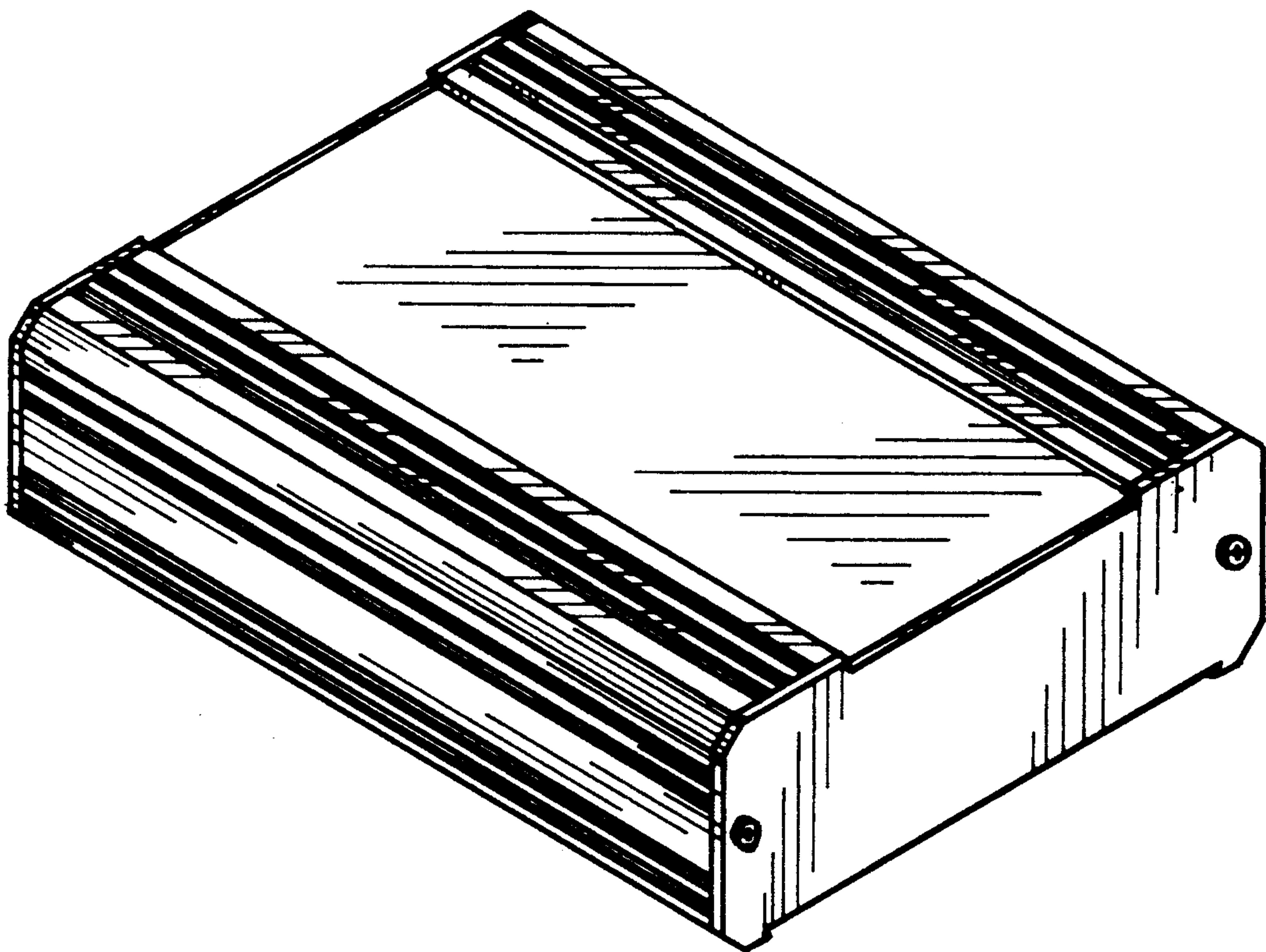
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being the same.



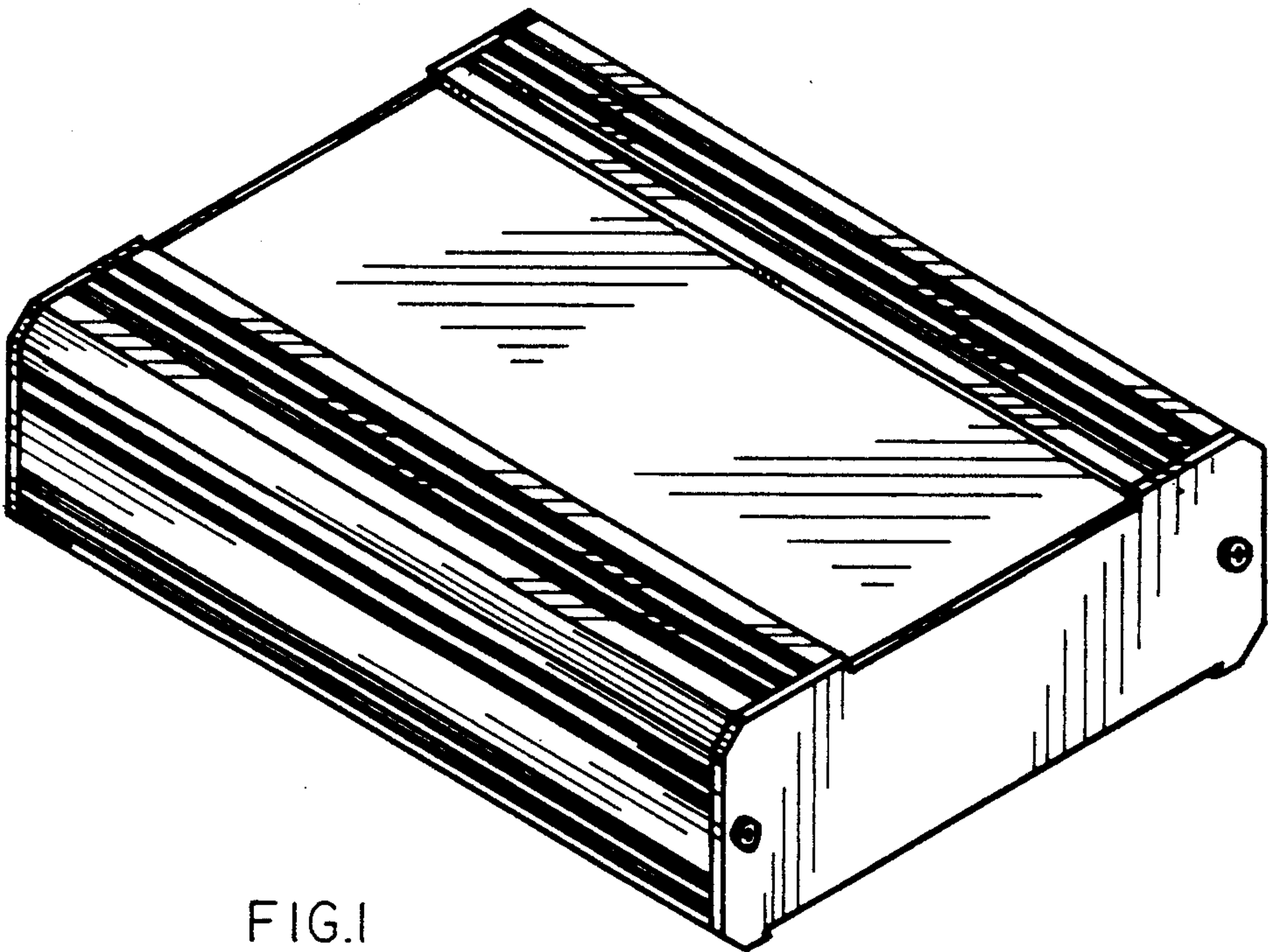

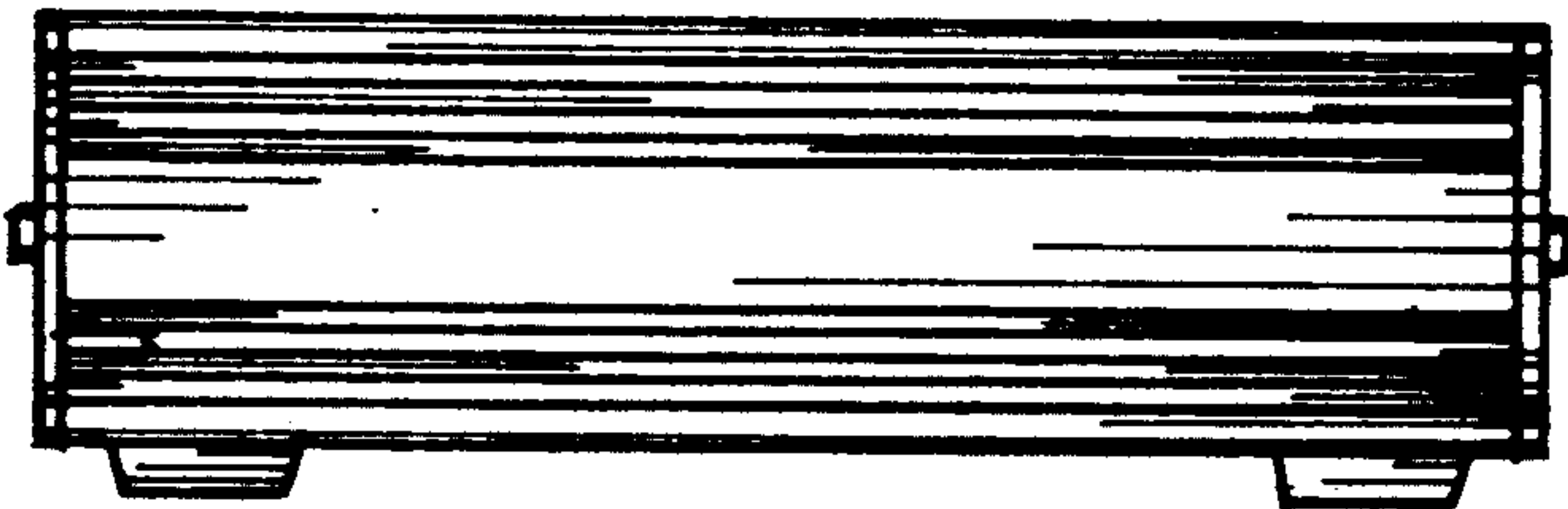

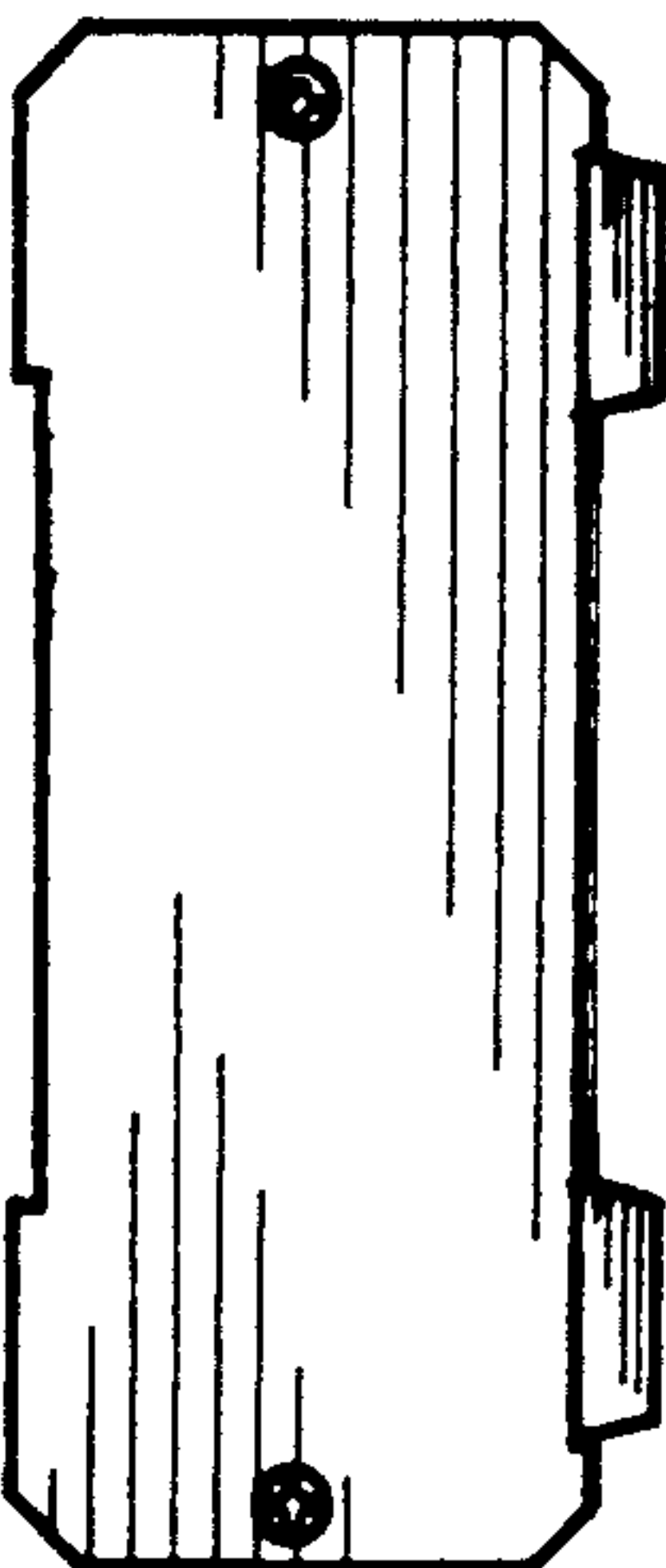

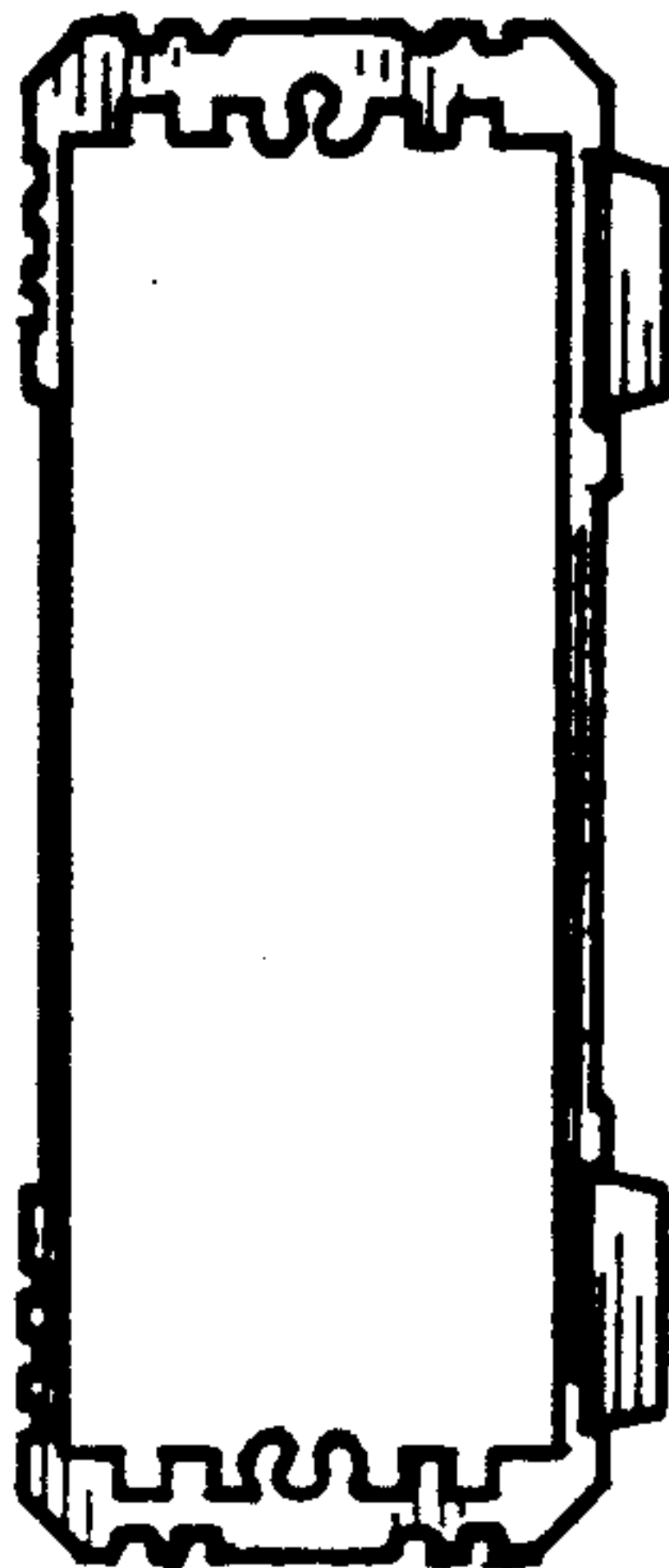

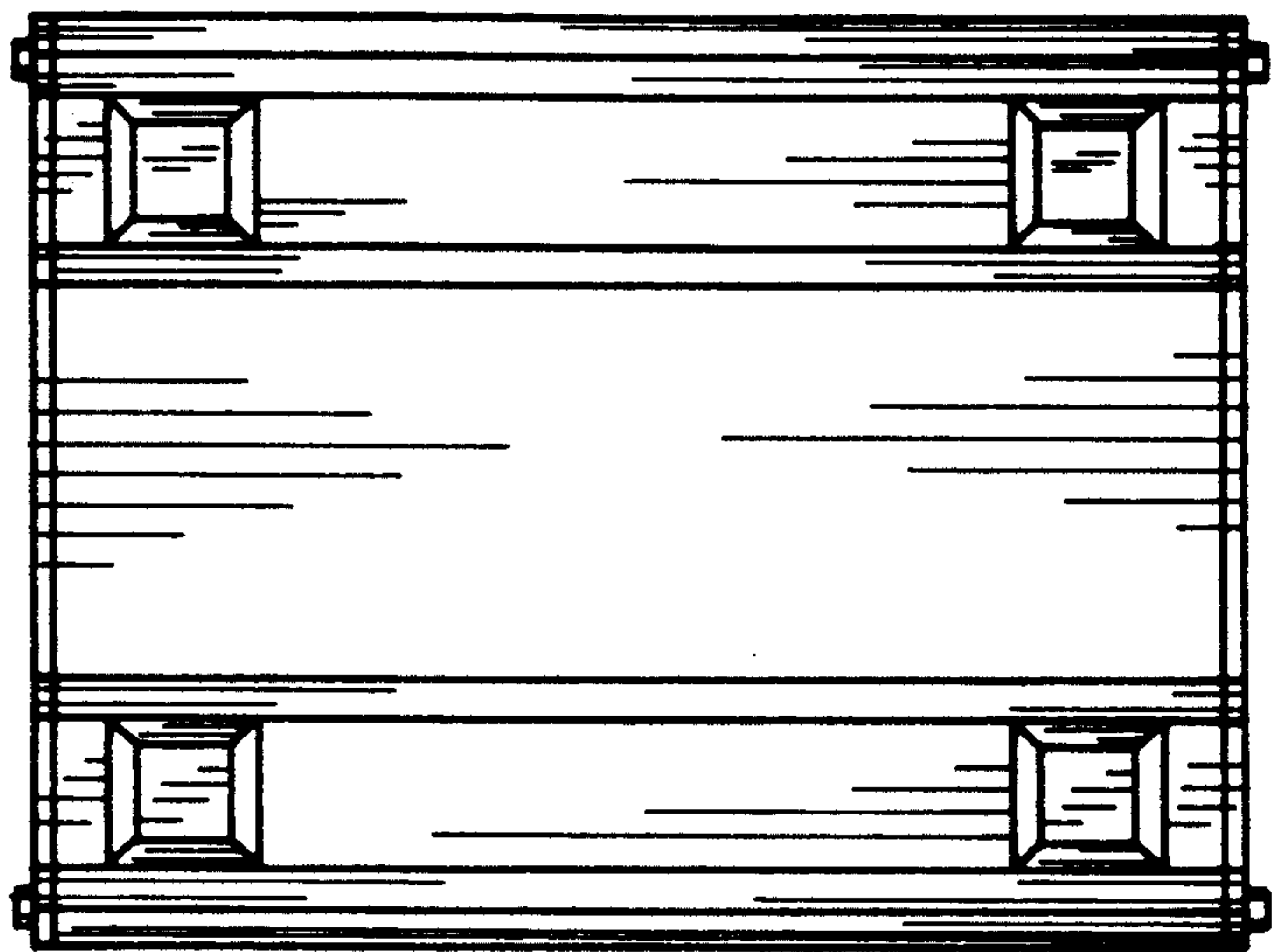

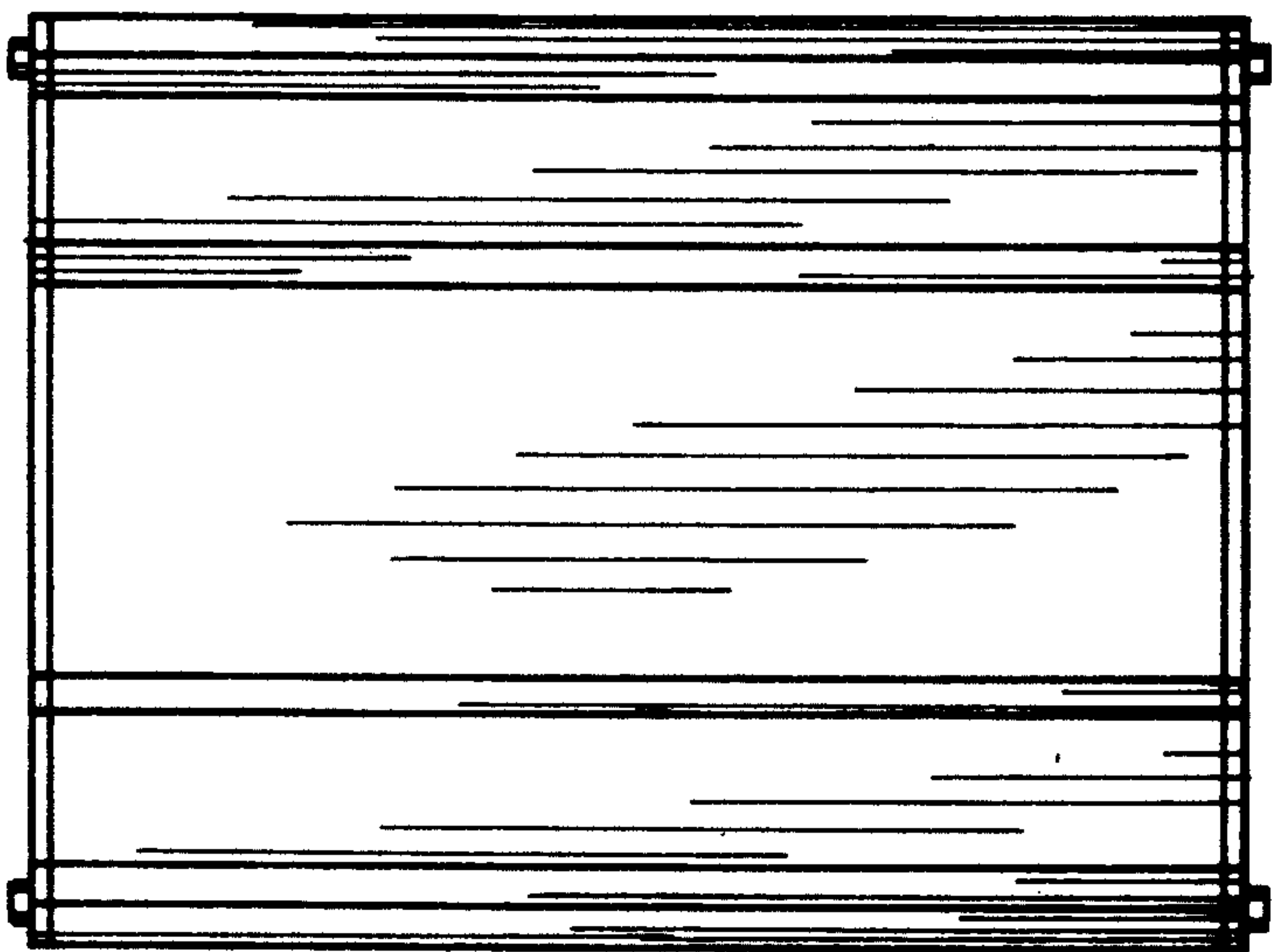

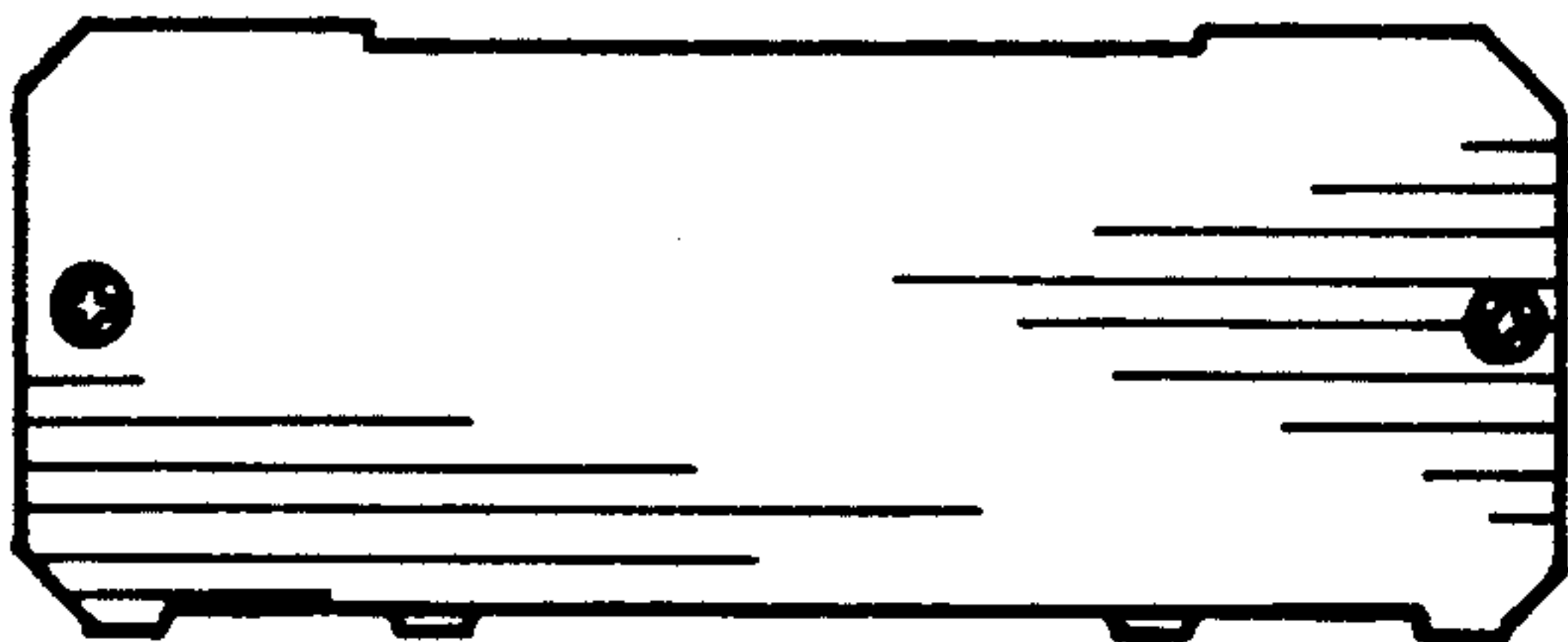

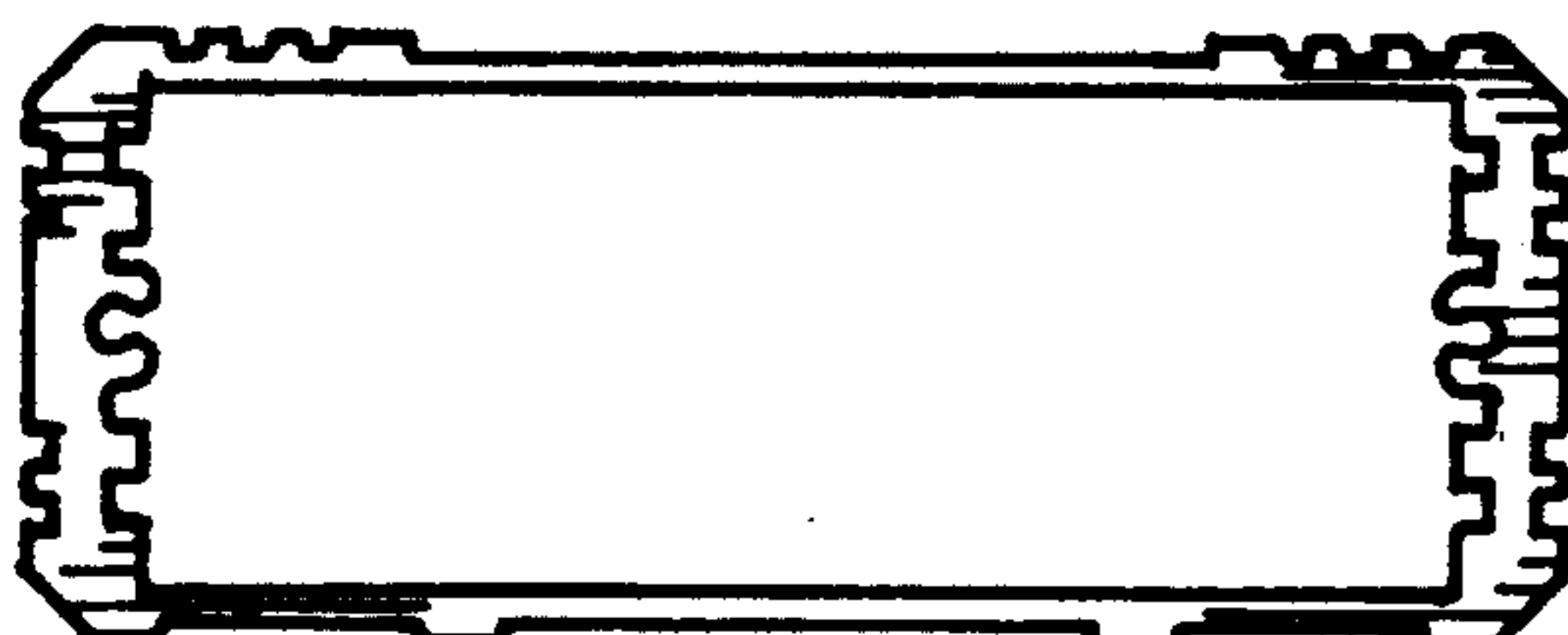

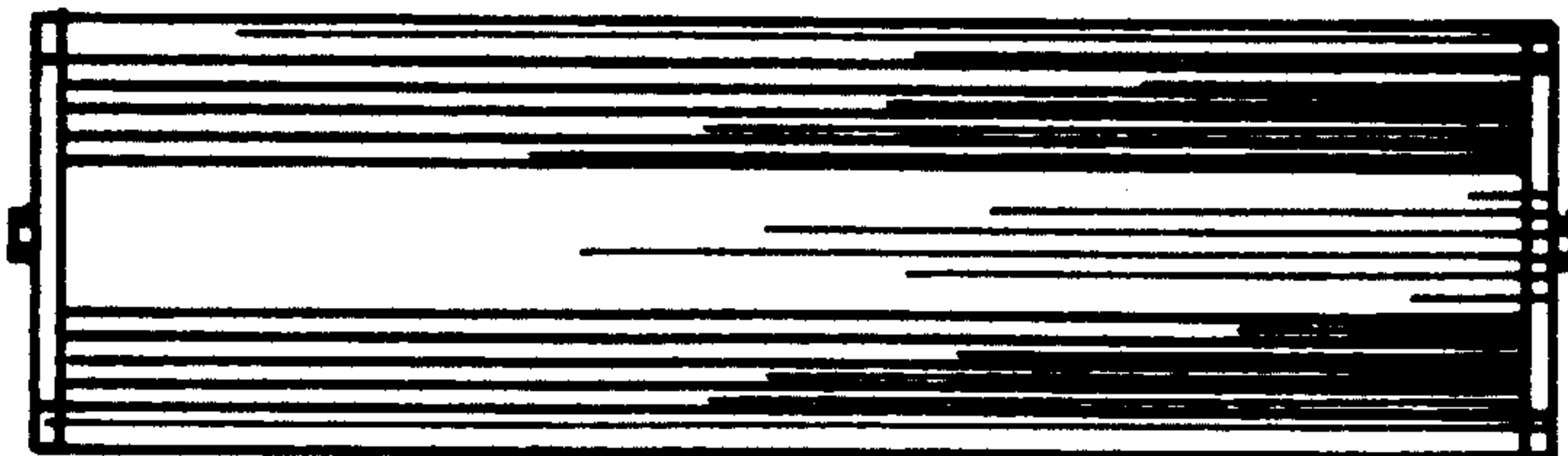
