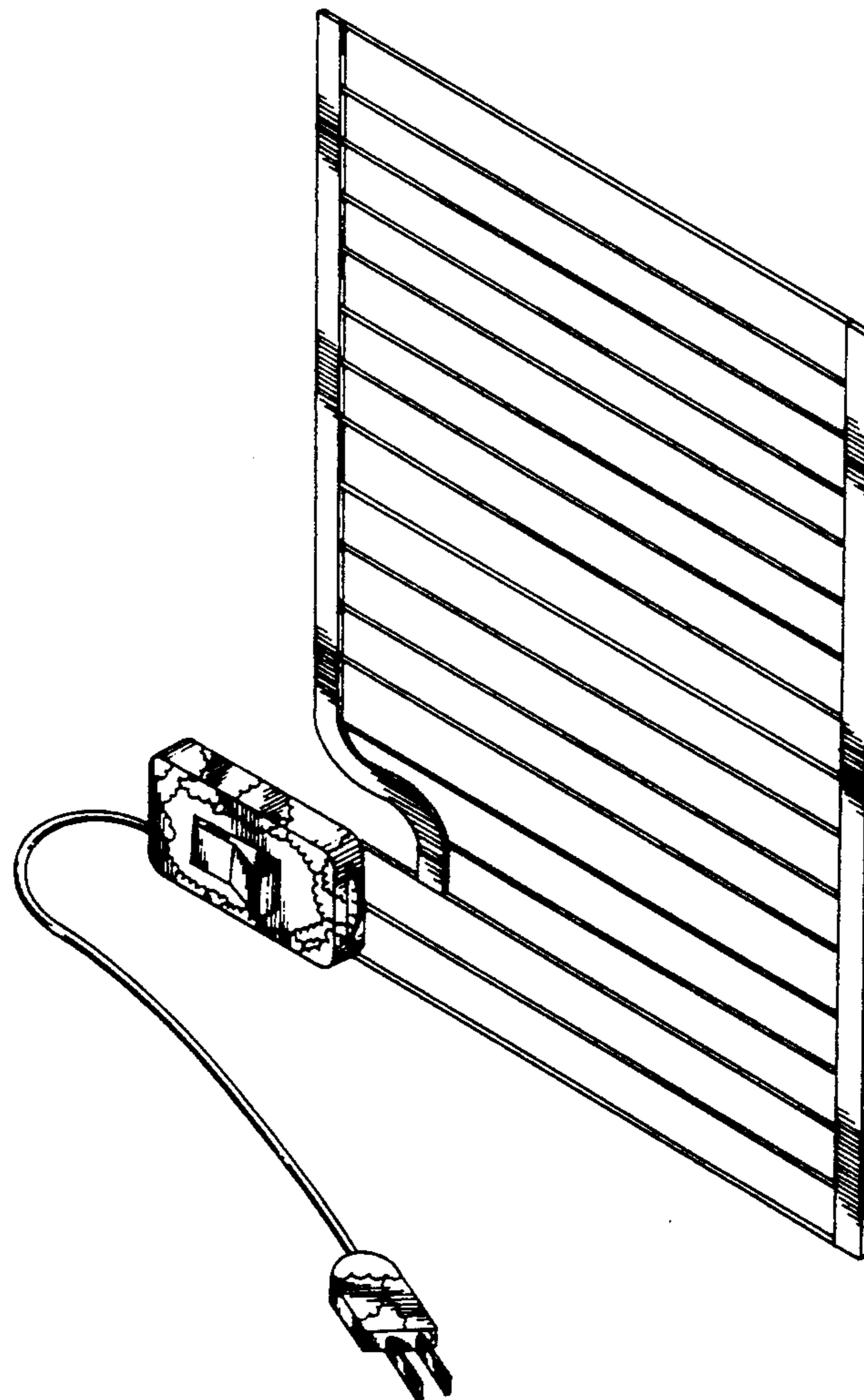

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a mirror defogger, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a mirror defogger, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof. The electrical cord has been broken away in the middle in FIGS. 2-7 for convenience of illustration.



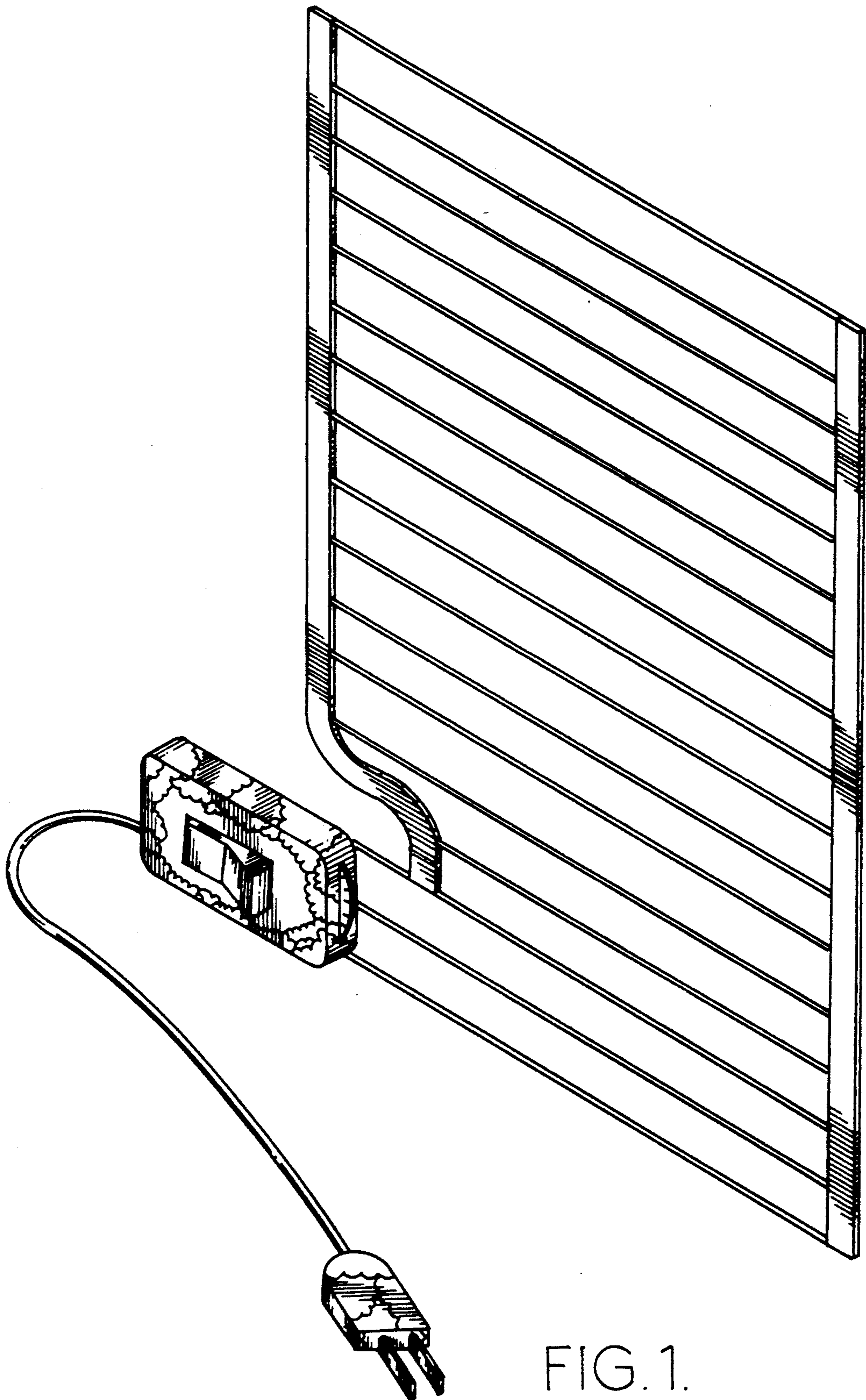

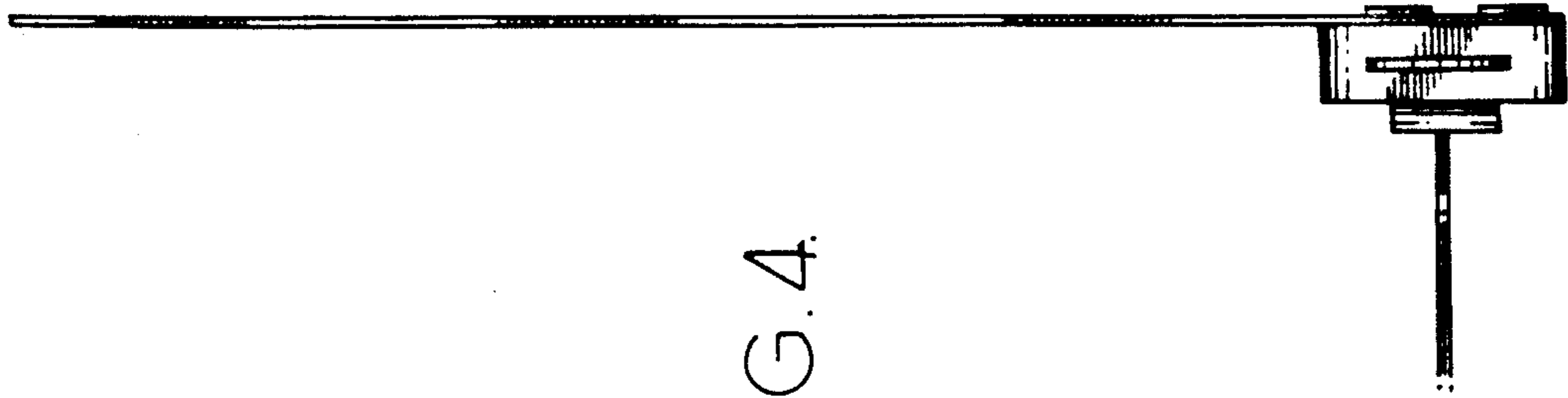

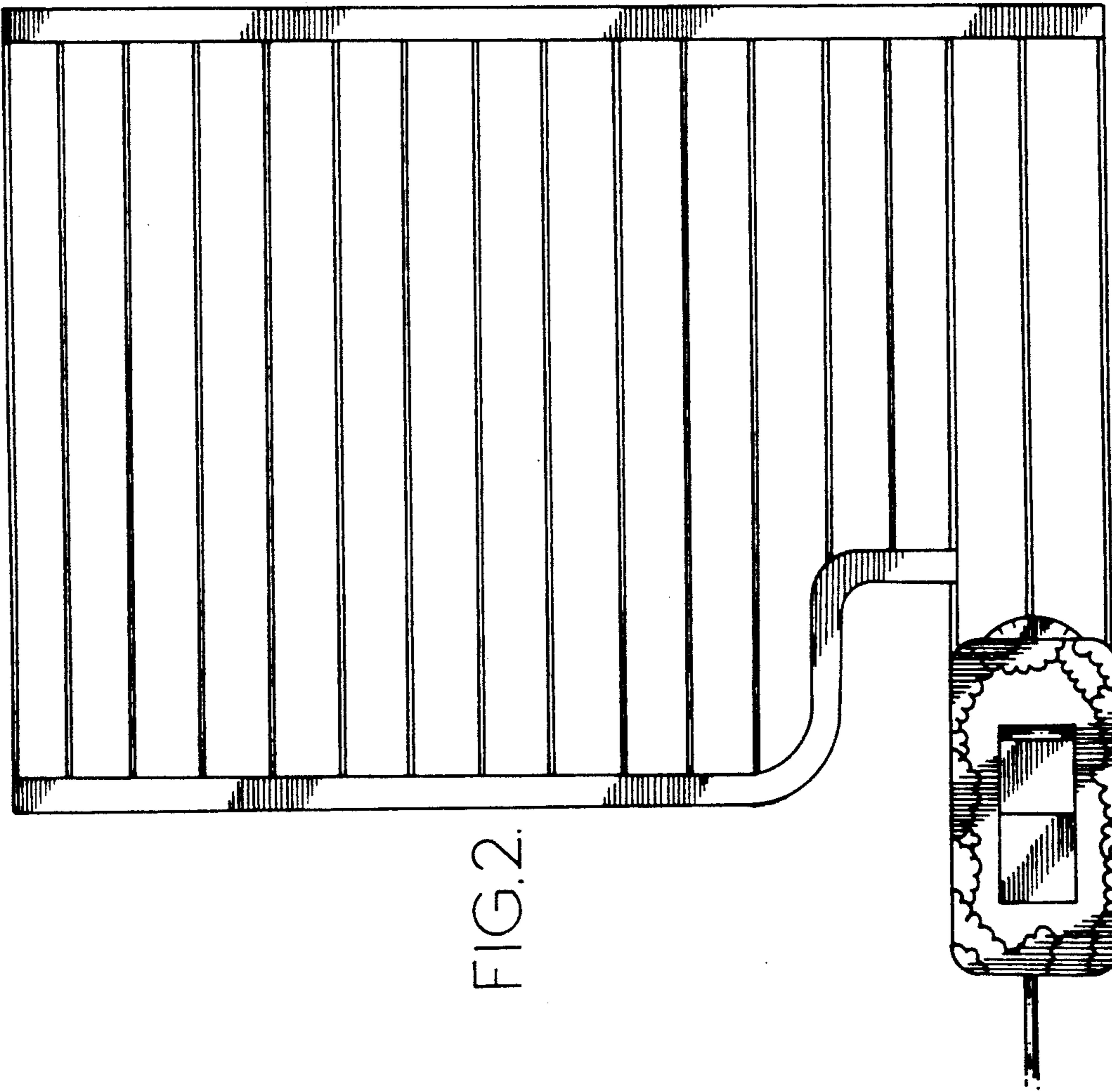

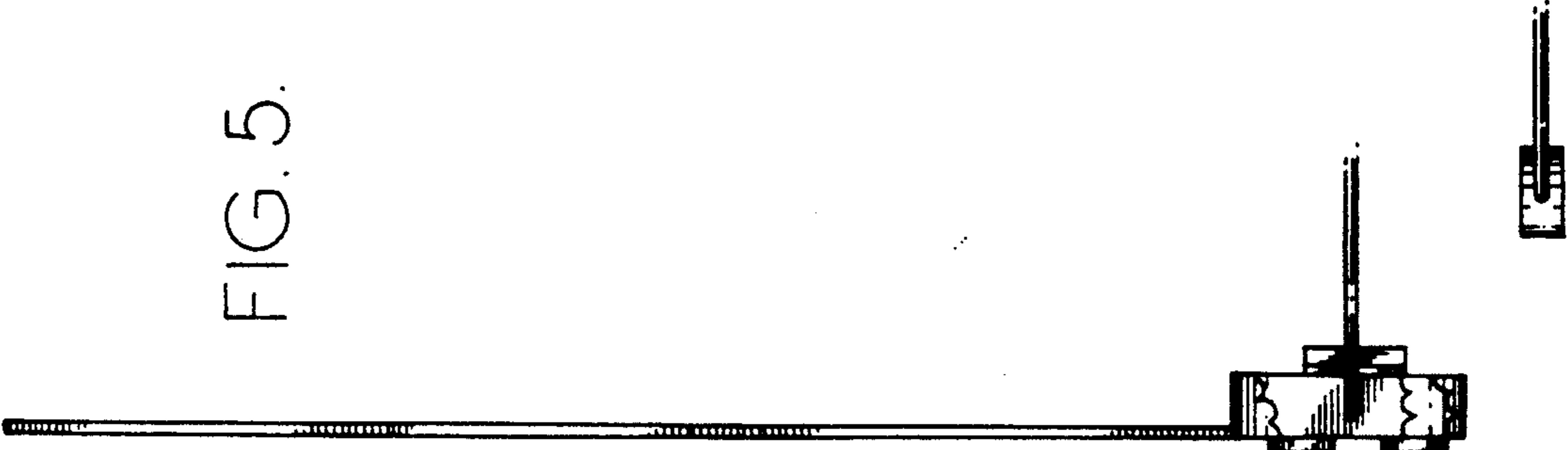
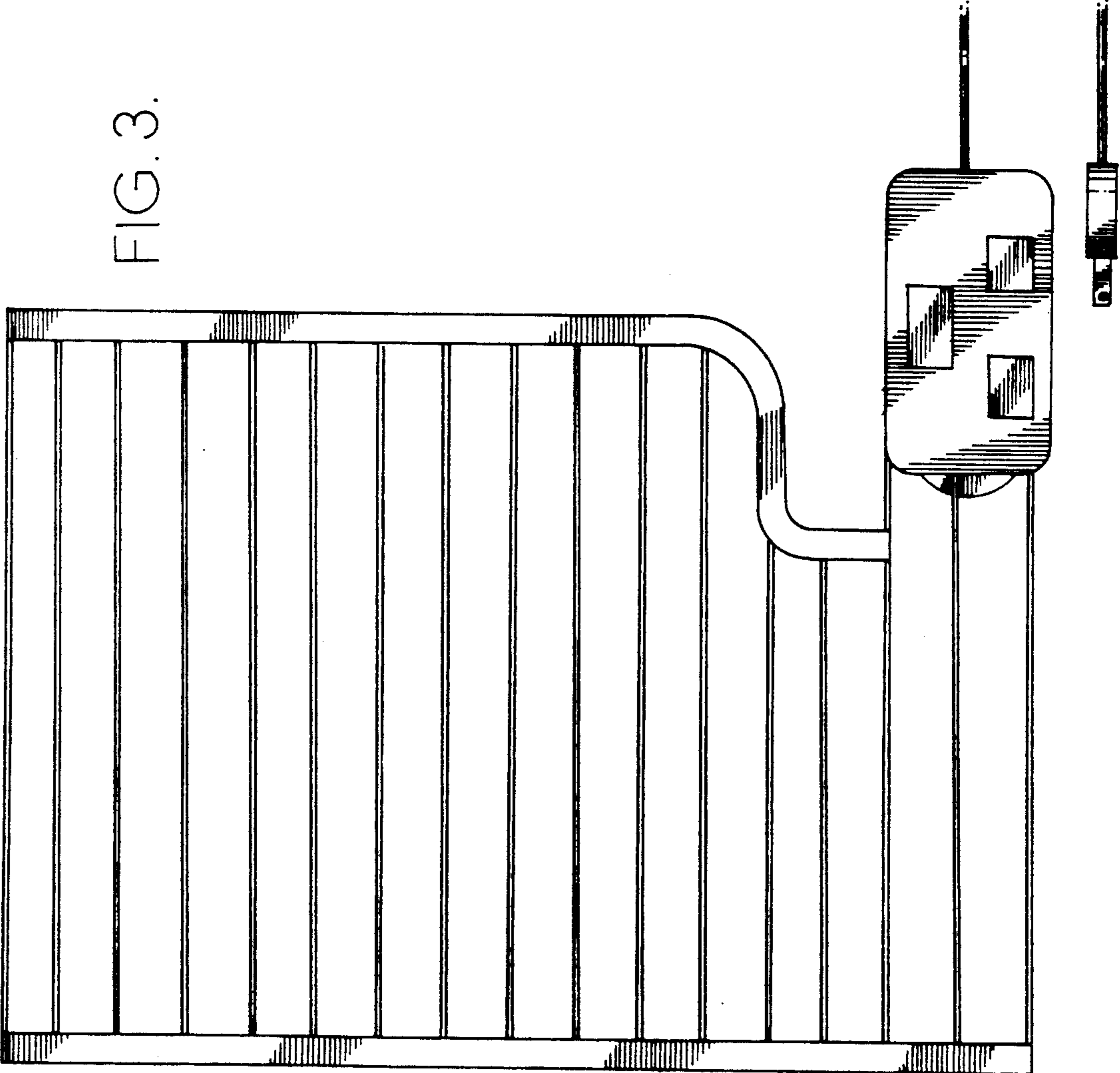

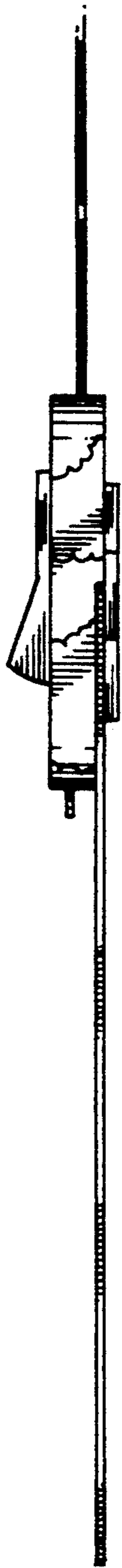
