DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a tool box showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof, the side flaps being shown in an open position;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof, the lid being shown in an open position;
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7;
FIG. 9 is an exploded left side view of FIG. 7;
FIG. 10 is a top plan view of an alternate embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1, the broken lines showing a saw being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the front tool holder element shown in FIG. 9;
FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of FIG. 11;
FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 11;
FIG. 14 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 11, the right side being a mirror image;
FIG. 15 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 11;
FIG. 16 is a rear elevational view of a second embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 17 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 16, the right side being a mirror image;
FIG. 18 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 19 is a perspective view of FIG. 7;
FIG. 20 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 11; and
FIG. 21 is a top perspective view of FIG. 11.
The broken lines showing a tray arrangement in FIGS. 7, 11, 13, 18, 19, and 21 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

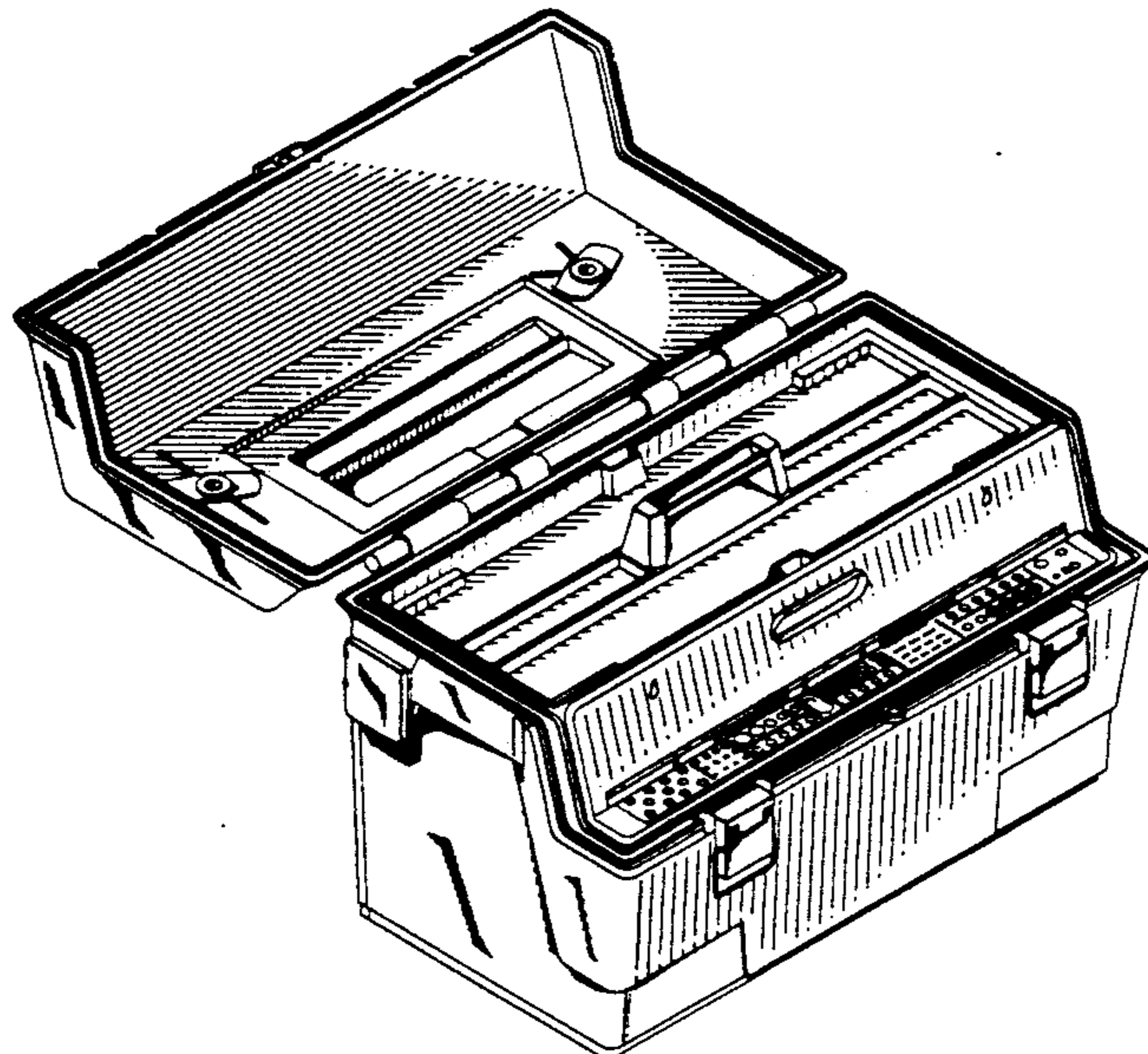

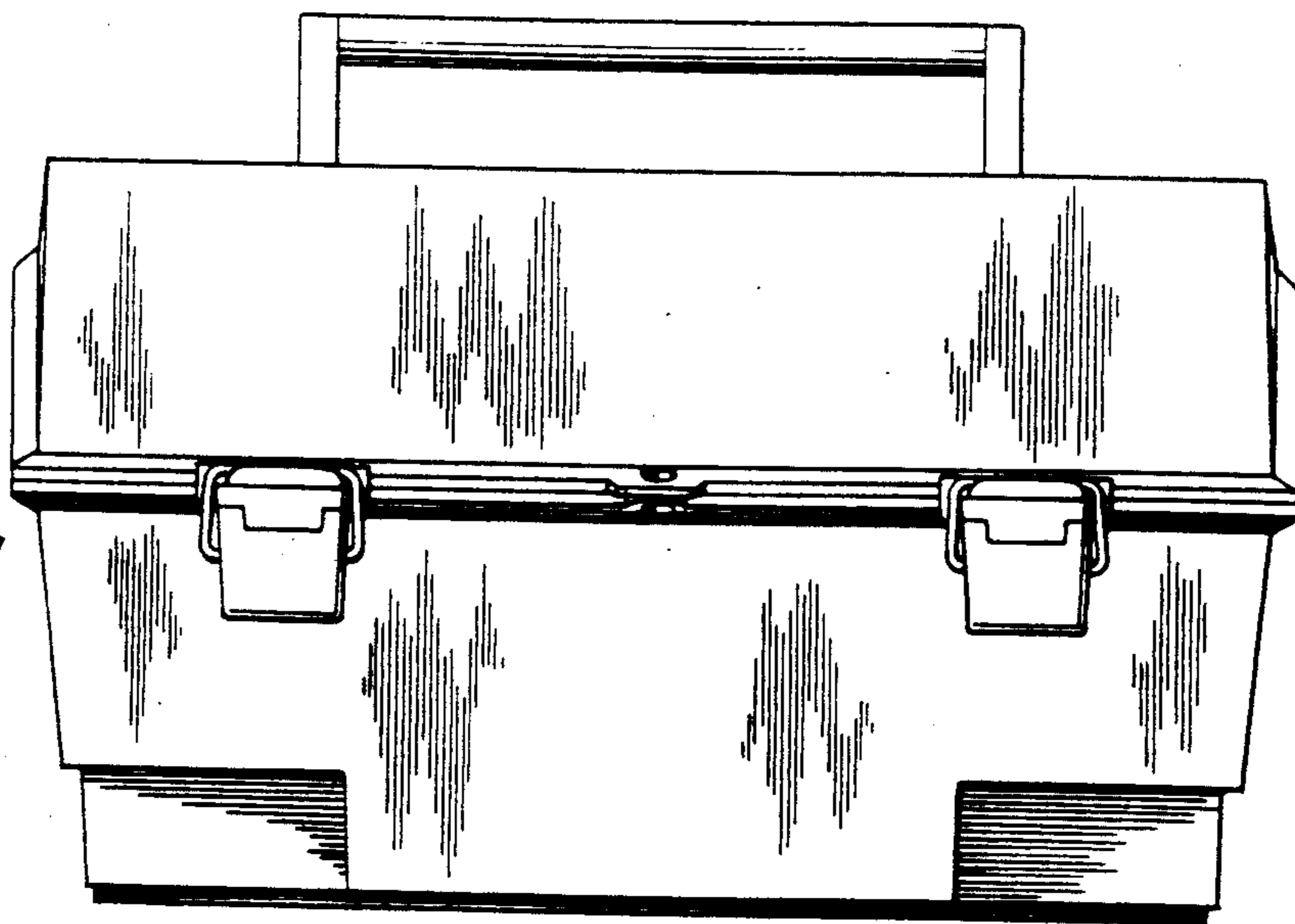

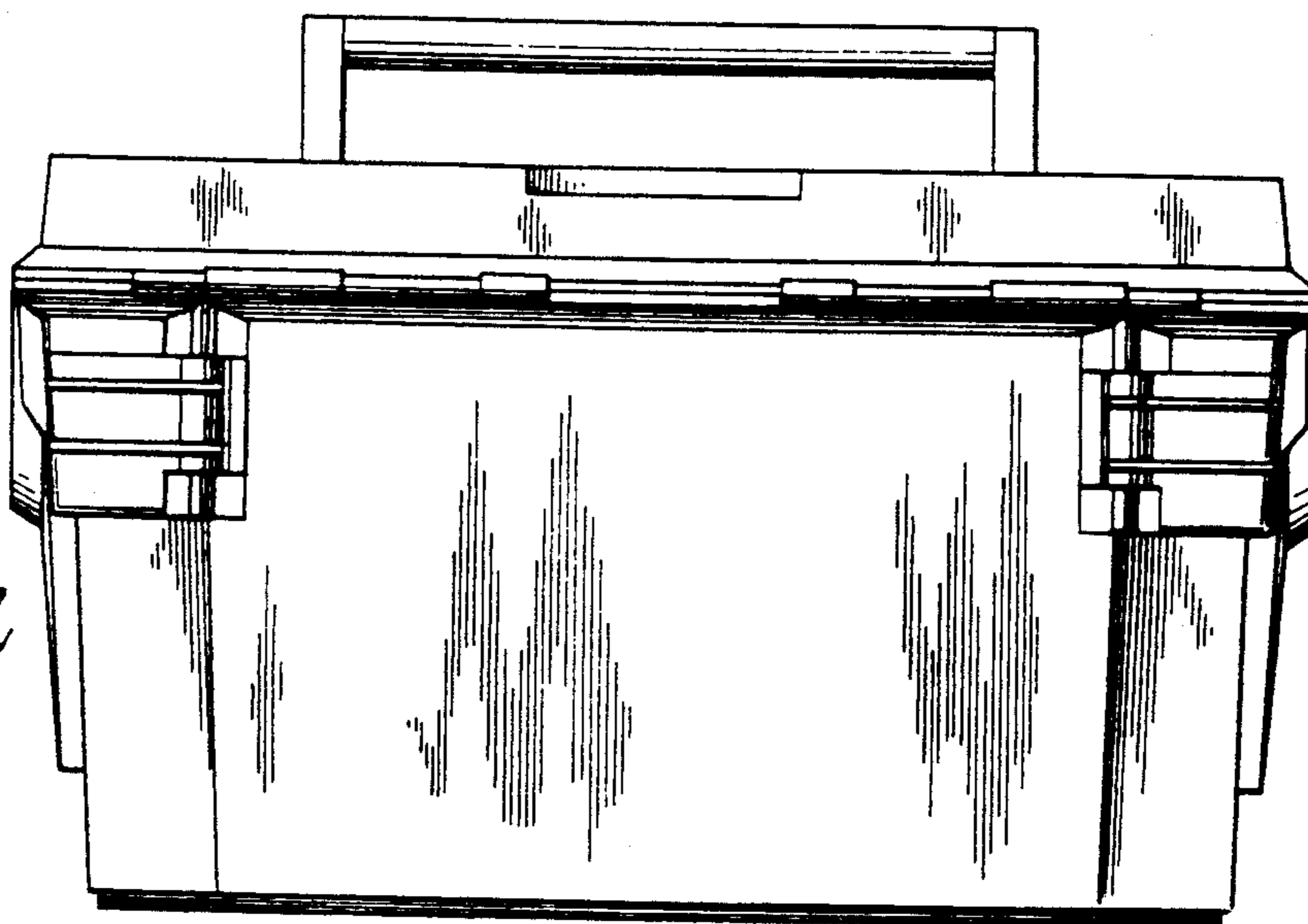

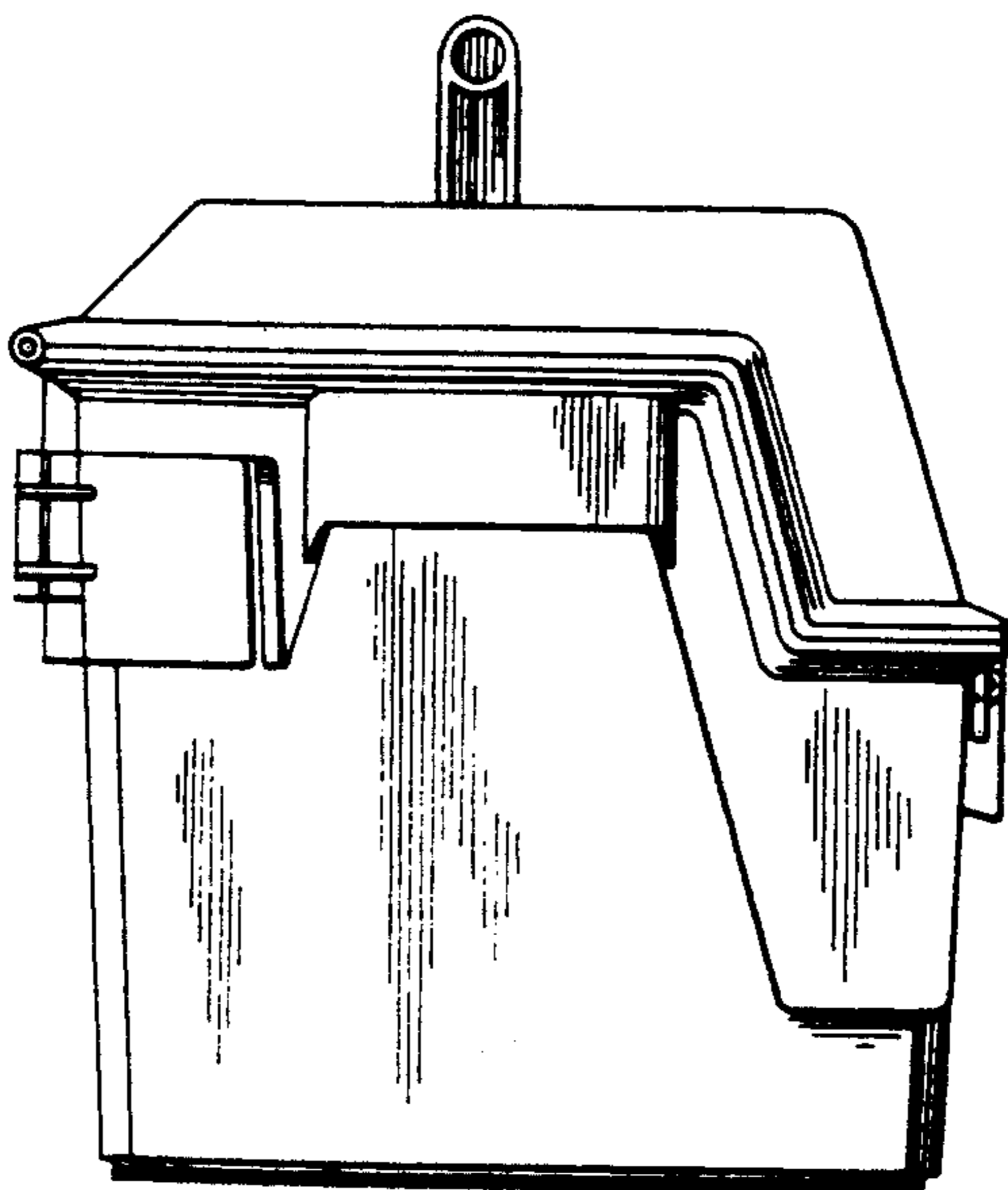

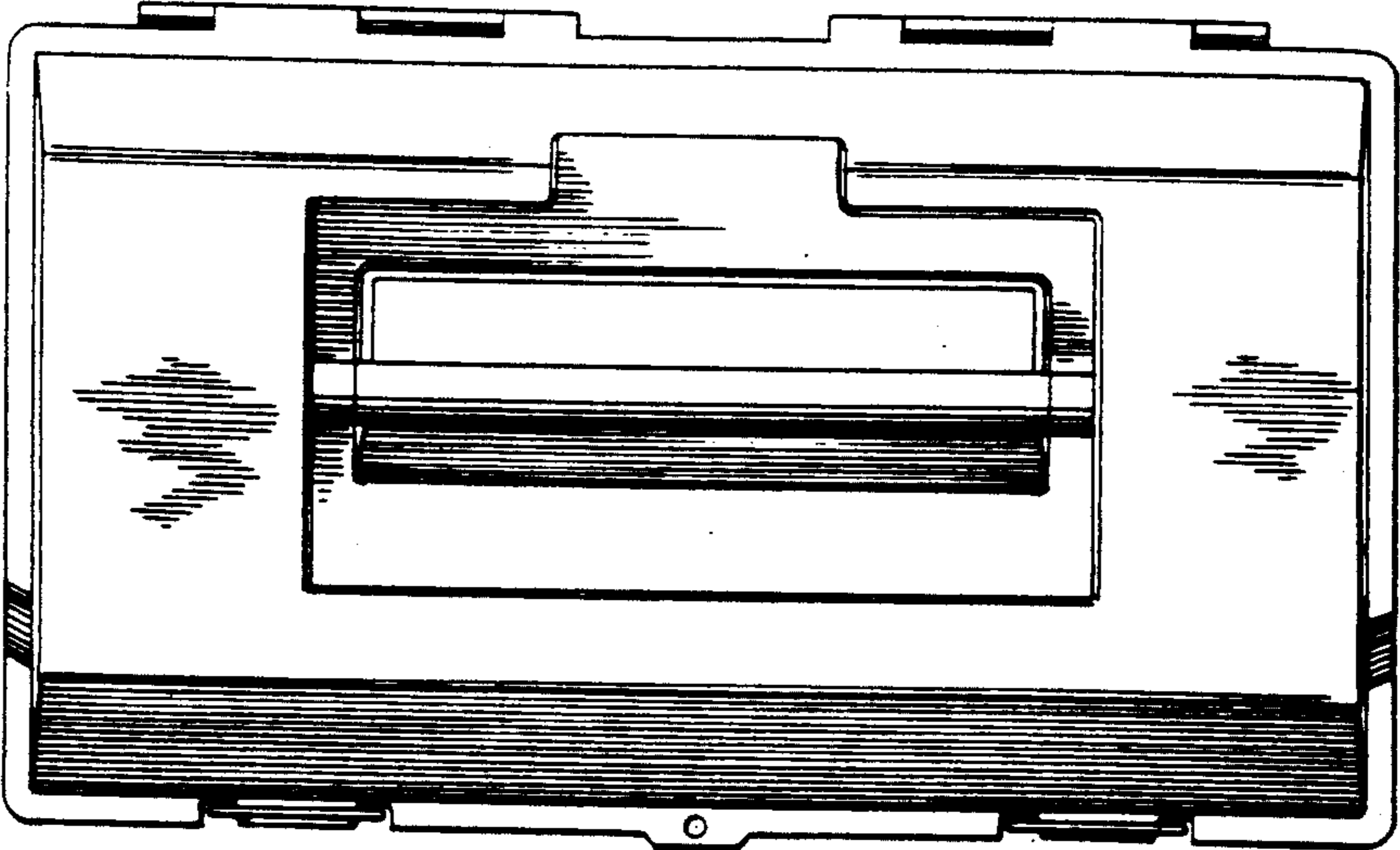

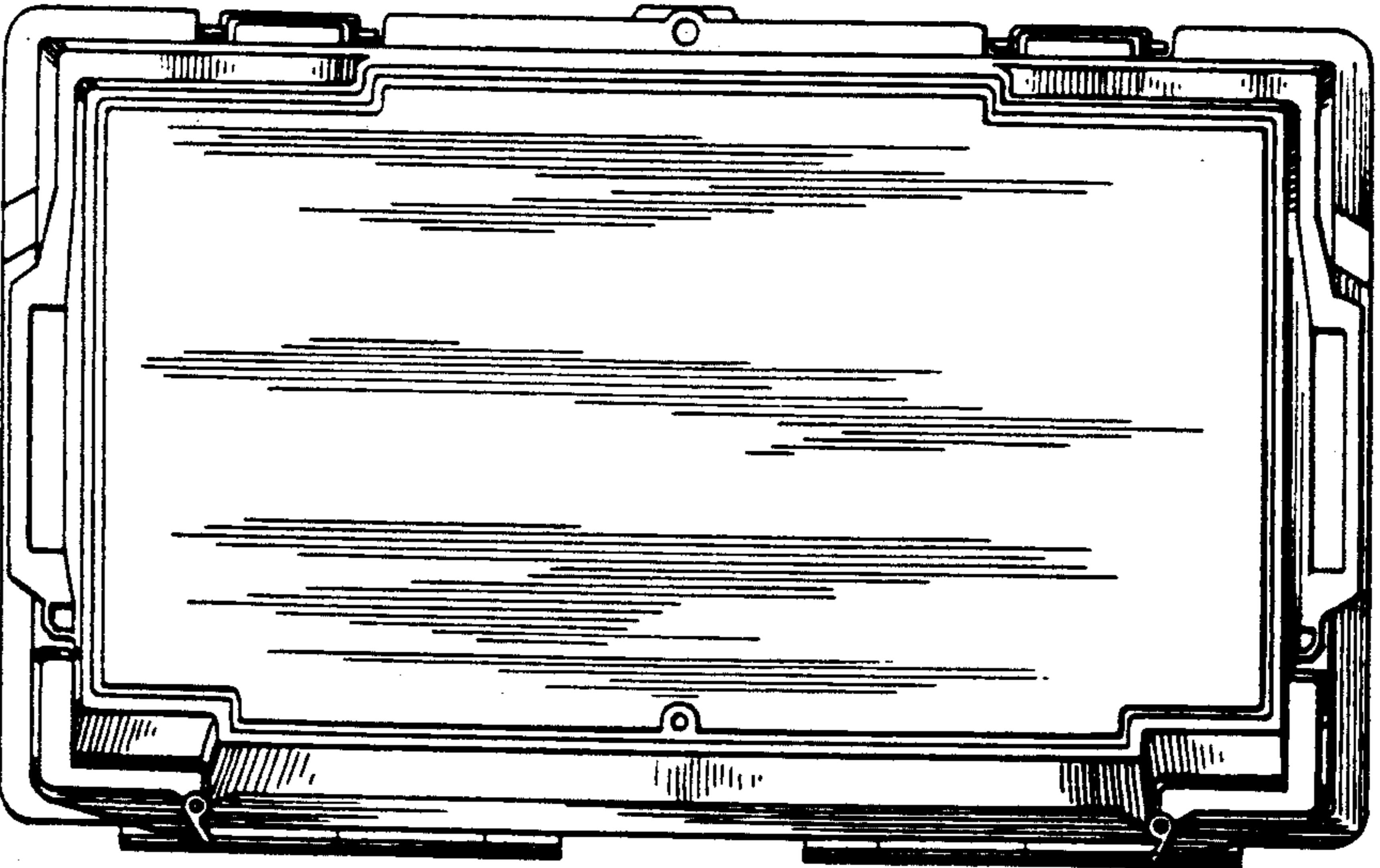

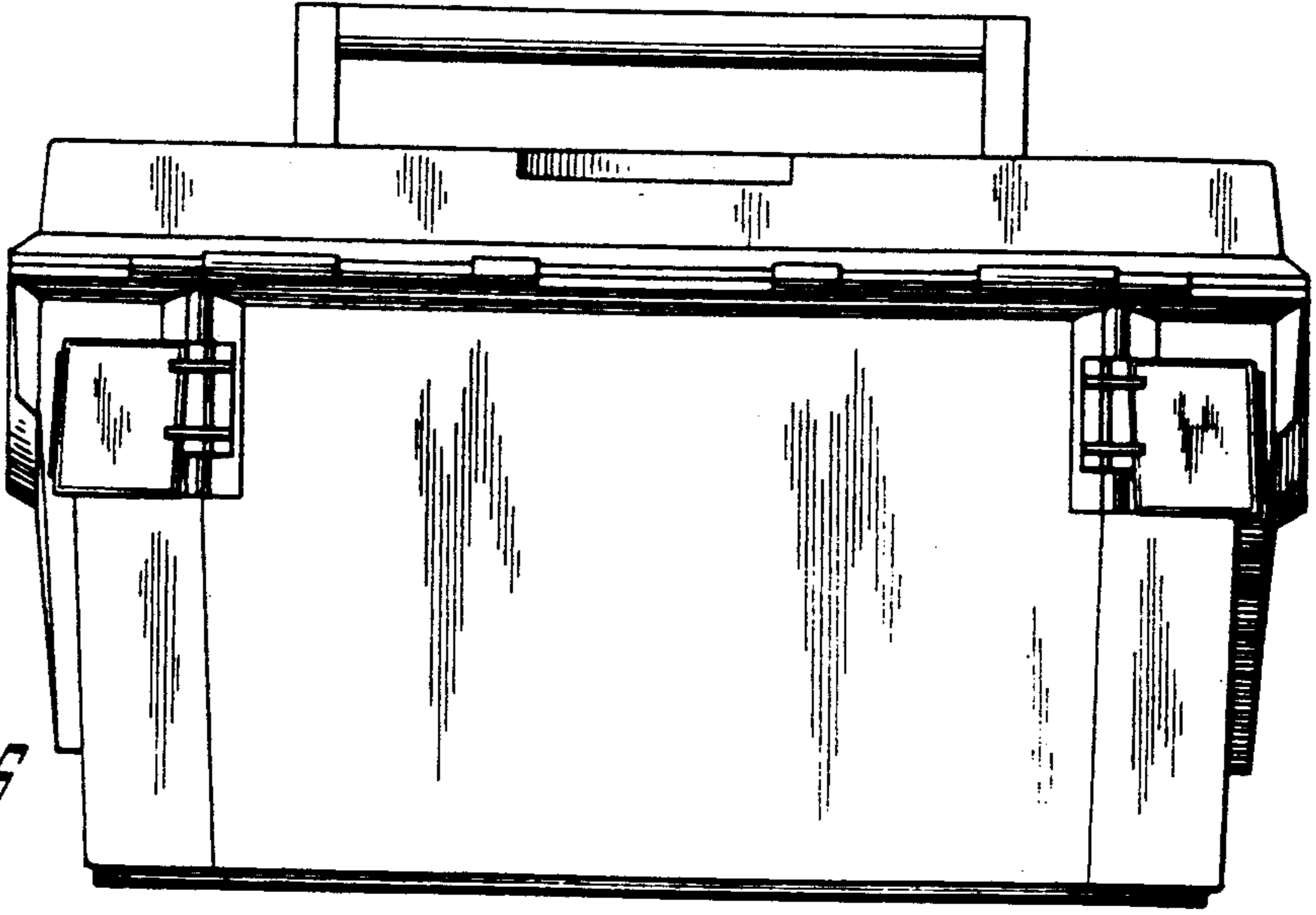

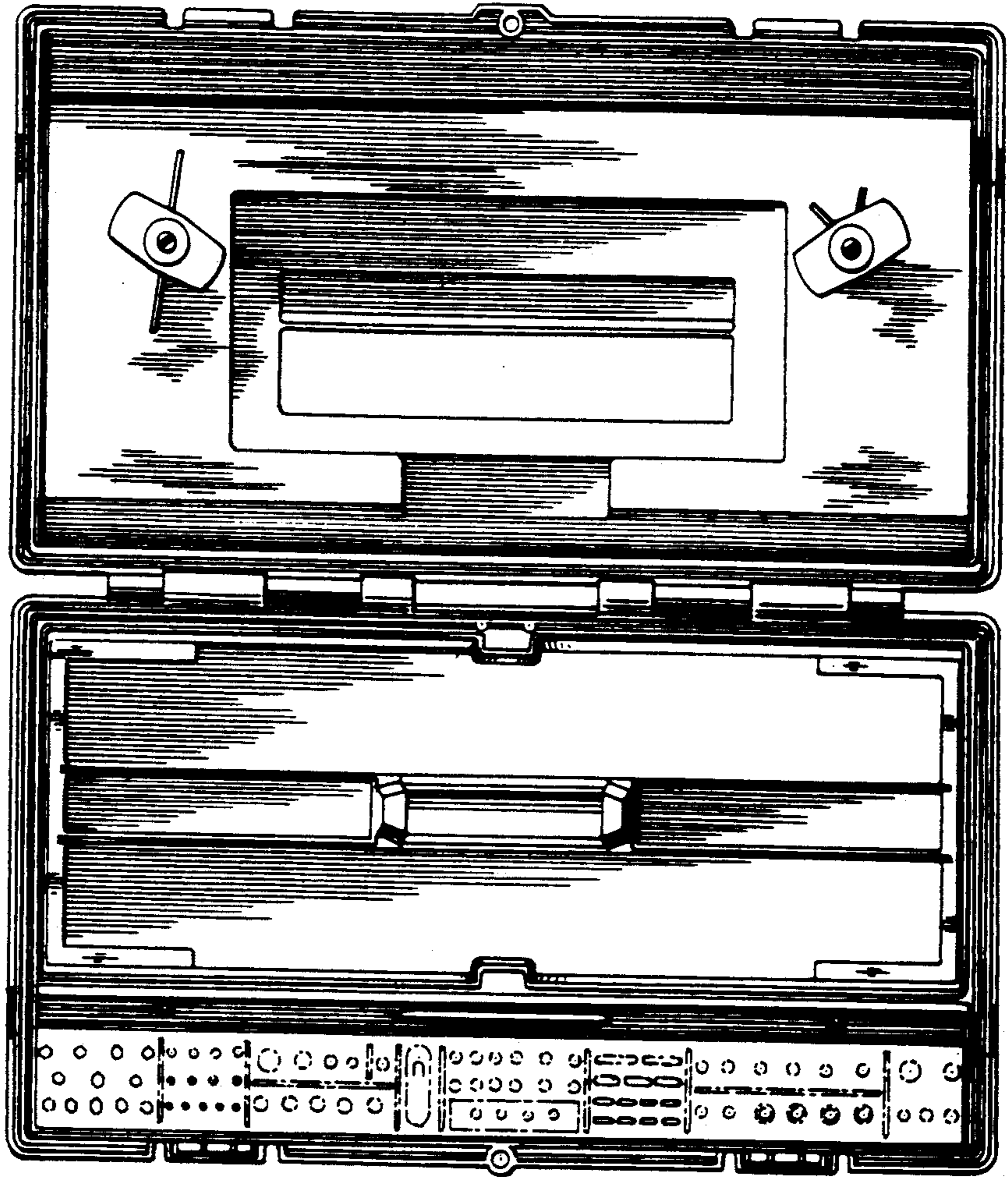
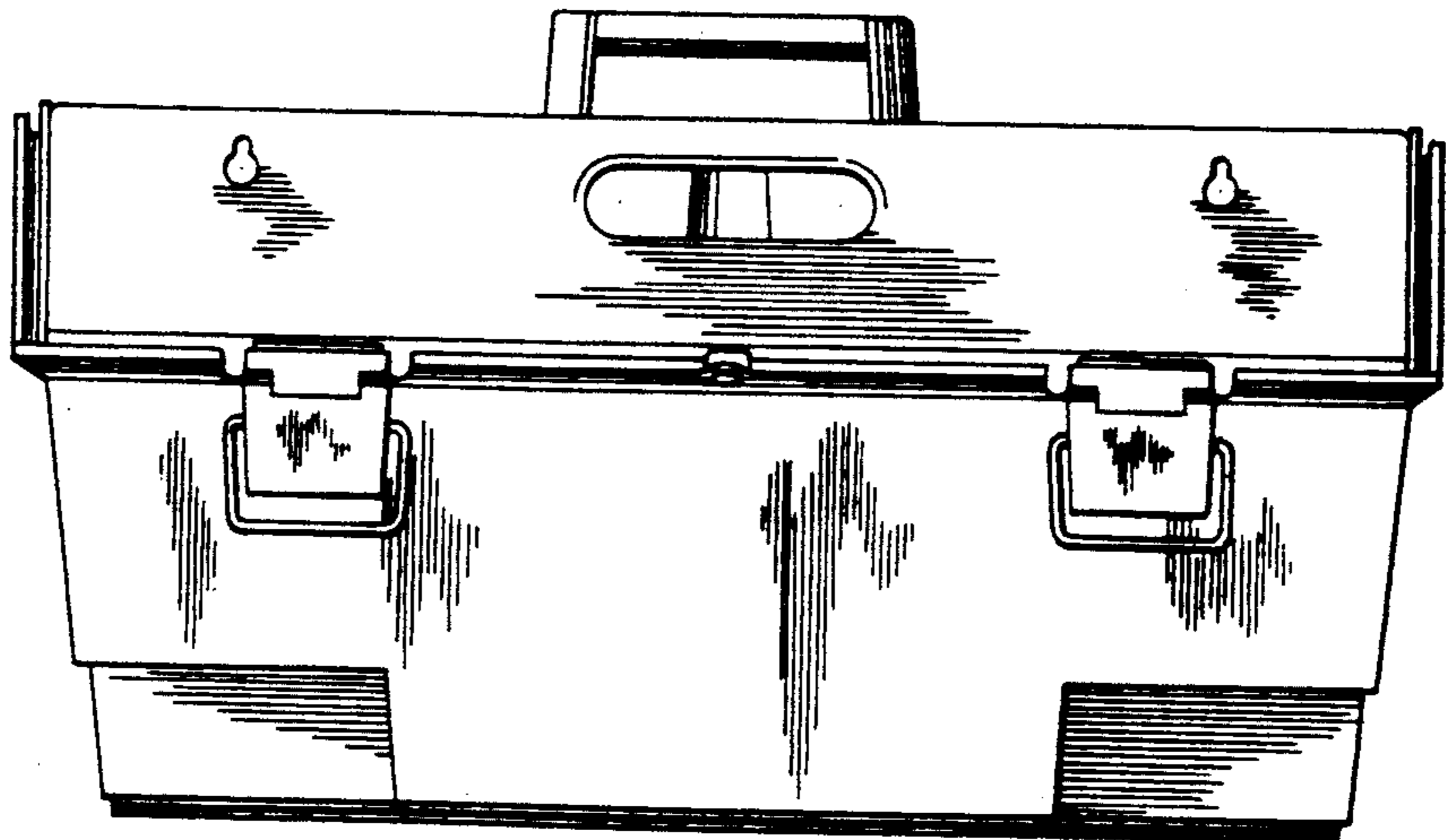

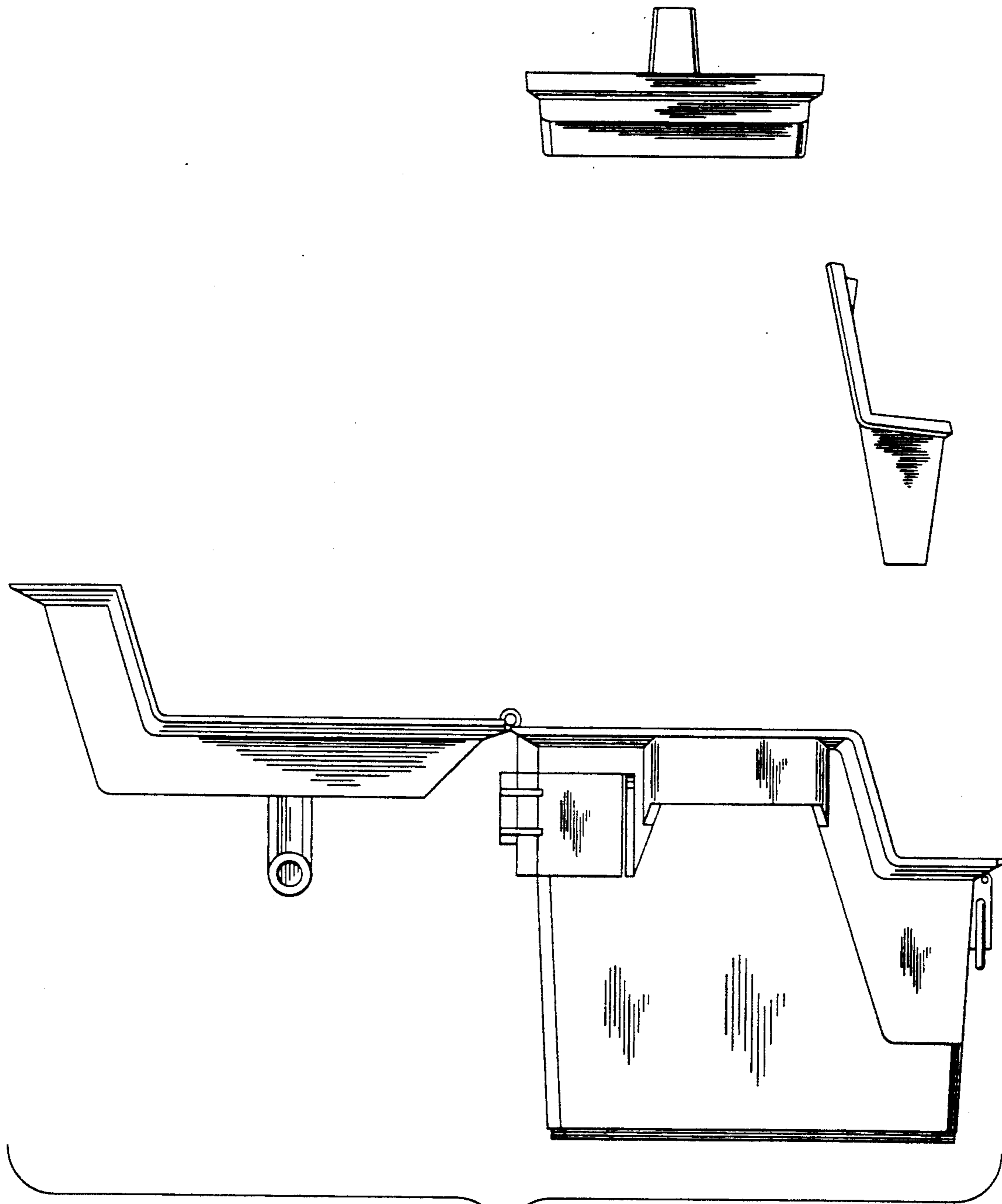

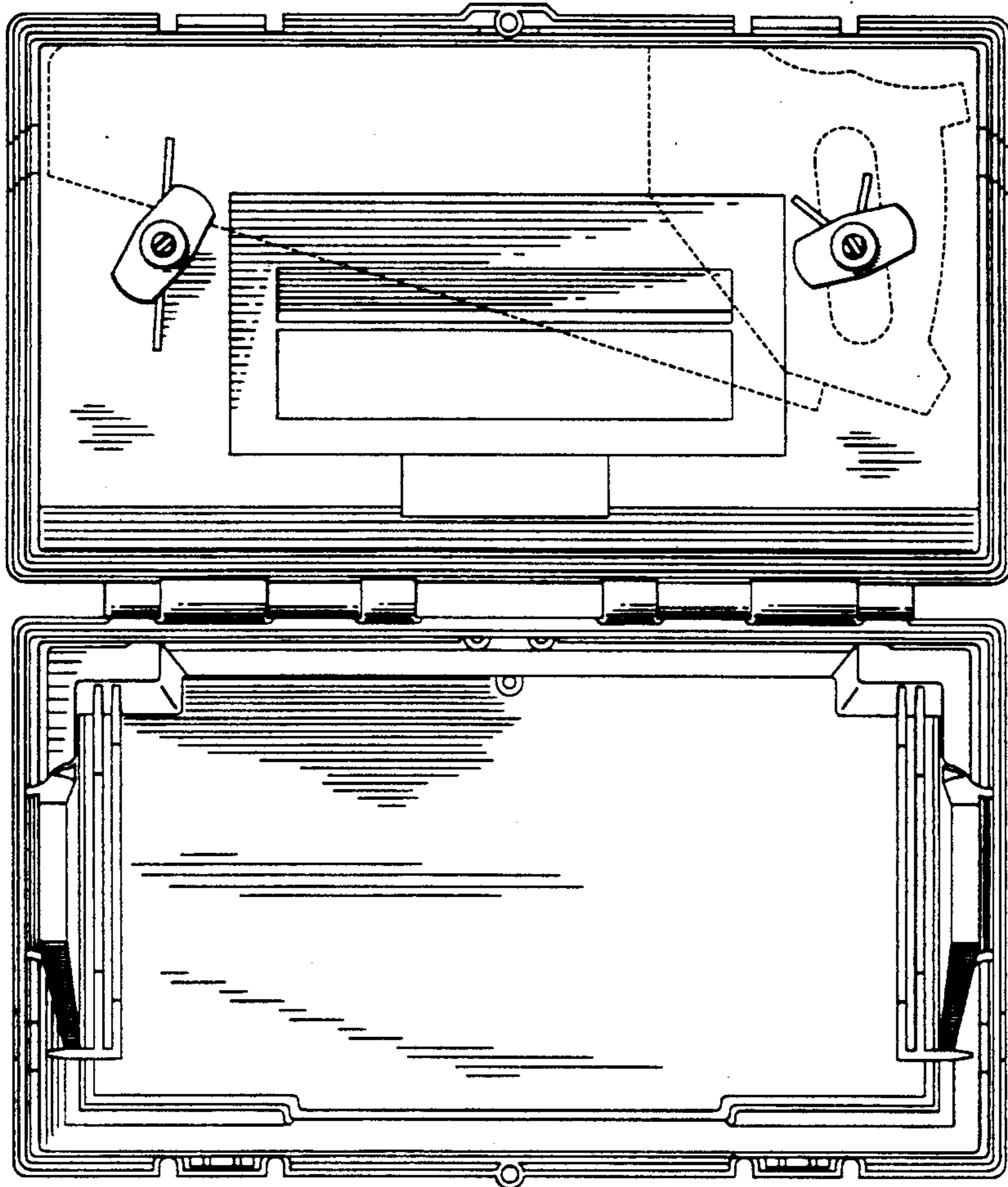
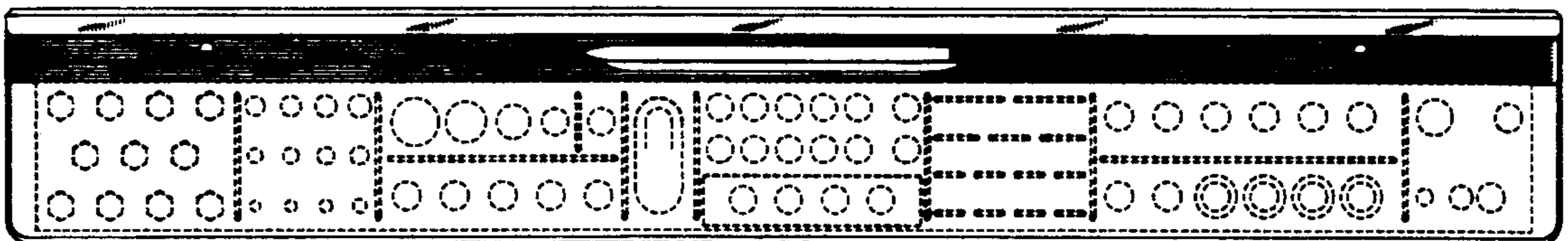

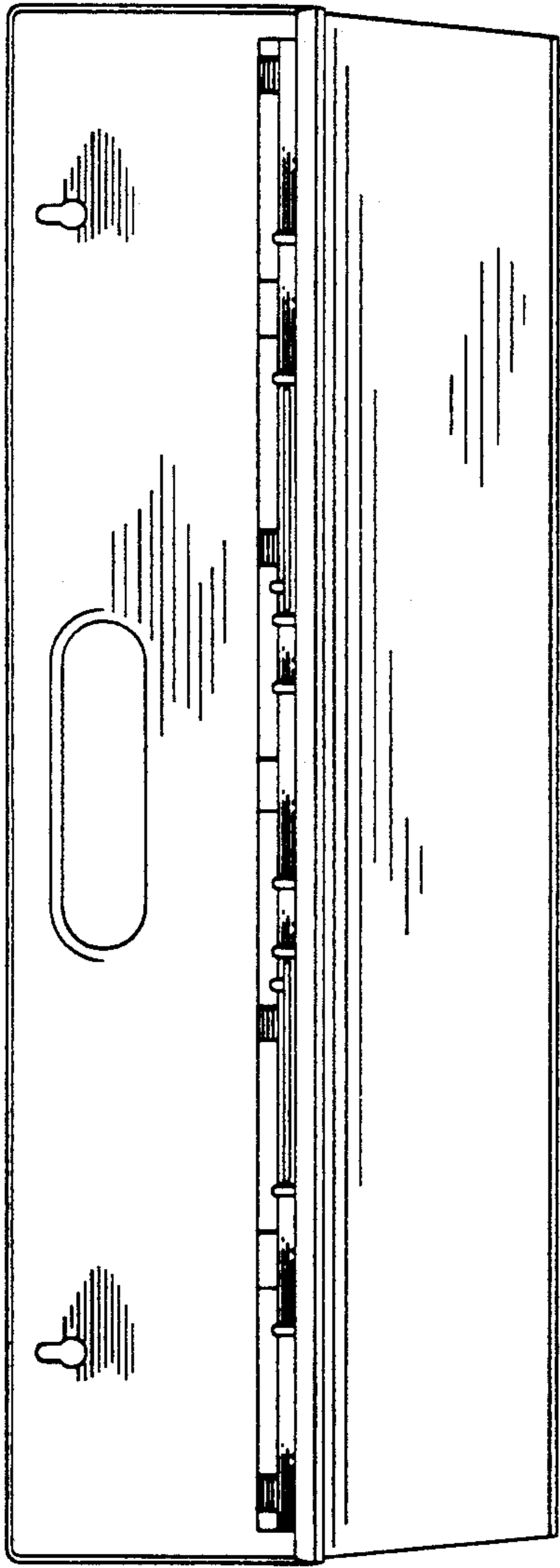

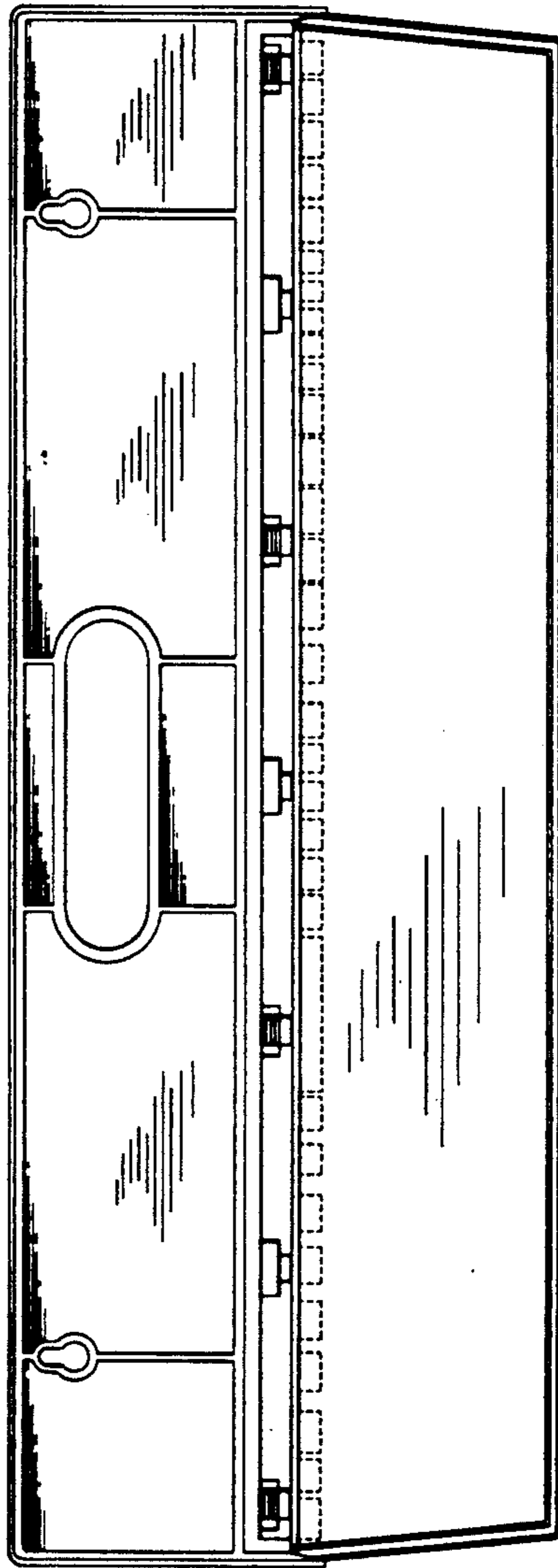

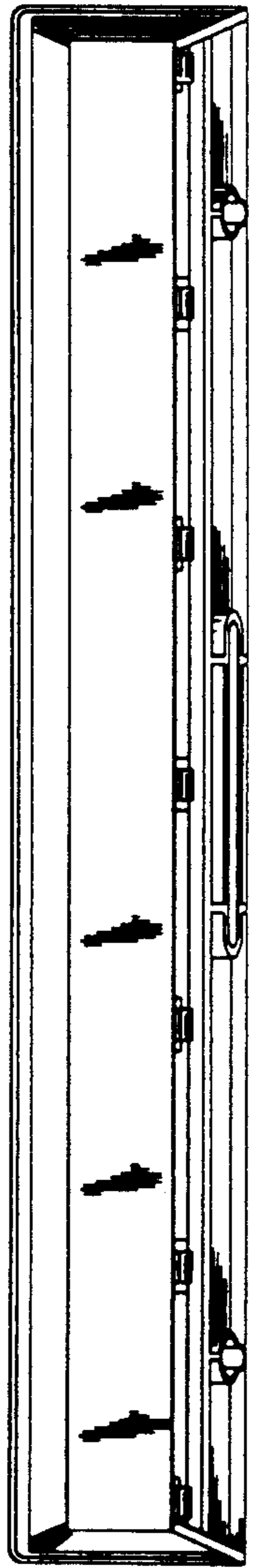

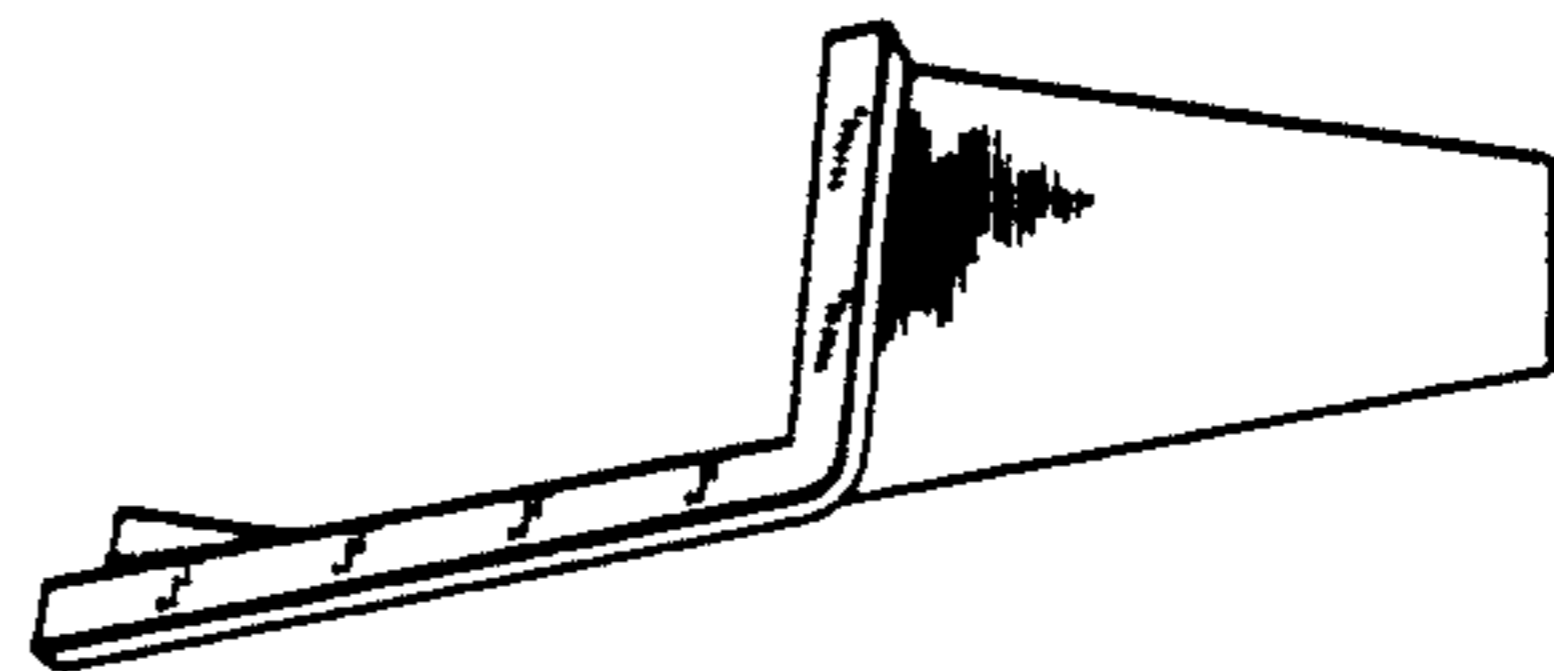

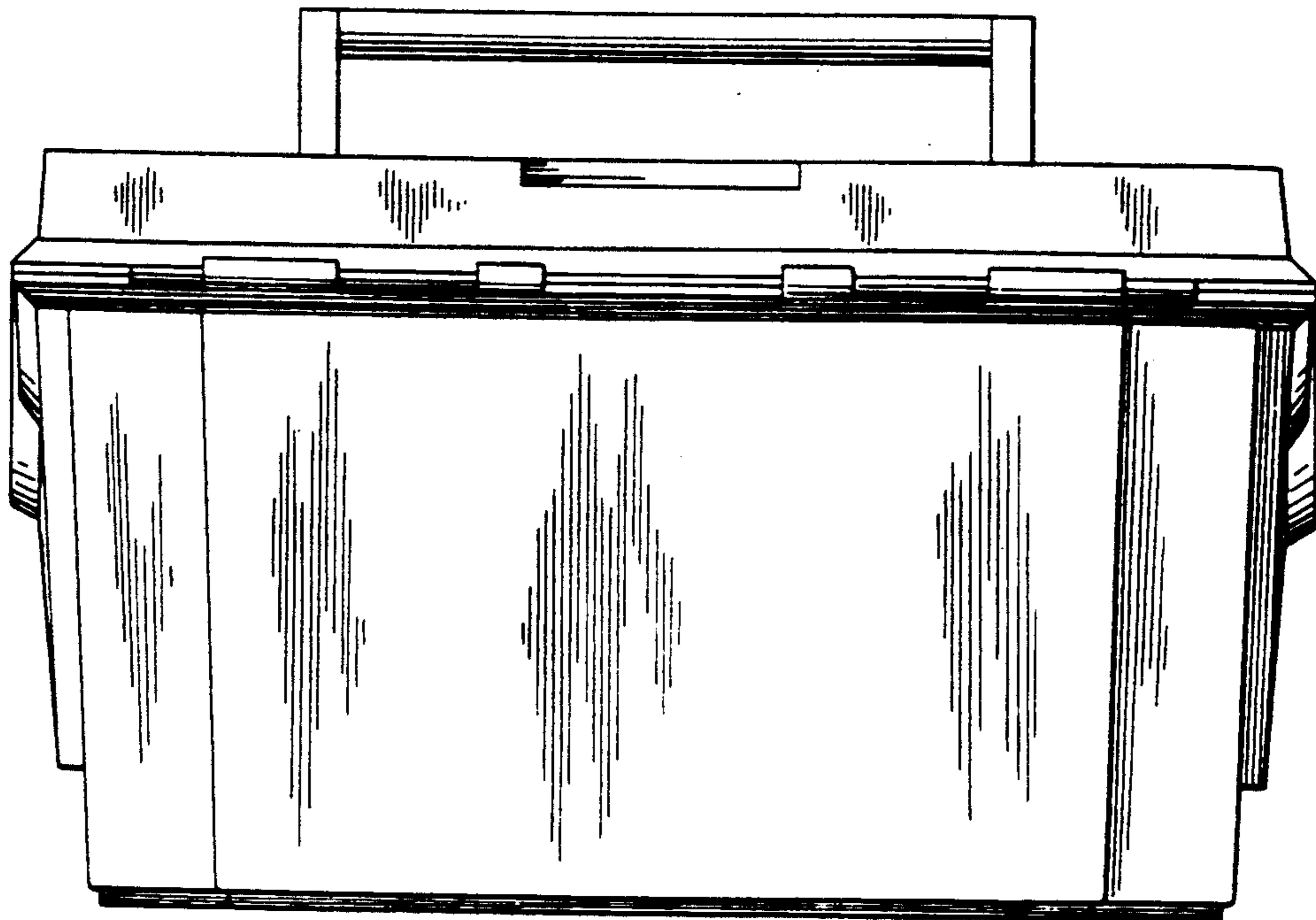
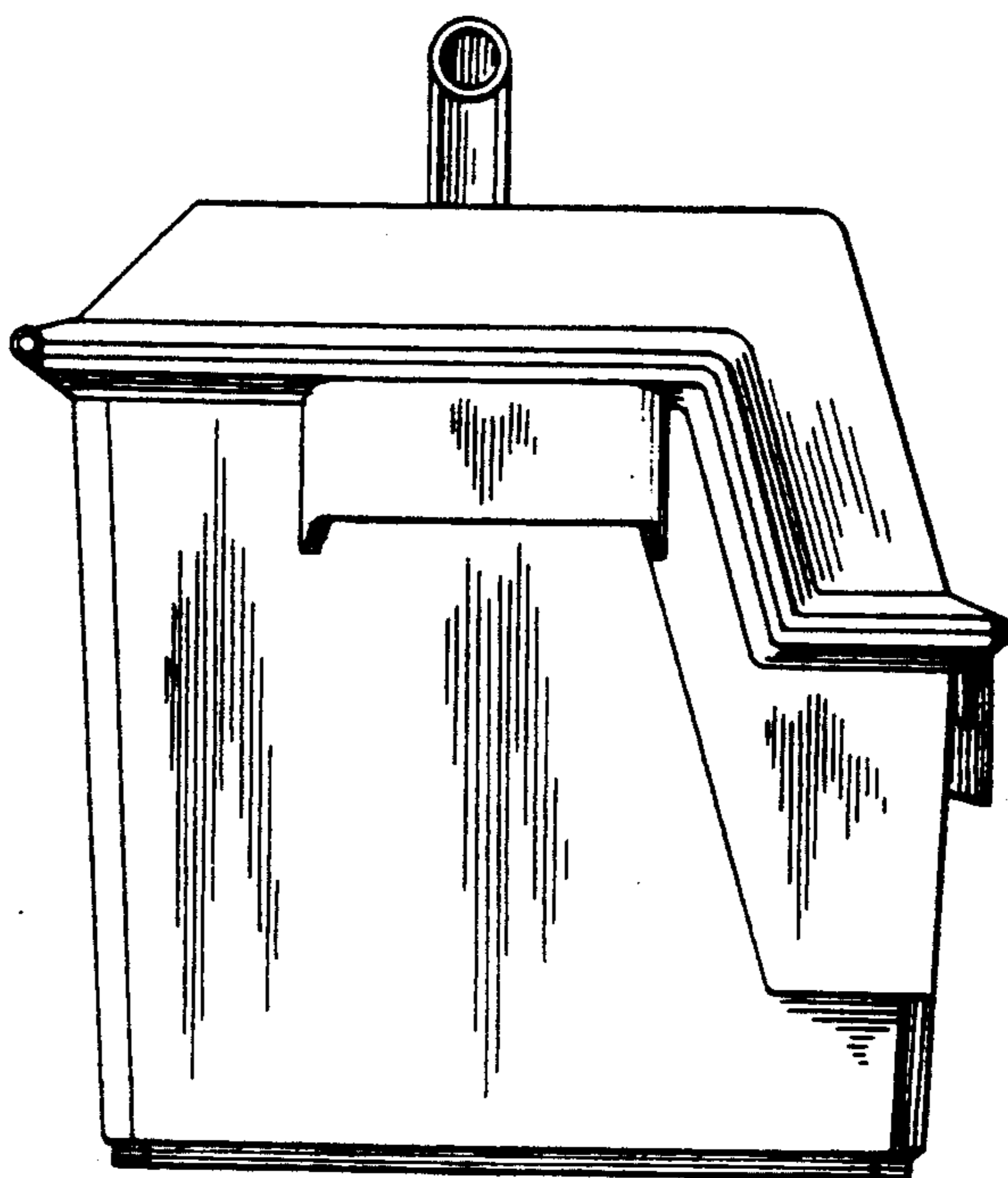

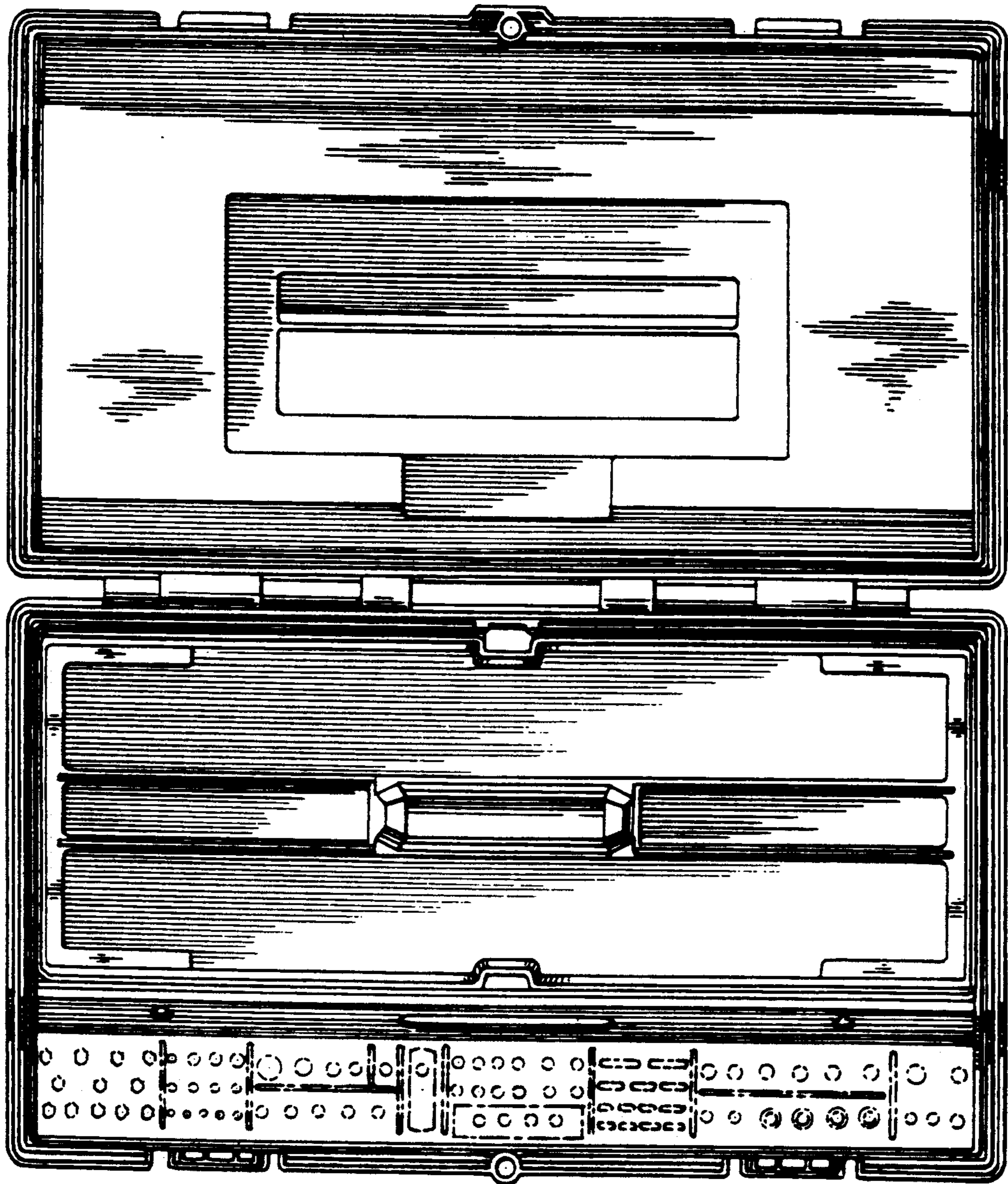

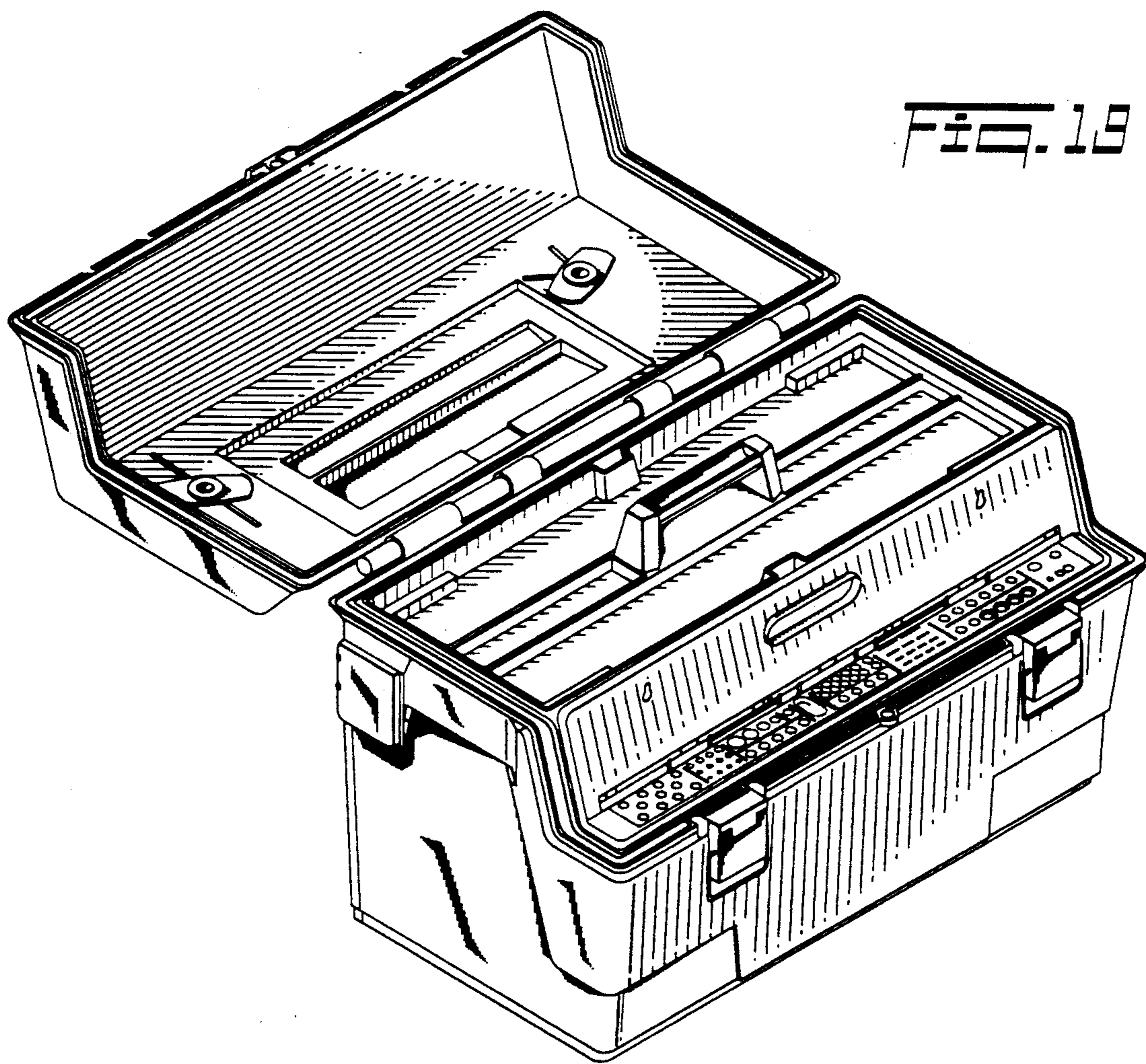

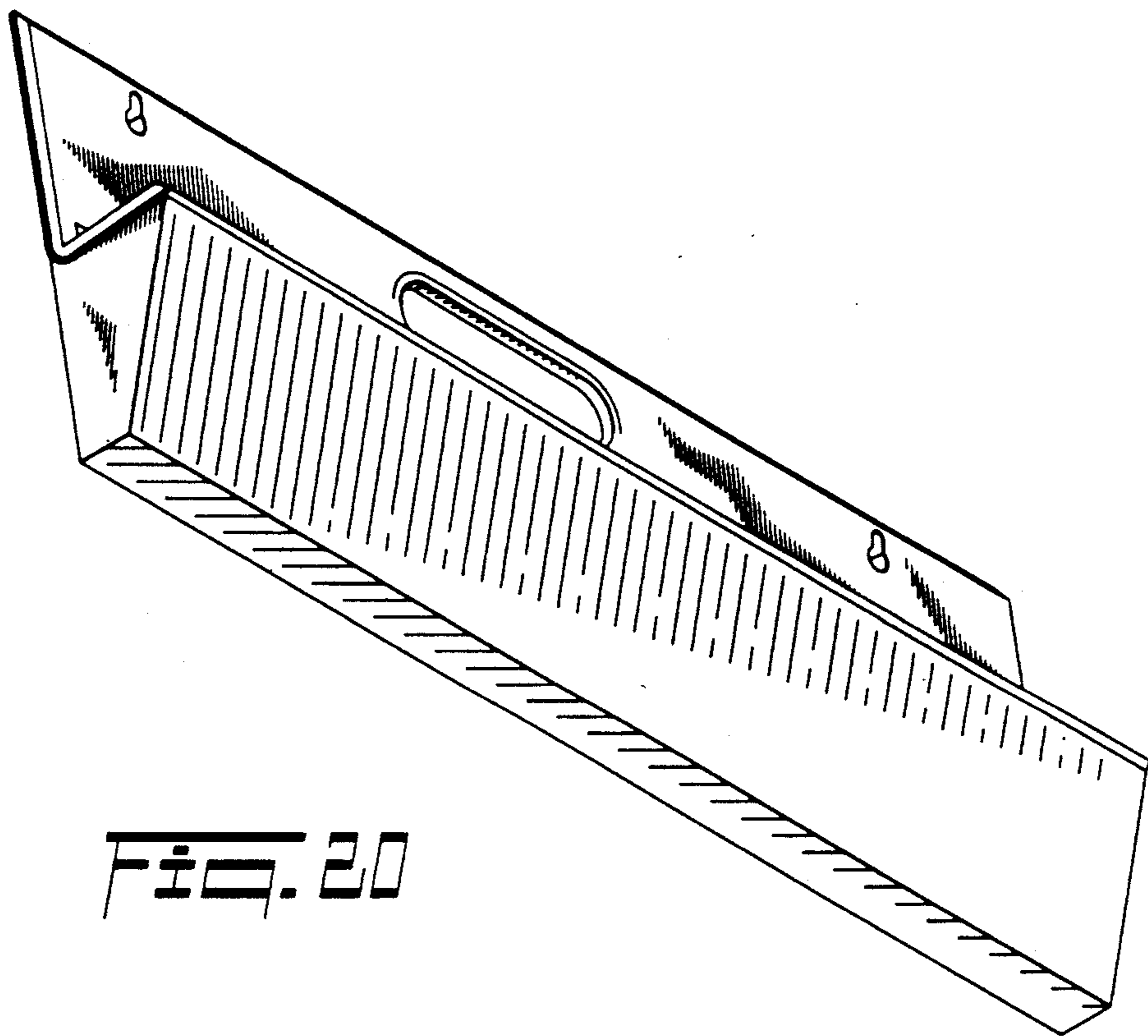
