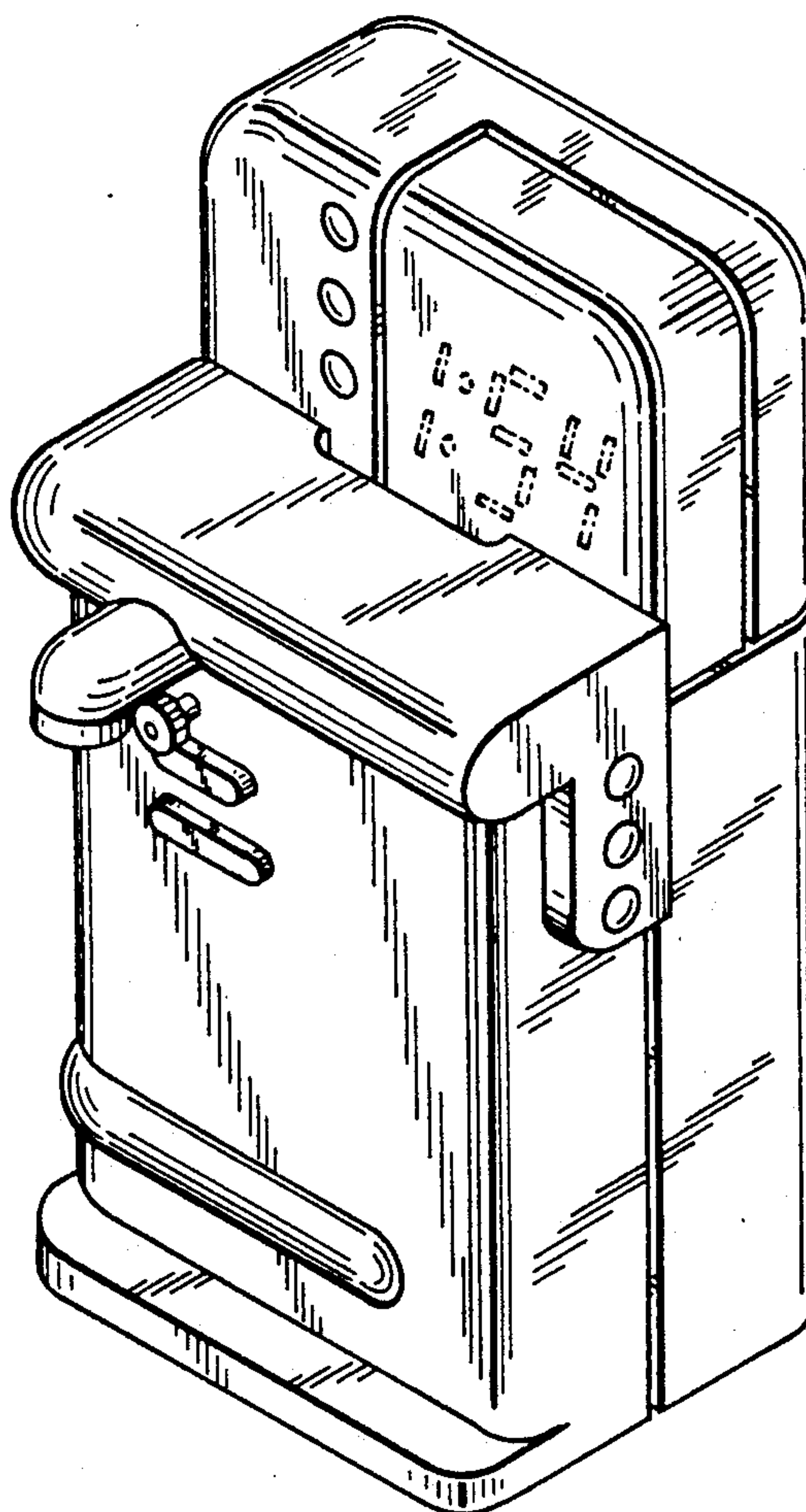
The ornamental design for a combination electric can opener, clock/timer, and knife sharpener, as shown.

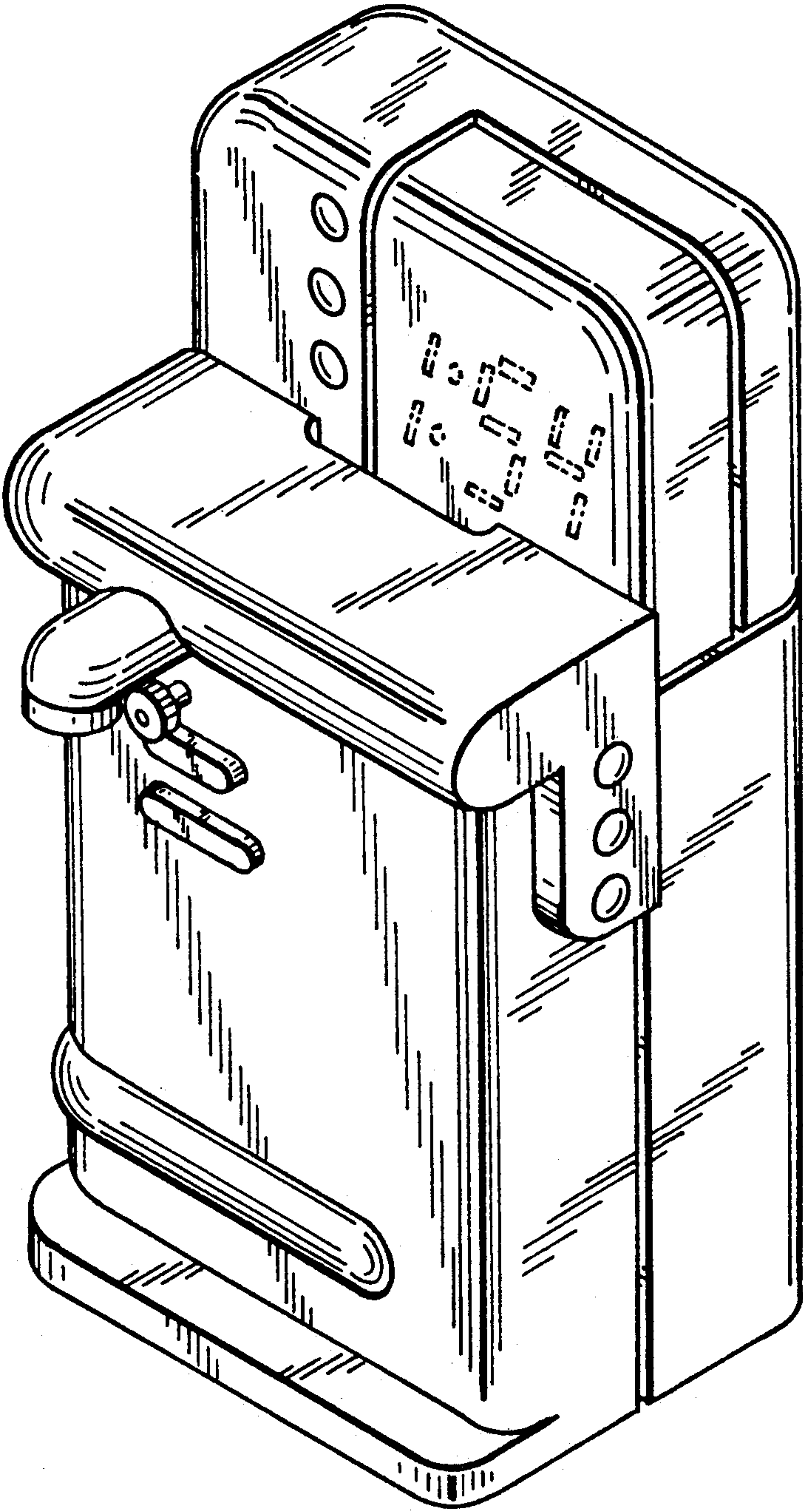
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof from the rear, bottom, and left side; and,

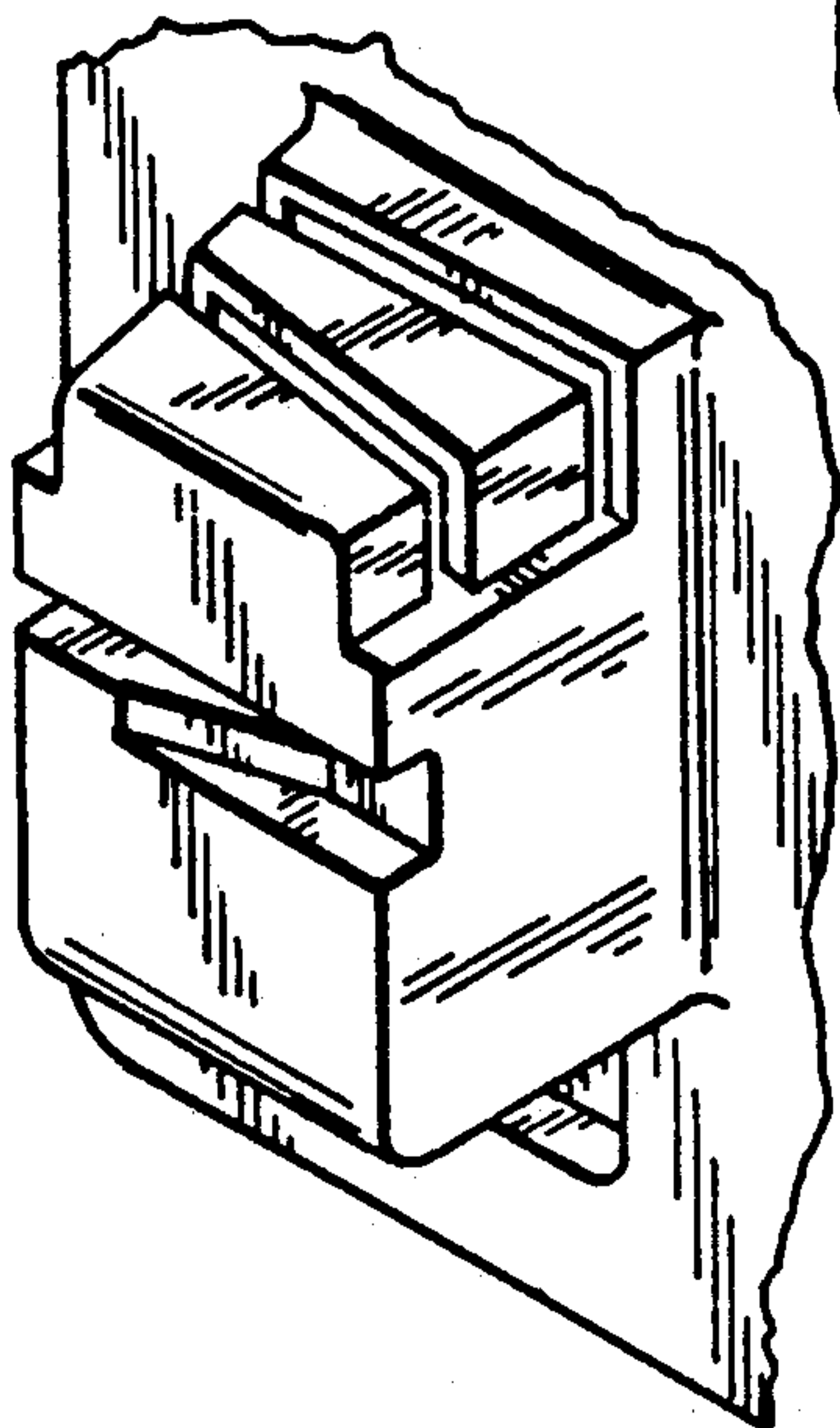
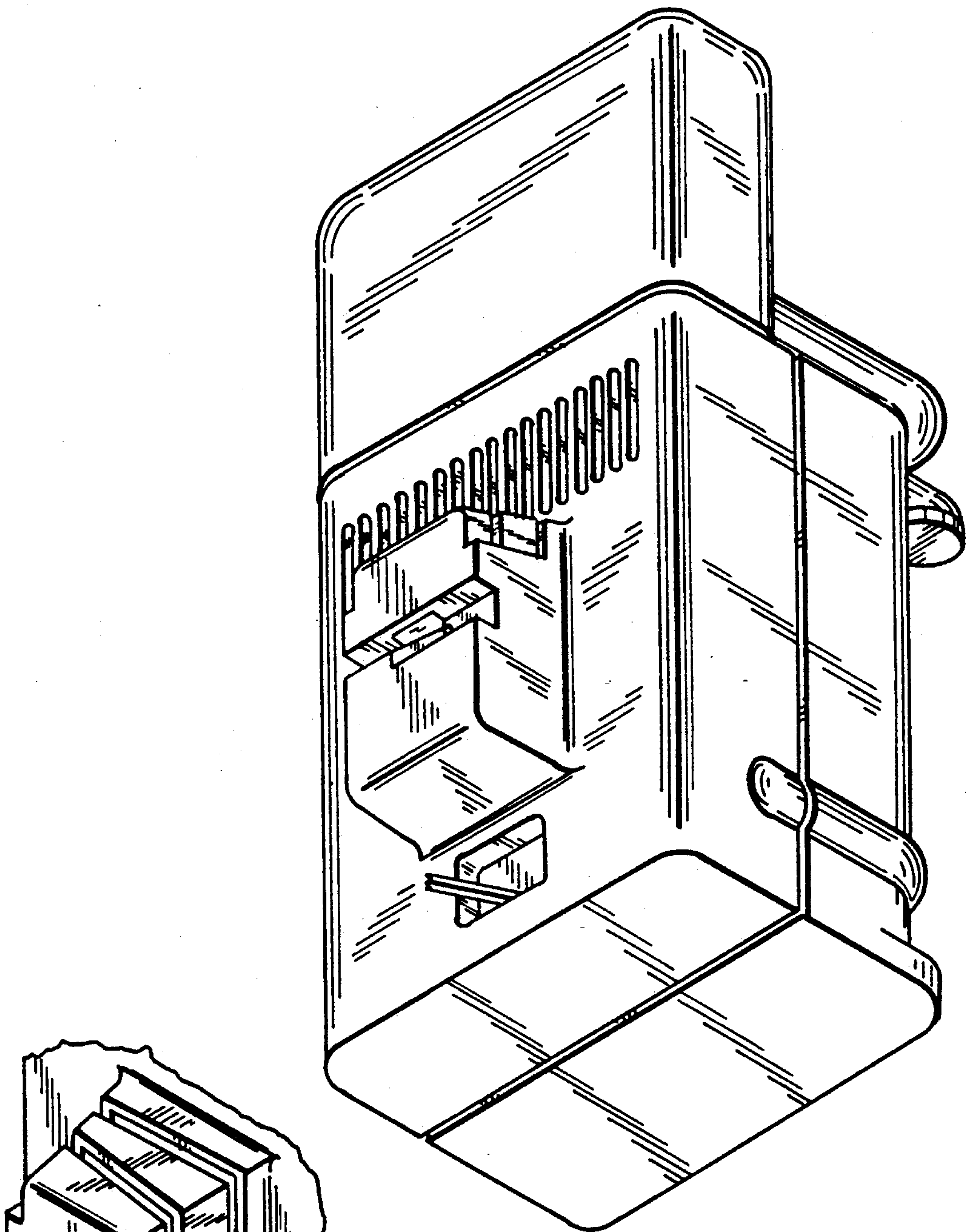
FIG. 3 is a fragmentary perspective view of the knife sharpener from the top, rear, and left side.
