[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a set of golf club heads, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a 3-iron showing a typical low loft angle golf club head which is part of a set of golf club heads embodying my new design;

FIG. 23 is an elevational view of the toe end thereof;

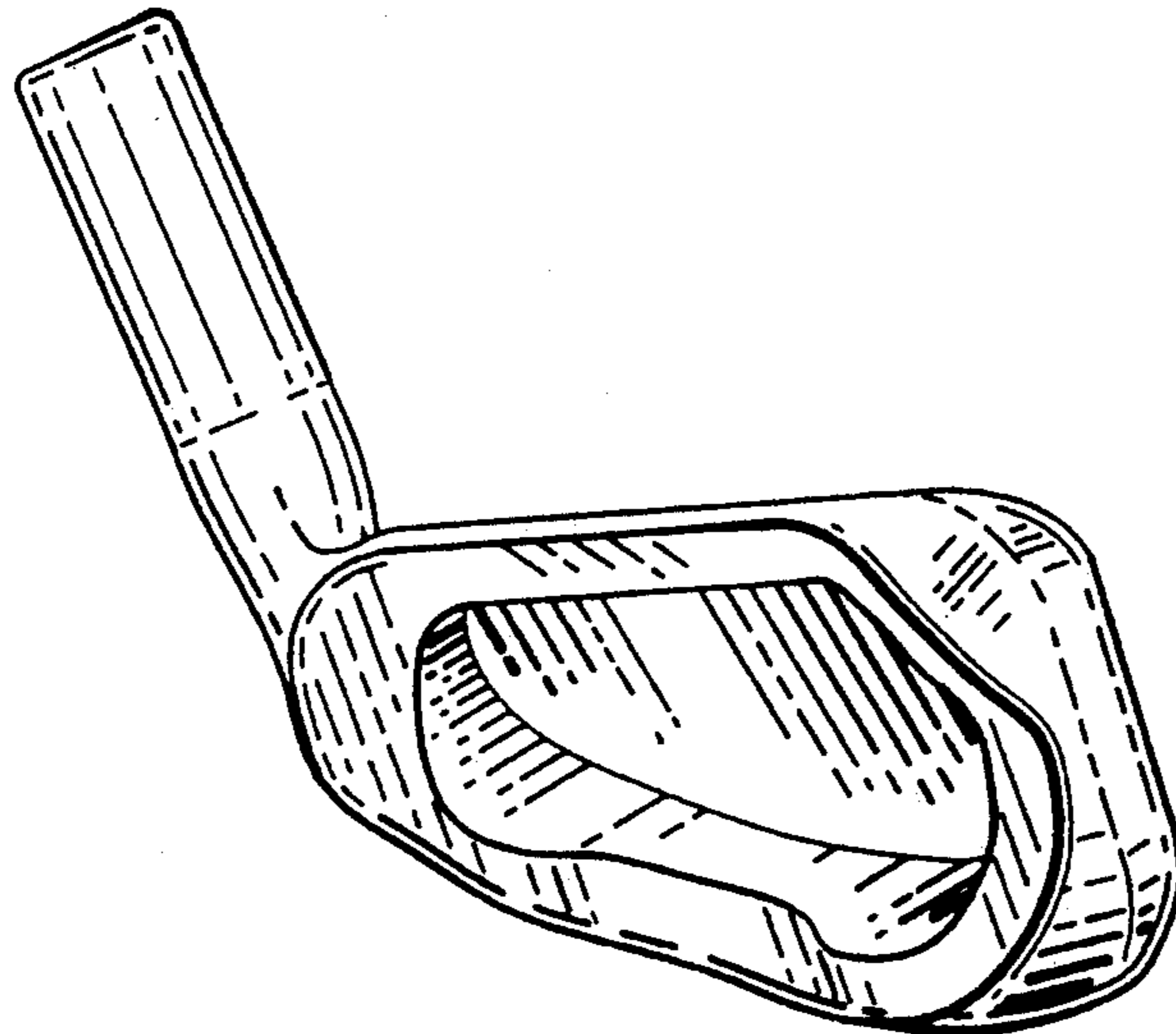
FIG. 24 is an elevational view of the heel end thereof;

FIG. 28 is a rear elevational view thereof.



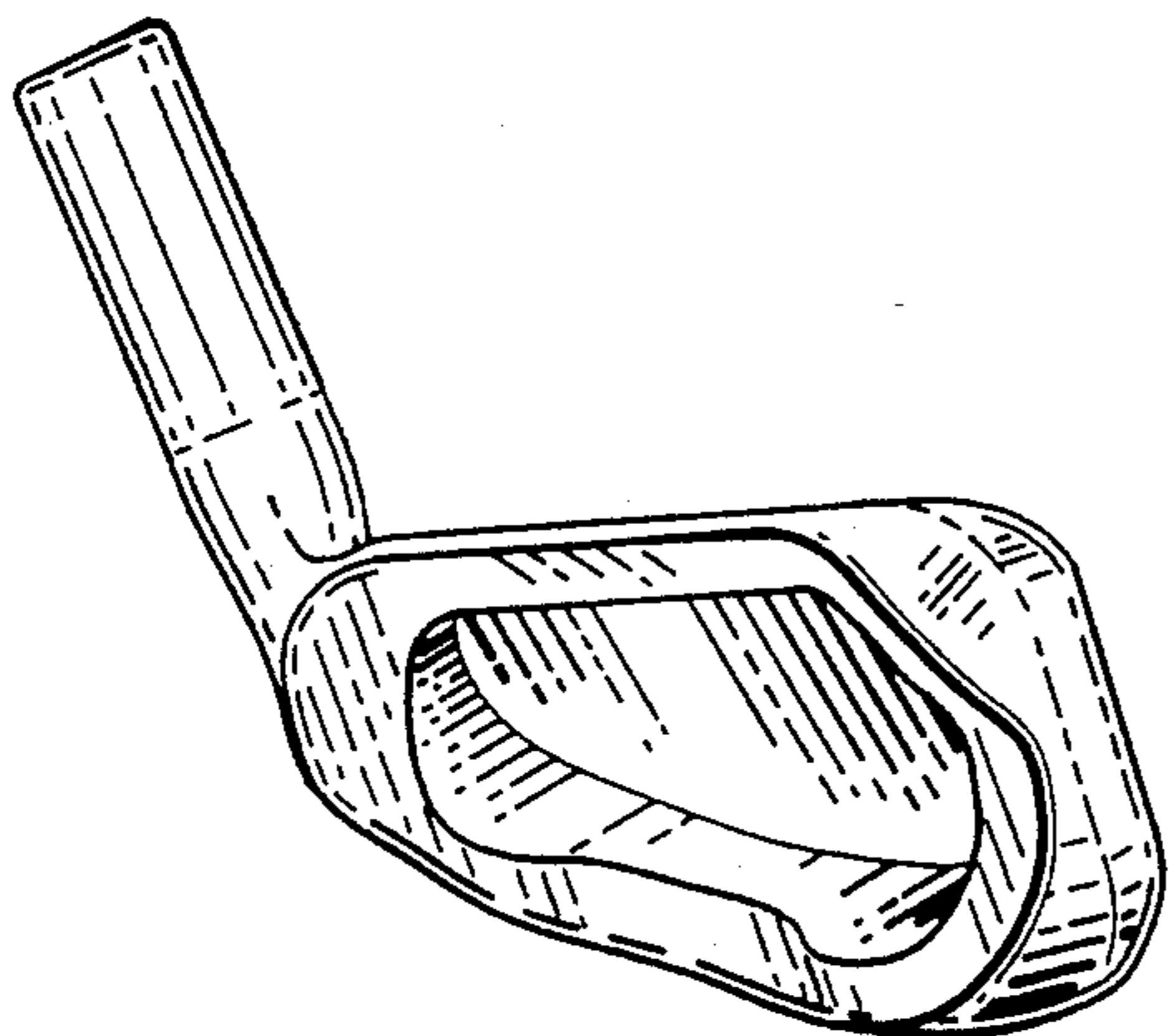

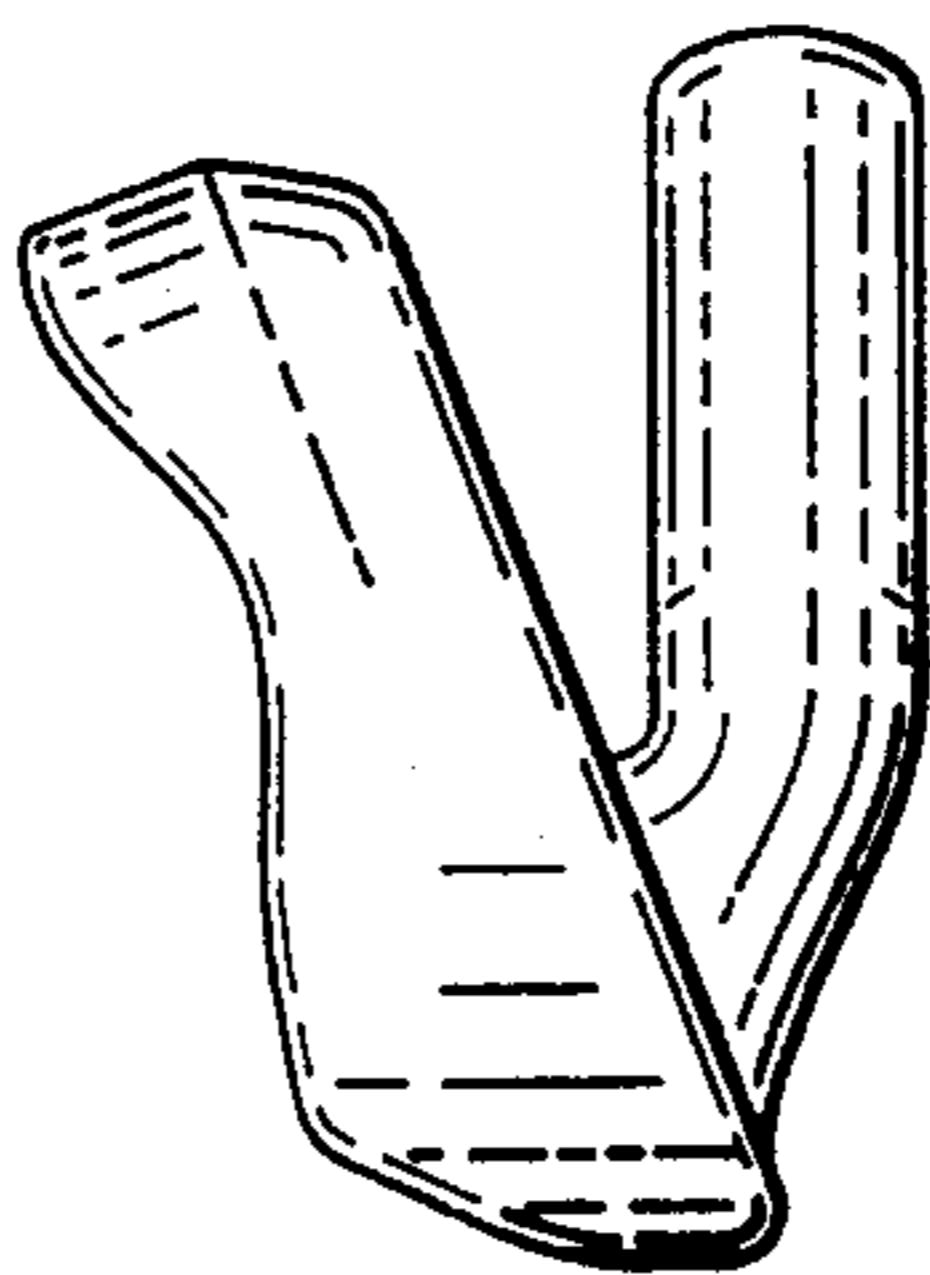

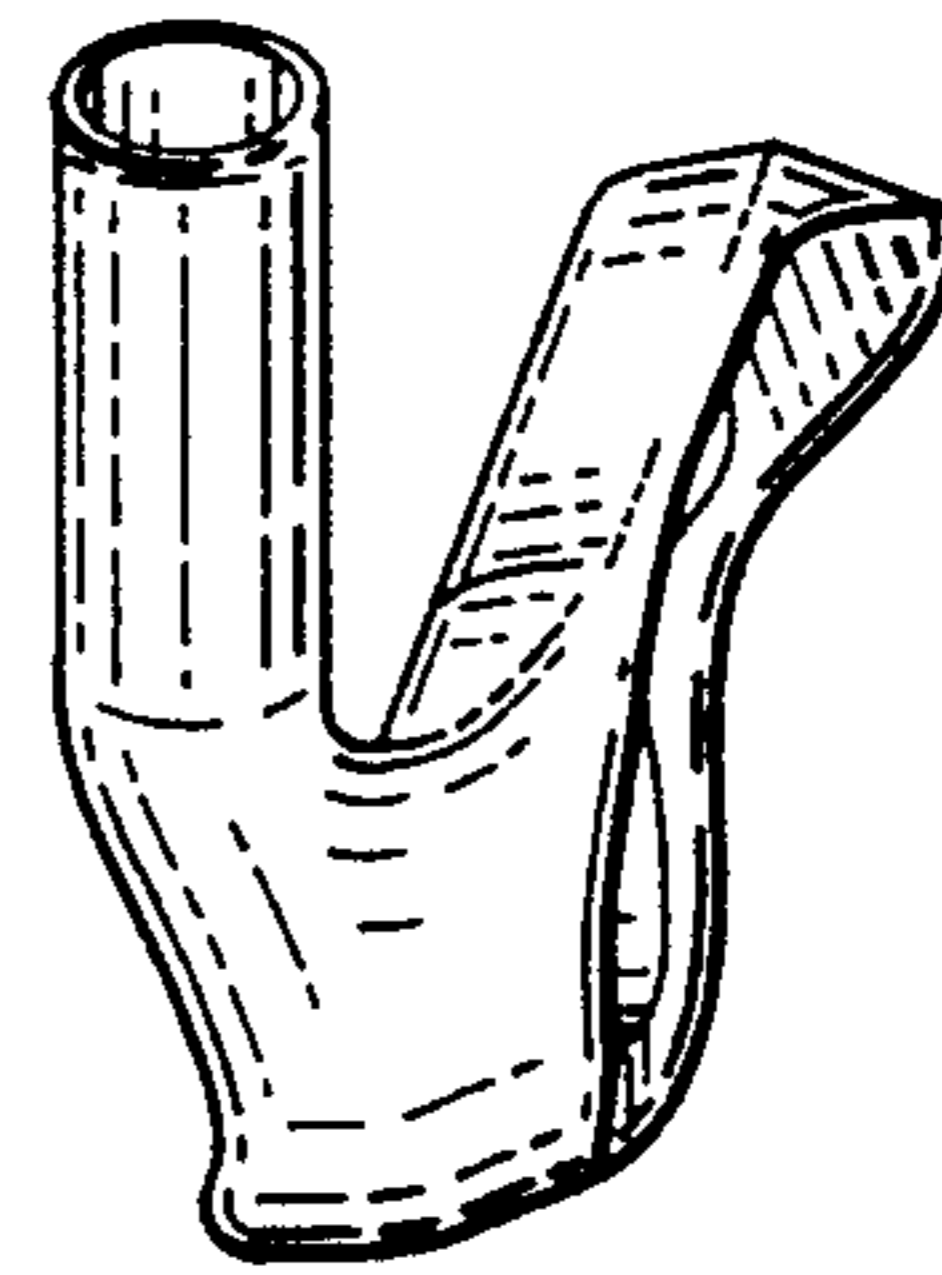

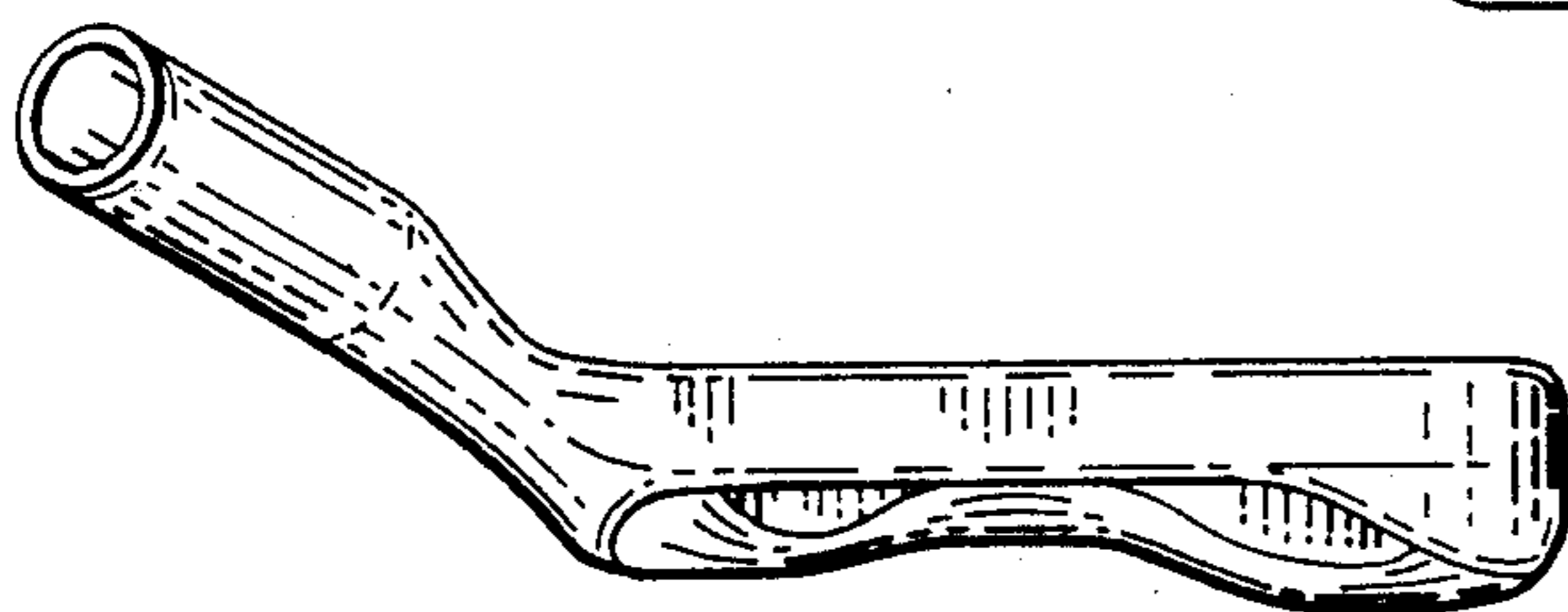

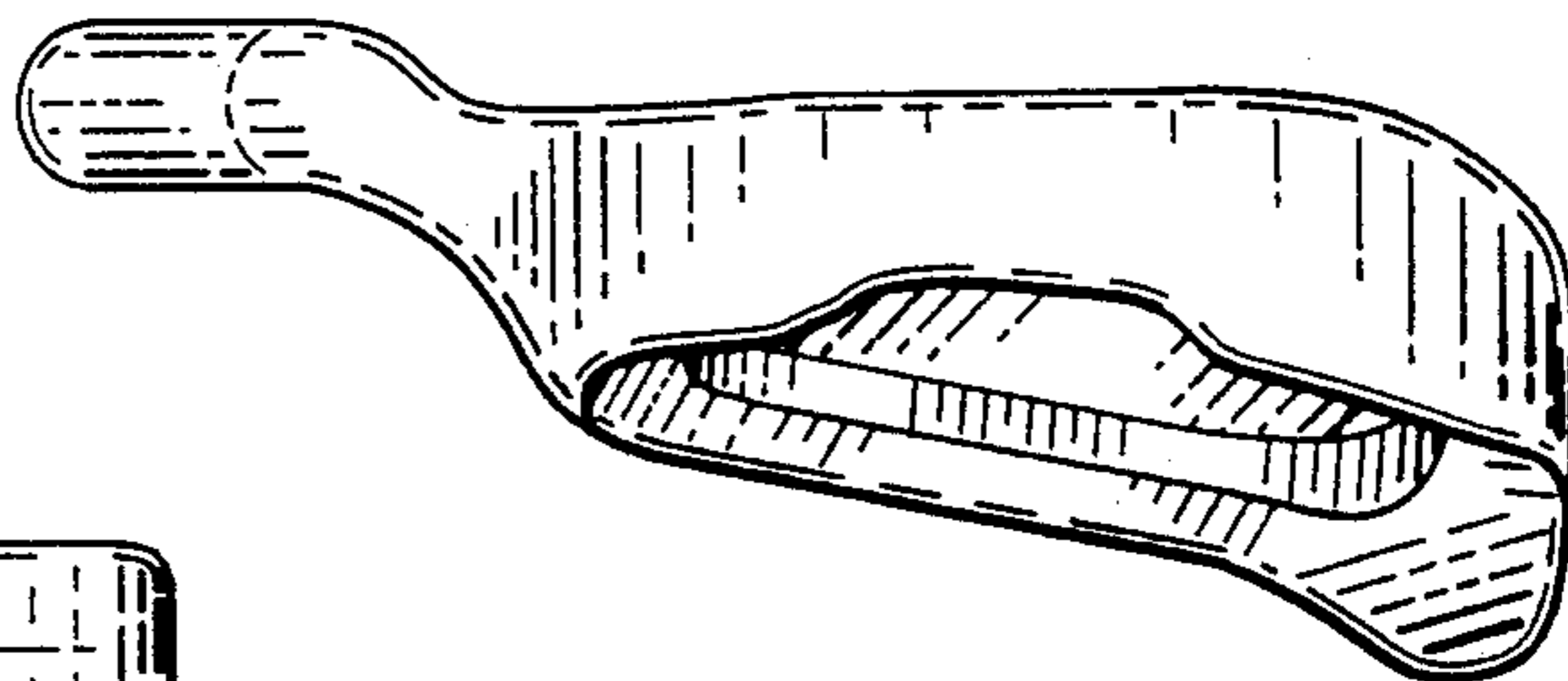

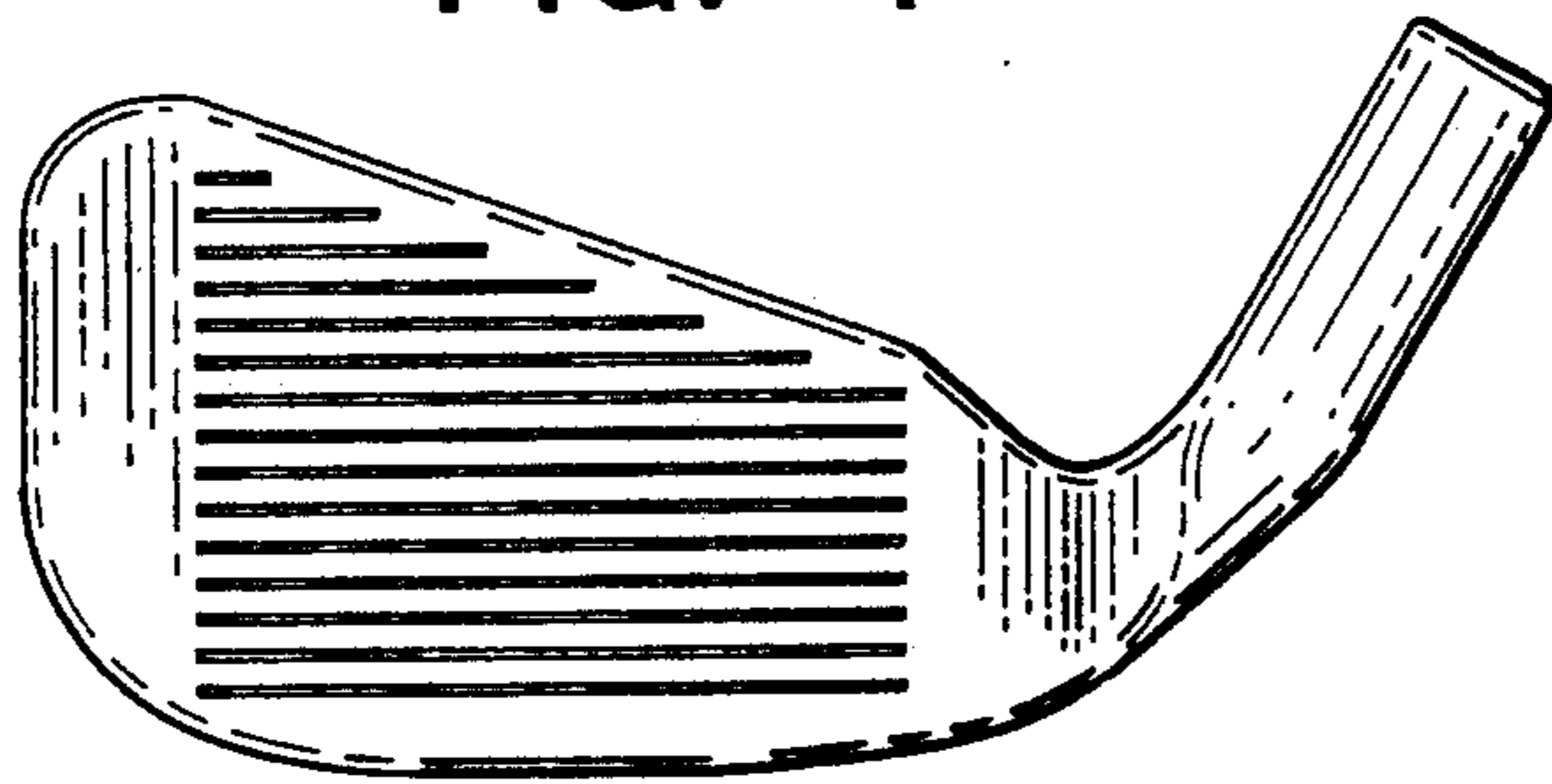

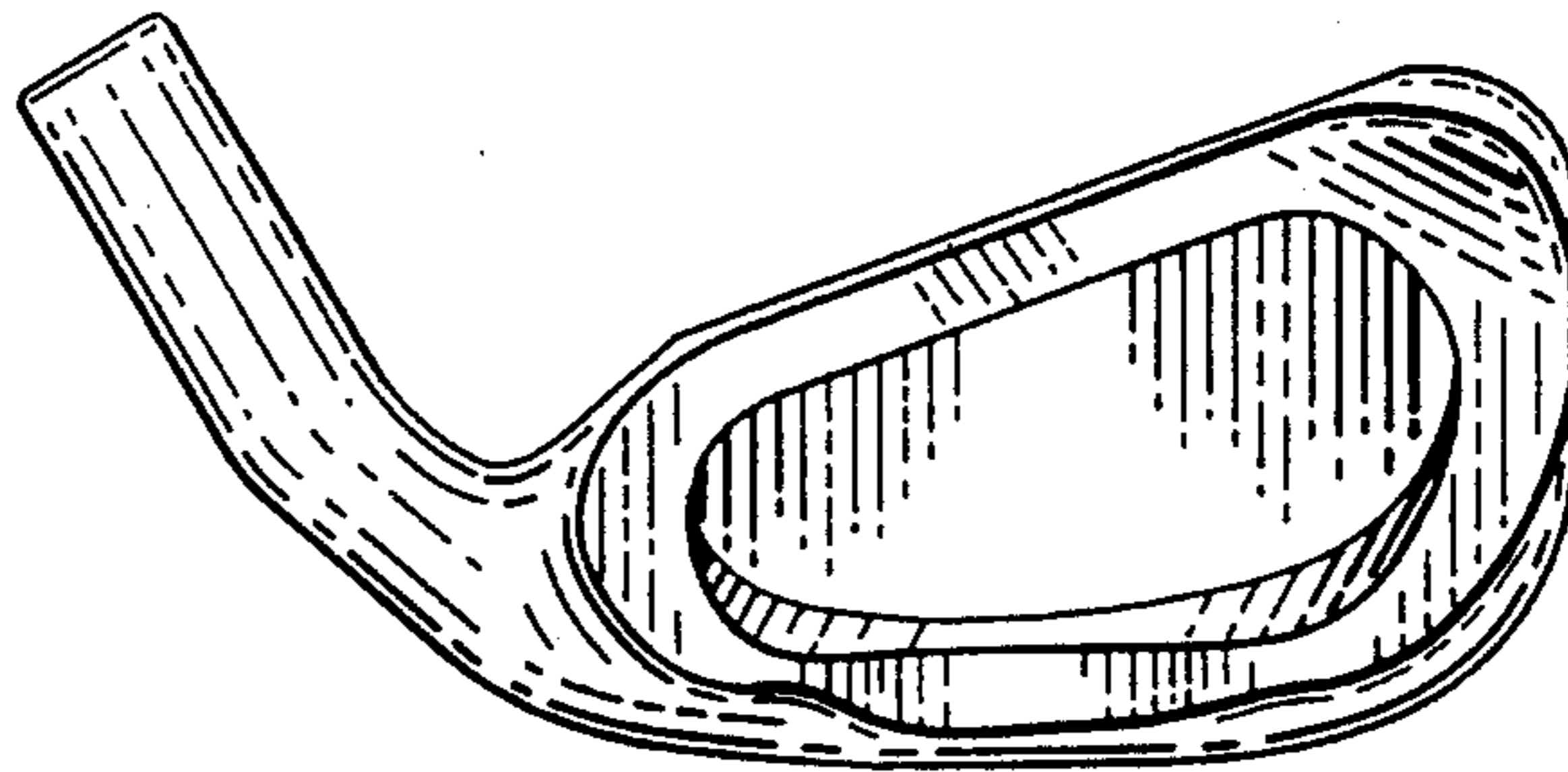

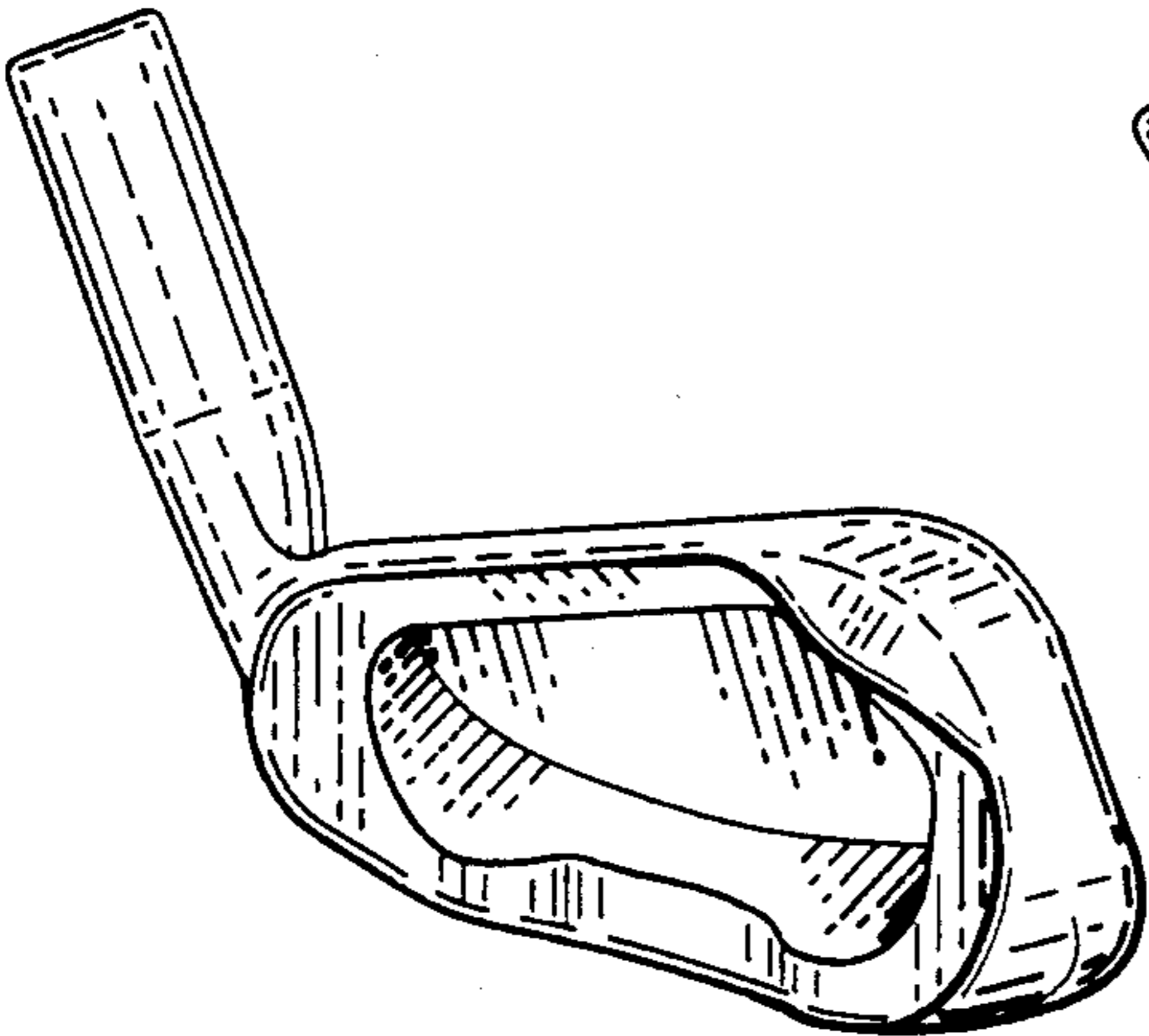

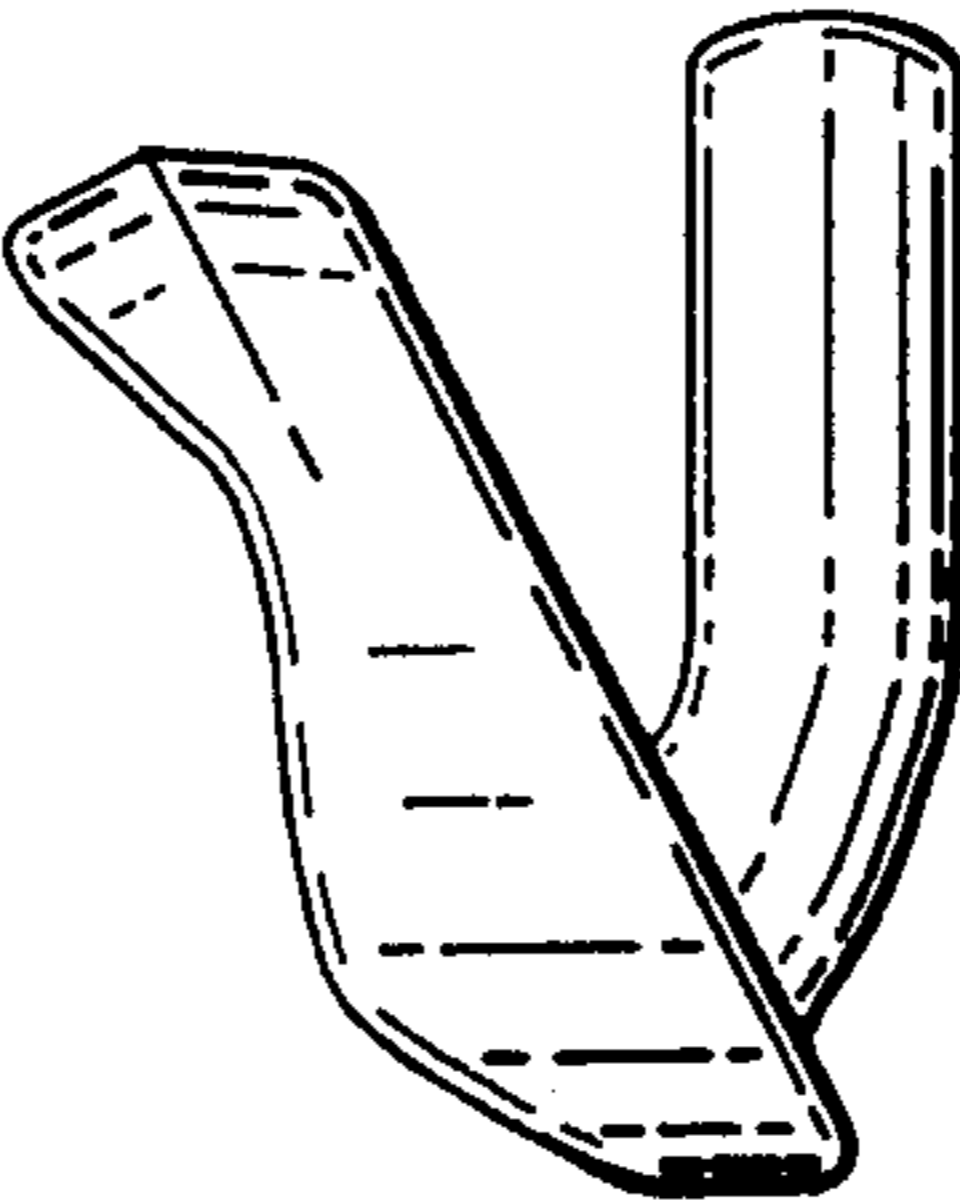

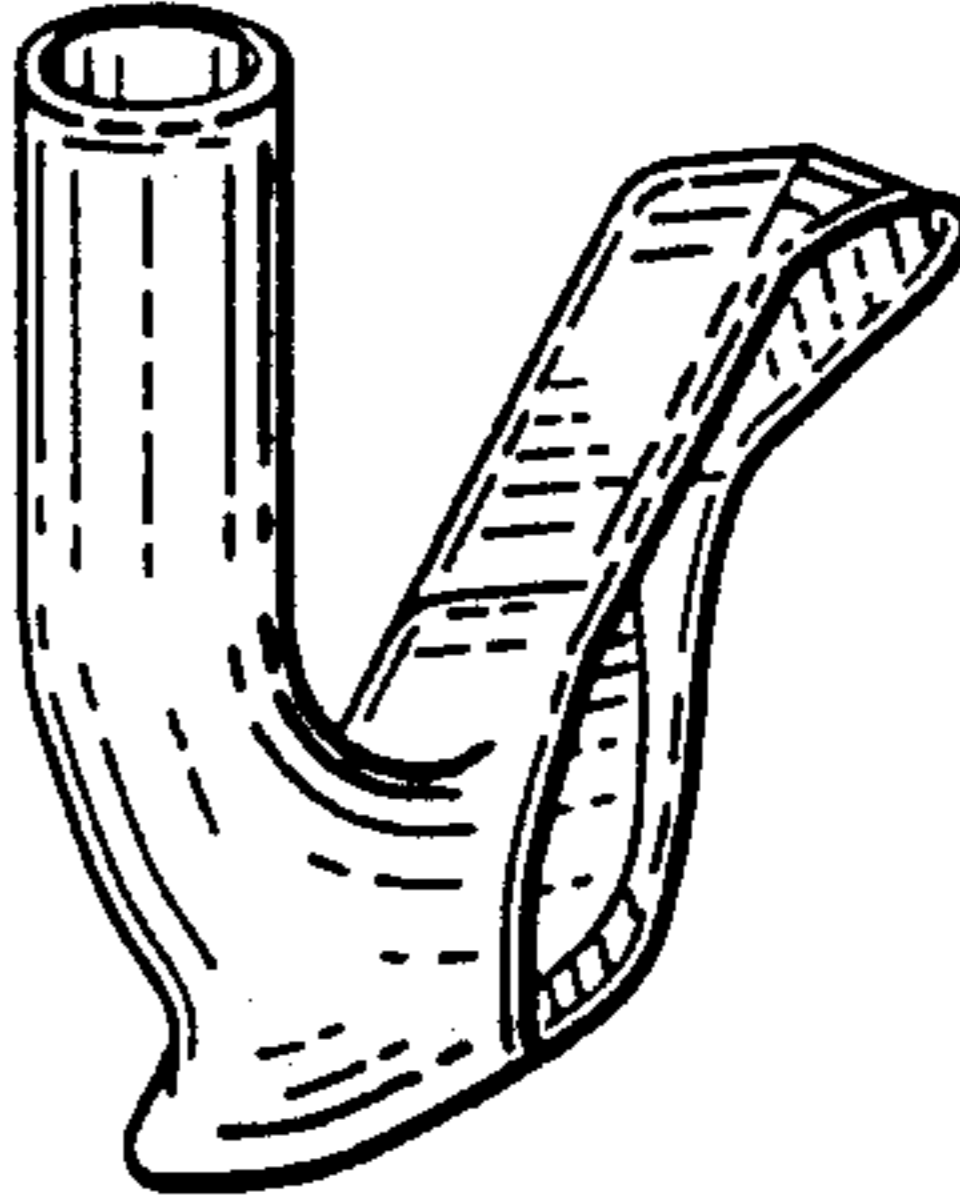

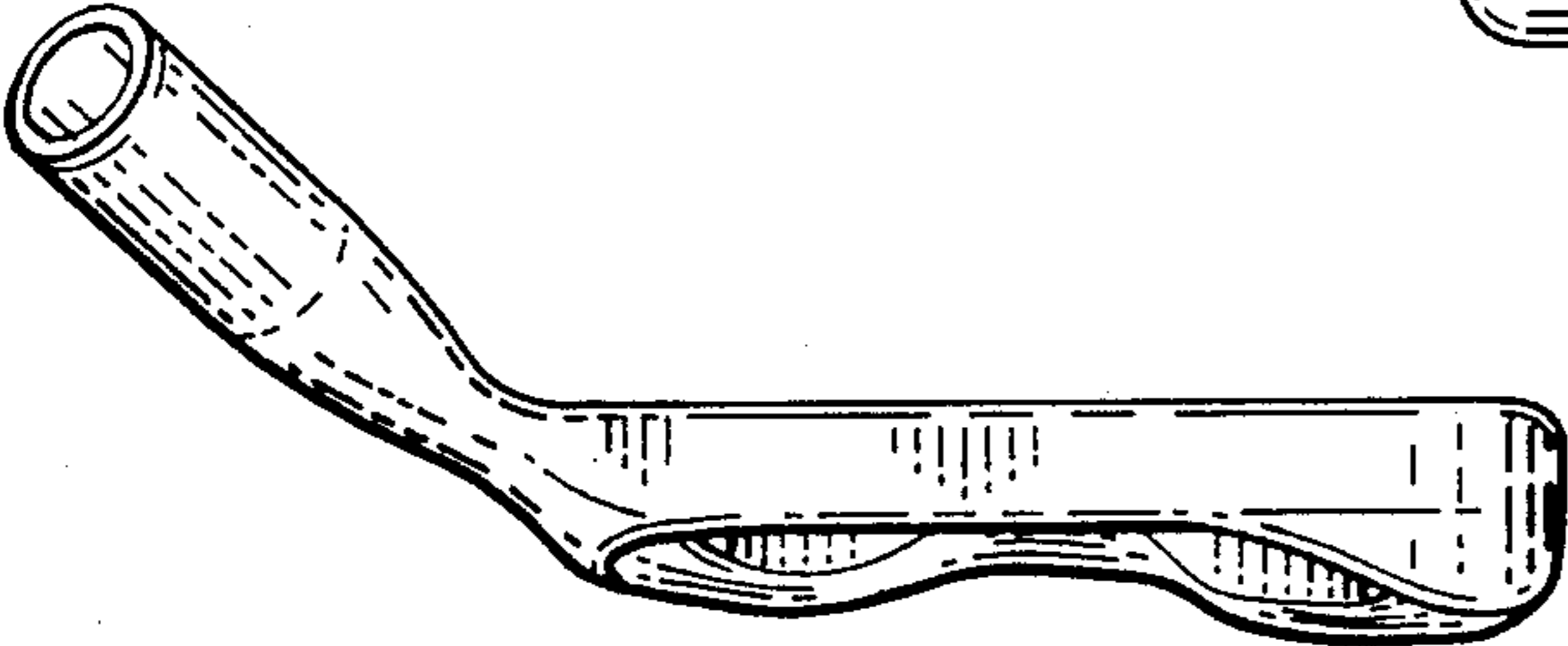

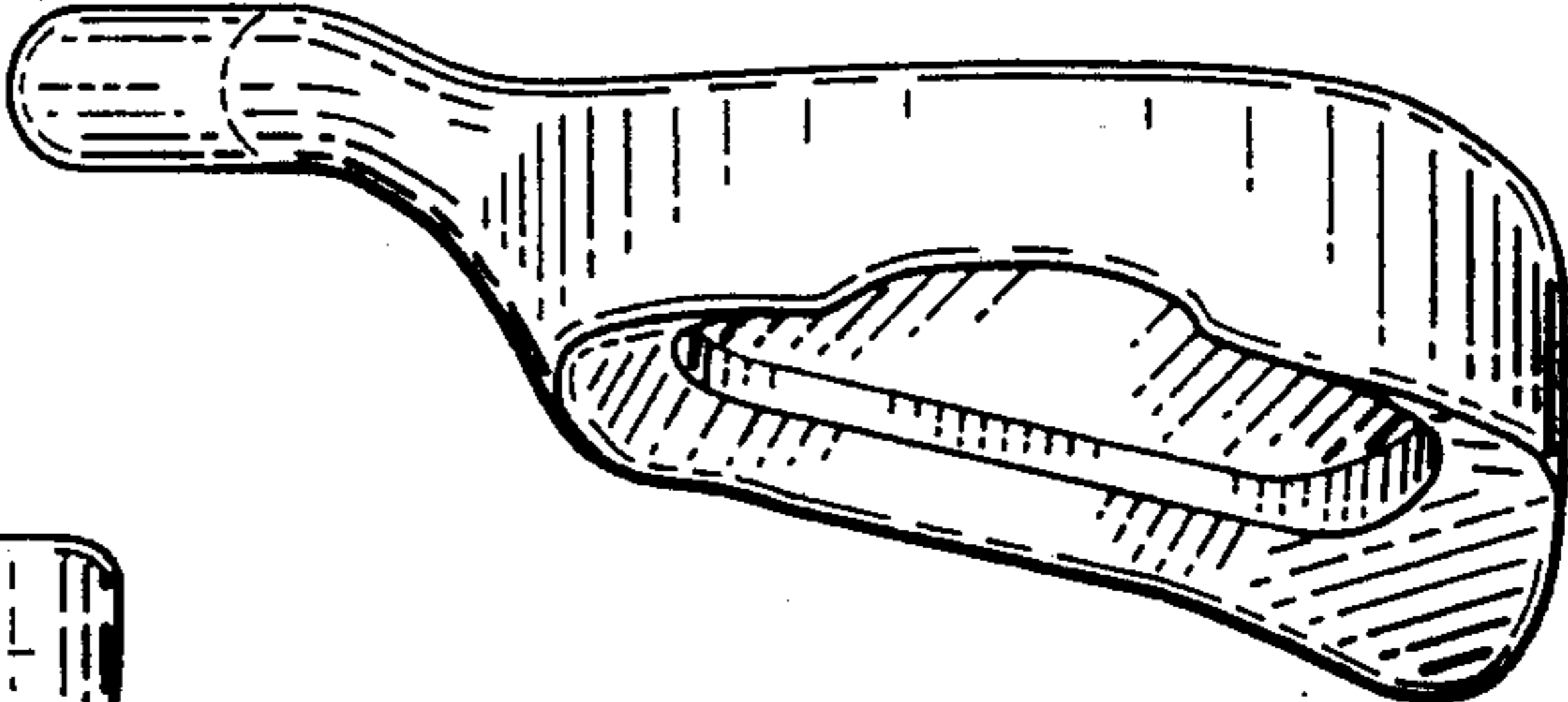

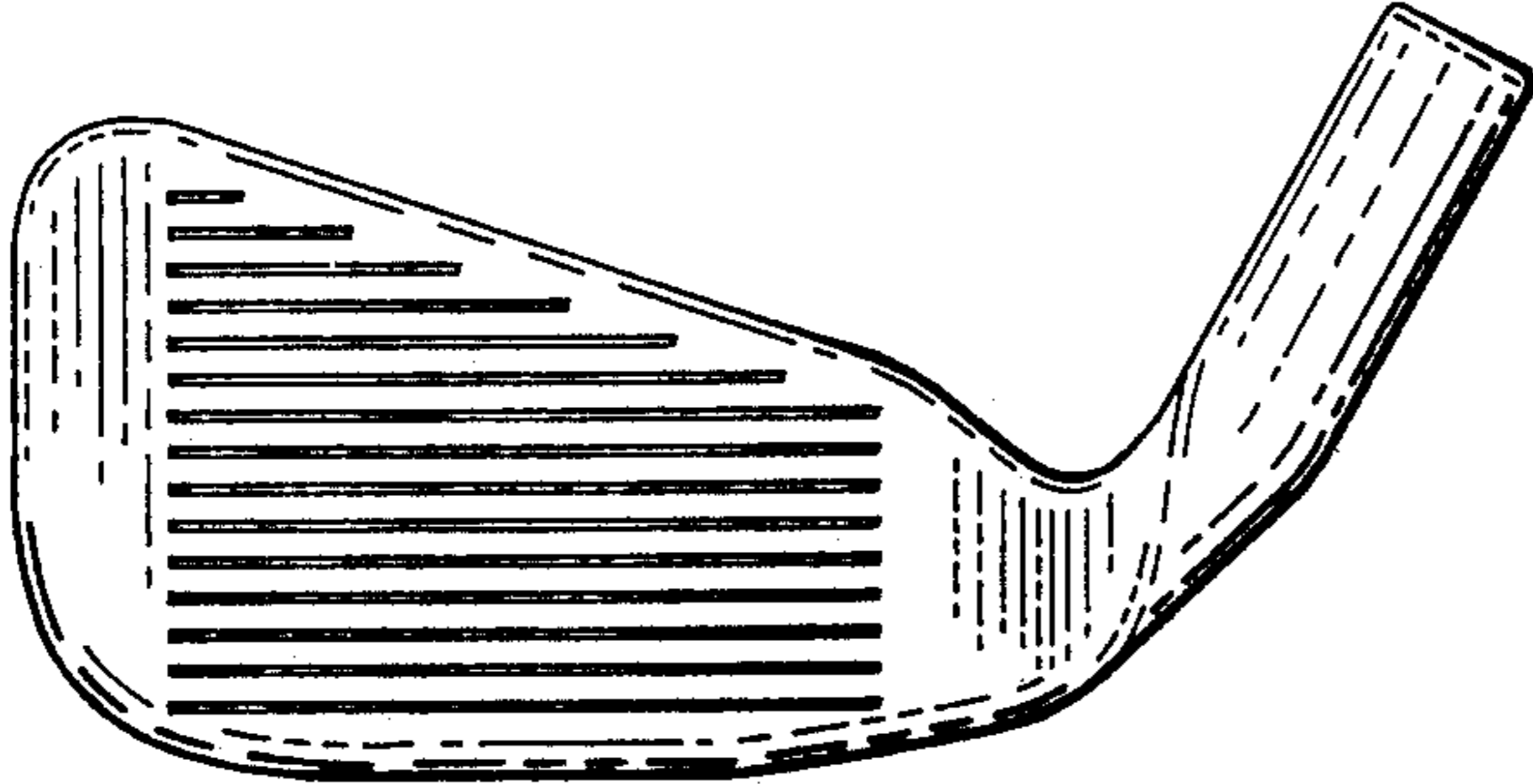

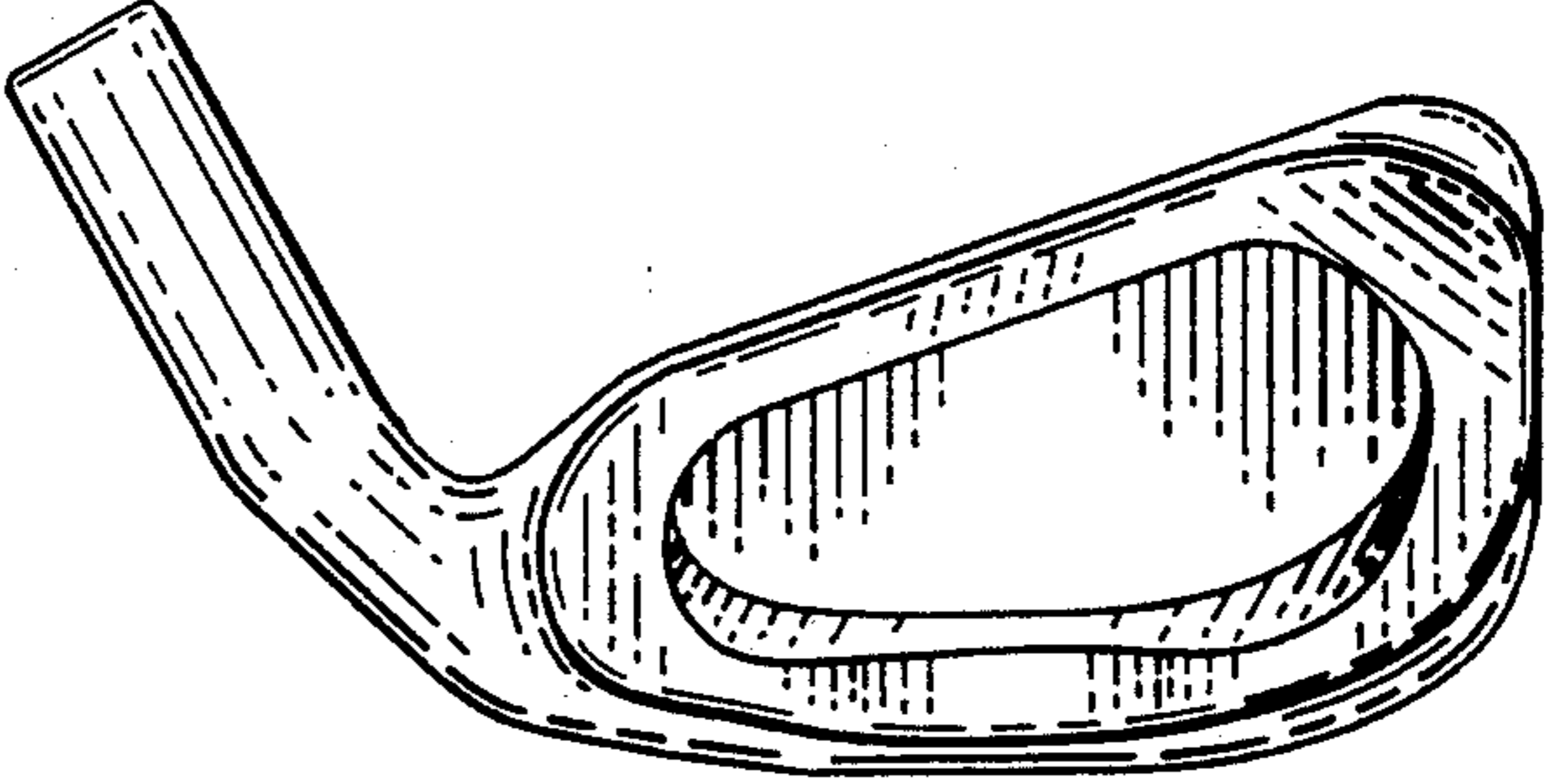

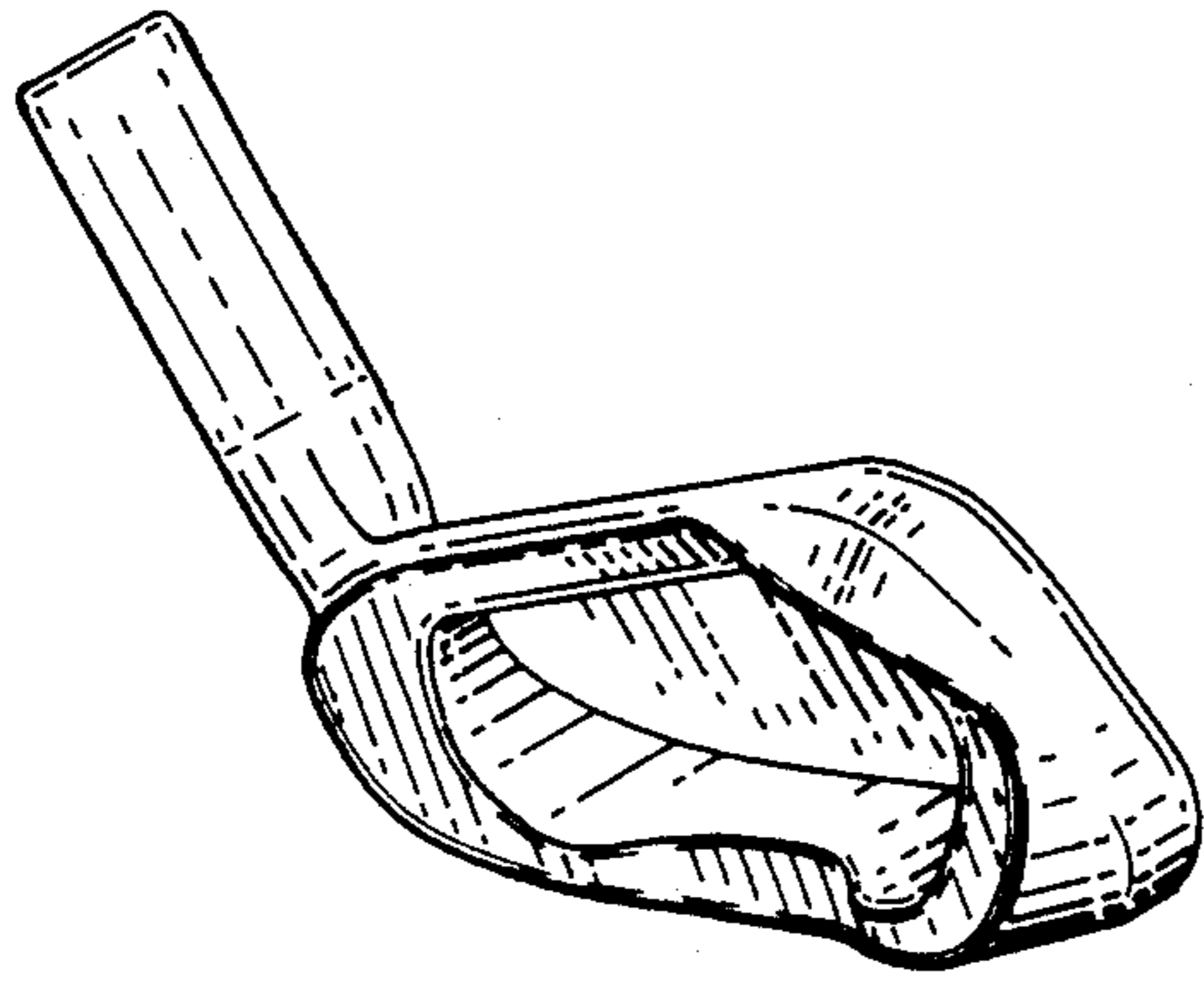

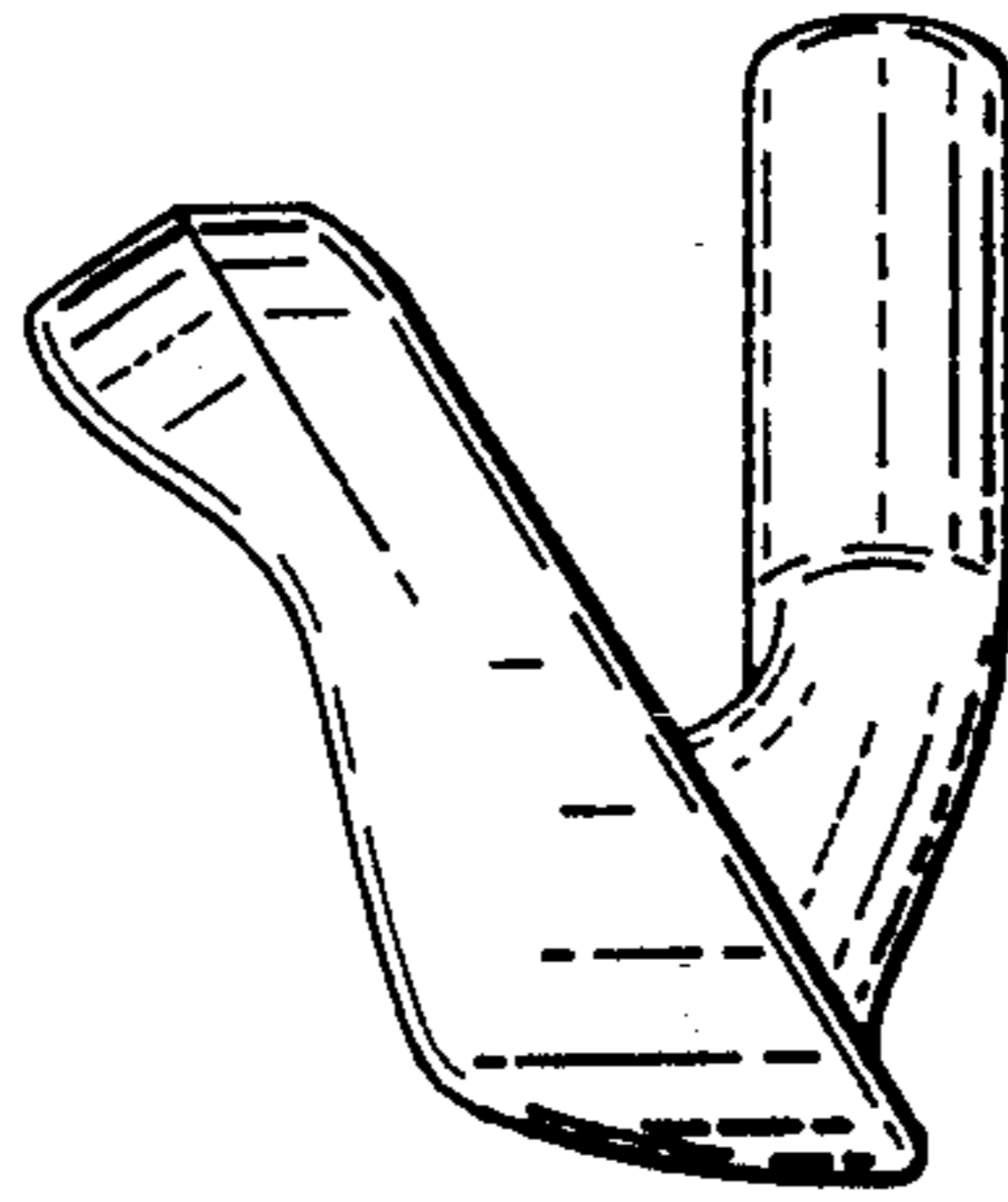

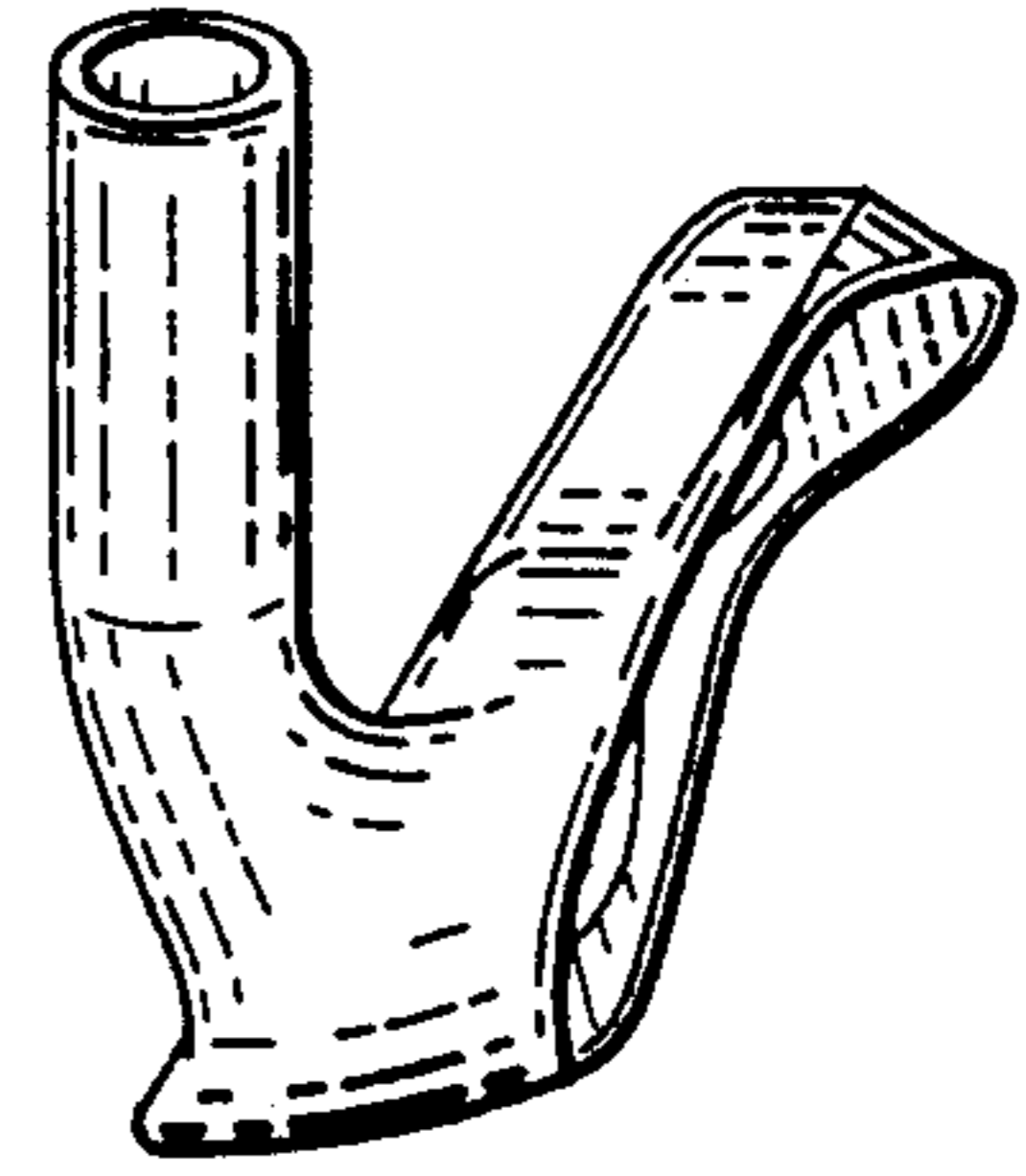

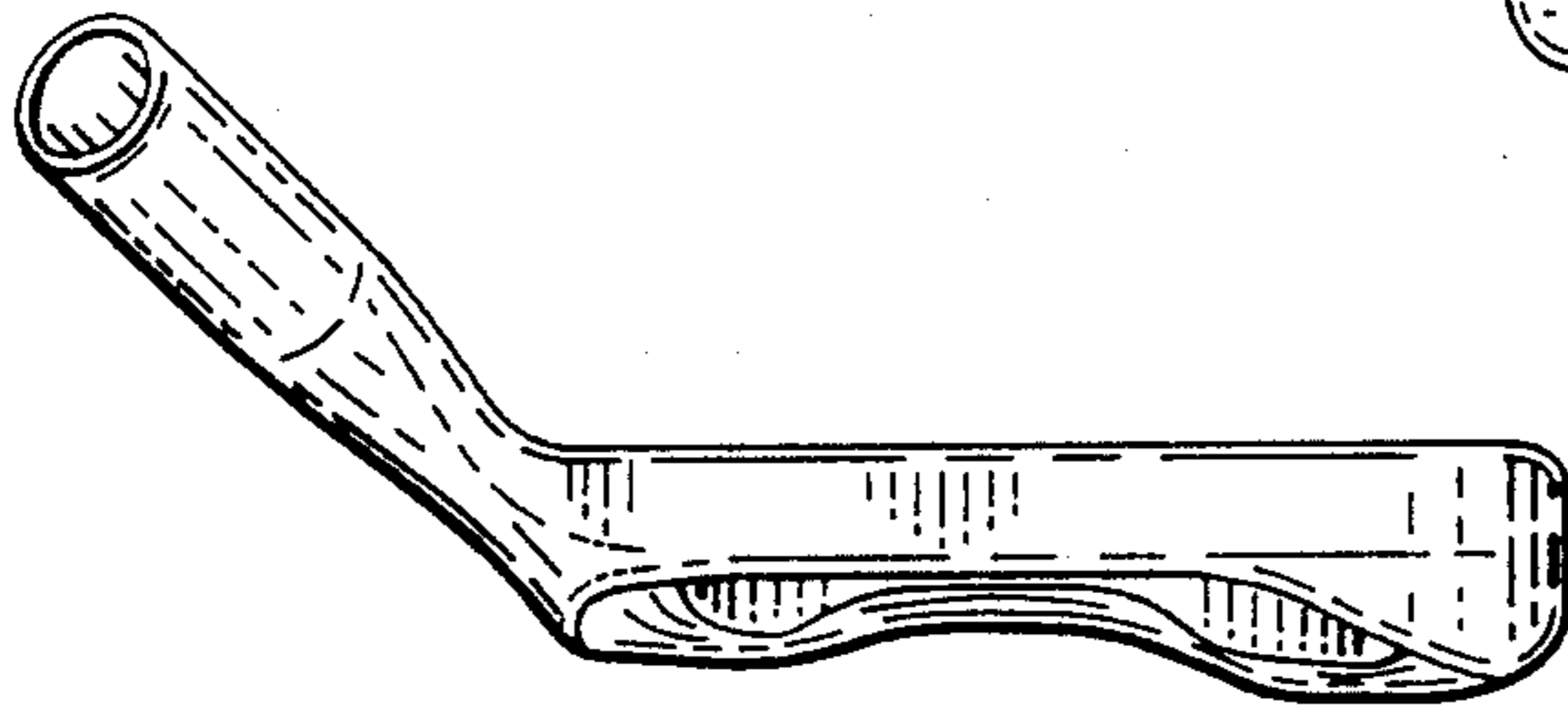

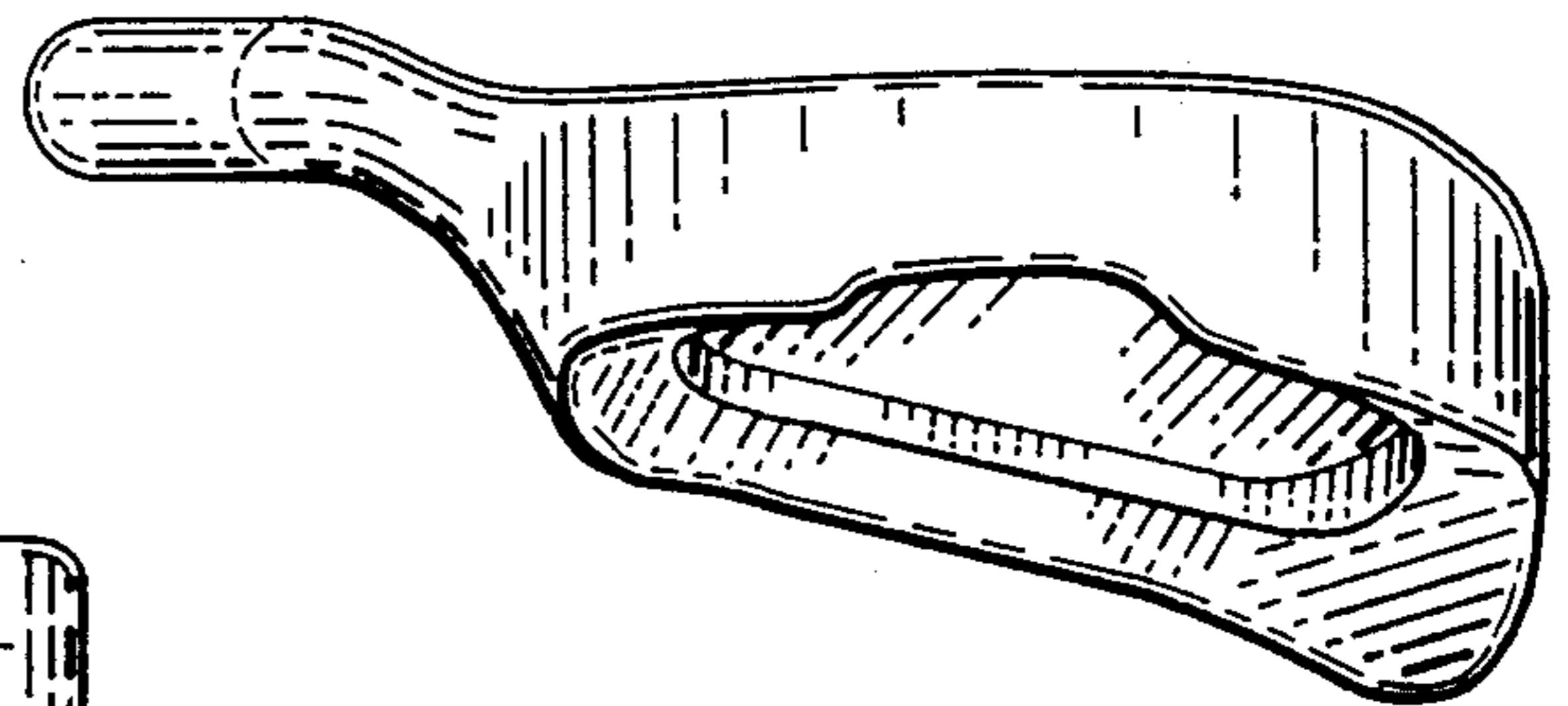

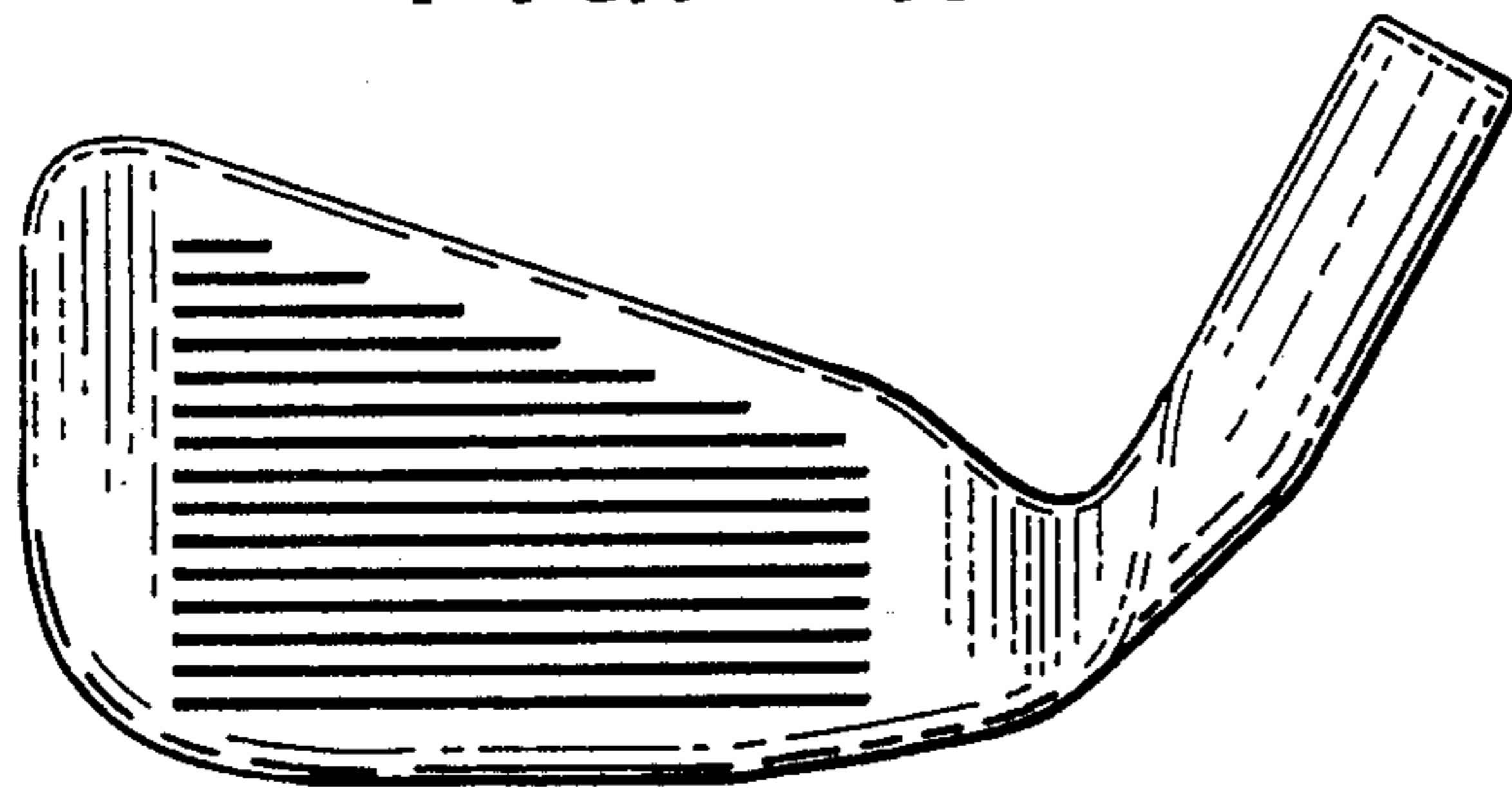

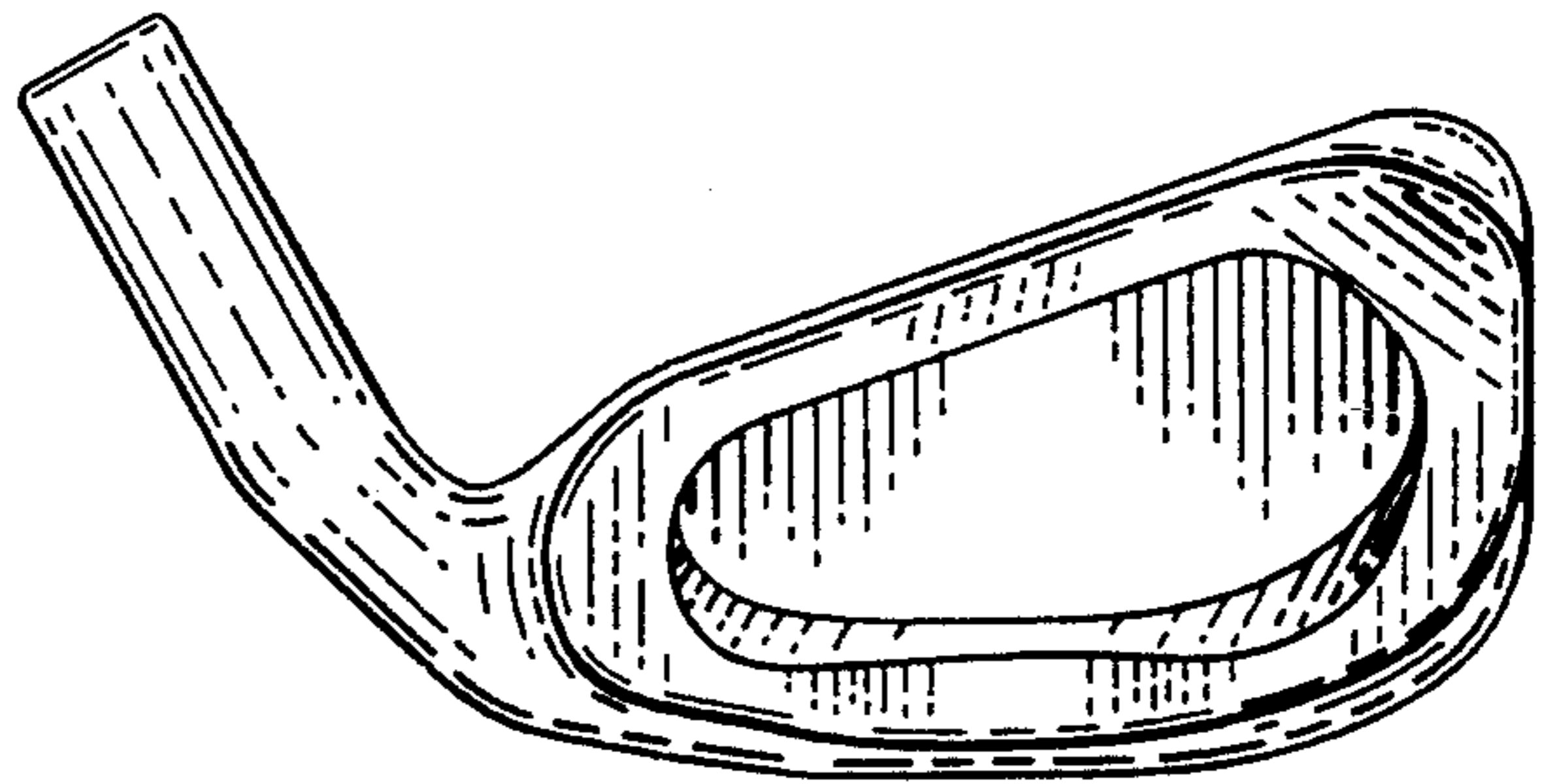

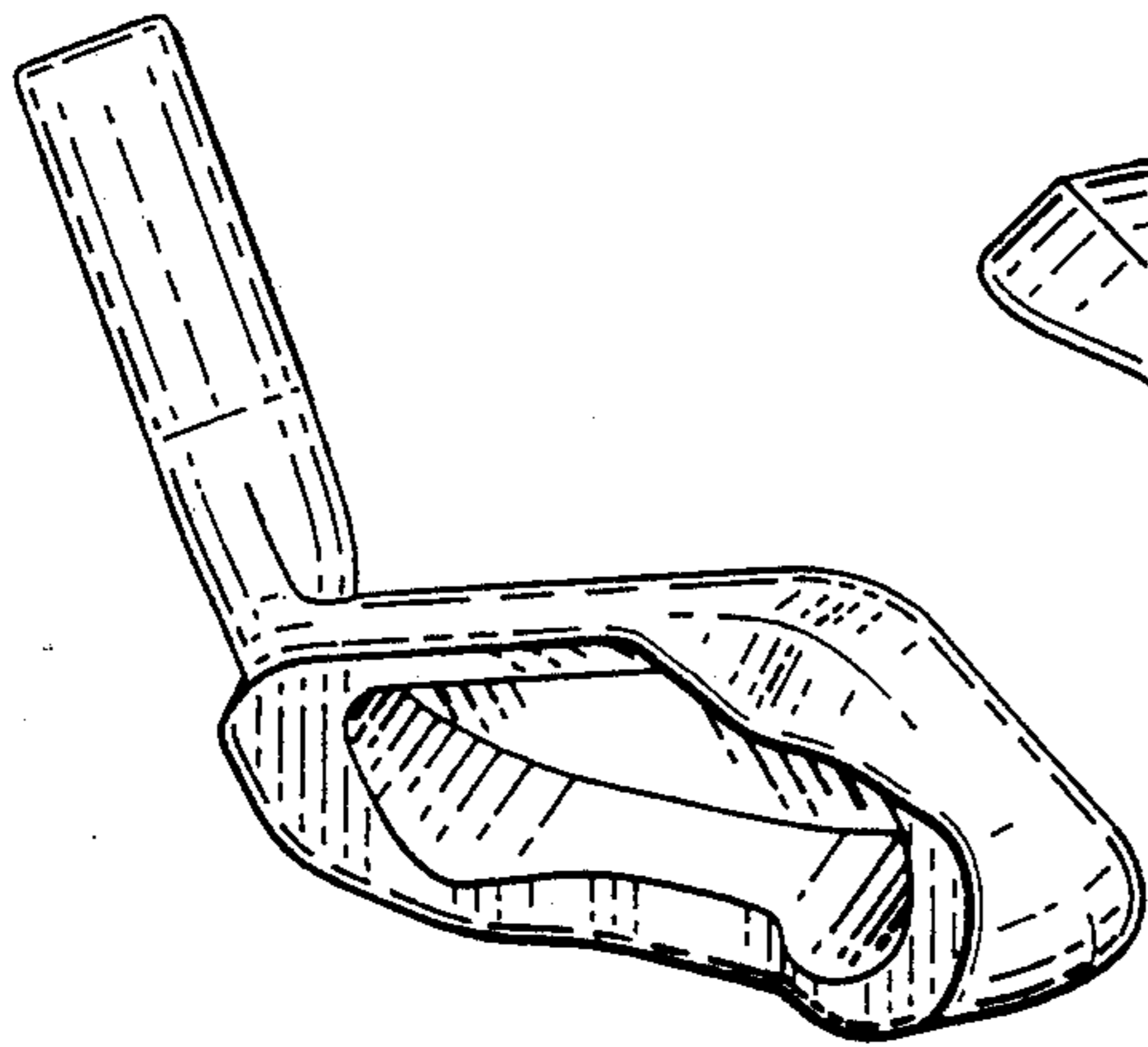

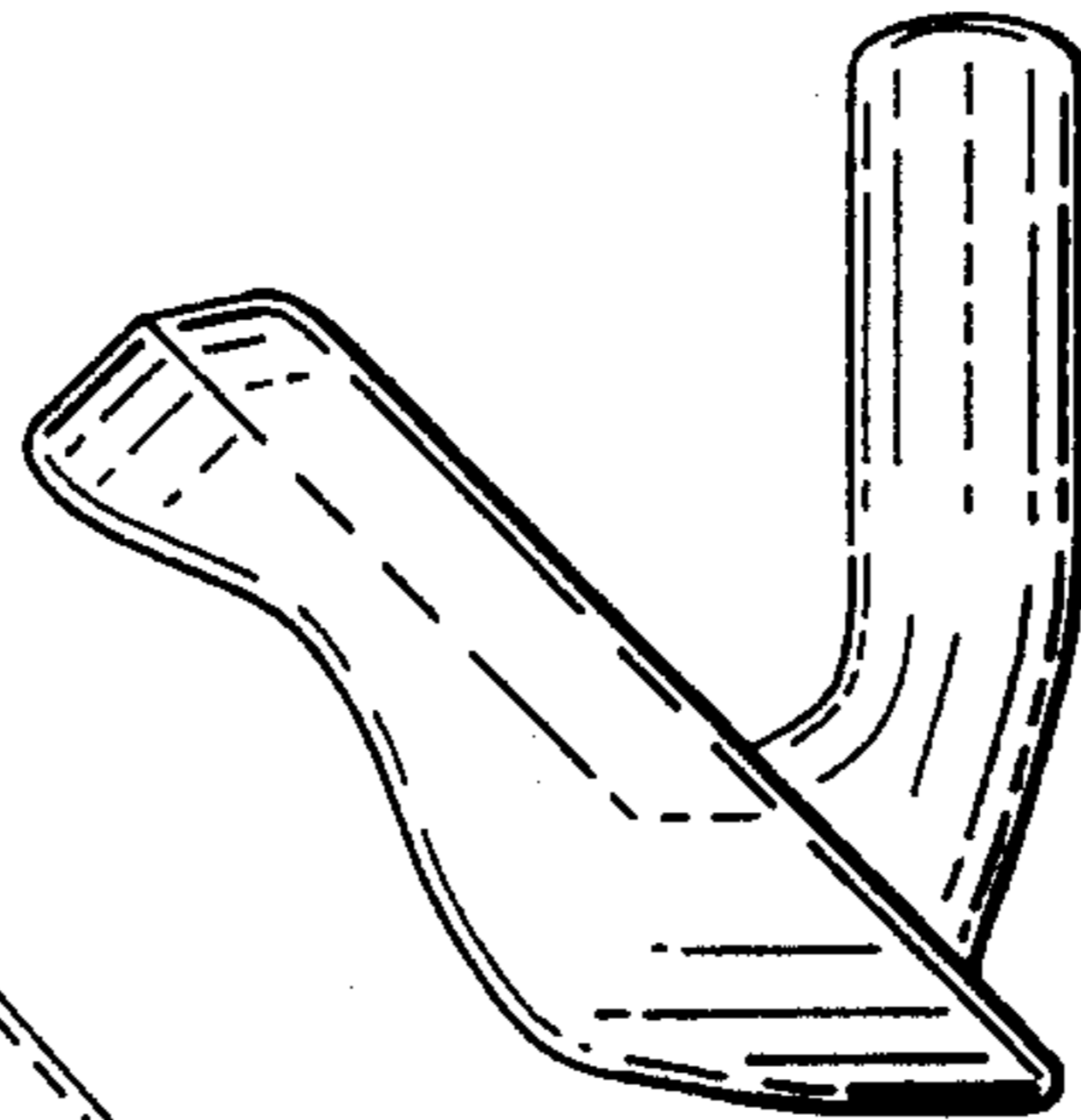

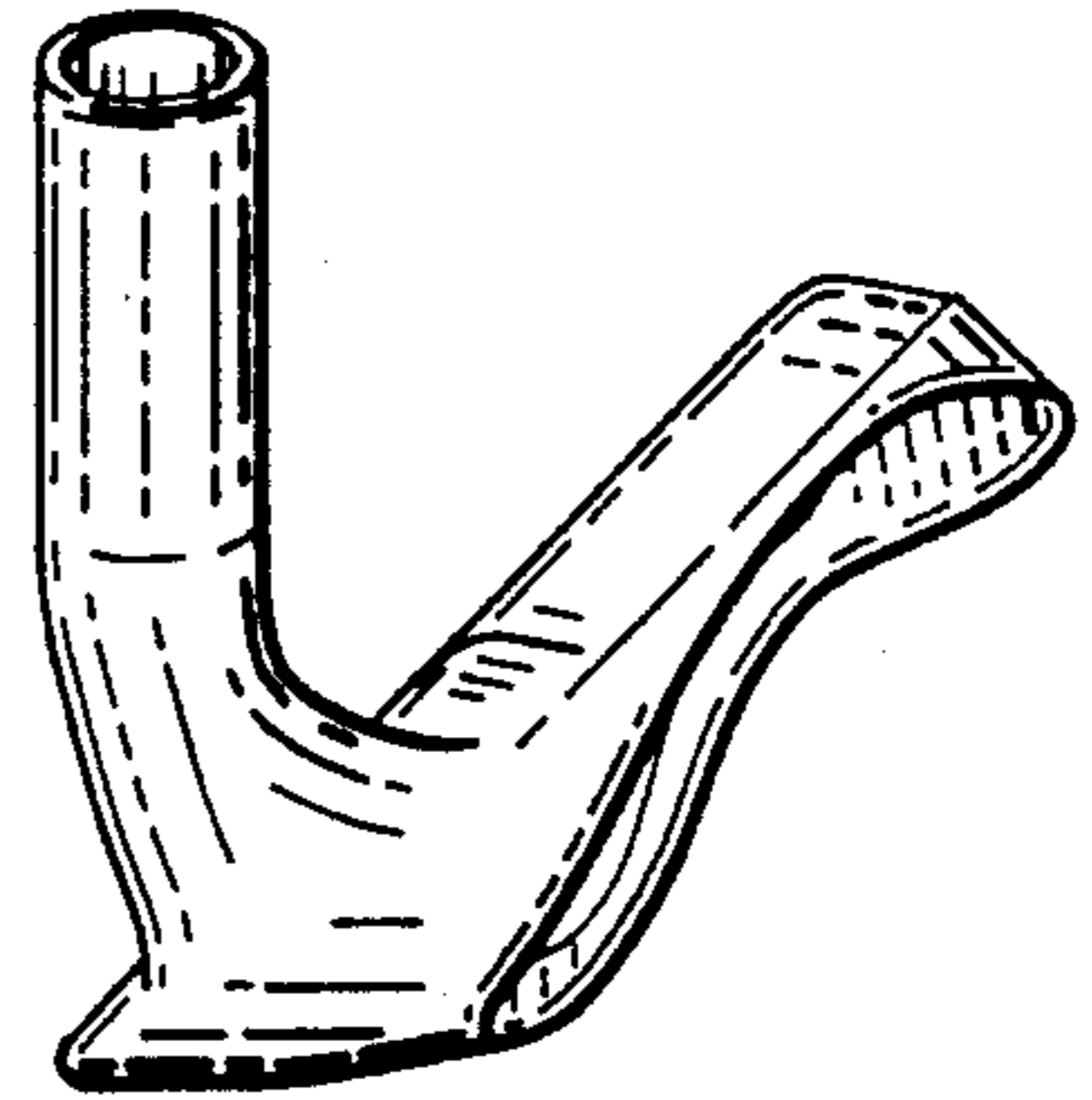

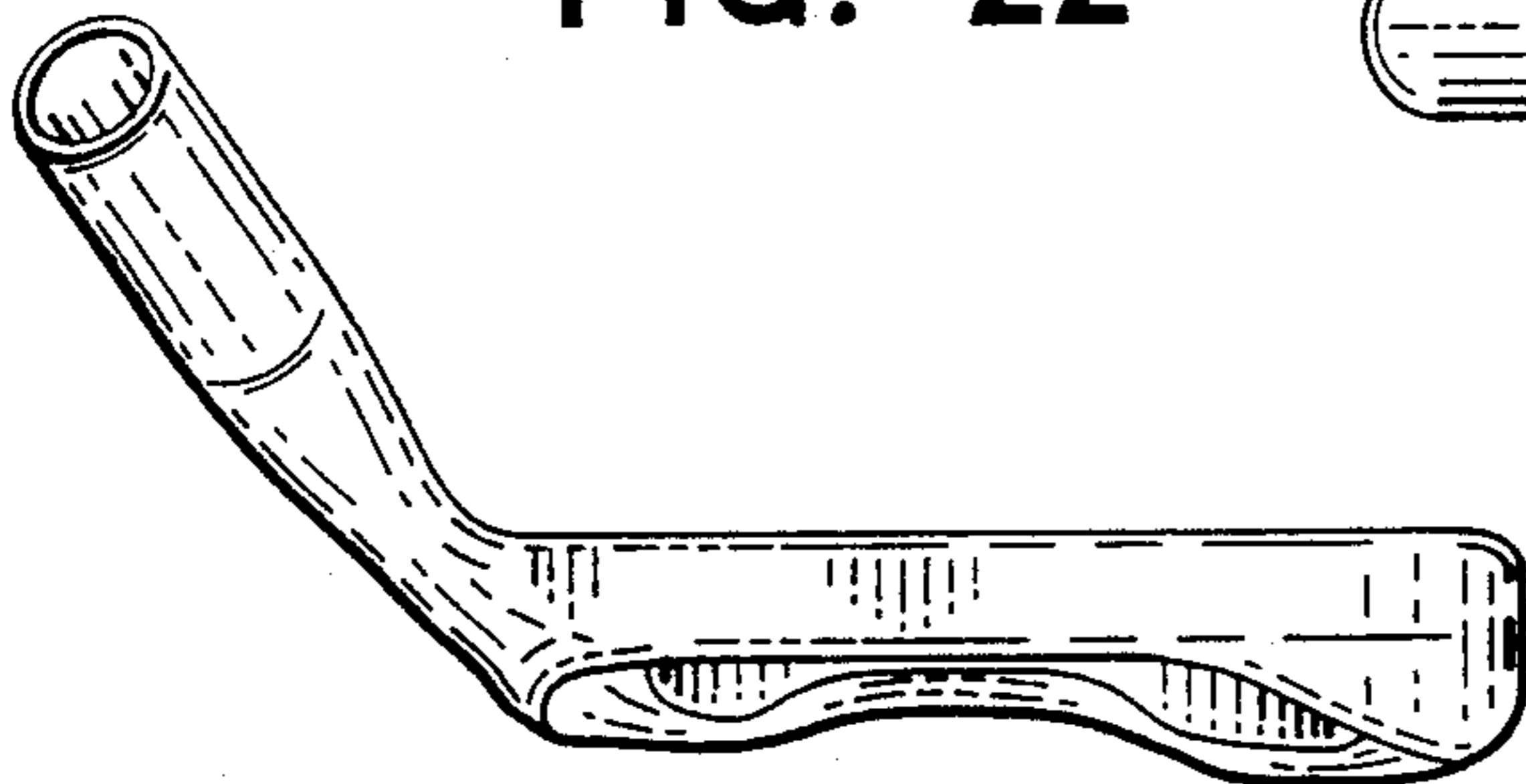

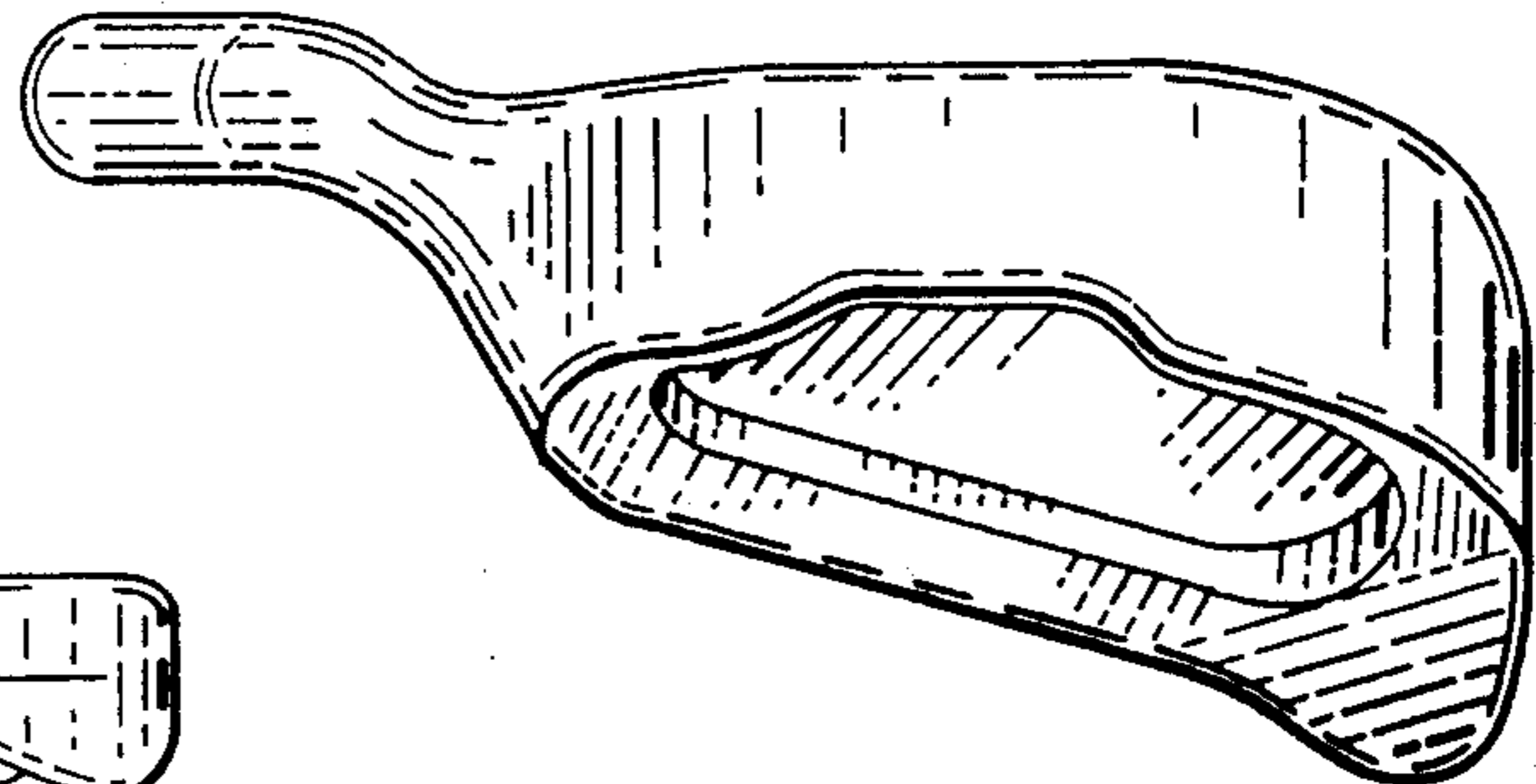

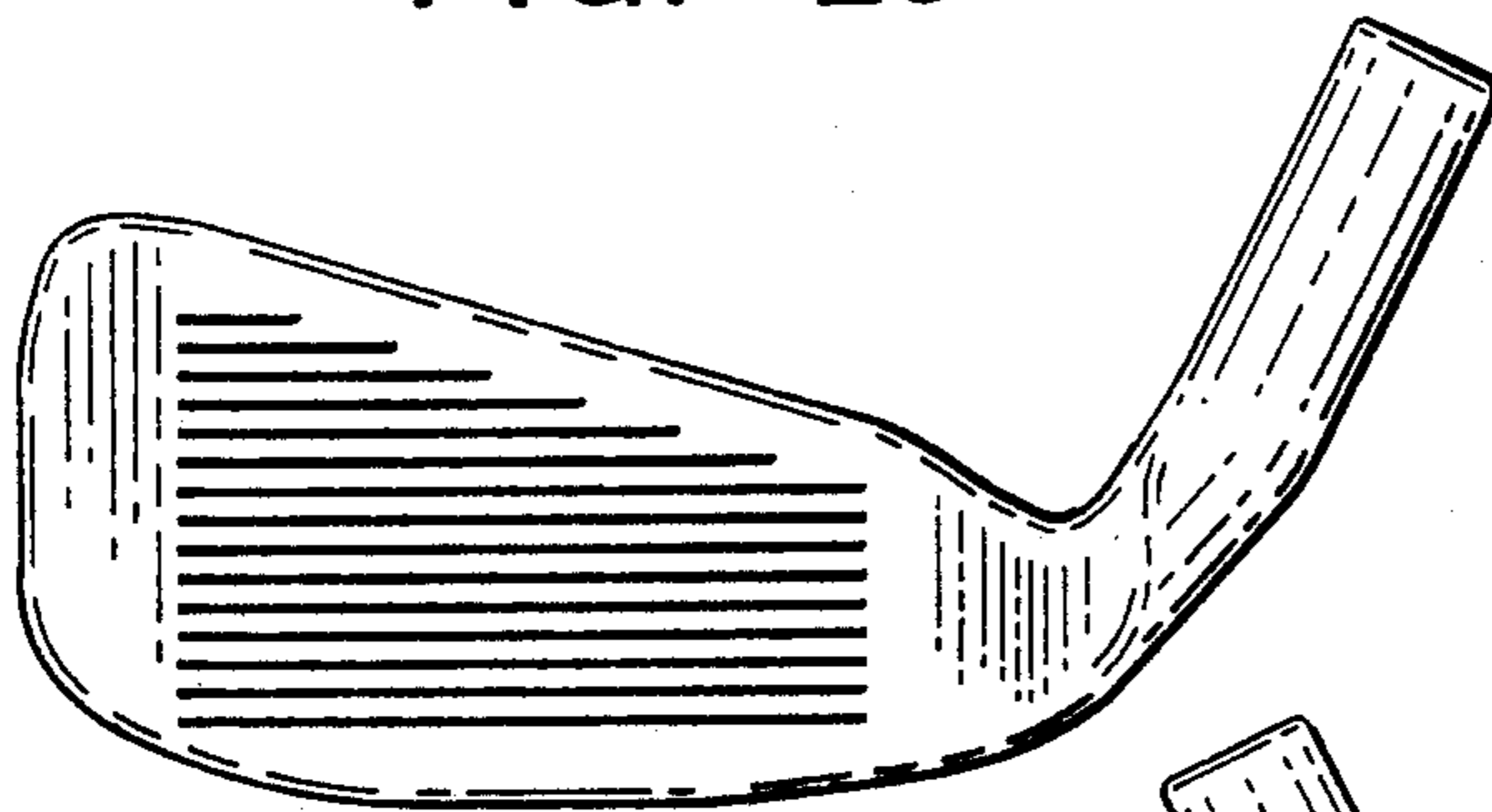

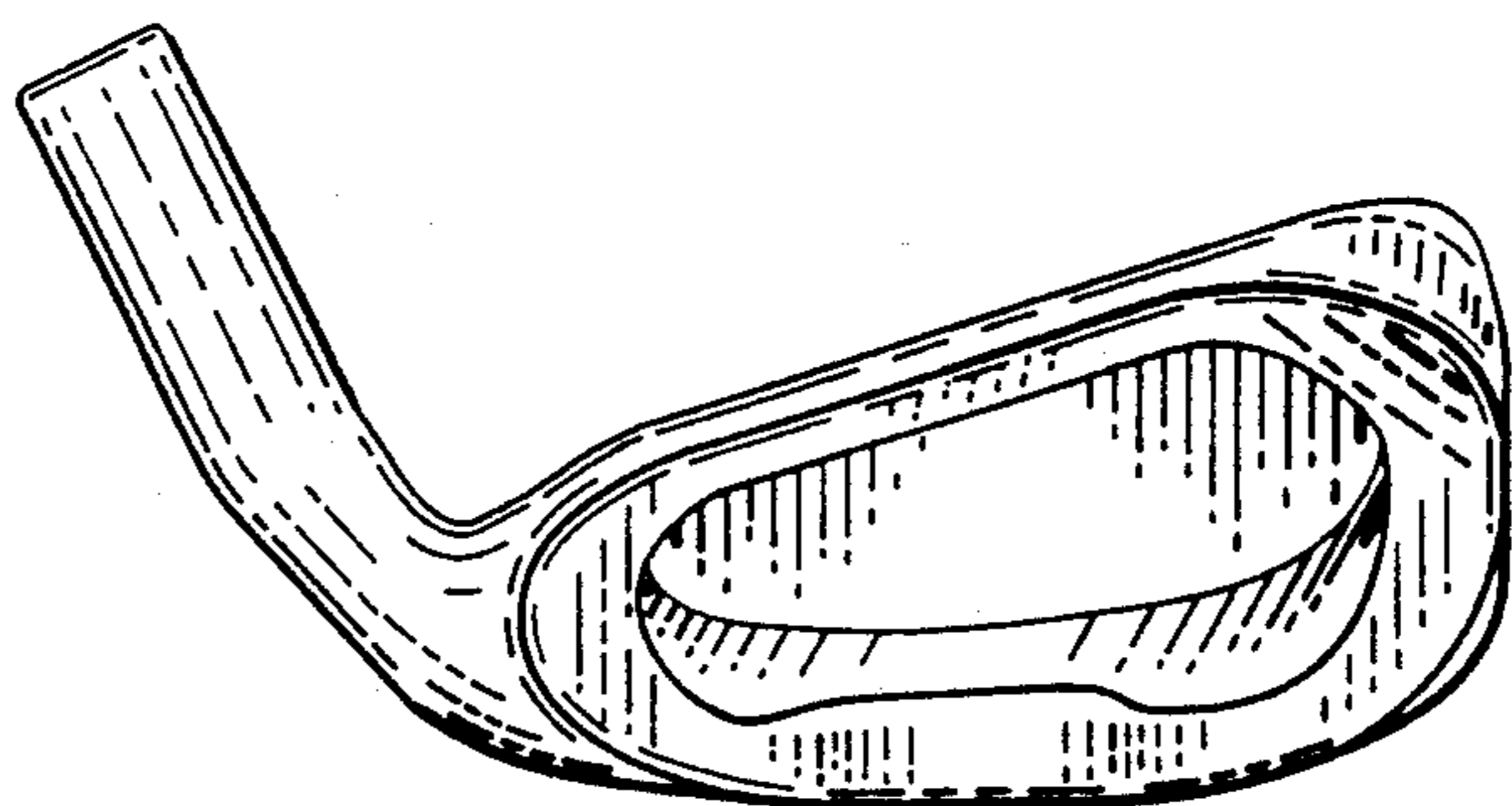
